At approximately five to nine thousand miles an hour.

He was talking with a friend where you work.

And he said to make a ninety degree turn at the speed that we mentioned, five thousand to nine thousand miles.

And your question would be then, if this is possible, as stated,

And there'd be a force of approximately sixteen million G's,

Oh, you'd like to defend about both these? Let's find out.

I have seen on several occasions UFOs making ninety degree turns,

not at the speeds you just mentioned, but I do know that they do the impossible to us, at least.

Dr. Herman Obrinth claims that the reason they could do what they are doing

118

is the fact that they are not only moving themselves through space,

119

but with them, around them, they are surrounding themselves with these atmospheres, whatever you might wish to call them.

In other words, you oftentimes do not even hear them because they're surrounded with...

The best thing I can call it is atmosphere.

Creating their own atmosphere for the better.

Creating their own.

Negate hours.

Negate hours is correct.

Would not then this atmosphere in turn, because it is made up of atoms,

127

would not this atmosphere in turn then be subject to this pressure?

128

This is the idea of the tremendous...

129

This is a function of momentum, not a function of the atmosphere through which the object itself is traversing.

130

And anything, regardless whether it has its own atmospheric pressure or not,

making a right angle turn with relation to a gravitational field,

132

with relation to a linear trajectory, is going to experience tremendous change in momentum

133

Now, however, again, it has been suggested purely on a theoretical basis

And this again, the term field with relation to...

Well, that's probably one of the most abused terms in the entire vernacular of UFO research is field.

And it has been suggested that the force fields that do surround UFOs possibly

141

can produce a cushioning effect on these right angle turns.

I can see a guy going through this, and since the pressure would destroy his atmosphere that he's carrying with him,

143

zooming along, just lost our atmosphere, fellas, go back and pick it up.

144

But I might say this hard, that explosions are by no means unknown in the field of UFOs.

145

And it is entirely possible and conceivable that there are times when they do certain things

146

that, like mentioned just on the phone, that would cause the explosion,

147

Let me check now. Thank you very much for calling. Very good question.

Let's talk now about this flying object that was sighted last night before we run into a livity out of time.

As just a very brief review, this object was seen, of course, in the Ravenna area last night,

153

approximately a little after 7.30, and the Ackerman Beacon Journal had it reported.

KYW carried immediately the report over radio on you.

155

And we're going to place the call now, then I'll go in.

156

You're going to call George Popovich?

157

Use line 4-0 if you will, okay?

158

Okay, yep.

159

00:12:03,000 --> 00:12:05,000

Now, what do you know about this thing that was sighted last night?

160

Well, George Popovich, who by the way is the director of the Acron UFO Research Committee,

161

and a very fine investigator has been for years.

162

Reliable?

163

Very, very reliable.

164

He called me at my home just before I left the station tonight, and I told him to call here.

165

Well, he got the call through before I arrived.

166

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:33,000

But beyond what Bob just mentioned here from the news wires, I couldn't fill you in.

167

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:44,000

I do know that he is perhaps by now, that is, I mean, Bob, George, is perhaps by now at the home of the people who witnessed this.

168

Now, George himself did not see the flight.

169

00:12:46,000 --> 00:12:52,000

I do not believe so, but George, like the rest of us, frequently gets the calls from here, there, and everywhere,

170

and I presume that's what happened in this case.

171

00:12:54,000 --> 00:13:02,000

Incidentally, while we were waiting, might I say that I received an interesting letter from a former Air Force man,

172

and I just spoke with him on the phone a moment ago and asked if he objected to my using his name.

173

So, right.

174

Alan Manek called, wrote me a bit, a short note, and in this, with this note, he has this information that I think is quite interesting.

175

Paul Ziates, of Emory Drive in Cleveland on the evening of December 1st, 1962, about 9.15 p.m.

176

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:38,000

relates this, a group of friends and myself were playing football in the backyards between Angle and Groce Drive.

177

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:42,000

As we were leaving, I saw the ground reflecting a very bright white light.

178

00:13:42,000 --> 00:13:47,000

It looked as if someone had turned on a giant fluorescent light above us.

179

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:52,000

And, certainly, I had a warm sensation, whether it was from the light or a reaction within my body,

180

00:13:52,000 --> 00:13:55,000

when I realized that the light might be extraterrestrial.

181

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:56,000

I do not know.

182

00:13:56,000 --> 00:13:58,000

I turned around to see where the light was coming from.

183

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:00,000

I looked up and saw a bright flash of light.

184

00:14:00,000 --> 00:14:04,000

It looked as if the object was moving across the sky and exploded.

185

From what I could make out, in the very short time, I saw the light.

186

It was moving north to south over the eastern sky.

187

There was no sound whatsoever accompanying the light.

188

After the disappearance of the light, everything got dark again,

189

and there was no trace of any object or debris falling from the light.

190

At the time that this report was made, a very detailed account of it,

191

by the way, has gone to NiCAP in Washington,

192

I received many other statements, and I was watching TV at the time,

193

and the TV was full of snow.

194

It never acted quite that badly, and this was at a NASA man's home.

