It's not everyday to run into somebody who is accustomed to hot-knock with space men

I'm perhaps in a rather privileged position and I have known Mr. Adamski since 1954 and

I have lived with him in California, where I can tell you now we did see by the course

of several occasions one and half percent projectivity for me and only very recently

24

I was with him when we had the privilege of meeting a space man.

I not get to talk very long.

26

My function really is to do which in between the chairmen, the current support, keep things

27

very well.

A lot of people just settle down and kick the nail and roll the nails up and generally

enjoy themselves.

I have never seen Mr. Adamski looking so well for such full of themes even though he has

been more than halfway around the world.

I think he has got 60 or 70 lectures on this world program.

You can tell you a great deal of things not in the books you've read and we do have two

questions you'll ask.

It will be there to bring out more things that you want to know.

You also can see which I may tell you is a very remarkable film with some extraordinary

shots and as I've seen over the afternoon on a static projector analyzing some of them

they're quite the best movies I've seen on flying saucers.

Well everyone seems fairly happy, very proud that it's getting me out of the way and you

40

Thank you Mr. Adamski.

I'm glad to be here after disappointing a lot of you three years back when I couldn't

43

make it when everything was really set up.

I have much to say and reference to what I've transpired in the last 11 years while I let

45

it go toward the last.

I will begin at the moment with my experience with the movie You Are More Interested, then

47

what has transpired in the governments themselves.

First of all, I would like everybody else being brought up in a way as sort of an astronomer

49

by taking astronomy 1929 naturally who were taught that there was no one in our system

50

on any of the other planets but ourselves.

51

Naturally when they appeared on the scene it was hard to accept how people were taught

52

00:05:42,600 --> 00:05:44,600

that way.

53

Yet many many times I have questioned what is the information given during the astronomical

54

studies were really correct.

55

I've been quite inquisitive ever since I was born and I say try to question everything quite

56

critical of some of them.

57

So in this case there was no exception.

58

So finally in 1946 in October when all of us that were amateur astronomers were informed

59

to count the meteorites that had funneled the one at one, I think it was on the 19th,

60

00:06:26,600 --> 00:06:31,600

count in his years record as how many would fall in for a minute.

61

00:06:31,600 --> 00:06:37,600

But due naturally was shining bright so some of the small ones could not be counted or seen.

62

00:06:37,600 --> 00:06:44,600

But due in that time quite a large number of us and Desmond Hampton and all that property

63

00:06:44,600 --> 00:06:52,600

overlooking George San Diego which is few mountains head up a stair known as Rodriguez Mountain

64

Velocan Mountain while the Palomar is the background of us.

65

00:06:57,600 --> 00:07:05,600

We saw this thing shift to here and it was something like at the original size but then

66

00:07:05,600 --> 00:07:10,600

there was a basket underneath which was strange.

67

00:07:10,600 --> 00:07:17,600

This basket was missing as a customary within but we thought then well do you want to warn

68

00:07:17,600 --> 00:07:21,600

they might have developed something we never heard of anything about.

69

00:07:21,600 --> 00:07:27,600

So we let it go there but suddenly the thing shot out into another space straight up

70

00:07:27,600 --> 00:07:31,600

awfully fast and left the amber trail behind it.

71

00:07:31,600 --> 00:07:37,600

But we questioned it a little bit and referenced to the amber trail.

72

00:07:37,600 --> 00:07:39,600

Still didn't think something of it.

73

00:07:39,600 --> 00:07:43,600

After it's come out of sight we no longer could count any meteorites.

74

We went to this cafe which Ms. Wells wrote that I never owned a business of any kind.

75

00:07:49,600 --> 00:07:51,600

I didn't own this cafe.

76

00:07:51,600 --> 00:07:57,600

I lived on the property and been seen in the cafe a lot of times I owned a few people.

77

00:07:57,600 --> 00:08:07,600

So we went to this cafe and of course the Kansas City San Diego station was broadcasting the news

78

00:08:07,600 --> 00:08:10,600

of the meteorites and other things.

79

00:08:10,600 --> 00:08:15,600

And they mentioned this particular ship.

80

00:08:15,600 --> 00:08:24,600

They said it was a spacecraft that passed over San Diego a big one which was Mother Ship type

81

00:08:24,600 --> 00:08:27,600

so we didn't tell sense.

82

00:08:27,600 --> 00:08:37,600

And they didn't know why it didn't land so they consulted a meteor down there in San Diego

83

00:08:37,600 --> 00:08:40,600

to follow the chef of mint plate.

84

00:08:40,600 --> 00:08:44,600

I'm giving it to you so there's a given there.

85

00:08:44,600 --> 00:08:52,600

And she was supposed to have come out to contact them mint plate and come back stating that they did not land

86

00:08:52,600 --> 00:08:56,600

because they did not know how they would be received.

