Now, I don't want to go too far into this story because the story is far more fascinatingly

told firsthand by our guests, who tonight are Betty and Barney Hill, who will be speaking

to us long distance from Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

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00:00:34,840 --> 00:00:39,280

But before we introduce Betty and Barney on the telephone, I would like you to meet our

friend and your friend, the noted Cleveland ufologist and a member of NYCAP and also APRO

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00:00:45,320 --> 00:00:51,000

and several other organizations, I'm sure, and himself an author and distinguished lecturer,

Mr. Earl Nett.

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00:00:52,000 --> 00:00:57,000

He is an experienced investigator, also he's a fascinating guy to have on as a guest, and

I never feel right doing any kind of a program about unidentified flying objects unless Earl

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00:01:02,880 --> 00:01:03,880

is with me.

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00:01:03,880 --> 00:01:08,880

Tonight, I'm particularly anxious to talk to Betty and Barney Hill, but before we do, I

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00:01:08,880 --> 00:01:14,280

just wanted to tell you that the introduction to the book, *The Interrupted Journey*, is written,

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00:01:14,280 --> 00:01:17,280

as I think I mentioned, by Benjamin Simon.

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00:01:17,560 --> 00:01:25,560

And the reason for writing the introduction was to give the reader the documentation and

the authority from the psychiatrist to reprint in certain sections of the book the transcript

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00:01:30,920 --> 00:01:34,040

of his treatment of both Mr. and Mrs. Hill.

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00:01:34,040 --> 00:01:40,240

I think it's very important to realize that this is not a story that has come from a person

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00:01:40,240 --> 00:01:43,640

who feels they've had this experience alone.

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00:01:43,640 --> 00:01:49,640

It rather comes not only from them, but it is documented as told to their psychiatrist

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00:01:49,640 --> 00:01:51,560

under the influence of hypnosis.

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00:01:51,560 --> 00:01:57,240

Hypnosis was the method of treatment, a time being of the essence that Dr. Simon chose to

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00:01:57,240 --> 00:01:58,240

use.

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00:01:58,240 --> 00:02:05,040

So, the story has been reconstructed, in effect, or parts of it have, through bona fide, hypnotic

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00:02:05,040 --> 00:02:09,160

treatment by a distinguished Boston psychiatrist.

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00:02:09,160 --> 00:02:16,680

I could read to you the entire excerpt from the 1966-67, Who's Who in the East, 10th edition.

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00:02:16,680 --> 00:02:22,480

There's about 42 inches worth of material in the columns on Dr. Benjamin Simon.

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00:02:22,480 --> 00:02:26,680

Suffice to say that he is a distinguished, respected psychiatrist.

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00:02:26,680 --> 00:02:33,480

All right, now, let's talk to Betty and Barney Hill, who are now on the telephone in Portsmouth,

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00:02:33,480 --> 00:02:34,480

New Hampshire.

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00:02:34,480 --> 00:02:37,480

Hello, which one have I got on the line, or have I got your phone?

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00:02:37,480 --> 00:02:38,480

Oh, how wonderful.

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00:02:38,480 --> 00:02:39,480

Hello, that's you, Barney?

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00:02:39,480 --> 00:02:40,480

Yes, that's correct.

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00:02:40,480 --> 00:02:41,480

And, Betty, are you there?

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00:02:41,480 --> 00:02:42,480

Yes, I'm here.

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00:02:42,480 --> 00:02:43,480

How are you?

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00:02:43,480 --> 00:02:44,480

I'm fine, thank you.

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00:02:44,480 --> 00:02:49,480

You both met, by a means of telephone, at least, Mr. Earl Netties with us tonight, too.

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00:02:49,480 --> 00:02:50,480

Hello, Barney and Betty.

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00:02:50,480 --> 00:02:51,480

Hi, Earl.

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00:02:51,480 --> 00:02:52,480

Good to hear your voice again.

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00:02:52,480 --> 00:02:53,480

Yes, it is a pleasure.

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00:02:53,480 --> 00:02:54,480

Thank you.

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00:02:54,480 --> 00:02:57,480

Now, before we get started, and I know you've told this story time and time again, and told

it fascinatingly, I'm going to express my gratitude to you in advance.

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00:03:02,480 --> 00:03:09,480

Both of you, Betty and Barney, for conceding to be on with us tonight.

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00:03:09,480 --> 00:03:10,480

Thank you.

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00:03:10,480 --> 00:03:17,480

Now, as I understand it, we have to go back to 1961 to start this whole incident, don't

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00:03:17,480 --> 00:03:18,480

we?

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00:03:18,480 --> 00:03:19,480

Yes, that's right.

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00:03:19,480 --> 00:03:20,480

September 19th, 1961.

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00:03:20,480 --> 00:03:22,480

That's when whatever happened happened.

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00:03:22,480 --> 00:03:23,480

Yes.

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00:03:23,480 --> 00:03:24,480

Where were you then, Barney?

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00:03:24,480 --> 00:03:31,480

Well, Betty and I were returning from a vacation trip in Canada, and we had left Montreal, Canada.

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00:03:31,480 --> 00:03:38,480

Arrived in New Hampshire across the Canadian, American Canadian border, about 9.30, close

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00:03:38,480 --> 00:03:47,480

to 9.30 o'clock p.m. And we stopped in a small town, border town, called Coldbroke, New

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00:03:47,480 --> 00:03:55,480

Hampshire, and we had a refreshment with coffee and hamburgers, and we left approximately

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00:03:55,480 --> 00:03:58,480

10 o'clock shortly after 10.

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00:03:58,480 --> 00:04:05,480

When we were traveling south on Route 3, arrived in an area called Lancaster, New Hampshire,

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00:04:05,480 --> 00:04:12,480

Betty called my attention to an object caused by a star that she had been watching because

she had noticed it, and she called my attention to it, but she could better tell what she had

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00:04:18,480 --> 00:04:23,480

seen because this would have been my first introduction to this star and all.

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00:04:23,480 --> 00:04:25,480

Betty, what was it you saw?

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00:04:25,480 --> 00:04:30,480

Well, when Peter writing a book in the Lancaster area, it was personal.

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00:04:30,480 --> 00:04:32,480

It was a beautiful night.

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00:04:32,480 --> 00:04:36,480

It was a hot, smooth, it was quite bright.

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00:04:36,480 --> 00:04:43,480

And it spread out in the long, rocky and corner of the moon with a large star which I really

played up with the planet Jupiter.

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00:04:45,480 --> 00:04:52,480

And suddenly, there appeared above this star a much larger star, which I had not been

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00:04:52,480 --> 00:04:55,480

there, and then suddenly I saw it.

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00:04:55,480 --> 00:05:01,480

And as I was watching, this star seemed to be getting larger and brighter.

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00:05:01,480 --> 00:05:05,480

And as we were going to do better all night, kept watching it, and then all of a sudden,

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00:05:05,480 --> 00:05:08,480

I noticed that it had started to move.

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00:05:08,480 --> 00:05:12,480

And it was at this time that I felt really called Betty's attention to it.

And we decided to stop, get out of the car with the binoculars, and take a look at it.

At this time, we thought it was a satellite.

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00:05:22,480 --> 00:05:31,480

So we just got out of the car, and we had seven systems of objects that I had not forgotten.

Besides, it was a device 7 by 50 power.

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00:05:34,480 --> 00:05:42,480

And we took turns watching this object, and it went across the face of the moon.

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00:05:42,480 --> 00:05:50,480

And then made a half turn, and started to come in towards our car.

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00:05:50,480 --> 00:05:55,480

And when it started coming towards us, this was when we returned to the car.

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00:05:55,480 --> 00:06:02,480

And just finally made the comment that it had seen us, and was coming towards us.

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00:06:02,480 --> 00:06:04,480

We got in the car, and we started driving.

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00:06:04,480 --> 00:06:10,480

How did you feel then, Barney, if you said it had seen you, it was coming toward you.

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00:06:10,480 --> 00:06:17,480

Well, Alan, I think that remark would have been made because after Betty had called my attention to this,

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00:06:17,480 --> 00:06:24,480

and this car that was in the sky moving, my remark to her was that it was obviously a satellite.

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00:06:24,480 --> 00:06:33,480

Prior to 1961, I was totally closed minded about flying saucers or UFOs,

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00:06:33,480 --> 00:06:39,480

so that this would have been a natural explanation for something distant, quite a distant, out moving.

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00:06:39,480 --> 00:06:43,480

The reason I said that it had not seen us, and was coming towards us,

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00:06:43,480 --> 00:06:50,480

is because there's rapidly, from a star-like position, which means it was quite a distant away,

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00:06:50,480 --> 00:06:56,480

it now had come in rapidly to where it would have been closed to.

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00:06:56,480 --> 00:07:05,480

What I mean by closed is that now it is something that you can see in the sky, like a light, with the sky in the background, you might say.

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00:07:05,480 --> 00:07:08,480

Would you say that it was just an off-and-rear fight in this moment?

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00:07:08,480 --> 00:07:14,480

Well, I became frightened only because I didn't say, well, Betty, it is an off-probability,

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00:07:14,480 --> 00:07:21,480

it is a commercial airliner going to Canada, because it was traveling north when we initially saw it.

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00:07:21,480 --> 00:07:29,480

And I said, well, it's probably a commercial plane on its way north, somewhere.

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00:07:29,480 --> 00:07:37,480

And it made this peculiar turn that Betty described, where it turned toward Vermont, which is west of New Hampshire,

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00:07:37,480 --> 00:07:44,480

and completing the turn started coming toward where we were parked on the highway, coming towards us.

