We're speaking now with Mayor Wolf of Wannapy

and reporter Howard Bell, ball of what paper?

9

Patterson News.

10

Now, Howard, do you want to proceed with what you started to say before?

11

I'll give you the background, basically.

12

I said newspaper editor.

13

00:00:54,000 --> 00:00:59,000

I sit in a desk and on a night, I may handle

14

three and four telephone calls of sightings in the sky.

15

So I've gotten into the habit.

16

00:01:06,000 --> 00:01:10,000

On my way to work, when I'm traveling in the dark, I scan the sky.

17

00:01:10,000 --> 00:01:12,000

I've learned a little bit about the sky.

18

00:01:12,000 --> 00:01:15,000

So that when someone calls, I can answer a question.

19

00:01:15,000 --> 00:01:19,000

I saw this and it was not what you think it was.

20

00:01:19,000 --> 00:01:24,000

It was Jetliner 7-Star, which is out of Newark and fly across the sky at this time of night.

21

00:01:24,000 --> 00:01:26,000

On this particular evening was Tuesday.

22

00:01:26,000 --> 00:01:31,000

I was a little bit late for work, so I left my home around 6.15.

23

00:01:31,000 --> 00:01:32,000

This was what evening?

24

00:01:32,000 --> 00:01:36,000

This was Tuesday, like January, and it would be the 11th.

25

00:01:36,000 --> 00:01:38,000

January 11th.

26

00:01:38,000 --> 00:01:43,000

I left my home and I traveled to the city of Patterson to work.

27

00:01:43,000 --> 00:01:47,000

I traveled via the Hamburg Turnpike.

28

00:01:47,000 --> 00:01:50,000

It was a fairly well-traveled road.

29

00:01:50,000 --> 00:01:53,000

My home is Pomp and Lakes.

30

00:01:53,000 --> 00:02:00,000

About five minutes on the road, I'd say a 20 minutes past six on that date,

31

the newsman on the radio was ballet-hooling the 6.30 news.

32

00:02:05,000 --> 00:02:08,000

I know it was before 6.30.

33

00:02:08,000 --> 00:02:16,000

I was at the near, I should say, near the junction of Colfax Road and Hamburg Turnpike.

34

00:02:17,000 --> 00:02:25,000

At this point, Hamburg Turnpike lies in the southeast-ily direction.

35

00:02:25,000 --> 00:02:29,000

I was, in other words, traveling southeast-ily.

36

00:02:29,000 --> 00:02:36,000

I saw, as I crested a hill, a very extremely bright light.

37

00:02:36,000 --> 00:02:38,000

Could you compare it to a landing light?

38

00:02:38,000 --> 00:02:45,000

No, I couldn't, because it didn't have the downward beam that I've seen on the landing lights.

39

00:02:45,000 --> 00:02:48,000

I would say this about it.

40

00:02:48,000 --> 00:02:53,000

The thing that really brought my attention to it was that as I traveled along,

41

00:02:53,000 --> 00:02:59,000

in general, a light, a starlight, will seem to travel with you.

42

00:02:59,000 --> 00:03:01,000

This didn't. This seemed to come at me.

43

00:03:01,000 --> 00:03:04,000

I got a red light and stopped.

44

00:03:04,000 --> 00:03:10,000

I kept it in observation while the red light was, let's say, about a minute in the length of time.

45

00:03:10,000 --> 00:03:12,000

It takes a light to change.

46

00:03:12,000 --> 00:03:18,000

In that time, it stopped and it made a transverse movement.

47

00:03:18,000 --> 00:03:24,000

I can't tell you on feet or miles, but it did make a transverse movement through the west.

48

00:03:24,000 --> 00:03:28,000

I was observing it in the southeast.

49

00:03:28,000 --> 00:03:38,000

When it made its transverse movement, it forwarded again and then took south-south-east to northwest course.

50

00:03:38,000 --> 00:03:43,000

I don't think this could have been the planet Venus, because at 6.20 pm,

51

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:48,000

according to what I think, Venus would have been in the southwest at that time.

52

00:03:48,000 --> 00:03:53,000

I wouldn't have been able to see it because there's a tree cover at this particular place.

53

00:03:53,000 --> 00:03:56,000

Of course, it was an afterthought. I would fly there again.

