They were recorded making 90 degree turns.

Go ahead.

At approximately 5 to 9,000 miles an hour.

He was talking with a friend where you work and he said to make a 90 degree turn at the

speed that we mentioned 5,000 to 9,000 miles.

And there'd be a force of approximately 16 million Gs, which is just not impossible for

129

any matter to survive something like that.

Do you like to find out about both these?

131

Let's find out.

132

I have seen on several occasions UFOs making 90 degree turns, not at the speeds you just

mentioned, but I do know that they do the impossible to us at least.

Dr. Herman Obert claimed that the reason they could do what they are doing is the fact that

135

they are not only moving themselves through space but with them around them.

136

They are surrounding themselves with these atmospheres, whatever you might wish to call

137

In other words, you oftentimes do not even hear them because they're surrounded with

the best thing I can call it is atmosphere.

Creating their own atmosphere for the space to negate hours.

Negate hours is correct.

Would not then this atmosphere in turn, because that is made up of atoms, would not this atmosphere

143

in turn then be subject to this pressure?

This is a function of momentum, not a function of the atmosphere through which the object

145

itself is traversing.

Anything regardless whether it has its own atmospheric pressure or not, making a right

angle turn with relation to a gravitational field with relation to a linear trajectory

148

is going to experience tremendous change in momentum and a tremendous impact of momentum.

149

However, again, it has been suggested purely on a theoretical basis that it is the momentum

150

itself, the idea that to the saucer itself or the object itself there has been no change

151

This again, the term field with relation to, well, that's probably one of the most abused

terms in the entire vernacular of UFO research is field.

Field indicates some invisible force mechanism surrounding.

155

It has been suggested then that the force fields that do surround UFOs possibly can produce

156

a cushioning effect in these right angle turns.

157

I can see a guy going through this and since the pressure would destroy that atmosphere

158

00:10:33,920 --> 00:10:37,280

that he's carrying with him, zooming along, zoop zoop zoop, just lost our atmosphere,

159

00:10:37,280 --> 00:10:38,680

I wasn't going to go back and pick it up.

160

00:10:38,680 --> 00:10:45,240

But I might say this hard that explosions are by no means unknown in the field of UFOs

161

and it is entirely possible and conceivable that there are times when they do certain

162

things that like mentioned just on the phone that would cause the explosion because many

163

Let me check now.

And of course, as just a very brief review, this object was seen of course in the Ravenna

172

area last night approximately a little after 7.30 and the Ackon Beacon Journal had it reported.

173

K-Y-W carried immediately the report over radio on news and we're going to place the

174

00:11:30,360 --> 00:11:31,360

call now then.

175

00:11:31,360 --> 00:11:33,360

You're going to call George Popovich?

176

00:11:33,360 --> 00:11:35,360

Use line 40 if you will, okay?

177

00:11:35,360 --> 00:11:36,360

Okay.

178

00:11:36,360 --> 00:11:38,360

Now what do you know about this thing that was sighted last night?

179

00:11:38,360 --> 00:11:42,680

Well, George called, George Popovich, who by the way is the director of the Acron UFO

180

00:11:42,680 --> 00:11:47,400

Research Committee and a very fine investigator has been for years.

181

00:11:47,400 --> 00:11:48,400

Reliable?

182

00:11:48,400 --> 00:11:50,400

Very, very reliable.

183

00:11:50,400 --> 00:11:55,000

He called me at my home just before I left for the station tonight and I told him to

184

00:11:55,000 --> 00:11:56,000

call here.

185

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:59,200

Well, he got the call through before I arrived.

186

00:11:59,200 --> 00:12:05,960

But beyond what Bob just mentioned here from the news wires, I couldn't fill you in.

187

00:12:05,960 --> 00:12:13,920

I do know that he is perhaps by now, that is, I mean, George is perhaps by now at the

188

00:12:13,920 --> 00:12:16,720

home of the people who witnessed this.

189

00:12:16,720 --> 00:12:18,560

Now George himself did not see the flying object.

190

00:12:18,560 --> 00:12:23,840

I do not believe so, but George, like the rest of us, frequently get the calls from

191

00:12:23,840 --> 00:12:26,920

here, there and everywhere and I presume that's what happened in this case.

192

Incidentally, while we were waiting, might I say that I received an interesting letter

193

from a former Air Force man and I just spoke with him on the phone a moment ago and asked

194

if he objected to my using his name.

195

John Manick called, wrote me a short note and in this, with this note, he has this information

196

00:12:50,920 --> 00:12:53,560

that I think is quite interesting.

197

Paul Ziates of Emory Drive in Cleveland on the evening of December 1st, 1962, about 9.15

198

00:13:02,160 --> 00:13:03,760

p.m. relates this.

