Tonight, I'm particularly anxious to talk to Betty and Barney Hill, but before we do,

16

I just wanted to tell you that the introduction to the book, *The Interrupted Journey*, is written,

as I think I mentioned, by Benjamin Simon.

The reason for writing the introduction was to give the reader the documentation and the

I think it's very important to realize that this is not a story that has come from a person

It rather comes not only from them, but it is documented as told to their psychiatrist

under the influence of hypnosis.

Hypnosis was the method of treatment, a time being of the essence that Dr. Simon chose to

So, the story has been reconstructed in a factor parts of it have through bonnive, if not

a treatment by, a distinguished Boston psychiatrist.

I could read to you the entire excerpt from the 1966-67, Who's Who in the East, 10th edition.

Suffice to say that he is a distinguished, respected psychiatrist.

All right, now let's talk to Betty and Barney Hill, who are now on the telephone in Portsmouth,

Hello, which one have I got on the line or have I got your phone?

Oh, how wonderful.

You both met by means of telephone at least, Mr. Earl Netties with us tonight too.

Good to hear your voice again.

Now, before we get started, and I know you've told this story time and time again and told

49

it fascinatingly, I'm going to express my gratitude to you in advance.

Both of you, Betty and Barney, for consenting to be on with us tonight.

Now, as I understand it, we have to go back to 1961 to start this whole incident, don't

53

we?

Yes, that's right.

September 19, 1961.

56

That's when whatever happened happened.

Yes.

Where were you then, Barney?

59

Well, Betty and I were returning from a vacation trip in Canada, and we had left Montreal,

60

Canada, arrived in New Hampshire across the Canadian, American Canadian border about 9.30,

61

close to 9.30 o'clock p.m. and we stopped in a small town, border town called Coldbroke,

62

New Hampshire, and we had a refreshment with coffee and hamburgers, and we left approximately

63

10 o'clock shortly after 10.

When we were traveling south on Route 3, arrived in an area called Lancaster, New Hampshire,

Betty called my attention to an object or a star that she had been watching because

she had noticed it, and she called my attention to it, but she could better tell what she had

Betty, what was it you saw?

Well, I saw the writing of one in the Lancaster area.

70

First of all, it was a beautiful night.

71

It was a harvest moon, and it was quite bright.

72

And right out in the lower, black-and-corner of the moon was a large star which I learned

later was the planet Cupidus, and suddenly there appeared above this star a much larger

74

star, which I said not then later, and then suddenly I saw it.

75

And as I was watching, this star seemed to be getting larger and brighter, and as we

76

wrote along, I kept watching it, and then all of a sudden I noticed that it had started

to move, and it was at this time that I got really caught by an attention to it, and we

78

decided to stop, get out of the car with the binoculars, and take a look at it.

At this time, we thought it was a satellite, so we did get out of the car, and we had

seven, five, or five, I forgot now, the size of the binoculars.

And so we took turns watching this object, and it went across the face of the moon, and

made a half turn, and started to come in towards our car.

And when it started coming towards us, this was when we returned to the car, and Barney

85

00:05:57,440 --> 00:06:02,440

made the comment that he had seen us, and was coming towards us.

86

00:06:02,440 --> 00:06:04,440

We got in the car, and we started driving.

87

00:06:04,440 --> 00:06:10,440

How did you feel then, Barney, if you had seen you, and was coming toward you?

88

00:06:10,440 --> 00:06:16,440

Well, Alan, I think that remark would have been made, because after Betty had called my

89

00:06:16,440 --> 00:06:22,440

attention to this, and the star that was in the sky moving, my remark to her was that it

90

00:06:22,440 --> 00:06:24,440

was obviously a satellite.

91

00:06:24,440 --> 00:06:34,440

Prior to 1961, I was totally closed-minded about flying saucers or UFOs, so that this

92

would have been a natural explanation for something distant, quite a distant out-moving.

93

The reason I said that it had now seen us, and was coming towards us, is because as rapidly

94

from a star-like position, which means it was quite a distance away, it now had come in rapidly

95

to where it would have been close to, what I mean by close is that now it is something

96

00:07:00,440 --> 00:07:05,440

that you can see in the sky, like a light, with the sky in the background, you might say.

97

00:07:05,440 --> 00:07:08,440

Would you say that it was just an off-and-rear-move you were fighting at that moment?

98

00:07:08,440 --> 00:07:14,440

Well, I became frightened, only because I then said, well, Betty, it is a probability,

99

00:07:14,440 --> 00:07:20,440

it is a commercial airline, or going to Canada, because it was traveling north when we initially

100

00:07:20,440 --> 00:07:28,440

saw it, and I said, well, it's probably a commercial plane on its way north somewhere.

101

00:07:28,440 --> 00:07:36,440

And it made this peculiar turn that Betty described, where it turned toward Vermont, which is west

102

00:07:36,440 --> 00:07:42,440

of New Hampshire, and completing the turn started coming in toward where we were parked

103

00:07:42,440 --> 00:07:47,440

on the highway, coming in towards us. Now we are in the mountainous areas, you have to understand that too.

104

So I became quite alarmed, and this was dark at night, I thought of bears, informally from a city,

105

and I kept thinking, well, what if bears came out of the woods there?

106

This has been quite the frightening to me as well, so that I said, Betty, it has seen us,

107

00:08:05,440 --> 00:08:11,440

and we returned to the car and began traveling on route 3, traveling south.

108

00:08:11,440 --> 00:08:19,440

Now, Betty would occasionally call my attention to the object, I would slow down, and sometimes I would make a complete stop,

109

00:08:19,440 --> 00:08:25,440

because the object was now following, going along in the same direction we were going.

110

00:08:25,440 --> 00:08:34,440

That is, the way it had been traveling north, it had now began traveling south, the direction we are traveling.

111

So that it was off on the passenger side of the car, and we would occasionally stop,

112

00:08:39,440 --> 00:08:49,440

and I kept thinking, if one has ever been in open areas at night, you can see millions of stars,

113

00:08:49,440 --> 00:08:57,440

much more prominent in the sky than you can in the city, so that on occasion when you are driving along at night,

114

00:08:57,440 --> 00:09:03,440

you can notice that a star seems to be moving along with the car motion,

115

00:09:03,440 --> 00:09:09,440

and I kept thinking, well, maybe this is what is happening, so I would stop the car and the object was still moving,

116

00:09:09,440 --> 00:09:17,440

and this was peculiar too, because it was still moving, so I obviously had to rule out that it was a star,

117

00:09:17,440 --> 00:09:20,440

and it is following us to the south.

118

00:09:20,440 --> 00:09:26,440

Well, we arrived at an area called Franconian Notch, and there is Cannon Mountain there,

119

00:09:26,440 --> 00:09:30,440

there is a tramway that goes up to the mountain that one can ride,

120

00:09:30,440 --> 00:09:37,440

going to some of the mountains top, and the object went around the west side of the mountain,

121

00:09:37,440 --> 00:09:42,440

which would have been the Burmock, while we were in New Hampshire, but it would have been on that side,

122

00:09:42,440 --> 00:09:49,440

while the road itself at the base of the mountain travels around on the left side,

123

00:09:49,440 --> 00:09:54,440

and then traveling around on the left side at the base of this mountain, Cannon Mountain,

124

00:09:54,440 --> 00:10:02,440

the object when we came out south of Cannon Mountain, there is a natural rock formation called Oman of the Mountain.

125

00:10:02,440 --> 00:10:06,440

It is actually a landmark marking New Hampshire,

126

00:10:06,440 --> 00:10:20,440

but we use it in many of the government brochures that is telling of sites and things to see, one-one visiting New Hampshire.

127

00:10:20,440 --> 00:10:28,440

So this is something that everyone is quite proud about, is this natural rock formation that looks like the face of a person, a profile.

128

00:10:28,440 --> 00:10:39,440

So the object was now front, it might be, in the front of us, and I came to another stop, and I looked, and I could see it,

129

00:10:39,440 --> 00:10:41,440

it was still off at a distance.

130

00:10:41,440 --> 00:10:43,440

What did it look like to you now?

131

00:10:43,440 --> 00:10:48,440

Well, from this point, it looked like, in all respects, a probability, it looked like,

132

00:10:48,440 --> 00:10:59,440

and then I thought it was a piper club, because I thought that a fast-moving commercial plane couldn't travel that slow,

133

00:10:59,440 --> 00:11:06,440

so it must have been a piper cub, and this is what I told Betty, there is nothing to get a lot about, it's a piper cub.

134

00:11:06,440 --> 00:11:13,440

But I was getting quite frightened because of this, and I thought it must have been a military pilot,

135

00:11:13,440 --> 00:11:22,440

and they could obviously see us on the ground with the lights of the car on, and I thought they were playing a game which was out there.

136

00:11:22,440 --> 00:11:30,440

And when we arrived south of Indian Head, I used Indian Head as a landmark, but it's just a little south of Indian Head,

137

00:11:30,440 --> 00:11:37,440

Betty again called my attention to this, and she was very excited, she said, I stopped the game, because I was telling Betty that,

138

00:11:37,440 --> 00:11:44,440

well now we have to get on to a part of this, if we can't bother ourselves with this, whatever it is out there,

139

00:11:44,440 --> 00:11:54,440

and as I'd said previously, military pilots, piper, car, commercial airline, I kept putting it all in this kind of natural explanation.

140

00:11:54,440 --> 00:12:02,440

So she called my attention again, and I stopped the car, and now the object has descended to about 250 feet.

141

00:12:02,440 --> 00:12:14,440

It was on the passenger side of the car, not directly to the right, but in an oblique, more to the right headlight on that kind of an angle.

142

00:12:14,440 --> 00:12:21,440

I looked through the windshield, and I could see that, as I said, that it has descended to about 200 feet, I estimate this,

143

00:12:21,440 --> 00:12:28,440

and I am not good at that, I am not good at estimating distance, but it was much closer.

144

00:12:28,440 --> 00:12:39,440

I became determined then that I was going to find out what this is, it had to have some natural explanation, and this is as simple as that.

145

00:12:39,440 --> 00:12:47,440

I got out of the car, took the binoculars from where they were sitting, on the seat between Betty and I,

146

00:12:47,440 --> 00:12:57,440

I stepped away from the car, and along the whole the object then shifted across from the passenger side, over the highway,

147

00:12:57,440 --> 00:13:08,440

over the field, which brought it over on the driver's side of the car now, also in, you might say, an oblique position from the car position,

148

00:13:08,440 --> 00:13:16,440

that way, not exactly to the passenger side of the car, but more front at an angle.

149

00:13:16,440 --> 00:13:26,440

And I began walking away, I began walking away from the car, across the highway, walked into the field, and I walked quite a distance,

150

00:13:26,440 --> 00:13:35,440

and I then, I mean, looking at it with the binoculars, and I can't believe what I am seeing, because now we have to understand that this is all,

151

00:13:35,440 --> 00:13:46,440

and have always been in the conscious memory. I can't believe what I am seeing, because with the binoculars I can discern what I call a figure's moving about,

152

00:13:46,440 --> 00:13:56,440

at a huge plate glass that seems to curve around, and this was so baffling because I kept thinking,

there's nothing, I can't believe it's flying off as UFOs,

153

00:13:56,440 --> 00:14:07,440

and this is just incredible, and I wanted to hear a sound, a noise of some kind of motor that would cause this thing to be able to be hovering there in a stationary position.