54

00:03:56,000 --> 00:03:59,000

There's a tree cover and I couldn't definitely see that portion of the sky.

55

00:03:59,000 --> 00:04:01,000

How high in the sky was this light that you saw?

56

00:04:01,000 --> 00:04:05,000

I say it was 12 o'clock hot.

57

00:04:05,000 --> 00:04:09,000

From the horizon to the zenith?

58

00:04:09,000 --> 00:04:14,000

From the horizon to the zenith. This was 60 degrees.

59

00:04:14,000 --> 00:04:16,000

Pretty much overhead then?

60

00:04:16,000 --> 00:04:21,000

Yes, and it passed over my head. I pulled to the side of the road in my face.

61

00:04:21,000 --> 00:04:25,000

I lost it. It went over my head and out of sight.

62

00:04:25,000 --> 00:04:29,000

The light I saw was of a bright brilliance.

63

00:04:29,000 --> 00:04:35,000

I'd say 16 or 17 times the brilliance of any planet or star I've ever seen.

64

00:04:35,000 --> 00:04:43,000

I would say also that I tried very, very much to look around and see if there were red or green running lights

65

00:04:43,000 --> 00:04:49,000

or any of the associated aircraft characteristics, and I couldn't find any.

66

00:04:49,000 --> 00:04:54,000

I didn't hear anything. I was inside the automobile and I didn't think to roll the window down.

67

00:04:54,000 --> 00:05:01,000

I observed the entire thing through the windshield and through the back window.

68

00:05:01,000 --> 00:05:06,000

But I could see it go back over my head in the northwest direction.

69

00:05:06,000 --> 00:05:08,000

You recall the weather conditions?

70

00:05:08,000 --> 00:05:10,000

Right and clear.

71

00:05:10,000 --> 00:05:13,000

And about how long did this last? How long did you have it?

72

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:18,000

I had it in observation. Three minutes, four minutes.

73

00:05:18,000 --> 00:05:20,000

Did you see it over the reservoir?

74

00:05:20,000 --> 00:05:21,000

I didn't know.

75

00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:27,000

Did you see any sign of the red beam that was reported?

76

00:05:27,000 --> 00:05:28,000

I didn't see any.

77

00:05:28,000 --> 00:05:30,000

What color? Was there any color to it?

78

00:05:30,000 --> 00:05:38,000

No. I can give it a color. If I could give it a color, I'd say brilliant blue-white.

79

00:05:39,000 --> 00:05:47,000

Similar to the ignition of a magnesium and pure oxygen.

80

00:05:47,000 --> 00:05:51,000

Really bright light.

81

00:05:51,000 --> 00:05:53,000

Did it travel very fast?

82

00:05:53,000 --> 00:06:00,000

No, I didn't notice it travel. It traveled a little better than the speed of an aircraft.

83

00:06:00,000 --> 00:06:03,000

I figure those things are relative.

84

00:06:03,000 --> 00:06:10,000

I believe I started to think much higher than the people in Wanakiu.

85

00:06:10,000 --> 00:06:12,000

I think it was at a greater height.

86

00:06:12,000 --> 00:06:16,000

Now while you were watching it, what thoughts went through your mind as to what it might have been?

87

00:06:16,000 --> 00:06:21,000

I thought it was a helicopter with a bright strobe light.

88

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:27,000

Which is one of the things I told the Air Force that I thought it was.

89

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:29,000

I think they mouthed it back.

90

00:06:29,000 --> 00:06:35,000

I'd like to explain things. We have the telephone calls coming in.

91

00:06:35,000 --> 00:06:37,000

I tried to think of what I could tell people this was.

92

00:06:37,000 --> 00:06:39,000

I couldn't come up with an answer.

93

00:06:39,000 --> 00:06:45,000

When I got to work, I decided I wouldn't say anything about it to anybody.

94

00:06:45,000 --> 00:06:48,000

Then we started getting telephone calls.

95

00:06:48,000 --> 00:06:53,000

I tried to explain to a woman what it was, but I couldn't.

96

00:06:53,000 --> 00:07:01,000

Then I got in contact with one of our police departments who handled the radio network for the entire area.

97

00:07:01,000 --> 00:07:04,000

I spoke with officer Severin.

