We're sent a very interesting and outstanding guest on our program this evening.

I would like to introduce my fellow hardy in this adventure, Mr. Ronald Maines, who is

And we are here to ask this gentleman questions, and we will be asking questions for the next

Our guest is Mr. Daringburger, route number 2, Mineral Wells, West Virginia.

14

Mr. Daringburger has a very interesting story to tell us this evening.

15

I will give you a thumbnail sketch to begin with.

16

Whether or not you believe in unidentified flying objects or not is not the point.

17

00:01:33,880 --> 00:01:39,160

But you believe in what you hear or see on this program is not the point.

18

We are here to talk to a man that allegedly did make contact with such an object within

19

the Prakersburg area last evening, November the 2nd, 1966, at approximately 7.00.

20

7.45 p.m.

21

00:01:55,120 --> 00:02:00,080

The incident allegedly took place on Interstate Highway 77 near the interchange of route

22

00:02:00,080 --> 00:02:02,080

number 47.

23

00:02:02,080 --> 00:02:04,360

This gentleman is a salesman in the area.

24

00:02:04,360 --> 00:02:10,400

He has been a resident of the area for the past 50 years, and he has given us permission

25

00:02:10,400 --> 00:02:15,000

to interview him, to assure his face, and to call him by name.

26

00:02:15,160 --> 00:02:23,960

This in itself takes a lot of initiative and to be very plain, a lot of know-how.

27

00:02:23,960 --> 00:02:31,320

Mr. Daringburger, in your own words, would you please relate what happened last night?

28

00:02:31,320 --> 00:02:39,360

Well, I am a salesman and I drive a truck, and last night, shortly after 7.00, I was

29

coming from Marietta, Ohio, coming down Interstate 77.

30

And just before I came to the intersection of route 47, there was a car past me.

31

He was taking me from behind, and following closely behind this car was this unidentified

32

blind object.

33

00:03:02,920 --> 00:03:09,920

And as the car behind passed me, this object was following close behind it, and it swerved

34

directly in front of my truck, turning crosswise.

35

And when it turned crosswise, it slowed down.

36

It started slowing, not abruptly or too fast, but it gave me plenty of time to step on my

37

brakes and slow down with it.

But it forced me to come to a complete stop.

As soon as I had stopped, there was a door opened in the side of this vehicle, and this

man stepped out and came directly to me, and I came to the truck.

41

He walked to the right-hand side of the truck, and he told me to roll down the window.

42

00:03:45,280 --> 00:03:51,280

He asked me to roll down the window on my right-hand side of my truck, and I had done

43

00:03:51,280 --> 00:03:53,280

what he asked.

44

00:03:53,480 --> 00:04:00,480

And this man stood there, and he first asked me what I was called, and I knew him at my

45

00:04:00,480 --> 00:04:02,480

name, and I told him my name.

46

00:04:02,480 --> 00:04:06,480

And he asked me, he said, Why are you frightened?

47

00:04:06,480 --> 00:04:09,480

He said, Don t be frightened, we wish you no harm.

48

He said, We mean you no harm, we wish you only happiness.

49

And I told him my name, and when I told him the name, he said he was called Cold.

50

That was the name that he was called by.

51

And he asked me what the city of Parkersburg, he pointed to the lights, he didn t point,

52

but he gave me the impression that he was pointing, and he asked me what that was called.

53

And I told him it was Parkersburg, it was a city, a town, and he asked me if most all

54

the people lived in this city or town.

55

And I explained to him that it was a place of business, it s where we transacted our

56

business, but the people lived in communities, outlying communities, most of the people.

And when I told him that this was a city, he said a huge, or his home was, that that

58

00:05:10,580 --> 00:05:13,580

was called a gathering.

59

00:05:13,580 --> 00:05:20,580

And again he told me not to be frightened, which I was, I was very frightened.

60

And as far as I can understand, this was all mental, there was no spoken words from him.

61

I knew what he was asking me, but yet he stood there and his mouth did not move.

62

He had a smile on his face, he was, he appeared very courteous, some friendly one.

63

And after I talked to him awhile, he told me he would see me, he said we will see you

64

again, and he left in his, in his, in his head.

