Alright, let's get off the recording and let's start with something. I'm the man I want to see.

I'm going to speak very frankly and I may get a little rough sometimes.

I hope that always I will remain within the bounds of not-financially-commodities with urban tax.

Let us dispose of very rough and slurped of all and I must explain.

Well, I must explain. I'm 6th chair of my good health and business. The woods is full of them.

Everybody is business and mathematicians today have in my head that he is not a physicist.

And let me start at the beginning. We are a technological culture in this country and a wedding world.

Now, our technology is a progressive element.

It started on what is called physics. Not only a physical scientist, but physics.

And the physicists are most monodomocal scientists today.

At least I suppose mathematicians on top do the kind of theory.

And then physicists and then down to chemists.

That's more like a biologist before taking a long...

Now, I would just like to find out that I don't know if you've noticed.

The only tip in this country don't realize when I've fallen a black tooth.

I discovered in my done-spotted amazement only a few years ago that what we call populace in this country sounds.

Not sounds, but sounds of technology, gadgety, artisanship, for the most part.

What we call philosophy in this country is what's called pure science.

And what the rest of the world calls philosophy.

We call mathematics in this country.

Alright? Now let's get out of here straight.

Now, about 99% of physicists, and I'm not saying anything in terms of it, are gadgeteers.

They're not scientists at all.

Mainly by the matter of semantics.

It only takes one family to devise, think out the principles of an atom bomb.

It takes 100,000 people to put one together.

And we live in an age when it's the people who put bombs together that matter.

We all must worship them.

And I think it's to the enormous credit of the physicists who underpaid as they are, overworked as they are,

43

have not yet found it an orthodoxy, and or a hierarchy, nor are they bullying people around.

They're trying to do a hard job.

45

So the last scientist, a last chemist, about 25% are probably real scientists.

Do you know what the definition of scientist is?

We look it up in the evening web search.

48

It is the exploration or investigation of the unknown, not of the known.

Technology, from Keknoff, you have got out a great fiction,

50

and you will find out that it actually comes down to the further elaboration of or understanding of our log of knowledge of the known, or Keknoff.

Keknoi, I think he doesn't have it anyhow.

Now many are really working in the field of pure science.

53

In other words, it's more of a, it starts with imagination, just like science fiction does.

Following which comes the hypothesis, other which may develop a theory,

after which you can't have a theory and it works out, you finally have practice and a theory.

The chemists are examining real things.

Do you realize that the only thing that doesn't exist, the only thing that we know for sure is absolutely true,

58

that mathematics, we can't tell you a word tonight,

59

the official thing is mathematics, in nature, outside of modern intelligence.

In the human time, mine doesn't exist. If you add five apples, three apples for two apples, you don't get five apples.

There's a lot of apples lying on the ground.

Mathematics is a very peculiar business, but it is, the only thing that's actually true,

63

and can actually, in every case, be proved right or wrong, despite that horrible little figure,

which means possibility, which is now trapped in, and infinity.

But it's a path, science, and it's the only thing that doesn't really exist.

Physics is the next one down.

You know a certain physicist, who's not mentioned his name,

who's one of the people who helped us put the alum bomb together, pointed out to me, not very long ago,

that when they let off the first experimental alum bomb at Elamador, though,

70

we knew of the existence of fourteen less particles in the nucleus than we know now.

71

So really, we're sitting around with some, we sit in every much of that.

72

So you have a lot of theoreticians, or a few theoreticians, people who put the stuff together,

73

then a master technologist, then you come down to the chemist, finally you come down to the biologist,

74

and the biologist, who's called a little forgot-so, so they're becoming of vital importance.

75

After all, biology is dealing with facts which are studying from ourselves on up and on down,

76

and the majority of them still have to be scientists.

There's a lot of biological technology going on, but on the whole,

78

the biologist has to be a little bit more scientific, shall we say, about it.

I'm not being snide, I'm simply trying to put some things, it's a matter of semantics and nothing else,

80

but a lot of people who understand it, they think that many radio stations putting alum bombs together,

81

it's not, it's not, it's gadgetary, it's a very advanced order.

82

If they want the bigger bang in the Russian, you get a hundred thousand people together,

83

you dig two things out of the ground, you put them together in a certain kind of way,

84

and you get your big bang, but the families of this world and the people who think of the theory

85

and develop the theory are exploring the unknown.

Now there's been some little scientific respect shown to this whole subject of what I call eupolysis,

87

and I think it's about time that one of the sciences could find time or space or place

88

to allow this strange subject to be taken in.

The meteorologists, the meteorologists don't want it, it's much too busy.

90

They're concerned with things in our sky, certainly, which they have to know about.

91

Astronomers, they weren't a part of it, anyhow they can't see how these things have reported

92

because they're either too far away or too close up, and as they don't get into their keeping things,

93

the physicists, they're one of a sort, and they're part of the physics,

94

the chemists are only interested in the chemistry of this guy in his home, and so on down the line.

95

The biologists, at least of all the people, have lived the eupolysis knowledge enough to live.

96

And really, even psychologists, the characters, they say, were bad liquor, mass hallucination,

97

deflated navy blimps, I don't know why, but earlier by the time all of us were on the slides,

98

there was a sea monster thing, that's one of the great explanations of sea monsters.

They say that navy blimps, the poor navy must be getting rid of blimps,

100

it's been about 400 years, about the last 100 years, but all these kinds of things, they're really very sensitive.

101

Here, there have been what their old child's court used to call, object-based, O-N-M,

102

object-based floating, I think it's a much nicer connotation to UFOs,

103

or I can say that they're flying objects, object-based floating,

104

00:08:10,000 --> 00:08:15,000

but I think, if you analyze this guy, I would point out that nowadays there was a dash in the background of this guy,

105

whereas in the early days, it had been just floating there, other gentlemen,

106

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:26,000

but these types of things have been seen throughout history, and don't think that it's all Fortin newspaper reports.

107

Fortin started picking up reports from his book, he took an after-date of 1800s.

