Hands down, hands down, and our people who don't believe it,

I should say actually, that it is in slightly in favour of the fact that there are unidentified flying objects about.

is Jampan who looks at eyes and things,

and Kit, of course, is far more famous for writing the Do-M-Watch series for television.

We have got Rex Dutton, who has just published a book about flying saucers,

Right?

Keith Palmer, who is the director of the International Unidentified Flying Object Research Association,

and Keith Robertson, who is the secretary of the Aetherious Society.

Now, which of the Keith's has written the book?

There's a Keith's written the book.

and one must accept that other life forms must exist far more intelligent than our own, which are capable of traveling to Earth, and obviously interested, but find out about it, so I believe very strongly that there must be UFOs.

Dr. Keith, would you say that all the sightings that there are of objects in the sky,

would you say that there is some form of mirage-top reason for them?

Would you think that anything would physically happen?

Because some people have great credibility, like all our pilots and policemen and stuff like that.

There's no doubt, whatever, that very hard-headed people who would have last to want to make tricks of themselves

I'd no doubt, whatever, that sincere and good people of good observational capability

But I'm totally and completely unwilling to believe in the type of explanation offered by some of our panelists tonight.

I'm perfectly happy to believe in anything the evidence shows up.

I'm simply saying that human beings are famous for being by what they honestly think it's observed,

You're asking the question.

Not little green men, no. This is one of the myths that have grown up from people who are skeptical.

The evidence for flying saucers is overwhelming and you can go back for years.

I said 25 years, you can go back thousands of years and find well-authenticated reports of craft visiting this earth right away into antiquity.

Especially since the end of the war, of course, as my friends have already said,

airline pilots, policemen in staffer chair a few weeks ago, goes on and on and on.

In your book about flying saucers, give us a trace of what you feel about them.

Particularly on this point of evidence, if I would like to take up the issue,

Here is my question.