65

Now I was at Dernberger for the sake of our television audience here, the words that you

66

use, cold, cold would be like a cold, it s his name.

67

00:06:05,080 --> 00:06:08,080

This is how it sounded to you that his name was cold.

68

00:06:08,080 --> 00:06:09,080

Yes.

69

00:06:09,080 --> 00:06:16,080

And the word gathering was like, we would know, together as far as something like that.

70

00:06:16,080 --> 00:06:19,580

Yes, that s what he meant, that was the impression that he did.

71

00:06:19,580 --> 00:06:26,580

And he did not move his lips nor utter any sound whatsoever, he talked with you in telepathy

72

00:06:26,580 --> 00:06:27,580

then.

73

00:06:27,780 --> 00:06:32,780

That is right, that his lips did not move, he uttered no words at all.

74

But you talked, I mean you, he did.

75

Yes, I talked, he told me, he told me twice that I could either talk or I could think.

76

What either would be better or easier for me.

This was an instant thing, this wasn't, there was no hesitation on his part, and on your

78

part you knew immediately what he was communicating to you, and he knew immediately what you were

That is right.

81

What did the subject, what color was the subject?

82

The subject was between a real dark gray and black, I would call it a charcoal color.

83

It glistened in my headlights, my headlights when it stopped me, my headlights were shining

84

directly on it.

85

00:07:15,780 --> 00:07:18,780

Were there lights in it?

86

No, I see no lights at any time, there was no lights in them.

87

There were windows?

88

00:07:24,380 --> 00:07:27,380

There was windows, I couldn t detect them, I couldn t see them.

89

And when the door, now you could, you had a very clear view from behind the wheel of

your van, the driver s seat of your van.

Yes.

He came forward toward you, did he tell you, did he communicate to you to roll your window

93

down before he got to the side of your truck, was he still in your headlights when he communicated?

94

He was still in my headlights walking, and I kind of got died in the way I crossed my

95

headlights to the right hand side of my truck when he told me then to roll down, if I would

96

00:08:00,980 --> 00:08:03,980

please roll down the window on the right hand side of my truck.

97

00:08:03,980 --> 00:08:10,980

In the beginning, you were driving south on 77, from Marriott, toward Mineral Wells.

98

00:08:11,980 --> 00:08:12,980

Yes.

99

00:08:12,980 --> 00:08:14,980

A car passed you.

100

00:08:14,980 --> 00:08:15,980

It did.

101

00:08:16,580 --> 00:08:19,580

Immediately behind this car of what distance?

102

00:08:19,580 --> 00:08:24,580

I would say between 25 and 30 feet, it was very close to the other car.

103

00:08:24,580 --> 00:08:30,580

It came this object hovering far off the ground, would you say?

104

00:08:30,580 --> 00:08:37,580

Well, when I first seen it, I seen it out of the corner of my eye and I first thought

105

it was just another car, and then I knew it wasn't a car almost immediately, and I turned

106

and looked at it, and I would say it was approximately 30 to 35 feet long, and it came

107

directly across past my truck and immediately turned sideways.

108

It was completely across the Tulane Highway.

109

It was completely blocked now.

110

I went partly off and rode onto the berm to try to go around it, but I couldn't get around

111

00:09:05,380 --> 00:09:06,380

it.

112

00:09:06,380 --> 00:09:09,380

Now, let me ask you something.

113

Then when it came in front of your car, may I have a, Mr. Dernberger was kind enough

114

00:09:15,380 --> 00:09:22,380

to draw a sketch of what this object appeared to him, and we'll let you see it here.

115

I'm correct then that the object came alongside of your car, veered in front of your car,

116

00:09:28,380 --> 00:09:33,180

and as you slowed, or your truck, and as you slowed your truck down, the object slowed

117

00:09:33,180 --> 00:09:37,180

down, and then when it landed, it didn't land.

118

00:09:37,180 --> 00:09:38,180

It stayed off the ground.

