Thirty-six. And where do you work?

At the police department. What's your occupation?

7

Police department. Any special training in the Army?

8

00:00:28,040 --> 00:00:31,920

Did you serve in the services? Yes. What service was it?

9

00:00:31,920 --> 00:00:35,280

As an Airman Marine Corps. And did you fly?

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00:00:35,280 --> 00:00:37,960

I had done some flying, yes, in Marine Corps. You did? Yeah.

11

00:00:37,960 --> 00:00:41,520

You consider yourself having a pretty good set of eyes even today? Oh, yeah.

12

00:00:41,520 --> 00:00:47,560

OK. What was the date of observation? It was a seventh, wasn't it? Sixth. Sixth wasn't it?

13

00:00:47,560 --> 00:00:52,080

What time was it? The approximate time? Approximately one thirty in the morning.

14

00:00:52,080 --> 00:00:56,880

That's Eastern Standard Time now. Yes. And the place where you saw the object?

15

00:00:56,920 --> 00:01:02,440

Was it a triple boulevard and quail? And quail. Were you traveling in what direction?

16

00:01:02,440 --> 00:01:06,800

I was traveling east. How long did you use the object? You know, minutes, seconds?

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00:01:06,800 --> 00:01:12,560

Well, actually it's kind of hard to tell. It wasn't very long. I'd say maybe two minutes.

18

00:01:12,560 --> 00:01:16,000

Something like that. Did you have good, what kind of a sky did you have?

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00:01:16,000 --> 00:01:18,960

And what kind of visibility? It was clear. We could see it good.

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00:01:18,960 --> 00:01:22,840

Was there clouds in the sky? Well, there may have been. I don't know.

I didn't notice actually. But it didn't look clear. It didn't rain. It wasn't raining.

Were the stars, was there a moon out? Yes, there was a moon out here. Which way was it from you?

23

00:01:32,760 --> 00:01:37,520

Well, from us it would have been, it was behind our cruiser and we was heading east.

24

00:01:37,520 --> 00:01:43,040

So from us it would have been west. Sort of west. Straight up just from us, yeah.

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00:01:43,040 --> 00:01:47,680

All right. In what direction did you see the object itself? East.

00:01:47,680 --> 00:01:53,200

You see more than one object? No, just one. All right. Now, what color was it?

27

00:01:53,320 --> 00:01:58,000

When we first seen it was yellowish gold or orangeish gold color.

28

00:01:58,000 --> 00:02:01,200

Did you ever see it behind trees or did it pass in front of trees?

29

00:02:01,200 --> 00:02:04,920

Yes. When we first seen it, you could see it through the trees.

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00:02:04,920 --> 00:02:07,160

Just just bottom portion of it. You can see through the tree.

31

00:02:07,160 --> 00:02:11,600

I'll give you a chance to tell the whole story, you know, all in one big swing in a minute here.

32

00:02:11,600 --> 00:02:14,120

Do you observe it through the windshield or did you get out of the car to see?

33

00:02:14,120 --> 00:02:17,320

And through the windshield. You didn't get out to look at all from the car.

34

00:02:17,320 --> 00:02:23,160

But it was after we had lost it the first time.

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00:02:23,160 --> 00:02:25,920

OK. You hear any sound at all? No.

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00:02:25,920 --> 00:02:30,200

Was it a clearly outlined object or was it blurred or fuzzy? No, it was clear.

You can see it. You think the light was coming from the object itself or was it reflecting lights from the city?

38

00:02:35,040 --> 00:02:38,760

No, it was coming from this. All right.

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00:02:38,760 --> 00:02:41,520

And we'll ask you about what about size?

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00:02:41,520 --> 00:02:43,280

What did it compare? How did it compare with the moon?

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00:02:43,280 --> 00:02:48,080

Did you try to compare the two? Well, compared to the moon, the moon was small compared to this object.

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00:02:48,080 --> 00:02:53,120

You see. Well, could you give me a proportion two or three times or what? Well, one and a half.

43

00:02:53,880 --> 00:02:58,800

No, it was I say twice as big as part of the one we could see.

