On this program, Major Donald E. Kehoe, author of *Aliens from Space*, opposes Colonel William

T. Coleman, former publicity chief of the U.S. Air Force.

From the Yorkville Studio Theater in downtown Toronto on the great debate.

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00:00:57,400 --> 00:01:03,360

Resolves that unidentified flying objects from outer space exist.

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00:01:03,360 --> 00:01:05,800

Your Chairman, P. Eberton.

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00:01:05,800 --> 00:01:11,760

Well, almost everybody in this audience thinks that UFOs from outer space exist.

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00:01:11,760 --> 00:01:18,320

The vote is 190 for the affirmative, to 32 for the negative.

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00:01:18,320 --> 00:01:24,200

And are they enough, Major Kehoe, that makes your job the harder one because you have fewer

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00:01:24,200 --> 00:01:25,200

minds to change.

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00:01:25,200 --> 00:01:27,200

And that is the purpose of a debate.

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00:01:27,200 --> 00:01:29,480

It might be harder for another reason.

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00:01:29,480 --> 00:01:30,480

All right.

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00:01:30,480 --> 00:01:32,240

We'll give you four minutes.

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00:01:32,240 --> 00:01:35,520

We'll give your opponent six, and we'll give you two for a bottle, and then we'll go on

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00:01:35,520 --> 00:01:38,400

with the more informal aspects of our program.

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00:01:38,400 --> 00:01:43,000

So would you start the clock please for the affirmative and Major Donald Kehoe?

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00:01:43,000 --> 00:01:53,720

So over 15 years, my honorable opponent has known that UFOs are alien spaceships.

Justice what thought about, he was piloting an Air Force bomber with two crewmen aboard,

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00:01:59,320 --> 00:02:03,640

when a metallic circular craft came swiftly toward them.

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00:02:03,640 --> 00:02:06,880

Now I will have to give Colonel Coleman credit.

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00:02:06,880 --> 00:02:11,880

In spite of possible danger, he went to full power and shot after it, thinking he might

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00:02:11,880 --> 00:02:16,400

get a closer look, but within a few seconds it was out of range.

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00:02:16,400 --> 00:02:21,080

Now this is something which should affect a man quite a bit when he's had such an experience,

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00:02:21,080 --> 00:02:28,200

but it really backfired because he was, sometime after that, appointed one of the leading UFO

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00:02:28,200 --> 00:02:30,240

officers in Air Force headquarters.

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00:02:30,240 --> 00:02:35,480

That means he was assigned to explain away cases, and some of them didn't require much

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00:02:35,480 --> 00:02:37,960

because they were fakes anyway.

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00:02:37,960 --> 00:02:43,280

But back at this, there was other evidence that he learned after he became a UFO officer.

He learned about General Nathan Twining's evaluation.

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00:02:46,840 --> 00:02:50,840

Lieutenant General Nathan Twining is a great figure in World War II.

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00:02:50,880 --> 00:02:58,880

He was then head of the Air Materiel Command, and using almost 100 experts on this command,

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00:02:58,880 --> 00:02:59,880

he evaluated it.

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00:02:59,880 --> 00:03:03,440

The conclusion, the UFOs were real, they were not illusions.

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00:03:03,440 --> 00:03:07,720

The majority of reports described flying discs, apparently metallic.

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00:03:07,720 --> 00:03:13,960

They were flat on the bottom, domed on top, and they gave indications of intelligent control,

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00:03:13,960 --> 00:03:20,240

either direct or remote, by the way they tried to evade approaching aircraft.

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00:03:20,240 --> 00:03:26,640

Now this is of the approach, but he recommended another full-scale scientific evaluation,

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00:03:26,640 --> 00:03:30,240

and the following year these scientists came up with a top secret conclusion.

It was called an Estimated Situation, that the UFOs generally reported, and there were

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00:03:36,200 --> 00:03:38,320

facts that they discarded those.

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00:03:38,320 --> 00:03:43,120

The genuine cases represented interplanetary spaceships.

The chairman of this group, one of the chief of staff to make it available to the public,

General Bannonberg, who was then chief of staff said no, he was afraid it would cause

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00:03:52,040 --> 00:03:53,040

trouble.

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00:03:53,040 --> 00:03:55,040

And there was one more.

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00:03:55,040 --> 00:04:00,160

Major Dewey Fournier, monitor for the entire project as headquarters, came out with a still

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00:04:00,160 --> 00:04:03,640

bigger evaluation after the great flap of 52.

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00:04:03,640 --> 00:04:07,880

Same conclusion, interplanetary spaceships and the public should be told.

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00:04:07,880 --> 00:04:10,920

Now since then there have been many, many developments.

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00:04:10,920 --> 00:04:16,800

The situation has grown worse because over 50% of the people in the United States, and

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00:04:16,800 --> 00:04:22,600

I think in Canada, believe the UFOs are real, and by implication they don't believe the

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00:04:22,600 --> 00:04:23,600

official explanations.

But what makes it more serious is this, there have been a number of serious cases, double

serious.

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00:04:29,560 --> 00:04:36,560

Anyway, one of the worst cases that occurred over Buffalo, Texas, when a brand of airliner,

a Lockheed Electra, was passing over the town of Buffalo, and people on the ground saw a

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00:04:41,680 --> 00:04:45,120

sort of a ready-to-slow, and shortly after that a flash of some kind.

There was a terrific light, and the airliner disintegrated with everyone on board.

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00:04:50,760 --> 00:04:54,880

The vice president of BANF, who investigated this along with the civil air night board,

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00:04:54,880 --> 00:04:58,920

said it was the most horrible crash he'd ever investigated.

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00:04:58,920 --> 00:05:01,560

And he said, the force that caused this came from outside.

