Regarding what was seen by you at the site, did you see the indentations or tracks while they were still very fresh?

Yeah, I'm the data editor the next morning and that was Saturday morning.

And before hundreds of people had gotten the chance to literally do all the tracks.

What was your impression of these tracks? Do you think they were made by a heavy object or by a light object or by a digging out or what?

I would say a heavy object coming down very slowly and made a full fire of each depression in a comparatively hard sand there in the grove.

And the even longer they were alive.