154

00:14:07,440 --> 00:14:17,440

I failed to mention that when I made this stop, this particular stop, Betty also had seen two red lights on the side of the craft,

155

00:14:17,440 --> 00:14:21,440

and I, when I stepped from the car, could see the same two red lights.

156

00:14:21,440 --> 00:14:32,440

Now, after it had shifted across the highway, these figures that were looking seemingly down toward me, because the object was tilted at a downward motion,

157

00:14:32,440 --> 00:14:38,440

plate glass, this huge glass was tilted toward the ground, you might say, at a slight angle.

158

00:14:38,440 --> 00:14:41,440

At an angle that would have enabled the occupants to look down.

159

00:14:41,440 --> 00:14:50,440

Yes, that's correct. I could see, well, I said that all the figures then, it would seem with the exception of one,

160

00:14:50,440 --> 00:14:56,440

moved away as if to take just one, no more than two steps from the plate glass,

161

00:14:56,440 --> 00:15:02,440

and I could see with the binoculars what I thought were going out, touching or pulling on the papers.

162

00:15:02,440 --> 00:15:05,440

The lack of a better thing to say, I called them levers.

163

00:15:05,440 --> 00:15:06,440

Yes.

164

00:15:06,440 --> 00:15:12,440

The two red lights that were now part of the craft began to move out and away,

165

00:15:12,440 --> 00:15:18,440

becoming the extension of a fan or fan-like type wing.

166

00:15:18,440 --> 00:15:19,440

Yes.

167

00:15:19,440 --> 00:15:28,440

The long wings that you find on planes thought more of a thin-like kind of wing,

168

00:15:28,440 --> 00:15:35,440

and the two red lights would have been the attitude of this, that became the extension of these wings.

169

00:15:35,440 --> 00:15:44,440

And I was just completely baffled by the entire experience Danny has seen this incredible thing.

170

00:15:44,440 --> 00:15:49,440

And I pulled the binoculars away from my eyes, dashing back to the car, screaming to Betty,

171

00:15:49,440 --> 00:15:52,440

oh my God, I said, Betty, there is going to capture it.

172

00:15:52,440 --> 00:15:58,440

I entered the car, put it into gear, and I thought I could see as I passed,

173

00:15:58,440 --> 00:16:03,440

as I mentioned it was in an oblique position towards the front, left front of the car,

174

00:16:03,440 --> 00:16:04,440

you follow my question?

175

00:16:04,440 --> 00:16:05,440

Yes.

176

00:16:05,440 --> 00:16:10,440

So that when I began driving down the highway, the object I thought shifted overhead,

177

00:16:10,440 --> 00:16:14,440

and there was a series of beeps, and Betty was saying, I don't see it, I don't say it.

178

00:16:14,440 --> 00:16:20,440

There was a series of beeps, beep, beep, beep, beep, beep, and the car vibrated very subtly.

179

00:16:20,440 --> 00:16:21,440

Yes.

180

00:16:21,440 --> 00:16:26,440

And could you sense where those beeps, if there was a vibration, where the vibration was coming from?

181

00:16:26,440 --> 00:16:32,440

I felt it with my hands on the steering wheel, I felt it tingling on the steering column.

182

00:16:32,440 --> 00:16:39,440

Betty has mentioned that, but she hasn't mentioned it yet, but she has told me that she reached itself to dash panel,

183

00:16:39,440 --> 00:16:44,440

and we all wondered, where is this subtle vibration coming from?

184

00:16:44,440 --> 00:16:46,440

It was not a violent vibration.

185

00:16:46,440 --> 00:16:47,440

Yes.

186

00:16:47,440 --> 00:16:55,440

The vibration was much, the description I have given is like a tuning fork being struck in place against one's arm.

187

00:16:55,440 --> 00:16:56,440

Yes.

188

00:16:56,440 --> 00:17:01,440

And that's just a subtle vibration, just the way the car vibrated from the beeping sound that we heard.

189

00:17:01,440 --> 00:17:04,440

And the vibration seemed to coordinate with the beeping sound.

190

00:17:04,440 --> 00:17:05,440

Yes, it beeps, yes.

191

00:17:05,440 --> 00:17:14,440

All right, now I would stop you with this point in your story, Barney, and Barney Hill is recounting, ladies and gentlemen, this story from his conscious memory.

192

00:17:14,440 --> 00:17:18,440

It is most important to realize that there was a lapse.

193

00:17:18,440 --> 00:17:25,440

What you're going to hear next in the story is a reconstructed version.

194

00:17:25,440 --> 00:17:34,440

It took some years for Barney and for Betty Hill to find out what happened after they first heard the beeping sound

195

00:17:34,440 --> 00:17:37,440

and felt the vibrations inside the car.

196

00:17:37,440 --> 00:17:44,440

But I would like to pause for just a moment, if I may, and render a commercial.

197

00:17:44,440 --> 00:17:52,440

And then we'll get back to the story that we're listening to from Betty and Barney Hill speaking to us from Portsmouth, New Hampshire tonight.

198

00:17:52,440 --> 00:18:11,440

And we will go aboard that unidentified flying object with Mr. and Mrs. Hill in a moment.

199

00:18:11,440 --> 00:18:15,440

And so will Earl Neff, our guest here in the studio tonight.

200

00:18:15,440 --> 00:18:21,440

We're talking Earl Neff of Cleveland and I with Betty and Barney Hill.

201

00:18:21,440 --> 00:18:27,440

And Betty and Barney live and are speaking to us tonight from their residence in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

202

00:18:27,440 --> 00:18:36,440

And we left them on Route 3 heading south and feeling a strange vibration in the car coordinated with beeps.

203

00:18:36,440 --> 00:18:40,440

And now let's get back to Barney and Betty.

204

00:18:40,440 --> 00:18:49,440

Before we go on with the story, Betty, you were alone in the car with the dog while Barney ran out in the field with the binoculars.

205

00:18:49,440 --> 00:18:55,440

Now what did you see from the car and how did you feel then while Barney was off in the field?

206

00:18:55,440 --> 00:19:04,440

Well, my first thought was, well, let me say, principal, I had had no fear whatsoever at this point.

207

00:19:04,440 --> 00:19:10,440

I was fascinated by this and I had a great deal of curiosity.

208

00:19:10,440 --> 00:19:17,440

When Barney stopped the car, he stopped at right directly in the middle of the highway.

209

00:19:17,440 --> 00:19:27,440

And so when he went out into the field, I was being in the car and I was watching in case of traffic any car coming along.

210

00:19:27,440 --> 00:19:33,440

Then I would drive the car over to the side of the highway.

211

00:19:33,440 --> 00:19:40,440

So I was sitting there waiting for him and I kept waiting and waiting and waiting.

212

00:19:40,440 --> 00:19:47,440

And he didn't come back. And at this point, I began to get quite upset.

213

00:19:47,440 --> 00:20:00,440

And I found out later under the hypnosis that I became so upset I was almost speaking for him to come back to the car.

214

00:20:00,440 --> 00:20:06,440

And if he did not hurry up and come back, I was going to go out and get him myself.

215

00:20:06,440 --> 00:20:12,440

And I then opened the door open on the side.

216

00:20:12,440 --> 00:20:18,440

And I started to open it more and I was going to slide out and go out into the field after Barney.

217

00:20:18,440 --> 00:20:22,440

When I heard him running back to the car.

218

00:20:22,440 --> 00:20:30,440

And then this is when he got into the car and said that they were going to capture us.

219

00:20:30,440 --> 00:20:37,440

And he would start up a tent. He was not hysterical. He was very upset.

220

00:20:37,440 --> 00:20:41,440

And he immediately started driving the car.

221

00:20:41,440 --> 00:20:44,440

You know, those were trying to escape.

222

00:20:44,440 --> 00:20:49,440

And he was also telling me to look out and see if I could see them.

And I was touching the metal because I kept seeing a little bit of some kind of some kind of electrical.

229

And possibly there would be electricity. Maybe a sight to feel is shocked.

230

From the metal of the car.

231

00:21:24,440 --> 00:21:30,440

Now at this point, this is a critical point in the story.

232

00:21:30,440 --> 00:21:33,440

It is typical to know quite where to go from here.

233

Because this is the point of the story at which you later realized that there were two hours missing in time.

234

And I think perhaps what we best do is follow you along home in your conscious memory to the point where you got home.

235

And then reconstruct the story as it actually happened to you.

236

And we'll do that in a moment.

237

After I pause to remind our audience that we're talking with Barney and Betty Hill tonight.

238

00:21:59,440 --> 00:22:02,440

They are the subjects of the book *The Interrupted Journey*.

239

00:22:02,440 --> 00:22:08,440

Two hours, two lost hours aboard a flying saucer by John G. Fuller.

240

00:22:08,440 --> 00:22:10,440

It is now available. It's published by Dyle.

241

00:22:10,440 --> 00:22:15,440

And if you are a ufologist, I strongly urge that you get this book.

242

00:22:15,440 --> 00:22:25,440

I think that this incident goes down as probably the best documented sighting of an unedited by flying object.

243

00:22:25,440 --> 00:22:32,440

And confrontation with creatures in an object in the history of UFOs.

244

00:22:32,440 --> 00:22:34,440

Now Betty and Barney will be with us.

245

00:22:34,440 --> 00:22:36,440

And so will Earl Ness.

246

00:22:36,440 --> 00:22:43,440

I feel impelled only through earthbound egoistic urges to remind you that my name is Alan Butters.

247

00:22:43,440 --> 00:22:48,440

Now let's get back to the story that Betty and Barney are telling us.

248

00:22:48,440 --> 00:22:52,440

You proceeded onward then toward Portsmouth.

249

00:22:52,440 --> 00:22:57,440

From the time you first heard those beats and felt the vibrations,

250

00:22:57,440 --> 00:23:04,440

was there any leg in time, in your conscious memory, to the second time you heard them?

251

00:23:04,440 --> 00:23:13,440

No, I would say that it was only later that we realized that this pot was sort of missing.

252

00:23:13,440 --> 00:23:15,440

May I say this?

253

00:23:15,440 --> 00:23:16,440

Yes, please.

254

00:23:16,440 --> 00:23:25,440

And Betty, that later we also described another time when we heard these series of beat.

255

00:23:25,440 --> 00:23:32,440

And Betty, as remarked to me, was, well now Barney, do you believe in flying saucers?

256

00:23:32,440 --> 00:23:35,440

And I said, of course not. Betty, don't be ridiculous.

257

00:23:35,440 --> 00:23:41,440

This would have been in the primate actual infection of New Hampshire on Route 3.

258

00:23:41,440 --> 00:23:44,440

This incidentally has always been the position that you had taken.

259

00:23:44,440 --> 00:23:48,440

Yes. And we then proceeded on to Portsmouth.

260

00:23:48,440 --> 00:23:54,440

We occasionally, we didn't stop after this, but we would occasionally look at the guy with,

261

00:23:54,440 --> 00:23:58,440

we would slow down very, to a slow pace occasionally.

262

00:23:58,440 --> 00:24:02,440

And we drove to Portsmouth.

263

00:24:02,440 --> 00:24:08,440

There wasn't much conversation between us from that point after the second beat to Portsmouth,

264

00:24:08,440 --> 00:24:14,440

except that when we arrived in the city of Portsmouth, it was dawn,

265

00:24:14,440 --> 00:24:23,440

well it was daybreak and the sun was coming up, it was not night any longer.

