right. And the locality of the observation?

between Monroe and Alliance on State Route 80 to Junction 153.

I see. And how long did you view the object?

14

3 to 4 minutes. 3 to 4 minutes.

Describe the weather conditions. The type of sky, bright daylight, nighttime dust, etc.

16

nighttime clear. Nighttime and clear. Any moon?

17

yes. Stars? yes.

18

00:01:12,000 --> 00:01:16,000

Did you see more than one object? yes. Two.

19

Two objects. Describe the appearance of the objects in detail.

20

They were bluish white and off long.

21

00:01:26,000 --> 00:01:33,000

They, when they were at a distance and when they came in close, the one,

22

the one came down low and come very bright.

23

00:01:40,000 --> 00:01:46,000

Very bright. Now I'll ask you some of the questions later on which will bear on this a little bit more.

24

Did the objects appear to stand still at any time?

25

00:01:50,000 --> 00:01:54,000

Just once. Just once and for how long?

26

00:01:54,000 --> 00:01:58,000

About a minute. About a minute. Did they suddenly speed up and rush away?

27

00:01:58,000 --> 00:02:02,000

Yes. Did they break up in the process?

28

00:02:02,000 --> 00:02:06,000

No. Did they give up any smoke?

29

00:02:06,000 --> 00:02:14,000

At a distance, they looked like there might be a slight vapor trail. I couldn't say for sure.

30

00:02:14,000 --> 00:02:17,000

I see. Did they drop anything?

31

00:02:17,000 --> 00:02:20,000

Did they? Did they drop anything?

32

00:02:20,000 --> 00:02:24,000

Did they change brightness?

33

00:02:24,000 --> 00:02:27,000

No, except when the one came down low.

34

00:02:27,000 --> 00:02:29,000

Changed shade? No.

35

00:02:29,000 --> 00:02:35,000

Changed color? No. Right. The one that came down low, it came very bright.

36

Very bright. But did it change color though?

37

No, it would turn more or less from a bluish white to a real bright white.

38

I see. Did the object at any time pass behind anything or in front of anything?

39

No. That is a earthly object on the ground.

40

No. Was there any wind?

41

Very little.

42

00:02:57,000 --> 00:03:02,000

Did you observe the object through the windshield or glasses or binoculars or anything like that?

43

I first observed it through the windshield on the ground, the car and watched it.

44

And you got what I said exposed?

45

00:03:09,000 --> 00:03:11,000

Right. I had to have it.

46

Was there any accompanying sound?

47

No, I didn't hear any. It would probably be two point away from me to hear any sound anyway.

48

Were the objects fuzzy or blurred like a bright star or sharply outlined?

49

00:03:24,000 --> 00:03:27,000

They were sharply outlined.

50

00:03:27,000 --> 00:03:31,000

Shuttered at a distance it would be blurred when it first came up in the southeast.

51

00:03:31,000 --> 00:03:38,000

From the southeast. Did you think the object had its own light within or was it reflecting or dull finished?

52

00:03:38,000 --> 00:03:41,000

No, it had. I would say it had its own light.

53

00:03:41,000 --> 00:03:43,000

Had its own light.

54

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:47,000

Did the object rise or fall while in motion?

55

00:03:47,000 --> 00:03:48,000

No.

56

00:03:48,000 --> 00:03:50,000

Did one of them come up?

57

00:03:50,000 --> 00:03:52,000

Except the one that came down, right?

58

00:03:52,000 --> 00:03:56,000

I see. Could you give us the apparent signs of the object when compared with the following?

59

How did arms length of pinhead, a pea, a dime, a nickel, a half dollar?

60

00:04:00,000 --> 00:04:04,000

I would say about a dime at a distance.

61

00:04:04,000 --> 00:04:15,000

And when a one came down below, probably could hold a nickel out in the bright light and still come out around the nickel.

62

00:04:15,000 --> 00:04:21,000

Well, you mean in other words the left area awaiting the object would have covered you in a quarter possibly?

63

00:04:21,000 --> 00:04:22,000

Possibly.

64

00:04:22,000 --> 00:04:23,000

I see.