119

00:09:38,180 --> 00:09:45,180

Yes, it was approximately 8 to 10 inches off of the ground, and as soon as it came to

120

00:09:45,180 --> 00:09:52,180

stop immediately, there was a door on the side facing me open, and this man stepped

121

00:09:52,180 --> 00:09:57,180

out, and he started walking immediately right to the right hand side of my truck.

122

Now, listen, that would be then the picture we have on our screen right now.

123

That would be the angle your truck would be going right at that.

124

00:10:06,180 --> 00:10:07,180

Is that the idea?

125

00:10:07,180 --> 00:10:08,180

That s right.

126

00:10:08,180 --> 00:10:12,180

Now, where would the door be in that particular object there?

127

00:10:12,180 --> 00:10:17,180

It would be right for the large part of the drawing star.

128

00:10:17,180 --> 00:10:18,180

Where the hump is?

129

00:10:18,180 --> 00:10:19,180

Yes, right where the hump is.

130

00:10:19,180 --> 00:10:22,180

It would be in this direction here.

131

00:10:22,180 --> 00:10:27,180

Back toward it, right there, no, that s too far Mr. Wilson, back up front farther.

132

00:10:27,180 --> 00:10:28,180

Right there?

133

00:10:28,180 --> 00:10:29,180

Right there.

134

00:10:29,180 --> 00:10:30,180

Right there.

135

00:10:30,180 --> 00:10:36,180

It resembled just an ordinary automobile door when it opened.

136

00:10:36,180 --> 00:10:41,180

All right, now this, it didn t open from the bottom hinge or the top hinge, it opened from

137

00:10:41,180 --> 00:10:42,180

the side hinge.

138

00:10:42,180 --> 00:10:43,180

It opened from the side?

139

00:10:43,180 --> 00:10:44,180

We know.

140

00:10:44,180 --> 00:10:46,180

Yes, it opened from the side.

141

00:10:46,180 --> 00:10:51,180

How about, would you, how was this gentleman, how was this person dressed?

142

00:10:51,180 --> 00:10:54,180

What type of clothing did he wear?

143

00:10:54,180 --> 00:11:01,180

He had a top coat on and it was zippered down the front.

144

00:11:01,180 --> 00:11:10,180

His top, the top two buttons like my coat here were open and this outfit was a shiny

145

00:11:10,180 --> 00:11:13,180

material, it was a glossy outfit.

146

00:11:13,180 --> 00:11:17,180

I like it, it was metallic I suppose you would call it.

147

00:11:17,180 --> 00:11:21,180

And his shirt was a little bit darker than his jacket.

148

00:11:21,180 --> 00:11:28,180

And below his coat he had on trousers of the same kind of a cloth material and I believe

149

00:11:28,180 --> 00:11:32,180

the trousers were just a shade lighter than his coat.

150

00:11:32,180 --> 00:11:38,180

Which would have been a navy blue, the dark blue coat.

151

00:11:38,180 --> 00:11:45,180

What about the texture of his skin, the color of his skin, his eyes, eyebrows, eyelashes,

152

00:11:45,180 --> 00:11:49,180

hairline, what were these, what did he look like?

153

00:11:49,180 --> 00:11:54,180

He looked perfectly natural and normal in any human being.

154

00:11:54,180 --> 00:11:59,180

His face looked like he had a good tan, a deep sun tan.

155

00:11:59,180 --> 00:12:05,180

He was not too dark but it was just like he had been out in the sun a lot and had a good

156

00:12:05,180 --> 00:12:06,180

tan.

157

00:12:06,180 --> 00:12:13,180

His hair was turned straight back and it was a dark brown and he seemed to have a good

158

00:12:13,180 --> 00:12:15,180

thick head of hair.

159

00:12:15,180 --> 00:12:22,180

And his eyebrows, his face, his features were very normal and I don't believe that he looked

160

00:12:22,180 --> 00:12:27,180

any different from any other man that we'd meet on the street.

161

00:12:27,180 --> 00:12:35,180

Now this ship that he stepped out of when he came up, when he left the ship and started

162

00:12:35,180 --> 00:12:37,180

toward your truck, toward your van.

163

00:12:37,180 --> 00:12:41,180

Does ship remain there as he walked toward you?

