Your involvement with the world of UFOs.

Yes I'm presently serving as director of investigations for an international group

called UFO Nefert which hails from Sageen, Texas right in their own backyards.

You know it's not like from Sageen though.

No I'm from New England, one of Massachusetts.

I've been involved in UFO research for a number of years.

My interest goes back to 1947.

I served as an early warning coordinator for the United States Air Force sponsored University

of Colorado project in 1966-67 at the time frame.

So I've been with it a long time and this particular case is very bizarre as compared

to some of the other types of work I've done in the UFO field.

What initially sparked your interest in the UFO field anyway?

And did you go into this as a point of curiosity, an adversary position?

Were you out hoping they were there or proving that they really weren't?

Well I must admit I was probably only about 15 years old when Kenneth Arnold sighted these

flying objects over at Malphe, New Washington in 1947, June 24th, 1947 and I began collecting

news clips thinking that they were experimental aircraft because I was interested in that

kid interest stuff.

When I joined the United States Air Force and become involved in the National Security

Agency I came across people in reports that indicated that the United States Air Force

was considering UFOs to be a very serious business.

I took it upon myself when I was discharged from the United States Air Force to join the

National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena as an associate member just to

keep abreast of what was going on in the world of UFOs.

But my interest got to the point where I began to conduct investigations myself and sending

unsolicited reports to the Air Force and NCAP and before you know it I got involved on a

job training program with NCAP as an investigator and things sort of snowballed and now they

say I'm a UFO expert and it was many years ago.

Let's come up to date now then and this case, how did you first get involved in this?

I reside in the state of Massachusetts and the Massachusetts group got involved with

the case through Dr. J. Allen Heineck Center for UFO Study.

My first impulse was not to get involved, it was very, very bizarre.

However the Massachusetts State Director indicated to me that the woman seemed to be all there

and that it was a very interesting case so I became a member of a five man team consisting

of a aerospace engineer, a solar physicist, a communications specialist, an electrical

engineer myself.

We conducted a very rigid character reference check on the family.

Two extensive lie detector tests were given to two of the primary witnesses.

The abductee was given a psychiatric examination not only to assure us that she was not a psychotic

but to assure her because she, I mean, much of this came out under hypnosis and she couldn't

believe that such a thing could have happened to her and thought that she was actually losing

her mind and wanted to be reassured and seek medical attention and this was something wrong

with her but I came to the conclusion that from these various tests that these people

were telling the truth as they knew it to be and they were honest and what intrigues

me is that we have about 200 cases like this on record and there are subtle similarities

which exist in these cases which come from all over the world which make me feel that

the close encounter of the third kind type G as we call it are real bona fide experiences.

Parent stimulus seems to be extra threshold.

It might be much more complex than that.

However, all we can do at the present time is to document cases like this and just wonder

what it's all about.

The situation of hypnosis, let's kind of go into the incident with the woman because

was hypnosis used because she either was leery of what she consciously thought happened

or she couldn't recall everything that happened or was this just an investigative tool on

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00:04:18,000 --> 00:04:19,000

your part?

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00:04:19,000 --> 00:04:20,000

This is an investigative tool.

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00:04:20,000 --> 00:04:24,000

You'll find that most close encounters of the third kind type G UFO experience, seeing

a UFO and its occupants at very close range.

But missing time is a time period which they kind of come for afterwards.

In the case of the Andreessen affair, let's go back to the date that happened.

January 25th, 1967, about 6.35 p.m. Betty and her seven children and two parents were

The children and their parents were in the living room.

The lights in the house went out.

Momentarily, a bright orange flash came through the kitchen window which will look to feel

and begin pulsating.

The children became very frightened.

She shoot them into the living room.

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00:05:08,160 --> 00:05:11,120

The father came running out and looked out the window, the back window to see where the

light was coming from.

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00:05:12,680 --> 00:05:19,760

He described in his own way some small childlike beings that looked like kids dressed up in

strange costumes coming toward the house.

All he remembers after that is somehow they got in the house.

The rest of the family went into, for want of a better description, suspended animation

which really shook up Betty.

