Well, our universe, as far as we know, appears to be about 5,000 million years old.

The yogis believe, and yogas are subject, I should hesitate to discuss,

it's perhaps more dear to my heart than flowing sources.

We think that God, or the deity or the absolute, is imagining our universe into existence,

82

and that our universe in we ourselves are creations, mental creations of God.

The ancient Hindus actually worked out that our universe lasts for 154 billion years.

84

It expands to 77 million from a primeval, really thought pattern,

85

supporting the big bang theory, and then expands to 77 million years, then contracts.

86

Then the absolute goes to sleep, nothing happens.

87

For a similar period, there is nothing, and then the universe starts up all over again.

88

A succession of cyclic universes, which was taught by the ancient Hindus, and also by the Greeks.

89

And we ourselves, just as the universe lives life after life, so we live life after life too.

90

Our earth is believed to be about 4,500 million years old.

91

These figures are rather important, as I should explain in a moment.

Actually, a Russian, Paul Gurling, claims that our earth is not 4,500 million years old,

93

but actually is actually 12,000 million years old.

Now, in this tremendous time, obviously wonderful things have happened.

95

Civilisations have risen and fallen.

96

And our earth at times has been struck, so we believe, by huge comets.

Herbger, the Austrian cosmologist, taught that four previous suns crashed into our earth, destroying civilisations.

98

And people all over the world generally believe that before our present civilisation,

99

there have been at least four previous civilisations.

100

You see, we know very, very little about ancient times.

101

One of the most desolate things to a student of ancient history is the fact, but odd as it might seem to you,

102

there seem to be very, very few records.

103

00:14:39,000 --> 00:14:45,000

Most of the records, of course, were destroyed by fire and flood.

104

00:14:45,000 --> 00:14:49,000

Many were destroyed by emperors.

105

Nabernazir, the emperor of Babylon in the year 723, destroyed all written records.

106

He wanted history to start from that particular date.

107

00:15:01,000 --> 00:15:08,000

In the year 213, the Chinese emperor, Huang Pee, destroyed all the records in China.

108

As you probably know, the Spaniards notably Bishop Lander in the 17th century destroyed all the records in Mexico.

109

And every time you try to delve back to history, you find that there are very, very few records left.

110

But I think, you know, that our archaeologists are wrong in many respects.

The oldest literature, for example, appears to be probably Achanatans really marvellous hymn to the sun,

116

written about 1370, the Gilgamesh epic, which probably goes back to about 2500 BC.

117

And the Ramayana, which is dated about 1800, and the Maburata in India about 1400 BC.

118

But ladies and gentlemen, these marvellous writings show such wonderful language and such exquisite thought.

The truly men must have evolved for thousands, tens of thousands, perhaps hundreds of thousands of years,

to produce such wonderful modes of thought and such marvellous language.

Also, in chemistry, the ancient Chinese had absolutely marvellous pharmaceutical preparations.

which surely they must have inherited from civilizations many generations ago.

I think one useful byproduct of the interest in UFOs and the spacemen in antiquity is that it is resurrecting

126

the lost continents of the past with perhaps more enthusiasm and more proof than before.

Some years ago, I wrote a series of articles for the Flying Source Review,

128

which on the advice of Brinsley Le Porte-Trench were published in God's or Spacemen,

129

published by Ray Palmer in 1964.

130

And I tried to give a picture of what I thought was God's or Spacemen in the past.

131

Unfortunately, Palmer published only 1,000 copies and they were restricted to private sale.

132

And actually, believe it or not, I myself advertised 2 or 3 times in Flying Source Reviews for copies,

and it could not get any.

134

Palmer reprinted 1,000 copies last year.

135

In God's or Spacemen, I do try to give some idea from the ancient record of these lost,

136

00:19:04,000 --> 00:19:09,000

not only of the lost continents, but of lost civilizations.

137

00:19:09,000 --> 00:19:13,000

I should deal with most of the countries of the world shortly,

138

00:19:13,000 --> 00:19:18,000

but just to give you an idea of the principal dates.

139

I should just mention a few to you.

140

00:19:21,000 --> 00:19:34,000

It is my belief that for about 2,000 years, its Spacemen were active on our own earth.

141

For example, in an ancient Chinese record, the Xu Qing, in the year 2,400 BC,

142

the Lord on high was very displeased with the Chinese and the wickedness in China.

143

There was a tribe with the perhaps rather sign of the name Mao, the Mao Tse,

144

whether they were just an ancestors of Mao Tse, we don't know.

145

God took away from them the power to fly.

146

00:20:10,000 --> 00:20:18,000

And that China at that time was troubled by stupendous wars.

147

The Japanese record states that in the year 2346 BC, ten suns appeared in the sky all at once.

148

And nine of them were shot down by a character called Su Yu, the divine archer.