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00:07:44,480 --> 00:07:47,480

Now we are in the mountainous areas, you have to understand that too.

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00:07:47,480 --> 00:07:56,480

So I became quite alarmed, and this was dark at night, I saw some bears, unformally, from a city.

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00:07:56,480 --> 00:08:00,480

And I kept thinking, well, what if bears came out of the woods then?

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00:08:00,480 --> 00:08:03,480

This has been quite frightening to me as well.

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00:08:03,480 --> 00:08:11,480

So that Betty, they had seen us, and we returned to the car and began traveling on Room 3, traveling south.

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00:08:11,480 --> 00:08:19,480

Now Betty would occasionally call my attention to the object, I would slow down, and sometimes I would make a complete stop,

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00:08:19,480 --> 00:08:25,480

because the object was now following, going along in the same direction we were going.

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00:08:25,480 --> 00:08:34,480

That is, the way it had been traveling north, it had now began traveling south, the direction we are traveling.

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00:08:34,480 --> 00:08:39,480

So that it was off on the passenger side of the car, and we would occasionally stop.

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00:08:39,480 --> 00:08:50,480

And I kept thinking, if one has ever been in open areas at night, you can see millions of stars,

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00:08:50,480 --> 00:08:54,480

or prominent in the sky that you can in the city.

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00:08:54,480 --> 00:09:03,480

So that on occasion when you are driving along at night, you can notice that a star seems to be moving along with the car motion.

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00:09:03,480 --> 00:09:06,480

And I kept thinking, well, maybe this is what is happening.

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00:09:06,480 --> 00:09:09,480

So I would stop the car, and the object was still moving.

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00:09:09,480 --> 00:09:12,480

And this was peculiar to me.

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00:09:12,480 --> 00:09:17,480

It was still moving, but it obviously had to rule out that it was a star.

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00:09:17,480 --> 00:09:20,480

And it is following us to the south.

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00:09:20,480 --> 00:09:26,480

Well, we arrived at an area called the Franconian Notch, and there is cannon-pump there.

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00:09:26,480 --> 00:09:33,480

There is a tramway that goes up to the mountain that one can ride, going to some of the much up to the summit of the Mount Stalk.

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00:09:33,480 --> 00:09:39,480

And the object went around the west side of the mountain, which would have been the Burmuk.

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00:09:39,480 --> 00:09:42,480

Well, we are in New Hampshire, but it would have been on that side.

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00:09:42,480 --> 00:09:49,480

While the road itself at the base of the mountain travels around on the left side.

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00:09:49,480 --> 00:09:54,480

And then traveling around on the left side at the base of this mountain, of Cannon-on-Ton,

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00:09:54,480 --> 00:10:02,480

the object when we came out south of Cannon-on-Ton, there is a natural rock formation called Oman of the Mountain.

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00:10:02,480 --> 00:10:06,480

It is actually a landmark marking New Hampshire.

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00:10:06,480 --> 00:10:18,480

We use it in many of the government approaches that is telling of sites and things to see.

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00:10:18,480 --> 00:10:20,480

One-one visiting New Hampshire.

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00:10:20,480 --> 00:10:23,480

So this is something that everyone is quite proud about.

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00:10:23,480 --> 00:10:28,480

It is this natural rock formation that looks like the face of a person, a mobile.

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00:10:28,480 --> 00:10:35,480

So the object was now front, might say, in the front of us.

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00:10:35,480 --> 00:10:41,480

And I came to another stop and I looked and I could see it. It was still all a bit distant.

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00:10:41,480 --> 00:10:43,480

What did it look like to you now?

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00:10:43,480 --> 00:10:48,480

From this point, it looked like, in all respects, out of probability, it looked like,

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00:10:48,480 --> 00:10:51,480

and then I thought it was a type of club.

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00:10:51,480 --> 00:10:59,480

Because I thought that a fast-moving commercial plane couldn't travel that slow.

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00:10:59,480 --> 00:11:01,480

So it was once again a type of club.

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00:11:01,480 --> 00:11:06,480

And this is what Gold-Bitty, there is nothing to get a lot about. It's a type of club.

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00:11:06,480 --> 00:11:10,480

But I was getting quite frightened because of this.

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00:11:10,480 --> 00:11:13,480

And I thought it must have been a military pilot.

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00:11:13,480 --> 00:11:18,480

What they could obviously see on the ground with the lights of the car on.

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00:11:18,480 --> 00:11:22,480

I thought they were playing a game with us out there.

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00:11:22,480 --> 00:11:28,480

And when we arrived south of Indian Head, I used Indian Head as a landmark.

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00:11:28,480 --> 00:11:30,480

But it was just a little south of Indian Head.

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00:11:30,480 --> 00:11:34,480

Betty again called my attention to this. She was very excited. She said,

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00:11:34,480 --> 00:11:38,480

that I stopped the game because I was calling Betty that way.

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00:11:38,480 --> 00:11:39,480

Now we have to get on to who we are.

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00:11:39,480 --> 00:11:44,480

I thought we can't bother ourselves with this, whatever it is out there.

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00:11:44,480 --> 00:11:50,480

And I, as I said previously, a military pilot, a type of car, a commercial airline,

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00:11:50,480 --> 00:11:54,480

I kept putting it all in this kind of natural explanation.

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00:11:54,480 --> 00:11:58,480

So she called my attention again and I stopped the car.

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00:11:58,480 --> 00:12:02,480

And now the object has descended to about 200 feet.

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00:12:02,480 --> 00:12:09,480

It was on the passenger side of the car, not directly to the right, but in an oblique.

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00:12:09,480 --> 00:12:14,480

Or to the right head like on that kind of an angle.

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00:12:14,480 --> 00:12:18,480

I looked through the windshield and I could see that, as I said,

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00:12:18,480 --> 00:12:22,480

that it has descended to about 200 feet. I estimate this.

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00:12:22,480 --> 00:12:26,480

And I am not good at that, good at estimating this thing.

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00:12:26,480 --> 00:12:28,480

It was quite a closer.

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00:12:28,480 --> 00:12:34,480

I became determined then that I was going to find out what this is.

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00:12:34,480 --> 00:12:37,480

It had to have some natural explanation.

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00:12:37,480 --> 00:12:39,480

And this is as simple as that.

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00:12:39,480 --> 00:12:44,480

I got out of the car, took the vanaculars from the row where they were sitting

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00:12:44,480 --> 00:12:48,480

between the seat, on the seat between Betty and I.

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00:12:48,480 --> 00:12:53,480

And I stepped away from the car and along the whole the object then shifted across

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00:12:53,480 --> 00:12:58,480

from the passenger side over the highway, over the field,

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00:12:58,480 --> 00:13:03,480

which brought it over on the driver's side of the car now.

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00:13:03,480 --> 00:13:09,480

And also in, you might say, an oblique position from the car position.

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00:13:09,480 --> 00:13:16,480

That way, not exactly to the passenger side of the car, but on front at an angle.

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00:13:16,480 --> 00:13:19,480

And I began walking away.

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00:13:19,480 --> 00:13:23,480

I began walking away from the car, across the highway,

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00:13:23,480 --> 00:13:26,480

walked into the field. I walked quite a distance.

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00:13:26,480 --> 00:13:32,480

And then I was looking at it with the vanaculars and I can't believe what I am seeing.

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00:13:32,480 --> 00:13:38,480

Because now we have to understand that this is all that have always been in the conscious memory.

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00:13:38,480 --> 00:13:39,480

Yes.

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00:13:39,480 --> 00:13:44,480

I can't believe what I am seeing because with the vanaculars I can discern what I call

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00:13:44,480 --> 00:13:50,480

a figure's moving about at a huge plate glass that seems to curve around.

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00:13:50,480 --> 00:13:54,480

And this was so baffling because we kept thinking, there's nothing this,

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00:13:54,480 --> 00:13:56,480

I can't believe it's flying off as UFOs.

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00:13:56,480 --> 00:13:58,480

And this is just incredible.

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00:13:58,480 --> 00:14:03,480

And I wanted to hear a sound or noise of some kind of motor

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00:14:03,480 --> 00:14:08,480

that would cause this thing to be able to be hovering there in a stationary position.

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00:14:08,480 --> 00:14:13,480

I failed to mention that when I made this stop, this particular stop,

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00:14:13,480 --> 00:14:18,480

Betty also had seen two red lights on the side of the graph.

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00:14:18,480 --> 00:14:21,480

And I, when I stepped from the car, could see the same two red lights.

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00:14:21,480 --> 00:14:24,480

She was now happy that she had shifted across the highway.

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00:14:24,480 --> 00:14:31,480

These figures that were looking seemingly down toward me because the object was tilted

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00:14:31,480 --> 00:14:36,480

at a downward motion, plate glass, this huge glass was tilted towards the ground,

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00:14:36,480 --> 00:14:39,480

you might say, at a slight angle.

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00:14:39,480 --> 00:14:42,480

At an angle that would have enabled the occupants to look down.

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00:14:42,480 --> 00:14:43,480

Yes, that's correct.

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00:14:43,480 --> 00:14:50,480

I could see, well, I said that all the figures then, it was the exception of one,

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00:14:50,480 --> 00:14:56,480

moved away as if to take just one, no more than two steps from the plate glass.

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00:14:56,480 --> 00:15:00,480

And I could see with the binoculars what I thought were going on,

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00:15:00,480 --> 00:15:02,480

touching or pulling on papers.

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00:15:02,480 --> 00:15:05,480

A lack of a better thing to say, I called the believers.

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00:15:05,480 --> 00:15:06,480

Yes.