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00:05:01,560 --> 00:05:04,280

There was no bomb inside the airliner.

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00:05:04,280 --> 00:05:09,680

So what I have been concerned about is that a sudden evaluation would startle people who

firmly believed the Air Force was telling the truth.

If it all came out at one time, about the secret developments and the many cases, and

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00:05:16,960 --> 00:05:22,800

some of them by top Air Force pilots, who've been sort of ridiculed like other people,

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00:05:22,800 --> 00:05:24,800

it might have a very bad after-effect.

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00:05:24,800 --> 00:05:29,800

And I think the public should be gradually prepared, pressing the statement home.

Thank you, Major Keel.

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00:05:31,800 --> 00:05:32,800

Willow.

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00:05:32,800 --> 00:05:37,800

Thank you.

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00:05:37,800 --> 00:05:42,800

In six minutes for Colonel Coleman and the Negative.

Mr. Chairman, honorable opponent, mystery of man's origin has intrigued him throughout

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00:05:52,720 --> 00:05:54,960

recorded history.

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00:05:54,960 --> 00:06:01,560

He has puzzled and theorized over the question of where, when, and how he began.

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00:06:01,560 --> 00:06:07,120

That man, like a detective arriving at the scene of a crime, at the long, long period

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00:06:07,120 --> 00:06:13,560

following the event, is so put to arrive at conclusions that would stand up in court.

The equal fascination in Wounder today is the question of whether there is life on other

worlds.

I support Dr. Sagan's theory that perhaps in our galaxy there are something on the order

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00:06:25,960 --> 00:06:34,160

of 100,000 to a million planets in this galaxy that perhaps have some form of intelligent

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00:06:34,160 --> 00:06:35,160

life.

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00:06:35,160 --> 00:06:44,680

Moreover, my colleague would have you believe that this intelligent life is in fact in existence

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00:06:44,680 --> 00:06:51,320

and that it has visited the earth, and very recently, perhaps even now.

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00:06:51,320 --> 00:06:57,240

The question we are exploring tonight, do they visit us or do they not?

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00:06:57,240 --> 00:06:59,360

Yes or no?

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00:06:59,360 --> 00:07:04,760

The general public seemed to demand a yes or no answer.

And that is the question I say cannot be answered, yes or no.

In the first place, you can't say no because you can't prove a negative hypothesis.

And that leaves us with only the yes.

It was precisely that attitude of which the United States Air Force approached Project

Blue Book, and for more, that is just the way we pursued our investigations, objectively,

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00:07:30,840 --> 00:07:34,600

systematically, thoroughly, and carefully.

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00:07:34,600 --> 00:07:38,920

Yet with imagination, open minds.

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00:07:38,920 --> 00:07:45,120

During that 20 years, we found no evidence, not an iota, that would prove or tend to prove

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00:07:45,240 --> 00:07:50,680

that manned extraterrestrial vehicles under intelligent control were visiting the planet

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00:07:50,680 --> 00:07:51,680

earth.

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00:07:51,680 --> 00:07:52,680

None.

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00:07:52,680 --> 00:08:00,360

We found so far nothing to indicate any technology beyond our current state of the art or present-day

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00:08:00,360 --> 00:08:01,360

knowledge.

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00:08:01,360 --> 00:08:08,240

The Earth Force was given the responsibility to investigate UFO sightings, and this mission

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00:08:08,240 --> 00:08:09,240

was too foal.

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00:08:09,240 --> 00:08:13,640

And my honorable opponent knows exactly what that mission was.

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00:08:14,160 --> 00:08:18,160

Was the national security being threatened?

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00:08:18,160 --> 00:08:20,160

Air defense.

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00:08:20,160 --> 00:08:22,160

National security threat.

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00:08:22,160 --> 00:08:25,440

Was our national security being threatened?

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00:08:25,440 --> 00:08:26,440

And the second reason?

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00:08:26,440 --> 00:08:33,640

Do whatever possible to preclude technological surprise, whether it be from this planet or

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00:08:33,640 --> 00:08:34,640

some other.

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00:08:34,640 --> 00:08:40,000

Our purpose was not to determine whether life existed elsewhere in the universe, and I might

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00:08:40,040 --> 00:08:45,240

add, contrary to reports, the United States Air Force has never denied the existence of

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00:08:45,240 --> 00:08:48,480

extraterrestrial intelligent life.

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00:08:48,480 --> 00:08:51,400

The question was not in our provenance.

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00:08:51,400 --> 00:08:56,880

We have been, and I have been accused of being less than truthful with the public regarding

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00:08:56,880 --> 00:08:57,880

UFO reports.

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00:08:57,880 --> 00:09:04,040

I can only tell you that the charge is totally denied by the Air Force and by me.

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00:09:04,040 --> 00:09:09,840

After the cessation of the Project Blue Book, we were left with a residue of some 700 cases.

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00:09:10,680 --> 00:09:16,160

This residue, as long as there is one, leaves a problem, and that's what we're discussing

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00:09:16,160 --> 00:09:17,160

tonight.

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00:09:17,160 --> 00:09:22,320

These few hundred cases included a number of puzzling sightings.

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00:09:22,320 --> 00:09:27,360

These are the ones that are once the strangest and the most credible.

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00:09:27,360 --> 00:09:33,200

It was easier, though, to identify high strangeness than high credibility.

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00:09:34,200 --> 00:09:38,080

UFO investigation is very fascinating.

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00:09:38,080 --> 00:09:40,960

It's a fascinating, interesting subject.

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00:09:40,960 --> 00:09:43,960

The problem was often all too slippery.

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00:09:43,960 --> 00:09:49,160

For all the evidence we discovered and all that presented to us out of the thousands

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00:09:49,160 --> 00:09:56,160

of cases, what we found was either originated here on this planet or was of natural origin

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00:09:57,360 --> 00:09:59,320

outside the planet.