44

00:02:58,800 --> 00:03:01,440

The diameter. Yeah. Yeah.

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00:03:01,440 --> 00:03:07,120

I would say from what we could tell at approximately 70 feet long from where we was at.

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00:03:07,120 --> 00:03:14,080

It looked. Why did you come to this estimate? How far away were you? Well, maybe a hundred yards,

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00:03:14,080 --> 00:03:19,320

one fifty yards, something like that. And how did the object disappear from view?

Well, it was sitting still when we first seen it.

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00:03:23,600 --> 00:03:27,360

And then when we stopped the cruiser and then we started to go towards you.

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00:03:27,360 --> 00:03:30,960

Go ahead and tell your whole story from now on, right in the very beginning.

We were going east on Triple Boulevard and we were at Woodstock and Triplet.

52

00:03:36,320 --> 00:03:41,920

When we spotted this object at Quail and Triplet, which is about maybe a hundred yards away,

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00:03:41,920 --> 00:03:48,720

one hundred fifty yards away. This object was sitting right behind the church there at Quail and Triplet.

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00:03:49,560 --> 00:03:51,560

And we stopped the cruiser.

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00:03:51,560 --> 00:03:55,560

One of the things I come up over, you know, kind of shakes you when you see something you've never seen before.

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00:03:55,560 --> 00:04:00,600

And with them, my buddy told me, well, let's go see what it is.

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00:04:00,600 --> 00:04:07,440

So when we got in the cruiser and started toward this object, it started to leave traveling east.

58

00:04:07,440 --> 00:04:13,320

Straight away? Yes. It didn't rise, but it started to go away from us.

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00:04:13,320 --> 00:04:21,320

It went in that direction while I couldn't say how many feet or miles for a ways.

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00:04:21,320 --> 00:04:23,320

And then it kind of veered to the left.

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00:04:23,320 --> 00:04:29,320

Now, it didn't make a sharp left, but it kind of banked like you would see an airplane bank off to the left.

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00:04:29,320 --> 00:04:34,320

And it went in this direction until we got to about a curved path, you mean? Yes.

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00:04:34,320 --> 00:04:37,320

The curved path. Did the object change shape as it curved like that?

Yeah, it seemed to kind of flatten out a little as it was going away from my idol.

I'd say accelerating, it kind of flattened out now.

66

00:04:48,400 --> 00:04:56,440

But stayed on this bank until we got to approximately Canton Road.

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00:04:56,440 --> 00:05:00,120

Then it seemed to go back in the east of the direction.

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00:05:00,120 --> 00:05:05,280

Now stayed in this direction until we got almost to Magador on Albrecht Avenue.

And it went out of sight. How?

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00:05:08,720 --> 00:05:12,520

Well, it just kept getting smaller and smaller and smaller until it got out of sight.

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00:05:12,520 --> 00:05:15,720

Just in distance? Right. It didn't get lost in any clouds or anything like that?

No, we could see it until it went out of sight.

00:05:19,280 --> 00:05:22,360

Then a few seconds later, it came back into sight.

And I told my buddy, I said, it's coming back down. Did it get larger? Yes, it got larger.

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00:05:28,360 --> 00:05:33,480

But it didn't come down, you know, as far as it was first, you know, just came down for me.

It was like three seconds that we could see it this time.

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00:05:38,520 --> 00:05:40,560

It seemed to be returning towards you. Yes.

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00:05:40,560 --> 00:05:44,960

And then it took off again and disappeared, you know, kept getting smaller and smaller.

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00:05:44,960 --> 00:05:47,320

And it took off again, and then we didn't see it anymore.

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00:05:47,320 --> 00:05:50,720

Did it appear to you that it was disappearing just like any other object, like an airplane or something like that?

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00:05:50,720 --> 00:05:53,120

It's like you was watching an airplane go away from you.

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00:05:53,120 --> 00:05:55,320

With a light in the back or something like that?

And at this time, the color of it was...

It wasn't the same color as we've seen it at first.

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00:06:02,480 --> 00:06:03,760

What was the color at first?

