history. But that is about the wildest extreme that you can get. So we, our opinion of the Kahn report

We found out what those were, didn't we?

Those things were apparently going to be something connected with the capsule itself,

use, but get that day into outer space. And what John Grandfell, as fireflies,

Technically, yes, very yes, that's right. But I don't think any, I know we never considered them

in the UNFOR thing is there's never been a complaint. You have over 3,000 top-rated observers

and they go from well-known scientists on down to about \$100,000 of all of the military services,

all the major airlines. They brought as well as here tower operators, radar trackers,

75

satellite trackers, besides very expert observers on the ground, people who are intelligent men

76

and women, uh, all and many, but I'm talking about the people who are specially trained.

Now, here's where all of them are walled, uh, they're incompetent or they were deluded or

78

bikes for drillers or something. And that means all of them. I don't mean 99 or 90 percent,

79

I mean 100 percent. Oh, some of those reports, it's right.

80

Well, we could for 10, 5 hours just reading names, which would impress a lot of people, I think.

But, uh, this is all on the record and the Kahnnen project. And they got around that very neatly

by simply evading back to everything that happened before the project opened.

Yes. Uh, amusing that term. Does that mean that there's a feeling that ufology has a kind of

86

religious quality to it? No, he meant by that. He said, I'm unagnostic means I am a disbeliever.

I do not believe, but I, uh, if you can prove it to me, maybe I will believe it.

But since then, he has said it was a quick type of operation. And, uh, uh, he's been in the report,

he said that many power witnesses get together afterwards and talk to them about the stories

that he's told. In other words, there's no credit to the master witnesses for being honest,

91

careful, and reliable people. Uh, this was the, this was the way they did a long time ago,

92

when the effort started out. You shouldn't really blame the effort, they were taught a spot. It was,

it was excitement of people hysterical. Uh, people, people had been buried on the highways or in

the aircraft by, uh, by flying jets or other UFO objects. Uh, and it was actually a desire to

play their turn. So the policy was to, uh, explain it in a way and put this possible, whatever it

96

seemed logical. And several times when the first accident took place, they changed it to another one.

Now, I learned that people were connected with this. I learned in the airport,

98

they pressed jets to the field of the project. And they didn't like it any more than the people

that were, uh, from battling them because they said, but we're up against it here. Uh, we have to try

100

to find some logical answers. In some places there weren't any. And the airport secretly

101

has proved at long term, you know, that these things were not anything made on their side,

102

something that was real and it was superior to any other made devices.

How do you know about made use?

I can't nail it down at the moment, but I have in my possession a document which is next

to it. You missed the existence. I was told that anyway, but three airport

thousands officers who were connected with the investigations, one of them is a director of

107

00:09:42,600 --> 00:09:49,480

intelligence. It was, it was true, but, uh, they simply did not feel that it had to be released.

And General Vandenberg fought very hard against releasing it. Uh, and that was when the policy

109

was changed to completely funky.

But we don't always know that military men are always right. We know that General was

111

more than in 1967, but we were winning the war in Vietnam. The next thing I knew,

in 1968 came along and we had the Pet Offensive. But we cannot assume it just because men are

113

belong to the Air Force and what they conclude or what they say in documents are necessarily correct.

So that too, but this thing was not one man's opinion. This was an evaluation by a large group

115

of people who had been on this for a long time.

Thinking for the Air Force then as a body?

A special body assigned to evaluate these things including

118

civilian fighters as well as, uh, Air Force judges, people and others.

Major, let me ask you to hold on a moment. We have a commercial coming up in a moment.

120

I want to come back with our guest Roger Brown, who's keyhole and, uh, Mr. Irmett.

And I asked about the meaning of the Air Force retiring from the UFO business.

What this may mean to UFO research? What we can look forward to in the future,

Now gentlemen, what is the, the retirement of the Air Force from the UFO affair?

It could be major, yes. Why not?

All right, now, it may be interesting to know that this is the second time the Air Force has made

129

the identical announcement. To say that that's, uh, a particular quote, all sightings were explained,

130

natural phenomena, delusions, folks, so forth and so forth.

Then they went underground and for approximately a year and a half,

our investigations were conducted in secret and the reports were kept secret.

Then this, then there was an outbreak deciding that the soap bank, that they had to,

well, come out of the investigation and then they said they had met it at the party that

had never been closed. This is exactly what's going on today.

