He came to my attention the first time when this photograph was given to me by August

C. Roberts, who resides and is a newspaper reporter and photographer in Wayne, New Jersey.

71

That also happens to be your own photographer.

72

Yes, he's a photographer.

73

00:03:16,220 --> 00:03:19,260

Therefore, our less reliable witness because he works for you, right?

74

He's a photographer, our organization, the National Investigations Committee on UFOs.

75

And he gave me this photograph and he said, this is a fellow whose photograph we took

I said, that and the self is not too conclusive.

But the fact is that this fellow, when I met him several years later in Washington, had

83

on the radio and talk about bringing an 800 pound dog back from the moon and a potato

84

that weighed 200 pounds?

85

00:03:58,900 --> 00:04:02,860

No, I think you're confused with a little fellow down the backwoods of Missouri.

86

No, this was Highbridge, New Jersey.

87

00:04:05,460 --> 00:04:07,900

And he said that the saucers used to come down his backyard.

88

00:04:07,900 --> 00:04:10,060

I'll never forget Highbridge, New Jersey.

89

This fellow used to go on different programs in New York.

90

No, I haven't heard this about the fellow in New Jersey.

91

I heard this about the fellow in Missouri.

92

Did you meet Valiant Thorne?

93

Yes, I did.

94

00:04:18,840 --> 00:04:20,760

I spoke with him for the period of 30 minutes.

95

And did you look at his fingertips?

96

I looked at his fingertips and he had no scars, no burn marks, no bruises, in fact, no fingerprints

97

on any of his 10 fingers.

Did you photograph his fingers?

99

No, I didn't because I had no photographic equipment.

Remember, this was the inside of the Pentagon building where he took the camera and the

The man didn't get his fingerprints.

Because at the time he was taking these photographs, he did not know that Valiant Thorne had no

Who finally told him?

I've never heard that about Mr. Menger.

114

Yes, and the Highbridge, New Jersey was his former home, as I recall.

115

Yes, that's right.

116

00:05:12,820 --> 00:05:15,220

Now, now, it's all coming back to you, isn't it?

117

Not about the dog.

118

00:05:16,220 --> 00:05:21,240

That's amazing, that news that Howard Menger with these rife things happening in the large

119

potato and the 800-pound dog, and the saucer's coming into his backyard, right?

120

00:05:25,360 --> 00:05:26,360

That's right.

We've seen that so many things.

122

And suddenly, Highbridge, New Jersey that nobody ever heard of before, we hear of it

123

once again.

This time Val Thorne, a mysterious person with no fingerprints, who comes from another world,

125

eh?

That's right.

127

Ding-a-ling, doctor.

128

Don't touch me.

129

00:05:42,160 --> 00:05:43,160

Ding-a-ling-a-ling.

130

00:05:43,160 --> 00:05:45,160

Oh, I wouldn't touch you for the world.

131

You'll have an explosion.

132

Now, doctor, tell us where we could find Val Thorne right now, please.

133

At the present time, Val Thorne is residing in Southern California in the city called

I see.

136

And what is Mr. Thorne's address?

137

I have no idea of his address, no idea of his telephone number, not even his zip code.

138

And yet, you have made a statement that Mr. Thorne comes to see you once a week.

139

Yes, he comes to Van Nuys on the average of once a week before I left for Europe.

140

So he knows where you live.

141

00:06:15,880 --> 00:06:16,880

Yes.

142

00:06:16,880 --> 00:06:17,880

And he has your phone number?

143

00:06:17,880 --> 00:06:18,880

Yes, he does.

144

00:06:18,880 --> 00:06:20,380

But you don't have Val Thorne's phone number?

145

No, I don't, because, eh, let's strike you as rather peculiar.

149

00:06:40,920 --> 00:06:45,700

And I don't think that this particular time Val is interested in running an answering

151

service at his front door.

152

00:06:47,100 --> 00:06:53,300

You see, ladies and gentlemen, but I mean, you go so far and then Dr. Strange evaporates

153

00:06:53,300 --> 00:06:54,700

before your very eyes.

154

00:06:54,700 --> 00:06:57,620

Joseph, would you rather I tell you a lie that has addressed me?

155

00:06:57,620 --> 00:07:01,740

I challenge you to bring Val Thorne here without his address.

156

00:07:01,740 --> 00:07:04,660

Just bring him here and show me his mitts with no fingerprints.

