We have literally dozens of reports pouring in right now from all over the country.

There was one open sign.

And the sight map is just prickling with thin.

Any particular theory as to why?

I think the sightings have been going on very steadily since last summer and I think the only difference right now

is that they got some publicity for a change and something touched off the wire services

and the national network people and therefore it's brought it more out into the open.

Yes, and it was the nearest Arbor and the University of Michigan and the radio telescope site that probably did it.

Plus the fact that Bud Van Horn was one of the witnesses and the deputy sheriff.

Gentlemen we've just been joined by Frida Stewart here of WBZ News and also a member of myCAP.

I think the reports have said that the reports were the most consistent that they had had by a large number of people in a long time.

He didn't say that it positively would swamp gas but from all indications as far as he could find out, he thought that it would swamp gas

I wondered, do you want to go along with the theory of Mr. Van Horn that it would be gas out there that caused this?

Bob I would like to ask Mr. Van Horn, why he didn't report this to the nearest Air Force and have them send some planes over to investigate what this thing actually was?

Why he watched it from the 11 until 2?

It's because on the previous reports to Self Reach Air Force Base, I have received very poor reception and they have been made to look like a very ignorant person.

And this occurred last night for your information and this information shall be released in the near future.

You mean the recent deciding last night?

The object was long in shape.

Now this is a different shape than I have ever been able to determine before and I think the reason for it was that it was closer to the surface of the Earth.

Have you seen them before you said that I have been able to estimate before?

I have always seen many of them Bob, many of them. I can't tell you how many.

Right. Just let me relate to you what happened last night. This is really an exclusive because I have not released any information to Newspane for Radio Media today.

Is it alright if I do this Bob?

You run ahead.

I have observed this after following a report of this having followed a train between the small village of Allen and the city of Hoseville last night.

And the train, I tried very hard to convince the engineer who reported it that it was an aircraft possible place.

After listening to him and finding that this was going alongside the train and then speeded up to a great speed, it then stopped and the train, which was a freight train, was able to come up to it again.

They sighted it, followed it and they immediately pulled me and I immediately got on it.

At that time that I got on it, I was able to visually with the naked eye see this object in the sky.

It appeared to be elongated and at the top it had a green light or a blue which sometimes referred to.

In the center was a white light and on the bottom was a red light.

And upon doing this, I then put the tocclars on it which brought it up very plain and it still appeared to be elongated and through the binoculars which were 755,

appeared to be about the length, maybe a little longer than the length of a common pin.

I immediately called Selfridge Airport's base in an attempt to get the radar confirmation on this and was given the run around.

The reader's story, our guest here in Boston on our long distance line in Washington is the assistant director of my camp, Dick Hall, in Michigan on a special conference called as Bud Van Horn,

We heard quite a startling story from Bud Van Horn.

I think it's a very impressive report and I'm glad to get some of the details directly from Bud Van Horn.

133

We had heard rumors about this and we're glad to hear it to confirm.

134

We have had similar reports in the past of objects joining up in the air and I think his description of it as a docking operation is very interesting.

You know something that I'd like to talk with Major Kehoe about a little bit later, but I was intrigued by finding out that the Republican leader of the House, Senator Ford, has called the representative for it.

I'd like to know his opinion on the fact why whenever the exciting of UFOs reported to the air force,

188

why the air force very rarely reports its findings to the public because you find a number of the times the air force keeps quiet on the manila.

I have the effort to report the findings to the public although they do get national trust coverage.

But the air force never comments on it.

191

All right, major.

Well, there is a high level policy with the air force to resound.

193

But these things must be played down, explained, and possible to avoid the hysteria or panic.

The air force really should not be playing too much of this policy except at a very high level.

And many people in the air force that don't even believe in it, I think that it's bound to cause trouble sooner or later.

First of all, I'd like to say that I'm a believer but you were major keel over the past few months.

I'm not a believer.

But it is true that in the Mayan Peninsula and other areas there have been prehistoric and historical evidences that perhaps could be interpreted as UFOs.

He said he couldn't see why they would pick a swamp.