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00:09:59,320 --> 00:10:04,760

If we take present knowledge and present technology, we must conclude that we have not received

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00:10:04,760 --> 00:10:09,560

extraterrestrial visitors, at least in recent times.

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00:10:09,560 --> 00:10:12,560

There was no evidence to support the visitation theory.

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00:10:12,560 --> 00:10:19,560

If one was to believe he's being visited, then he has to do it strictly on faith.

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00:10:20,360 --> 00:10:21,840

Thank you.

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00:10:21,840 --> 00:10:23,160

Thank you, Colonel Coleman.

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00:10:23,160 --> 00:10:24,160

Two minutes for a bottle.

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00:10:24,160 --> 00:10:26,160

Start the clock for Major Keel.

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00:10:27,000 --> 00:10:30,960

I was as bad a skeptic as you were, maybe worse, because I went around kidding my

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00:10:30,960 --> 00:10:33,160

pilot friends in the Marine Corps.

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00:10:33,160 --> 00:10:37,480

That was before Admiral Farny, who was then head of Navy Guided Missiles, showed me two

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00:10:37,480 --> 00:10:42,720

hundred or more reports by Navy Marine Corps pilots, carrier pilots, and carrier officers,

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00:10:42,720 --> 00:10:47,400

and some of them were close encounters, daylight, showing exactly what was described by pointing.

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00:10:47,400 --> 00:10:51,720

Incidentally, Colonel, you did not mention the three evaluations.

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00:10:51,720 --> 00:10:52,720

I have one of them.

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00:10:52,720 --> 00:10:53,720

The photos started one of them with me.

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00:10:53,720 --> 00:10:55,960

I'll show it to you later if you haven't seen it.

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00:10:55,960 --> 00:11:00,560

I also saw the 1948 top secret evaluation.

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00:11:00,560 --> 00:11:03,760

You mentioned that one when we met at Cape Kennedy, but anyway, I've seen that in Four

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00:11:03,760 --> 00:11:04,760

and A also.

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00:11:04,760 --> 00:11:07,560

And his was secret and is still being kept as an unfinished document.

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00:11:07,560 --> 00:11:13,560

So I don't know why you evade those particular documents, because those are the belt foundation.

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00:11:13,560 --> 00:11:16,760

Now, in twenty years, you say there's no evidence at all.

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00:11:16,760 --> 00:11:19,360

Well, that's when we get to a general exchange here.

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00:11:19,360 --> 00:11:22,440

I can bring up some cases I would like to have you mention.

You say there were only seven hundred cases.

Dr. Heineck stated there were over three thousand when he left the Air Force that were completely

unexplained.

Nobody ever answered that either.

Now, there are quite a number of serious cases that do come to mind.

The F-89 interceptor had chased an object out over Lake Superior.

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00:11:41,800 --> 00:11:47,200

And with big-triple radar, they saw the plane and the UFO merged on the scope, and then

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00:11:47,200 --> 00:11:48,200

they vanished.

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00:11:48,720 --> 00:11:52,560

There were about five different answers put out on that.

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00:11:52,560 --> 00:11:56,960

Donald Cape Kennedy, when I asked you about that case, and you said the Air Force explanation

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00:11:56,960 --> 00:12:01,720

was that it was a Canadian airliner that got off course.

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00:12:01,720 --> 00:12:05,400

And I said, well, I have copies of many of your letters.

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00:12:05,400 --> 00:12:08,400

In fact, a whole stack of them, original and photocopies.

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00:12:08,400 --> 00:12:13,720

And I said, well, Colonel, we looked into that, and the Canadian Airlines denied completely

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00:12:13,720 --> 00:12:15,240

that they were anywhere near it.

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00:12:15,240 --> 00:12:19,040

And then, shortly after that, you switched to the Royal Canadian Air Force.

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00:12:19,040 --> 00:12:23,920

We contacted the Chief of Staff of the Royal Canadian Air Force, and he denied there was

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00:12:23,920 --> 00:12:26,240

anything to it at all because we had nothing there.

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00:12:26,240 --> 00:12:27,240

Thank you, Major Kehoe.

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00:12:27,240 --> 00:12:29,800

You'll get a chance later to argue with Colonel Coleman.

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00:12:29,800 --> 00:12:33,840

In fact, in a moment, you'll be doing just that in a face-to-face confrontation when

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00:12:33,840 --> 00:12:35,480

we come back from our usual break.

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00:12:35,480 --> 00:12:37,880

We'll see you in a moment.

Some background on our debaters.

Major Donald E. Kehoe is a writer who has been writing about flying saucers for 25 years.

his latest is called Aliens from Space, The Real Story of Unidentified Flying Objects.

He was named national director of the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomenon

some years ago, a position he held until 1970.

Colonel William Coleman has just retired as Chief Public Information Officer of the

He's a former World War II combat pilot with 15 missions.

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00:13:26,960 --> 00:13:32,600

He was recalled for the Korean War and the Air Force and stayed in after that.

He's written two books on the use of animals and medical and space research.

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00:13:36,480 --> 00:13:37,880

He writes science fiction stories.

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00:13:37,880 --> 00:13:40,000

He just finished a screenplay.

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00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:41,000

He's working on a novel.

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00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:44,160

I've got a couple of questions for each of you gentlemen.

You keep talking about top secret documents Major Keough, but you apparently have them

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00:13:48,760 --> 00:13:49,760

all.

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00:13:49,760 --> 00:13:53,920

One in your briefcase and the rest in your hand.

How can they be top secret if you have these answers to them?

