Looking for money, huh?

300

And in San Francisco, Ole J. Snide explained that the saucers were spaceships sent out by the great master who left the Earth in disgust after the fall of the Roman Empire,

Now you see?

Now I do not know them in new circles.

How has the attitude changed then?

This, up to this time, has changed very greatly.

Now this is in 1952 from 47 to 55 years.

And the picture that you see across the top here, about eight inches deep, is a color painting by the wife of Lincoln LaPause.

And they're both authorities on meteors.

Both she and her husband have observed the fireballs at first hand.

326

And this is a beautiful picture of the fireball.

But the headline says, have we visitors from space?

328

The Air Force is now ready.

329

Now this is a funny part.

330

00:23:22,000 --> 00:23:30,000

The Air Force is now ready, this is in 1952, to concede that many saucer and fireball sightings still defy explanation.

331

00:23:30,000 --> 00:23:35,000

Here life offers some scientific evidence that there is a real case for interplanetary flying saucers.

332

00:23:35,000 --> 00:23:40,000

And yet today, the attitude is the same as it was then by the Air Force.

333

00:23:40,000 --> 00:23:43,000

In other words, they're still not admitting any more than they did then.

334

00:23:43,000 --> 00:23:45,000

But it looked then like it was kind of open.

335

00:23:45,000 --> 00:23:51,000

Because from time to time, just as the major mentioned, the attitude changed.

336

And they were just about ready to crack it open and then somebody else changed.

337

So then again, as very often I take the opportunity, when the subject arises like this, to issue the open, standing and abiding invitation to the Air Force.

On December the 27th, 1949, after two years of operation, project saucer wrote up all products of reports of unidentified aerial phenomena as hoaxes, hallucinations, or misinterpretations of familiar objects.

These stubborn 34 seemingly unexplainable were briskly dismissed as psychological aberrations.

347

Like the, well, we'll get into that because we covered the 1954 flag over Washington a couple of weeks ago.

348

Earl, just then, held up a picture that I'd like to mention again.

349

Several weeks ago, I guess, was about three months ago, I received a letter in the mail from, let's see, from Orville, Ohio.

350

The letter was a picture, a picture in living color, as they say, a quite clear picture of a field, a grass along the roadside, apparently, and hovering above the field.

351

That is all I know or am allowed to say.

Well, everyone we've had on the show has given their opinion, their opinion is, their opinion, not mine, that it is authentic, that it is a real picture of a flying saucer.

And shortly after that, and I'd like to do it again right now, I ask the person, if they would please have courage enough to at least tell us who you are, you know who we are.

Would it do us much good to know more about the circumstances of this picture and being taken?

There were two small children also sighted it. The object continued to hover for two or three minutes,

and that road vertically disappeared. And after the sighting, Mrs. Zalanka hesitated to report the object.

She said, fearing ridicule. She remarked that I'm a down-to-earth woman.

She said, I don't want to be made out of crackpot.

397

A local police officer who investigated, stated that he thought the object might have been a round kite,

398

but he added, as I asked him, that he was not going to speculate.

There was a nearby airfield that had no knowledge of the object, but we have had a number of instances.

400

I've been to the

brain sizes. I just read an article on collecting various accounts of these small UFOs.

402

Let me tell you that. It's an April magazine.

403

Fine article. I had occasion to read that. It's just fantastic. What book is that?

404

April Bot, APRO, Phenomenon Research Organization's bot.

405

00:31:56,560 --> 00:32:01,560

That, of course, is a brief account, but a very recent one of these smaller objects.

406

00:32:01,560 --> 00:32:10,560

And there was a particularly interesting case. It took place in Massachusetts last November.

407

This fine object was seen over a Salem Street in Wolburn, Mass on November 2nd by Mr. Charles F. Kirk,

408

00:32:21,560 --> 00:32:27,560

20-year-old of that place. Kirk reported that the mysterious fine object

409

hovered over his head three to nine minutes on Salem Street on Tuesday, November the 1st.

410

He said the object looked like a streamlined egg cut through the middle, and that he first noticed it about 2 p.m.

411

Yesterday against the dark blue sky, Estimus proved that the object was hovering about a 2,000-foot altitude.

412

00:32:51,560 --> 00:32:58,560

Kirk works for the Welk Machine Company, that place, the Machines and Carbner.

413

00:32:58,560 --> 00:33:03,560

And he was up, the time, was working on top of their new building on Salem Street.

414

00:33:03,560 --> 00:33:10,560

He sighted this strange object, and he estimated it was about 40 feet long, 30 feet wide, and 15 foot in height.

415

He said, it could have been much larger.

416

00:33:13,560 --> 00:33:18,560

Fortunately, Kirk was visibly shaken by his encounter.

417

00:33:18,560 --> 00:33:25,560

He described the eerie feeling of being watched, and he said, thoughts of fear entered his mind.

418

00:33:25,560 --> 00:33:31,560

He had no idea that the object was or where it came from, but he said he had a very good idea as to why it was there,

419

which is more than a lot of people had, or was his idea.

420

00:33:34,560 --> 00:33:37,560

He said, well, I will explain that to him in just a moment.

421

00:33:37,560 --> 00:33:41,560

He said, he made the comment, I never wanted to see one again either.