87

00:08:56,600 --> 00:09:00,600

There was no reason and that's all there was to it.

88

00:09:00,600 --> 00:09:06,600

Well a few Sundays after that finally people coming up to this cafe

89

00:09:06,600 --> 00:09:16,600

there was Pro-Con knowing that I was interested in astronomy and all the direction on it right there

90

00:09:16,600 --> 00:09:22,600

to people that come from the top to one of the engines of the earth.

91

00:09:22,600 --> 00:09:24,600

So we had an argument going on.

92

00:09:24,600 --> 00:09:30,600

Pro-Con among some people there that come up to the restaurant to eat.

93

00:09:30,600 --> 00:09:35,600

And I was saying at the time it was fantastic basing it at the time

94

00:09:35,600 --> 00:09:40,600

on the information received through astronomical teachings.

95

00:09:40,600 --> 00:09:47,600

When three officers were sitting at table next to the table I was talking to

96

00:09:47,600 --> 00:09:51,600

and one of them was a captain from Arizona.

97

00:09:51,600 --> 00:09:56,600

And finally they couldn't stand it I guess so one of them spoke up and he says

98

00:09:56,600 --> 00:09:59,600

this man is fantastic as a son.

99

00:09:59,600 --> 00:10:05,600

When you're nine feet away from one of these things you really know what you're looking at.

100

00:10:05,600 --> 00:10:08,600

So then I turned my attention to them.

101

00:10:08,600 --> 00:10:10,600

I wonder no more.

102

00:10:10,600 --> 00:10:14,600

And we asked them and I told them a few things not too much.

103

00:10:14,600 --> 00:10:23,600

They couldn't talk too much about it they said but they did tell us and they showed us that the spacecraft was coming.

104

00:10:23,600 --> 00:10:28,600

Well then of course in 1447 when the news broke quite a while ago

105

00:10:28,600 --> 00:10:33,600

that General Maul from North Carolina State of Washington

106

00:10:33,600 --> 00:10:38,600

naturally again there were a lot questioning from them

107

00:10:38,600 --> 00:10:41,600

from the astronomical angle and many of us.

108

00:10:41,600 --> 00:10:48,600

And so again I was wondering how much truth there was to this situation in general

109

and I kept on doing that.

110

I didn't accept the thing immediately.

111

I started looking into it I never I closed my mind to it but I never accepted it for either.

112

So on 49 when the military French commander had gone up the top it was raining there very heavily

113

and there was one up the top what he called the beak of the great.

114

00:11:13,600 --> 00:11:15,600

Two steps.

115

00:11:15,600 --> 00:11:19,600

Two photographs what was going on in space.

116

00:11:19,600 --> 00:11:23,600

That first instruction was given to the beak of the great to do that.

117

00:11:23,600 --> 00:11:33,600

Now they can do that very well in the 200 age but they could do it with the 18 and the 48 of something as well as there's the 12.

118

00:11:33,600 --> 00:11:37,600

So those instruments we believe themselves that work very well.

119

So they stopped to eat at the place and no even I had a 15 and a 6.

120

00:11:43,600 --> 00:11:47,600

So they asked me if I would also do the same.

121

00:11:47,600 --> 00:11:49,600

There was no money involved.

122

00:11:49,600 --> 00:11:52,600

No me of any kind as volunteer work.

123

00:11:52,600 --> 00:11:55,600

I said I would but I just want to write the photograph.

124

00:11:55,600 --> 00:11:58,600

For whom it's driving through space it wouldn't say.

125

00:11:58,600 --> 00:12:00,600

They wouldn't name it.

126

00:12:00,600 --> 00:12:02,600

I said what is the target?

127

00:12:02,600 --> 00:12:05,600

Well he said the target is the moon.

128

00:12:05,600 --> 00:12:11,600

So the moon even went to a moon picture that I had good size or 4 for it.

129

00:12:12,600 --> 00:12:15,600

That I got from McDonald's observatory of Texas.

130

00:12:15,600 --> 00:12:19,600

And they even marked the site that I should watch.

131

00:12:19,600 --> 00:12:21,600

That portion of the moon.

132

00:12:21,600 --> 00:12:29,600

Sure enough after a few tries certified equipment in Northern and I got two pictures.

133

00:12:29,600 --> 00:12:35,600

And according to the agreement made between them and myself I kept quiet.

134

00:12:35,600 --> 00:12:41,600

I sent those pictures to the laboratory at Point Blower where I was told to.

135

00:12:41,600 --> 00:12:46,600

And I got the last one way or the other.

136

00:12:46,600 --> 00:12:56,600

So one day shortly after the pictures were sent with about two weeks I was lecturing in North

Carolina district of San Diego.

137

00:12:56,600 --> 00:12:59,600

To what they call the Everyman's Club.