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00:13:56,920 --> 00:14:02,680

Well, there is a rule that when the 12 year period is over, documents have to be declassified

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00:14:02,680 --> 00:14:07,160

unless a strong reason is presented that there was a danger of security.

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00:14:07,160 --> 00:14:12,080

A number of these things were released before then to me, but they were stamp declassified.

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00:14:12,080 --> 00:14:16,160

I'm not naming anybody, but I have some very good friends in the Pentagon, including Air

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00:14:16,160 --> 00:14:17,160

Force.

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00:14:17,160 --> 00:14:20,080

Well, how can you say that the US Air Force is hiding something if they're declassifying

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00:14:20,080 --> 00:14:22,720

the very documents that you say they're hiding?

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00:14:22,720 --> 00:14:26,880

The Freedom of Information committee aided by NICAP, the organization you mentioned,

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00:14:26,880 --> 00:14:31,200

kept that there for about a year and we finally got out projects one to twelve, which is an

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00:14:31,200 --> 00:14:35,960

Air Force, a combination of documents and all the sightings in there stamp either secret

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00:14:35,960 --> 00:14:36,960

or confidential.

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00:14:36,960 --> 00:14:39,720

Well, of course, to release them, they had to stamp declassified.

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00:14:39,720 --> 00:14:43,120

All those years, these things were being hidden.

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00:14:43,120 --> 00:14:45,280

I knew some of them, but I couldn't use them.

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00:14:45,280 --> 00:14:49,320

All right, a question or two for you, Colonel Coleman.

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00:14:49,320 --> 00:14:54,600

You did not answer Major Keough's point that General Twining of the Chief of Staff himself

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00:14:54,600 --> 00:15:00,400

after a lengthy investigation, according to your opponent, said that unidentified flying

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00:15:00,400 --> 00:15:01,800

objects were real.

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00:15:01,800 --> 00:15:06,840

Well, this was prior to General Twining becoming Chief of Staff and later Chairman of the Joint

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00:15:06,840 --> 00:15:07,840

Chief of Staff.

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00:15:07,840 --> 00:15:13,920

This was when he was head of the Air Force Logistics Command and the project.

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00:15:13,920 --> 00:15:17,880

Since they handled the R&D or Research and Development functioned the Air Force, he headed

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00:15:17,880 --> 00:15:20,280

that aspect up when he was a Lieutenant General.

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00:15:20,280 --> 00:15:25,320

And yes, this was in the beginning of the project and our first concern, of course, was air

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00:15:25,320 --> 00:15:26,320

defense.

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00:15:26,320 --> 00:15:30,960

Therefore, there was classification early on in the program when it was Project Grudge,

but later as we began to learn more, we began to look at a few thousand cases, things became

Well, now, did Quoting say or did he not say there was this thing as unidentified flying

They're flying objects that are unidentified and remain so.

But he said...

Objects that were circular, metallic, and right on the bottom, dome on top, which is

the typical explanation of Project Sign.

You remember there what they came out with?

Well, Donald, that was 25 years ago now.

And yes, there were a lot of...

And there were mistakes made.

We had the wrong people in the project.

Later on, we were finding...

You were finding the wrong person?

No, no, no.

Wait a minute.

Okay.

And put it in the time.

We hired Dr. Heineck later and brought him into the program as a consultant.

I personally called him and assigned him to certain cases.

Those that were high strangeness, high credibility, we thought, these are the cases that we had

265

Heineck work on.

And we consulted with him.

267

Well, there's another point.

268

As far as the 3,000 cases that he mentioned, there are still 700 some on.

3,000, perhaps, in Heineck's mind.

But that's not an official Air Force point of view.

In December of 69, when the Air Force said that he'd quit everything, closed investigation,

That's not true.

275

We never made such a statement.

276

00:17:05,920 --> 00:17:06,920

It's all over there.

277

00:17:06,920 --> 00:17:11,360

Well, I'll be glad to provide you copies of our official statement, which clearly show

278

00:17:11,360 --> 00:17:14,040

that we have about 730 odd cases.

279

00:17:14,040 --> 00:17:19,200

Well, I'll launch the case now that the Air Force wrote Vice President Humphrey when he

280

00:17:19,200 --> 00:17:22,440

was vice president, and said, now the single unexplained case left.

281

00:17:22,440 --> 00:17:23,440

Same thing to Senator Birch Bay.

282

00:17:23,440 --> 00:17:25,880

And a lot of others got that kind of letter.

283

00:17:25,880 --> 00:17:31,600

Now, somebody in the Department of Legislative Liaison was asleep or something wrong there,

284

00:17:31,600 --> 00:17:34,600

and they're supposed to help Congress and give them the facts.

285

00:17:34,600 --> 00:17:38,320

Colonel, I'm still trying to figure out one thing.

286

00:17:38,320 --> 00:17:42,240

Major Kieh was at you saw, a metallic circular spacecraft.

287

00:17:42,240 --> 00:17:50,360

Yes, I was flying in a Mitchell bomber from South Florida to a base in Mississippi.

288

00:17:50,360 --> 00:17:55,760

About two o'clock on a cloudless Sunday afternoon around two o'clock, I spotted a strange object

289

at what I would guess to be around 20,000 feet and some several miles in front of me

290

00:18:01,480 --> 00:18:03,640

and to the right.

291

00:18:03,640 --> 00:18:06,280

I punched my copilot, and I said, do you see what I see?

And he said, yes, I believe it's a reflection on their windscreen.

293

I said, I don't think so.

294

Start making a turn to the left.

295

00:18:13,120 --> 00:18:14,400

Give me about one needle width.

296

00:18:14,400 --> 00:18:19,280

And of course, the object moved, and I said, well, it's for real.

297

00:18:19,280 --> 00:18:20,960

And we're gaining on it.