108

A couple of other gentlemen you mentioned before, gentlemen so on, have dug out reports in Wilkinson,

109

they know that my most group is a working-class and co-student,

110

anyhow, everybody who's been to the single novel and told me about it,

111

00:08:43,000 --> 00:08:48,000

has gone a way back to early Chinese literature, the credit-bunch of the Bible, you know,

112

00:08:48,000 --> 00:08:53,000

rather than the flying wheel in the sky, but the isa'ving taken up in the Far East Chariot.

113

People wanted to know today, they weren't fighting for what the company was going to tell them,

114

that you're lying, you're hoaxing, all the time.

115

What they said, what they saw, they thought they saw, they said,

116

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:09,000

and they got into credit through the different available, they changed the gypsies,

117

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:13,000

have certain very peculiar things to say, but much more important than that.

118

And I would ask you, and any of you listeners, just go to the New York Public Library,

119

get ahold of the proceedings of the world study in London, starting with his inception in the late 17th century,

120

and going on up to about 1865, just ruffle through the pages of those proceedings,

121

you will find Dory Arthur Dory reported two pieces of world study in London,

122

five members of the Royal Society, of all kinds of very things being seen in the sky.

123

And I think the poor, but the only shape that never seems to have once been reported yet is out of the form.

124

Lenses, things that look like bottom of land, lobs in shape jobs,

125

some spices where things still in there, things that look like types, cigar shaped objects,

126

lights of all kinds, objects with lights on them and so on.

127

00:10:07,000 --> 00:10:13,000

I really don't think that anybody, except for Hossie possibly, is a gentleman of the press,

128

and I can't think where they're going to sit any longer, really,

129

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:21,000

at the fact of there being a lot of things buzzing about in the sky, or having things being in the sky.

130

I mean, to tell you I've stayed at all months, except the third, and the 30th of October,

131

00:10:26,000 --> 00:10:32,000

I stood with 10,000 people out on that road watching this alleged balloon.

132

My eyesight's fine, of course, I didn't have any fuel glasses, it looked awful funny to me.

133

It was a balloon, it was one chicken, a big one, it certainly wasn't that little small-foot job,

134

which was let off in Long Island, but because it was in the sky nearly 100 miles away,

135

00:10:44,000 --> 00:10:47,000

half an hour before that one was let off, the purpose of sky was,

136

00:10:47,000 --> 00:10:50,000

it was let off out in Minnesota, where were they doing this now,

137

00:10:50,000 --> 00:10:53,000

there was private corporations doing it out there.

138

00:10:53,000 --> 00:10:57,000

They won't tell us if one was let off, and they won't tell us if the wind was in the wrong direction.

139

So, this is a balloon, a lot of people looked at it to the field glasses

140

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:02,000

and had something hanging down underneath, alright.

141

00:11:02,000 --> 00:11:06,000

But the whole thing, despite the fact that they finally wiped it away,

142

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:09,000

as I was talking about, saying it was a balloon, we know it was a balloon.

143

Alright, but in the meantime, all these nigh remarks about it there,

144

00:11:13,000 --> 00:11:15,000

it must have been a balloon, it can't be anything else,

145

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:18,000

everybody doesn't know what they see, and there's tens of thousands of people looking at it.

146

They get all these reports, there's scientific journals, and the world's the start of London,

147

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:26,000

three spirits in mind, there's organization, and all this has, I think, been credited with being there.

148

And hearing at them in their official journals, you can find them in several meteorological journals,

149

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:34,000

with some free sports. It's not all these things, you know.

150

It gives you little references, and not the funny way, but the references are there.

151

And I spent days, maybe cut out four copies of Charles Ford and Cardin Decker,

152

and cut in dark every single statement of the nature of those things

153

that we're trying to figure into this, on the Cardin Decker.

154

And I did a lot of sitting in the library after I'd been able to talk.

155

We were asking for these different journals, some newspapers,

156

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:59,000

and seeing if the things were really in there, they're there, alright.

157

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:02,000

Well, actually, it's funny enough where the actual pages have been drawn out of the journals,

158

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:05,000

right in the public library. We had a central, second set, and a third set,

159

00:12:05,000 --> 00:12:09,000

before we could find the proper pagination in there, it was a story.

160

00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:13,000

But it all seems to have come to an end in the Royal Pagination, it was about 1870.

161

We had a wonderful person called David Brewster,

162

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:20,000

who I think had a completely open mind to the better sense of that word,

163

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:23,000

and that he allowed these things to be published.

164

But about that time, you see, far or rather, technology was getting going,

165

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:34,000

becoming patronized, and you couldn't have things outside the textbook.

166

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:40,000

It upset the system. I mean, after a serious, geological serious disorder had been laid down,

167

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:45,000

you couldn't suddenly ask another two million years' jam between the illigacy and the ear syndrome.

168

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:47,000

So it was an acceptable picture.

169

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:51,000

And until somebody could actually come out and show you a huge block of rock that went in there,

170

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:52,000

the thing is ignored.

171

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:56,000

In other words, they said, look, let's concentrate on what has to be done to get on with the technology.

172

00:12:56,000 --> 00:12:59,000

We can have scientific thinking forever.

173

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:03,000

So we've got our medicine, all the sciences, and that seems to work.

174

00:13:03,000 --> 00:13:08,000

And then, after the rest, it's a purely historical gesture, as it were.

175

Now, with great cause, and you could say, well, I don't know.

176

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:15,000

I'm sort of pontificating too much.

177

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:19,000

There isn't any reason for it. Sound has a methodology.

178

In addition to being the investigation of the unknown,

179

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:28,000

I started to never get a thing like the occult received into the body of pure sound,

180

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:32,000

because I'm not interested in the occult and the nature of everything.

181

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:37,000

And then I might throw in one thing my shortest, the largest, the short way.

182

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:40,000

But a lot of things are improbable.

183

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:42,000

I don't think anything is implausible.

184

00:13:42,000 --> 00:13:47,000

Now, the occult I don't think will be included in sound,

185

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:50,000

but certainly it is not open to measurement,

186

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:53,000

which means in a quite extent that if a man says,

187

00:13:53,000 --> 00:13:57,000

I have been dealt with then with a vaccine to polio,

188

00:13:57,000 --> 00:14:01,000

not only has that vaccine got to prevent polio,

189

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:06,000

but somebody else using his publishing to counter how he prepared that vaccine

190

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:10,000

has got to be able to do it in another time and place and come up with the same result.