138

00:12:59,600 --> 00:13:02,600

Every day Everyman's Club yes.

139

00:13:02,600 --> 00:13:10,600

And the reporter come up there that was an ace reporter in a world one number two and the Pacific.

140

00:13:10,600 --> 00:13:14,600

There was supposed to be no reporters there at the time.

141

00:13:14,600 --> 00:13:21,600

Well he sat down and asked me some questions in reference to the things that are moving through space.

142

00:13:21,600 --> 00:13:26,600

Not because in reference to the pictures I have taken already.

143

00:13:26,600 --> 00:13:32,600

So naturally I thought that was all right.

144

00:13:32,600 --> 00:13:36,600

So it was a journal that's out of existence now.

145

00:13:36,600 --> 00:13:41,600

So the journal published a very nice article about the lectures so forth.

146

00:13:41,600 --> 00:13:55,600

And finally somehow the union and the tribune that is in existence today have gotten some information from some source in reference to the existing pictures.

147

00:13:55,600 --> 00:14:01,600

So they went to this laboratory and asked and they denied it.

148

00:14:01,600 --> 00:14:04,600

So the denial kept on going.

149

00:14:04,600 --> 00:14:14,600

I have a full stack of clippings from the town going on about between Washington and the tribune and the union.

150

00:14:14,600 --> 00:14:19,600

They come to me finally and I was to be a sort of a scapegoat in this case.

151

00:14:19,600 --> 00:14:25,600

Being in the military service I have been from 1913 to 1919.

152

00:14:25,600 --> 00:14:27,600

I knew the procedure.

153

00:14:27,600 --> 00:14:31,600

So I knew the papers going on that way.

154

00:14:31,600 --> 00:14:37,600

So since they let me down I figured in five years I was open my mind up which I did.

155

00:14:37,600 --> 00:14:42,600

I claimed that it weren't existence and still denial kept coming.

156

00:14:42,600 --> 00:14:50,600

So finally Copley Cable is known by that name which is the union and tribune.

157

00:14:50,600 --> 00:14:53,600

Shout over a message to Pentagon.

158

00:14:53,600 --> 00:15:00,600

Three months prior to this Pentagon have discontinued research on blind sources.

159

00:15:00,600 --> 00:15:03,600

They made that public.

160

00:15:03,600 --> 00:15:09,600

Well so nobody knew that they weren't more interested in the blind sources.

161

00:15:10,600 --> 00:15:18,600

Yet the answer came to the paper and said that if there were such a pictures they would have known

about it.

162

00:15:18,600 --> 00:15:23,600

They know nothing about and they were a little skeptical in reference to those pictures.

163

00:15:23,600 --> 00:15:28,600

Which proof began also that they were double talking.

164

00:15:28,600 --> 00:15:32,600

Three months prior to that they made a statement they were no longer interested.

165

00:15:32,600 --> 00:15:38,600

Here they still tell us that they were interested in the future like that it would have been brought to them had they been in existence.

166

00:15:39,600 --> 00:15:42,600

But they were not sure of themselves.

167

00:15:42,600 --> 00:15:49,600

So they must have sent them back to the laboratory and the laboratory issued the letter.

168

00:15:49,600 --> 00:15:57,600

I'll tell you this past a while since with the Los Angeles Times they wrote the science part for that paper

169

00:15:57,600 --> 00:16:00,600

which was present with a document that never came.

170

00:16:00,600 --> 00:16:07,600

And it read, as you probably remember those are the blind sources that have landed, we published it there.

171

00:16:07,600 --> 00:16:16,600

It read that they thought it probably was electric discharge from static electricity on the film

172

00:16:16,600 --> 00:16:20,600

doing a process of rolling in cold or hot weather.

173

00:16:20,600 --> 00:16:24,600

The type remains that I did not use for old films.

174

00:16:24,600 --> 00:16:33,600

I had plates so that not set up yet they did not ask me what sort of a film I used at the time taking these photographs.

175

00:16:33,600 --> 00:16:42,600

Well the next thing of course they said in the next paragraph as those of you read the black source of Atlanta can

176

00:16:42,600 --> 00:16:49,600

read and see for yourself that they didn't think it had anything to do with visitors.

177

00:16:49,600 --> 00:16:52,600

Well if there is no visitors, why even mention them?

178

00:16:52,600 --> 00:16:54,600

Yes they did.

179

00:16:54,600 --> 00:17:02,600

So they immediately picked up this here, so give me that letter and I'll take it to the Times and pass them on over.

180

00:17:02,600 --> 00:17:07,600

I said, Bill I've been in the search, I know what the program is more or less in that way.

181

00:17:07,600 --> 00:17:12,600

I said, just let it be quite new or not all right, I don't have it that way.

182

00:17:12,600 --> 00:17:17,600

So he said, okay, come on in the hand.