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00:15:06,480 --> 00:15:12,480

The two red lights that were now part of the graph began to move out and away,

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00:15:12,480 --> 00:15:18,480

becoming the extension of a thin or thin light type wing.

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00:15:18,480 --> 00:15:19,480

Yes.

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00:15:19,480 --> 00:15:28,480

The long wings that you find on a plane, thought more of a thin light type of wing

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00:15:28,480 --> 00:15:31,480

and the two red lights would have been the adipate of this,

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00:15:31,480 --> 00:15:34,480

and it became the extension of these wings.

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00:15:34,480 --> 00:15:42,480

And I was just completely saffled by the entire experience that he has seen,

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00:15:42,480 --> 00:15:44,480

this incredible thing.

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00:15:44,480 --> 00:15:49,480

And I pulled the binoculars away from my eyes, dashing back to the car, screaming to Betty,

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00:15:49,480 --> 00:15:52,480

oh my God, I said, Betty, there is going to capture it.

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00:15:52,480 --> 00:15:58,480

I entered the car, put it into gear, and I thought I could see as I passed.

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00:15:58,480 --> 00:16:03,480

I mentioned it was in an oblique position towards the front of the car.

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00:16:03,480 --> 00:16:04,480

You thought I might want to use it?

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00:16:04,480 --> 00:16:05,480

Yes.

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00:16:05,480 --> 00:16:10,480

So that when I began driving down the highway, the object I saw shifted overhead.

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00:16:10,480 --> 00:16:14,480

And there was a series of beeps, and Betty was saying, I don't see it, I don't see it.

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00:16:14,480 --> 00:16:20,480

There was this series of beeps, beep, beep, beep, beep, beep, and the car vibrated very subtly.

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00:16:20,480 --> 00:16:21,480

Yes.

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00:16:21,480 --> 00:16:26,480

And could you sense where those beeps, if there was a vibration, where the vibration was coming from?

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00:16:26,480 --> 00:16:32,480

I felt it with my hands on the steering wheel, I felt it tingling on the steering column.

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00:16:32,480 --> 00:16:39,480

Betty has mentioned that, but she hasn't mentioned it yet, but she has told me that she reached itself to dash panel

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00:16:39,480 --> 00:16:44,480

and we all wondered, where is this subtle vibration coming from?

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00:16:44,480 --> 00:16:46,480

It was not a violent vibration.

222

00:16:46,480 --> 00:16:47,480

Yes.

223

00:16:47,480 --> 00:16:55,480

The vibration was much, the description I have given is like a tuning fork being struck in place against one's arm.

224

00:16:55,480 --> 00:16:56,480

Yes.

225

00:16:56,480 --> 00:16:57,480

That's just a subtle vibration.

226

00:16:57,480 --> 00:17:01,480

That's the way the car vibrated from the beeping sound that we heard.

227

00:17:01,480 --> 00:17:04,480

And the vibration seemed to coordinate with the beeping sound.

228

00:17:04,480 --> 00:17:05,480

Let the beeps, yes.

229

00:17:05,480 --> 00:17:08,480

All right, now I would stop you with this point in your story.

230

00:17:08,480 --> 00:17:14,480

Barney and Barney Hill is recounting, ladies and gentlemen, this story from his conscious memory.

231

00:17:14,480 --> 00:17:18,480

It is most important to realize that there was a lapse.

232

00:17:18,480 --> 00:17:25,480

What you're going to hear next in the story is a reconstructed version.

233

00:17:25,480 --> 00:17:34,480

It took some years for Barney and for Betty Hill to find out what happened after they first heard the beeping sound

234

00:17:34,480 --> 00:17:37,480

and felt the vibrations inside the car.

235

00:17:37,480 --> 00:17:44,480

But I would like to pause for just a moment if I may and render a commercial.

236

00:17:44,480 --> 00:17:52,480

And then we'll get back to the story that we're listening to from Betty and Barney Hill speaking to us from Portsmouth, New Hampshire tonight.

237

00:17:52,480 --> 00:18:11,480

And we will go aboard that unidentified flying object with Mr. and Mrs. Hill in a moment.

238

00:18:11,480 --> 00:18:15,480

And so will Earl Ness, our guest here in the studio tonight.

239

00:18:15,480 --> 00:18:21,480

We're talking Earl Ness of Cleveland and I with Betty and Barney Hill.

240

00:18:21,480 --> 00:18:27,480

And Betty and Barney live and are speaking to us tonight from their residence in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

241

00:18:27,480 --> 00:18:36,480

And we left them on Route 3 heading south and feeling a strange vibration in the car coordinated with beeps.

242

00:18:36,480 --> 00:18:40,480

And now let's get back to Barney and Betty.

243

00:18:40,480 --> 00:18:49,480

Before we go on with the story, Betty, you were alone in the car with the dog while Barney ran out in the field with the bonacutters.

244

00:18:49,480 --> 00:18:55,480

Now what did you see from the car and how did you feel that while Barney was off in the field?

245

00:18:55,480 --> 00:19:04,480

Well, my first thought was, well, let me say first of all, I had no fear whatsoever at this point.

246

00:19:04,480 --> 00:19:10,480

I was fascinated by this and I had a great deal of curiosity.

247

00:19:10,480 --> 00:19:17,480

When Barney saw the car, he stopped at right, right in the middle of the highway.

248

00:19:17,480 --> 00:19:27,480

And so when he ran out into the field, I was reading the car and I was watching in case of traffic, any car coming along.

249

00:19:27,480 --> 00:19:33,480

Then I would drive the car over to the side of the highway.

250

00:19:33,480 --> 00:19:40,480

So I was sitting here waiting for my help. And I kept waiting and waiting and waiting.

And I started to open it and when I was going to find out and go out in the field and get out of the car,

256

00:20:18,480 --> 00:20:29,480

when I heard him running out to the car, and then this is when he got into the car and said that they were going to capture us.

257

00:20:30,480 --> 00:20:37,480

And he was so upset. He was so hysterical. He was very upset.

258

00:20:37,480 --> 00:20:41,480

And he immediately started driving the car.

259

00:20:41,480 --> 00:20:44,480

Those wheels tried to escape.

260

00:20:44,480 --> 00:20:49,480

And he was also telling me to look out and see if I could see them.

261

00:20:49,480 --> 00:20:52,480

Saying that they were directly over here.

262

00:20:52,480 --> 00:20:57,480

I looked the car and went down and I checked my house, the window and looked down.

263

00:20:57,480 --> 00:21:00,480

And I couldn't see any sign.

264

00:21:00,480 --> 00:21:08,480

And so then I took a little backup and it just turned out completely that we heard some beeping on the train to the car.

265

00:21:08,480 --> 00:21:10,480

And the car vibrated.

266

00:21:10,480 --> 00:21:17,480

And I was touching the metal because I could see a little something electrical.

267

00:21:17,480 --> 00:21:21,480

And possibly there would be electricity. Maybe if I could feel a shock.

268

Yes.

269

00:21:22,480 --> 00:21:25,480

But a metal or a car. There was no sign.

270

00:21:25,480 --> 00:21:30,480

Now, at this point, this is a critical point in the story.

271

It is typical to know where to go from here because this is the point of the story at which you later realized that there were two hours missing in time.

272

And I think perhaps what we best do is follow you along home in your conscious memory to the point where you got home and then reconstruct the story as it actually happened to you.

We'll do that in a moment.

274

After I pause to remind our audience that we're talking with Barney and Betty Hill tonight.

275

00:22:00,480 --> 00:22:08,480

They are the subjects of the book *The Interrupted Journey*. Two hours, two lost hours aboard a flying saucer by John G Fuller.

276

00:22:08,480 --> 00:22:11,480

It is now available. It's published by Zyle.

277

00:22:11,480 --> 00:22:15,480

And if you are a ufologist, I strongly urge that you get this book.

278

00:22:15,480 --> 00:22:32,480

I think that this incident goes down as probably the best documented fighting of another device flying object and confrontation with creatures in an object in the history of UFOs.

279

00:22:32,480 --> 00:22:36,480

Now, Betty and Barney will be with us and so will Earl Ness.

280

00:22:36,480 --> 00:22:43,480

I feel him felt only through earthbound egoistic urges to remind you that my name is Alan Ness.

281

00:22:43,480 --> 00:22:48,480

Now, let's get back to the story that Betty and Barney are telling us.

282

00:22:48,480 --> 00:22:52,480

You proceeded onward then toward Portsmouth.

283

00:22:52,480 --> 00:23:04,480

From the time you first heard those beats and felt the vibrations, was there any lag in your conscious memory to the second time you heard them?

284

00:23:04,480 --> 00:23:13,480

I would say that we feel only later that we realize that this chat was sort of missing.

285

00:23:13,480 --> 00:23:15,480

May I F.B.A. say this?

286

00:23:15,480 --> 00:23:16,480

Yes, Tony.

287

00:23:16,480 --> 00:23:25,480

And Betty, that later we also described another time when we heard these series of beat.

288

00:23:25,480 --> 00:23:32,480

And Betty remarked to me, well now Barney, do you believe in flying saucers?

289

00:23:32,480 --> 00:23:35,480

And I said, of course, not Betty, don't be ridiculous.

290

00:23:35,480 --> 00:23:41,480

This would have been in the September's National Infection of New Hampshire on Route 3.

291

00:23:41,480 --> 00:23:44,480

This incident has always been the position that you had taken?

292

00:23:44,480 --> 00:23:48,480

Yes, and we then proceeded on to Portsmouth.