149

We perhaps might look upon the ten suns in the sky,

150

00:20:46,000 --> 00:20:51,000

send it to all those suns seeing the sky in wrong time, perhaps as you thought.

151

A very little-known Japanese work called the Sei Ki Tu mentioned

152

that in the year 2300 BC, a man descended in Korea from the sky under a sandal tree, actually,

153

and that he lived in Korea for a thousand years,

154

00:21:14,000 --> 00:21:20,000

recalling that marvelous character of, I'll put my alt-right in God's place,

155

00:21:20,000 --> 00:21:24,000

and that was the name of the man called San Jume.

156

00:21:24,000 --> 00:21:33,000

In the year 2000 BC, according to Dionysius of Halechianassus in his writings,

157

and Mark, you, we are a bit uncertain about the date,

158

00:21:38,000 --> 00:21:46,000

minus of Crete was presented with the laws by Zeus,

159

00:21:46,000 --> 00:21:51,000

Moses receiving the Ten Commandments from God.

160

Also, about 2000 BC, a chip San Jume in Japan depicts seven suns over Kyoto,

161

00:22:04,000 --> 00:22:14,000

and it shows a drawing of the Emperor of Japan making an airplane,

162

00:22:14,000 --> 00:22:20,000

and kneeling to these seven, of course, we would call them UFOs in the sky.

163

And about the year 1800 BC, there was the famous Indian Ramayana.

164

This is a really marvelous story about Rama's quest for his wife, Sita,

165

00:22:34,000 --> 00:22:42,000

who had been abducted to Ceylon by the evil genius Ravan.

166

00:22:42,000 --> 00:22:52,000

And the writer, Balmiki, described battles in the air between Rama and Ravan.

167

00:22:52,000 --> 00:23:00,000

He described marvelous celestial spaceships, and if one read it with modern eyes,

168

00:23:00,000 --> 00:23:06,000

one would be absolutely certain, I think, that you were reading about

169

00:23:06,000 --> 00:23:13,000

celestials from the sky in wonderful UFOs.

170

00:23:13,000 --> 00:23:29,000

In 1785, the Babylonians, King Hammurabi, also received laws from the Babylonian sun god,

171

00:23:29,000 --> 00:23:34,000

Shemash evoking again Moses and Minos.

172

00:23:34,000 --> 00:23:44,000

In 1500 BC, of course, you have those circles of fire alleged to have been seen

173

00:23:44,000 --> 00:23:47,000

over the court of Tutmose's III.

174

00:23:47,000 --> 00:23:50,000

I know in most of your four books you will have read about that

175

00:23:50,000 --> 00:23:56,000

and the translation of the Papyrus by Count Rackervils.

176

00:23:56,000 --> 00:24:00,000

Actually, I wrote to the British Museum about that, trying to verify it,

177

00:24:00,000 --> 00:24:04,000

and the Department of Egyptology wrote back the rather vague,

178

00:24:04,000 --> 00:24:08,000

I think it is the Tullio Papyrus, but there are rather vague about it,

179

00:24:08,000 --> 00:24:13,000

so I don't think that Egyptologists themselves believe it.

180

00:24:13,000 --> 00:24:23,000

Now, in 1400 BC, Klossos, the capital of Crete, was destroyed.

181

00:24:23,000 --> 00:24:28,000

Now, I know perfectly well that almost all historians and geologists

182

00:24:28,000 --> 00:24:33,000

attribute the destruction of Klossos to earthquakes.

183

00:24:33,000 --> 00:24:39,000

I think the latest theory is that Klossos was destroyed by the explosion of Santorin Island

184

00:24:39,000 --> 00:24:41,000

in the Mediterranean not far away.

185

00:24:41,000 --> 00:24:46,000

It is probably what the truth was, but it probably was destroyed by earthquakes.

186

00:24:46,000 --> 00:24:50,000

But then, on the other hand, as I shall mention later,

187

00:24:50,000 --> 00:24:57,000

cities do appear to have been destroyed by extraterrestrial action.

188

00:24:57,000 --> 00:25:02,000

And although it seems a bit improbable, it isn't beyond the bounds of possibility

189

00:25:02,000 --> 00:25:08,000

that Klosos itself might have been destroyed by spacemen,

190

00:25:08,000 --> 00:25:13,000

especially as one or two geologists or somebody who disagrees with the experts

191

00:25:13,000 --> 00:25:22,000

say that from the evidence at Klosos itself, the fires and whatnot that were started

192

00:25:22,000 --> 00:25:26,000

don't have been started by earthquakes.

193

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:33,000

And in the year 1400, in India, we get now to the Marbarata.