183

00:17:17,600 --> 00:17:21,600

Then after they did that of course I got disgusted with him.

184

00:17:21,600 --> 00:17:23,600

See?

185

00:17:23,600 --> 00:17:31,600

And so I switched over to the Air Force and I didn't do that immediately either.

186

00:17:31,600 --> 00:17:39,600

So it was after Mr. Thompson of the REN project, which is their air research project in Ceremonica,

187

00:17:39,600 --> 00:17:41,600

in Montpourers, why?

188

00:17:41,600 --> 00:17:44,600

And he wanted to see all the film I had.

189

00:17:44,600 --> 00:17:55,600

He examined it early and then ordered me to send all the photographs of East Illinois to the right field in Ohio

190

00:17:55,600 --> 00:17:58,600

where the research was going on.

191

00:17:58,600 --> 00:18:06,600

At that time Captain Luke was the most important one, was better lieutenant but in charge of the research.

192

00:18:06,600 --> 00:18:09,600

So I did that very thing.

193

00:18:09,600 --> 00:18:16,600

Then he told me now, this film that you've got, The Rich Knows, I would like for you to lock them up.

194

00:18:16,600 --> 00:18:23,600

You can make copies of them from which you can take my prints, but The Rich Knows lock them up, which they are locked up.

195

00:18:23,600 --> 00:18:29,600

Not where I cannot get them at all, but they are locked up.

196

00:18:29,600 --> 00:18:35,600

So immediately things started moving.

197

00:18:35,600 --> 00:18:40,600

Well I realized then that things were happening that we do with little and far.

198

00:18:40,600 --> 00:18:45,600

A lot of fancy ideas came along from all sources. Everybody seemed to know the answer.

199

00:18:45,600 --> 00:18:48,600

At a sub-to-date we find the same thing.

200

00:18:48,600 --> 00:18:55,600

That overnight experts sprung up on space and spacecraft.

201

00:18:55,600 --> 00:19:01,600

That even today most of the research was up to this day, still don't know anything about it.

202

00:19:01,600 --> 00:19:05,600

And a way to become an expert in that field.

203

00:19:05,600 --> 00:19:08,600

Yet experts sprung up all over the world.

204

00:19:08,600 --> 00:19:15,600

Suddenly all kinds of messages began to trick in from various sources, which was not the truth at all.

205

00:19:15,600 --> 00:19:18,600

But it used to be issued terrifically.

206

00:19:18,600 --> 00:19:32,600

So we finally find that in 1900 and 51, when Walter Wynchell over a nationwide hookup,

207

00:19:32,600 --> 00:19:39,600

and he's a top recorder or commentator in the states, made the statement point of blank,

208

00:19:39,600 --> 00:19:47,600

seeing that spacecraft was landing up in the desert, which is only about 30 miles from where we live.

209

00:19:47,600 --> 00:19:53,600

That there were sea landing there by the big observatory, men getting out of the ships,

210

00:19:53,600 --> 00:20:00,600

looking around, walking around, boarding into the ship's can, and taking off.

211

00:20:00,600 --> 00:20:05,600

Then I thought, well, this is a good place to go and try to get some photographs.

212

00:20:05,600 --> 00:20:08,600

If that's what they're doing, I might get closer.

213

00:20:08,600 --> 00:20:12,600

The pictures you have seen, they and the books.

214

00:20:12,600 --> 00:20:19,600

As good as they are, due to the fact that a telescope, if you understand how that works,

215

00:20:19,600 --> 00:20:23,600

telescopes act similar to your flashball.

216

00:20:23,600 --> 00:20:29,600

You get all this good picture with a flashball, but you might not get as good a picture if you didn't use it.

217

00:20:29,600 --> 00:20:31,600

Well, the same is true with a telescope.

218

00:20:31,600 --> 00:20:35,600

The mirror acts as a flashball there, backing up the object.

219

00:20:35,600 --> 00:20:40,600

And then also, magnification brings it down close to the photograph.

220

00:20:40,600 --> 00:20:47,600

So naturally, I would take my 6-inch, as I could, make it 4-inch, and go out to the desert.

221

00:20:47,600 --> 00:20:53,600

Many times, I went out there, nothing happened, but I've always considered it was a day spent

222

00:20:53,600 --> 00:21:00,600

sort of a vacation away from home, and I didn't really get discouraged.

223

00:21:00,600 --> 00:21:11,600

So one day, in the fall of the year, when Williamson and babies come out from Arizona,

224

00:21:11,600 --> 00:21:18,600

they heard of me, since that all that publicity went out and ran into the pictures that was denied

225

00:21:18,600 --> 00:21:21,600

and then finally admitted.

226

00:21:21,600 --> 00:21:27,600

So when they come out and were to store, they thought they had a great story to tell.