293

00:23:48,480 --> 00:23:54,480

We occasionally, we didn't stop after this, but we would occasionally look at the sky.

294

00:23:54,480 --> 00:23:59,480

We would throw down very, to a full base occasionally.

295

00:23:59,480 --> 00:24:02,480

And we drove to Portsmouth.

296

00:24:02,480 --> 00:24:09,480

There wasn't much conversation between us from that point after the second beat to Portsmouth.

297

00:24:09,480 --> 00:24:20,480

Except that when we arrived in the city of Portsmouth, it was dawn, it was daybreak, and the sun was coming up.

298

00:24:20,480 --> 00:24:23,480

It was not night any longer.

299

00:24:23,480 --> 00:24:30,480

Now this is the trip, it's approximately 170 miles from Coldbrook, New Hampshire to Portsmouth.

300

00:24:30,480 --> 00:24:33,480

And the speed of the highway is 50 miles an hour.

301

00:24:33,480 --> 00:24:40,480

We don't know that it should have taken us, oh, I should say, at least 3 to 4 hours to get home.

302

00:24:40,480 --> 00:24:42,480

It would have had you home about midnight.

303

00:24:42,480 --> 00:24:46,480

Yes, well, no, we left at Coldbrook at 10 o'clock.

304

00:24:46,480 --> 00:24:49,480

We should have arrived, I would say, around 2 o'clock in the morning.

305

00:24:49,480 --> 00:24:50,480

2 am, right?

306

00:24:50,480 --> 00:24:56,480

Yes, but when we arrived, it was after 4, closer to 5, when we arrived in Portsmouth.

307

00:24:56,480 --> 00:25:05,480

But it was very determined that I would not bring the car refrigerator we had with food in it, of fresh food, that is,

308

00:25:05,480 --> 00:25:12,480

that I would not bring it into the house, that I would carry it around to the back soup and place it there because she wanted to discard all this food.

309

00:25:12,480 --> 00:25:18,480

And I wondered why, and she just thought, but she didn't want it in the house and we shouldn't eat it.

310

We entered the home and we felt unclean, more than just the accumulation of dirt and slime, one would get from a trip.

311

But we felt foiled, and there was foiled and kind of uncleanliness.

312

And I went into the bathroom, took a mirror and examined my body for no reason.

313

I wasn't looking for anything.

314

00:25:40,480 --> 00:25:44,480

I just felt something had touched me and I wasn't sure what it was.

315

00:25:44,480 --> 00:25:46,480

And I went to look around and see.

316

And I didn't see or find anything.

317

00:25:48,480 --> 00:25:52,480

Well, this is basically what would have happened.

318

00:25:52,480 --> 00:25:58,480

Betty and I retired then and we awakened several hours later in the late afternoon.

319

00:25:58,480 --> 00:26:02,480

We followed what we would never tell anyone about this.

320

00:26:02,480 --> 00:26:10,480

And we decided that we would draw a picture of what we thought this thing looked like and compare our drawings.

321

00:26:10,480 --> 00:26:16,480

So Betty went into one room and I, the other, we drew our pictures, we brought them together and we looked at them.

322

And there was the similarity of the structure of what we were trying to draw.

323

00:26:22,480 --> 00:26:30,480

So our drawing techniques, basically, we're not odd as far as the imagination, but there was the similarity.

324

00:26:30,480 --> 00:26:36,480

Well, Betty then called her sister. We weren't going to tell anyone.

325

00:26:36,480 --> 00:26:43,480

So she called her sister and told her sister about it and also remarked about the beat.

326

00:26:43,480 --> 00:26:45,480

Because she was very upset about this.

327

00:26:45,480 --> 00:26:52,480

And her sister called back a few minutes later telling us that she had talked with her sister's friend of hers.

328

00:26:52,480 --> 00:27:00,480

And he had suggested that if there was beeping and the tingling sensation that Betty had described to go out and take a look at her car,

329

00:27:00,480 --> 00:27:06,480

if she had anything she could use to take it with her, and one suggestion was a compass.

330

00:27:06,480 --> 00:27:07,480

Yes.

331

00:27:07,480 --> 00:27:12,480

So we found the compass and it was interesting. Many people have a question. Why did we have a compass?

332

00:27:12,480 --> 00:27:15,480

Why do we have a compass? Did we have an oculus?

333

00:27:15,480 --> 00:27:16,480

The only answer is...

334

00:27:16,480 --> 00:27:18,480

Your camphor is there, she's got me.

335

00:27:18,480 --> 00:27:19,480

Your camphor is there, she's got me.

336

00:27:19,480 --> 00:27:20,480

We're camphors, we love it.

337

00:27:20,480 --> 00:27:28,480

And the interesting thing, we live on the coast and we're only about three miles from the ocean

338

00:27:28,480 --> 00:27:34,480

so that anyone living by the sea, we enjoy sitting on the beach looking out at ocean line

339

00:27:34,480 --> 00:27:39,480

and going up the coast occasionally, coming into portmouth as well as going into the mountain areas

340

00:27:39,480 --> 00:27:44,480

and going up on the summit of some mountain and then looking off at the best distances

341

00:27:44,480 --> 00:27:47,480

and trying to pick out objects with the binoculars.

342

00:27:47,480 --> 00:27:49,480

So this is just standard equipment.

343

00:27:49,480 --> 00:27:54,480

I would say that any rational mind will grant you a pair of binoculars and a compass.

344

00:27:55,480 --> 00:27:56,480

Yes.

345

00:27:56,480 --> 00:28:00,480

So that goat, bedding went out and he came into the house very, very upset.

346

00:28:00,480 --> 00:28:06,480

Now, I get told that to keep me out of this and not to involve me with a conversation with the sister or any of this.

347

00:28:06,480 --> 00:28:10,480

Well, we have tenants living in our apartment at that time.

348

00:28:10,480 --> 00:28:16,480

This young man in his life that we're living in our apartment, that is the building we have home to building itself.

349

00:28:16,480 --> 00:28:20,480

They knew we had been on vacation and they could hear us talking.

350

00:28:20,480 --> 00:28:25,480

So they came down to ask about our trip and they noticed I was very excited

351

00:28:25,480 --> 00:28:29,480

and was trying to get me to go look at her car.

352

00:28:29,480 --> 00:28:31,480

And they went off to Goloka and they came in and they said,

353

00:28:31,480 --> 00:28:33,480

Bonnie, you should go out and take a look at the car.

354

00:28:33,480 --> 00:28:34,480

I said, what's the deal?

355

00:28:34,480 --> 00:28:36,480

Oh, there are large spots on it.

356

00:28:36,480 --> 00:28:41,480

So I went out and we looked at them and took a look and they were on the front of the car.

357

00:28:41,480 --> 00:28:45,480

They were very large shiny spots about the size of silver dollars.

358

00:28:45,480 --> 00:28:50,480

These spots were the same color of the car because this has been a misconception.

359

00:28:50,480 --> 00:28:54,480

Some people have thought that they were different color, but it was the same color of the car.

360

00:28:54,480 --> 00:29:00,480

Only as if it had been highly polished, this is a circular polish.

361

00:29:00,480 --> 00:29:06,480

And there must have been around 15 to 20 of these spots in no particular pattern.

362

00:29:06,480 --> 00:29:09,480

Just spotted throughout the trunk.

363

00:29:09,480 --> 00:29:10,480

Around the trunk area.

364

00:29:10,480 --> 00:29:11,480

Yes.

365

00:29:11,480 --> 00:29:17,480

And when placing the compass over the spot, the compass would revolve very erratically.

366

00:29:17,480 --> 00:29:20,480

The reason I wasn't too interested about taking the compass out

367

00:29:20,480 --> 00:29:25,480

because I knew that a car would invariably or any kind of metal of this type

368

00:29:25,480 --> 00:29:30,480

would attract the magnet of the compass to what it.

369

00:29:30,480 --> 00:29:33,480

I didn't find anything too upsetting about that

370

00:29:33,480 --> 00:29:39,480

except that when putting the compass over the spot, then it would erratically revolve.

371

00:29:39,480 --> 00:29:44,480

So Betty then decided that there's only one thing to do with this.

372

00:29:44,480 --> 00:29:50,480

That is to notify the PSA of fourth base, which is a fact base in our town, in our area.

373

00:29:50,480 --> 00:29:52,480

And she called.

374

00:29:52,480 --> 00:29:58,480

I told her, well, okay, you may, but you mustn't give my name or tell me anything about me.

375

00:29:58,480 --> 00:30:03,480

Well, this is ridiculous on my part because obviously she had to say that her husband was with her on vacation.

376

00:30:03,480 --> 00:30:08,480

And as their next, as their questioning heard, their next action would have been

377

00:30:08,480 --> 00:30:13,480

well now that I speak to your husband, you know, so I, they're not involved.

378

00:30:13,480 --> 00:30:20,480

But as I have pointed out in the book that Mr. Fulish has written documenting this story,

379

00:30:20,480 --> 00:30:26,480

I pointed out that after talking with these officers, I formed at peace.

380

00:30:26,480 --> 00:30:31,480

I felt a great relief because they handled it with great dignity, you might say.

381

00:30:31,480 --> 00:30:34,480

In a very official way.

382

00:30:34,480 --> 00:30:40,480

And as if this was the responsible thing that she and I should have done to report it to them,

383

00:30:40,480 --> 00:30:47,480

they also said that we were going to be hooked up with another phone.

384

00:30:47,480 --> 00:30:51,480

They didn't tell us at this time and it would be monitored.

385

00:30:51,480 --> 00:30:55,480

We later learned that this would have been hooked up to Wright-Patterson Airport,

386

00:30:55,480 --> 00:30:58,480

where we again told the same story.