She wanted to be assured that her family was alright and they left the younger daughter

who was 11 years old at the time out of this state as it were.

She lived under hypnosis a very complimentary experience as it were from her standpoint

talking using the vocabulary in the description of 11 year olds.

You said they left.

You mean the appeal to the beings?

I'm worried about my family.

They established, she heard voices in her head.

The mouth didn't move.

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00:06:00,200 --> 00:06:04,000

We'll probably be seeing some of the visuals later on.

She described him as three to four foot high with a large pear shape head wrapped around

her eyes, small nose mouth and the mouth was almost like scot tissue.

Just to go very briefly through what happened, it's a very complex and detailed thing indeed.

But up to this point though, you have one other family member corroborating it.

Yes, they kept it to themselves for a long time.

But getting back to the experience, what happened was they convinced her through mind control

She was brought out to the backyard, taken aboard a small 20, 25 foot diameter craft,

physical examinations and then was put in a container filled with liquid.

Oh, yeah, that is this picture here, right?

Bear in mind we're dealing with a woman that has only 10 years of formal education and

Now these are her drawings.

She's a non-amateur artist and she has a remarkable talent to remember things in detail.

Of course, under hypnosis she relived this experience which we were just describing.

When they took her out of that particular chair, they floated her down a black track

which ran between the chairs.

If you'd like to show that, there are eight chairs there, four on each side, and she was

subjected to several of these chairs.

And then she was floated down the middle of these chairs, down a black track, and a door

just appeared.

to the house.

When she returned to the house, the two aliens, whatever we might call them, brought two

And the father just ignores her, walks right back, shuffles right at the buyer into the

And every member of the family was taken to bed in this sort of state, unaware of her

yelling at them so hard and then she was put to bed and it was the next morning.

It's very typical of other cases we have on fire.

What was the time period involved, too?

We feel it took place between 6.35 and perhaps 11 o'clock in the evening.

The younger daughter under hypnosis noticed a clock was read 6.35 and Betty, when she

was returned to the house, noticed a clock reading 10.40.

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00:09:24,880 --> 00:09:29,800

It's interesting, you can go back to January 25th, 1967, as a reliving this, and you can

ask questions like how the weather was, how much snow was there on the ground, what was

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00:09:34,760 --> 00:09:38,960

the temperature, what was on TV, the power blackout and things like that.

And we went back and checked local weather records, power company records, and many of

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00:09:44,240 --> 00:09:48,240

the things, in fact, all of the things they described that happened on that day could

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00:09:48,240 --> 00:09:49,240

be checked.

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00:09:49,240 --> 00:09:53,280

A lot of these things were indicated at least through hypnosis that we're reliving that

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00:09:53,280 --> 00:09:54,280

particular day.

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00:09:54,280 --> 00:09:56,280

Let's take our break and get it out of the way.

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00:09:56,280 --> 00:09:57,480

We'll be back in two minutes.

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00:09:57,480 --> 00:10:03,320

The engineer that was taking the thoughts from the lady and trying to put them together

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00:10:03,320 --> 00:10:05,240

and what that craft might really look like.

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00:10:05,240 --> 00:10:06,240

Could you hit on that again?

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00:10:06,240 --> 00:10:07,240

Yeah.

I want to be investigating team as aerospace engineers and manager at the Arathiol company.

It holds a very good position there, very skilled individual.

One of his sketches are in the book, a number of sketches he was able to do.

Speaking of sketches, one of the unique things about the book, *The Andrius in Affair*, is

that she is an amateur artist, but a very excellent amateur artist, and she was given

a post-synoptic suggestion to remember in detail the various things that she saw.

And she has given us in the book, in the report, which brought 528 pages long, three volumes,

a series of drawings, giving a sort of a chronicle survey, as it were, of her trip through the

They're very, very detailed.

I wonder how someone with a 10th grade education could ever concoct something like that on

because obviously, we're using the term close encounters as a third kind, and the little

Were they it?

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00:11:48,600 --> 00:11:49,600

Wow.

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00:11:49,600 --> 00:11:54,120

It was a male-female situation, but it looks like the characters were in the film.