194

00:25:33,000 --> 00:25:40,000

This is the nine days war in northern India, a war waged by Prince Arjuna,

195

00:25:40,000 --> 00:25:48,000

aided by the god Krishna, who were fighting another,

196

00:25:48,000 --> 00:25:52,000

claimed to be the kingdom actually in northern India.

197

00:25:52,000 --> 00:25:59,000

Now, this war is described in the Marbarata in absolutely fantastic detail,

198

00:25:59,000 --> 00:26:08,000

not only with flying ships, but also these, what we would call hydrogen bombs,

199

00:26:08,000 --> 00:26:13,000

nuclear bombs, stupendous bombs that wipe out whole armies,

200

00:26:13,000 --> 00:26:18,000

destroy herds of elephants, and actually not only shattered cities,

201

00:26:18,000 --> 00:26:22,000

but make the very universe quick.

202

00:26:22,000 --> 00:26:26,000

If you read these accounts in the Marbarata, written as far as we know,

203

about 1400 years ago, you would swear, ladies and gentlemen,

204

00:26:31,000 --> 00:26:39,000

that you were reading an account similar to the destruction of Hiroshima.

205

And following year 1400, you notice I'm switching from country to country

206

00:26:46,000 --> 00:26:50,000

because I want to get this particular data in chronological order.

207

00:26:50,000 --> 00:26:56,000

These are the few records we have from that time.

208

In 1375, in Egypt, ruled this marvelous, really marvelous king, Ashnatham.

209

00:27:05,000 --> 00:27:11,000

I know some people think he was not a great king, that he was a pacifist,

210

00:27:11,000 --> 00:27:20,000

and while he reigned, he tried to usher in a kingdom of peace and enlightenment.

211

And finally, he was overthrown and the rule of Armon restored.

But when he became king, he was only about 14 or 15,

213

and he showed such immense wisdom that frankly, I, at least, would not be surprised

215

And then, as I made this cross later, if I have time,

216

about the year 1200 BC, there was the Trojan War.

217

I'm sure you will have read at least some of the marvelous accounts

218

out of any Iliad or later on in the Odyssey, that the gods took sides in the siege of Troy.

219

Well, the gods, in goddesses, were such vivid detail that I prefer to think that they were spacemen.

220

For example, suppose the Russians and the Americans, suppose they are visiting Mars or one of the planets,

221

and just suppose there is a local war on Mars or on one of the planets they visit.

222

Well, it's quite possible that the Americans and the Russians may give advice to different sides,

223

even if they don't actually interfere in the fighting.

224

00:28:38,000 --> 00:28:46,000

Well, I prefer to believe that the gods or the spacemen were actually present during the siege of Troy.

225

Now, the Bible says that in about 915, Solomon's temple was built.

226

Well, Solomon's temple, so it says in Kings, was built by angels and by caroben,

227

00:29:03,000 --> 00:29:09,000

which, who are now, I said which, there's some confusion really.

228

It's the way the word caroben refers to a fiery wheel, perhaps to a spaceship itself,

229

00:29:16,000 --> 00:29:19,000

or actually to the people manning it.

230

I think Solomon's temple in 950 was probably constructed with the help of an extraterrestrial.

231

Now, Babylonian and Assyrian reliefs and statues show, for the year 880 BC,

232

the king Charmonesa II, accompanied by weird beings.

233

I think that there were spacemen who were advising him,

234

00:29:55,000 --> 00:30:00,000

and they were given wings just to denote if they came from space.

235

Similarly, about 20 years later, in the year 860, the Babylonian king, as a Nardi Palna III,

236

he was depicted accompanied by beings with wings.

237

I know this probably sounds a bit fatuous, but just suppose, just suppose for the sake of argument,

238

that beings did land from one of the planets on our earth, you see,

239

00:30:24,000 --> 00:30:31,000

and after we had sort of got used to them, they appeared with our own loyalty.

240

Well, I guess they read it, perhaps they might be drawn, perhaps with wings,

241

00:30:37,000 --> 00:30:44,000

just to denote that they were not earthlings like ourselves, but had come from other planets.

242

And in the year 850, according to most chronology, lived Elijah.

243

We know, according to the Bible, that Elijah used to call up praetorus heaven

244

and called down fire on his enemies, and that Elijah was translated,

245

or he used to be translated to the skies, about the age of 50.

246

In the year 800, lived a marvellous queen of Babylon, Queen Smelemus.

247

You may remember some reference to her by Shakespeare,

248

it was someone I'd screened by praetorus antisperi,

249

00:31:28,000 --> 00:31:32,000

going to make love by old Nini's tomb.

250

Nini, or Nina's, was her husband, too, said by the minister,

251

00:31:37,000 --> 00:31:42,000

and she raised a tomb sort of Babylonian wreck, about a mile long,

252

00:31:42,000 --> 00:31:46,000

and about a mile high, and a mile wide, which seems to be an important possible thing,

253

00:31:46,000 --> 00:31:49,000

but she was an absolutely fabulous queen,

254

00:31:49,000 --> 00:31:55,000

and she led the Babylonian into Syrian armies to Egypt, and right through India.