227

00:21:27,600 --> 00:21:38,600

Well, I listened to them for a little bit, and that was in reference to the ticker in the Santa Fe station at Needles.

228

00:21:38,600 --> 00:21:46,600

And this ticker, like all the rail stations have, to direct the trains and so forth,

229

00:21:46,600 --> 00:21:53,600

were supposed to make a contact over the ticker system with the space people.

230

00:21:53,600 --> 00:21:55,600

And they come and tell me about it.

231

00:21:55,600 --> 00:22:01,600

Well, I've already had quite a bit of information in that relationship from other sources.

232

00:22:01,600 --> 00:22:07,600

So I told them what I knew a little bit, not too much, and they figured I knew more than they did,

233

00:22:07,600 --> 00:22:09,600

so they didn't tell me much more after that.

234

00:22:09,600 --> 00:22:17,600

But instead they asked me, would you let us go out with you sometime when you go out with us?

235

00:22:17,600 --> 00:22:21,600

I said, that'd be all right. They seemed to be nice people.

236

00:22:21,600 --> 00:22:30,600

So when you do telephone us and reverse the charges, which I did, so we met them at light.

237

00:22:31,600 --> 00:22:38,600

And then after we had the breakfast, we figured, where are we going?

238

00:22:38,600 --> 00:22:42,600

I followed my hunches, where are we going?

239

00:22:42,600 --> 00:22:49,600

So I finally figured to go back to a room that was branching off the main highway.

240

00:22:49,600 --> 00:22:56,600

No one could go back the highway, which goes to Shparkadan Hospital for Indian Reservation.

241

00:22:56,600 --> 00:23:00,600

It's a very beautiful highway and a wide one.

242

00:23:00,600 --> 00:23:05,600

So we went back, which was 40 miles from the light back Jackie,

243

00:23:05,600 --> 00:23:11,600

and turned back and went up about 10 miles or one tenth of something of that nature,

244

00:23:11,600 --> 00:23:14,600

not quite 10 and a half miles.

245

00:23:14,600 --> 00:23:17,600

And it come up the hill and go down again.

246

On the right-hand side, going up that road, is a no-adventure airport.

Here's doing a war.

On the left-hand side, going up, is a no-target range.

252

00:23:40,600 --> 00:23:45,600

Putting out at a town by the heavy machinery going through the engines like that.

253

And there's quite a wash up there.

254

00:23:47,600 --> 00:23:53,600

It goes up into the mountain area, but some hillsides on the left of it.

255

00:23:53,600 --> 00:24:01,600

So we stood upon this top and the B-29 came through on this routine flight.

256

Next thing we saw was this big mothership aircraft that is now the name mothership.

257

And we thought our eyes were deceiving us.

258

So we looked to the map and we saw this ship having no wings or appendages of any kind.

But it had a rib, sort of a symbol on the back of it, on the top, an orange looking.

260

So immediately thought, well this must be one of those ships.

While some of us will go down, there was a saveness, all together including me,

But it was right here I watched.

Where I might photograph this ship and that was the idea.

At the time, putting this instrument together and placing the camera on it,

267

I had eight plates fully filled with the film ready to go.

We were so busy watching and putting up the instrument that we didn't watch what was happening in the sky.

269

During that time, the mothership released one of these so-called flying saucers.

270

And it came in just like we'd come into this room.

271

Here we are and his mouth is going certainly all around just like that.

272

And I had shot all eight shots at it.

273

It didn't take too much time to focus, it didn't have the time.

274

You were excited, you didn't know how long the equipment would be there for you to photograph it.

275

00:25:41,600 --> 00:25:43,600

It didn't win anything.

276

00:25:43,600 --> 00:25:45,600

So you'd done the best you could.

277

I figured that most of the shots probably were no better or worse.

278

00:25:49,600 --> 00:25:54,600

Because the way I had to work, the group against stood a little away from me.

279

00:25:54,600 --> 00:25:57,600

Not too far, it says, my hope, that's not true.

280

00:25:57,600 --> 00:26:01,600

Less than I have a man, some of them, some even closer than that.

281

00:26:01,600 --> 00:26:05,600

You are this well sketched a man perfectly.

282

00:26:05,600 --> 00:26:08,600

Alright? And she couldn't see that much.

283

00:26:08,600 --> 00:26:13,600

Ah, less, fewer, close enough to sketch him, than an artist must be.

284

00:26:13,600 --> 00:26:17,600

But I had them there standing because highway is heavily crowded.

285

00:26:17,600 --> 00:26:21,600

The traffic sometimes, not always, but most of the time.

286

00:26:21,600 --> 00:26:25,600

And they were cars moving very heavy on a dead day.