195

We were watching it.

196

00:14:41,000 --> 00:14:48,000

So this then would seem to lead one to believe that there is something to this particular sighting on December 24th.

197

I have quite a few reports on it.

198

00:14:50,000 --> 00:14:54,000

I hoped at the time to tell them, but time did not permit.

199

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:59,000

Okay, now let me knock another report in the teeth.

200

We have been getting a lot of calls, Earl has, and Bob has, I know,

201

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:08,000

about a report of a sighting over Saskatchewan on the evening of December 24th.

202

00:15:08,000 --> 00:15:11,000

That was a week ago this past Monday.

203

00:15:11,000 --> 00:15:14,000

Now, people said, well, it was done in all seriousness, and I said, yes,

204

00:15:14,000 --> 00:15:19,000

there was a sighting of an unidentified flying object December 24th reported on KYW-TV.

205

00:15:19,000 --> 00:15:23,000

Well, just to set the matter straight, this is true in a way,

206

00:15:23,000 --> 00:15:28,000

but since after so much love at night, and I think most children are in bed,

207

00:15:28,000 --> 00:15:32,000

let's just report that this was not the kind of view that we're concerned with on this program.

208

00:15:32,000 --> 00:15:35,000

The report that Dick Goddard made was a true report.

209

00:15:35,000 --> 00:15:40,000

There was an object over Saskatchewan headed toward the Cleveland area that night,

210

00:15:40,000 --> 00:15:43,000

but it was nothing more than Santa Claus and his reindeer.

211

00:15:43,000 --> 00:15:48,000

And Dick Goddard, in all seriousness, truthfully reported it.

212

00:15:48,000 --> 00:15:53,000

And don't you ever try to tell Dick Goddard that there's not a Santa Claus or an Easter Bunny, for that matter.

213

00:15:53,000 --> 00:15:55,000

All right, now we're going to get this report.

214

00:15:55,000 --> 00:15:56,000

Bob, is it all set up?

215

00:15:56,000 --> 00:16:02,000

Yes, on the line right now, we have Mr. George Popovich, whom we've already introduced a moment ago.

216

00:16:02,000 --> 00:16:07,000

He will introduce the gentleman who made this sighting as we pick up a line for him.

217

00:16:07,000 --> 00:16:08,000

Okay, let me just check on George.

218

00:16:08,000 --> 00:16:09,000

Yes.

219

00:16:09,000 --> 00:16:10,000

This is Mark Morgan.

220

00:16:10,000 --> 00:16:12,000

Just to get this straight, did you see the...

221

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:13,000

No, I'm not.

222

00:16:13,000 --> 00:16:15,000

No, I'm only investigating.

223

00:16:15,000 --> 00:16:17,000

You have the people there ready to talk to you.

224

00:16:17,000 --> 00:16:18,000

Yes, Mr. Carl Rice.

225

00:16:18,000 --> 00:16:19,000

Okay, go ahead.

226

00:16:19,000 --> 00:16:20,000

What's this new thing?

227

00:16:20,000 --> 00:16:22,000

Um, throughout the...

228

00:16:22,000 --> 00:16:26,000

cars, and can I on?

229

00:16:26,000 --> 00:16:27,000

Yes.

230

00:16:27,000 --> 00:16:39,000

Well, I have with me tonight Mr. Carl Rice that he and his wife and two other persons had adhered what I had labeled as a UFO.

231

And this occurred last evening at approximately around 6pm at the Revano, Ohio.

232

00:16:46,000 --> 00:16:52,000

So, I would like to have you talk with Mr. Carl Rice, one of the observers.

233

Hello.

234

00:16:53,000 --> 00:16:54,000

Mr. Rice?

235

00:16:54,000 --> 00:16:55,000

Hello.

236

00:16:55,000 --> 00:16:59,000

Mr. Rice, could you describe in detail just exactly what you saw?

237

00:16:59,000 --> 00:17:01,000

Now, what time was this again, you said?

238

00:17:01,000 --> 00:17:03,000

About 10 minutes and 6.

239

00:17:03,000 --> 00:17:04,000

10 minutes and 6.

240

00:17:04,000 --> 00:17:05,000

What did you see?

241

00:17:05,000 --> 00:17:08,000

Well, I saw bright light and it was still...

242

00:17:08,000 --> 00:17:12,000

the light and the proof light was like a stone, well, one by generation, light bulb.

243

00:17:12,000 --> 00:17:15,000

And it was just still in there.

244

00:17:15,000 --> 00:17:20,000

Just still a minimum going home up to 1pm or so, about a 1.5pm or so.

245

00:17:20,000 --> 00:17:25,000

And then, I was about, I was about 44 and we got closer to it.

246

00:17:25,000 --> 00:17:32,000

It was still still, it was still standing still and then the light went off.

247

00:17:32,000 --> 00:17:37,000

Then the light came back on again, went out again.

248

00:17:37,000 --> 00:17:39,000

How long did this fan still last?

249

00:17:39,000 --> 00:17:43,000

Well, approximately, I'd say about 15 minutes or so.

250