191

00:14:10,000 --> 00:14:18,000

If somebody says, I saw a flying disk over a horrid ship,

192

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:20,000

flying 10 on the 11th,

193

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:25,000

because I'm much encouraged to say that if he's not assigned to be taken in so far,

194

00:14:25,000 --> 00:14:29,000

that you can't reproduce the disk at any other place at the same time,

195

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:31,000

that's a very crude way of putting it.

196

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:35,000

I'm fetching a rubber band as far as I can to try and make my point.

197

Sound is precise.

198

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:39,000

You've got to be able to weigh and measure the object.

199

00:14:39,000 --> 00:14:42,000

At least you've got to be able to reproduce it on the mark.

200

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:47,000

Dr. J.B. Rine ran into that great difficulty when he was working on ESP.

201

00:14:47,000 --> 00:14:50,000

He'd say, come on and go on without any kind of regularity.

202

00:14:50,000 --> 00:14:51,000

You couldn't deathly just say to him,

203

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:53,000

look, I've got the following results.

204

00:14:53,000 --> 00:14:56,000

I've got papers to take with this gentleman sitting in front of me

205

00:14:56,000 --> 00:15:01,000

and with a girl in a room, another one to call us the way.

206

00:15:01,000 --> 00:15:04,000

And then get up and walk out in another investigative paper.

207

00:15:04,000 --> 00:15:05,000

It's only consistently self.

208

00:15:05,000 --> 00:15:07,000

You've got to come on and go on.

209

00:15:07,000 --> 00:15:11,000

It's going to be very difficult in those borderline investigations.

210

However, if you're polishing, I believe it's a very much practical thing to do there.

211

I believe it would eventually be subject to a proper analysis

212

00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:28,000

and proper measurement in time if people could take this thing seriously.

213

00:15:28,000 --> 00:15:32,000

I don't know whether any of the animal citizens, particularly the Swedes and the Peruvians,

214

00:15:32,000 --> 00:15:36,000

I continue to spread it because those were the true great areas in the world

215

00:15:36,000 --> 00:15:40,000

where you think that it becomes so very, very numerous.

216

00:15:40,000 --> 00:15:44,000

I know that the British have grabbed a lot of strange substances

217

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:47,000

and have spawned out of the sky because of the actual police reports of it.

218

00:15:47,000 --> 00:15:49,000

And I think they are also pretty interested.

219

00:15:49,000 --> 00:15:53,000

But to say once again, we give credit to our Air Force for having come out and done something about it.

220

I don't think that there's enough to be consensus for covering up.

221

If anything is the other way, they're going to want a book of charge

222

and trying to find out something and putting out these useful reports.

223

So we'll cover those details, I'll try and fix up an ad.

224

But we have overlooked one major fact in trying to be what I'd like to call scientific about it.

225

These objectives include a logical study.

And I'm just dashing about with preconceived ideas

and all of them that I've heard on your program recently have been

ideas stemming from physics with a little bit of chemistry thrown in,

229

a great deal of the Krozenberger stuff,

230

00:16:29,000 --> 00:16:33,000

and a lot of publishing business and all the rest of it.

231

Not one single person has thought or really used their minds and said,

232

00:16:37,000 --> 00:16:41,000

now, is the overall, what could these things be?

233

Are you thinking of going to jump right over to the subject of money?

234

Say something, you're not a funny.

There are 25,000 species of, no species of beetles, but the British isles alone.

350

Have these been published in any of the flying saucers books?

352

No, because no flying saucer book yet has ever come to what I'm building up to.

They have never come to the biological aspect of the saucer.

Now, these two here, I just wanted, if I were to get in this correctly,

are these the photographs of egg-beater?

No.

You may, at any time this year, look into me like a phase of an egg-beater,

358

possibly set up on a piece of black velvet or a photograph of black paper,

and just some light-dark arms.

360

I'm going to explain to you, John, to your listeners, that I have presented these photographs

361

stuck on cards with a piece of brown paper over that card, tipped on,

362

with a window-cutting it to show just one photograph out of a series or a part of a photograph.

363

By taking your picture, lifting up the brown paper, you can see what they really are.

364

Their page is taken out of Dr. Harvins' book on animal life,

365

00:25:42,000 --> 00:25:50,000

and they are all animals, all vegetables, which luminesce, as I could chemiluminesce.

366

The two of them, looking at, are very small animals which are found in the sea of the jellyfish nature.

367

00:25:57,000 --> 00:26:06,000

They have in every way the appearance of many of the descriptions of different types of UFOs.

368

Now, I'm not saying the photographs of UFOs that have been presented by such gentlemen as Dr. Danity

369

are photographs of this nature.

370

00:26:15,000 --> 00:26:22,000

We have gotten from that two measures by which photographs could be taken.

371

I'd have used at this point to say whether I think the photographs have been printed

372

or otherwise are taken or not. That's another whole subject, which I'd like to get on with, if I may.

373

I think I hope I've got you and I hope I've got some of your listeners to a point of concern,

374

which I'm sure you've never seen before, as though I had it on the shape of them.

380

They are called radiolaria, infusoria, globiterina.

381

There's a huge group of single-celled animals which are found in every drop of water that is in the world.

382

Diaphanos, currently any biologic crust and just a drop of dead water and you'll see,

383

00:27:19,000 --> 00:27:25,000

cylinder, lentils, even porpoises, triangular things.

384

00:27:25,000 --> 00:27:28,000

Yes, little porcelain crust, little plate, right?

385

00:27:28,000 --> 00:27:31,000

Just take some of your own blood and have a look at the plate and it's finished.

386

00:27:31,000 --> 00:27:34,000

There is a blind spot, there's really a field.

387

00:27:34,000 --> 00:27:38,000

The red, the red, you've seen a field, the red, red, red, red blood cells.

388

00:27:38,000 --> 00:27:44,000

Even in the big medium, it is suitable for an animal to adopt the most specific of all forms,

389

00:27:44,000 --> 00:27:46,000

the globular form, I presume.