All right, uh, that is a, an air defense directive which states that, that any object,

137

unknown object which is picked up in the skies, um, is definitely moving under control,

138

which is tracked by a radar or seen visually must be investigated and it's possible intercepted

139

and Air Force jet intercepted and sent up under the command of Air Defense to try to

140

force these things down or identify them. Now that is just the thing that it was

141

last year or 15, 10 years ago.

142

Well that would be logical wouldn't it maybe?

143

Right, and the, the project is not perfect, they are just saying in effect this project

blue book is closed, they may have changed the name, but then they have said this is not a project

145

and then they go on and they will say, uh, there is a new, uh,

146

00:12:36,920 --> 00:12:40,840

organization here and we're going to do this, but they, Air Force is still

147

00:12:40,840 --> 00:12:44,920

violating the standardness. You see, they, they hope that the Connor Report

148

00:12:44,920 --> 00:12:49,320

will sit these things down completely and we can see that with the purpose a long time ago

149

00:12:49,320 --> 00:12:54,360

with the fire, the Air Force concerned, they, they gambled, but this word happened because

150

that Connor was, they ignored it and they figured that, uh, uh, he probably was going to be very

151

hard to convince. Then it was a split among scientists in that project and two of them got

152

fired, essentially because they were trying to prove to be different with it, but then anyway,

153

uh, this unexplained evidence still exists and there are hundreds of pilots who are just

154

waiting to take, to come forward, when some of the ridicule is lifted, come forward in the body

155

and say, look, here is the evidence, we saw it, we saw these things closely, many people bought

156

the plane saw them, they were, they were photographed, it's there, and this is not fooling about it

157

and get it out the open. Now that's exactly what we've been trying to do for years and coming

158

up, what do you mean, close? Well, uh, two or three times in the excitement, excitement in 1957

159

and later on in 65 and 66, there were so many settings pouring in that even Air Force pilots

160

were putting them on record and, uh, Air Force intelligence almost lost control. The newspapers

161

were kneading in them and say, come on, it's time you were talking, what's going on here?

162

So, they finally, they took my pillow out, stung me on something, in one case,

163

my man came out with one of these large contact planes that I, I talked with two or three space

164

men that, when I landed near my field or something like that, uh, and that's just as I, and immediately

165

all of these serious things ended, but behind it, they kept that right on and it's going on,

166

they spent a very nice amount of money and today, he was, if you look at right down inside of it,

167

you would find that there are not only some very high effort sources, but there are other people

168

00:14:30,120 --> 00:14:32,680

connected with the government who are involved in this.

169

Major, and, uh, and Mr. Nebel, any, Mr. Morales, yes.

170

Well, that's, you know, the silent member here, and I want to hear what Major had,

171

any comment from you, Major, about the psychosexual, uh, aspects of flying saucers, you think that's

172

interesting? Of course, there are lots of people like that, I've been involved, most of those contact

173

cases that, to reinvestigate it, well, it appears to be the delusions, uh, actual true delusions,

174

people believe the things that they were doing up north, so, oh, I don't know, we're playing

175

fast, so people can understand something. What about the case of the Brazilian farm boy who claims

176

that his bastard landed, uh, I believe, with his, uh, Antonio, and he claimed that he was raped by a

woman from outer space? I stopped Alan the night I told him, many years ago, I'm a doctor, I remember

178

Dr. Cornyn, he wonders, he gets a little juicy reading about this and about this, and then he

179

came up with the book and this thing was, uh, described, but, uh, I think that this has never

180

been really nailed down, and it's sort of one of those things that trails off in the thin air,

181

seemingly, I like that, because the many things, it's almost, uh, you can't say anything about

182

police, but I would say that, uh, I wouldn't believe that, that's not how it happened. I, I really,

I, I am curious about his face. Well, I think we ought to leave off on that. We are talking tonight

understandable, after all the stuff that was burned very readily, but they wanted another piece

which could be used, because there wasn't too much of it again, but that, uh, reportedly was from

the exploded one off the Brazilian coast. Now, I do know that, uh, Dr. Robert...

uh, starring, uh, Project Redge, Project Twinkle, Project Bluebook, etc., and, um, uh,

he claimed that he had been handed a piece while in Washington by Admiral Nose, and over this very

202

microphone many years ago, Admiral Herbert D. Nose, and you know him well, I may do that to you.