00:06:03,760 --> 00:06:06,400

Well, I don't know. It was kind of a silver-gray maybe.

87

00:06:06,400 --> 00:06:09,720

At first, no, it was a yellowish-orange color.

88

00:06:09,720 --> 00:06:16,480

But then as it kept getting, you know, going faster seemed like it changed its color to all kind of a whiteish color, silver-gray maybe.

89

00:06:16,480 --> 00:06:18,720

What about when it went into this curving turn?

90

00:06:18,720 --> 00:06:24,040

Yeah, that's when it started changing color and shape like, you know, it kind of flattened out.

91

00:06:24,040 --> 00:06:30,040

Well, maybe it's much like if you look at a quarter head on, and then you make the quarter flatten out a bit.

92

00:06:30,040 --> 00:06:35,840

Now, if you took that quarter head on like that and then immediately you sort of flipped it like that, you couldn't see the whole thing now.

93

00:06:35,840 --> 00:06:38,400

You see it as an oval shape, something of that nature.

94

00:06:38,400 --> 00:06:41,280

Yes, yes.

95

00:06:41,280 --> 00:06:42,920

You didn't hear a sound at all?

96

00:06:42,920 --> 00:06:45,080

You see any sparks or any smoke or anything like that coming from it?

97

00:06:45,080 --> 00:06:48,080

Sound and see no lights or nobody?

98

00:06:48,080 --> 00:06:49,920

It was standing still at one time.

99

00:06:49,920 --> 00:06:50,960

When we first seen it, yes.

100

00:06:50,960 --> 00:06:55,480

Yes. And what kind of speed was it making when it was moving away?

101

00:06:55,480 --> 00:06:59,720

What do you think? Just compared to an airplane, is the only thing you can compare it with?

102

00:06:59,760 --> 00:07:02,160

Well, when it was going away from us, it was going my first one.

103

00:07:02,160 --> 00:07:04,160

I believe in any airplane could go.

104

00:07:04,160 --> 00:07:09,680

I think it was. I believe because considering the length of time that we've seen it for this,

105

00:07:09,680 --> 00:07:17,000

I think to disappear from the size it was when we first seen it for it to go clear out of sight and us to be able to watch it go out of sight.

106

00:07:17,000 --> 00:07:22,120

How long did you think it took to go out of sight? Could you just estimate that time?

107

00:07:22,120 --> 00:07:27,080

Maybe a minute and a half. What was your altitude estimate?

108

00:07:27,120 --> 00:07:30,440

When we first seen it, when you first seen it, then went outside. Yes.

109

00:07:30,440 --> 00:07:32,320

Well, when we first seen it, it was awful, though.

110

00:07:32,320 --> 00:07:41,480

I would say maybe a hundred to two hundred feet off the ground when we looked like when we first seen it, you know, it's hard to tell.

111

00:07:41,480 --> 00:07:46,800

And the altitude when we lost it, I have no idea what it was because it just kept going up and going farther and farther away.

112

00:07:46,800 --> 00:07:50,880

Now, it actually it actually raised in its elevation as it went away.

113

00:07:50,880 --> 00:07:56,800

As it's going away. Yes. It was usually if it's flying a level course, it would drop a little bit of time.

114

00:07:56,840 --> 00:07:59,960

It was going toward the horizon, but in this case, you say it was just rising. It was right.

115

00:07:59,960 --> 00:08:02,760

But then it was actually on a rise as it went out. Yes.

116

00:08:02,760 --> 00:08:07,960

And the first thought is, was there any landmarks or objects to give you any height comparison?

117

00:08:07,960 --> 00:08:13,600

Well, yes, the church there. Now, we could see this object above the church.

118

00:08:13,600 --> 00:08:18,600

See, and there's there's trees there and you can see it through the trees on the size of the church.

119

00:08:18,600 --> 00:08:23,680

Now, whether it was on the ground or off the ground, we don't know. You know, I couldn't tell.

120

00:08:23,720 --> 00:08:28,560

On the ground, off the ground. Well, whether it had landed or all seek on top of it.

121

00:08:28,560 --> 00:08:32,440

But how close it was down, actually, I don't know.