266

00:24:23,440 --> 00:24:30,440

Now this is the trip, it's approximately 170 miles from Colbrook and Hampshire to Portsmouth.

267

00:24:30,440 --> 00:24:33,440

And the speed of the highway is 50 miles an hour.

268

00:24:33,440 --> 00:24:40,440

We don't know that it should have taken us, oh I should say, at least 3 to 4 hours to get home.

269

00:24:40,440 --> 00:24:42,440

It would have led you home about midnight.

270

00:24:42,440 --> 00:24:46,440

Yes, well no, we left Colbrook at 10 o'clock.

271

00:24:46,440 --> 00:24:49,440

We should have arrived, I would say around 2 o'clock in the morning.

272

00:24:49,440 --> 00:24:50,440

2 a.m.

273

00:24:50,440 --> 00:24:56,440

Yes, but when we arrived it was after 4, closer to 5, when we arrived in Portsmouth.

274

00:24:56,440 --> 00:25:03,440

But it was very determined that I would not bring the car refrigerator we had with food in it,

275

00:25:03,440 --> 00:25:09,440

fresh food that is, that I would not bring it into the house, that I would carry it around to the back soup

276

00:25:09,440 --> 00:25:14,440

and place it there because she wanted to discard all this food and I wondered why

277

00:25:14,440 --> 00:25:18,440

and she just thought that she didn't want it in the house and we shouldn't eat it.

278

00:25:18,440 --> 00:25:25,440

We entered the home and we felt unclean, more than just the accumulation of dirt and grime,

279

00:25:25,440 --> 00:25:32,440

one would get from a trip, but we felt foiled, and there was foiled a kind of uncleanliness.

280

And I went into the bathroom, took a mirror and examined my body for no reason.

281

I wasn't looking for anything, but I just felt as if something had touched me and I wasn't sure what it was

282

and I wanted to look around and see and I didn't see or find anything.

283

Well, this is basically what would have happened. Betty and I retired then and we awakened several hours later in the late afternoon.

284

We vowed we would never tell anyone about this and we decided that we would draw a picture of what we thought this thing looked like

and compare our drawings. So Betty went into one room and I, the other, we drew our pictures, we brought them together

and we looked at them and there was the similarity of the structure of what we were trying to draw.

So our drawing techniques were basically, oh, we're not odors by the stretch of the imagination, but there was the similarity.

Well, Betty then called her sister. We weren't going to tell anyone, you know.

She called her sister and told her sister about it and also remarked about the beep because she was very upset about this

290

and her sister called back a few minutes later telling us that she had talked with her sister's friend of hers

291

00:26:52,440 --> 00:26:58,440

and he had suggested that if there was beeping and the tingling sensation that Betty had described

292

00:26:58,440 --> 00:27:03,440

to go out and take a look at her car, if she had anything she could use to take it with her

293

00:27:03,440 --> 00:27:10,440

and one suggestion was a compass. So we found a compass and this is interesting. Many people have a question.

294

Why did we have a compass? Why did we have a binoculars? The only answer is...

295

00:27:16,440 --> 00:27:17,440

Your campers, actually.

296

00:27:17,440 --> 00:27:18,440

Pardon me?

297

00:27:18,440 --> 00:27:19,440

Your campers, actually.

298

00:27:19,440 --> 00:27:28,440

We're campers. We love it. And the interesting thing, we live on the coast and we're only about three miles from the ocean

299

00:27:28,440 --> 00:27:34,440

so that anyone living by the sea, we enjoy sitting on the beach looking out at ocean line

300

00:27:34,440 --> 00:27:39,440

and going up the coast occasionally while coming into portsmouth as well as going into the mountain areas

301

00:27:39,440 --> 00:27:44,440

and going up on the summit of some mountain and then looking off at the vast distances

302

00:27:44,440 --> 00:27:49,440

and trying to pick out objects with the binoculars. So this was just standard equipment.

303

00:27:49,440 --> 00:27:54,440

I would say that any rational mind will grant you a pair of binoculars and a compass.

304

00:27:55,440 --> 00:28:00,440

Yes. So that...Betting went out and we came into the house very, very upset.

305

00:28:00,440 --> 00:28:06,440

Now, I had told her to keep me out of this and not to involve me with the conversation with the sister or any of this.

306

00:28:06,440 --> 00:28:10,440

Well, we have tenants living in our apartment at that time.

307

00:28:10,440 --> 00:28:16,440

This young man in his life that we're living in our apartment, that is the building we have on the building itself.

308

00:28:16,440 --> 00:28:20,440

They knew we had been on vacation and they could hear us talking.

309

00:28:20,440 --> 00:28:25,440

So they came down to ask about our trip and Betty, they know this is very excited

310

00:28:25,440 --> 00:28:31,440

and was trying to get me to go look at her car and they went off, took a look and they came in.

311

00:28:31,440 --> 00:28:36,440

They just wanted you to go out and take a look at the car and see what their large spots on it.

312

00:28:36,440 --> 00:28:41,440

So I went out reluctantly and took a look at zero in the front of the car.

313

00:28:41,440 --> 00:28:45,440

There were very large shiny spots about the size of silver dollars.

314

00:28:45,440 --> 00:28:50,440

These spots were the same color of the car because this has been a misconception.

315

00:28:50,440 --> 00:28:54,440

Some people have thought that they were different color but it was the same color of the car.

316

00:28:54,440 --> 00:29:00,440

Only as if it had been highly polished, this is a circle of polish.

317

00:29:00,440 --> 00:29:01,440

I see.

318

00:29:01,440 --> 00:29:06,440

And there must have been around 15 to 20 of these spots in no particular pattern.

319

00:29:06,440 --> 00:29:09,440

Just spotted throughout the trunk.

320

00:29:09,440 --> 00:29:10,440

Around the trunk area.

321

00:29:10,440 --> 00:29:11,440

Yes.

322

00:29:11,440 --> 00:29:17,440

And when placing the compass over the spot, the compass would revolve very erratically.

323

00:29:17,440 --> 00:29:22,440

The reason I wasn't too interested about taking the compass out is because I knew that a car with invariably

324

00:29:22,440 --> 00:29:30,440

or any kind of metal type would attract the magnet of the compass toward it.

325

00:29:30,440 --> 00:29:36,440

So I didn't find anything too upsetting about that except that when putting the compass over the spot

326

00:29:36,440 --> 00:29:39,440

then it would erratically revolve.

327

00:29:39,440 --> 00:29:40,440

Yes.

328

00:29:40,440 --> 00:29:44,440

So Betty then decided that there's only one thing to do with this.

329

00:29:44,440 --> 00:29:50,440

That is to notify the police there for a phase which is a fact base in our town, in our area.

330

00:29:50,440 --> 00:29:52,440

And she called.

331

00:29:52,440 --> 00:29:58,440

I told her, well okay, you may but you mustn't give my name or tell anything about me.

332

00:29:58,440 --> 00:30:03,440

Well this was ridiculous on my part because obviously she had to say that her husband was with her on the occasion.

333

00:30:03,440 --> 00:30:04,440

Yes.

334

00:30:04,440 --> 00:30:10,440

So there's next, after questioning her, the next action would have been, well now let us speak to your husband.

335

00:30:10,440 --> 00:30:11,440

Yes.

336

00:30:11,440 --> 00:30:13,440

So I did get involved.

337

00:30:13,440 --> 00:30:20,440

But as I have pointed out in the book that Mr. Fuller has written documenting this story,

338

00:30:20,440 --> 00:30:27,440

I pointed out that after talking with these officers by form at peace, I felt a great relief

339

00:30:27,440 --> 00:30:31,440

because they handled it with great dignity, you might say.

340

00:30:31,440 --> 00:30:34,440

In a very official way.

341

00:30:34,440 --> 00:30:40,440

And as if this was the responsible thing that she and I should have done is to report it to them.

342

Yes.

343

00:30:41,440 --> 00:30:47,440

They also said that we were going to be hooked up with another phone.

344

00:30:47,440 --> 00:30:51,440

They didn't tell us at this time and it would be monitored.

345

00:30:51,440 --> 00:30:58,440

We later learned that this would have been hooked up to write Paterson Health for the State where we again told the same story.

346

00:30:58,440 --> 00:30:59,440

Yes.

347

00:30:59,440 --> 00:31:07,440

And they called back a few times to ask us about details concerning the structure of the craft, its maneuverability, etc.

348

00:31:07,440 --> 00:31:12,440

And that was the only official interview we had with the military.

349

00:31:12,440 --> 00:31:14,440

No one ever came out to the house.

350

00:31:14,440 --> 00:31:23,440

Betty Beanewell obtained books from the library because neither of us knew anything about the so-called UFO flying saucer.

351

00:31:23,440 --> 00:31:28,440

And she was like, interested now to find out just what did we see.

352

00:31:28,440 --> 00:31:36,440

And these books that she went down to the library to obtain one contained information about reporting sightings to NYCAP,

353

00:31:36,440 --> 00:31:47,440

a national investigative committee on aerial phenomenon, so she jotted off a letter to NYCAP and then they sent an investigator out to visit us from Boston.

354

00:31:47,440 --> 00:31:50,440

They're located in Washington, the headquarters.

355

00:31:50,440 --> 00:31:52,440

They have investigators throughout the country.

356

00:31:52,440 --> 00:32:01,440

So Walter Webb, a, you might call him, a scholar, he's a lecturer at Hatlen Planetarium, came to interview us.

357

00:32:01,440 --> 00:32:12,440

And I found later, found out later that he did, this was greatly loved because there was the mention of me having seen Paterson speakers inside the craft.

358

00:32:12,440 --> 00:32:13,440

Yes.

359

00:32:13,440 --> 00:32:19,440

But after arriving later he said he was very impressed with the sincerity of both Betty and I.

360

00:32:19,440 --> 00:32:27,440

He certainly did respond to Walter when he came to the house, an intelligent young man.

361

00:32:27,440 --> 00:32:32,440

I thought, well, I didn't know what was going to come to visit me concerning this kind of a story.

362

00:32:32,440 --> 00:32:35,440

Other scientists became interested.

363

00:32:35,440 --> 00:32:52,440

They heard of this throughout now that we had reported it to NYCAP, a French newsletter to their subscribers, so that we never volunteered any of this information to any news media,

364

00:32:52,440 --> 00:32:55,440

because we didn't want this kind of publicity.

365

00:32:55,440 --> 00:32:57,440

So these other scientists got interested in it.

366

00:32:57,440 --> 00:33:02,440

But NYCAP visited tours from different states, different areas.

367

00:33:02,440 --> 00:33:16,440

And while going over this one day, we must have spent about 12 hours going over this great depth when they came up with the idea that we realized that from the time we left Overrock,

368

00:33:16,440 --> 00:33:22,440

and the time we arrived in Portsmouth, was close to six hours, then four hours, which we should have taken.

369

00:33:22,440 --> 00:33:23,440

Yes.

370

00:33:23,440 --> 00:33:27,440

Well, we were sort of, well, we hadn't really realized it.

371

00:33:27,440 --> 00:33:37,440

But the fact that why after my dashing back to the car, at Indian Head screaming something's going to capture us, Betty remarked later,

372

00:33:37,440 --> 00:33:39,440

do you believe in flying saucers?