Yes, yes. Uh, broad member, uh, he, uh, like that, uh, he told, uh, me right here, and told the audience

radio audience on the air that he had actually handed this piece to Dr. Robert Smith. Now,

half of the piece of that kind had been analyzed later by Dr. Smith in, uh, Shirley Bay up in

Canada where the Project headquarters was, and it was very, very unusual material. Frank Edwards

knew a lot about it, and over these very microphones also, uh, told about it. They had little, uh, tiny,

uh, pimples in the metal, uh, flowers and stuff, and were in a small area under the microscope.

And the first part of this metal was, it seemed, it seemed, there was no bender for it. It was a

fern's metal unknown to us. That's all I can tell you about. How about you, Major?

Now, if he's trying so desperately to

545

oppose him by a man who would be discussing

546

the usual situation,

547

I feel they must have added desperate.

548

And I think it's not his time that you, Alan,

549

00:35:28,840 --> 00:35:30,360

and the producer here, Bill Baker,

550

and NBC are permitting us to give

the kind of information you're all going to do.

552

We are, Bill.

But Donald Kehoe can stay with us only another 10 minutes

though we're going to make the ticket benefit

584

by getting right back to the phones and doing business

with the customers.

586

Hello, you're on the air.

587

Thank you for waiting.

588

You know, one thing has always been a fascinating to me

589

is the UFO propulsion system.

590

What do you feel is the type of propulsion

591

that these UFOs are using?

592

Major?

Oh, well, as I said,

594

00:36:59,160 --> 00:37:00,600

I wouldn't kill myself for that

595

00:37:00,600 --> 00:37:03,080

because we've had some of our technical,

596

00:37:03,080 --> 00:37:04,440

scientific advisors,

597

00:37:04,440 --> 00:37:05,560

and they always come out and say,

598

00:37:05,560 --> 00:37:07,480

well, it's possible to play this and possibly that,

599

00:37:07,480 --> 00:37:09,400

but the only person in there that's come out

600

00:37:09,400 --> 00:37:10,920

made a definite commitment.

601

00:37:10,920 --> 00:37:11,880

There's Obers, he said,

602

00:37:11,880 --> 00:37:14,760

that was connected with the control of gravity.

603

00:37:14,760 --> 00:37:19,240

And I understand how by having artificial gravity fields,

604

00:37:20,280 --> 00:37:24,120

you can drag air molecules along with you

605

00:37:24,120 --> 00:37:27,480

and cut down the friction you only have from heat

606

00:37:27,480 --> 00:37:29,400

and you can get very high speed acceleration.

607

00:37:29,400 --> 00:37:31,720

And without any of those effects,

608

00:37:31,720 --> 00:37:34,840

there's also changes defective to sonic devices

609

00:37:34,840 --> 00:37:36,040

out of sound area.

610

00:37:36,040 --> 00:37:38,440

But as for specifics,

611

00:37:38,440 --> 00:37:40,840

I don't know exactly how the propulsion is.

612

00:37:40,840 --> 00:37:41,640

I don't know.

613

00:37:42,200 --> 00:37:46,920

I read about 200 scientific and technical explanations of it

614

00:37:46,920 --> 00:37:49,160

and they told me I had a different idea.

615

00:37:50,200 --> 00:37:51,880

Major, do you recall many years ago

616

00:37:51,880 --> 00:37:53,640

the Cleveland Nephology Project,

617

00:37:53,640 --> 00:37:54,600

which I've been the director,

618

00:37:55,560 --> 00:37:57,560

along with the fine group down in Akron,

619

00:37:59,160 --> 00:38:02,840

financed a book showing that 84 cases

620

00:38:02,840 --> 00:38:05,480

that UFOs in Washington had at the time

621

00:38:06,520 --> 00:38:09,480

where electromagnetic effects apparently

622

00:38:09,480 --> 00:38:12,680

had solved the engines of autos and planes?

623

00:38:12,680 --> 00:38:14,520

Well, I agree with that, but that's not...

624

00:38:14,520 --> 00:38:17,320

We don't know how we tie it into the propulsion right,

625

00:38:17,320 --> 00:38:20,120

although I have no doubt it's connection in there

626

00:38:20,760 --> 00:38:21,640

of a force field.

627

00:38:23,720 --> 00:38:25,160

I thought the gentleman was asking

628

00:38:25,800 --> 00:38:29,160

for specific explanation of propulsion systems.

629

00:38:29,160 --> 00:38:29,640

Yes.

630

00:38:29,640 --> 00:38:31,480

I don't think it, but I had no question

631

00:38:31,480 --> 00:38:33,240

about the electromagnetic influence.