387

00:30:58,480 --> 00:31:05,480

And they called back a few times to ask us about details concerning the structure of the craft,

388

00:31:05,480 --> 00:31:07,480

its maneuverability, etc., so forth.

389

00:31:07,480 --> 00:31:12,480

And that was the only official interview we had with the military.

390

00:31:12,480 --> 00:31:14,480

No one ever came out to the house.

391

00:31:14,480 --> 00:31:22,480

Betty Beanewell obtained books from the library because neither of us knew anything about the so-called UFO flying saucer.

392

00:31:22,480 --> 00:31:28,480

And she was quite interested now to find out just what did we see.

393

00:31:28,480 --> 00:31:32,480

And these books that she went down to the library to obtain,

394

00:31:32,480 --> 00:31:36,480

one contained information about reporting fighting with the NCAC,

395

00:31:36,480 --> 00:31:41,480

a national investigator committee on aerial phenomenon, so she started off a letter to NCAC,

396

00:31:41,480 --> 00:31:47,480

and then they sent an investigator to visit us from Boston.

397

00:31:47,480 --> 00:31:52,480

They located in Washington, the headquarters, which have investigators throughout this country.

398

00:31:52,480 --> 00:31:59,480

So Walter Webb, a, you might call him, a astronomer, he's a lecturer at Aitton Planetarium,

399

00:31:59,480 --> 00:32:01,480

came to interview us.

400

00:32:01,480 --> 00:32:06,480

And I found later, found out later, that he did, this was greatly loved because

401

00:32:06,480 --> 00:32:12,480

that was the mention of me having seen, of, there's a certain figure inside the craft.

402

00:32:12,480 --> 00:32:19,480

Yes, but after arriving later, he said he was very impressed with the sincerity of both Betty and

I.

403

00:32:19,480 --> 00:32:27,480

And I certainly did respond to Walter when he came to the house, an intelligent young man.

404

00:32:27,480 --> 00:32:33,480

I thought, well, I didn't know what was going to come to visit me concerning this kind of a story.

405

00:32:33,480 --> 00:32:41,480

Other scientists became interested, so they heard of this throughout now that we had reported it to NCAC.

406

00:32:41,480 --> 00:32:51,480

They published a newsletter to their subscribers so that we never volunteered and used this information to any news media.

407

00:32:51,480 --> 00:32:54,480

Because we didn't want this kind of publicity.

408

00:32:54,480 --> 00:32:56,480

So these other scientists got interested in it.

409

00:32:56,480 --> 00:33:02,480

And they stayed, visited us from different states, different areas.

410

00:33:02,480 --> 00:33:09,480

And while going over this one day, we must have spent about 12 hours going over this great depth

411

00:33:09,480 --> 00:33:16,480

when they came up with the idea that we realized that from the time we left Colbrook

412

00:33:16,480 --> 00:33:22,480

and the time we arrived in Portsmouth was close to six hours than four hours, which we should have taken.

413

00:33:22,480 --> 00:33:23,480

Yes.

414

00:33:23,480 --> 00:33:27,480

Well, we were sort of, well, we hadn't really realized it.

415

00:33:27,480 --> 00:33:34,480

But the fact that why after my dashing back to the car at Indian Head screaming something's going to capture us,

416

00:33:34,480 --> 00:33:38,480

Betty remarked later, do you believe in trying to process?

417

00:33:38,480 --> 00:33:45,480

And we have to understand that when I made this remark at Indian Head and in this series of beeps,

418

00:33:45,480 --> 00:33:52,480

the next series of beeps occurred in the Plymouth Ashland area, and this is the Park from the 330 to 35 miles apart.

419

00:33:52,480 --> 00:33:53,480

Yes.

420

00:33:53,480 --> 00:34:03,480

And we could never fill in, we could never think and understand exactly what we had been doing from the first beep to the second beep.

421

00:34:03,480 --> 00:34:04,480

Yes.

422

00:34:04,480 --> 00:34:09,480

Except to say that while I was driving the car after I ran back at Indian Head,

423

00:34:09,480 --> 00:34:15,480

I was driving and when the second beeps occurred in the Plymouth area, I'm driving the car.

424

00:34:15,480 --> 00:34:22,480

And, well, I don't know why she didn't tell me or ask me what's going to capture us, you see.

425

00:34:22,480 --> 00:34:24,480

No, yes, no.

426

00:34:24,480 --> 00:34:35,480

Along with this, along with these scientific inquiries that you were so laboriously and I'm sure interestingly answering,

427

00:34:35,480 --> 00:34:42,480

you and Betty had begun to have dreams, the dreams begun by this time.

428

00:34:42,480 --> 00:34:51,480

Betty had these dreams five days or ten days, correction, ten days after the fighting in 1961.

429

00:34:51,480 --> 00:34:54,480

And they lasted for only five days.

430

00:34:54,480 --> 00:34:55,480

I see.

431

00:34:55,480 --> 00:34:59,480

This is very important because she did not dream of UFOs after it.

432

00:34:59,480 --> 00:35:01,480

I did not have dreams.

433

00:35:01,480 --> 00:35:02,480

You had not?

434

00:35:02,480 --> 00:35:03,480

I had not.

435

00:35:03,480 --> 00:35:06,480

Betty dreamed for four, for what, five consecutive days?

436

00:35:06,480 --> 00:35:07,480

Five consecutive days.

437

00:35:07,480 --> 00:35:09,480

And what was the dream like, Betty?

438

00:35:09,480 --> 00:35:10,480

You get it, don't you, Betty?

439

00:35:10,480 --> 00:35:20,480

Well, actually, we found out later that my dreams were very, very similar to the information that we obtained

440

00:35:20,480 --> 00:35:22,480

under the headmaster.

441

00:35:22,480 --> 00:35:26,480

There was some minor differences.

442

00:35:26,480 --> 00:35:34,480

And I think probably the most important difference is that in my dreams, I made the argument,

443

00:35:34,480 --> 00:35:40,480

and I think more human than they were under the headmaster.

444

00:35:40,480 --> 00:35:43,480

Well, no, that leads us.

445

00:35:43,480 --> 00:35:49,480

I know there's a great deal more to the story, but I think what we had better do now is go back to that.

446

00:35:49,480 --> 00:36:01,480

Back to that moment, just after the first beeping, in order to do that, if I may very rapidly fill in our audience in the interest of time,

447

00:36:01,480 --> 00:36:05,480

Betty and Barney Hill were so disturbed by the dreams that Betty had had.

448

00:36:05,480 --> 00:36:07,480

Is that true?

449

00:36:07,480 --> 00:36:08,480

Barney had had none.

450

00:36:08,480 --> 00:36:10,480

Barney had had dreams.

451

00:36:10,480 --> 00:36:13,480

But Betty had had dreams, and you were disturbed by these dreams.

452

00:36:13,480 --> 00:36:14,480

Yes.

453

00:36:14,480 --> 00:36:19,480

And you thought the help of a psychiatrist.

454

00:36:19,480 --> 00:36:21,480

Is my or a psychologist?

455

00:36:21,480 --> 00:36:22,480

Was it the first?

456

00:36:22,480 --> 00:36:25,480

No, I think I have fixed the structure of this.

457

00:36:25,480 --> 00:36:26,480

Proper way.

458

00:36:26,480 --> 00:36:35,480

Is after Betty had these dreams, then it was a matter of her later when Walter Webb came to interview us,

459

00:36:35,480 --> 00:36:40,480

telling him, including in the entire story, she did mention about the dreams.

460

00:36:40,480 --> 00:36:44,480

And one of the two scientists came to inquire about this sighting.

461

00:36:44,480 --> 00:36:45,480

She mentioned this.

462

00:36:45,480 --> 00:36:47,480

She had also told me about the dreams.

463

00:36:47,480 --> 00:36:51,480

And my conclusion was that is exactly what she had.

464

00:36:51,480 --> 00:36:54,480

Three or more or less.

465

00:36:54,480 --> 00:37:01,480

But when they decided that there was a missing period here of approximately two hours,

466

00:37:01,480 --> 00:37:06,480

also that it was obvious that we both had suffered amnesia at Indian Head,

467

00:37:06,480 --> 00:37:11,480

and we did not come out of this amnesia state until Plymouth.

468

00:37:11,480 --> 00:37:18,480

There's some things very baffling, because this is highly improbable for two people to suffer amnesia at the same time.

469

00:37:18,480 --> 00:37:19,480

Yes.

470

00:37:19,480 --> 00:37:25,480

Well then, this is a few months after she had had her dreams.

471

00:37:25,480 --> 00:37:37,480

That we began hoping to find a qualified psychiatrist, preferably a person trained in medical perfection,

472

00:37:37,480 --> 00:37:39,480

conducted diagnosis.

473

00:37:39,480 --> 00:37:46,480

We had an interview with one psychiatrist in Massachusetts, and he, after observing us, said that,

474

00:37:46,480 --> 00:37:54,480

I felt pleased about this, because he gave us the assurance that we were not hallucinating,

475

00:37:54,480 --> 00:37:56,480

and that we were seeing.

476

00:37:56,480 --> 00:38:01,480

But since the experience was very recent, sit on it for a while,

477

00:38:01,480 --> 00:38:07,480

and possibly it will open up the amnesia, might open up in a natural way.

478

00:38:07,480 --> 00:38:13,480

This would have been very soon after the sighting, when we had this appointment with the psychiatrist,

479

00:38:13,480 --> 00:38:15,480

the doctor, who was closest.