373

00:33:39,440 --> 00:33:50,440

And we have to understand that when I made this remark at Indian Head, and then this series of beeps, the next series of beeps occurred in the Plymouth Ashland area,

374

00:33:50,440 --> 00:33:53,440

approximately 30 to 35 miles apart.

375

00:33:53,440 --> 00:34:04,440

And we could never fill in, we could never think and understand exactly what we had been doing from the first beep to the second beep.

376

00:34:04,440 --> 00:34:10,440

Except to say that while I was driving the car, after I ran back at Indian Head,

377

00:34:10,440 --> 00:34:16,440

I was driving and when the second beeps occurred in the Plymouth area, I'm driving the car.

378

00:34:16,440 --> 00:34:22,440

And I don't know why she didn't tell me or ask me what's going to capture us, you see.

379

00:34:22,440 --> 00:34:35,440

No, yes, no. Along with this, along with these scientific inquiries that you were sort of oriously, and I'm sure interestingly answering,

380

00:34:35,440 --> 00:34:41,440

you and Betty had begun to have dreams. Had the dreams begun by this time?

381

00:34:41,440 --> 00:34:51,440

Well, Betty had these dreams five days, or ten days, correction, ten days after the sighting in 1961.

382

00:34:51,440 --> 00:34:59,440

And they lasted for only five days. This is very important because she did not dream of UFOs after it.

383

00:34:59,440 --> 00:35:01,440

I did not have dreams.

384

00:35:01,440 --> 00:35:02,440

You had not?

385

00:35:02,440 --> 00:35:03,440

I had not.

386

00:35:03,440 --> 00:35:06,440

Betty dreamed for what, five consecutive days?

387

00:35:06,440 --> 00:35:07,440

Five consecutive days.

388

00:35:07,440 --> 00:35:09,440

And what was the dream like, Betty?

389

00:35:09,440 --> 00:35:10,440

You get it, Betty?

390

00:35:10,440 --> 00:35:23,440

Well, actually, we found out later that my dreams were very, very similar to the information that we obtained under hypnosis.

391

00:35:23,440 --> 00:35:33,440

There were some minor differences. And I think probably the most important difference is that in my dreams,

392

00:35:33,440 --> 00:35:41,440

I may be argument, and I say more human than they were offended at the moment.

393

00:35:41,440 --> 00:35:51,440

Well, now, that leads us. I know there's a great deal more to the story, but I think what we had better do now is go back to that moment,

394

00:35:51,440 --> 00:36:00,440

just after the first beeping, now, in order to do that, if I may very rapidly fill in our audience in the interest of time,

395

00:36:00,440 --> 00:36:08,440

Betty and Barney Hill were so disturbed by the dreams that Betty had had. Is that true? Barney had had none.

396

00:36:08,440 --> 00:36:09,440

Barney had no dreams.

397

00:36:09,440 --> 00:36:13,440

But Betty had had dreams. And you were disturbed by these dreams.

398

00:36:13,440 --> 00:36:14,440

Yes.

399

00:36:14,440 --> 00:36:22,440

And you sought the help of a psychiatrist. Is my aura psychologist one of the first?

400

00:36:22,440 --> 00:36:24,440

No, I think I have to structure this.

401

00:36:24,440 --> 00:36:25,440

Five.

402

00:36:25,440 --> 00:36:35,440

I think I have to go the proper way. Is after Betty had these dreams, then it was a matter of her later when Walter Webb came to interview us,

403

00:36:35,440 --> 00:36:39,440

telling him, and filling in the entire story, she did mention about the dreams.

404

00:36:39,440 --> 00:36:47,440

When the other two scientists came to the bar about this sighting, she mentioned this. She had also told me about the dreams.

405

00:36:47,440 --> 00:36:51,440

And my conclusion was that is exactly what you had.

406

00:36:51,440 --> 00:36:52,440

Yes.

407

00:36:52,440 --> 00:36:53,440

Nothing more or less.

408

00:36:53,440 --> 00:37:01,440

But when they decided that there was a missing period here of approximately two hours,

409

00:37:01,440 --> 00:37:07,440

also that it was obvious that we both had suffered amnesia at Indian Head,

410

00:37:07,440 --> 00:37:12,440

and we did not come out of this dead-shake state until Plymouth,

411

00:37:12,440 --> 00:37:19,440

or something very baffling, because this is highly improbable for two people to suffer amnesia at the same time.

412

00:37:19,440 --> 00:37:20,440

Yes.

413

00:37:20,440 --> 00:37:34,440

And this is a few months after she had had her dreams, that we began hoping to find a qualified psychiatrist,

414

00:37:34,440 --> 00:37:39,440

preferably a person trained in the medical profession, conductive diagnosis.

415

00:37:39,440 --> 00:37:47,440

We had an interview with one psychiatrist in Massachusetts, and he, after observing us, said that both of you people,

416

00:37:47,440 --> 00:37:55,440

I felt pleased about this because he gave us the assurance that we were not hallucinating and that we were seeing.

417

00:37:55,440 --> 00:37:56,440

Yes.

418

00:37:56,440 --> 00:38:01,440

But he felt that since the experience was very recent, sit on it for a while,

419

00:38:01,440 --> 00:38:06,440

and possibly it will open up the amnesia, you might open up in a natural way.

420

00:38:06,440 --> 00:38:13,440

This would have been very soon after the sighting when we had this appointment with the psychiatrist,

421

00:38:13,440 --> 00:38:15,440

and the doctor had noticed us.

422

00:38:15,440 --> 00:38:23,440

Now, I had an offer that had not bothered people for much years, but it then began to bother me,

423

00:38:23,440 --> 00:38:28,440

and it did not respond to any medication from the medical doctor,

424

00:38:28,440 --> 00:38:34,440

and so he then decided, well, possibly it had some kind of psychological origin,

425

00:38:34,440 --> 00:38:44,440

or a cause that had persisted in causing this distress with me, the offer itself.

426

00:38:44,440 --> 00:38:52,440

So he suggested, based on some of the things I had told him about my son, teenagers,

427

00:38:52,440 --> 00:38:59,440

and they were in another state and it wouldn't write, and I would get upset because I wasn't getting the kind of correspondence,

428

00:38:59,440 --> 00:39:04,440

but Betty would say, well, I'm half of all this is teenage, but you know, boys don't like the right,

429

00:39:04,440 --> 00:39:13,440

but it wasn't satisfying me, and so now I'm telling this to the psychiatrist as a part of why I had been upset thinking this was the reason for the offer.

430

00:39:13,440 --> 00:39:23,440

But I one day mentioned to him how Betty and I had seen a UFO, and as a result of it,

431

00:39:23,440 --> 00:39:29,440

well, it looked as if we both had amnesia at the same time because then I told him briefly what we know.

432

00:39:29,440 --> 00:39:36,440

So he recognized that this was possibly the cause of my offer.

433

00:39:36,440 --> 00:39:43,440

Two people, Betty had had her nightmare streamed several years ago, that is, they ran for five days,

434

00:39:43,440 --> 00:39:46,440

but they were still plaguing while bothering her.

435

00:39:46,440 --> 00:39:51,440

Several years later, my offer not responding to medical medicine,

436

00:39:51,440 --> 00:39:57,440

and we are primary concerned about an experience that had happened in 1961.

437

00:39:57,440 --> 00:40:00,440

This is now the latter part of 1963.

438

00:40:00,440 --> 00:40:09,440

But he then recommended that we, that he would establish an appointment with us to visit this psychiatrist,

439

00:40:09,440 --> 00:40:17,440

and Dr. Benjamin Simon, a very qualified, prominent psychiatrist,

440

00:40:17,440 --> 00:40:25,440

and well, you might say, qualified to regret one back with the use of hypnotherapy.

441

00:40:25,440 --> 00:40:33,440

Yes, now, it was Dr. Simon who elected to use hypnotherapy because it was a more expedient means.

442

00:40:33,440 --> 00:40:37,440

It was, this is what he determined after the consultation.

443

00:40:37,440 --> 00:40:44,440

We set up, we established an appointment, both Betty and I went together when we kept this appointment,

444

00:40:44,440 --> 00:40:49,440

and he immediately could recognize that we both had amnesia at the same time,

445

00:40:49,440 --> 00:40:58,440

and that he then decided that one way of opening the amnesia, the amnesia itself,

446

00:40:58,440 --> 00:41:03,440

could possibly be the technique of the specific hypnosis.

447

00:41:03,440 --> 00:41:11,440

All right, now, at the point at which Dr. Simon began to treat both of you using hypnosis,

448

00:41:11,440 --> 00:41:19,440

let's go back now and reconstruct from that first moment on the highway on Route 3 heading south.

449

00:41:19,440 --> 00:41:24,440

When you heard those beats rather than go into Dr. Simon's office,

450

00:41:24,440 --> 00:41:30,440

I think it would be better now for you to tell us what you now have had opened up to you

451

Let's go back to those first beatings and pick up the story from there

453

Well, I first was carried through the experience in a regressive recall by Dr. Simon,

455

and I also would like to point out that at no time, whenever information was being extracted from a guile in a deep trance,

456

Betty and I in the same room together, I would spend maybe an hour in a deep trance telling him and the doctor within,

457

00:42:10,440 --> 00:42:16,440

leave a post-synagogical suggestion that I would not remember anything that I had told him,

458

00:42:16,440 --> 00:42:21,440

and we do the same with Betty, and this way it prevents us from telling each other

459

00:42:21,440 --> 00:42:24,440

what we were telling the doctor while we regressed back to that period.

460

00:42:24,440 --> 00:42:32,440

Yes, it's very unusual for one psychiatrist, as I understand it, to treat two people, particularly a man and wife,

461

but in this instance because of this dual experience, each of you having experienced the same thing,

462

I can see where the course of treatment and the method of one psychiatrist handling both patients was a logical and ethical expedient.

463

Yes.

464

00:42:53,440 --> 00:43:01,440

Okay, I saw now under regressive diagnosis, after returning to the car,

465

00:43:01,440 --> 00:43:12,440

I would rather, while out in the field, it seems as if there was some communication between this object hovering in the sky.

466

00:43:12,440 --> 00:43:22,440

I could always remember one person continuing to stay in that plate class, looking back at me while the others moved away from the glass itself,

467

00:43:22,440 --> 00:43:27,440

reaching up, as I described as reaching to a water panel.

468

00:43:27,440 --> 00:43:28,440

Yes.

469

00:43:28,440 --> 00:43:32,440

I accept this one, that continues to stay back at me.

470

00:43:32,440 --> 00:43:42,440

Now under regressive diagnosis, it seems as if I was being compelled to come closer to this craft, actually being told to come close to the craft.

471

00:43:42,440 --> 00:43:48,440

Now, we have to realize that the craft was approximately 100 feet away from me up in the air.

472

00:43:48,440 --> 00:43:50,440

It's not on the ground at this point.

473

00:43:50,440 --> 00:43:54,440

Yet there was this kind of communication that I was receiving.

474

I had my binoculars up to my eyes and I was also told he keeps them there, not take them away.

475

I pulled him somehow, as well as the tapes of the hypnosis, were very emotional.

476

And I screamed and pulled the binoculars from my eyes.

477

And I also broke the straps.

478

00:44:13,440 --> 00:44:20,440

Now I failed to mention that when we returned to Pluton, that made of us looking at my binoculars, I noticed the straps was broken.