98

00:07:04,000 --> 00:07:10,000

I told officer Severin we had a number of calls and he indicated that they had a number of calls.

99

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:12,000

What time was this?

100

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:16,000

This was in the area of 7.15 or 7.30.

101

00:07:16,000 --> 00:07:21,000

I got it in Patterson at 20 minutes of 7.

102

00:07:21,000 --> 00:07:28,000

At about 7.15 or 7.30 the thing was starting to shake up that other people were making the same.

103

00:07:28,000 --> 00:07:32,000

All through the night we got telephone calls.

104

00:07:32,000 --> 00:07:35,000

Then I heard that Mayor Wolf of Guantanamo had seen it.

105

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:40,000

I called Harry, friend of mine, and we discussed it.

106

00:07:40,000 --> 00:07:44,000

Much of what we saw was the same thing.

107

00:07:44,000 --> 00:07:50,000

Incidentally, the course of North-North-West from the corner of Colfax Road

108

00:07:50,000 --> 00:07:55,000

and Hamburg Turnpike leads directly to Raymond Vann.

109

00:07:55,000 --> 00:08:01,000

I didn't know it before, but I put a map down this morning and drew a line, which is very inaccurate, but it does.

110

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:08,000

We got a lot of current calls and I must admit that a lot of people saw airplanes that night.

111

00:08:08,000 --> 00:08:12,000

I can identify them as airplanes, people who saw red and green blinking lights

112

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:15,000

and the associated things that we associate with air.

113

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:19,000

Anything I saw with any aircraft I've ever seen.

114

00:08:19,000 --> 00:08:24,000

You know what time this story hit the radio?

115

00:08:24,000 --> 00:08:27,000

What time it hit radio?

116

00:08:27,000 --> 00:08:34,000

When I called WJRZ radio stations to find out if their helicopter was in the air,

117

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:38,000

they already knew about it. They had already had telephone calls.

118

00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:47,000

I called them 7.05, something like that, in the area at 7 o'clock.

119

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:53,000

I had seen the thing and I was interested, but I want to know what it is.

120

00:08:53,000 --> 00:09:00,000

I'm trying to get some idea of when the story might have gone out, it was a radio to alert people.

121

00:09:00,000 --> 00:09:06,000

I think he said that they were interested in it at that point, but I don't think they had broadcasted it.

122

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:13,000

I think they made their initial broadcast on radio sometime around 7.30, in their 7.30 newscast.

123

00:09:13,000 --> 00:09:16,000

Had you gotten crank calls prior to that?

124

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:21,000

We had calls prior to that, but we didn't have the crank calls until we were on radio, actually.

125

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:24,000

That got the people excited.

126

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:32,000

Mayor, do you want to give us a rundown on your experience at 7.30?

127

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:41,000

Yes, I'll give you a little background on Tuesday evening, I guess that's what we were 11 talking about.

128

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:47,000

I was scheduled to leave early dinner, which we naturally did.

129

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:56,000

With Councilman Barton and Councilman Warren-Hagstrom,

130

00:09:56,000 --> 00:10:05,000

I was ready and supposed to be picked up approximately about 5.27 after a little delay in seeing they weren't being picked up.

131

00:10:05,000 --> 00:10:07,000

This was probably just a little after 7.

132

00:10:07,000 --> 00:10:15,000

I made a call to Councilman Barton's house and his wife told me she's not your hero.

133

00:10:15,000 --> 00:10:25,000

I was on the news on the radio and of course she was referring to the police radio, which I report from the Warranty Reservoir Police.

134

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:32,000

Apparently, the Warranty Reservoir Police, that he was seeing something there.

135

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:40,000

Well, just a couple of minutes later, Councilman Barton and Councilman Hagstrom came by.

136

00:10:40,000 --> 00:10:45,000

Instead of going down to dinner, we went up to the Reservoir itself.

137

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:59,000

My son, Billy, went along with us and stopped at the Reservoir Police car that was on duty there.

138

00:10:59,000 --> 00:11:06,000

About that time, a little bit of patrolman's sysco of our Warranty Police.

139

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:18,000

We went into what they call a daily track, which is the east of the Warranty Reservoir to see if we could see anything.

140

00:11:18,000 --> 00:11:23,000

The patrolman's sysco had seen something before, previous then.

141

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:24,000

This was a few minutes ago.

