He said the Air Force man told him that after he'd been on television 200 people came to the Air Force and reported they'd seen this in the air

and before they'd been afraid to report it.

These were all military pilots, military people, airline pilots and so forth.

127

As I say, he was very indignant about the press.

128

He said a lot of people thought that a damsel's photo was a light fixture, but he said that it wasn't.

129

He'd seen one, he'd talked to some people who didn't even know a damsel.

130

He described exactly the same thing that they'd seen hovering over Mount Palomar.

They won't just come down handed to us, we have to make an effort ourselves.

So then when that was over life, I did this as an insert here.

I talked to Van Tassel and joined about tape recording from outer space via light transmission that they had made the night before or that played the night before.

Van Tassel got up and he said he wasn't interested in spaceships, he was interested in the people.

They said to go to Ann Arbor to an old abandoned golf course and he gave him a location.

354

00:24:52,360 --> 00:24:57,360

They said that the message said that personal contact was imperative.

355

00:24:57,360 --> 00:24:59,360

And he was alone when it came through.

356

00:24:59,360 --> 00:25:01,360

But this came through in a 16 meter band.

357

So he went out this isolated place drove up went to a gully.

358

Now it was October 24th, 1944.

359

He was there all Sunday at 1 p.m.

And they wouldn't be contacted and they would be contacted by radio.

And he was there about 15 minutes.

366

And out of the corner of his eyes saw you full coming straight down very fast.

367

And it hovered on top of the hill.

It flipped over once a little bit on its side.

417

The guy that he met had a white coverall.

468

They say it's been imitation H bomb and they'll never let us sort of pure H bomb.

469

The reason that they stopped these two shots, one in Russia, one in the US,

470

00:31:18,360 --> 00:31:22,360

was because they were boarding with being true hydrogen bombs.

471

472