479

And I wondered if Betty had somehow broken the straps.

480

And then I questioned my son and asked if they had broken my straps.

481

And then pulling the binoculars from my eyes, except for fourth, they parted, the straps parted from around my neck.

So then you were really friar, let's be afraid.

And then I dashed back to the car and then upon entering the car, there was a series of beeps.

And there was this oblivion where I didn't remember anything.

But under regressive hypnosis, where I am made to recall exactly what I am doing, I am driving the car.

488

And I drive towards the south on Route 3, where I leave Route 3, driving off into a very desolate spot, a part of the mountain section.

489

Where there is no car traffic at that time of night, incidentally there wasn't any traffic on Route 3.

490

00:45:19,440 --> 00:45:21,440

Because we have to realize this is afterly.

491

00:45:21,440 --> 00:45:28,440

But they, up there in the White Mountains, after September 7th, it is very desolate spot at night.

492

00:45:28,440 --> 00:45:31,440

Yes, without turning off, you turned off Route 3.

493

00:45:31,440 --> 00:45:36,440

You turned away, I drove off Route 3 and into a very desolate wooded area.

494

00:45:36,440 --> 00:45:40,440

Even under the regressive treatment, can you recall any motive for turning off?

495

00:45:40,440 --> 00:45:42,440

Yes, I am being told to.

496

00:45:42,440 --> 00:45:44,440

I am actually being told.

497

00:45:44,440 --> 00:45:49,440

Even after returning to the car, it seems as if, and I think of the words of mine,

498

00:45:49,440 --> 00:45:54,440

if there had been damage done to me, it was done at that time I was standing in the field.

499

00:45:54,440 --> 00:46:00,440

Because it seems as if even after returning to the car, I am being directed to drive down to this spot

500

00:46:00,440 --> 00:46:05,440

and meet the highway where I made this left turn and I could turn to drive.

501

00:46:05,440 --> 00:46:09,440

And then suddenly there are these men standing in the road.

502

00:46:09,440 --> 00:46:16,440

Upon getting into this desolate area spot, I suddenly saw a huge orange grove.

503

00:46:16,440 --> 00:46:25,440

Now this is interesting because both Betty and I consciously remember somehow of seeing an orange ball in the road.

504

But we could never go any further than somehow we could see and always remember an orange ball in the road.

505

And our remark was that well it must have been the moon.

506

And then we dismissed it.

But now under aggressive hypnosis, I can see this orange ball diminishing in bright,

508

in some orange as a bright color, into a duller color where it eventually delights.

509

This is complete doubt, this darkness.

510

00:46:49,440 --> 00:46:54,440

And these men are standing in the road several of them begging for me to halt.

511

00:46:54,440 --> 00:46:55,440

Well the car stopped.

512

00:46:55,440 --> 00:47:00,440

Now the car stopped and I am trying to get it going and I don't get any of its ignition.

513

00:47:00,440 --> 00:47:01,440

The lights are out.

514

00:47:01,440 --> 00:47:02,440

I am very confused.

515

00:47:02,440 --> 00:47:04,440

I am in a total state of confusion.

516

00:47:04,440 --> 00:47:06,440

And I started to get out of the car.

517

00:47:06,440 --> 00:47:11,440

I had a tire iron that I had taken from the trunk of the car further back on Route 3.

518

00:47:11,440 --> 00:47:16,440

When we were watching this thing before we had arrived at Indian Head.

519

00:47:16,440 --> 00:47:22,440

And I tried to get to that and the door was open and there were these men standing by.

520

00:47:22,440 --> 00:47:24,440

And I thought well are they going to rob me?

521

00:47:24,440 --> 00:47:26,440

And then one pulled me from the car.

522

00:47:26,440 --> 00:47:27,440

Not in a violent way.

523

00:47:27,440 --> 00:47:31,440

But more or less as if I was partly complying.

524

00:47:31,440 --> 00:47:37,440

And I stepped from the car where they literally dragged me, though I was in an upright position,

525

00:47:37,440 --> 00:47:48,440

down and around the car and into the woods and to where I could see the dark outline of a physical structure kind of thing.

526

Now Barney, can you, for just a moment can we pause?

527

Can you describe, are you able to describe what these men looked like?

528

Are they real trash?

529

Well, when I saw them standing in the headlights of the car before the lights went out,

530

they were in dark, similar kind of garment.

531

And I called it a uniform which I thought as a paycheck.

532

I also understand Alan, that in critical situations,

533

00:48:16,440 --> 00:48:22,440

we continually try to put things into the frame of reference that we can identify with as a natural thing.

534

00:48:22,440 --> 00:48:26,440

So that I thought of the uniform being much like a Navy P-jacket.

535

00:48:26,440 --> 00:48:29,440

Barney, may I interrupt just one second?

536

00:48:29,440 --> 00:48:30,440

Sure.

537

00:48:30,440 --> 00:48:38,440

Was the one of these six people, or creatures on the road, wearing a visor on a cap?

538

00:48:38,440 --> 00:48:39,440

No.

539

00:48:39,440 --> 00:48:40,440

No.

540

00:48:40,440 --> 00:48:49,440

I think that you had told me at one time that in the last partition of the Bob, as you were looking

up,

541

00:48:49,440 --> 00:48:51,440

one appeared to have like a cap.

542

00:48:51,440 --> 00:48:52,440

A military cap on.

543

00:48:52,440 --> 00:48:54,440

Yeah, but that you did not now recognize.

544

00:48:54,440 --> 00:48:56,440

No, I did not recognize any caps.

545

00:48:56,440 --> 00:48:57,440

Thank you.

546

00:48:57,440 --> 00:49:03,440

But while in the field at Indian Head, I described one that I was looking with the binoculars at,

547

00:49:03,440 --> 00:49:10,440

that continued to stay at this panel glass as having a military type visor cap.

548

00:49:10,440 --> 00:49:15,440

So I was taken from the car and I actually was very impressed.

549

00:49:15,440 --> 00:49:24,440

And as I pointed out, Jack towards the wood, and I was being told that no harm would come to me and to keep my eyes closed.

550

00:49:24,440 --> 00:49:27,440

And I was then carried off a ramp.

551

00:49:27,440 --> 00:49:31,440

This is interesting because Betty had never mentioned ramp in her dreams.

552

00:49:31,440 --> 00:49:37,440

I was carried up a ramp where my feet struck a gate, a high rise at the door, at the doorstep,

553

00:49:37,440 --> 00:49:39,440

where they bumped over this object.

554

00:49:39,440 --> 00:49:46,440

And this was sort of a fleeting thing of recognizing that my feet are bumping something, you might say.

555

00:49:46,440 --> 00:49:55,440

And I opened my eyes just fleetingly and I could see this corridor that curved around the inside of the grass,

556

00:49:55,440 --> 00:49:59,440

where the rooms were on the inner side of the corridor.

557

00:49:59,440 --> 00:50:00,440

Yes.

558

00:50:00,440 --> 00:50:05,440

And I was carried past one door into another door and there was this room in a pie shape.

559

00:50:05,440 --> 00:50:11,440

Well, as I described it, much like a pie with the point of the pie cut off.

560

00:50:11,440 --> 00:50:15,440

And it was just one table that was very small for my body.

561

00:50:15,440 --> 00:50:20,440

I'm about five foot eight, where I was, I lie down.

562

00:50:20,440 --> 00:50:29,440

I got off to the table myself and I am continually hearing this voice that is telling me that no harm is going to come to me.

563

00:50:29,440 --> 00:50:34,440

It's only a matter of a few tests that are going to be conducted.

564

00:50:34,440 --> 00:50:37,440

Just as some of the more or less remained calm.

565

00:50:37,440 --> 00:50:43,440

The room will be over with and I'll be about my business with no damage done.

566

00:50:43,440 --> 00:50:50,440

Now, Bonnie, when you say you continually keep hearing this voice, it's a voice that you apparently are hearing with your mind,

567

00:50:50,440 --> 00:50:52,440

but you're not hearing anybody speak, are you?

568

00:50:52,440 --> 00:50:54,440

Well, I am hearing it much.

569

00:50:54,440 --> 00:50:58,440

I do it under deep hypnosis.

570

00:50:58,440 --> 00:51:06,440

I gave the doctor what I considered an analogy about explaining the circumstances and the situation.

571

00:51:06,440 --> 00:51:11,440

Sometimes it's difficult to explain things in abstract terms to find the words to fit the picture.

572

00:51:11,440 --> 00:51:16,440

But I explained it to the doctor while I was in a deep trance by Dr. Reimann,

573

00:51:16,440 --> 00:51:23,440

that though I had a sense of awareness in deep trance in the doctor's office,

574

00:51:23,440 --> 00:51:28,440

and he was sitting across from me, once I had been placed into a deep trance,

575

00:51:28,440 --> 00:51:35,440

I no longer knew that he actually was sitting across from me, but I knew that some way he was surrounded in the room.

576

00:51:35,440 --> 00:51:37,440

And I could hear his voice.

577

00:51:37,440 --> 00:51:39,440

I could hear his voice, but I couldn't tell.

578

00:51:39,440 --> 00:51:45,440

If I was asked to point out in a direction where the voice is coming from, I wouldn't have been able to tell.

579

00:51:45,440 --> 00:51:49,440

Does this give you the feeling that I'm trying to survive at this time?

580

00:51:49,440 --> 00:51:52,440

You definitely did hear with your ears.

581

00:51:52,440 --> 00:51:54,440

Well, I could hear.

582

00:51:54,440 --> 00:51:58,440

We get into the matter of did they speak English?

583

00:51:58,440 --> 00:52:03,440

I don't know. I only know that I knew what was expected of me, and I complied.

584

00:52:03,440 --> 00:52:11,440

I thought of a willingness on my part and great fear and terror to comply with the belief that I had been assured that no harm was going to come to me,

585

00:52:11,440 --> 00:52:16,440

and I would go along with this and eventually and hopefully to be on my way.

586

00:52:16,440 --> 00:52:20,440

In any case, you are totally without a will of your own, is that it?

587

00:52:20,440 --> 00:52:26,440

Correct. This is the best way to say I did not have any will of my own, my own but no resistance.

588

00:52:26,440 --> 00:52:31,440

No, I won't be concerned about Betty's will or whereabouts.

589

00:52:31,440 --> 00:52:37,440

I might feel a little guilty as a father or husband to not be concerned about my life,

590

00:52:37,440 --> 00:52:44,440

but this is such a terrifying situation that I was only concerned about myself and I was being assured that I wasn't going to be harmed.

591

00:52:44,440 --> 00:52:56,440

So that I was based on this table where my trousers were removed and my shirt was pulled up toward my head, which would have made my back.

592

00:52:56,440 --> 00:53:00,440

My under shirt was pulled up along with it where my back would have been there,

593

00:53:00,440 --> 00:53:13,440

and I would turn over on my back and my stomach as well as while I could feel what I called a spinger going up and down the spinal column.

594

00:53:13,440 --> 00:53:16,440

I could feel this and I could feel it.

595

00:53:16,440 --> 00:53:23,440

You know, Alan, when I tell this, I still feel very uncomfortable.

596

00:53:23,440 --> 00:53:34,440

Yes, I can tell that as you describe the experience aboard the craft that you're very upset and I sense that Betty is upset too. Is it true?