122

00:08:32,440 --> 00:08:37,600

How's the compare in size when you look at the church and it? Well, it was as big as the church or bigger.

123

00:08:37,600 --> 00:08:42,520

And that's quite that's quite a harvest. Moon. No, this was no moon because we've seen the moon there.

124

00:08:42,520 --> 00:08:46,160

I pointed. Was there anything at all that you could see?

125

00:08:46,160 --> 00:08:50,120

I mean, was there any detail at all outside of a what was the shape of the object?

126

00:08:50,120 --> 00:08:53,640

I mean, the general shape was round, you say the bottom of it was round.

127

00:08:53,760 --> 00:08:57,040

And it was flat on the top. You know, right.

128

00:08:57,040 --> 00:09:00,200

And there was nothing to cut it off. No clouds to cut it off like that.

129

00:09:00,200 --> 00:09:03,520

No, no, there was nothing to cut it off like that. No, it had a form to it.

130

00:09:03,520 --> 00:09:06,840

This had a form to have anything sticking out like antennas. I didn't see any.

131

00:09:06,840 --> 00:09:09,760

No, what about this? What about the surface of this object?

132

00:09:09,760 --> 00:09:12,280

Did it have anything that met your eye that was strange?

133

00:09:12,880 --> 00:09:19,320

Well, other than being a strange object, it wasn't a real smooth surface.

134

00:09:19,920 --> 00:09:27,400

You know what I mean? It had, I don't know if you'd call it waves or what you would call it, but it wasn't with a geometrically placed all the way.

135

00:09:27,400 --> 00:09:33,480

Yes, it looked, you know, like, well, they weren't actually what I don't know if you call them squares or not.

136

00:09:33,480 --> 00:09:38,040

It's kind of hard to describe it, but it wasn't a smooth surface.

137

00:09:38,040 --> 00:09:42,240

You know what? When you get some time, sit down with a piece of paper and do the best you can.

138

00:09:42,240 --> 00:09:46,520

And you keep drawing until you get what you think is right. We'd like to see what you come up with.

139

00:09:47,520 --> 00:09:51,520

I don't know whether we should show him what we have or not until we get the drawing.

140

00:09:51,520 --> 00:09:54,120

But we do have something here that might compare with what you saw.

141

00:09:55,120 --> 00:10:01,720

But it wasn't a smooth surface. There was, I don't know if it was a design on this thing or what it was, but it wasn't a smooth surface.

142

00:10:01,720 --> 00:10:08,520

You saw no other lights with it, you know, another light, which are of a different color or even with more brilliance.

143

00:10:08,520 --> 00:10:09,120

No.

144

00:10:09,120 --> 00:10:11,720

Nothing rotating. It didn't seem to be rotating at all.

145

00:10:11,720 --> 00:10:12,720

No.

146

00:10:12,920 --> 00:10:18,600

All right. Now, was it was it banking this way? Now, let's say, for instance, you got the flat top and you got the rounded bottom.

147

00:10:18,600 --> 00:10:21,920

It was it yawing back and forth? No, not that I can tell.

148

00:10:21,920 --> 00:10:24,360

It was completely level, even in all flight. Yes.

149

00:10:24,360 --> 00:10:27,960

And well, until it started banking off like this, but it wasn't moving this way.

150

00:10:27,960 --> 00:10:30,640

No, not that we could tell. This is what I call a wobble.

151

00:10:30,640 --> 00:10:36,600

You know, did you see any kind of smoke or any kind of aura or corona effect around it?

152

00:10:36,600 --> 00:10:40,440

Did you see the atmosphere around it? It was just clear cut the atmosphere.

153

00:10:40,680 --> 00:10:44,080

Yeah. I mean, it wasn't faded out. You know what I mean?

154

00:10:44,080 --> 00:10:47,560

Like say you would see smoke in the sky at night, how to kind of fade out.

155

00:10:47,560 --> 00:10:49,960

This was not like it didn't give off any any other light.

156

00:10:49,960 --> 00:10:52,480

So let's say, for instance, you see the clear cut area.