65

00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:30,000

Now, did you ever notice the object? How did you ever notice the object in the first place?

66

00:04:30,000 --> 00:04:41,000

I just sitting there at the intersection of very traffic and I just glanced up the sky and saw them coming up from the southeast.

67

From the southeast? Could you describe how they traveled towards you?

68

From southeast to northwest.

69

00:04:50,000 --> 00:04:56,000

And after they got over me they all us spared off to the northeast and went directly east.

Did they ever stop?

71

Yes, once. When the one came down low, the other one stayed up high and hovered over.

72

In other words, they did stop. For how long do you think they stopped?

Approximately a minute.

74

Approximately a minute.

75

And they came to the southeast and traveled towards the northwest to begin with.

76

And then they changed direction in which direction?

77

How could they come over and stop over and directly east?

78

Directly east from there.

79

Could you estimate the distance of the object from you?

80

Just, I know it's a very tough thing to do.

81

When they, when I was close or far, when they stopped?

82

When they stopped they were, oh, maybe the one that was way up, I suppose,

83

00:05:46,000 --> 00:05:49,000

it was probably a mile or more up in the air, maybe more than that.

84

00:05:49,000 --> 00:05:54,000

The one that came down low, couldn't have been more than,

85

00:05:54,000 --> 00:05:57,000

well, I doubt it could be a half a mile away.

86

It was probably a thousand feet up maybe.

87

So how's we think?

88

Did it throw any light on the ground?

89

00:06:04,000 --> 00:06:07,000

No, I don't believe, they would be too far away for me to see.

90

I see.

91

00:06:08,000 --> 00:06:09,000

But it was on the ground.

92

00:06:09,000 --> 00:06:11,000

It lit up enough that it possibly could have.

93

00:06:11,000 --> 00:06:15,000

How did the object disappear from view?

94

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:21,000

When it came down low it just lit up like somebody turned the lights on when they just sort of dimmed out

95

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:24,000

and disappeared directly to the east.

96

00:06:24,000 --> 00:06:26,000

I mean, did they disappear from distance?

97

00:06:26,000 --> 00:06:28,000

No, they didn't do it more than that.

98

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:31,000

It seemed to just dim the lights and took off.

99

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:33,000

And would you didn't see them?

100

How long since they've been in there in the air?

101

After you saw them hover for the minute that you said that they hovered

102

and one came down toward you and then finally they changed direction

103

and went the other way to the east, how long did it take for them to disappear?

104

It would be no time at all, they just disappeared about a few seconds.

A few seconds?

You see, they disappeared after hovering in the same position,

107

they disappeared in a very few seconds.

108

It seemed like a very short time to you.

109

Yes.

110

00:07:04,000 --> 00:07:07,000

What approximate elevation were they?

111

30 degrees, 45 degrees when they stopped?

112

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:12,000

Or were they overhead?

113

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:14,000

No, they weren't overhead.

114

00:07:17,000 --> 00:07:20,000

Could you point with your hand and try to imagine for me?

115

00:07:20,000 --> 00:07:22,000

Maybe.

116

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:25,000

But this must be, what, 30 degrees?

117

Just about 30 to 35 degrees, yes.

118

30 to 35 degrees, and maybe even less, about 30 degrees.

Yes.

And were there any conventional objects in the sky like aircraft?

121

No, no.

What about afterwards?

And were there anybody, could you compare the speed of the objects

125

once they came from the horizon in the southeast toward you?

126

Were they like a piston craft, like a jet craft, or much faster?

127

00:07:56,000 --> 00:07:58,000

Much faster.

128

Much faster than what?

129

00:08:00,000 --> 00:08:04,000

Then the jet, they just came about the southeast,

130

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:09,000

and in that period of four minutes, they came from completely out of sight,

131

00:08:09,000 --> 00:08:14,000

through from the southeast up to where I was at, hovering there and disappeared to the east.

132

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:18,000

And when they took off, going away from you, did they seem to be going very fast?

133

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:19,000

Yes.

134

00:08:19,000 --> 00:08:20,000

Faster than a jet?

135

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:21,000

Yes.

136

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:25,000

Do you have any other witnesses with you?