157

00:07:04,660 --> 00:07:08,060

All right, I would suggest that if you ever announce that you're going to have Val Thorne

158

here to show you better get the Shrine Auditorium.

159

And the reason I say this is because many thousands of outspoken apatres, right?

from Venus, whom Dr. Strange has been talking about, will appear on the Joe Fine show.

What would you suppose would happen?

167

Strange is, I'll tell you the truth.

168

If you could get Val Thorne, you wouldn't be fooling around with Joe Fine.

169

You'd hire the auditorium, you'd print the tickets, and you'd make all the money because

170

you're not about making money out of fine cards.

171

I take issue with you because if I were about to do that, I wouldn't wait until today to

I would have done it many years ago if I were going to use Val Thorne as a money making

174

I'll tell you what we'll do.

176

00:08:05,940 --> 00:08:09,920

You bring him here and we'll just have a few official witnesses and we won't tell anybody

177

00:08:09,920 --> 00:08:12,000

until after the show is already taped.

178

All right?

179

You know you're not going to bring him here.

180

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:18,160

I'll do this much.

181

I will give him your message.

182

All right?

183

00:08:22,560 --> 00:08:23,560

What more could I do?

184

What more could I do?

185

And then he'll say, you come back and say, sorry Joe, he just won't appear.

186

188

They invite him.

189

Now this unusual man without the fingerprints, Val Thorne, who comes to your home, but you're

190

never invited to his, which is kind of a, he's telling you something socially, I guess.

191

00:08:55,140 --> 00:08:58,140

This unusual fellow is, he has been at the Pentagon.

192

00:08:58,140 --> 00:08:59,140

Is that right?

193

00:08:59,140 --> 00:09:00,340

He has for three years.

194

00:09:00,340 --> 00:09:05,600

Now, see, you could have planted him in a rose garden someplace, or you could have said

195

that Val Thorne was discovered sitting in the loges section of a certain motion picture

196

00:09:11,520 --> 00:09:12,520

theater.

197

No, you mean you charge for this book and television commentators and people who want

209

to give it a review.

210

Yeah, what is the charge for this book?

211

At Pickwick Bookshop in Hollywood, that book goes for \$4.

212

What does it go for in Denver?

213

In Denver, it goes for \$4.

214

00:09:57,180 --> 00:09:58,180

It's also \$4.

215

00:09:58,840 --> 00:10:03,680

Because you cannot buy for just a pittance of monies some of the photographs that are

216

found in this book.

217

Now, he wouldn't make any money out of Val Thorne.

218

Four bucks a pop for this.

219

00:10:11,200 --> 00:10:14,080

And what do you charge them to get into the lecture when you're talking about this book?

220

Well, the past few lectures that we've held throughout the country, people have walked

221

in without paying a dime.

222

00:10:19,080 --> 00:10:20,960

But they have been invited to make a donation.

223

No, sir.

224

00:10:21,960 --> 00:10:24,960

Not at many of the meetings, especially at the State of California.

225

00:10:24,960 --> 00:10:25,960

That's exactly right.

226

00:10:25,960 --> 00:10:28,000

And somebody has paid you to be there, haven't they?

227

00:10:28,000 --> 00:10:29,000

Yes, I've been invited.

228

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:30,000

Ah!

229

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:32,000

In other words, there has been money.

230

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:33,000

Sure.

231

00:10:33,000 --> 00:10:35,100

You're making money out of Val Thorne.

232

I'm making money off of the UFO subject.

233

And because of the 21 years of research...

238

Now, you've got to really have a sense of humor to go along with this.

241

People...people do believe this fellow is strangest.

242

My name is Val Thorne.

243

00:11:02,200 --> 00:11:05,680

I'm a native of the planet you call Venus.

244

Now, the Griffith Park Observatory, so there's absolutely no atmosphere and no human being

Let me go on with this introduction.

252

You see how he had just...

I'm not hedging.

254

00:11:28,100 --> 00:11:29,100

I'm reading this introduction.

255

Your work will have to stand for itself.

256

Pardon me.

257

00:11:31,980 --> 00:11:35,300

It says, Venus, it is not too unlike your Earth.

258

In fact, we still enjoy the air-conditioned atmosphere the Earth had before the Great

259

Flood.

260

00:11:39,940 --> 00:11:43,860
