subject. Many supersonic jets as well as balloons are reported as UFOs under adverse weather and

sighting conditions. Man-made satellites in orbit have confused many sky watchers. Highly

technical electronic systems track everything that moves across our skies without positive

identification yet as a flying saucer as such. Jet reports the flying saucers persist. We will

a number of occasions. I think it would be best to start off with him and ask him how

in the face of overwhelming evidence against flying saucers, do you still claim, sir, that

Well, having a personal experience at one time, I didn't believe me there because I brought

But after years of experience and so forth and coming close contact with them, I can't

Oh, Dr. Clark, there's an astronomer. Can you buy this line of ideas?

aware of it. Mr. Adamski, you claim to have seen flying saucers on a number of occasions. Why do

you think you have seen flying saucers so frequently and the rest of us have never seen

a flying saucer? Well, you can't stay in the building and see them. You've got to watch them.

the beings on our own making this kind of flight this time? And I have just to hear what

97

the historian says and the physicist says. We have an interesting subject to follow you up on.

Do we have an interesting subject that just came to me before I went on the strip? There's the article

99

here in German and it was copied from an Italian and it is the Vatican official paper, the observatory

of Mano published this and it says in there, the Vatican is already training space missionaries.

What is this picture?

This is a picture from Mr. Adamski's book. He's showing the face man that Mr. Adamski says he saw.

And there was an artist with you at the time.

Yes, and I'd sketch that picture. Well, now let me tell you what I feel is surprising about the fact

139

different way of forming bone structure out of the mineral, wheat and so forth because it wouldn't

have the strength to support us. So that the size that we are is well suited to our particular

148

size of the earth and the gravity and the associated gravitational pull. Now these planets

149

differ widely in size and gravity. Perhaps Dr. Clark could...

Well, I would like to comment on that too. Let's go back to our structure of the present day.

I'm 73 years old. I've gone through 73 years of life here. And I have seen in my time when I was a

kid starting out in labor, I've seen in my time men here on earth, very heavy structure because

they had to do everything by hand, big and ditches, pursuers and all of that. And since we have

154

machines, notice our present generation is still the same design, same structure, but

155

00:14:50,360 --> 00:14:54,200

they're much lighter in structure and bone and everything else in nature seems to take care of that.

156

Well, I think they're relatively the same.

157

00:14:56,200 --> 00:14:58,040

Because they're much too elliptical.

158

00:14:58,040 --> 00:15:00,920

I went to the trial last week and I saw some very big fellows going there.

159

Well, Dr. Clark, could I address a question to you? Could you quote some figures on the

160

00:15:09,240 --> 00:15:11,720

relative gravitational forces on other planets?

161

00:15:11,720 --> 00:15:16,360

Well, for example, the moon, that's about 1-6 out of the earth as far as the gravitational

162

00:15:16,360 --> 00:15:16,440

forces go.

163

00:15:16,440 --> 00:15:18,440

It'd be a wonderful place to play a baseball game, wouldn't it?

164

I'd do it at home or at home every time.

165

00:15:20,840 --> 00:15:26,120

I don't have the exact figures, but I think Jupiter is about 30 times the gravitational

166

00:15:26,120 --> 00:15:26,920

attraction of the earth.

167

00:15:26,920 --> 00:15:29,000

And that would seem to call for smaller people, wouldn't it?

168

00:15:29,960 --> 00:15:35,000

Well, it depends. I don't know if you need someone smaller or larger to support this

169

00:15:35,160 --> 00:15:42,360

heavy force, which would be pulling you down towards the center of gravity on the planet.

170

You may need someone with something that was larger.

171

00:15:44,520 --> 00:15:50,200

No, I would think smaller because consider the amp, he can fall off the table when I've heard himself.

172

00:15:50,200 --> 00:15:50,840

Right.

173

00:15:50,840 --> 00:15:56,440

In other words, you might think that the person would be spread out in this coordinate more than that.