390

00:27:46,000 --> 00:27:50,000

The fetus is a locomotion, also sitting on the bottom or going up and down,

391

00:27:50,000 --> 00:27:53,000

they become compressed out of the bottom of the side to side.

392

00:27:53,000 --> 00:27:58,000

Then comes the crest of tensile stress of the structure.

393

00:27:58,000 --> 00:28:01,000

The gelatinous ones just go into the air like an amoeba.

394

00:28:01,000 --> 00:28:07,000

If they want to retain some kind of form, they will probably become hexagonal, triangular,

395

00:28:07,000 --> 00:28:14,000

dodecahedron, tetrahedron, various geometric shapes.

396

00:28:14,000 --> 00:28:18,000

These four animals have drift about, the plant from a system known,

397

00:28:18,000 --> 00:28:23,000

which we may all have to feed on one day, which whales feed on, which most fishes feed on.

398

00:28:23,000 --> 00:28:27,000

It's made up of millions of these little diatoms and things and they're the most wonderful little shapes

399

00:28:27,000 --> 00:28:31,000

because they're so suspended in the water.

400

00:28:31,000 --> 00:28:35,000

They take so long to sink, they never get anywhere, does it, I mean.

401

00:28:35,000 --> 00:28:41,000

Their whole life cycle is passed through in the sinking of a few feet, perhaps.

402

00:28:41,000 --> 00:28:45,000

Sometimes the year when the sea goes green, when lakes suddenly go sort of reddish,

403

00:28:45,000 --> 00:28:49,000

that is when you have what's called a flush of maybe bacteria or inclusions

404

00:28:49,000 --> 00:28:55,000

or one of these small cerdizeras, a type of animal, or bacteria in some cases,

405

00:28:55,000 --> 00:28:57,000

some of the blue bit of bacteria.

406

00:28:57,000 --> 00:29:01,000

You will open your refrigerator and found the dishes that you've got in there

407

00:29:01,000 --> 00:29:03,000

for the next day, glowing happily in the dark.

408

I have, it's my two-long experience.

409

00:29:05,000 --> 00:29:09,000

That is the type of bacteria which is lodged in the fishes' scales.

410

Those individual little bacteria, those small, which cannot be put to the naked eye,

411

00:29:14,000 --> 00:29:19,000

you have to get a quite powerful microscope of the individual little ones.

412

They put out continuous cold light throughout their tiny little lives,

413

00:29:24,000 --> 00:29:29,000

which in proportion to their size is about 400 times that of the power

414

00:29:29,000 --> 00:29:31,000

that gives them the New York sedatives.

415

00:29:31,000 --> 00:29:33,000

Nature is a very, very wonderful thing.

416

00:29:33,000 --> 00:29:36,000

Now, I'm coming finally to my point.

417

Why brought these things up?

418

00:29:38,000 --> 00:29:43,000

But to point out that the biologist has not yet had a say in his UFO business.

419

Now, I would give credit to a Swedish gentleman who I've never met.

420

I don't know who he is or where he is.

421

00:29:49,000 --> 00:29:54,000

His name is ZOE, which I understand is the Polish way of saying Joe.

422

00:29:54,000 --> 00:30:01,000

Wetnookle W-A-L-K-O, Heism Zarecki, S-E-R-E-C-K-I.

423

00:30:01,000 --> 00:30:04,000

I've talked about this myself a couple of times on the air.

424

00:30:04,000 --> 00:30:05,000

I was very tangentially.

425

00:30:05,000 --> 00:30:10,000

This gentleman has developed a theory, and I give full credit to him for bringing it to my attention.

426

00:30:10,000 --> 00:30:13,000

I've been working on a theory here, and when I've been working on it,

427

00:30:13,000 --> 00:30:18,000

I've been thinking of aspects of it and putting them down in his hopes and logics and sequences.

428

You know that animals feed on matter, materials.

429

00:30:22,000 --> 00:30:27,000

Plants, on the other hand, feed half on matter and half on energy.

430

00:30:27,000 --> 00:30:32,000

They take the substances in liquid form out of the soil through their roots,

431

00:30:32,000 --> 00:30:36,000

and they take, they combine sunlight, the youth and flower fields,

432

00:30:36,000 --> 00:30:41,000

and the energy of the sunlight, combining the chemicals to build up their food substances,

433

00:30:41,000 --> 00:30:43,000

in which they build their bodies.

434

00:30:43,000 --> 00:30:48,000

So we have life forms that are best to deserve, which are living on matter entirely,

435

or half matter and half energy.

436

Now, there is nothing as defaultful in nature, and it's exactly that kind of probable

437

that there could be life forms, and I'm not talking about animals, or viruses, or plants,

438

but another type of force type, but another type of force type of life form,

439

Where is energy of certain kinds to be obtained in curious forms,

on the whole matter of energy basically, but it's kind of locked up in, isn't it?

We're finding that out now with our fusion and our addition, Bob.

443

They can all have a lot of power to get the locked up energy out of matter,

444

Where is a lot of free energy of certain kinds available?

447

At the outer limit of our atmosphere, where such energy is pouring upon us from the start,

there's many other sources that we find now from radio astronomy.

449

This, you've heard of gentlemen, the initial suggestion was that the maybe life forms

450

living up there are of a high tenuous nature, which has, are enclosed in a bladder type thing,

which for some reason, and I think he has good reasons to say this,

452

and I just never much to try and go into the technical character too much,

453

00:32:01,000 --> 00:32:03,000

but I think that in certain days and certain months,

454

there's a certain closure of the silicon as it's a considerable element.

455

The inside maybe, it's got to be a gauges mixture or part of gelatinous, but mostly it's a thing.

456

That they will adopt certain forms, particularly the globular, the lenticular,

457

I use the form of the, the oblate and spheroid, I think it's called,

458

the cylindrical, perhaps when they're breathing, they will adopt like I have seen myself

459

have another in some time, the chromosomes, how they bunch themselves together

There are other kinds where they'll come together and then they'll put a plate of light

471

they make like a little cylinder, the next thing is one in a wire, the other,

473

and they rest in that stage of time and then out of them come little pairs of little things

474

most of our telecoms are trained, these are trained, of things outside our atmosphere.