Well, I think his reasoning was that no sensible pilot, as we know them here on Earth,

whether it was a helicopter pilot, a plane pilot, a pilot of anything that flies, would pick a swamp as a place to actually land.

But actually, you know, many of these UFOs seem to hover rather than land,

304

and if they picked out a swamp where people are not expecting this and where they wanted some privacy while they did some observing

305

or gathering some specimens or the like, perhaps a swamp would be an ideal place for them to so-called hover or come close to land.

306

I'm sure I bet there are any number of people asking this question.

307

I have asked it so many times, and sometimes I almost forget to ask it again, but I think it's important.

People who might be hearing the program tonight, they say, oh, for heaven's sake, again, with those flying saucers,

if they're out there, why in the world, if they're watching us and if they're down here?

For heaven's sake, if they were with Tuesday, they'd go right up to Washington, hover over the White House,

311

and say, President Johnson, here we are, we're from outer space, how are you?

312

And end all of this controversy once and for all.

313

So Bob, you know, these, if there are intelligent creatures in the spacecraft, there's no indication that these are identical to us.

314

It could very well be that if a civilization has reached an advanced state of technology

315

whereby they are able to propel their spaceship at an ever-increasing acceleration,

316

and they can travel at the speed of sound, it's not inconceivable that they are willing to spend the four years in space travel

317

that it would take from one of the other suns in our planet, or in our solar system, rather,

318

or outside of our solar system, but in our galaxy, that's what our really name,

319

to come here and establish a base, some place that we don't know, and then use these so-called surface ships,

320

just as we will use a small capsule to go down to the surface of the moon, and make these exploratory contacts.

321

It could very well be that we are going to be very much surprised if they are intelligent beings in these spacecrafts

322

that they are not like human beings at all. So their way of thinking wouldn't be the same.

Alright, let's take a phone call, gentlemen. Hello.

324

And also, a question on swamp gas. How would swamp gas create an illusion of illuminated objects in the sky at night?

Is there any possibility? I've heard people who have seen swamp fires, that's what they call them, street.

Apparently, there is a phenomenon on this, something like the decaying matter in some logs,

331

the so-called socks fire and all kinds of these false fires.

332

This actually, if it has a certain chemical content and a phosphorous, it will glow.

333

I've seen this so evident at night in decaying logs that you could take objects that were made of this,

334

take it into a darkened room and it would give off a glow that you could readily see.

335

It would almost light up a corner of a room.

336

00:27:42,500 --> 00:27:48,500

And if the gas is filled with this particular substance, it would give off an illumination.

337

And then if it came upward because of the expansion of the gas or because of warm temperatures causing the gas to rise,

338

this would create the illusion of something, an object that was rising into the sky.

339

Bob Kennedy, you run contact around the air. Hello.

340

00:28:06,500 --> 00:28:07,500

Good evening, Bob.

341

00:28:07,500 --> 00:28:08,500

Yes, sir.

342

00:28:08,500 --> 00:28:13,500

Yes, I have a question. I can't remember where I heard this comment, but this was on the spot.

343

00:28:13,500 --> 00:28:15,500

Well, I'll show you a dig that made it feel.

344

00:28:15,500 --> 00:28:16,500

Sure.

345

00:28:16,500 --> 00:28:26,500

But in the comment that was mentioned that lashes at UFO sightings were usually related to a certain planet,

346

00:28:26,500 --> 00:28:29,500

being solar systems, being close to the Earth.

347

00:28:29,500 --> 00:28:38,500

Well, I was wondering if there were any planets close to the Earth that this particular planet were under a suspicion.

348

00:28:38,500 --> 00:28:49,500

And also, sort of a science fiction comment, about a week and a half ago, I think was the Russians that sent up a probe to see if the flag was merged.

349

00:28:49,500 --> 00:28:53,500

And now a week or so later, you're here about all the UFOs.

350

00:28:53,500 --> 00:28:55,500

But I'd just like to hear from you.

351

00:28:55,500 --> 00:28:57,500

All right. Thank you for calling.