142

00:11:24,000 --> 00:11:28,000

I was talking about maybe 5 minutes there, 7, 10 minutes there, 7, or something of this nature.

143

00:11:28,000 --> 00:11:37,000

And we went out over there into the field, which is maybe a quarter of a mile, at least a 1 or 2 Reservoir.

144

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:40,000

And what down there is pretty dark in there.

145

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:42,000

We thought maybe we could see something down there.

146

00:11:42,000 --> 00:11:43,000

Well, I couldn't see anything.

147

00:11:43,000 --> 00:11:45,000

I don't think anybody else saw anything.

148

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:51,000

So we come back through to the Reservoir and went up on top of the Reservoir and went down there itself.

149

00:11:51,000 --> 00:12:06,000

And we went up to the top of the dam there.

150

00:12:06,000 --> 00:12:14,000

And it was myself, Councilor Clark, Councilor Hankstrom, a couple of sysco, and my son Billy.

151

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:23,000

And we were up there, and of course we were in the normally direction of the car, which was facing the normally direction.

152

00:12:23,000 --> 00:12:36,000

Over towards the Stone Town area, which I'd say is probably northwest direction,

153

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:52,000

what seemed to be low to the horizon was something that looked like a star, a little bit bigger, I would say probably a little bit brighter.

154

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:59,000

So I viewed it, and I think everyone else did, for about 3-4-5 minutes there.

155

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:05,000

And it seemed to stay in one place now.

156

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:22,000

There was a couple of brilliant syscoes, right at the start, I don't think it was as blue as the start, I would say, or something.

157

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:37,000

But it did at times seem to emit the reddish water, pale green lights, or yellowish ones, not all at the same time, at different points.

158

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:45,000

In other words, when I remember we were taking down, of course the first thing I would think of was a helicopter or anything else,

159

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:52,000

but standing and standing there was a spot for about 3-4-5 minutes, or a few of the companies wanted to met.

160

00:13:52,000 --> 00:14:03,000

And then it seemed to move over just in a straight direction, either away, or what appeared to be not coming back, but out further,

161

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:09,000

but probably going towards the south, or the southwest, or something like that.

162

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:23,000

About that time, we turned the car around, and we of course come down, and we enjoyed it more about that, basically.

163

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:34,000

I saw according to reports that the helicopter was moving up and down too, but I didn't see it moving up and down, but I was just sideways, I would say.

164

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:36,000

Did it move steadily?

165

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:49,000

Yes, it appeared to move steadily, and as I say, it was very close to the horizon, up to the top level.

166

00:14:50,000 --> 00:14:52,000

What was the total time you saw?

167

00:14:52,000 --> 00:14:55,000

All I'd say was about 10 minutes altogether.

168

00:14:55,000 --> 00:14:57,000

How much of a sky did it cross?

169

00:14:57,000 --> 00:15:08,000

Not a very great distance, in an area, left to a certain area, depending on how far it was out of support.

170

00:15:08,000 --> 00:15:13,000

From what coppers direction to what coppers direction?

171

00:15:13,000 --> 00:15:26,000

Well, we were pointing north, and we were going back towards the south, and we were pointing north, and this was a tech class, or a math class, and when we come back to Ada class, it's a pretty tech nation.

172

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:29,000

And how did it disappear?

173

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:33,000

I don't believe that it disappeared when we had the lessons.

174

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:39,000

I think it was still visible, and you laughed at it, and I would entirely believe some of this.

175

00:15:39,000 --> 00:15:46,000

I would say my man, this emitted a red beam, do you know exactly how it was activated?

176

00:15:46,000 --> 00:15:50,000

I would say it was a light green light.

177

00:15:50,000 --> 00:15:55,000

Did it seem to emit it, shoot it onto the ice of reservoir?

178

00:15:55,000 --> 00:15:57,000

We were safe from the north, and of course...

179

00:15:57,000 --> 00:16:00,000

Let me make this clear.

180

00:16:00,000 --> 00:16:10,000

When I saw it was a little bigger than a star, a lot of weight, depending on the size, or a mile away, or 10 to 15 miles away, or 10 billion miles away.

181

00:16:10,000 --> 00:16:12,000

I wouldn't know.

182

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:19,000

Yeah, I would have judged it, but that's basically what I say.