Most of our meteorologists are trained in their lives and things inside our atmosphere.

489

We are working like mad now, so is the effort, everybody is to find out what goes on at the edge of our atmosphere.

But every minute I run and tell me that things have to be disease-loading about this guy, they have.

491

And they are just the type of form which, due to the natural environment,

492

a natural object is, which is not an inanimate object,

493

00:35:03,000 --> 00:35:07,000

and it's neither an animal nor a plant nor a bird, but it's an, in other words, a life form,

494

00:35:07,000 --> 00:35:12,000

that might take up, then people say, well wait, come come, some of these things are going to be normal,

495

00:35:12,000 --> 00:35:14,000

the fires are going to be reported.

496

00:35:14,000 --> 00:35:19,000

I'll take that up in one second, then they say, how do they travel this fast?

497

00:35:19,000 --> 00:35:23,000

Well, I never to figure that I should have made the note before I came, I'm sorry John,

498

00:35:23,000 --> 00:35:29,000

but I will give them to you, and if you want to read on the air, I can either read them or I can send you a note and you can read them yourself.

499

If you take the density of water as a medium, and the pressure of water at the bottom of the ocean, and the top of the ocean,

and you compare it with the density of air at ocean level, and then on up through to our other atmosphere,

and you exit from the lake, and you see what the biggest we have in water into the air.

which is just one great huge hung up muscle, actually,

and it can go to tremendous speeds, you can go to 113 feet, put long jumping clean out of the water,

508

you can go to certain speeds.

509

In the atmosphere, in the lower atmosphere, things can travel much faster, both through the sea.

510

As the atmosphere rarefies and goes up, the things can travel much faster still,

511

and by pure escalation,

512

00:36:25,000 --> 00:36:28,000

according to Mr. Wetzelowski and he said himself,

it's good we've got to get some of this to go into the actual details, we should say good, but I'll bounce it.

514

You can mobilize the speed of something in water by 7 hundred I think,

515

and you will get the speed at which an object is the same size,

516

00:36:42,000 --> 00:36:45,000

or comparable size, can travel in the atmosphere.

Also, measure size.

518

The harder you push down from around, the better it is in its form.

519

The looser the medium around you is, the bigger you can be without setting things.

The normal size is reported to some users,

521

and I'm told, without the fact of a life form living in a rarefied atmosphere,

522

they're seeing it exclusively on the radio energy.

May I ask you, is there a question with a question following your thoughts now?

524

Is it conceivable that as this life, if this life exists,

which on earth are plant life uses,

it can completely move at the speed of light?

528

That's a lovely thought. I haven't gone that far.

529

That's not one of anybody's thought-ups before.

That I would have to ask some citizens of my country,

like Dr. Keaton Barthel, who does have a slight interest in the biological aspect of these things,

532

I may make a note of that and forget it for a moment, so I can remember it for myself.

533

But I would, in the meantime, like to find myself as a bound of possibility,

534

I live with animals right now.

562

Don't think that animals, whether any animals in the universe have intelligence.

563

If you ever watch a cat talking a mouse or a bird,

564

but if the birds are mouthing the cat, are certainly using intelligence.

565

But very advanced forms, the cat is thinking out his next move.

566

It's not all instinctive.

567

And if anybody can tell me the difference between instinct and reason,

they better get on the air right sharp and prove it.

Now, take some of the things that these creatures do.

570

I'll come even to this button-stop in turn.

Any animal with life forms which could travel at 15,000 miles an hour.

572

Some of these things have been alleged to do just that.

573

90,000 people say this is absolutely ridiculous.

574

00:40:30,000 --> 00:40:36,000

By extrapolation of what animals can do in a liquid medium for burrowing under the earth,

575

00:40:36,000 --> 00:40:38,000

start with moans, things like that.

576

00:40:38,000 --> 00:40:39,000

So do they get along?

577

00:40:39,000 --> 00:40:40,000

No, moans go around.

578

00:40:40,000 --> 00:40:43,000

It's a matter of fact that anyhow things burrowing around under the earth take a long time.

579

00:40:43,000 --> 00:40:45,000

They just shovel their way through.

580

00:40:45,000 --> 00:40:47,000

They have to use a lot of muscular energy.

581

00:40:47,000 --> 00:40:50,000

Animals and water can travel faster and more freely.

582

00:40:50,000 --> 00:40:52,000

Animals and air can travel faster still.

583

00:40:52,000 --> 00:40:56,000

If you get up and food, you can try to be nowhere, they could travel to Norman's Street.

584

00:40:56,000 --> 00:40:59,000

And that wonderful point that Sylvia brought up is that we had to think about it really deeply.

585

Is it not possible that the closer they get to the source of their energy, the faster they may be able to go?

586

Of course, I've got some nasty ones coming in a minute when we come to another aspect of ufology.

587

That is the whole question of teleportation and the possibility of transgressing the speed of life, which is unsanitary.

588

Just before he dies, he's only a theoretical point.

589

Just the same as speed of sound is a relative point.

590

I remember when I was a kid, I was told no airplane would ever surpass the sound barrier

591

00:41:33,000 --> 00:41:36,000

because air became virtually spotless at that point.

592

00:41:36,000 --> 00:41:39,000

And it'd be like describing an airplane into a brick wall.

593

00:41:39,000 --> 00:41:43,000

Of course, all the silly people who were telling me it all forgot about the bullet wounding thing

594

00:41:43,000 --> 00:41:45,000

which was very long time.

595

00:41:45,000 --> 00:41:47,000

It's been very well-adapted in fact.

596

And that's just business of running into a brick wall, incidentally.

597

We'll bring it back to when I'm talking about youth loads.

598

You know the ordinary cockchaper or dune bus, the big people which comes bubbling along.

599

It is made of a tough curve.

600

It's a natural plastic. It's exoskeleton.

601

It's a hard shell.

But it is a very nice entity.

603

It's a something of a millimeter in thickness, certainly.