164

00:12:41,180 --> 00:12:48,180

No, immediately as he stepped out of the truck, out of his vehicle, the door closed and the

165

00:12:48,180 --> 00:12:50,180

vehicle lifted straight up.

166

00:12:50,180 --> 00:12:56,180

It went straight, just as straight as you could point upward and it went up and I did see it.

167

00:12:56,180 --> 00:13:01,180

On an occasion as I was talking to this man, I looked up and it was still there.

168

00:13:01,180 --> 00:13:08,180

It was approximately 50 to 75 feet off the ground and it stayed there all the time this

169

00:13:08,180 --> 00:13:10,180

man was talking to me.

170

00:13:10,180 --> 00:13:17,180

Now when he talked to you, did he turn his head away as I'm turning my head away now

171

00:13:17,180 --> 00:13:24,180

or did he stare right at you or what was his movement?

172

00:13:24,180 --> 00:13:27,180

He watched me when he was talking to me.

173

00:13:27,180 --> 00:13:34,180

He looked at me directly in the face but there were several cars and several big trucks passed

174

00:13:35,180 --> 00:13:41,180

and as these big trucks passed he would turn his head and glance at the trucks.

175

00:13:41,180 --> 00:13:46,180

But there was no, did you look at the object in the air while he was talking with you?

176

00:13:46,180 --> 00:13:47,180

Did you glance up at me?

177

00:13:47,180 --> 00:13:53,180

Yes, I, in fact, I leaned forward and looked kind of out of my windshield and I could see it.

178

00:13:53,180 --> 00:13:54,180

It was still...

179

So then this communication that he had with you would not necessarily depend upon him looking

180

00:13:59,180 --> 00:14:02,180

you in the eye or anything like that, they're not evident.

181

No, no, he did not.

182

00:14:04,180 --> 00:14:10,180

In fact, when he first got out of the vehicle, when he told me to roll the window down, it

183

was impossible for him to see my eyes because I was behind my own headlights and he could

184

00:14:15,180 --> 00:14:16,180

not have done it.

185

00:14:16,180 --> 00:14:17,180

How old would you say he was?

186

00:14:17,180 --> 00:14:21,180

He looked approximately 35, 40 years old.

187

00:14:21,180 --> 00:14:24,180

He was a very nice looking man.

188

00:14:24,180 --> 00:14:25,180

He was me.

189

00:14:25,180 --> 00:14:27,180

What specifically did he say to you?

190

00:14:27,180 --> 00:14:30,180

Did he say, hi, it's a nice evening?

191

00:14:30,180 --> 00:14:32,180

Or what, I mean, why did he stop you?

192

00:14:32,180 --> 00:14:33,180

What was his...

193

00:14:33,180 --> 00:14:39,180

When he asked me to roll the window down, which I did, I rolled the window down and he told

194

00:14:39,180 --> 00:14:43,180

me, he said, I would like to talk to you.

195

00:14:43,180 --> 00:14:45,180

I just couldn't answer him.

196

00:14:45,180 --> 00:14:46,180

I just couldn't speak.

197

00:14:46,180 --> 00:14:49,180

And at that, that is the first time he told me not to be frightened.

198

00:14:49,180 --> 00:14:52,180

He said, he wished me no harm.

199

00:14:52,180 --> 00:14:55,180

And he talked a little bit in this thing.

200

00:14:55,180 --> 00:14:56,180

He asked me why.

201

00:14:56,180 --> 00:14:58,180

He said, why are you frightened of us?

202

00:14:58,180 --> 00:15:00,180

He said, we are the same as you.

203

00:15:00,180 --> 00:15:05,180

He said, we eat, we breathe, we sleep, we bleed, even as you do.

204

00:15:05,180 --> 00:15:07,180

He said, we are like you.

205

00:15:07,180 --> 00:15:10,180

And he said, please, be not frightened.

206

00:15:10,180 --> 00:15:12,180

Did he say where he was from?

207

00:15:12,180 --> 00:15:19,180

He did not say where he was from, but when he asked me what part he spoke was, and I told

208

00:15:19,180 --> 00:15:27,180

him, he said, at Christ's day or where I live, my home, he said, we call it a gathering.