352

Bob, the Russian wanted us to Venus. They did actually make a hard contact on Venus.

353

00:29:03,500 --> 00:29:07,500

And we have been avoiding that because we don't want to contaminate the planet.

354

00:29:07,500 --> 00:29:13,500

And that's why we preferred a flyby. And we did do a flyby of Venus, making observations.

355

00:29:13,500 --> 00:29:22,500

Unfortunately, our flyby was so far away that most scientists feel that any results that we had were rather inconclusive.

356

00:29:22,500 --> 00:29:26,500

What was the other planets they talked about?

357

00:29:26,500 --> 00:29:28,500

Whether they were in an opposition at this particular time.

358

00:29:28,500 --> 00:29:39,500

No, I don't believe that any are that close. However, when they are, it is true that not only have we had an increase in UFO activity at those times,

359

00:29:39,500 --> 00:29:44,500

especially when Mars is close by, but scientists have been able to discover many things.

360

00:29:44,500 --> 00:29:54,500

And I wish Donald T. Hall would talk a little bit about the report in the UFO investigator about the confirmation of the canals of Mars.

361

Major?

362

00:29:56,500 --> 00:30:00,500

Well, yes, the relevant first reports were released.

363

00:30:00,500 --> 00:30:08,500

They bestated out of the depoportional laboratory that there was absolutely no sign of any of the so-called canals or oases.

364

The areas where the canal lines intersect.

365

00:30:12,500 --> 00:30:18,500

Now, it turns out that there actually are lines on these stones, on a number of them.

366

Matter of fact, we have seen two movies from here in the office.

367

They were shown to us by Dr. Frank Southbury, who is an eminent expert biologist at State University of Colorado,

and who also studied Mars for a long time, and will strongly suggest that there may be intelligent landform Mars.

369

Now, these were films made by the astronauts once in a major key home?

370

00:30:41,500 --> 00:30:47,500

No, they were made by the mayor. Remember, the mayor and the crew were there, and they took pictures from the...

371

I guess, several thousand miles, and he couldn't expect too much detail in here, but on the basis of this,

372

00:30:56,500 --> 00:31:04,500

the depoportional laboratory, and then asked us that there was no indication of any canals, and that ideal remained fixed for a while.

373

Now, it turns out that there were lines on the films, and I don't know whether they thought better not to mention it at the time,

374

00:31:12,500 --> 00:31:17,500

but they were laterally discovered, when they made a more careful determination, that they are there.

375

Dr. Pombo, the deoport, also confirms the fact that he's found several canals on these stones.

376

I understand too that there is a movement under foot to put more money into the Mars exploration,

377

and to sort of dismiss, or not give the money that we had planned to use for the exploration of Venus,

because it was felt that there was a greater reward to be raised by putting all of our eggs into one basket, so to speak, in the exploration of Mars.

And you've heard much on that, the...

380

Well, I've heard that too. I don't think any actual figures have been released showing a change in appropriation,

381

but it's saying the reasonable, because Mars has indicated that there's more chance of...

382

I mean, our evidence indicates there's more chance of some kind of intelligent life there, if it doesn't exist now, then there possibly wasn't the past.

383

And I believe it's right, we would get more rewards, and certainly Venus, if all of the reports of the last two years are correct,

384

00:32:24,500 --> 00:32:30,500

or, for example, whether there is any life of the type that we would recognize, please.

385

Gentlemen, we have a message at two, and we'll be back continuing our conversation tonight.

386

For a long distance line from Michigan in a few minutes, we'll be Daniel Campbell,

387

00:32:38,500 --> 00:32:44,500

who's a reporter on the Insulantie Press, and has been interviewing many of the people who have cited some of these objects.

388

Yes, sir. I brought them. Nice to do with it.

389

00:32:46,500 --> 00:32:47,500

Nice to do with you, too.

390

00:32:47,500 --> 00:32:48,500

I enjoy your show very much.

391

Thank you so much.

392

00:32:49,500 --> 00:32:51,500

Listen, I have two very brief things.