604

And yet, one of those people can drive straight into a brick wall

605

and after 50 miles an hour, bang into the wall, fall down on the ground, get up and walk away.

606

I'd like to see some of our leaders travel in the speed of 70 miles an hour.

607

There is a lady who just said, OK.

608

00:42:33,000 --> 00:42:36,000

Oh, there's an intake of travel in the knowledge business.

609

00:42:36,000 --> 00:42:38,000

There's a certain speed to fly.

610

You know when you're going into a pine wood and you see this thing looks like a yellow jacket

611

00:42:43,000 --> 00:42:46,000

and it's hovering in the air and suddenly it's somewhere else.

612

00:42:46,000 --> 00:42:49,000

It's sort of egg-bead and helicopter thing.

613

00:42:49,000 --> 00:42:53,000

It was a legend by one scientist, of course he was immediately blocked on the head

614

00:42:53,000 --> 00:42:58,000

having said, but I believe that he wasn't too far off from the work of other people.

615

But the legend has been able to travel 800 miles an hour.

616

00:43:01,000 --> 00:43:05,000

Well that's before anybody broke the sound barrier and there was an uproar.

617

It's virtually over the top of a Mexican mountain.

618

00:43:07,000 --> 00:43:10,000

I don't know. I bring it up more as a joke then.

619

00:43:10,000 --> 00:43:17,000

He did say it and it sounded like Prince and he got the warmth that was at the end of him at the time.

620

00:43:17,000 --> 00:43:20,000

But they had found that animals do travel flying.

621

00:43:20,000 --> 00:43:24,000

Animals dig the insects and follow the artifacts that they can go along.

622

00:43:24,000 --> 00:43:27,000

And the beetle is a specific part of the mission itself.

623

00:43:27,000 --> 00:43:29,000

But I'm thinking the other aspects of it,

624

00:43:29,000 --> 00:43:31,000

flying into a brick wall would make it only 40 or 30.

625

00:43:31,000 --> 00:43:34,000

You try driving your car into a brick wall of 40 miles an hour.

626

00:43:34,000 --> 00:43:39,000

I'd like to see some steel produced which has a 10,000 strength of the material

627

00:43:39,000 --> 00:43:43,000

outside the shell of a beetle is made sitting half in it.

628

00:43:43,000 --> 00:43:45,000

We've got a long way to go.

629

00:43:45,000 --> 00:43:51,000

Anyhow, back to these UFOs, those ones which might possibly be a life form.

630

The enormous speed would not be much the intolerable.

631

Anything that can go that enormous speed, obviously does not suffer from too many geese as it were in acceleration.

632

But they can go so far, they can stop so far.

633

And it takes up so far that they can go off to another angle.

634

00:44:11,000 --> 00:44:13,000

In other words, they don't make a right angle turn.

They come to a dead stop and go to another direction.

636

That is possible.

But I don't think that this type really do that very often.

Another category of UFOs.

There are luminous animals in the sea, a fungus, bacteria, spade.

644

Almost every form of life known has luminous members.

645

00:44:41,000 --> 00:44:44,000

I found a luminous beetle in a cave in Trinidad.

646

00:44:44,000 --> 00:44:46,000

I've actually got some others there.

647

00:44:46,000 --> 00:44:48,000

But it's all along the side of it.

648

00:44:48,000 --> 00:44:50,000

Another plant is found light often.

649

00:44:50,000 --> 00:44:52,000

But there are luminous spades.

650

00:44:52,000 --> 00:44:56,000

There is one bird, the young one, just a finger, a bird in a pheasant.

651

00:44:56,000 --> 00:44:59,000

There are little birds hoping their mouths to be fed.

652

00:44:59,000 --> 00:45:01,000

Sometimes the inside of the mouth is luminous.

653

00:45:01,000 --> 00:45:04,000

Not because they are luminous, but because they have luminous bacteria

654

00:45:04,000 --> 00:45:06,000

that have lodged in there.

655

00:45:06,000 --> 00:45:10,000

The theory is that the mother can find them more easily in the dark.

656

00:45:10,000 --> 00:45:12,000

There are sponges which are luminous.

657

00:45:12,000 --> 00:45:16,000

There are jellyfish that are squids.

658

00:45:16,000 --> 00:45:18,000

Squids are particularly interesting.

659

00:45:18,000 --> 00:45:20,000

They have a gar shape.

660

00:45:20,000 --> 00:45:23,000

And they have like potlives all around the side.

661

00:45:23,000 --> 00:45:24,000

And they are vivid.

662

00:45:24,000 --> 00:45:27,000

Some of the deeply squished have been brought up in the Indian Ocean.

663

00:45:27,000 --> 00:45:31,000

Four different colors grow the potlives around the side.

664

00:45:31,000 --> 00:45:33,000

If you like us to look through some more,

665

00:45:33,000 --> 00:45:35,000

you'll see some of those squids.

666

00:45:35,000 --> 00:45:40,000

There's a fish called Poteleflaparov, which I caught when I was very young,

667

00:45:40,000 --> 00:45:45,000

in the band of seas, often coasters in the looker.

668

00:45:45,000 --> 00:45:47,000

And there were those coasters, the labies.

669

00:45:47,000 --> 00:45:50,000

They let marbles, which were sort of really looking like fish,

670

00:45:50,000 --> 00:45:53,000

rather sort of a polder, which looked a bit like a porgy.

671

00:45:53,000 --> 00:45:57,000

And under the eyes, which of course, fishers, I don't have any eyelids,

672

00:45:57,000 --> 00:46:00,000

it's sort of like another eye, really a pocket.

673

00:46:00,000 --> 00:46:03,000

A sort of a kidney-shaped pocket underneath each eye,

674

00:46:03,000 --> 00:46:06,000

with a movable lid, as it were.

675

00:46:06,000 --> 00:46:08,000

And in this pocket, in some extraordinary ways,

676

00:46:08,000 --> 00:46:14,000

this fish manages invariably to gather an enormous amount of luminous bacteria,

677

00:46:14,000 --> 00:46:17,000

which just live in there like for the parasite.

678

00:46:17,000 --> 00:46:19,000

They're happily there, glowing away all the time.