209

00:15:27,180 --> 00:15:29,180

Did he say anything about him?

210

00:15:29,180 --> 00:15:30,180

Did he volunteer?

211

00:15:30,180 --> 00:15:33,180

Did he have a family?

212

00:15:33,180 --> 00:15:36,180

Did he ask you what you did for a living?

213

00:15:36,180 --> 00:15:37,180

Where you were?

214

00:15:37,180 --> 00:15:41,180

He asked me if I worked for a living.

215

00:15:41,180 --> 00:15:48,180

He asked me if I had the work to live, and I explained to him what I was.

216

00:15:48,180 --> 00:15:54,180

He even asked me where I lived, and I told him, and I told him that I was a salesman.

217

00:15:54,180 --> 00:15:57,180

And he told me that he was a searcher.

218

00:15:57,180 --> 00:15:58,180

A searcher?

219

00:15:58,180 --> 00:15:59,180

A searcher.

220

00:15:59,180 --> 00:16:01,180

But he didn't tell you what he was searching for?

221

00:16:01,180 --> 00:16:03,180

No, he didn't.

222

00:16:03,180 --> 00:16:11,180

He didn't offer me no information other than this, but at two or three times he did tell me.

223

00:16:11,180 --> 00:16:14,180

He said, Mr. Dernberger, look at me.

224

00:16:14,180 --> 00:16:16,180

He said, do not be frightened.

225

00:16:16,180 --> 00:16:17,180

Look at me.

226

00:16:17,180 --> 00:16:19,180

And I believe that I hadn't been frightened.

227

00:16:19,180 --> 00:16:29,180

I believe that if I had have looked to him, I believe that I could have understood a lot more of what he wanted me to and what I actually did.

228

00:16:29,180 --> 00:16:31,180

You just have this feeling.

229

00:16:31,180 --> 00:16:33,180

I had that feeling.

230

00:16:33,180 --> 00:16:35,180

I was very nervous.

231

00:16:35,180 --> 00:16:39,180

I was very upset after this happened.

232

00:16:39,180 --> 00:16:48,180

And after I got home and after I had calmed down, I can look back now and I see where I should have asked him questions.

233

00:16:48,180 --> 00:16:53,180

And I believe I have the impression that he would have answered these questions readily.

234

00:16:53,180 --> 00:16:55,180

He believed in flying sensors.

235

00:16:55,180 --> 00:16:59,180

I had never had believed in flying sensors before.

236

00:16:59,180 --> 00:17:03,180

I have heard about them a few times.

237

00:17:03,180 --> 00:17:06,180

I've even read in the paper about flying objects.

238

00:17:07,180 --> 00:17:10,180

But I honestly never did believe in them.

239

00:17:10,180 --> 00:17:12,180

Do you believe in them now?

240

00:17:12,180 --> 00:17:15,180

I believe in what I've seen last night.

241

00:17:15,180 --> 00:17:20,180

I believe it was, I don't believe it was a false air, but I believe it was an alien.

242

00:17:20,180 --> 00:17:25,180

Some kind of an aircraft, a spacecraft or something.

243

00:17:25,180 --> 00:17:28,180

Mr. Dernberger, we have a program on radio called the Joe Pine Show.

244

00:17:28,180 --> 00:17:44,180

And Mr. Pine interviews extraordinary people in various, that are involved in various occupations and some non-occupational type of businesses.

245

00:17:44,180 --> 00:17:47,180

And have you ever heard of Joe Pine?

246

00:17:47,180 --> 00:17:50,180

No, I have. I don't believe I have.

247

00:17:50,180 --> 00:18:03,180

Alright, and one of his recent broadcasts, he talked with a man, he interviewed a man who had not only had somewhat similar experience to what you had last evening.

248

But this gentleman went one step further and he had been taken aboard a spaceship, which by the way was described quite similarly to what you described this particular ship.

249

And this ship, with these people who looked like we do and so forth, took him to Venus and took him to Mars and brought him back home again.

What would you think of a story like that if somebody told it to you?

What would you think of the person telling you that story? Would you believe that now? Would you believe that that could be possible?
