Well, I have 17 sources of information concerning a number of crashes throughout the United States,

These will be presented in my talk in Dayton, and since then I've added eight more sources, which will not be in the paper.

Some of these sources will be used in the form of a Denda.

191

Two of them are so super sensitive, I'm not quite sure at this time if I can use them.

close encounters, live encounters.

This too will be presented by Ted Losher, who was collected over 1800 close encounter cases in his catalog, live encounters.

If there is a reaction to what we present, relate, and it does make APUP, CBS, ABC and NBC.

We have had close links with England, Australia, New Zealand, and other countries.

We depend on us for our technology and where we're going to do proper research and it's going to be very good to work in concerted actions in this area.

In reference to my work at the United Nations for one week last winter, I was asked by the Prime Minister of Grenada to work with his ambassadors and presenting hopefully at the United Nations 32nd Assembly to introduce a committee, a working group within the United Nations.

I gave my full support of that. This was known to the United States government and I even advised them on the approach to the anti-Meditation.

343

I knew what was going on sort of behind the scenes. I realized the United States put much pressure right there when they called.

And some of their comments. Pressure was on heavy.

348

This is a good wedge, a good weapon used against nations if they don't behave according to the way we like.

350

This has been Carter's approach now. What about human rights in South Africa? Human rights here and there.

351

And the same thing, the same tourniquet was applied to Grenada because there was intelligence information that I was aware of that they were playing Panky with Chile.

He was communist. I was with the Prime Minister. I was by the Prime Minister sitting on dirt that ran his news conference when he was drilled by two reporters on this.

353

354

They have no common affiliations with regards to what the United States may charge.

However, what I will not give to the Prime Minister is the additional data that I'm aware of, which is even more sensitive.

Bob Oldridge, I guess everybody, a lot of the people here know I was with NASA.

370

But you've suggested that there are six, maybe seven, and I didn't count how many of these retrievals.

We maintain the Manhattan Project with several thousand people and we're very successful in keeping the main bit of information,

ensuring that projects are way for the public.

380

When there were many enemy airs listed in it, and I think we were very successful there,

381

00:35:27,820 --> 00:35:31,820

and the thousands of people involved in the development of the town were long,

382

00:35:31,820 --> 00:35:39,820

it's not quite that difficult to maintain around a thousand people involved with top security,

383

00:35:39,820 --> 00:35:43,820

especially when they ought to sign letters, practically signing their life away,

384

00:35:43,820 --> 00:35:48,820

that they were to reveal it, and this is not true.

385

00:35:48,820 --> 00:35:50,820

It is part of the question I'm interested in.

386

00:35:50,820 --> 00:35:56,820

If you have talked to informants and cut through these informants,

387

00:35:56,820 --> 00:36:00,820

could you get an idea of how many people might be involved,

388

00:36:00,820 --> 00:36:04,820

or how many groups of investigators might be involved?

389

00:36:04,820 --> 00:36:05,820

Well, yes.

390

00:36:05,820 --> 00:36:07,820

You're going to hone in either now or later.

391

00:36:07,820 --> 00:36:11,820

I would not have access to the total information or something like that,

392

00:36:11,820 --> 00:36:13,820

but I'm just lucky what I got.

393

00:36:13,820 --> 00:36:17,820

I would know that the National Act of Contingent or the people involved,

394

00:36:17,820 --> 00:36:22,820

whether it's involved in a Colonel's man involving a squad,

395

00:36:22,820 --> 00:36:28,820

you know, security police officers or whatever team they were.

396

00:36:28,820 --> 00:36:34,820

This is very difficult to answer because actually it would not be a position to really know the number,

397

00:36:34,820 --> 00:36:40,820

but I suppose the logistics involved in a retrieval would require a number of people

398

00:36:40,820 --> 00:36:44,820

with some good muscles and some good machinery to go to them there.

399

I could say that could be better.

400

I'm guessing, but probably involved in all the retrievals since retrievals began

Now, technical people, people in the medical area are specialists in metallurgy,

403

whatever, people of that kind.

These people could be worked with pretty reasonably and would maintain a secret.

405

Now, your lucid times would come amongst those who were doing the brawn work,

406

heavy work, truck drivers, the what-have-you type.

407

But again, these people are available who would be very willing to keep that secret

408

00:37:28,820 --> 00:37:32,820

and that doesn't exceed a thousand or so.

409

I would admit that if you got involved with fifty thousand people,

410

it would be pretty difficult to maintain a secret.

I have been able to get information from twenty-seven of them.

The direction that my government is, to me, in a thousand might be an expanded...

So I was interested in that, to trust.

I believe it was a lead cadre, the ships here and there, and every part of the news...

who move and most knows any area where retrieval is necessary.

Could you speculate or enlighten us in that direction?