679

00:46:19,000 --> 00:46:22,000

And when the fish wants to see his food on the bottom,

680

00:46:22,000 --> 00:46:26,000

he simply opens his little shutters and he gets two little headlights pointing down

681

00:46:26,000 --> 00:46:29,000

onto the ground, as the most amazing thing to see.

682

00:46:29,000 --> 00:46:31,000

He has some in the pocket, and it was all dark,

683

00:46:31,000 --> 00:46:35,000

but these two little headlights came on, so he could see the ground and splunk of him.

684

00:46:35,000 --> 00:46:38,000

Now, I come back to the luminous squids,

685

00:46:38,000 --> 00:46:40,000

and we'll have these porgy lights next along the side.

686

00:46:40,000 --> 00:46:44,000

You'll see others there, that wonderful frog, zero-fog,

687

00:46:44,000 --> 00:46:48,000

which has red lights for the stopping and green lights for going, presumably.

688

00:46:48,000 --> 00:46:50,000

It really does have red and green lights on it.

689

00:46:50,000 --> 00:46:56,000

It lives all the time inside a dark log in the Brazilian jungle.

690

00:46:56,000 --> 00:47:01,000

Now, a lot of these UFOs have been reported to have these brilliant porgy lights on the side,

691

00:47:01,000 --> 00:47:03,000

some of which are circular, some of which are log-shaped,

692

00:47:03,000 --> 00:47:07,000

some of which are square, and the pilot has described the lights being so dark

693

00:47:07,000 --> 00:47:11,000

it can't look like a mysterious layer inside, the wicked cave.

694

00:47:11,000 --> 00:47:16,000

So, the idea of light forms having self-luminosity or carrying their own light

695

00:47:16,000 --> 00:47:21,000

is not anyway beyond the bound possibility, in fact, it's highly probable.

696

00:47:21,000 --> 00:47:29,000

Now, if these things give their food, their energy, and evolve to live in rare-sized atmosphere,

697

00:47:29,000 --> 00:47:32,000

you may have just as many be right, outside the atmosphere.

698

00:47:32,000 --> 00:47:34,000

Actually, it is a set of space, there may be things drifting about,

699

00:47:34,000 --> 00:47:37,000

up close, if they can speedy, smoothly, beyond energy,

700

00:47:37,000 --> 00:47:40,000

and we know this map are all through space now, and the very tiny response,

701

00:47:40,000 --> 00:47:45,000

they might be able to pick up on us, matter, to make a sort of sphere,

702

00:47:45,000 --> 00:47:49,000

or whatever other shape, cigar, or lamp, and it is interesting that many,

703

00:47:49,000 --> 00:47:53,000

in fact, in many all cases, report that the outside of these animals

704

00:47:53,000 --> 00:47:55,000

look more like luminous.

705

00:47:55,000 --> 00:47:59,000

Most fish have a sort of slippery look, I can say, it's very true.

706

00:47:59,000 --> 00:48:04,000

They might be things like the devil, which they came down to low and got drowned,

707

00:48:04,000 --> 00:48:07,000

in our atmosphere, they were drowned, probably in our atmosphere,

708

00:48:07,000 --> 00:48:12,000

it's not technically where I'm putting it, if they come down too far.

709

00:48:12,000 --> 00:48:17,000

On the other hand, another aspect of this fellow series is certainly delightful.

710

00:48:17,000 --> 00:48:20,000

These things always seem to be in the sky, sometimes drift down,

711

00:48:20,000 --> 00:48:25,000

maybe they get sick, they go down, like when whales get sick, they come up.

712

00:48:25,000 --> 00:48:32,000

But they have been appearing, if you take a map, and map appears for you first,

713

00:48:32,000 --> 00:48:37,000

as Dr. Davidson said last night, they're all turning up in radio beings.

714

00:48:37,000 --> 00:48:43,000

Also, they occur much more frequently over atomic energy plants, over large cities.

715

00:48:43,000 --> 00:48:48,000

Exactly, over all the places where we are broadcasting, telecasting,

716

00:48:48,000 --> 00:48:52,000

putting out masses and masses of electromagnetic energy,

717

00:48:52,000 --> 00:48:55,000

which didn't in the old days used to be put out of these places.

718

00:48:55,000 --> 00:48:57,000

These things get their food from above,

719

00:48:57,000 --> 00:49:00,000

and they can be indicated by certain food from below.

720

00:49:00,000 --> 00:49:03,000

They being life forms come down to a bit of investigating,

721

00:49:03,000 --> 00:49:06,000

maybe they can come down with this very strong radio beam,

722

00:49:06,000 --> 00:49:09,000

and they in the radio beam pick up a certain amount of electrical energy from there,

723

00:49:09,000 --> 00:49:12,000

but they need very little to be included in you.

724

00:49:12,000 --> 00:49:15,000

When they are partly out, when they affect our radar,

725

00:49:15,000 --> 00:49:19,000

naturally they were their solid objects, they may not be very solid,

726

it's probably got to have some kind of intelligence,

of course, in bad words, maybe they've yet to find it.

But in other words, they are intelligently directed from within,

do you get me?

And they come down and play tag with the aeroplects.

These funny, great bumbling things have come up.

765

All the things that come up from the bottom of the sea were amazed.

766

It was a world-living thing called the Crackers.

But one professor, Feral, could probably actually go out there and catch one.

But we are amazed at some of the things that come up from the bottom of the sea

When I take a life form, feeding on energy,

789

Electric eel can store, oh my goodness,

791

what a lot of electricity is stored in storage batteries.

792

These things are little power houses of their own.

793

Coming down here, buzzing around the floor,

maybe he got lost or passed,

or sunk to the bottom,

or got in a wrong convection current or something.

797

And he's floating down there,

798

feeling probably slightly uncomfortable

799

because it's tremendous air pressure around him,

800

I'm making these barge humans,

802

which is a man that explains animal intelligence

803

and behavior rather, behaviors are better words.

804

And that comes at human beings.

805

And out of all innocence,

806

he goes up and gets too close or even touches it

807

and whammer to get the terrific electric shock.