480

00:38:15,480 --> 00:38:23,480

I had an ulcer that had not bothered me for months and years, but it then began to bother me,

481

00:38:23,480 --> 00:38:28,480

and it did not respond to any medication from the medical doctor,

482

00:38:28,480 --> 00:38:35,480

and so he then decided, well, I thought we had had some kind of psychological origin or cause

483

00:38:35,480 --> 00:38:44,480

that continued, that it persisted in causing this distress with the ulcer itself.

484

00:38:44,480 --> 00:38:52,480

So he suggested, based on some of the things I had told him about my son's teenagers,

485

00:38:52,480 --> 00:38:59,480

and they were in another state and they wouldn't write, and I would get upset because I wasn't getting the kind of correspondence,

486

00:38:59,480 --> 00:39:04,480

but he would say, well, after all, this is teenage, but boys don't like the right.

487

00:39:04,480 --> 00:39:13,480

So what it wasn't satisfying me, so now I'm telling this to the gashes as a part of why I had been upset thinking this was the reason for the ulcer.

488

00:39:13,480 --> 00:39:23,480

But I one day mentioned to him how Betty and I had seen a UFO, and as a result of it,

489

00:39:23,480 --> 00:39:29,480

all the books as if we both had amnesia at the same time, because then I wrote him in briefly with what we know.

So he recognized that this was possibly the cause of my ulcer.

491

Two people Betty had had her nightmare streamed several years ago, that is, they ran for five days,

Several years later, my ulcer not responding to medical medicine,

494

00:39:52,480 --> 00:39:57,480

and we are primary concerned about an experience that has happened in 1961.

495

This is now the latter part of 1963.

496

00:40:00,480 --> 00:40:07,480

He then recommended that we, that he would establish an appointment with us,

497

00:40:07,480 --> 00:40:17,480

as Dr. Benjamin Simon, a very qualified, prominent psychiatrist,

498

00:40:17,480 --> 00:40:25,480

and will, you might say, qualify to regret one back with the use of hypnotherapy.

499

00:40:25,480 --> 00:40:33,480

Yes, now it was Dr. Simon who elected to use hypnotherapy because it was a more expedient means.

500

00:40:33,480 --> 00:40:37,480

It was, this is what he determined after the consultation.

501

00:40:37,480 --> 00:40:44,480

We set up, we established an appointment, both Betty and I went together when we kept this appointment,

502

and he immediately could recognize that we both had amnesia at the same time,

503

00:40:49,480 --> 00:40:58,480

and that he then decided that one way of opening the amnesia, the amnesia itself,

504

00:40:58,480 --> 00:41:03,480

which could possibly be the technique of the specific hypnosis.

505

All right, now at the point at which Dr. Simon began to treat both of you using hypnosis,

506

let's go back now and reconstruct from that first moment of my way on Route 3 heading south.

507

When you heard those beats rather than go into Dr. Simon's office,

508

00:41:24,480 --> 00:41:31,480

I think it would be better now for you to tell us what you now have had opened up to you through hypnosis

509

00:41:31,480 --> 00:41:35,480

and through the psychiatric treatment of Dr. Simon.

510

00:41:35,480 --> 00:41:40,480

Let's go back to those first beatings and pick up the story from there

511

00:41:40,480 --> 00:41:43,480

and reconstruct those missing two hours.

512

Well, I first was carried through the experience in a regressive recall by Dr. Simon.

513

00:41:52,480 --> 00:41:53,480

Yes.

514

00:41:53,480 --> 00:42:02,480

And I also would like to point out that at no time, whenever information was being extracted from us,

515

while in the deep trance, Bobetti and I in the same room together,

516

00:42:06,480 --> 00:42:11,480

I would spend maybe an hour in the deep trance telling him and the doctor with him

517

00:42:11,480 --> 00:42:16,480

a legal post-sacrostatic suggestion that I would not remember anything that I had told.

518

00:42:16,480 --> 00:42:21,480

And we do the same with Betty in this way, if you've been from telling each other,

519

00:42:21,480 --> 00:42:24,480

what we were telling the doctor while we got back to that period.

520

00:42:24,480 --> 00:42:31,480

Yes, it's very unusual for one psychiatrist, as I understand it, to treat two people,

521

00:42:31,480 --> 00:42:33,480

legally a man and wife.

522

00:42:33,480 --> 00:42:38,480

But in this instance, because of this dual experience,

523

each of you having experienced the same thing,

524

00:42:40,480 --> 00:42:47,480

I can see where the course of treatment and the method of one psychiatrist handling both patients

525

00:42:47,480 --> 00:42:52,480

was a logical and an ethical expedient.

526

00:42:52,480 --> 00:42:53,480

Yes.

527

00:42:53,480 --> 00:42:55,480

Okay, I saw.

528

00:42:55,480 --> 00:43:01,480

Now, under the progressive diagnosis, after returning to the car,

529

00:43:01,480 --> 00:43:09,480

rather while out in the field, it seems as if there was some communication

530

00:43:09,480 --> 00:43:12,480

between this object hovering in the sky.

531

00:43:12,480 --> 00:43:17,480

I could always remember one person continuing to stay in that plate class,

532

00:43:17,480 --> 00:43:22,480

looking back at me while the others moved away from the glass itself,

533

00:43:22,480 --> 00:43:27,480

reaching up as I described, reaching to a water panel.

534

00:43:27,480 --> 00:43:28,480

Yes.

535

00:43:28,480 --> 00:43:32,480

Except this one, that continued to stare back at me.

536

00:43:32,480 --> 00:43:38,480

Now, under the progressive diagnosis, it seemed as if I was being compelled to come close to this graph,

537

00:43:38,480 --> 00:43:42,480

actually being told to come close to the graph.

538

00:43:42,480 --> 00:43:48,480

We have to realize that the graph is approximately 100 feet away from me up in the air.

539

00:43:48,480 --> 00:43:50,480

It's not on the ground at this point.

540

00:43:50,480 --> 00:43:54,480

Yes, there was this kind of communication that I was receiving.

541

00:43:54,480 --> 00:44:01,480

I had my binoculars up to my eyes and I was also told to keep them there, not take them away.

542

00:44:01,480 --> 00:44:08,480

I pulled them somehow as well as the tapes of the hypnotist were very emotional,

543

00:44:08,480 --> 00:44:13,480

and I screamed and pulled the binoculars on my eyes, and I also broke the straps.

544

Now, I failed to mention that when we returned to person,

545

00:44:16,480 --> 00:44:20,480

later I was looking at my binoculars, I noticed the straps were broken,

546

00:44:20,480 --> 00:44:23,480

and I wondered if Betty had somehow broken the straps,

547

00:44:23,480 --> 00:44:27,480

and then I questioned my son and asked if they had broken my straps.

548

00:44:27,480 --> 00:44:32,480

I never knew, although it was not, so now we go back to that period standing in the field,

549

00:44:32,480 --> 00:44:37,480

and then pulling the binoculars from my eyes was such a thought,

550

00:44:37,480 --> 00:44:41,480

they parted the straps, parted from around my neck.

551

So you were really privately afraid?

552

Yes, and then I dashed back to the car, and then upon entering the car,

553

there was a series of beats, and there was this oblivion where I didn't remember anything,

but on the regressive notice where I am made to recall exactly what I am doing,

555

I am driving the car and I drive further south on Route 3,

556

00:45:03,480 --> 00:45:09,480

where I leave Route 3, driving off into a very tessalious spot,

557

00:45:09,480 --> 00:45:15,480

a part of the mountain section, where there is no car traffic at that time of night,

558

00:45:15,480 --> 00:45:18,480

incidentally there wasn't any traffic on Route 3,

559

00:45:18,480 --> 00:45:23,480

because we have to realize this is afterly, but they, not there in the white mountains,

560

00:45:23,480 --> 00:45:28,480

after September 7th, it is very tessalous to part at night.

561

00:45:28,480 --> 00:45:31,480

Yes, we turn off, you turn off Route 3.

562

00:45:31,480 --> 00:45:35,480

You turn away, I drove off Route 3, and into a very tessalous wooded area.

563

00:45:35,480 --> 00:45:39,480

Even under the regressive treatment, can you recall any motive for turning off?

564

00:45:39,480 --> 00:45:45,480

Yes, I am being told to. I am actually being told, even after returning to the car,

565

00:45:45,480 --> 00:45:48,480

it seems as if, and I knew the words of mine,

566

00:45:48,480 --> 00:45:53,480

if there had been damage done to me as was done at that time, I was standing in the field,

567

00:45:53,480 --> 00:45:56,480

because it seems as if even after returning to the car,

568

00:45:56,480 --> 00:46:02,480

I am being directed to drive down to this spot, and leave the highway where I made this left turn,

569

00:46:03,480 --> 00:46:08,480

and I continued to drive, and then suddenly there are these men standing in the road.

570

00:46:08,480 --> 00:46:15,480

Upon getting into this tesselous wooded area spot, I suddenly saw a huge orange grove.

571

00:46:15,480 --> 00:46:24,480

Now this is interesting because both Betty and I consciously remembered somehow of seeing an orange ball in the road.

572

00:46:24,480 --> 00:46:25,480

Yes.

573

00:46:25,480 --> 00:46:30,480

But we could never go any further than somehow we could see, and always remember, an orange ball in the road,

574

00:46:30,480 --> 00:46:35,480

and our remark was that, well, it must have been the moon, and then we dismissed it.

575

But now, under regressive treatment, I can see this orange ball diminishing in white,

576

into an orange as a bright color, into a color color, where it eventually, the light is completely out, is just dark.