183

00:16:19,000 --> 00:16:26,000

It wasn't any shooting, any rays of light, any place, or anything like that, just looked like there was light to it.

184

00:16:27,000 --> 00:16:37,000

When the lights were there, did the main part retain its original color, and have other lights in addition, or did the whole thing change color?

185

00:16:37,000 --> 00:16:55,000

Well, I think that it was changed, and it seemed to change fairly quickly, and it comes back to its normal color, if that's what it was.

186

00:16:55,000 --> 00:16:58,000

At any time, did it make any very rapid or abrupt motion?

187

00:16:58,000 --> 00:17:01,000

No, it didn't seem to me.

188

00:17:01,000 --> 00:17:06,000

Did it move in a way similar to an airplane?

189

00:17:06,000 --> 00:17:09,000

Yes, I would say it did.

190

00:17:09,000 --> 00:17:14,000

Of course, it still did, for like 3-4-5 minutes or longer.

191

00:17:14,000 --> 00:17:24,000

I would have discounted an airplane just for that, and of course the helicopter, and whatever I could discount that, but I doubt if the helicopter would stay in the position.

192

00:17:25,000 --> 00:17:28,000

Was there any sound from this?

193

00:17:28,000 --> 00:17:32,000

Well, as I said, no sound as far as I was concerned.

194

00:17:32,000 --> 00:17:34,000

You were outside or in the whole car?

195

00:17:34,000 --> 00:17:41,000

Well, I would come out of the car, and I would come back in the car. It was really cold that night, about 15 degrees up there, so...

196

00:17:41,000 --> 00:17:44,000

When you were outside, you couldn't hear anything?

197

00:17:44,000 --> 00:17:46,000

No, no, perhaps.

198

00:17:46,000 --> 00:17:52,000

I don't know about these holes in the ice. I really think that the reservoirs also pay a lot of holes in the ice.

199

00:17:53,000 --> 00:17:56,000

Well, we had two of these.

200

00:17:56,000 --> 00:18:05,000

A company that we received stated that, with the saw, the algae he met a red beam which caught a hole in the ice, but we just wanted to...

201

00:18:05,000 --> 00:18:09,000

Some of the reservoir fellows told me they had a thing that...

202

00:18:09,000 --> 00:18:21,000

I admit, a white thing, about 9 feet in diameter on the ice, and I don't know whether it was George or who, as to observe that, but somebody thought...

203

00:18:21,000 --> 00:18:26,000

We have an additional member of the gathering here. Do you want to identify yourself?

204

00:18:26,000 --> 00:18:29,000

I'm a counselor in the hospital with a heart.

205

00:18:29,000 --> 00:18:33,000

And you were with the mayor Tuesday nights?

206

00:18:33,000 --> 00:18:36,000

Yes, we were all sleeping together.

207

00:18:36,000 --> 00:18:39,000

Do you want to describe for us what you saw?

208

00:18:39,000 --> 00:18:44,000

Well, I don't think what I saw was too very dramatic. It certainly isn't.

209

00:18:44,000 --> 00:18:50,000

The same as what's been described in the newspapers, what others have seen.

210

00:18:50,000 --> 00:18:55,000

I mean, what I saw appeared to be a star.

211

00:18:55,000 --> 00:19:05,000

And the only thing, the only fact of that made me think that it was anything at all I usual about was the fact that it was very low on the horizon,

212

00:19:05,000 --> 00:19:12,000

in a position which appeared to be lower than what I would normally expect a star to be in.

213

00:19:12,000 --> 00:19:22,000

And also, it appeared to be changing colors, but this could have been due to the fact that we're listening to the police radio at the time,

214

00:19:22,000 --> 00:19:29,000

and the police radio was talking about people calling in and saying that this was changing colors,

215

00:19:29,000 --> 00:19:35,000

and playing with the seat in my mind, which perhaps could have made me think that it was actually changing colors,

216

00:19:35,000 --> 00:19:40,000

when it may not have been. How did it appear to change color?

217

00:19:40,000 --> 00:19:48,000

Well, as I say, as you looked at it, why, you looked at it and think it was white,

218

00:19:48,000 --> 00:19:57,000

and then you would look again and it appeared to be green, and even to a degree at times red.