199

00:13:03,760 --> 00:13:08,080

A group of friends and myself were playing football in the backyards between Angle and

200

00:13:08,080 --> 00:13:10,000

Grossie Drive.

201

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:13,960

As we were leaving, I saw the ground reflecting a very bright white light.

202

00:13:13,960 --> 00:13:18,200

It looked as if someone had turned on a giant fluorescent light above us.

203

00:13:18,200 --> 00:13:22,560

Suddenly I had a warm sensation, whether it was from the light or a reaction within my

204

00:13:22,560 --> 00:13:26,080

body when I realized that the light might be extraterrestrial.

205

00:13:26,080 --> 00:13:27,080

I do not know.

206

00:13:27,080 --> 00:13:29,160

I turned around to see where the light was coming from.

207

I looked up and saw a bright flash of light.

208

It looked as if the object was moving across the sky and exploded.

209

From what I could make out, in the very short time I saw the light, it was moving north

210

to south over the eastern sky.

211

There was no sound whatsoever accompanying the light.

212

After the disappearance of the light, everything got dark again and there was no trace of any

213

object or debris falling from the light.

At the time that this report was made, a very detailed account of, by the way, has gone

215

to NiCAP in Washington, I received many other statements and I was watching TV at the time

216

and the TV was full of snow.

217

It never acted quite that badly and this was at a NASA man's home.

218

00:14:10,040 --> 00:14:11,840

We were watching it.

219

00:14:11,840 --> 00:14:17,560

So this then would seem to lead one to believe that there is something to this, a particular

220

00:14:17,560 --> 00:14:18,560

sighting on December 1st, right?

221

00:14:18,560 --> 00:14:19,560

Yeah.

222

00:14:19,560 --> 00:14:20,560

I have quite a few reports on it.

223

00:14:20,560 --> 00:14:24,520

I hoped at the time to tell them, but time did not permit.

224

00:14:24,520 --> 00:14:29,080

Okay, now let me knock another report in the teeth.

225

00:14:29,080 --> 00:14:33,840

You've been getting a lot of calls, Earl has and Bob has, I know, about a report of a sighting

226

00:14:33,840 --> 00:14:41,120

over Saskatchewan on the evening of December 24th that was a week ago this past Monday.

227

00:14:41,120 --> 00:14:44,240

Now people said, well, it was done in all seriousness, no, like us, and yes, there was

228

00:14:44,240 --> 00:14:48,600

a sighting of an unidentified flying object, December 24th reported on KYWTV.

229

00:14:48,600 --> 00:14:54,800

Well, just to set the matter straight, this is true in a way, but since it's after, it's

230

00:14:54,800 --> 00:14:58,760

almost 11 o'clock at night and I think most children are in bed, let's just report that

231

00:14:58,880 --> 00:15:01,880

this was not the kind of UFO that we're concerned with on this program.

232

The report that Dick Goddard made was a true report.

233

00:15:04,400 --> 00:15:09,320

There was an object over Saskatchewan headed toward the Cleveland area that night, but

234

00:15:09,320 --> 00:15:12,720

it was nothing more than Santa Claus and his reindeer's.

235

00:15:12,720 --> 00:15:16,840

And Dick Goddard in all seriousness, truthfully reported it.

236

00:15:16,840 --> 00:15:21,280

And don't you ever try to tell Dick Goddard that there's not a Santa Claus or Easter Bunny

237

00:15:21,280 --> 00:15:22,280

for that matter.

238

00:15:22,280 --> 00:15:24,280

All right, now we're going to get this report.

239

Bob has all set up.

240

00:15:25,320 --> 00:15:30,280

Yes, on the line right now, we have Mr. George Papowicz, whom we've already introduced a

241

moment ago.

He will introduce the gentleman who made this sighting as we pick up a line for him.

243

Okay, let me just check on George.

Yeah, this is Mark Morgan.

245

Just to get this straight, did you see the, uh, the, uh, the, uh, the, uh, the

246

car.

247

00:15:42,280 --> 00:15:43,280

No, I'm only investigating.

248

00:15:43,280 --> 00:15:45,280

You have the people there ready to talk to you.

249

00:15:45,280 --> 00:15:46,280

Mr. Carl Rice.

250

Okay, go ahead.

251

We'll just listen to you then.

252

Um, for all of us, are am I on?

253

Well, I have with me tonight, Mr. Carl Rice, that he and his wife and two other persons

254

that observed what I have labeled as a UFO.

255

00:16:05,280 --> 00:16:10,280

And this occurred last evening, uh, approximately around 6pm at the Revano, Ohio.

256

So, uh, I would like to have you talk with Mr. Carl Rice, one of the observers.

257

Well, Mr. Rice.

258

00:16:18,280 --> 00:16:19,280

Hello.

259

00:16:19,280 --> 00:16:22,280

Mr. Rice, could you describe in detail just exactly what you saw?

260