174

If he falls, I think what a bone-crushing experience that would be was 30 times the

175

00:16:02,120 --> 00:16:03,080

gravitational force.

176

00:16:03,320 --> 00:16:06,680

Well, it doesn't have to be flying saucers instead of flying cops.

177

Where do we get the answer on the gravity as being exact to begin with from our instruments?

178

Instruments still need improvement.

179

Let me remind you of something here just a little while back, which we sent up the second satellite

180

00:16:22,200 --> 00:16:27,480

up there and supposed to register and bring that message back of outer space and also register

181

00:16:27,480 --> 00:16:28,360

what's on earth.

182

00:16:28,360 --> 00:16:33,560

Combination in order to get some kind of a measuring stick there by which we could go

183

00:16:33,560 --> 00:16:36,360

and mind God, that the register no oxygen on earth.

184

Dr. Harrison, let's talk about the spacecraft that we have seen on this film.

185

We have heard of saucers and the cigar type objects that we saw at the beginning of the program.

186

What appeared to be the movement of a fly in a rush in all directions at once.

187

Is it physicist or just, what do you think of this?

188

Well, I would like to tell you the following story.

On Labor Day weekend, I had my boat down to Smith Island, which as you know it in the lower part of

And I looked a few minutes later and was gone before I had a chance to call it to his attention.

About an hour went by and I saw it again.

196

And once again, I tried to call it to his attention, but he was busy doing other things.

197

The third time I succeeded in calling it to his attention, so he saw it also.

198

Now, at the time I didn't give a great deal of thought to it.

199

I thought, well, it's something and that's the end of it.

Something I don't know what it is, but I didn't jump any hasty conclusion.

Later on, we got over to Solomon's Island.

Now, how is my observations different in kind than yours?

But today we have a lot of things to observe them.

And plus then we've got 500 pieces or more debris flying around in space that we have put up there

217

00:19:23,000 --> 00:19:25,080

since we started dealing with space.

And any deal, any one of those could be reported as a flying saucer.

219

00:19:28,680 --> 00:19:33,080

But this also could be confirmed because the Air Force follows these objects

220

00:19:33,080 --> 00:19:36,200

right along in order to know where they are at the given time.

221

00:19:36,200 --> 00:19:40,440

And reporters, they check on it and know whether it's flying saucer or is it debris?

222

Mm-hmm.

I would say at least 15,000 miles per hour.

I would say according to the way it's moving.

321

Although it made me much faster.

322

Well, within our Earth's atmosphere, you think that's right.

323

It goes over within an Earth's atmosphere, I would say, at the height and a

distant basis is to be judged not correctly, because it would have to measure it exactly.

sonic boom.

Now, how do you calculate that?

331

It's hard to tell whether this object produced a sonic boom or it didn't, because when I saw

332

it was already moving, it entered our atmosphere, so the sonic boom would have been gone.

333

And then that territory, there's got...

334

00:26:02,360 --> 00:26:04,760

No, the sonic boom stays with an object as it moves.

335

00:26:04,760 --> 00:26:05,960

No, no, no, no.

336

It doesn't stay because I've seen it there on myself, our own jets break my sonic...

337

00:26:11,480 --> 00:26:13,560

In that territory, there's camp metal, though.

338

00:26:13,560 --> 00:26:14,920

Almost every day, you got it.

339

00:26:14,920 --> 00:26:20,280

They break the sonic boom and they go on and you watch them and they disappear, no more sound.

340

00:26:20,280 --> 00:26:25,960

So the sonic boom is when the particular shock wave traveling out from the outside...

341

00:26:25,960 --> 00:26:28,200

I know how to fly where you happen to be standing.

342

00:26:28,200 --> 00:26:28,840

Yeah.

343

00:26:28,840 --> 00:26:29,240

Well...

344

00:26:29,240 --> 00:26:31,000

Gentlemen, I'm sure I must interrupt.

345

00:26:31,000 --> 00:26:32,280

Time has run out.

346

I don't think we'll resolve the question of whether there's such a thing as flying sources

347