157

00:10:52,480 --> 00:10:58,040

Did it give off any light? I say sometimes it gives off a certain amount of light all the way around perfectly.

158

00:10:58,040 --> 00:11:02,760

You mean like you see around the moon? Yeah, sometimes. Yes.

159

00:11:02,760 --> 00:11:05,720

No change of brightness, except when it changed.

160

00:11:05,720 --> 00:11:08,600

It was there to move. That's the only time when we see it.

161

00:11:08,640 --> 00:11:11,240

When it first started to go away from us, it was the same color.

162

00:11:11,240 --> 00:11:17,760

You know, it did change shape only because you thought there was a possibility that it was that it was changing its position.

163

00:11:17,760 --> 00:11:21,760

Well, you don't know. I don't know why it changed the shape, but it looked like it did.

164

00:11:21,760 --> 00:11:27,800

It was leaving. All right. Now let's see.

165

00:11:27,800 --> 00:11:31,120

When you look through the windshield, what part of the windshield did you look through?

166

00:11:31,120 --> 00:11:35,560

I mean, was it the middle of windshield? The upper part of the windshield? Yeah, it was through the middle of the windshield.

167

00:11:35,600 --> 00:11:39,200

We didn't have to look up. You didn't know it was directly in the middle.

168

00:11:39,200 --> 00:11:42,720

Pretty much in the middle. That seems to be a pretty low angle. Right.

169

00:11:42,720 --> 00:11:49,480

OK. And your comparison, of course, you gave it at the big, the big as a church and not larger.

170

00:11:49,480 --> 00:11:54,800

That was right next to right. Well, it's pretty hard to tell unless we know exactly how far away was somebody on that side.

171

00:11:54,800 --> 00:11:59,320

You have to see that. That's what we need. Somebody east of you and beyond that should have seen it.

172

00:11:59,320 --> 00:12:03,640

And then we could get a pretty good idea. You know, we're just exactly where it was as far as distance is concerned.

173

00:12:03,680 --> 00:12:08,840

I understand this. But you didn't see it. He was on east of us when he said he was.

174

00:12:08,840 --> 00:12:12,120

He was a little more south of you. Well, he was in storywood.

175

00:12:12,120 --> 00:12:13,800

Yeah. Yeah.

176

00:12:13,800 --> 00:12:17,000

It's still with us an idea. You see, because we could cross those two lines.

177

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:23,080

He was on route two twenty four and we were on triple Boulevard and they run parallel, approximately a mile apart.

178

00:12:23,080 --> 00:12:27,480

Let me ask another question here. What about the.

179

00:12:27,480 --> 00:12:30,760

It just happened to be there. You just looked and there was as you were driving down the road.

180

00:12:30,760 --> 00:12:34,680

Yeah, we didn't see it come down or anything. We didn't see nothing until we.

181

00:12:34,680 --> 00:12:38,160

Is there a rise or something? Is there a little bit of a rise where you come up over and level off?

182

00:12:38,160 --> 00:12:41,040

Yeah, it kind of goes up the hill there. Yeah.

183

00:12:41,040 --> 00:12:44,080

It goes up the hill and it makes a curve and then starts down.

184

00:12:44,080 --> 00:12:49,000

When we get on top of the curve, there's where we see it. Right. OK.

185

00:12:49,000 --> 00:12:53,600

Did you see any airplanes around during the time that you were watching this thing or just before or just after?

186

00:12:53,600 --> 00:12:59,360

No, I didn't. And what other person was with you?

187

00:12:59,880 --> 00:13:03,000

Gary, you know, and you know the name of the patrolman.

188

00:13:03,000 --> 00:13:06,880

No, I don't. I couldn't tell you that. I don't know. Did we find out, Chuck?

189

00:13:06,880 --> 00:13:12,200

I don't work in there. I didn't. I don't know.

190

00:13:12,200 --> 00:13:15,560

Let's see now. Did anybody else talk to you?

191

00:13:15,560 --> 00:13:21,720

Let's say, for instance, of an official nature like the military, like the Air Force, like the sheriffs.