632

00:38:33,240 --> 00:38:34,680

I just thought I could throw that in

633

00:38:34,680 --> 00:38:36,840

in case he was at all in doubt on that.

634

00:38:36,840 --> 00:38:39,080

Yeah, well, you have been many cases, I reckon,

635

00:38:39,080 --> 00:38:41,400

when there's still automobile addiction,

636

00:38:41,400 --> 00:38:43,800

radio turnout like preachers have had that happen,

637

00:38:44,440 --> 00:38:48,680

TVs and homes, electrical appliances, and so on.

638

00:38:48,680 --> 00:38:50,680

And in aircraft, you've had radio directions

639

00:38:50,680 --> 00:38:52,600

finders burn out, transmitters burn out,

640

00:38:52,600 --> 00:38:53,560

receivers burn out.

641

00:38:55,000 --> 00:38:57,000

And many things of that kind have happened

642

00:38:57,000 --> 00:38:59,480

when UFOs were in close proximity.

643

00:39:00,680 --> 00:39:04,440

And it's probably true that some things

644

00:39:04,440 --> 00:39:06,760

of the unified field theory applies in there.

645

00:39:07,960 --> 00:39:09,640

Electricity managers and their gravity

646

00:39:09,640 --> 00:39:12,120

are all different phases of the same thing.

647

00:39:12,120 --> 00:39:14,120

And I thought there are also electrical failures

648

00:39:14,120 --> 00:39:16,120

when UFOs are not in close proximity.

649

00:39:17,160 --> 00:39:19,000

Yeah, that may be true.

650

00:39:19,000 --> 00:39:24,360

But the ones that I think are more probably true

651

00:39:24,360 --> 00:39:27,560

are those where the center was relatively close

652

00:39:27,560 --> 00:39:30,440

and there were enough witnesses nearby

653

00:39:30,440 --> 00:39:33,160

and the car was seen to be stolen, so forth.

654

00:39:33,240 --> 00:39:34,840

Well, you have a single witness, I'd say,

655

00:39:34,840 --> 00:39:36,120

I don't say the man is lying,

656

00:39:36,120 --> 00:39:38,760

but it is a big help to have more than one witness.

657

00:39:39,800 --> 00:39:41,880

There is another factor that is usually added

658

00:39:41,880 --> 00:39:43,800

when we say the car is stolen.

659

00:39:43,800 --> 00:39:45,880

We usually, well, we don't always,

660

00:39:45,880 --> 00:39:48,200

but it is not unusual to hear that the dogs bark.

661

00:39:48,760 --> 00:39:51,560

So it seems to be an equation between howling dogs

662

00:39:51,560 --> 00:39:55,080

or frightened dogs and the appearance of UFOs.

663

Well, that was brought out in the X-ray case.

664

And, well, I was explaining,

665

00:40:00,760 --> 00:40:03,320

who was for 20 years an airport chief consultant on this,

666

00:40:03,320 --> 00:40:07,160

said until he began to criticize the airport's policy,

667

00:40:08,120 --> 00:40:09,640

and that time for some strange reason,

668

00:40:09,640 --> 00:40:10,680

his contract was ended.

669

00:40:10,680 --> 00:40:13,560

But anyway, he only admitted the mob gas,

670

00:40:13,560 --> 00:40:17,400

the other day, he said that he has written

671

00:40:17,400 --> 00:40:19,640

a few reports to accept the message,

672

00:40:19,640 --> 00:40:23,000

so certainly serious, and they have been investigated.

673

00:40:24,680 --> 00:40:27,240

And since animals do have different ways of hearing,

674

00:40:27,240 --> 00:40:28,760

it's quite possible that they're getting

675

00:40:29,720 --> 00:40:33,800

vibrations some ways, or some kind of ways that we go here.

676

So you can't discount all of these things,

677

or tie them with UFOs,

678

they may not always be completely true,

679

but there are some that have proven to be in the case

680

00:40:44,840 --> 00:40:46,040

of electromagnetic effects.

681

00:40:47,000 --> 00:40:49,400

There's a nice proof in there that I would personally accept it.

682

00:40:49,400 --> 00:40:51,080

Another call from Cleveland.

683

00:40:51,080 --> 00:40:53,000

Hello, you're around here, thank you for waiting.

684

00:40:53,000 --> 00:40:55,640

I'd like to direct my question to Major Kehoe.

685

00:40:55,640 --> 00:40:56,440

Go ahead.