597

00:53:34,440 --> 00:53:41,440

Somewhat. We do build up pressure when we talk about that.

598

00:53:41,440 --> 00:53:46,440

It's not a matter of being on the radio because you have been on before.

599

00:53:46,440 --> 00:53:47,440

Yes.

600

00:53:47,440 --> 00:53:52,440

So that it does do something to you apparently to recount this experience now.

601

00:53:52,440 --> 00:54:03,440

We have a copy also of the tape with us under Regressive Hypnosis and it must have taken a year before Betty and I could sit down and really listen to the entire context.

602

00:54:03,440 --> 00:54:13,440

Now while in the doctor's office when he played the tapes back, funneling this back into our conscious memory, this was the reason he decided to recall at this own tape.

603

00:54:13,440 --> 00:54:16,440

Was this the method by which he affected back to you?

604

00:54:16,440 --> 00:54:23,440

This was a part of the method. He also used it for the product suggestions while we were in a train.

605

00:54:23,440 --> 00:54:33,440

Just by way of interest, how long did the entire treatment take from the time Dr. Simon began to treat you until you finished?

606

00:54:33,440 --> 00:54:38,440

From January until the early part of July.

607

00:54:38,440 --> 00:54:40,440

January through July?

608

00:54:40,440 --> 00:54:41,440

Yes.

609

00:54:41,440 --> 00:54:43,440

And this was once every week?

610

00:54:43,440 --> 00:54:49,440

This was every week, every Saturday morning. Betty and I are paid to visit to his office.

611

00:54:49,440 --> 00:54:52,440

May I pause for just a moment Barney and Betty?

612

00:54:52,440 --> 00:55:00,440

We'll be back in just a moment to continue this fantastic, fascinating tale told to us tonight by Betty and Barney Hill.

613

00:55:00,440 --> 00:55:05,440

Speaking to us long distance from the residence at Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

614

00:55:05,440 --> 00:55:11,440

Earl L. Lapp is visiting with us tonight. Earl is a noted Cleveland ufologist and a documenter.

615

00:55:11,440 --> 00:55:17,440

And I have never seen Earl so quiet. On the other hand, you've never heard me shut up to this extent.

616

00:55:17,440 --> 00:55:28,440

But I must say that I am enjoying this story as it is told so completely and so rationally by Betty and Barney Hill.

617

00:55:28,440 --> 00:55:30,440

Earl, do you want to say something?

618

00:55:30,440 --> 00:55:40,440

I would like to say that many times people ask me, both on radio or by the letter, if I've gone, where they can learn about things like this.

619

00:55:40,440 --> 00:55:45,440

Well, the best way to learn is to go to organizations where these things are discussed.

620

00:55:45,440 --> 00:55:52,440

In the Cleveland area, the Cleveland Ufology Project, one of the fine organizations that have existed for many years.

621

00:55:52,440 --> 00:55:59,440

And we meet the third Saturday of every month at 8 to 11 p.m.

622

00:55:59,440 --> 00:56:04,440

And this is at the Kintarma that's about a block beyond Snow Road on Pearl.

623

00:56:04,440 --> 00:56:14,440

My name, incidentally, is Alan Douglas, listening to the Fascinating Tales, a fascinating story of Betty and Barney Hill and their two lost hours.

624

00:56:14,440 --> 00:56:23,440

I would like very much to convey to the audience my impression at this moment of Betty and Barney Hill.

625

00:56:23,440 --> 00:56:30,440

These are two extremely intelligent and sensitive human beings.

626

00:56:30,440 --> 00:56:37,440

And I find from this experience that I have a tendency to like them.

627

00:56:37,440 --> 00:56:42,440

I think that I would find them as friends if I knew them better.

628

00:56:42,440 --> 00:56:57,440

Let me say that the story that we are hearing is a story that is documented in the opinion of a noted Boston psychiatrist as being told by two people who implicitly believe it.

629

00:56:57,440 --> 00:57:00,440

And I think this is very important to remember.

630

00:57:00,440 --> 00:57:05,440

Now, back to you, Barney, and this experience of having been physically examined.

631

00:57:05,440 --> 00:57:12,440

Did you ever determine in your own mind what it may have been they were looking for, what they were trying to learn from you?

632

00:57:12,440 --> 00:57:21,440

No, I have not, Alan. I'd like to just go back and elaborate just briefly on your last remark about callers.

633

00:57:21,440 --> 00:57:27,440

This doesn't distress me when you understand why we have released this information.

634

00:57:27,440 --> 00:57:37,440

Number one, after the regressive diagnosis, we then decided that we would never let this go any further.

635

00:57:37,440 --> 00:57:42,440

It would all be continually investigated on the scientific level.

636

00:57:42,440 --> 00:57:49,440

Well, we have friends, and so we would occasionally tell close friends and confidants.

637

00:57:49,440 --> 00:57:53,440

Well, they have friends, and so to give a tell, they're friends and confidants.

638

00:57:53,440 --> 00:57:58,440

And in a military town, the story eventually got out and really spread.

639

00:57:58,440 --> 00:58:01,440

But this is only by word of mouth.

640

00:58:01,440 --> 00:58:07,440

And a reporter in Massachusetts heard of it one day, and he decided to investigate.

641

00:58:07,440 --> 00:58:08,440

To the John Luttrell?

642

00:58:08,440 --> 00:58:09,440

Yes.

643

00:58:09,440 --> 00:58:17,440

And he called us to ask for verification of what he had pieced together, and we named not to write the story.

644

00:58:17,440 --> 00:58:18,440

Yes.

645

00:58:18,440 --> 00:58:21,440

But the story was written anyway without eye cooperation.

646

00:58:21,440 --> 00:58:24,440

It's strange. Newspaper people have kind of a penchant for that.

647

00:58:24,440 --> 00:58:34,440

So we then began, this is when the pressure was on us, because we then began getting the misconceptions of the newspaper article.

648

00:58:34,440 --> 00:58:40,440

People would ask, well, now when you took the trip to Venus or when you were on Mars, or what was it like on the moon?

649

00:58:40,440 --> 00:58:44,440

It just upset me very badly, because we had never said any of these things.

650

00:58:44,440 --> 00:58:52,440

And we had another visit with Dr. Simon, and we discussed this thoroughly, and he decided that for our well-being,

651

00:58:52,440 --> 00:58:58,440

it would be best for the total documentation to come out, the facts.

652

00:58:58,440 --> 00:59:07,440

And all we have consented to do is to release all the facts containing this entire experiment, the experience,

653

00:59:07,440 --> 00:59:10,440

and the reader would have to make their own decisions.

654

00:59:10,440 --> 00:59:14,440

So one can't believe the story. This is only natural.

655

00:59:14,440 --> 00:59:24,440

I would find it's a good belief I'd solve if I heard of this kind of story, so that it is the support of the regressive,

656

00:59:24,440 --> 00:59:34,440

the regression back to that period of time, the qualifications of the characters that was involved,

657

00:59:34,440 --> 00:59:40,440

these are the reasons that I can tonight talk to you over the phone, and tell you about the documentation.

658

00:59:40,440 --> 00:59:47,440

Well, then in a way, the fact that this story got out has, if anything, strengthened you, hasn't it?

659

00:59:47,440 --> 00:59:51,440

The fact that the story got out and then subsequently had to be documented.

660

00:59:51,440 --> 00:59:56,440

That is a full story with all the facts released as you know them, and as you believe them to be.

661

00:59:56,440 --> 01:00:00,440

This has sort of strengthened you as an individual, hasn't it?

662

01:00:00,440 --> 01:00:04,440

Well, I don't know. I think I have misgivings about it occasionally.

663

01:00:04,440 --> 01:00:05,440

Really?

664

01:00:05,440 --> 01:00:10,440

Yes, sometimes I don't feel too happy about it, and there are other times that I feel that,

665

01:00:10,440 --> 01:00:18,440

well, the story was going to be told, it would have to be told, even if someone heard about it, it would have been written somehow or another.

666

01:00:18,440 --> 01:00:22,440

So these are just circumstances, and this is it.

667

01:00:22,440 --> 01:00:32,440

But with this examination, I remembered a tug at my teeth, and this is the way I described it,

668

01:00:32,440 --> 01:00:40,440

and also while on this position of being examined, I opened my eyes again, slatingly,

669

01:00:40,440 --> 01:00:47,440

because I could hear a kind of noise of as if people or someone was talking.

670

01:00:47,440 --> 01:00:53,440

I opened my eyes and I looked and I saw these three short men, and this is when I got a good look at the face.

671

And I immediately closed my eyes because what I saw was terrifying by as standard.

672

It doesn't mean that they were terrifying.

673

01:01:03,440 --> 01:01:05,440

Well, how would you describe what you saw?

674

01:01:05,440 --> 01:01:12,440

I saw this kind of grayish color, and this is interesting because most people, they know,

675

01:01:12,440 --> 01:01:20,440

when you saw the little green men, and they were not green men, they were a grayish metallic kind of gray in color.

676

01:01:20,440 --> 01:01:28,440

And I might also say that I'm quite sure they were not wearing a mask or rather any kind of apparatus over the head for breathing purposes,

01:01:28,440 --> 01:01:35,440

because I could see what would have been a mouth, a thin line, without a lip muscle,

678

01:01:35,440 --> 01:01:42,440

that when parting, when opened, there was a membrane inside that fluttered,

679

really right at the end of the mouth itself, and this fluttered, and this seemed to be a way that they communicated with one another,

with a very peculiar kind of mumbling, humming sound, and I also tried to give an analogy here,

681

01:02:00,440 --> 01:02:06,440

is the sound we have heard when someone in a commercial is speaking underwater,

682

01:02:06,440 --> 01:02:13,440

we have all been acquainted with that in cartoons where he is up something underwater and it has that kind of a sound.

683

01:02:13,440 --> 01:02:14,440

Good reading sound.

684

01:02:14,440 --> 01:02:20,440

A burglary sound, and this was very backling, and the head, the cranium was very large,

685

01:02:20,440 --> 01:02:25,440

the men are moving down toward the chin into a very small chin,

686

01:02:25,440 --> 01:02:34,440

and the eyes were very, very distinguishing because they were very large at the front of the face,

687

01:02:34,440 --> 01:02:40,440

but only continued back, and I did not notice any ears, I can't remember seeing ears,

688

01:02:40,440 --> 01:02:45,440

but the eyes continued back where you might say eye ears are located,

689

01:02:45,440 --> 01:02:49,440

which means that they were quite long and large inside,

690

01:02:49,440 --> 01:02:56,440

I said that they were not like an oriental eye, but yet we might say that we would think of an oriental eye.

691

01:02:56,440 --> 01:02:58,440

How tall were these men?

692

01:02:58,440 --> 01:03:05,440

They were approximately, I would say, 4.5 to 5 feet in total height, no taller than that,

693

01:03:05,440 --> 01:03:14,440

and also that there was the absence of the nose as we understand it, but just the nostrils and tooth slit.

694

01:03:14,440 --> 01:03:21,440

Now, there was an absence of the nose and just a nostril in tooth slit.

695

01:03:21,440 --> 01:03:31,440

Now, Betty, you described in your dream that you had more or less in your dreams reconstructed these individuals

696

01:03:31,440 --> 01:03:38,440

as human or as human types of people through the normal process of identification perhaps,

697

01:03:38,440 --> 01:03:43,440

but now in your regressive hypnosis, how did you envision these people?