It definitely would be.

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00:11:55,120 --> 00:11:59,000

Dr. J. L. Heineck was technical director for the film, and much of the material that went

into the film was drawn from cases like the Injuries and Affairs, and they came up with

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00:12:03,400 --> 00:12:08,280

a composite of what people have described as aliens.

The term close encounter, the third kind, for example, was coined by Heineck many years

ago, and was used in the film.

In any areas of research, other people that have had somewhat similar experiences, is

there any thread of similarity, though, as far as description of beings that they've

seen, description of spacecraft?

Yes.

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00:12:30,360 --> 00:12:35,520

In fact, the United States Air Force Academy text that was being used at the Air Force

Academy back in 1968 indicates the most commonly reported alien is just about what ends Mrs.

Andreessen described, three to four foot high, large head, wrap around eyes, slit her

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00:12:47,240 --> 00:12:50,280

mouth, the telepathic communication.

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00:12:50,280 --> 00:12:54,440

We had a case involving an Air Force master's sergeant getting away from the housewife type

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00:12:54,440 --> 00:13:01,600

of sighting that belongs to the Air Force's Human Reliability Program.

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00:13:01,600 --> 00:13:05,680

This group consists of a very select group of people in the United States Air Force

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00:13:05,680 --> 00:13:09,360

that have passed psychiatric exams and so forth, so the cream of the crop of the Air

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00:13:09,360 --> 00:13:10,360

Force.

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00:13:10,360 --> 00:13:14,760

He went outside of Harlem in the Air Force base to watch a media shower on his way home

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00:13:14,760 --> 00:13:19,360

from a night shift, and he had an experience very similar to Betty Andreessen's experience.

The same type of occupants, the fact that they didn't walk, they floated, and an abduction

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00:13:25,160 --> 00:13:30,680

experience being put on a similar examination table given a physical examination.

There are a number of people from various walks of life that are about 200 reports that

we have on file that's under FIUFO studies that involve close and conscious of the third

kind type G where people report on board experiences, and many of the similarities which exist

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00:13:45,760 --> 00:13:48,360

between these reports are very subtle.

In some cases, they've never been published before, and this serves as a check from our

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00:13:52,480 --> 00:13:54,480

point of view on the apparent.

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00:13:54,480 --> 00:13:59,680

I say apparent because we don't approve validity that these cases have a common stimulus, which

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00:13:59,680 --> 00:14:03,720

seems on the surface to be extraterrestrial, but you can't prove that.

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00:14:03,720 --> 00:14:07,240

It might be more complex than that.

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00:14:07,280 --> 00:14:12,800

The best we can do is to take the tools of science which we do have with lack of physical

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00:14:12,800 --> 00:14:16,920

evidence in the case of the Andreessen affair and apply them just like a criminologist would

do in dealing with a criminal.

Again, the background checks, the lie detector tests, the hypnotic regression, the psychiatric

exam, and as many tools as we can apply to cases like this, which at least have convinced

us that the experience is real, and that the people believe that the experience is real

233

and that they've actually experienced this, and that they seem to be honest, industrious,

very credible people who describe something totally incredible and outside of a rational

By virtue of doing investigations that put you, Alexia, in an adversary position going

in and trying to maintain your objectivity, but personally, we believe, obviously you

believe that she believes this happened.

That's right.

But do you believe it really happened?

I can't prove it, but I just have a very, very strong feeling based upon the evidence,

not the proof, but the evidence that has been accumulated from, as I say, about 200 cases

involving people from various walks of life, from other countries, describe something very,

very similar to what the Andreessen family experienced.

It's very hard for me not to take such cases into account.

Then you have a host of other type of UFO sightings.

For example, you have the case where someone sees a UFO similar to what Mrs. Andreessen

saw, which leaves physical indentations behind in the ground, which penetrometers indicate

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00:15:37,680 --> 00:15:43,400

maybe you had a ton or two from that object sitting in the ground, or traces, electromagnetic

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00:15:43,400 --> 00:15:44,400

effects.

No hypnosis needed.

These people see this object.