298

00:18:20,960 --> 00:18:25,200

That was strange because we were at a lower altitude and a slower machine.

299

00:18:25,200 --> 00:18:31,000

And then the object began to descend in front of us, and so I decided then to give chase.

300

00:18:31,000 --> 00:18:36,400

I did go up to maximum military continuous power, and then we started down.

301

00:18:36,400 --> 00:18:42,920

I was cruising at that time at about 10,000 feet, and we did get very close to it.

302

00:18:42,920 --> 00:18:49,000

And the sighting lasted for several minutes, not a few seconds, and we did gain on it.

303

00:18:49,000 --> 00:18:51,800

And it just didn't change your mind regarding the...

304

No, I saw an object that I could not identify.

305

00:18:55,320 --> 00:18:57,880

I was not then in research and development.

306

00:18:57,880 --> 00:18:59,760

It could have been a test vehicle out of England.

307

00:18:59,760 --> 00:19:02,760

I doubt it, based upon knowledge that I could...

308

00:19:02,760 --> 00:19:04,040

Are you an idea of what it was?

309

00:19:04,040 --> 00:19:09,400

I have no idea, and it disappeared on me, and I had several good observers.

310

00:19:09,400 --> 00:19:13,920

I had representatives of Lockheed Aircraft on board and representatives of the Allison

311

00:19:13,920 --> 00:19:19,920

Indian Division of General Motors, plus my own copilot, who was a flight engineer, and

312

00:19:19,920 --> 00:19:23,120

of course my own enlisted flight engineer.

313

00:19:23,120 --> 00:19:24,640

We had no cameras, unfortunately.

314

00:19:24,640 --> 00:19:29,800

Incidentally, the camera is the best tool to pursue this subject with.

315

00:19:29,800 --> 00:19:34,680

Unless you get some of these people that get on the ground and hang something up on a wire

316

00:19:34,680 --> 00:19:35,680

and take a shot of it.

317

00:19:35,680 --> 00:19:40,680

Well, we have about four rooms full of photographs, like that, and second-builders, light sheds,

318

00:19:40,680 --> 00:19:41,680

and all that.

319

00:19:41,680 --> 00:19:42,680

We have many of them.

320

00:19:42,680 --> 00:19:43,680

You can spot them almost immediately.

321

00:19:43,680 --> 00:19:48,920

All right, but if the camera is the best evidence, what photographic evidence, if any, is there,

322

00:19:48,920 --> 00:19:50,640

but there are objects found in space?

323

00:19:50,640 --> 00:19:55,840

Let's say that's just one aspect of evidence, Mr. Burton.

324

00:19:55,840 --> 00:20:01,440

The camera is a good tool because it's so readily available to everyone.

325

00:20:01,440 --> 00:20:02,680

What about the...

326

00:20:02,680 --> 00:20:04,180

But are there...

327

00:20:04,180 --> 00:20:11,080

Let me ask you if the Air Force examined photographs of so-called flying saucers in other space.

328

00:20:11,080 --> 00:20:15,560

We have two exposures of one unidentified flying object.

329

00:20:15,560 --> 00:20:17,040

We know it's a large object.

330

00:20:17,840 --> 00:20:24,040

It is dense, that is, it has mass, but we are not able to identify it under any known

331

00:20:24,040 --> 00:20:25,040

technology.

332

00:20:25,040 --> 00:20:26,040

McMindle?

333

00:20:26,040 --> 00:20:31,200

But that doesn't mean that it came from Bernard Starr or Alpha Centauri.

334

00:20:31,200 --> 00:20:32,700

We just haven't unidentified objects.

335

00:20:32,700 --> 00:20:38,680

I don't know whether you're referring to the McMindle case, but that was one where an object

336

00:20:38,680 --> 00:20:41,960

was said to have a man's wife, a farm woman's wife named Trent.

337

00:20:41,960 --> 00:20:42,960

This is the Mendel case.

338

00:20:42,960 --> 00:20:43,960

That was what you were talking about?

339

00:20:43,960 --> 00:20:44,960

Yes.

340

00:20:44,960 --> 00:20:45,960

Right.

341

00:20:45,960 --> 00:20:47,480

They kept quiet about for a while.

342

00:20:47,480 --> 00:20:51,600

They got pictures of it, and they showed this typical UFO thing with a sort of a dome

343

00:20:51,600 --> 00:20:52,600

on the top.

344

00:20:52,600 --> 00:20:56,280

When I first saw it, I thought it was one of those phony rigged things.

345

00:20:56,280 --> 00:21:00,120

Later on, several people I knew, including a man in a life magazine and others who went

346

00:21:00,120 --> 00:21:01,600

out there, said, I don't know.

347

00:21:01,600 --> 00:21:03,480

I think there may be something to it.

348

00:21:03,480 --> 00:21:08,320

That is one of the cases that was given to the Colorado University study.

349

00:21:08,320 --> 00:21:15,520

For those of you who don't know, the Air Force paid \$523,000 to the University of Colorado

350

00:21:15,520 --> 00:21:16,520

for it.

351

00:21:16,520 --> 00:21:17,520

\$550,000.

352

00:21:17,520 --> 00:21:18,520

They jumped it up.

353

00:21:18,520 --> 00:21:23,360

They got that without being in the record because they copied the contract I got.

354

00:21:23,360 --> 00:21:26,000

Let's not argue about a mere \$50,000.

355

00:21:26,000 --> 00:21:34,160

Anyway, this thing came in, and there's a scientist there who is an expert photographer.

356

00:21:34,160 --> 00:21:38,400

He went up there and spent about two weeks or more checking at all the angles.

357

00:21:38,400 --> 00:21:44,480

You read his report, it's about nine pages in the Condon document, and he ends up and

358

00:21:44,480 --> 00:21:48,000

said, for all intents and purposes, they saw exactly what they said.