698

01:03:43,440 --> 01:03:47,440

How do you now recollect them? Are they similar to Barney's?

699

01:03:47,440 --> 01:03:56,440

Yes, I think they are probably the most significant factor to me with the HCI.

700

01:03:56,440 --> 01:04:06,440

Now, I'm going to ask Earl Neff, who has a piece of information that neither of you,

701

01:04:06,440 --> 01:04:13,440

I don't believe could possibly know about unless you have been in much closer contact with some night cat people

702

01:04:13,440 --> 01:04:18,440

and some investigators and perhaps we realize, and I think it's very important now at this point,

703

01:04:18,440 --> 01:04:26,440

after this description of these creatures, to have Earl tell us about another experience that took place,

704

01:04:26,440 --> 01:04:31,440

I believe, a few years previous to yours in Brazil.

705

01:04:31,440 --> 01:04:34,440

Earl, can you very quickly tell Betty and Barney about it?

706

01:04:34,440 --> 01:04:39,440

I'm going to tell you a little bit about this woman by the name of Antonio Villas-Buervez,

707

01:04:39,440 --> 01:04:42,440

a 23-year-old chap.

708

01:04:42,440 --> 01:04:50,440

I learned about this through Carl Lorenzen, the woman who has, with her husband, James,

709

01:04:50,440 --> 01:04:55,440

has Afro-organization, the oldest organization in this kind of the world,

710

01:04:55,440 --> 01:05:02,440

and this took place, this incident, took place in Minas Gerais, Brazil

711

01:05:02,440 --> 01:05:09,440

at 11.30 am on the morning of October 15, 1957.

712

01:05:09,440 --> 01:05:18,440

It was a very strange event that took place and it somewhat parallels, in a way,

713

01:05:18,440 --> 01:05:21,440

what few folks have experienced.

714

01:05:21,440 --> 01:05:26,440

There are two nights of manifestations of strange lights near the farm of his parents,

715

01:05:26,440 --> 01:05:33,440

and this was near this town of Francisco de Salos in the state of Minas Gerais, Brazil.

716

01:05:33,440 --> 01:05:39,440

The first two incidents were witnessed by Antonio's brother, Joe,

717

01:05:39,440 --> 01:05:46,440

this young man was riding, he was plowing a tractor he was riding on, in a field near his home,

718

01:05:46,440 --> 01:05:52,440

when his attention was arrested by what appeared to be a very bright star.

719

01:05:52,440 --> 01:05:56,440

This again you see relatively parallels yours in the beginning,

720

01:05:56,440 --> 01:06:05,440

which he shortly realized afterwards was not a star at all, but a brilliantly lit egg-shaped object approaching at high speed,

721

01:06:05,440 --> 01:06:14,440

and shortly was hovering overhead at an altitude of about 175 feet, and illuminates the ground with a bright red light.

722

01:06:14,440 --> 01:06:21,440

Antonio, more or less panicked, could realize he couldn't escape the thing because of the soft clouds ground in the field,

723

01:06:21,440 --> 01:06:25,440

and so he sat there, rooted to his tractor seat, you might say.

724

01:06:25,440 --> 01:06:33,440

As he sat there, the object moved again and settled slowly to the ground about 15 yards away, and he got a very good look at it.

725

01:06:33,440 --> 01:06:39,440

Now, it looked like an elongated egg, sort of a torpedo shaped or a cigar shaped,

726

01:06:39,440 --> 01:06:47,440

with small perpish lights all over it, a huge red light on the leading end, and three metal bars protruding from the end.

727

And on the top of the object was something which rotated at high speed and gave off a sharp fluorescent red light.

728

This began to turn green the moment the object slowed, probably in preparation for landing,

729

but as it slowed, the top became more visible and appeared as a round plate or squashed tubula.

730

Three props or metal legs emerged from the underside of this craft,

731

01:07:14,440 --> 01:07:21,440

and at this point Antonio was thoroughly frightened and attempted to move the tractor away,

732

01:07:21,440 --> 01:07:24,440

and then the tractor quit and the lights went out.

733

01:07:24,440 --> 01:07:27,440

Now, this probably was due to electromagnetic force fields.

734

01:07:27,440 --> 01:07:34,440

He tried to start up the engine, but it was unsuccessful, and then he opened the door of the tractor, jumped out and started running.

735

01:07:34,440 --> 01:07:39,440

At this point, he was caught short by something that grasped his arm.

736

01:07:39,440 --> 01:07:48,440

As he turned to shake off the pursuer, he came face to face with a small figure dressed in gray striped suit with a strange helmet,

737

01:07:48,440 --> 01:07:53,440

which entirely covered the head, showing only the eyes through a faceplate.

738

01:07:53,440 --> 01:07:59,440

There were tubes that led from the top of this helmet to a point on a suit at the back of it.

739

01:08:00,440 --> 01:08:06,440

Then Antonio pushed the creature and started running, and whereupon he was grabbed by three other creatures,

740

01:08:06,440 --> 01:08:09,440

all a little taller than the first one.

741

01:08:09,440 --> 01:08:12,440

He was then lifted and dragged to the ship.

742

01:08:12,440 --> 01:08:19,440

Now, as I remember, Bonnie, when you were speaking before they were taking you up on this ramp,

743

01:08:19,440 --> 01:08:25,440

they more or less dragged you, and as I recall, to the toes of your shoe more or less were scuffed, is that correct?

744

01:08:25,440 --> 01:08:29,440

He occasionally called for help, even cursing his captors.

745

01:08:29,440 --> 01:08:39,440

Further on, he speaks of where, sometime later in fact, the door of this object opened.

746

01:08:39,440 --> 01:08:47,440

He was in, by the way, I might go back a little ways and state that it was sort of a bed-like thing that he was asked to lay the lie down on,

747

01:08:47,440 --> 01:08:53,440

and that this was covered with a soft-grain material and situated in the center of the room.

748

01:08:53,440 --> 01:08:56,440

It was curiously humped up in the middle.

749

01:08:56,440 --> 01:09:03,440

It was then, while he was lying down, that he noted the presence of tiny holes in the walls, which were giving off a grayish vapor.

750

01:09:03,440 --> 01:09:10,440

Sometime later, the door opened, and two of the men led a woman into the room and then closed the door on left.

751

01:09:10,440 --> 01:09:13,440

Now, the woman is described in this manner.

752

01:09:13,440 --> 01:09:16,440

She was about four feet six inches tall.

753

01:09:16,440 --> 01:09:26,440

She was fair skinned, blue-eyed, and darkly outlined, wide-set slanted eyes, which gave her the look of an ancient Egyptian painting.

754

01:09:26,440 --> 01:09:36,440

Her hair, however, was blonde and nearly white, you might say, and it was short, expanding only to about an inch or two below the earlobes.

755

01:09:36,440 --> 01:09:40,440

This was part of the middle and turned under slightly.

756

01:09:40,440 --> 01:09:48,440

Her face was very broad through the cheekbones, which seemed to be quite pronounced, and tapered to a very point, small chin.

757

01:09:48,440 --> 01:09:55,440

Her nose appeared to be normal, but her mouth was only a slit, completely without lips.

758

01:09:55,440 --> 01:10:00,440

She was well-formed, and this was quite easy to see as she was completely naked,

759

01:10:00,440 --> 01:10:05,440

and all in all gave the general impression of a very beautiful woman.

760

01:10:05,440 --> 01:10:13,440

Now, the woman's purpose was instantly obvious, for she set about to seduce Antonio, succeeding twice.

761

After the second act was complete, the woman was called for by the two men and left the room.

762

But just before leaving, she pointed to Antonio, then she pointed to her stomach, then down toward the earth,

763

Then he was given his clothes, and I'll accept his cigarette lighter, and furiously taken us from the ship.

765

But I thought you should know about this, there's more, but I don't want to take time to tell you.

766

Has anybody told you about this incident at all?

767

01:10:41,440 --> 01:10:48,440

Well, I don't know how you feel having the incident related to you, but there are some striking points of similarity,

768

01:10:48,440 --> 01:10:55,440

and both Earl and I were talking about this earlier this evening, and Earl pointed out that there could be, in all probability,

769

01:10:55,440 --> 01:10:58,440

for you to know of this particular experience.

770

01:10:58,440 --> 01:11:00,440

I think I've heard of it.

771

01:11:00,440 --> 01:11:06,440

The army, this other part of this seduction, nothing like that is in place with me,

772

01:11:06,440 --> 01:11:15,440

but I described a metal, a cup-like object being placed over my lower...

773

01:11:15,440 --> 01:11:16,440

Over the grind?

774

01:11:16,440 --> 01:11:17,440

Yes.

775

01:11:17,440 --> 01:11:26,440

And I could feel it being placed, and as if there was some kind of...

776

01:11:26,440 --> 01:11:33,440

I was thinking of the word vibration, but this doesn't describe what I am trying to say.

777

01:11:33,440 --> 01:11:40,440

As if something was movable in a soft way, and it was placed over me, and it was removed.

778

01:11:40,440 --> 01:11:48,440

I don't know the reason for it, but this is where I later developed the words that came on my body.

779

01:11:48,440 --> 01:11:57,440

And Betty, as I understand it, you were interested in performing what they described to you, you say, as a pregnancy test.

780

01:11:57,440 --> 01:12:01,440

Well, this is what they call that.

781

01:12:01,440 --> 01:12:03,440

This is the...

782

01:12:03,440 --> 01:12:10,440

...trending of a needle-like apparatus of some kind into my navel.

783

01:12:10,440 --> 01:12:14,440

And it was painful, at first, you say?

784

01:12:14,440 --> 01:12:17,440

It was quite painful, yes.

785

01:12:17,440 --> 01:12:25,440

And I was very upset, even when I realized what they were going to do, and asked them not to do this.

786

01:12:25,440 --> 01:12:29,440

And it seemed to take it with not fear.

787

01:12:29,440 --> 01:12:32,440

And it seemed to be quite surprised that it did.

788

01:12:32,440 --> 01:12:42,440

And the man I... the one I called the leader, rubbed his hand in front of my eyes, and the pain went away.

789

01:12:42,440 --> 01:12:51,440

I see. Now, when the pain went away, did you ever feel any discomfort or pain afterward in any of your conscious memory?

790

01:12:51,440 --> 01:12:52,440

No.

791

01:12:52,440 --> 01:12:53,440

No discomfort?

792

01:12:53,440 --> 01:12:55,440

No, not what I could remember.

793

01:12:55,440 --> 01:13:02,440

Did you feel impelled at any time to have yourself examined by a doctor? Of course, this all came later, didn't it?

794

01:13:02,440 --> 01:13:09,440

Yes, this was the experience that all happened in 1961, and this notice was in 1964.

795

01:13:09,440 --> 01:13:13,440

So it was quite time-wrapped, I see.

796

01:13:13,440 --> 01:13:15,440

And I wasn't aware of this.

797

01:13:15,440 --> 01:13:16,440

I see.

798

01:13:16,440 --> 01:13:20,440

And I never did make a boy to a doctor about it.

799

01:13:20,440 --> 01:13:30,440

And so you weren't even aware of that part of the experience until you, several years later, were regressed, hypnotically.

800

01:13:30,440 --> 01:13:31,440

That's right.