192

00:13:21,720 --> 00:13:24,720

No, nobody's talking to me, but just just us.

193

00:13:24,720 --> 00:13:27,640

That's all nobody else, but somebody else has talked to you on a phone.

194

00:13:27,680 --> 00:13:32,240

Oh, yeah. Just about 20 minutes ago, Mr. Popwich, George Popwich. OK.

195

00:13:32,240 --> 00:13:37,720

The U.S. or C. And you didn't have a camera with you.

196

00:13:37,720 --> 00:13:40,240

No, we didn't. I wish we would. Oh, boy.

197

00:13:40,240 --> 00:13:44,720

You know, it's amazing to me because almost all police cars are lacking a camera.

198

00:13:44,720 --> 00:13:50,560

I think that there should be some kind of a Polaroid or something in there that you guys could take a picture of our traffic.

199

00:13:51,400 --> 00:13:54,800

Our cameras are crucial. Well, they all should have one.

200

00:13:54,800 --> 00:14:00,200

Do you people have a log down at the down at your police station on UFOs that come in?

201

00:14:00,200 --> 00:14:03,280

Do they put them on the log? We were told they don't.

202

00:14:03,280 --> 00:14:08,200

Whether they do or not. I don't know. Now, we radioed in that we spot.

203

00:14:08,200 --> 00:14:11,480

It seems kind of funny to me that they wouldn't put on the record.

204

00:14:11,480 --> 00:14:19,880

Now, whether they do or not, I couldn't tell you. Is there any possibility that you you have anything against the use of your name for particular purpose?

205

00:14:20,280 --> 00:14:25,640

Mitching on a radio or a newspaper or something. I mean, on our little pamphlet that we sent out.

206

00:14:25,640 --> 00:14:29,040

It's OK. Thank you for that. No.

207

00:14:29,040 --> 00:14:34,000

Is there any other question? Very. Anyone have you seen other actors?

208

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:38,440

Oh, yeah. Have you ever seen something like this before? Well, I don't know.

209

00:14:38,440 --> 00:14:42,960

Also, you told you not. We've seen it going across the sky one night.

210

00:14:42,960 --> 00:14:46,240

But what it was, I don't know. It was too far away. We couldn't tell what it was.

211

00:14:46,280 --> 00:14:50,480

But we watched it, but it was nothing like this here. This is it wasn't the April 17th in the morning.

212

00:14:50,480 --> 00:14:53,120

Was it? When was it?

213

00:14:53,120 --> 00:14:55,920

Was I don't know when it was. You know, I couldn't tell you.

214

00:14:55,920 --> 00:15:00,160

I know it was in the summertime. Did I tell you about now you didn't see.

215

00:15:00,160 --> 00:15:04,040

Well, but it was so far away, but we couldn't tell what it was.

216

00:15:04,040 --> 00:15:08,360

But it was nothing like this here, which is the white.

217

00:15:08,360 --> 00:15:11,080

Going across could have been a satellite to go to.

218

00:15:11,080 --> 00:15:14,600

Now, let me ask you a question about this surface because this is important to us.

219

00:15:14,640 --> 00:15:16,480

Was there a scintillation? You know what scintillation is?

220

00:15:16,480 --> 00:15:20,680

You know, you think, for instance, if you look at a diamond or something or something with many little particles

221

00:15:20,680 --> 00:15:27,360

of very shiny material that continually give off little bits of light all the time, did it look like that at all?

222

00:15:27,360 --> 00:15:31,760

No. Well, no, it looked more like a.

223

00:15:31,760 --> 00:15:36,680

Well, I don't know what you described as a waffle finish on it. You know what I mean?

224

00:15:36,680 --> 00:15:39,920

A waffle finish. Right. You know how a waffle is a little checked.

225

00:15:39,920 --> 00:15:42,280

Yeah. Yeah. That's what it looked like. It wasn't smooth.

226

00:15:43,280 --> 00:15:48,240

Mm hmm. But I didn't give off this business like different surfaces of light.

227

00:15:48,240 --> 00:15:53,360

No, giving off color so that maybe the color at one moment was let's say a tiny bit of green,
