And the broken lines were expeditions.

And in doing the research of this, the heavy lines all go to stars systems that we've

102

believed to be five to 11 billion years old.

And the broken lines all go to stars that are younger than that.

But also on the map, I had two stars which our astronomers did not find until 1969 or

Right?

And not only that, this area of the sky has a large number of stars.

But I had all the stars that we believed to be possible, have the characteristics to be

possible to have planets and maybe life.