255

Her father was deemed to be O'Ani's, the Babylonian god,

256

00:31:59,000 --> 00:32:06,000

and her mother was a teary artist, who was a fish goddess.

257

And then, in the year 716, Romulus, I'll have more to say about this later on if I have time,

258

Romulus was whisked to heaven in a cloud,

259

00:32:17,000 --> 00:32:21,000

he was given judgment on the Palatine hill.

260

When the cloud came down from the sky, so were you told it anyway,

and Romulus was whisked off to heaven.

262

In the year 660 BC,

263

the Japanese emperor, Gimo, was helped, according to the Kujiki in the Nihongi,

the Japanese ancient record,

265

00:32:47,000 --> 00:33:02,000

he was aided by Celestials in his war against the Aeol of northern Japan.

266

In the year 640, the one of the early Roman emperors, Tullus Hostilius,

267

00:33:10,000 --> 00:33:16,000

he and all his family were destroyed by fire from heaven.

268

In the year 630, as far as we know it anyway,

269

00:33:22,000 --> 00:33:30,000

Zoroaster received the laws of Persia from Ahura Mazda,

270

00:33:30,000 --> 00:33:41,000

the great Persian god, Sky god whom many of us think was the Persian name for denoting Spaceman.

271

And in 593, we had Ezekiel by the river Chobal in Babylon, saw his famous wheel.

272

In 536, according to the Bible, Daniel met an angel or a being who is described very much,

273

and almost the same words practically, is Adamski's description of autumn from Venus.

274

That is if you care to believe Adamski.

275

00:34:11,000 --> 00:34:21,000

In 508 BC, the city of Bonsano in Italy, so it was told by a plenie,

276

00:34:21,000 --> 00:34:24,000

was destroyed by fire from heaven.

277

00:34:24,000 --> 00:34:34,000

Last Portná was besieging Rome, the Romans were fighting the, I think it was the Samnites or the Etruscans.

278

00:34:34,000 --> 00:34:39,000

In last Portná, we believe, enlisted the help of the space people,

279

00:34:39,000 --> 00:34:47,000

and according to Plenie Dennerit, Bonsano was practically annihilated by a blast from heaven.

280

In 498 BC, the Romans say that wondrous beings came to the aid of the Romans

281

00:34:55,000 --> 00:34:59,000

who had pressed at the battle of Lake Regulus.

282

00:34:59,000 --> 00:35:10,000

In 490 BC, the Greeks alleged that wonderful beings aided Leonidas in marathón.

283

00:35:10,000 --> 00:35:17,000

And in 480 BC, a wonderful light, or approximation, what we would call a UFO,

284

00:35:17,000 --> 00:35:19,000

was seen at the battle of Salamis.

285

00:35:19,000 --> 00:35:25,000

These, in a few, I think that happened most of the days, between 2400 and about 400,

286

00:35:25,000 --> 00:35:37,000

which I, at any rate, prefer to believe were at least some evidence of extraterrestrial visitation.

287

In my book, Ancient East, I, at very great length, deal with the spacemen in ancient India,

288

00:35:48,000 --> 00:35:56,000

Tibet, China, Japan, Egypt and Babylon.

289

I have very much doubts, seeing as I wanted to discuss the ancient west with you,

290

00:36:01,000 --> 00:36:07,000

I very much doubt really whether I'll have a great deal of time to mention those.

291

But I should be glad, I think, to answer any questions about those countries later on.

292

Ancient West.

293

Well, after writing Ancient East, I decided to write about the rest of the world.

294

Incidentally, I finished Ancient East in 1966, and the book was not published until 1968.

295

As soon as I had finished Ancient East, I started Ancient West.

296

That took about three years, and in January of last year, I deposited with the publisher

297

00:36:51,000 --> 00:36:59,000

a 465 page volume, Spacemen in the Ancient West.

298

00:36:59,000 --> 00:37:03,000

Perhaps, well, I thought quite sure, really well, I'll just say something about this.

299

The bibliography to Ancient West lists 510 items in nine languages.

300

So you will see that whatever shortcomings may be, I have at least tried to resurrect as much data as possible

301

for far better brains than my own to interpret.

302

Unfortunately, for me, the publisher kept the manuscript 12 months.

303

And although at the beginning, I think he was keen on publishing it, unfortunately,

304

it was supplanted by chariot of the gods.

305

Now, I don't think for one moment that I'm criticizing Eric von Denikin at all.

306

Good luck to him. The more publicity we can get, the more books which are published on Spacemen

307

both today and yesterday, the more good for the cause.