393

00:32:51,500 --> 00:32:59,500

Number one, my hobby, one of my hobbies is old newspapers, old books, and as a result, I have quite a collection of them.

394

00:32:59,500 --> 00:33:04,500

I spend considerable time in the libraries, one in particular, the Boston Public Library.

395

00:33:04,500 --> 00:33:12,500

And today, by saying, for instance, I was reading an actual newspaper, the original copy of a thing called the Athenian Mercury,

396

which was published in London in 1692.

397

00:33:15,500 --> 00:33:20,500

This paper consists of letters to the editor and answers.

398

00:33:20,500 --> 00:33:26,500

And the fascinating thing about it was that on the front page, there were two flying saucers, like,

399

00:33:26,500 --> 00:33:32,500

and this fellow went on to say he was standing by the ocean somewhere there.

400

00:33:32,500 --> 00:33:34,500

They didn't call them flying saucers.

401

00:33:34,500 --> 00:33:37,500

No, they didn't. They called them flying dishes, but I thought that was pretty cool.

402

00:33:37,500 --> 00:33:38,500

Flying dishes.

403

00:33:38,500 --> 00:33:39,500

Flying dishes.

404

00:33:39,500 --> 00:33:49,500

And he went on to describe in perfect detail pretty much what you'd read in today's papers about a thing wheeling in and then going at great speed and then making sharp turns into the peg.

405

00:33:49,500 --> 00:33:52,500

And the answer is, well, the question is, what is it?

406

00:33:52,500 --> 00:34:03,500

The answer is something that was a well over the years, we have had many such studies of flying ax handles, flying anvils, and all the flying paraphernalia that was popular at that time in history.

407

And that was all it was, too, but I thought it was kind of interesting.

408

00:34:06,500 --> 00:34:07,500

Flying digits.

409

00:34:07,500 --> 00:34:12,500

Now, the second thing, and this is something that's probably been concerning me for quite some time,

410

have you noticed how the general public in the country feels to be alone in the flying saucer, is that right?

411

00:34:19,500 --> 00:34:32,500

You take something like the sales tax, the Vietnam crisis, where people who are very, very vocal, I mean people in the news media, the Walter Lippman, the, uh, the context, the Huntsley Brinkley,

412

00:34:32,500 --> 00:34:38,500

they all take definite stand. The newspaper is right editorial, some of my best reporters come out for it.

413

00:34:38,500 --> 00:34:45,500

But in flying saucers, what you generally get is straight reporting, and there doesn't seem to be a reporter really,

414

00:34:45,500 --> 00:34:56,500

major national statue who has yet to take a definite stand on this, there's been no clamor from your so-called big people for national investigation.

415

00:34:56,500 --> 00:34:58,500

It's sort of a community, even the newspaper reporting.

416

00:34:58,500 --> 00:35:02,500

You're reporting as representative Ford, as of this afternoon, clamoring for an investigation.

417

00:35:02,500 --> 00:35:09,500

I agree. And this is a little bit unique, but over the past few years, and I'm killing the representative Ford,

418

00:35:09,500 --> 00:35:18,500

who seems kind of alone in this as well, your big network, NBC, CBS, well, these specials on, on some of these things.

419

00:35:18,500 --> 00:35:30,500

What's the problem? Los Angeles, unemployment situation, but yet a sort of the magnitude of possibility of extra-terrestrial visited has drawn a blank.

420

00:35:30,500 --> 00:35:33,500

Well, they have done special programs on UFOs.

421

00:35:33,500 --> 00:35:34,500

Yes, they have.

422

00:35:34,500 --> 00:35:40,500

They have had a movie, which I think was kind of a bomb, but I mean, that's beside the point.

423

00:35:40,500 --> 00:35:47,500

It's just, the handle's been enough often. I get the feeling that an awful lot of people who are, you might consider him or those folks who are from the country,

424

00:35:47,500 --> 00:35:53,500

a radio for television from this place, but I kind of either shying away or they don't believe in it at all.

425

00:35:53,500 --> 00:36:00,500

I frankly, if I can talk perhaps from the inside, I don't think that they're shying away from it.