287

00:26:25,600 --> 00:26:32,600

And I figured when Luther's skulls start camping in the sky and set up a telescope right here by,

288

00:26:32,600 --> 00:26:38,600

all these cars will be stopping and the next thing we won't have a chance to even photograph it,

289

00:26:38,600 --> 00:26:41,600

it might just vanish on the side just that way.

290

00:26:41,600 --> 00:26:45,600

So I took the questions to handle it that way.

291

00:26:45,600 --> 00:26:53,600

But after I shot the aid up there, she went over the hill and asked to ask the song.

292

00:26:53,600 --> 00:26:55,600

And that was the end.

293

00:26:55,600 --> 00:27:01,600

I looked up into the sky, the big mentorship was so small out there,

294

00:27:01,600 --> 00:27:04,600

I must have been awfully high up there, she went out in other spaces,

295

barged from there and she could, and yet she seemed a little dead.

296

I didn't see the song really go up, it worked or nothing, I just shot over the hill and disappeared.

297

So I thought to myself, well, I'm going to wear it down too.

298

And I told the group to help me dismantle the instrument when a man finally waved to me.

So I knew that if anything did happen to me, they would see it, and in that way I could get help.

308

I realized this man had a long hair, but that was nothing new either.

Because in California, when you get out there and stay here, or a half a minute here or a year,

311

00:28:28,600 --> 00:28:34,600

you naturally have no promise or I'll tell you, you must let them grow when they want to really get long.

312

So that was nothing strange.

313

00:28:37,600 --> 00:28:41,600

So I think it could be one of our people.

314

00:28:41,600 --> 00:28:46,600

Well, when I got close to them then, I realized that something just dropped away from you.

315

Caution and a very mild sort of a feeling come over you,

316

00:28:50,600 --> 00:28:57,600

like the way you feel like you have known a man for all your lifetime, even before.

317

00:28:57,600 --> 00:29:00,600

He had that condition around him.

318

00:29:00,600 --> 00:29:03,600

He had this what appeared to be one piece soup.

319

00:29:03,600 --> 00:29:08,600

Yet it wasn't later I have learned, because of the two pieces and where the belt came in,

320

00:29:08,600 --> 00:29:12,600

that's where the two pieces joined, where you couldn't see it that way.

321

00:29:12,600 --> 00:29:17,600

So he had this belt with his three things, six and eight inches width.

322

And so he put out his hand to shake hands first.

323

For a like, naturally grab a grip. He refused that.

332

And I also knew that once ship wasn't flying, and I was photographing it,

333

that there was no one stepped out of it.

334

So I was wondering where he came from.

335

Then all of a sudden while I was talking, of course, he stepped away from the pockets of sand.

336

So there's a wind blowing in there, those sand as pockets.

337

00:30:22,600 --> 00:30:26,600

And it's not the kind of sand that you think like John Beats or someone like this.

338

00:30:26,600 --> 00:30:30,600

It's a sand that takes an imprint pretty good.

339

00:30:30,600 --> 00:30:36,600

And it was not heavier to make that imprint, because I left mine there too, as I walked away.

340

00:30:36,600 --> 00:30:41,600

And I wasn't putting on any extra weight on myself to do that.

341

00:30:41,600 --> 00:30:45,600

But he left those imprints, they were funny, and he fined it to them.

342

00:30:45,600 --> 00:30:47,600

Moody Dave Manson.

343

00:30:47,600 --> 00:30:55,600

I have been studying and teaching also telepathic communication, which is a taught transference.

344

00:30:55,600 --> 00:30:57,600

So I tried it.

345

00:30:57,600 --> 00:31:04,600

There was a reason for him leaving. We made three of them.

353

Like that.

354

00:31:31,600 --> 00:31:35,600

After he did that, wind was going pretty good.

355

00:31:35,600 --> 00:31:43,600

He out in the desert and it must have moved that ship that was hiding, because a flash of light shot out into space.

356

And I spotted him.

357

00:31:45,600 --> 00:31:47,600

So I immediately started looking away at Dave Manson.

358

And then when I found where the ship was covering in a coal, horseshoe type coal,

368

You forget yourself.

369

00:32:39,600 --> 00:32:48,600

And I kept moving around just like you did over and before I knew I was partially under the length of the ship.

370

00:32:48,600 --> 00:32:53,600

And that's when my arm got caught and slammed back and paralyzed.

371

00:32:53,600 --> 00:32:56,600

Well, he grabbed for me there.

372

00:32:56,600 --> 00:33:02,600

Actually grabbed for me because had he not done so, I would have fallen fully under that ship.

373

00:33:02,600 --> 00:33:07,600

And my whole body would have got that condition instead of the arm alone.

374

00:33:07,600 --> 00:33:12,600

He grabbed for me and there was a lot of brush, wild brush going in the desert.

375

00:33:12,600 --> 00:33:19,600

As he grabbed for me, he scratched his hand and bled very fiercely right here on the surface.