686

00:40:56,440 --> 00:41:00,120

Throughout the years, most of my, as I recall,

687

00:41:00,120 --> 00:41:01,640

about six or seven years ago,

688

00:41:02,280 --> 00:41:04,760

I read it on this paper, one of the Cleveland papers,

689

00:41:04,760 --> 00:41:07,560

involving the U.S. Navy and the Polaris missile.

690

00:41:07,560 --> 00:41:12,600

I can't recall the year, but I assume it was around 1961 or 62.

691

00:41:12,600 --> 00:41:15,800

That thing, Polaris missile launching is in the Atlantic,

692

00:41:15,800 --> 00:41:19,000

I believe, and the Polaris missile was launched.

693

00:41:19,000 --> 00:41:20,520

I don't recall what altitude it was,

694

00:41:20,520 --> 00:41:22,200

but it was pretty high up.

695

00:41:22,760 --> 00:41:24,840

That was barely two to L or two to Z.

696

00:41:24,840 --> 00:41:26,200

I assume so.

697

00:41:26,280 --> 00:41:27,080

I know that case.

698

00:41:27,080 --> 00:41:29,320

I saw a copy of the laws on it.

699

00:41:29,320 --> 00:41:34,280

The tracking locked onto a UFO much larger

700

00:41:34,280 --> 00:41:35,880

than the Polaris missile itself,

701

00:41:35,880 --> 00:41:39,080

and it was so close to the missile that the tracking

702

00:41:39,080 --> 00:41:42,120

locked onto the UFO instead and tracked the UFO

703

00:41:42,120 --> 00:41:43,560

rather than the Polaris missile.

704

00:41:43,560 --> 00:41:44,840

That's right, that's right.

705

00:41:44,840 --> 00:41:46,520

It did it for 14 minutes.

706

00:41:46,520 --> 00:41:49,000

Right, this was significant to me from the standpoint

707

00:41:49,000 --> 00:41:51,080

that it was acknowledged by the U.S. Navy

708

00:41:51,080 --> 00:41:52,440

that they had a radar contact.

709

00:41:52,440 --> 00:41:55,640

Well, I don't, there was just this picture,

710

00:41:55,640 --> 00:41:58,680

I'm basing my knowledge of my particular entirely

711

00:41:58,680 --> 00:42:02,440

or, if having seen, a photo strip of the log.

712

00:42:02,440 --> 00:42:03,560

Well, this is what I see.

713

00:42:04,600 --> 00:42:07,400

Instead of a color, it's unidentifiable,

714

00:42:07,400 --> 00:42:09,720

which is determined, maybe, as used a number of times

715

00:42:09,720 --> 00:42:12,360

where the Air Force uses or was identified.

716

00:42:12,360 --> 00:42:14,600

Well, the reason it interested me is the fact

717

00:42:14,600 --> 00:42:17,240

that I saw a brief article with only about four or five

718

00:42:17,240 --> 00:42:19,880

paragraphs and I never saw anything after that.

719

00:42:19,880 --> 00:42:21,560

And I looked for weeks after that,

720

00:42:21,560 --> 00:42:22,920

I couldn't appeal any more in for me.

721

00:42:22,920 --> 00:42:24,120

I'll tell you where they got it.

722

00:42:24,200 --> 00:42:28,520

They got it from NACAP because I wrote that particular report

723

00:42:28,520 --> 00:42:31,880

myself and they put it in our publication for members,

724

00:42:31,880 --> 00:42:33,720

which is called the UFO Investigator.

725

00:42:34,360 --> 00:42:36,600

And I just think to remember putting in all the details

726

00:42:36,600 --> 00:42:40,520

which I was allowed to use, I was not supposed to give

727

00:42:40,520 --> 00:42:44,840

the source or anything, but I was down at Cape Kennedy

728

00:42:44,840 --> 00:42:48,040

and talked with people there and one of the engineers

729

00:42:48,040 --> 00:42:50,120

gave me a copy of that.

730

00:42:51,000 --> 00:42:51,560

Fantastic.

731

00:42:51,640 --> 00:42:52,120

Wow.

732

00:42:52,760 --> 00:42:54,120

Thank you very much for calling, sir.

733

00:42:54,120 --> 00:42:54,600

Thank you.

734

00:42:54,600 --> 00:42:56,600

And I'd like to express my thanks tonight.

735

I'll miss the mind of Major Dennis Keogh

736

737