But I personally found it somewhat embarrassing because I'd heard articles publicizing the book

thinking that I myself was writing them because I had given many talks in the Northeast

it's really not for me to say, but the point is that Chariot came out in the English translation in October.

317

So the publisher returned the manuscript to me after having it 12 months,

318

and I honestly thought he had accepted it, of course now I'm looking for him in the publisher.

Well, Spacemen in the Ancient West is a fairly lengthy analysis of Spacemen in Lemuria,

320

Atlantis, Ancient Greece, the Etruscans, Rome, Scandinavia,

00:39:40,000 --> 00:39:48,000

North and South America, Mexico, and Peru, and also ancient Africa.

322

I should try to give you a brief resume, but I should be very glad to try to answer any questions later on.

323

The first three chapters deal with the antiquity of our Earth.

324

I explained very briefly how originally, perhaps about 2,000 million years ago,

325

all the land on our Earth was grouped into one continent called Pangea, surrounded by a sea called Pantalacia.

326

And then after billions of years, the continent split into two, into Laurasia and Gondwana land.

327

00:40:32,000 --> 00:40:43,000

Gondwana land later split up into Lemuria, and I describe as far as I can from various records and so forth,

328

00:40:43,000 --> 00:40:48,000

and I'm talking about the Lemurians, who we think lived, of course it's very difficult to guess it,

329

00:40:48,000 --> 00:40:56,000

an exact chronology I know, probably 10 or even 20 million years ago.

330

00:40:56,000 --> 00:41:05,000

And many of us believe that there was a very great civilization in the Pacific known as Lemuria,

331

00:41:05,000 --> 00:41:13,000

and the Lemurians were inspired by beings from the planet, notably Venus,

332

00:41:13,000 --> 00:41:19,000

or on the Middle, our astronomers have very doubtful whether life could exist on Venus.

333

00:41:19,000 --> 00:41:26,000

Lemuria was finally destroyed by earthquakes, which students of the occult allege,

334

00:41:26,000 --> 00:41:32,000

of course, believe it or say, as you may, was really promoted by the black magicians

335

00:41:32,000 --> 00:41:37,000

who were using the Lemurian occult forces for evil purposes.

336

00:41:37,000 --> 00:41:43,000

Those of you who are familiar with Churchwood's works may recall that, I think it's the children of Moe,

337

00:41:43,000 --> 00:41:49,000

I describe this spaceship, the Lemurians.

338

00:41:49,000 --> 00:41:59,000

The Lemurians, before their continent disappeared, migrated to India and began the earliest Indian civilizations,

339

00:41:59,000 --> 00:42:08,000

and also to South America and over to the new continent of Atlantis.

340

00:42:08,000 --> 00:42:14,000

In those days, according to the Austrian herpiger, there was no moon in the sky,

341

00:42:14,000 --> 00:42:24,000

and the Atlantis existed as far as we know, I should think for about a quarter million years.

342

We have three fairly long chapters dealing with Atlantis.

343

00:42:29,000 --> 00:42:37,000

There are two schools of thought regarding the credibility of the information for Atlantis.

344

00:42:37,000 --> 00:42:45,000

We have a lot of information by psychics, such as Rudolf Steiner and Edgar Cayce,

345

00:42:45,000 --> 00:42:49,000

and you may have read the book, Phyllis the Tibetan.

346

00:42:49,000 --> 00:42:57,000

The information from the scum entities and from people who under hypnosis have regressed the previous lives.

347

00:42:57,000 --> 00:43:01,000

They have regressed the previous lives and returned back to present life.

348

00:43:01,000 --> 00:43:10,000

All under hypnosis give us wonderful details alleging that Atlantis had a really brilliant civilization,

349

00:43:10,000 --> 00:43:14,000

a civilization probably a couple of hundred years in advance of ours.

350

00:43:14,000 --> 00:43:23,000

And then you have perhaps the semi or the quasi historical side of ancient histories,

351

00:43:23,000 --> 00:43:31,000

such as Dionysius of Hadesanases, Plutarch to some extent, and Deocasius,

352

00:43:31,000 --> 00:43:36,000

who gave it very hints of this marvellous continent in the West.

353

00:43:36,000 --> 00:43:43,000

It is generally believed now, I think, that probably about 12,000 years ago

354

00:43:43,000 --> 00:43:51,000

that the Atlantans invaded the West, just as they made them, invaded the West on D-Day.

355

00:43:51,000 --> 00:43:58,000

In fact, Greek legend states that the Atlantan forces were led by Hercules,

356

00:43:58,000 --> 00:44:03,000

after whom the pillars of Hercules were named, and that the Atlantans,

357

00:44:03,000 --> 00:44:08,000

Conqueror, Libya, Spain, Southern France,

358

00:44:08,000 --> 00:44:17,000

were finally smashed by a coalition of the Athenians and the Egyptians.