376

00:33:19,600 --> 00:33:22,600

Blood like tears of mine, not one bit different.

377

00:33:22,600 --> 00:33:27,600

He rubbed it three times finally and stopped leaving and he smiled.

378

00:33:27,600 --> 00:33:30,600

And he made it through his gestures and so forth,

379

00:33:30,600 --> 00:33:35,600

ensuring me that my arm will be all right, which has cleared up.

380

00:33:35,600 --> 00:33:43,600

Yet here and there, about two, three times a year, sometimes I offer it, my arm goes in.

381

00:33:43,600 --> 00:33:46,600

I feel I've got something there but I can't move.

382

00:33:46,600 --> 00:33:53,600

It doesn't stay there for a length of time, about a minute or two, and then that's away.

383

00:33:53,600 --> 00:34:00,600

But finally I looked up into the ship where the docking part was and I saw another person there.

384

00:34:00,600 --> 00:34:03,600

I had no plans, I had never got to know him.

385

00:34:03,600 --> 00:34:06,600

But there was another person in the ship.

386

00:34:06,600 --> 00:34:12,600

So he talked with me for a little bit and that's the time I asked him where he was from.

387

00:34:12,600 --> 00:34:16,600

When I find it, good sir, it was one o'clock in the morning.

388

00:34:16,600 --> 00:34:20,600

And I made it swing with my hand all in orbit number one.

389

00:34:20,600 --> 00:34:27,600

So after all, you must admit that we are the person in the ship.

390

00:34:27,600 --> 00:34:35,600

According to the ones who discovered it, that they would not have the same name for their plans that we give them.

391

00:34:35,600 --> 00:34:40,600

The only answer to the question that we ask them in the ship is to tell them that we are the one in the ship

392

00:34:40,600 --> 00:34:43,600

and that we are the one in the ship.

393

00:34:43,600 --> 00:34:48,600

So I made it swing with my hand all in orbit number one.

394

00:34:48,600 --> 00:34:53,600

And I said, well, I don't know if we are the one in the ship,

395

00:34:53,600 --> 00:34:55,600

but we give them.

396

00:34:55,600 --> 00:35:02,600

The only answer to the question would be that they are the system which is naturally a natural situation.

397

00:35:02,600 --> 00:35:05,600

So I got that thought and I proceeded.

398

00:35:05,600 --> 00:35:09,600

And I thought, this is orbit number one, Mercury.

399

00:35:09,600 --> 00:35:14,600

And it swam to another one and I said, orbit number two, Venus.

400

00:35:14,600 --> 00:35:18,600

Then another one, there's this wish like that.

401

00:35:18,600 --> 00:35:22,600

And I said, orbit number three, Mercury.

402

00:35:22,600 --> 00:35:27,600

And I said to myself when I said, Earth, finder myself in Earth.

403

He finally did the same thing, but he stopped at orbit number two.

404

00:35:32,600 --> 00:35:38,600

And he pointed to himself and focused into that orbit, which means Venus.

405

00:35:38,600 --> 00:35:43,600

So I said Venus again, about three times.

406

00:35:43,600 --> 00:35:47,600

So finally he said Venus just as plain as I did.

It shall be published in a blank, susser-reviewed article, I don't know which is of the publication.

413

But it's here now.

414

00:36:21,600 --> 00:36:26,600

There will tell the whole story of the thing that kept silent all this time.

415

00:36:26,600 --> 00:36:30,600

So the jets were there, and they beat 29, susser.

416

00:36:30,600 --> 00:36:33,600

And they were coming around on applications.

417

00:36:33,600 --> 00:36:38,600

The way the tip was so that we thought both of our heads would come off.

418

419

423

424

425

426

427

So again, he got a plastic cast and so forth, and started taking those footprints, which he has today, the best ones.

428

429

430

442

Therefore I had printed it out without me knowing what to think about.

443

00:38:43,600 --> 00:38:48,600

Therefore I was really brought to the front before the public with the whole experience

444

00:38:48,600 --> 00:38:51,600

without even my knowledge.

445

00:38:51,600 --> 00:38:57,600

Then I actually had to face the music in general, which I have to this day.

446

00:38:57,600 --> 00:39:11,600

But again, when I came home, the FBI, the Air Force Intelligence and others came to see me.

447

00:39:11,600 --> 00:39:18,600

They didn't ask me at all. They didn't even ask me anything at that time, what they called me really.

448

00:39:18,600 --> 00:39:26,600

They just asked me to tell them what I said to the man, what he said to me, how we understood each other.

449

And I didn't know as much as I did how, what I best understood, and they took all of them down.

450

451

To this day, they have never yet crossed the outboard through me on anything so far.

452

They always come down and ask me this and that, my telephone, which is down at the top, very friendly,

453

454

Then it was far, I think a month or so after that, I have to look right in my pocket.