422

00:33:41,560 --> 00:33:43,560

In fact, he didn't matter.

423

The object was golden orange in color, and flatly they sat on the bottom, and had a black band near its outer edge,

424

00:33:51,560 --> 00:33:56,560

a projection or a periscope hanging about 10 feet from the bottom of it.

425

This strange device, he said, kept clicking on and off at about 15 second intervals like a camera.

426

Kirk felt that the strange object was taking pictures of the land beneath, including himself.

427

That was the reason that he had a desire not to see one again.

428

00:34:15,560 --> 00:34:18,560

He said it was a little too close to be possible, which I...

429

00:34:18,560 --> 00:34:19,560

Right.

430

00:34:19,560 --> 00:34:28,560

And other sightings of the same object were reported over Burlington and Wolburn by several witnesses on Sunday night, October 28.

431

00:34:28,560 --> 00:34:30,560

How late was that after his sighting?

432

00:34:30,560 --> 00:34:31,560

That was October 28.

433

00:34:31,560 --> 00:34:34,560

October 28, and he saw it on November 1.

434

00:34:34,560 --> 00:34:38,560

So this was just ahead of his sighting, but these other reports had come in.

435

00:34:38,560 --> 00:34:44,560

He reported that the object produced a band of light around the building on which he was working.

436

00:34:44,560 --> 00:34:49,560

And before it disappeared, he said, like, grease lightning.

437

00:34:49,560 --> 00:34:58,560

So the sound of all except the strange cooking noise which it made during its hovering over his head.

438

00:34:58,560 --> 00:35:07,560

They later checked the area of the Geiger powder and said there was a slight increase in radiation at the sighting area.

439

00:35:07,560 --> 00:35:15,560

Now this is one thing, one point that constantly raises doubts in my mind and I think in the mind of many people.

440

00:35:15,560 --> 00:35:22,560

In this case, someone had seen the object about, what, three or four days before.

441

00:35:22,560 --> 00:35:24,560

Why is it that when people see these objects?

442

00:35:24,560 --> 00:35:31,560

Now I don't care whether you're in a relatively isolated place like Maine or in California or where.

443

00:35:31,560 --> 00:35:39,560

The thing had to get there and you would think that in most cases, certainly in more cases than this does happen,

444

00:35:39,560 --> 00:35:42,560

that there would be corroborating reports along the way.

445

00:35:42,560 --> 00:35:43,560

Why is this not true?

446

00:35:43,560 --> 00:35:48,560

It's always one guy and I went to get my life and I couldn't get her back in time.

447

00:35:48,560 --> 00:35:50,560

But yeah, you know that's true.

448

00:35:50,560 --> 00:35:51,560

That's right, that's all North here.

449

00:35:51,560 --> 00:35:59,560

Well in most of the cases yes, higher, but there are other cases that we would get the impact of to them such as the Monon railroad case

450

00:35:59,560 --> 00:36:09,560

that happened a couple of years ago in which four members of the train crew all watched this object following the train for an hour and five minutes.

451

00:36:09,560 --> 00:36:13,560

In that case, every acting member of the train crew was watching it.

452

00:36:13,560 --> 00:36:17,560

So there have been several cases on that which more than one person saw.

453

00:36:17,560 --> 00:36:20,560

The two majority cases, only one or two people see them.

454

00:36:20,560 --> 00:36:26,560

How do you explain that in most of these cases that since it had to get there that somebody else didn't see it along the way?

455

00:36:26,560 --> 00:36:27,560

Right, true.

456

00:36:27,560 --> 00:36:28,560

Why?

457

00:36:28,560 --> 00:36:37,560

It could go up rather than the speed with which they travel in many instances, just as this party described, it disappeared like grease lightning.

458

00:36:37,560 --> 00:36:41,560

It seems that they can appear and disappear almost instantaneously.

459

00:36:41,560 --> 00:36:43,560

Look, they're a high altitude of each completely invisible.

460

00:36:43,560 --> 00:36:51,560

And of course that route instead of you picturing them is going on a straight B line route and

therefore being seen by numerous witnesses,

461

00:36:51,560 --> 00:37:01,560

they could very easily go up, send, rapidly out of sight and descend several miles or hundreds of miles, even distant, in a matter of, we'll say, minutes.

462

00:37:01,560 --> 00:37:06,560

And not have been seen by anybody else only when they come down again made themselves visible closer to the ground.

463

00:37:06,560 --> 00:37:13,560

Well, there again, we're guilty perhaps of associating things that we can relate to.

464

00:37:13,560 --> 00:37:24,560

I can relate to an object getting here by taking a normal course, but like this one can come down in such a way that I can't relate to or quite believe, come down suddenly like that.

465

00:37:24,560 --> 00:37:28,560

Because of their powers, that's why we're there utilizing.

466

00:37:28,560 --> 00:37:34,560

It makes it possible to maneuver so quickly and travel so rapidly that we just don't comprehend it.

467

00:37:34,560 --> 00:37:36,560

We're not used to that type of speed.

468

00:37:36,560 --> 00:37:37,560

Yeah, Joe.

469

00:37:37,560 --> 00:37:48,560

There are a lot of people that do see objects at the same time and fail to report them or are reported to various airports or radar sites who had this information.

470