137

No.

138

00:08:26,000 --> 00:08:27,000

Just by yourself?

139

00:08:27,000 --> 00:08:28,000

Yes.

140

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:34,000

About seven miles away, there were two Minerva policemen that observed at the same time I did it.

141

Then I went to Minerva, checked with them, the CSA,

142

00:08:37,000 --> 00:08:41,000

decided the same object I had, and they advised they had,

143

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:45,000

and I asked them what they saw and they advised that they saw everything that I did,

144

00:08:45,000 --> 00:08:49,000

and they did the same thing that I'm saying right now.

145

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:54,000

But you were not in connection with one another, telling each other things while you were watching?

146

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:58,000

No, I went down to check to see if anyone else had seen it,

147

00:08:58,000 --> 00:09:00,000

and see if I was nuts.

148

00:09:00,000 --> 00:09:04,000

And you found out then that somebody else had done the same observing you did.

149

00:09:04,000 --> 00:09:05,000

Right.

150

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:07,000

Is there an airport around the area?

151

00:09:07,000 --> 00:09:09,000

Military or governmental research installation?

152

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:12,000

Is there an airport around here, close by?

153

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:16,000

There's one in the Akron Canton airport, but it's directly west.

154

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:17,000

Directly west?

155

00:09:17,000 --> 00:09:18,000

Yes.

156

00:09:18,000 --> 00:09:20,000

And you don't think it was an aircraft?

157

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:21,000

No, I know it wasn't.

158

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:22,000

I see.

159

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:27,000

Have you ever seen other objects of this nature, under the fights?

160

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:30,000

Yes, about ten years ago.

161

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:31,000

About ten years ago?

162

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:32,000

Yes.

163

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:34,000

I saw seven of them.

164

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:35,000

Seven of them?

165

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:36,000

Right.

166

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:40,000

Could you give us just some kind of a quick description of those?

167

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:42,000

That seems to be a case in itself.

168

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:50,000

They also came up directly from the southeast, and they more or less,

169

00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:55,000

act like they were playing games with each other, and flying around,

170

00:09:55,000 --> 00:09:58,000

and more or less hubbub for a while, and take off.

171

00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:03,000

They more or less came directly overhead, and they went directly east also.

172

00:10:03,000 --> 00:10:04,000

Is that right?

173

00:10:04,000 --> 00:10:05,000

No.

174

00:10:05,000 --> 00:10:09,000

In other words, there were like a swarm of bees, or a swarm of mosquitoes flying around,

175

00:10:09,000 --> 00:10:14,000

or like aircraft making dyes and things like that.

176

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:21,000

In other words, you thought that they must have been almost like they were just having fun.

177

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:22,000

Right.

178

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:24,000

They were less like they were playing games.

179

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:26,000

And how would you describe those objects?

180

00:10:26,000 --> 00:10:28,000

Were they just licensed guys or what?

181

00:10:28,000 --> 00:10:31,000

No, they were, they looked just the same as these here,

182

00:10:31,000 --> 00:10:33,000

they never kept them low.

183

00:10:33,000 --> 00:10:34,000

They were hot.

184

00:10:34,000 --> 00:10:35,000

Right.

185

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:45,000

Did these, did this object that you described to us, that you saw on the 18th here, Tuesday,

186

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:48,000

would you describe them as round or just a straight oblong?

187

00:10:48,000 --> 00:10:49,000

What do you mean by oblong?

188

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:50,000

Like a brick?

189

00:10:50,000 --> 00:10:57,000

No, no, they, maybe not quite as oblong as an egg.

190

00:10:57,000 --> 00:11:02,000

You could use an egg and cut it down in half or so, I guess.

191

00:11:02,000 --> 00:11:03,000

Cut in half?

192

00:11:03,000 --> 00:11:10,000

That would be at the angle that I was looking at when they came up out of the southeast

193

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:11,000

of the Polnus oblong.

194

00:11:11,000 --> 00:11:19,000

In other words, the one side of it was flat, like the cutting an egg in half, which half,

195

found the long ways, or the short side.

196

Right.

197

The long ways.

198

00:11:25,000 --> 00:11:26,000

Long ways.