And these men are standing in the road several hours a second, and he told me to halt.

and I thought, well, are they going to rob me? And the then one pulled me from the car, not in a violent way,

but more as this fight was hardly complying. And I stepped from the car, where they literally dragged me,

585

though I was in an upright position, down and around for the car and into the wood,

586

00:47:42,480 --> 00:47:49,480

and to where there is, I could see the dark outline of a physical structure kind of thing.

587

Can you produce a moment, can you describe, are you able to describe what these men looked like?

588

They were dressed.

589

Well, when I saw them standing, they had lights in the car before the lights went out,

590

they were in dark, similar kind of garment, and I called it a uniform, which I thought as they P-jacket.

591

I also understand, Alan, that in critical situations, we continually try to put things into the frame of reference

592

00:48:19,480 --> 00:48:26,480

that we can identify with as a natural thing, so that I thought of the uniform being much like a Navy P-jacket.

593

For me?

594

00:48:27,480 --> 00:48:28,480

Yes.

595

00:48:28,480 --> 00:48:29,480

May I interrupt just one second?

596

00:48:29,480 --> 00:48:30,480

Sure.

597

00:48:30,480 --> 00:48:38,480

Was the one of these six people, or creatures on the road, wearing a visor on a cap?

598

00:48:38,480 --> 00:48:39,480

Oh, no.

599

00:48:39,480 --> 00:48:40,480

Oh.

600

00:48:40,480 --> 00:48:49,480

I think that you had told me at one time that in the last partition of the bus, as you were looking up,

601

00:48:49,480 --> 00:48:52,480

one appeared to have a military cap on.

602

00:48:52,480 --> 00:48:54,480

Yes, but that you did not know recognized.

603

00:48:54,480 --> 00:48:56,480

No, I did not recognize any caps.

604

Thank you.

605

00:48:57,480 --> 00:49:02,480

But while in the field at Indian Head, I described one another being with the binoculars,

606

00:49:02,480 --> 00:49:06,480

through the binoculars of that, that continued to stay at this panel glass,

607

00:49:06,480 --> 00:49:10,480

that having a military type visor cap.

608

00:49:10,480 --> 00:49:15,480

So, I was taken from the car, and I actually was very demented.

609

00:49:15,480 --> 00:49:22,480

And as I pointed out, Jack, towards the woods, and I was being told that no harm would come to me,

610

00:49:22,480 --> 00:49:24,480

and to keep my eyes closed.

611

00:49:24,480 --> 00:49:27,480

And I was then carried up a ramp.

612

00:49:27,480 --> 00:49:31,480

This is interesting because Betty had never mentioned ramp in her dreams.

613

00:49:31,480 --> 00:49:37,480

I was carried up a ramp where my feet struck a gate of high rise at a door, at the doorstep,

614

00:49:37,480 --> 00:49:39,480

where they bumped over this object.

615

00:49:39,480 --> 00:49:46,480

And this was sort of a fleeting thing of recognizing that my feet were bumping something, you might say.

616

00:49:46,480 --> 00:49:50,480

And I opened my eyes just fleetingly, and I could see this corridor.

617

00:49:50,480 --> 00:49:59,480

That curved around the inside of the glass, where the rooms were on the inner side of the corridor.

618

I was carried past one door into another door, and there was this room with a pie shape,

619

00:50:05,480 --> 00:50:11,480

as I described it, much like a pie, with the point of the pie cut off.

620

And there was this one table that was very small for my body.

621

00:50:15,480 --> 00:50:30,480

I'm about 5'8", where I got onto the table myself, and I am continually hearing this voice that is telling me that no harm is going to come to me.

622

It's only a matter of a few tests that are going to be conducted.

623

00:50:34,480 --> 00:50:43,480

Just as some of the more or less remains calm, that the room will be over with, and I'll be about my business with no damage done.

624

Now buddy, when you say you continually keep hearing this voice, it's a voice that you apparently are hearing with your mind, but you're not hearing anybody speak, are you?

625

00:50:53,480 --> 00:50:56,480

Well, I am hearing it much. I do it.

626

00:50:56,480 --> 00:51:06,480

Under deep hypnosis, I gave the doctor what I considered an analogy about explaining the circumstances and situations.

627

00:51:06,480 --> 00:51:16,480

Sometimes it's difficult to explain things in abstract terms to find the words to fit the picture, but I explained it to the doctor while I was in a deep trance by Dr. Freiman,

628

00:51:16,480 --> 00:51:27,480

that though I had a sense of awareness in deep trance, in the Dr. Valtemar, and he was sitting across from me, once I had been placed into a deep trance,

629

00:51:27,480 --> 00:51:34,480

I no longer knew that he actually was sitting across from me, but I knew that some way he was surrounded in the room.

630

00:51:34,480 --> 00:51:43,480

And I could hear his voice. I could hear his voice, but I couldn't tell if I was asked to point out in the direction where the voice was coming from.

631

00:51:43,480 --> 00:51:44,480

I wouldn't have been able to tell.

632

00:51:44,480 --> 00:51:45,480

I understand.

633

00:51:45,480 --> 00:51:49,480

Does this give you the feeling that I'm trying to survive at this time?

634

00:51:49,480 --> 00:51:52,480

You definitely did hear with your ears.

635

00:51:52,480 --> 00:51:53,480

Well, I could hear.

636

00:51:53,480 --> 00:51:54,480

Yes.

637

00:51:54,480 --> 00:51:55,480

All right.

638

00:51:56,480 --> 00:51:58,480

We get into the matter of, did they speak English?

639

00:51:58,480 --> 00:51:59,480

I don't know.

640

00:51:59,480 --> 00:52:03,480

I only know that I knew what was expected of me, and I complied.

641

00:52:03,480 --> 00:52:11,480

I thought of a willingness on my part and great fear and terror to comply with the belief that I

had been assured that no harm was going to come to me,

642

00:52:11,480 --> 00:52:16,480

and I would go along with this, and virtually and hopefully to be on my way.

643

00:52:16,480 --> 00:52:20,480

In any case, you are totally without a will of your own, is that it?

644

00:52:20,480 --> 00:52:21,480

Correct.

645

00:52:21,480 --> 00:52:27,480

This is the best way to say I did not have any will of my own, but low resistance.

646

00:52:27,480 --> 00:52:32,480

So I won't be concerned about Betty's will or whereabouts.

647

00:52:32,480 --> 00:52:38,480

I might feel a little guilty as a husband to not be concerned about my life,

648

00:52:38,480 --> 00:52:45,480

but this is such a terrifying situation that I was only concerned about myself and I was being assured that I wasn't going to be harmed.

649

00:52:45,480 --> 00:52:55,480

So that I was based on this table where my trousers were removed and my shirt was pulled up towards my head,

650

00:52:55,480 --> 00:53:01,480

which would have made my back, my under shirt was pulled up along with it, where my back would have been there.

651

00:53:01,480 --> 00:53:14,480

And I was turned over on my back and my stomach as well as while I could feel what I called a finger going up and down the final column.

652

00:53:14,480 --> 00:53:17,480

And I could feel this, and I could feel it.

653

00:53:17,480 --> 00:53:24,480

You know, Alan, when I tell this, I still feel very uncomfortable.

654

00:53:24,480 --> 00:53:30,480

Yes, I can tell that as you describe the experience aboard the craft that you are very upset,

655

00:53:30,480 --> 00:53:34,480

and I sense that Betty is upset too. Is it true?

656

00:53:34,480 --> 00:53:40,480

I don't know if it's a term, but we do build up pressure on these characters.

657

00:53:40,480 --> 00:53:45,480

Yes, there's not a matter of being on the radio because you have been on before.

658

00:53:45,480 --> 00:53:46,480

Yes.

659

00:53:46,480 --> 00:53:52,480

So it does do something to your ability to recount this experience now.

660

00:53:52,480 --> 00:54:03,480

We have a copy also of the tapes of our under-regressive notices, and it must have taken a year before Betty and I could sit down and really listen to the entire contents.

661

00:54:03,480 --> 00:54:09,480

Now, while in the doctor's office when he played the tapes back, following this back into our conscious memory,

662

00:54:09,480 --> 00:54:13,480

this was the reason he decided to recall it, his own tape.

663

00:54:13,480 --> 00:54:17,480

Was this the method by which he fed this back to you?

664

00:54:17,480 --> 00:54:23,480

This was a part of the method. He also used certain post-apartic suggestions while we were in a train.

665

00:54:23,480 --> 00:54:34,480

Just by way of interest, how long did the entire treatment take from the time Dr. Simon began to treat you until you finished?

666

00:54:34,480 --> 00:54:39,480

Until January, until the early part of July.

667

00:54:39,480 --> 00:54:40,480

January through July?

668

00:54:40,480 --> 00:54:41,480

Yes.

669

00:54:41,480 --> 00:54:43,480

And this was, what, once every week?

670

00:54:43,480 --> 00:54:49,480

This was every week, every Saturday morning. Betty and I paid a visit to his office.

671

00:54:49,480 --> 00:54:52,480

May I pause for just a moment, Barney and Betty?

672

00:54:52,480 --> 00:55:00,480

We'll be back in just a moment to continue this fantastic, fascinating tale told to us tonight by Betty and Barney Hill.

673

00:55:00,480 --> 00:55:05,480

Speaking to us long distance from the residence at Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

674

00:55:05,480 --> 00:55:11,480

Earl, that is visiting with us tonight. Earl is a noted Cleveland ufologist and a documenter.

675

00:55:11,480 --> 00:55:17,480

And I have never seen Earl so quiet. On the other hand, you've never heard me shout out to this extent.