455

461

I could not focus no telescope on anyone unless they'd be in the air.

462

So he admitted there that he was one of the, either the jets or the B-29 in the air at the time the conflict was being made.

463

He didn't speak English now. Testing him a little bit to see whether he could speak in the other language.

473

I cannot speak very well Polish anymore, but I can say few words.

474

00:42:42,600 --> 00:42:46,600

So I did. And he came back in Polish a lot better than I could.

475

00:42:46,600 --> 00:42:52,600

So there was no shop to go. So then he told me why he did what he did.

476

00:42:52,600 --> 00:43:00,600

He said, now there is no telephone system between us and your planet.

477

00:43:00,600 --> 00:43:05,600

So the only way if I wanted to meet you again would be by an impression.

478

The same is true with a spacecraft. It does the same thing.

You're already accustomed to it and the ships are fully pressurized, same as our own aircraft are.

513

Fully pressurized to meet the expectations of the humans they are occupied of or working with and so forth.

So it's no better than traveling in our own ships except that they are faster, are far greater types of instruments and stuff.

And things like that, more comfort and safer in many ways.

For instance, to give you some idea of the ship now before I go into the other details is something like this.

As one of our great men of the Navy has stated in America, that the submarine and the spacecraft are identical instruments in every respect.

522

And that wasn't that more than maybe lecturing in Europe.

523

I'd like to lecture here.

524

00:47:53,600 --> 00:47:55,600

They're identical.

525

00:47:55,600 --> 00:47:58,600

One is made for liquid, which is water.

526

00:47:58,600 --> 00:48:03,600

The other is what is made for gas, which is space.

527

00:48:03,600 --> 00:48:05,600

And both operate identically the same.

528

00:48:05,600 --> 00:48:10,600

Except of course, spacecraft has got more instruments probably for space purposes.

529

It has more to encounter than the submarine has.

530

00:48:14,600 --> 00:48:22,600

But, giving the idea of the submarine, it doesn't make no difference to the men that are inside of that submarine.

531

What they surface it, surface the water, or go down to a depth of 300 feet, and the bottom of the air.

532

They don't know the difference.

When the thing goes down, the wind is coming up.

Or are they crushed when the ground is at the end of the level of the depth of the opening?

538

The submarine is pressurized to suit them.

539

Give them all the comforts possible that they've been enjoying on Earth outside of the submarine.

540

The submarine is better to take care of all of that.

The same thing as with a spacecraft.

It's been the same way when it's coming towards the Earth.

It's no different than a ship submarine going down to the bottom of the ocean.

Going up again is the same way.

Coming up from that heavy version, upwards to surface on the water.

The noise inside the submarine don't know any difference.

549

They still are the same as they were at the bottom and it won't be at the surface.

550

00:49:46,600 --> 00:49:51,600

They don't go around because of the lack of gravity and things like that like with the Taiwan.

551

00:49:51,600 --> 00:49:58,600

In a submarine, we do another spacecraft, people in the spacecraft do, once they leave our atmosphere.

552

They don't go around either.

553

00:50:00,600 --> 00:50:08,600

That's ideas that have been promoted by man's speculations as what I think, but the facts are not yet there.

554

But that is as near as I can tell you how the ships behave.

555

And that in reference to mother ships are two stars.

556

Now, the people in themselves are no different than you and I.

557

They are better looking, they look better in general.

558

Men and women alike.

559

00:50:28,600 --> 00:50:30,600

Why?

560

00:50:30,600 --> 00:50:33,600

They have got the tension of life that we have.

561

00:50:33,600 --> 00:50:35,600

They don't go through the same tension.

562

00:50:35,600 --> 00:50:45,600

They live longer, they live up to thousands of years of age, yet our own life tells us that one night people on the ship had lived that sort of an age.

563

Now, of course, thousands of years of their life on their planet would be much shorter,

564

00:50:50,600 --> 00:50:58,600

if it's somewhere around seven or eight hundred years or thirty, type of years, because the areas are short on beings.

565

I think around two hundred and sixty some odd days to an year, around hours is three hundred thirty-five, thirty-five, or sixty-five.

So there is a difference there.

The only difference between a planet and a spacecraft is that a spacecraft travels wherever you want it to travel. A planet must go on and on and on like on a rail, at years that that all the time, or it's controlled.

would you defend yourself with the power that you have which is even greater than any atomic power you have hoped up?

597

Because it's the power that's a greater power than some as well as disintegrating power. Because disintegrates you in the twink of an eye.

With that part they want to use in the mining, they said, no, we couldn't. We can't take advantage of our younger brother because he doesn't understand.

And that is never going to be. They don't follow human beings like they did before. That's the manifestation of the Creator. That's how the planet is organized. They have leaders yet.
