On the night of September 19, 1961, Mr. and Mrs. Barney Hill were driving through New Hampshire

on their way home to Portman, and they say they started applying saucer.

There have been many such reports, but what makes the Hill's story interesting is that

This encounter, this alleged encounter, has been made into a film now titled the UFO incident,

which will be shown and then be seen tonight at 9, 8 o'clock Central Time.

Mr. Hill died six years ago, but Mrs. Barney Hill is with us today to tell us about the incident,

and so is Dr. Benjamin Simon, a psychiatrist who used hypnosis to help probe the amnesia,

which both Mr. and Mrs. Hill said they suffered after this incident.

Mrs. Hill, you were first unable to account for what happened during the two hours that you were,

so you were taking a board of the spacecraft, and then under hypnosis you were able to recall incidents.

Was there any other evidence of that happened?

Later, there were readout reports released of the object being seen.

Do you know about the readout reports indicated?

Dr. Simon, how did you first get involved in this?

Barney was referred to me by a psychiatrist up in New Hampshire under whose care he'd been for about a year.

He was suffering from marked anxiety, hypertension, and also there's quite a few things indeed.

And was this before?

This was before the incident.

Well, it was after the incident, as we know now, but the incident itself came out in this psychiatrist's treatment.

In the interest of the human, he thought there might be a connection between Barney's anxiety and symptoms and the experience of that incident.

And so he was referred to me.

Betty was not in the picture in any sense of illness at the time, but Barney brought her along and asked us to see the two together.

And during that, they produced the NICAP report, a very condensed six page report.

And as Barney's story developed, the story came out of Betty's dreams, which had taken place in the week or so after the actual incident.

What have you concluded from your examination of mystery, and is there still?

I don't understand. What did I conclude?

Did you conclude that they were actually, what aboard a spacecraft, or did you conclude that it was a fantasy?

I concluded that it was, if we make a dream, fancy, fancy, dream that it was a fantasy, as you put it.

Here it is.