801

01:13:31,440 --> 01:13:34,440

Barney, what about the rash on your back?

802

01:13:34,440 --> 01:13:35,440

Not a rash.

803

01:13:35,440 --> 01:13:37,440

These were warts on your right.

804

01:13:37,440 --> 01:13:38,440

On the right.

805

01:13:38,440 --> 01:13:51,440

Yes. The doctor took the position that these warts were, I might say, could have been of a natural development.

806

01:13:51,440 --> 01:13:58,440

Well, I'll tell you, it's a heck of a question to ever ask a doctor because they haven't found out yet for sure what it caused my red-bound warts, right?

807

01:13:58,440 --> 01:13:59,440

Yes.

808

01:13:59,440 --> 01:14:04,440

So I guess we really can't answer that question, and we can't logically expect the doctor to as yet.

809

01:14:04,440 --> 01:14:18,440

I asked the leader where he came from, and he stepped over by the wall and put his hand on the wall, and these panels were back, and a map came out, which I believe would be called a sky map.

810

01:14:18,440 --> 01:14:24,440

And while the map was exposed, he asked me if I knew where the Earth was.

811

01:14:24,440 --> 01:14:28,440

And for that to tell him I did not know there.

812

01:14:28,440 --> 01:14:32,440

And he acted a little disgusted with me.

813

01:14:32,440 --> 01:14:36,440

And I did get a look at the map.

814

01:14:36,440 --> 01:14:43,440

He did not say just where he came from on it, but I noticed certain things about it.

815

01:14:43,440 --> 01:14:52,440

I did ask him if there was any line, heavy solid line, lighter solid line, and broken line.

816

01:14:52,440 --> 01:14:54,440

And I asked him the meaning of these.

817

01:14:54,440 --> 01:14:58,440

He said the heavy lines were trade lines.

818

01:14:58,440 --> 01:15:06,440

In the light lines, there are places that they go sometimes, but the program lines are expeditions.

819

01:15:06,440 --> 01:15:07,440

I see.

820

01:15:07,440 --> 01:15:09,440

Trade lines.

821

01:15:09,440 --> 01:15:10,440

I see.

822

01:15:10,440 --> 01:15:11,440

Yes.

823

01:15:11,440 --> 01:15:17,440

And incidentally, it should be mentioned that your sketches appear in the book, *The Interrupted Journey*.

824

01:15:17,440 --> 01:15:18,440

Yes, very true.

825

01:15:18,440 --> 01:15:26,440

And this would be, I think, a more complete way of feeding an answer to that question.

826

01:15:26,440 --> 01:15:33,440

Perhaps both Betty and Barney will tell us how they feel about it and what they believe it to be.

827

01:15:33,440 --> 01:15:44,440

Shortly after the sighting, and after the investigation by the scientists that became involved in the experience that Betty and I had,

828

01:15:44,440 --> 01:15:50,440

where they noticed that this thing had been amnesia experienced by both of us,

829

01:15:50,440 --> 01:15:54,440

we visited a psychiatrist in Massachusetts.

830

01:15:54,440 --> 01:16:00,440

And he, and I also mentioned how he had suggested that this was a very recent experience,

831

01:16:00,440 --> 01:16:08,440

and possibly amnesia would open up any natural way where we would, in the course of time, begin to remember.

832

01:16:08,440 --> 01:16:13,440

We never did this result that later in our going to Dr. Simon.

833

01:16:13,440 --> 01:16:19,440

As I understand it, I think the implication of the question may be slightly obscured,

834

01:16:19,440 --> 01:16:25,440

but what he really wanted to know was, is there a history of any mental disorder?

835

01:16:25,440 --> 01:16:27,440

No, there is no history of any mental disorder.

836

01:16:27,440 --> 01:16:32,440

And you did that you had never, previously either of you, had an occasion to visit a psychiatrist.

837

01:16:32,440 --> 01:16:33,440

All right.

838

01:16:33,440 --> 01:16:35,440

I think that's really what the man wants to know.

839

01:16:35,440 --> 01:16:42,440

Now, I'd like to also briefly make a statement concerning, as you point out, the matter of serenity,

840

01:16:42,440 --> 01:16:53,440

concerning the word of the documentary, documentation, that what we mean when we say documented is that there is the existence of the tapes

841

01:16:53,440 --> 01:16:59,440

of Betty and I both regressed back while in a deep, trans-like state,

842

01:16:59,440 --> 01:17:08,440

articulating a set of experiences in the most controlled way, the most scientific controlled way that it catches could possibly do it.

843

01:17:08,440 --> 01:17:11,440

And this is what is meant by documentation.

844

01:17:11,440 --> 01:17:12,440

All right, very good.

845

01:17:12,440 --> 01:17:14,440

Now, who received the fund?

846

01:17:14,440 --> 01:17:16,440

Who did look like it was in pay for that?

847

01:17:16,440 --> 01:17:26,440

Well, we have to understand that obviously, when the story was publicized in one of the papers here in the East,

848

01:17:26,440 --> 01:17:32,440

that there was a great demand for people to want to know more, because Betty and I were in telling.

849

01:17:32,440 --> 01:17:35,440

We hadn't told this reporter who wrote the story.

850

01:17:35,440 --> 01:17:38,440

If this demand became very great, there was tremendous pressure.

851

01:17:38,440 --> 01:17:47,440

Plus, as I point out, much of the kind of remarks that were stated untrue fantasies attributed to what we were supposed to have been doing

852

01:17:47,440 --> 01:17:51,440

when we had never said we had done any of those particular things.

853

01:17:51,440 --> 01:17:57,440

And we then, in releasing this material, contracts were drawn up.

854

01:17:57,440 --> 01:18:08,440

This is quite a standard procedure, because once we became a part of exposure this way, obviously, it could not be expected of us, Betty and I,

855

01:18:08,440 --> 01:18:15,440

to let our names go out this way without some kind of...

856

01:18:15,440 --> 01:18:19,440

The defense is being paid for the efforts.

857

01:18:19,440 --> 01:18:25,440

For instance, the night where I am employed, I work for the government as a postal worker,

858

01:18:25,440 --> 01:18:35,440

and quite obvious tomorrow I'll have to be out there delivering my appointed rounds after having been up to what I probably wanted.

859

01:18:35,440 --> 01:18:37,440

Let me point out this, too.

860

01:18:37,440 --> 01:18:41,440

I think the question is probably well put.

861

01:18:41,440 --> 01:18:50,440

But I think it also needs to be pointed out that if I had found myself experiencing this kind of thing in my own consciousness,

862

01:18:50,440 --> 01:18:59,440

and if I had been compelled to go to a psychiatrist and to spend some seven months in psychiatric care,

863

01:18:59,440 --> 01:19:04,440

is there a way I presume that Dr. Simon does not provide a free service to anyone?

864

01:19:04,440 --> 01:19:10,440

Betty and I paid for those services seven months where we both were regressed factors,

865

01:19:10,440 --> 01:19:14,440

which meant that both of us were paying the hourly rate.

866

01:19:14,440 --> 01:19:16,440

And may I add something?

867

01:19:16,440 --> 01:19:17,440

All right.

868

01:19:17,440 --> 01:19:24,440

I also would like to say that from 1961, or up until really up until the present time,

869

01:19:24,440 --> 01:19:35,440

Betty and I were trying to find out as much information and as much we could scientifically about this experience.

870

01:19:35,440 --> 01:19:45,440

We went to scientific conventions, we went to scientists, and we spent a great many hours doing this,

871

01:19:45,440 --> 01:19:52,440

and not only that, we spent hundreds and hundreds of our own money in our own investigation of this.

872

01:19:52,440 --> 01:19:58,440

Well, I was just going to add to that, Betty, that if I had experienced all of this as you have,

873

01:19:58,440 --> 01:20:10,440

I would have, and also had the fortune, the good fortune of having that selling author choose to document the experience in a book.

874

01:20:10,440 --> 01:20:14,440

I would have no compunction about signing my name to a contract either,

875

01:20:14,440 --> 01:20:21,440

and I would hesitate to choose anybody at random in this society who would, incidentally.

876

01:20:21,440 --> 01:20:26,440

I think that the question was well put, and I believe it to have been well answered.

877

01:20:26,440 --> 01:20:27,440

Sure.

878

01:20:27,440 --> 01:20:30,440

Well, I didn't understand any noise.

879

01:20:30,440 --> 01:20:31,440

Betty, did you?

880

01:20:31,440 --> 01:20:33,440

No, I didn't either.

881

01:20:33,440 --> 01:20:41,440

When we saw the object coming in closer, it appeared like a solid yellow light, like a star.

882

01:20:41,440 --> 01:20:46,440

And then as it came in closer, it gave a twinkling effect.

883

01:20:46,440 --> 01:20:51,440

When it was coming in closer, I had the impression that it was flowing down.

884

01:20:51,440 --> 01:20:57,440

Also, there was a very erratic light coming, and this was another thing that I noticed.

885

01:20:57,440 --> 01:20:59,440

There was no change in color.

886

01:20:59,440 --> 01:21:05,440

It was the twinkling effect, and then as it came in closer and we saw the windows,

887

01:21:05,440 --> 01:21:11,440

we had the impression, I don't know how true it is, but we had the impression that the ground was spinning,

888

01:21:11,440 --> 01:21:15,440

and it was actually the windows that we were seeing.

889

01:21:15,440 --> 01:21:21,440

Was the gradual change diminishing from orange into dull up and then blackness?

890

01:21:21,440 --> 01:21:28,440

It was a different kind of symbol than I'd ever seen before.

891

01:21:28,440 --> 01:21:33,440

There was no resemblance to writing or printing.

892

01:21:33,440 --> 01:21:35,440

I couldn't say what it was.

893

01:21:35,440 --> 01:21:44,440

The printing went up in order, lettering, or I didn't say writing, the symbol went up and down rather than across.

894

01:21:44,440 --> 01:21:48,440

Was the binding Betty in any way similar to our books?

895

01:21:48,440 --> 01:21:52,440

Well, I've only had it for a few moments in a...

896

01:21:52,440 --> 01:21:54,440

You didn't really have too much chance to look at it.

897

01:21:54,440 --> 01:21:56,440

But at a quick glance, did it look like a book?

898

01:21:56,440 --> 01:21:58,440

I would say it looked like a book.

899

01:21:58,440 --> 01:22:01,440

I never thought about that.

900

01:22:01,440 --> 01:22:08,440

But wait, I would assume that it probably would be about the same weight as one of our books

901

01:22:08,440 --> 01:22:11,440

that I probably might have noticed a difference.

902

01:22:12,440 --> 01:22:16,440

Did it look to you that either the book had been mechanically reproduced

903

01:22:16,440 --> 01:22:20,440

as one of our books might be, or could it have been hand-lettered?

904

01:22:20,440 --> 01:22:28,440

Did it appear more artistically done than might be done by a machine, for example?

905

01:22:28,440 --> 01:22:39,440

That's just a casual answer, but I would say it didn't look as though it would be something that we would do in handwriting.

906

01:22:39,440 --> 01:22:41,440

How would that be more like a published book?

907

01:22:41,440 --> 01:22:49,440

Maybe the whole line of questioning in this way, as far as publishing or hand-lettered, would be illogical.

908

01:22:49,440 --> 01:23:00,440

I would assume that another more advanced intelligence would at least have been able to discover the principle or the means of publishing books,

909