359

00:44:17,000 --> 00:44:22,000

Many of us think, at least we perhaps would prefer to think,

360

00:44:22,000 --> 00:44:29,000

that before Atlantis was finally destroyed, that initiates for Atlantis

361

00:44:29,000 --> 00:44:34,000

were rescued by spaceships from Venus.

362

00:44:34,000 --> 00:44:38,000

Many of us think that, well, before very long,

363

00:44:38,000 --> 00:44:42,000

that our own civilization would probably be destroyed,

364

00:44:42,000 --> 00:44:49,000

and that spacemen will land and rescue the initiates among us.

365

00:44:49,000 --> 00:44:54,000

And there are garbled references in the Bible that are more or less supporting that.

366

00:44:54,000 --> 00:45:02,000

What I think is interesting is that about 10,000 BC, Athens seems to have had

367

00:45:02,000 --> 00:45:06,000

quite a brilliant civilization.

368

00:45:06,000 --> 00:45:10,000

This does conflict with the archaeologists.

369

00:45:10,000 --> 00:45:19,000

I think at the present time, the archaeologists say that probably before about 2,500 BC,

370

00:45:19,000 --> 00:45:22,000

Greece was not even inhabited.

371

00:45:22,000 --> 00:45:28,000

Although discoveries that come from the Kütök in Turkey seem to suggest

372

00:45:28,000 --> 00:45:33,000

civilizations not far away, about as far back as 9,000.

373

00:45:33,000 --> 00:45:41,000

According to Plato, this is very strange for almost 2,000 years.

374

00:45:41,000 --> 00:45:48,000

Western civilization is from unto practically every word that Plato wrote.

375

00:45:48,000 --> 00:45:53,000

As a matter of fact, Plato and Aristotle between them really hypnotized men

376

00:45:53,000 --> 00:45:56,000

for about at least 1,500 years.

377

00:45:56,000 --> 00:46:00,000

There was really no progress at all because the church and scholars

378

00:46:01,000 --> 00:46:05,000

didn't thought, as Aristotle and Plato said they should.

379

00:46:05,000 --> 00:46:13,000

But Plato's really marvelous account of Atlantis is generally dismissed as science fiction.

380

00:46:13,000 --> 00:46:24,000

But actually, I really don't think it can be, because Plato says that he was relating

381

00:46:25,000 --> 00:46:33,000

the words of Solon, his great ancestor who lived about 550 BC.

382

00:46:33,000 --> 00:46:37,000

He had had this story from the Egyptian priests.

383

00:46:37,000 --> 00:46:44,000

It's noteworthy that Preetius, Homocrates and Socrates present at these discussions

384

00:46:44,000 --> 00:46:50,000

in Socrates who would argue about anything, never disputed the Atlantis story at all.

385

00:46:50,000 --> 00:46:56,000

However, I should be very glad to address him later on about ancient Athens.

386

00:46:56,000 --> 00:47:02,000

Now, a study of the Greek legends is very revealing.

387

00:47:02,000 --> 00:47:09,000

Hesiod, principally, although his tales were garbled to some extent by Orbeez

388

00:47:09,000 --> 00:47:17,000

about 800 years later, Hesiod writes of the golden age of the gods,

389

00:47:18,000 --> 00:47:23,000

the silver age, the bronze age and the iron age.

390

00:47:23,000 --> 00:47:27,000

The golden age was under Cronus.

391

00:47:27,000 --> 00:47:33,000

Now, Cronus actually, he supplanted Uranus.

392

00:47:33,000 --> 00:47:38,000

Very little is known about Uranus, but a lot of us attempted to believe

393

00:47:38,000 --> 00:47:44,000

that the Uranus were most ancient stellar civilizations

394

00:47:44,000 --> 00:47:49,000

who perhaps landed on our Earth very, very long ago.

395

00:47:49,000 --> 00:47:53,000

Our Earth might have been used as a transit base,

396

00:47:53,000 --> 00:48:02,000

really for expeditions from other solar systems, through our solar system,

397

00:48:02,000 --> 00:48:05,000

onto further systems.

398

00:48:05,000 --> 00:48:09,000

The Uranus were a very ancient civilization.

399

00:48:09,000 --> 00:48:19,000

It was landed by Cronus or Saturn who was emperor of a marvellous golden age.

400

00:48:19,000 --> 00:48:26,000

Actually, you'll think about these golden ages in the Greek golden age

401

00:48:26,000 --> 00:48:33,000

and also in the golden age the Populvul, it was mentioned in the Populvul in Guatemala,

402

00:48:33,000 --> 00:48:36,000

that there were no women.

403

00:48:36,000 --> 00:48:39,000

Well, it was a golden age because there were no women,

404

00:48:39,000 --> 00:48:42,000

it is a matter of speculation.