359

00:21:48,000 --> 00:21:50,000

He said, everything measures.

360

00:21:50,000 --> 00:21:53,520

He said, the photogram, the metric analysis and all that was perfect.

361

00:21:53,520 --> 00:21:55,920

That's what it was in.

362

00:21:55,920 --> 00:22:00,600

Now, Condon rushed that thing through because Nixon was coming up, and they thought he was

363

00:22:00,600 --> 00:22:01,600

going to be elected.

364

00:22:01,600 --> 00:22:08,000

Nixon were like that ever since that fight over his being a full communist.

365

00:22:08,000 --> 00:22:11,600

They hurried the thing through so that in case he was elected, that he wouldn't be coming

366

00:22:11,600 --> 00:22:12,600

in stopping it.

367

00:22:12,600 --> 00:22:13,600

Well, I don't wish to participate in the doctor.

368

00:22:13,600 --> 00:22:18,680

I don't want to be in Dr. Condon's background because I'm talking about the fact that he's

369

00:22:18,680 --> 00:22:22,600

dead, Hitler's dead too, but I couldn't detest him less.

370

00:22:22,600 --> 00:22:29,280

Anyway, on this photograph, in the first two sections, which you're all at Condon wrote,

371

00:22:29,280 --> 00:22:33,280

I've been told by people who are on the project, it says in there that this picture is bought

372

00:22:33,280 --> 00:22:37,280

forward, but it was too fuzzy and begged for photogrammetric analysis.

373

00:22:37,280 --> 00:22:42,080

And here's his own specialist out there telling exactly what he did, and it was specific and

374

00:22:42,080 --> 00:22:43,080

short.

375

00:22:43,080 --> 00:22:44,080

I think we'll get off the picture.

376

00:22:44,080 --> 00:22:47,640

I've also seen pictures of Sasquatches and sea serpents.

377

00:22:47,640 --> 00:22:51,680

And what you're seeing, Ninja Keo, is it, am I right?

378

00:22:51,680 --> 00:22:55,080

There's only one picture available that anybody agrees on.

379

00:22:55,080 --> 00:22:57,280

No, there's one other, but it's kind of vague.

380

00:22:57,280 --> 00:22:58,280

There are two.

381

00:22:58,280 --> 00:23:00,280

There's a gun camera, and therefore, it's a gun camera picture.

382

00:23:00,280 --> 00:23:05,280

But you clearly don't face your belief in this on photographs.

383

00:23:05,280 --> 00:23:06,280

No, no, no, no, no.

384

00:23:06,280 --> 00:23:12,280

Only on evidence by reliable people, it was double checked, and there's usually some physical

385

00:23:12,280 --> 00:23:13,280

proof.

386

00:23:13,280 --> 00:23:16,720

Let me say a word just about evidence.

387

00:23:16,720 --> 00:23:22,480

Any good prosecuting attorney will tell you that the best evidence in the world is circumstantial

388

00:23:22,480 --> 00:23:29,240

evidence, provided that the chain of evidence is unbroken.

389

00:23:29,240 --> 00:23:38,360

And throughout all of your reports, Mr. Keoh, I find circumstantial evidence and vague, wide

390

00:23:38,360 --> 00:23:39,520

gaps in it.

391

00:23:39,520 --> 00:23:40,880

You have no evidence.

392

00:23:40,880 --> 00:23:43,720

The Congress asked you to submit to evidence.

393

00:23:43,720 --> 00:23:44,720

You have nothing to submit.

394

00:23:44,720 --> 00:23:45,720

I did submit.

395

00:23:45,720 --> 00:23:48,880

So it has to be done on the basis of faith.

396

00:23:48,880 --> 00:23:50,360

I sent that to the McCormick.

397

00:23:50,360 --> 00:23:53,960

He was there, and he looked at it, and he said that he thought that it was very serious

398

00:23:53,960 --> 00:23:59,840

and strong, and he passed it on and got a special project started, but then the top

399

00:23:59,840 --> 00:24:05,360

man in that committee died and that killed it all.

400

00:24:05,360 --> 00:24:13,800

Now, people are always passing away, just like you and I will someday.

401

00:24:13,800 --> 00:24:16,160

I want to bring up some, you said circumstantial evidence.

402

00:24:16,160 --> 00:24:17,160

I will tell you this.

403

00:24:17,160 --> 00:24:21,360

There have been more people convicted of murder, except lately when nobody gets convicted

404

00:24:21,360 --> 00:24:28,000

of anything, because of evidence that wasn't as strong as some of these UFO cases.

405

00:24:28,000 --> 00:24:30,880

Now, I'll ask you about this one.

406

00:24:30,880 --> 00:24:32,080

Colonel Donald J.M.

407

00:24:32,080 --> 00:24:37,120

Blake'sley, he was the number one Air Corps ace in World War II.

408

00:24:37,120 --> 00:24:38,760

He was also a wing commander.

409

00:24:38,760 --> 00:24:43,080

He was over in Japan, and he was making a routine flight, and he got a call from the

410

00:24:43,080 --> 00:24:49,200

Brown Radar, and they said two, the powers of two other Air Force planes had radiodine

411

00:24:49,200 --> 00:24:50,720

and said there was strange object.

412

00:24:50,720 --> 00:24:56,120

So he climbed up, came onto the clouds, and here was this thing which had rotating beams

413

00:24:56,120 --> 00:24:57,360

of light.

414

00:24:57,360 --> 00:25:00,320

And so he tried to go near it, and it pulled away.

415

00:25:00,320 --> 00:25:06,200

And he started down again, and they called him and said it was back, and gave him the

416

00:25:06,200 --> 00:25:07,200

direction.