426

00:36:00,500 --> 00:36:06,500

I frankly think that it's because a large percentage of people who would be involved in this really don't strongly.

427

00:36:06,500 --> 00:36:11,500

They think it's too far out of their heads in fact, and they treat it as sort of a feature type of thing.

428

00:36:11,500 --> 00:36:21,500

In fact, I think, Peter, this is probably the first time that flying saucers, trying to make such extensive hard news, as we call it, you know,

429

00:36:21,500 --> 00:36:22,500

that's the word I was looking for.

430

00:36:22,500 --> 00:36:30,500

Yeah, rather than someone writing about the financial farmers or the train that jumped out and taken to your leader, you know, or something like that.

431

00:36:30,500 --> 00:36:35,500

The first time I recall, they usually read stories, but nothing like this. Is that like, things?

432

00:36:35,500 --> 00:36:41,500

Well, there have been other times it seems to me when they have in the past, and at that time, of course, we gave more emphasis to it,

433

00:36:41,500 --> 00:36:51,500

and then after a passage of time, you don't recall how exciting and how much coverage there really was, believe, and I think that would explain that.

434

00:36:51,500 --> 00:36:58,500

But I do believe that a lot of people feel that anyone who thinks that things could come from outer space is a kind of a nut.

435

And yet, if you realize that we do really plan in our own lifetime to make manned exploration to the planet, even though it seems almost impossible that we would ever think of sending a spaceship to another solar system,

We also have statements from these men, statements they also saw the lights.

532

One in addition to saying they just looked like lights, gives you an indication they were

UFOs and they just looked like lights could have been things on an airplane or some sort

534

of an advertising balloon going by and one of a number of things.

535

Well, we talked to about fifteen of the students this afternoon and all of them have concurred

536

with the fact that the lights were stationary.

We had students say they watched them for ten minutes.

538

We have another that said he watched it for an hour and a half.

The lights changed from red to green to white in order, then back to red, green and white.

Were the colors bright?

541

They said about as bright as a bright star.

542

I mean the colors themselves, they said red to green to white, were the changes distinguishable

543

changes or just sort of shading they changed?

544

No, they said they were changing almost as if two different colored lights had been put on a

545

00:47:16,500 --> 00:47:21,500

policeman's light on his car and then the flasher.

They were flashing in different colors and then all three lights would change, all three of them would

547

00:47:26,500 --> 00:47:28,500

change every two seconds.

548

So the intervals were that fast.

549

You also talked to the farmer, was his name Manners?

550

Yes, Frank Manners.

551

He and his son saw one of these things, Hubbard or land?

Yes, and all at Hubbard I believe.

But we haven't any reports of what actually hit him.

Well, if you start that kind of feeling, you can spread alarm and there's actually no basis to feel fear of these objects as far as we've found out.

There's no evidence of any hostility and I think we should look at them more calmly and try to get as much scientific information as we can.

And impress people, in fact, there has not been any attacks, there's been no hostility.

And there's a great deal that can be learned if these are actually machines from some other and more advanced civilization.

597

So from the 19th point of view, somebody up there likes us?

598

No, I think that we don't know what motive could be back of these.

599

It could simply be something the Air Force itself years ago suggested in the Project Country Report

600

that an advanced civilization was concerned because we were now preparing to go into space.

601

We were launching high altitude rockets.

602

00:51:33,500 --> 00:51:35,500

We were exploding nuclear bombs.

They wanted to check and see whether we were likely to be any sort of a problem as we did get out of space.

Bob, I like Jacques Ballet's idea in the book Anatomy of a Phenomenon in which he suggests that there has been enough evidence now

and it's about time that a group of scientists actually got to work on this as a project, putting their heads together,

not just one man going out and interviewing a few people over a few hours,

607

but really working on this to find out if there is something to the UFOs, if they really are from outer space and coming up with an answer as to what they are.

Daniel Campbell, before we close down our line to Michigan tonight, are you going to be out doing any investigating this evening?

I hope not. I was out all last night.