405

00:48:42,000 --> 00:48:49,000

But I think really during the golden age, Earth was ruled by Saturn,

406

00:48:49,000 --> 00:48:58,000

possibly by space being from the planet Saturn, or the Saturn moon.

407

00:48:58,000 --> 00:49:06,000

They were followed by Jupiter, who is identified with the planet Jupiter.

408

00:49:06,000 --> 00:49:15,000

And that age, a silver age, Earth was not quite as present as it was under the previous age.

409

The giants rebelled, there was war between heaven and Earth,

410

00:49:20,000 --> 00:49:24,000

evidence for what we say all over the world of space wars.

411

00:49:24,000 --> 00:49:31,000

There were cataclysms, Berlikowsky mentions that comets struck our Earth.

412

00:49:31,000 --> 00:49:35,000

In fact, apart from possible interplanetary war,

413

00:49:35,000 --> 00:49:43,000

civilizations on our Earth were disrupted, if not destroyed, by cataclysms.

414

00:49:43,000 --> 00:49:49,000

Which are mentioned in a garble form, not only in the Greek legends, but in other legends too.

415

00:49:49,000 --> 00:49:56,000

Now, Greek literature is very fascinating.

416

00:49:56,000 --> 00:50:02,000

We have really some marvellous characters.

417

00:50:02,000 --> 00:50:09,000

Crete, for example, we have marvellous tales about the Minotaur in Invergillus,

418

00:50:09,000 --> 00:50:12,000

who appeared to have been Leonardo da Vinci.

419

00:50:12,000 --> 00:50:21,000

A deadless to escape from the famous Labyrinth on Crete, invented, so we told, invented wings.

420

00:50:21,000 --> 00:50:25,000

He escaped with his son Icarus.

421

00:50:25,000 --> 00:50:31,000

Unfortunately, he hadn't invented the law of gravity.

422

00:50:31,000 --> 00:50:38,000

Unfortunately for Icarus, who went too high in the sky and his wings fell off, and Icarus was killed.

423

00:50:38,000 --> 00:50:54,000

In a lot of the Greek heroes seem to me to bear a market resemblance to the prophets of the Old Testament.

424

00:50:54,000 --> 00:50:57,000

You have one of the great poets, Italides.

425

00:50:57,000 --> 00:51:04,000

He claimed to have gone on a trip to the planets.

426

00:51:04,000 --> 00:51:12,000

He had epimenities, who were without looking for sheep, and ended a cave.

427

00:51:12,000 --> 00:51:18,000

When he came out, about 45 years had elapsed.

428

00:51:18,000 --> 00:51:23,000

In our present UFO context, we would probably might construe that,

429

00:51:23,000 --> 00:51:27,000

it's a being whisked away through another planet.

430

00:51:27,000 --> 00:51:33,000

He returned and was noted as a wonderful teacher.

431

00:51:33,000 --> 00:51:40,000

Aristides, in the third century, was famed for astral travelling,

432

00:51:40,000 --> 00:51:47,000

and also what called as astral journeys.

433

00:51:47,000 --> 00:51:54,000

Pythagoras was taught, as far as we know, by the druid Aboris.

434

00:51:54,000 --> 00:52:05,000

He is credited with journeying to various countries too.

435

00:52:05,000 --> 00:52:14,000

The Greek playwrights also wrote about the gods, as if the gods actually existed.

436

00:52:14,000 --> 00:52:19,000

The Greek playwrights introduced into Greek tragedy,

437

00:52:19,000 --> 00:52:24,000

the deus ex machina, which is that really from God, from the machine.

438

00:52:24,000 --> 00:52:28,000

We think that the deus e fer to the machine is the universe,

The Greeks too, I'll have one or two rather scanty references to spaceships.

447

For example, in 392 BC, during the fall of Sparta,

448

a spaceship was alleged to have been seen overhead.

In 327 BC, Alexander the Great was besieging Tyre,

450

and it is alleged that a fleet of fiery shields descended from the sky

451

and aided Alexander by destroying the walls of Tyre.

452

I'd be glad to answer any questions on Greece,

453

but I would really like to turn to ancient Rome.

454

The Romans, perhaps more than antitrustians,

455

more than any other people of antiquity, worshipped sky gods,

456

00:54:13,000 --> 00:54:21,000

and they devoted, their priests devoted most of their time to studying the sky.

457

The Romans and the Etruscans before them ruled their very lives by prodigies seen in the sky.

458

In about 950 BC, one of the Etruscan kings, Tiberinas,

459

fell into the river Albula in the ground.

460

00:54:44,000 --> 00:54:48,000

The name of the Albula was changed to the river Tiber.