417

00:25:07,200 --> 00:25:11,800

And when he walked through that time, he caught off his lights and closed in at full power.

418

00:25:11,800 --> 00:25:14,240

And the thing disappeared in about three seconds.

419

00:25:14,240 --> 00:25:19,480

Now this was an official Air Force report that was declassified out of Wright Pat, sent

420

00:25:19,480 --> 00:25:25,320

by Rupel, was declassified again in Air Force intelligence, and I was given, there's a detailed

421

00:25:25,320 --> 00:25:26,320

report of the whole thing.

422

00:25:26,320 --> 00:25:28,520

Are you familiar with this Colonel Colm?

423

00:25:28,520 --> 00:25:29,520

Just vaguely.

424

00:25:29,520 --> 00:25:35,200

My only comment here that you mentioned pilots, incidentally you credited me with 15 combat

425

00:25:35,200 --> 00:25:36,960

missions, I had 155.

426

00:25:36,960 --> 00:25:37,960

I'm sorry, yes.

427

00:25:37,960 --> 00:25:38,960

I've seen many strange things.

428

00:25:38,960 --> 00:25:47,480

I wouldn't want them to change my records.

429

00:25:47,480 --> 00:25:53,080

And I wouldn't want them to have to go back and make all those up.

430

00:25:53,080 --> 00:25:58,800

Pilots are not experts on astronomical or meteorological phenomena.

431

00:25:58,800 --> 00:26:00,960

I don't care how qualified they are.

432

00:26:00,960 --> 00:26:04,840

I've got 30-some odd college credit hours and meteorology.

433

00:26:04,840 --> 00:26:08,040

I am not an expert on meteorological phenomena.

434

00:26:08,040 --> 00:26:13,000

I know a lot about it, but I haven't seen everything yet.

435

00:26:13,000 --> 00:26:14,000

Same way with astronomy.

436

00:26:14,000 --> 00:26:15,240

I've been an amateur astronomer.

437

00:26:15,240 --> 00:26:19,720

I've been looking through the glass ever since I was a small child.

438

00:26:19,720 --> 00:26:22,000

And yet I have not seen all there is to see.

439

00:26:22,000 --> 00:26:26,960

There's one question I think we've got to hear up before we go to our audience, Colonel

440

00:26:26,960 --> 00:26:27,960

Colm.

441

00:26:27,960 --> 00:26:34,400

Major Keough specifically accused the U.S. Air Force of a cover-up, which if it were

442

00:26:34,400 --> 00:26:38,560

revealed would be a greater cover-up than a Watergate cover-up, a cover-up of enormous

443

00:26:38,560 --> 00:26:39,560

proportions.

444

00:26:39,560 --> 00:26:40,560

And I think...

445

00:26:40,560 --> 00:26:41,560

Well, I'd like to hear how much you would like to hear about it.

446

00:26:41,560 --> 00:26:42,560

I can submit.

447

00:26:42,560 --> 00:26:44,560

I'd give him names and evidence there if you want it.

448

00:26:44,560 --> 00:26:46,720

I mean Air Force people have said it.

449

00:26:46,720 --> 00:26:48,000

We would appreciate the evidence.

450

00:26:48,000 --> 00:26:52,320

We've been asking you for it for years, but all we get is the citing reports.

451

00:26:52,320 --> 00:26:54,040

We want evidence that we can get.

452

00:26:54,040 --> 00:26:55,040

Let me answer the question.

453

00:26:55,040 --> 00:26:57,160

I'm the evidence of the cover-up.

454

00:26:57,160 --> 00:26:58,160

All right.

455

00:26:58,160 --> 00:27:00,080

There is no cover-up.

456

00:27:00,080 --> 00:27:02,080

All of the material is declassified.

457

00:27:02,080 --> 00:27:08,320

It's open to any serious researcher or reporter that cares to go to the Air Force Archives.

458

00:27:08,320 --> 00:27:14,240

We've been isolated blue-book so that we have ready access to it, even though it's located

459

00:27:14,240 --> 00:27:15,800

in a Class B vault.

460

00:27:15,800 --> 00:27:18,200

Now the vault happens to be a building.

461

00:27:18,200 --> 00:27:19,440

We have to house it somewhere.

462

00:27:19,440 --> 00:27:25,360

But the serious researcher can go in there and spend months reading all of the reports

463

00:27:25,360 --> 00:27:27,360

and let him make his own conclusions.

464

00:27:27,360 --> 00:27:32,200

I was the guy that opened up blue-book files to reporters, invited them down there.

465

00:27:32,200 --> 00:27:37,000

I even extended the invitation to you to go out to blue-book and help yourself.

466

00:27:37,000 --> 00:27:38,000

There is nothing classified.

467

00:27:38,000 --> 00:27:42,120

Now they said I couldn't go.

468

00:27:42,120 --> 00:27:43,120

That's not true.

469

00:27:43,120 --> 00:27:46,600

The assistant to the secretary, I've got his letter and he said it's because I said there

470

00:27:46,600 --> 00:27:47,600

was a cover-up I couldn't go to.

471

00:27:47,600 --> 00:27:50,080

I spoke to the secretary because I was the security review authority for the Air Force.

472

00:27:50,080 --> 00:27:51,080

I'll show you.

473

00:27:51,080 --> 00:27:53,840

And I had the authority to grant you in or not grant you in.

474

00:27:53,840 --> 00:27:55,840

Well, it didn't get to you apparently.

475

00:27:55,840 --> 00:27:58,640

You've never been in there?

476

00:27:58,640 --> 00:28:00,640

I haven't been on a right pat in the UFOs.

477

00:28:00,640 --> 00:28:01,640

He says you can go in.

