And that's two years

180

before they're ever, ever, ever.

181

This isn't what happens.

182

You get an enlarged

183

00:07:37,000 --> 00:07:39,000

old man

184

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:41,000

and start to shock him.

185

And if it contracts,

186

it gets brighter and brighter.

187

Well actually, if it's brighter than the cooler,

188

it gets smaller and smaller

189

and a higher,

190

what you call a younger star.

191

It goes up to the east right here.

192

And that is finally a business

193

and it's finally a business

when it's burning out the sky on the force.

195