219

00:19:57,000 --> 00:20:04,000

Yet there was no dramatic change, where you could specifically state that it changed white to red,

220

00:20:04,000 --> 00:20:13,000

or like a very light. Yes, no, it wasn't, it wasn't. And yet, and again I don't know whether this was provoked by the fact that

221

00:20:13,000 --> 00:20:21,000

the thought was clearly in my mind by the police radio, or whether I was actually singing this,

222

00:20:21,000 --> 00:20:28,000

but I think if you look at a star or anything more, and you can almost see what you want to do in that star.

223

00:20:28,000 --> 00:20:39,000

And as I say, I could never, from what I saw, I could never go over the pinnacle of it expressed by other people.

224

00:20:39,000 --> 00:20:46,000

This man, I couldn't say it's two feet in diameter, certainly wasn't what I saw.

225

00:20:46,000 --> 00:20:55,000

It certainly wasn't close what I saw, and yet it could have been ten miles or ten million miles away.

226

00:20:55,000 --> 00:21:04,000

I mean, this point I couldn't say. I mean, I wish I had seen these things with some other people.

227

00:21:04,000 --> 00:21:13,000

I would have found it intensely interesting, but I guess we looked at it for maybe half an hour or so.

228

00:21:14,000 --> 00:21:30,000

It didn't move, I mean, it didn't move during the numbers, it wasn't moving, it was moving away from us in a straight line.

229

00:21:30,000 --> 00:21:35,000

So, it was clear to me to be stationed, or clear to me to move over to one side.

230

00:21:35,000 --> 00:21:40,000

When I said side, it went to the west or southwest, or something like that.

231

00:21:40,000 --> 00:21:46,000

Well, I'm not sure the movement was so slight that it always...

232

00:21:46,000 --> 00:21:53,000

I couldn't say that I thought that it moved at all, but it didn't move.

233

00:21:53,000 --> 00:21:58,000

Also, from the time he told me I'd say it was 5 minutes prior, I guess, my wife next to the neighbor

So I was there.

And he said that he had read about this, that there was a hole being built in the ice.

625

This is what brought him out here.

And what they always hear say again, that they were in Spencer's backyard,

I think there are a lot of holes in that ice up there, though.

634

and they had the excessive number of lights on this night, which is unusual for this house.

And they made a bad company and had the full lights on and so forth, which was sort of like that.

650

I'm not saying that these fellas didn't say, but I'm saying that we saw when we were up there.

651

Who saw that, Michael?

652

00:46:43,000 --> 00:46:48,000

Uh, Spence Dines, Custodian Diana.

653

Spenser was with him.

654

And I think Big Brumman was with him, I'm not sure.

655

There were a lot of people who saw what they wanted, like Arthur said before.

656

There were a lot of people, but there were some most observers who observed that saw the same thing, who saw the right thing.

657

Without mentioning any names or without any discrepancies,

658

673

It was very tall.

It was just my sword.

So, it was my first time in my backyard.

And of course, we had two bright lights in the house.

So, three nights in a row, it was just like a couple minutes.

And then it was around the background.

And it started to move.

753

And then it was probably just a few hours before we got to the front of the sun.

Was this thing going as faster or slower than it seemed before?

It started to be slow, right?

So, just go back to the first night when you were on the dam with your father.

It was slow over the map.

And it was sort of toward the sun, the town, and the back of the city.

Most of the time it was white.

765

And it was pretty bright.

768

Darker and brighter, sometimes to the sea.

You know, unless it was really streamlined, it was a little too beneath.

We were watching after that time, and it was two years around,

771

because we were only going to turn it into an hour.

And then we went across the dam,

773

and just turned around one minute at the end, and came back down the road.

774

We went up down the street, and when we came back, we stopped,

and we were sure to be safe, just like a little step in the sky.

Now, last night, it was on two.

783

That's Friday night.

784

We were fighting.

785

00:53:40,000 --> 00:53:42,000

We peed him, and we were getting there again.

We said he'd start and decide,

787

00:53:44,000 --> 00:53:46,000

but the same thing, we were seeing Wednesday night.

788

And it was about the same time.

789

We didn't see the same camera back, but two friends of mine,

790

and I said, two of them this time,

791

coming back in the same direction.

They said that's the same speed.

793

If we had seen one down in the east, that's the direction.

794