478

00:28:01,640 --> 00:28:02,640

There's one thing that...

479

00:28:02,640 --> 00:28:03,640

I'll just tell Max.

480

00:28:03,640 --> 00:28:06,640

Mr. Barton, there's one thing that he did not answer.

481

00:28:06,640 --> 00:28:09,080

I'd like you to finish that.

482

00:28:09,080 --> 00:28:10,760

I do want to finish one of the points.

483

00:28:10,760 --> 00:28:12,440

I'd like you to finish just the brakes, we said.

484

00:28:12,440 --> 00:28:13,440

Let me finish this.

485

00:28:13,440 --> 00:28:14,440

You didn't...

486

00:28:14,440 --> 00:28:15,440

You couldn't open that.

487

00:28:15,440 --> 00:28:16,440

So I wanted to tell you where we do cover-up.

488

00:28:16,440 --> 00:28:19,240

We've got one minute and then we're going to go to our audience.

489

00:28:19,240 --> 00:28:20,240

One minute for you.

490

00:28:20,240 --> 00:28:21,240

Okay.

491

00:28:21,240 --> 00:28:22,240

I'm going to give you...

492

00:28:22,240 --> 00:28:23,240

I've got a man.

493

00:28:23,240 --> 00:28:24,760

This will take less than that.

494

00:28:24,760 --> 00:28:25,760

Good.

495

00:28:25,760 --> 00:28:28,760

We've developed certain aircraft which we had to keep undercover.

496

00:28:28,760 --> 00:28:33,960

And I'll give you a very recent example, the A11 SR-71, that our craft was developed totally

497

00:28:33,960 --> 00:28:34,960

in secrecy.

498

00:28:34,960 --> 00:28:38,000

Yes, it flew and it was spotted by people.

499

00:28:38,000 --> 00:28:40,920

We knew who they were that saw it because they reported it.

500

00:28:40,920 --> 00:28:44,000

We immediately debriefed them and had them sign a little paper.

501

00:28:44,000 --> 00:28:45,000

Saying it's not flying through.

502

00:28:45,000 --> 00:28:48,400

And that was for a good reason because we jumped out technologically wise.

503

00:28:48,400 --> 00:28:49,400

They go ahead of the Soviets.

504

00:28:49,400 --> 00:28:50,400

All right.

505

00:28:50,400 --> 00:28:51,400

You've got your 10 seconds.

506

00:28:51,400 --> 00:28:52,400

Or even a minute.

507

00:28:52,400 --> 00:28:53,400

It makes you feel to be fair.

508

00:28:53,400 --> 00:28:58,480

You innovated that Commander Colonel Blakshley, who had all that backing, was a number one

509

00:28:58,480 --> 00:29:01,320

World War II ace, was not competent.

510

00:29:01,320 --> 00:29:06,200

The official answer to his sighting when I made it public was that he was looking at

511

00:29:06,200 --> 00:29:07,200

the planet Jupiter.

512

00:29:07,200 --> 00:29:12,760

Now that night, the planet Jupiter, and I checked this with the government, was 366 million

513

00:29:12,760 --> 00:29:13,760

miles from the Earth.

514

00:29:13,760 --> 00:29:18,800

The radar that was reporting this object had a range of less than 500 miles.

515

00:29:18,800 --> 00:29:23,520

Blakshley, this top ace, a great man, and terrific, was really cool.

516

00:29:23,520 --> 00:29:27,320

And he got so annoyed at it, that he said some things about the people in the Air Force

517

00:29:27,320 --> 00:29:28,560

that I don't think you could hear.

518

00:29:28,560 --> 00:29:31,000

I don't think he was talking about you, because you weren't up there.

519

00:29:31,000 --> 00:29:32,520

We will not repeat them in this program.

520

00:29:32,520 --> 00:29:37,120

I'm trying to get our audience into the show because there's a lot of people out there

521

00:29:37,120 --> 00:29:38,120

who want to ask questions.

522

00:29:38,120 --> 00:29:40,280

And we're going to give them a chance to do that in a moment.

523

00:29:40,280 --> 00:29:42,520

We'll take a break and then be back with the great debates.

524

00:29:42,520 --> 00:29:44,320

Okay, gentlemen, down the corner here.

525

00:29:44,320 --> 00:29:45,320

Would you stand up, sir?

526

00:29:45,320 --> 00:29:46,320

Yes.

527

00:29:46,320 --> 00:30:07,800

Well, there was something at Crownsville, Maryland in 1957, which was supposed to fall

528

00:30:07,800 --> 00:30:12,800

into the state hospital grounds after an object was seen to explode nearby.

529

00:30:12,800 --> 00:30:18,920

Army intelligence came in and corded off the area, and they got this object and put

530

00:30:18,920 --> 00:30:24,200

it into a sometimes kind of container, and kept taking Geiger counter checks on it.

531

00:30:24,200 --> 00:30:26,720

And this was sent out to the right-person Air Force base.

532

00:30:26,720 --> 00:30:29,200

First they denied the head.

533

00:30:29,200 --> 00:30:31,600

Then they said that when they opened the container, the thing had evaporated.

534

00:30:31,600 --> 00:30:33,240

It was not even dust left.

535

00:30:33,240 --> 00:30:36,400

That was, in one case, it was proof of the head or something, but it didn't turn out

536

00:30:36,400 --> 00:30:37,400

to be any help.

537

00:30:37,400 --> 00:30:43,480

Then there's a story about the trash UFOs way down in the southwest and the small

538

00:30:43,480 --> 00:30:44,480

beings that were deep frozen.

539

00:30:44,480 --> 00:30:46,920

As far as I'm concerned, you can write that off.

540

00:30:46,920 --> 00:30:50,120

I investigated that for two magazines years and years ago.

541