676

00:55:17,480 --> 00:55:28,480

I must say that I am enjoying this story as it is told so completely and so rationally by Betty and Barney Hill.

677

00:55:28,480 --> 00:55:29,480

Earl, do you want to say something?

678

00:55:29,480 --> 00:55:40,480

I would like to say that many times people ask me, both on radio or by the letter, like on where they can learn about things like this.

679

00:55:40,480 --> 00:55:45,480

Well, the best way to learn is to go to organizations where these things are discussed.

680

00:55:45,480 --> 00:55:52,480

In the Cleveland area, the Cleveland Ufology Project, one of the fine organizations that has existed for many years.

681

00:55:52,480 --> 00:55:59,480

And we meet the third Saturday of every month at 8 to 11 p.m.

682

00:55:59,480 --> 00:56:04,480

And this is the Encolon that's about to block beyond Snow Road on Pearl.

683

00:56:04,480 --> 00:56:14,480

My name is Eddie Zell and Douglas, listening to the Fascinating Tale, a fascinating story of Betty and Barney Hill and their two lost hours.

684

00:56:14,480 --> 00:56:23,480

I would like very much to convey to the audience my impression at this moment of Betty and Barney Hill.

685

00:56:23,480 --> 00:56:29,480

These are two extremely intelligent and sensitive human beings.

686

00:56:29,480 --> 00:56:37,480

And I find from this experience that I have a tendency to like them.

687

00:56:37,480 --> 00:56:41,480

I think that I would find them as friends if I knew them better.

688

00:56:41,480 --> 00:56:57,480

Let me say that the story that we are hearing is a story that is documented in the opinion of a noted Boston psychiatrist as being told by two people who implicitly believe it.

689

00:56:57,480 --> 00:57:00,480

And I think this is very important to remember.

690

00:57:00,480 --> 00:57:05,480

So back to you Barney and this experience of having been physically examined.

691

00:57:05,480 --> 00:57:13,480

Did you ever determine in your own mind what it may have been they were looking for, what they were trying to learn from you?

692

00:57:13,480 --> 00:57:22,480

No, I have not. I'd like to just go back and elaborate just briefly on your last remark about colors.

693

This doesn't distress me when you understand why we have released this information.

694

Number one, after the regressive diagnosis, we then decided that we would never let this go any further.

695

It would all be continually investigated on the scientific level.

696

00:57:43,480 --> 00:57:49,480

Well, we have friends and so we would occasionally tell close friends and confidants.

697

00:57:49,480 --> 00:57:53,480

Well, they have friends and so to give a tell, they're friends and confidants.

698

00:57:53,480 --> 00:57:58,480

In a military town, the story eventually got out and it really spread.

699

00:57:58,480 --> 00:58:01,480

But this is only by word of mouth.

700

00:58:01,480 --> 00:58:07,480

And a reporter in Massachusetts heard of it one day and he decided to investigate.

701

00:58:07,480 --> 00:58:09,480

To the John Luttrell?

702

00:58:09,480 --> 00:58:18,480

Yes. And he called us to ask for verification of what he had pieced together and we named not to write the story.

703

00:58:18,480 --> 00:58:22,480

But the story was written anyway without our cooperation.

704

00:58:22,480 --> 00:58:25,480

And it's strange, newspaper people have a kind of a penchant for that.

705

00:58:25,480 --> 00:58:34,480

So we then began, this is when the pressure was on us because we then began getting the misconceptions of the newspaper article.

706

People would ask, well now when you took the trip to Venus or when you were on Mars, what was it like on the moon?

707

00:58:40,480 --> 00:58:44,480

This upset me very badly because we had never said any of these things.

708

00:58:44,480 --> 00:58:52,480

And we had another visit with Dr. Simon and we discussed this thoroughly and he decided that for our well-being,

709

00:58:52,480 --> 00:58:58,480

it would be best for the total documentation to come out, the facts.

710

And this is all we have censored and those are the release, all the facts,

711

00:59:02,480 --> 00:59:07,480

training to this entire experiment, the experience.

712

00:59:07,480 --> 00:59:10,480

And the reader would have to make their own decisions.

713

So one can't believe the story. This is only natural.

714

00:59:14,480 --> 00:59:23,480

I would find it difficult to believe by itself if I heard of this kind of story so that it is the support of the regressive,

715

00:59:23,480 --> 00:59:33,480

the regression back to that period of time, the qualification of the characters that it was involved.

716

00:59:33,480 --> 00:59:40,480

These are the reasons that I can tonight talk to you over the phone and tell you about the documentation.

717

Well then in a way, the fact that this story got out has, if anything, strengthened you, hasn't it?

718

The fact that the story got out and then subsequently had to be documented.

It would have been written somehow or another.

So these are just circumstances and this is it.

727

But with this examination, I remember a talk at my teeth and this is the way I described it

and also while on this position of being examined, I opened my eyes again statingly

when you saw the little green men and they were not green men,

they were a grayish metallic kind of gray in color.

And I might also say that I'm quite sure they were not wearing a mask

or rather any kind of apparatus over the head for breathing purposes

740

without a lip muscle that when parting was open, there was a membrane inside that spluttered

742

as they really right at the end of the mouth itself.

And this spluttered and this seemed to be a way that they communicated with one another

744

with a very peculiar kind of mumbling, humming sound.

And I also try to give an analogy here, the sound we have heard when someone in a commercial is speaking underwater

And I think that the front of the face only continues back, I did not notice the ears, I can't remember seeing the ears,

which would have means that they were quite long and large inside.

755

Approximately I would say 4.5 to 5 feet in total height, that's all I've been asked.

And also that there was the absence of the nose as we understand it, but just the nostrils and toothlets.

perhaps we realize, but I think it's very important now at this point, after this description of these creatures,

to have Earl tell us about another experience that took place, I believe, a few years previous to yours in Brazil.

his Afro organization, the oldest organization in this kind of world, and this took place,

this incident took place in Minas Gerais, Brazil at 1.30 am on the morning of October 15, 1957.

773

It was a very strange event that took place and it somewhat parallels, in a way, what you folks have experienced.

774

There are two nights of manifestations of strange light near the farm of his parents,

775

and this was near this town of Francisco de Salos in the state of Minas Gerais, Brazil.

The first two incidents were witnessed by Antonio's brother, Joa.

777

This young man was plowing a tractor he was riding on in a field near his home,

778

when his attention was arrested by what appeared to be a very bright star.

779

01:05:52,480 --> 01:05:59,480

This, again, you see, is a parallel to yours in the beginning, which he shortly realized,

780

01:05:59,480 --> 01:06:05,480

after Rizzo, who is now the star of all, that a brilliantly lit egg-shaped object approaching at high speed

781

01:06:05,480 --> 01:06:11,480

and shortly was hovering overhead at an hour or two of about 175 feet,

782

01:06:11,480 --> 01:06:14,480

and illuminates the ground with a bright red light.

783

01:06:14,480 --> 01:06:21,480

Antonio, more or less, panicked, but realized he couldn't escape the thing because of the soft cloud ground in the field,

784

and so he sat there, rooted to his tractor-states, might say.

Yes, and I could feel it being placed, and as if there was some kind of,

848

I was thinking of the word vibration, but this doesn't describe what I am trying to say,

as if something was movable in a soft way, and it was placed over me, and it was removed.

It was quite painful, yes.

857

And, uh, I was very upset, or even when I realized what they were going to do,

and asked them not to do that.

859

And, uh, they seemed to think it was not fair, and there seemed to be quite some tries, but it did.

Yes.

And the man I, the one I called the leader,

862

looked at you and infunded my eyes, and the pain went away.

Of course this all came later, didn't it?

869

Yes, this was, uh, the experience was all happened in 1961, the analysis was in 1964.

870

Uh, so...

871

01:13:10,480 --> 01:13:15,480

And, uh, the, the week-long time lapse, and I wasn't aware of this.

872

01:13:15,480 --> 01:13:16,480

I see.

873

01:13:16,480 --> 01:13:19,480

And I never did make a point to a doctor about it.

874

01:13:19,480 --> 01:13:30,480

And, uh, so you weren't even aware of that part of the experience until you were, several years later, were, uh, regressed, hypnotically.

875

That's right.

876

01:13:31,480 --> 01:13:34,480

Barney, what about the rash on your back?

877

01:13:34,480 --> 01:13:35,480

Uh, not really.

878

01:13:35,480 --> 01:13:37,480

These were warts on your right.

879

01:13:37,480 --> 01:13:38,480

On the right?

880

01:13:38,480 --> 01:13:39,480

Yes.

881

01:13:39,480 --> 01:13:51,480

Uh, the, uh, doctor took the position that these warts were, or I might say could have been of, of a natural, uh, development.

882

01:13:51,480 --> 01:13:58,480

Well, I'll tell you, that's the heck of a question to ever ask, because doctors haven't found out yet for sure what it caused my retinal organs, right?

883

01:13:58,480 --> 01:13:59,480

Yes, I guess so.

884

01:13:59,480 --> 01:14:04,480

So I guess we really can't answer that question, and we can't logically expect the doctor to as yet.

885

I asked the leader where he came from, and he stepped over the back of the wall, and put his hand on the wall, and these panels, through backs, and a map came out, which I believe would be called a sky map.

I see. Trade lines.

Here.

And, and, incidentally, it should be mentioned that, uh, that your sketches appear in the book *The Interrupted Journey*.

900

Yes, thank you.

And, uh, this would be a, uh, I think, uh, a, uh, a more complete way of feeding an answer to that question.
