So first, this is a picture taken May 11, 1950 by Paul Trenton, in McKinville, Oregon. It was examined and published by Life Magazine, and Life describes them as an unassuming, what it said, a negative appear to be untampered with.

Here's another picture taken by, here's another picture, here's another picture taken by Paul Trenton, the famous Paul Trenton in Oregon.

Okay, August 1951, the next page, I didn't even know those pictures, you know, like a slide shows, changes, like, okay, August 1951, the most famous American UFO sightings in Lubbock, Texas.

The photo was taken by Carl Hart Jr. of a V-shaped light formation known as the Lubbock Lights. The Air Force said it was light reflected from a high flying bird. That's pretty weird.

Okay, here's an official US Coast Guard photo taken by Shale Alford in the Salem, Massachusetts Coast Guard Station in 1952.

He watched bright lights in the sky, watched them for a few seconds more, called in another Coast Guard, and then took this picture.

In 1964, the Coast Guard added this note to their caption on the picture saying that no further information or explanation to add concerning this photograph, and no official opinion as to the identity or origin of the lights.

Now here's a surprise, take a look at this. This photograph was published in the official Oregon of the Royal Air Force, the RAF Flying Review, which the magazine said seemed one of the few photographs of UFOs that does appear to be authentic.

The photograph was taken in France in 1954, and it looks identical with a Paul Trent photo we already showed you taken thousands of miles away four years earlier. Let's go back and show you the Paul Trent picture. The one before that.

Now, here are a couple of pictures that were taken in 1957 over Fuji-Sawa in Japan.

And a series of pictures taken off Brazil, the Trinidad East Islands, as the unidentified flying object was in motion. These pictures were taken by a marine photographer on a Brazilian ship participating in the International Geophysical Year.

Oh, I see up in the corner. Okay.

Okay, now this is interesting. An aircraft company that we cannot name took this picture as a promotion picture for the Zero Plan of B-57, but they never published it.

I live in those two and there must be several thousand in the country who have seen one and you must be called to these people

looking the sky every night. I do, I run in the observatory and I take several hundred people up the cage,

lay them out, find out constellations and if there should be a star there, it doesn't belong there.