461

00:54:48,000 --> 00:54:56,000

Well, Deocasius tells us that his grandson Amulius, who lived about age 50,

462

00:54:56,000 --> 00:55:01,000

had inherited a wonderful, apparently inherited,

463

00:55:01,000 --> 00:55:04,000

this wonderful electrical science,

464

00:55:04,000 --> 00:55:11,000

and he mastered absolutely marvelous power and could create stupendous damage.

465

Unfortunately, according to Deocasius, he raised an earthquake and destroyed his palace.

466

And himself, when his lake overflowed.

467

Now Romulus, I think, is an absolutely marvelous character.

468

You may recall that the mother of Romulus, Reia Silvia,

469

00:55:36,000 --> 00:55:40,000

was a vestal virgin who was not supposed to marry.

470

00:55:40,000 --> 00:55:45,000

Well, she had twins, Romulus and Remus,

471

00:55:45,000 --> 00:55:51,000

and she said that her father was the god Mars.

472

00:55:51,000 --> 00:56:00,000

Now, Romulus found it wrong, actually, on the 21st of April, 753 BC,

473

00:56:00,000 --> 00:56:04,000

although he didn't know that it was 753 BC

474

00:56:04,000 --> 00:56:10,000

and he didn't know that he was found, I believe, on Shakespeare's birthday.

475

00:56:10,000 --> 00:56:13,000

However, be that as it may.

476

Romulus was a very good thing indeed.

477

As I mentioned to you earlier, in the year 716, he was whisked to heaven on a cloud.

478

Classical histories say the same thing happened to Hercules, to Escalapius,

479

and to a few other heroes too.

480

Now, this seemed a very tall tiered force, of course, to accept.

481

Although, I believe, in the humanoid states that,

482

what, on the 21st of November 1952, in D'Amantina, in Brazil,

483

a Brazilian peasant was actually disappeared in a cloud,

484

00:57:02,000 --> 00:57:10,000

which was emanated from two balls that were left nearby him,

485

00:57:10,000 --> 00:57:14,000

by two humanoids, about 18 inches high.

486

00:57:14,000 --> 00:57:20,000

Now, it seems a bit difficult for us to believe that people actually disappeared in the cloud.

487

00:57:20,000 --> 00:57:26,000

Both this case in Brazil and, I think, one or two others that have happened in the last few years

488

00:57:26,000 --> 00:57:28,000

seemed to support that.

489

00:57:28,000 --> 00:57:32,000

There was no evidence that Romulus was there or was murdered.

490

00:57:32,000 --> 00:57:40,000

Now, a couple of days afterwards, Julius Proculus, a well-known Roman senator,

491

00:57:40,000 --> 00:57:50,000

swore on the most holy of oaths that he had seen Romulus on the road to Rome,

492

00:57:50,000 --> 00:57:56,000

and then Romulus said that Rome would develop into a great city.

493

00:57:56,000 --> 00:58:02,000

Now, it seems, I must say, it seems very trite, and perhaps you just believe it,

494

00:58:02,000 --> 00:58:06,000

friends of mine say, fancy you, fancy you, Roman, believing,

495

00:58:06,000 --> 00:58:08,000

what do you think you believe?

496

00:58:08,000 --> 00:58:09,000

What do you say?

497

00:58:09,000 --> 00:58:15,000

That this man ascended to heaven, and then his mother was a virgin, his father was a god.

498

00:58:15,000 --> 00:58:19,000

He went to heaven, and then he came back from the dead.

499

00:58:19,000 --> 00:58:25,000

But fancy a man of you, a leg, question mark, a leg of intelligence believing it's there like that.

500

You say?

501

00:58:26,000 --> 00:58:36,000

And I say, yes, but 700 years later, didn't the same thing supposed to have happened to a man called Jesus?

502

All that was different, that was different.

503

No, the Romans were just plagiarising the Christians.

504

00:58:43,000 --> 00:58:52,000

Well, and then you say, well, how was it that Livy and other historians wrote about this before the birth of Jesus?

505

So, this to me, I've written rather a tendentious chapter on Jesus, I should be glad to answer questions later on.

506

But you say, we ascribe to Jesus almost the very things that we really know about Romulus.

507

Now, the successor of Romulus, Pneumocompeius, was a remarkable fellow.

508

He was probably about the best emperor that Rome ever had.

509

He was a philosopher king.

510

00:59:26,000 --> 00:59:31,000

The one thing I'd like to mention too before we play for profit,

511

that he was an absolute marvellous man.

512

He said to have married a nymph called Echebria, and he tried to pass a law which would have changed human history.

513

If only he could have passed this law, all our lives would have been different.

514

This wonderful man was a philosopher, and he brought before the Romans sense a law against women who gossip and who meddle in other people's business.

515

And, believe it or not, according to Livy, it is very best to get this law passed, which will change human history.

But, unfortunately, he couldn't.