Did you see an actual hump such as that?

200

No, I didn't see a hump.

201

I mean...

202

I know what you're talking about.

203

00:11:34,000 --> 00:11:36,000

You're talking about the oval shape, right?

204

00:11:36,000 --> 00:11:37,000

Right.

205

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:39,000

Right, so you're looking at the flat side, right?

206

00:11:39,000 --> 00:11:44,000

You couldn't see any definite shape such as a, whether it was rounded at the top, like

207

a dome or anything like that?

208

No, it didn't more or less look to me like just being flat, only was hollow.

209

And there was no material, which you could see, nothing different, nothing solid like

210

to see on an airplane?

211

No.

212

Nothing black, no black things outlined in the back of the light?

213

No, just...

214

Frequently this light.

215

Right.

216

00:12:05,000 --> 00:12:06,000

Right.

217

Right.

218

Right.

219

00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:11,000

Were you interrogated by anybody else?

220

00:12:11,000 --> 00:12:15,000

By the Air Force, federal, state of county officials?

221

00:12:15,000 --> 00:12:22,000

No, I guess I'm going to be interrogated by Ray Patterson, Air Force Base.

222

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:24,000

You will be, right?

223

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

Did they tell you when?

224

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:28,000

They said they would get in contact with you.

225

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:29,000

I see.

226

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:32,000

Well, I'm glad I'm here before they are.

227

00:12:32,000 --> 00:12:35,000

Were you told not to discuss the Zinsus by anybody?

228

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:36,000

No.

229

00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:37,000

I don't know.

230

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:40,000

So, may we have permission to put your name?

231

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:45,000

This will encourage others to report similar observations to our group, FSIC.

232

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:49,000

If you prefer, we will keep your name confidential.

233

Yes.

234

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:51,000

Right?

235

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:53,000

Thank you very, very much.

236

Is there anything that you had in mind at the time when you were watching this object?

237

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:02,000

Could you tell us something about your thinking?

238

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:11,000

Were you surprised or were you cool and collected as you watched?

239

00:13:11,000 --> 00:13:15,000

I think I was cool and collected.

240

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:22,000

Like I said, I thought I saw them before, about ten years ago, and I saw that movie, UFO,

241

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:29,000

and some of the actual pictures that were taken, taking that, some of the actual films in that movie.

242

These objects compared to those, just exactly.

243

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:42,000

Well, we thank you very, very much for your very generous act here,

244

00:13:42,000 --> 00:13:49,000

for giving us this wonderful interview, and this is Mark Kondusso terminating the interview

245

on the 19th of September at around 12 o'clock at night.

246

Thank you very, very much.

247

This is Mark Kondusso signing off.

248

This is Mark Kondusso continuing, making some additions after the fact, of course,

249

of McCurry's signing just described.

250

He said that the object that had come down, the objects had come up from the southeast to a point 35 degrees

251

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:20,000

in elevation, stopped there, waited there for about a half a minute to a minute,

252

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:26,000

and then the left-hand one, the one on the left-hand side, dropped down to an altitude of about a thousand feet from the earth.

253

00:14:26,000 --> 00:14:30,000

I think you heard him say that, and it brightened up considerably.

254

00:14:30,000 --> 00:14:37,000

Now, what happened was that it rejoined its partner upstairs and then took off to the east.

255

00:14:37,000 --> 00:14:42,000

This is one of the points that I ascertained after the fact, after this interview.

256

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:51,000

Now, as to the previous interviews on the tape, Delmus Early was interviewed first at the police station in Minerva,

257

and Patroman Nelson was interviewed at his home outside of Minerva.

258

00:14:58,000 --> 00:15:03,000

And they were interviewed, of course, you know the dates.

259

00:15:03,000 --> 00:15:08,000

All I wanted to point out was that there were independent interviews every one.

260

00:15:08,000 --> 00:15:14,000

Nobody was in the same room, none of the sifers were together in the same room.

261

00:15:14,000 --> 00:15:24,000

And another point that has to be made is that none of the sifers themselves notified each other when they were watching these objects.

262

And I suppose that's just about all the comments I have to make. Thank you.