I'm using the word electricity to again over-simplify

809

because the different types of electromagnetic waves

And so there may be one kind of speed in this wave range,

812

seconded by hypotheses.

827

We need facts.

828

I don't know if anybody's got the UFO yet.

829

I very much doubted this animal type,

830

or this life form type could be gotten.

831

Because apparently when they get down to our atmosphere,

832

they dissolve, they proceed to dissolve.

833

And sometimes when they clash amongst themselves,

it seems to be a discharge of some kind,

and this angel pair comes down.

In other cases, the policeman in Philadelphia,

837

who saw it land on the pavement,

838

and made a shout of it,

839

he went out and picked it up.

840

I can bring you four or five witnesses from up in our Warren County

841

who saw the similar thing,

842

00:54:28,000 --> 00:54:30,000

and they went and picked this stuff up for three.

843

And you know, they all stated that it's migrating spiders,

844

and they put out a web, and they go blowing on a witness,

845

and the spiders' web, and you can tell spiders would put on the mic,

846

and the string would drop the boil on it.

This stuff, they picked it up,

848

and as they put it on their hands, it becomes jelly.

849

And then it doesn't seem to dissolve right in the fight tube.

Other people, I believe, the Donald King Ho has

851

and that's a chemical all those color is.

863

And the atmosphere at the crest of the mountains,

864

where they came up with highly charged carbonations matter,

865

and they seem to be unable to cope with carbonations matter

866

in the case of formal particles that may have plugged

867

their breathing vents,

868

00:55:36,000 --> 00:55:39,000

three-day machines, or edible life forms.

869

And they all went out of gear at the same time.

870

One managed to land. Two got away because they were on an outside edge.

871

Don't forget it was number one and number six,

872

so we did serve to keep on going.

873

And over two crashed and one flew out in the air, all of you.

874

So it came apart in the air, came unstuck.

And the ashes that set out in the deep within the door

was nothing else but the beginning of Angel's hair.

Or, as Charles Ford says,

there are being rains of substance which would evacuate blood.

There have been rains of ashes.

There have been rains which would share a certain carbonation content.

881

First you had one of these things a mile and a half long.

882

It might be so genius that you could, without the energy,

883

you thought you could drive a plane through.

884

And you'd only come up with sticky metal, all of you.

885

But the stillness of the enormous amount of material in there,

886

and the very tenuous form, first it dies.

887

First it dies, sometimes, and it's run out of energy,

or something goes wrong with their mechanism.

When I'm speaking of biology, biological mechanism,

when it runs out they die, and what are you left with?

That amount of carbon, silicon and so on.

And the end product, as it falls very rapidly

through the increasingly dense atmosphere,

will burn up just like an meteor.

And all you get is ashes,

896

and your range of carbonaceous matter,

your range of blood may be of a similar nature,

may be the heavy part, you may have a certain amount of liquidism,

and so on and so forth, in your realm.

Let us appear theoretical purposes.

901

Let us say that 80% of UFO reports are dealing with life forms,

of the level of our intelligence, or above it.

909

And nobody can deny the possibilities that intelligence

910

of our level, or higher, right up to the almost godlike,

911

00:57:34,000 --> 00:57:37,000

need not be contained in a body such as we have,

912

00:57:37,000 --> 00:57:39,000

made of hydrogen and carbon, specifically,

913

which is highly suitable to our planet,

914

00:57:42,000 --> 00:57:45,000

but on other planets, not necessarily going around our sun,

915

00:57:45,000 --> 00:57:47,000

going around other planets.

916

And in the, how many suns are there in our galaxy

917

of our suns? I think it's 400 million,

918

00:57:53,000 --> 00:57:55,000

or something like that, 400,000 million,

919

00:57:55,000 --> 00:57:57,000

something like that, in our galaxy alone,

920

00:57:57,000 --> 00:58:00,000

and according to the theories of Coikler of Chicago

921

and Weisegel of Germany, planets are a natural

922

00:58:03,000 --> 00:58:06,000

concomitant of the formation of a sun,

923

00:58:06,000 --> 00:58:09,000

when the sun starts at the whirling legatelle or this,

924

00:58:09,000 --> 00:58:12,000

as it contracts, an heavy matter flies out,

925

00:58:12,000 --> 00:58:14,000

and I can set it to use in the light matter,

926

00:58:14,000 --> 00:58:16,000

goes to the middle of the sun, automatically,

927

by a very complicated thing of world,

928

and we have to gather up all the heavy matter and make the planets,

929

and there will always be a set of planets going around every sun,

930

well, every sun of the same size as ours,

931

probably got a set of the same number of planets,

932

about the same average as ours, according to both the law anyhow.

933

I don't know that in the respect to the truth,

934

as an astronomer.

935

00:58:34,000 --> 00:58:37,000

And the third planet ours will probably be very equivalent to Earth.

936

There is nothing in nature known to biologists as parallel evolution, you know.

937

One animal living on one continent,

938

00:58:43,000 --> 00:58:45,000

can over a bit of years,

939

00:58:45,000 --> 00:58:48,000

due to the same things that it has to do,

940

00:58:48,000 --> 00:58:53,000

develop it to look more exactly like a completely different animal on another continent.

941

00:58:53,000 --> 00:58:55,000

They're not related in any way, genetically,

942

00:58:55,000 --> 00:58:57,000

but they come to look almost identical.

943

00:58:57,000 --> 00:58:59,000

That's called parallel evolution,

944

00:58:59,000 --> 00:59:02,000

there's no reason why even human light-looking mammals

945

00:59:02,000 --> 00:59:04,000

couldn't be developed on a planet going around another sun

946

00:59:04,000 --> 00:59:06,000

at the same size as ours,

947

00:59:06,000 --> 00:59:08,000

the sun being made of the same material as we know

948

00:59:08,000 --> 00:59:11,000

through respect to the topic analysis and so on.

949

00:59:11,000 --> 00:59:14,000

Therefore, there's no reason why there should not be

950

00:59:14,000 --> 00:59:17,000

light forms with intelligences about the virus,

951

00:59:17,000 --> 00:59:20,000

in other words, who can build machines, who would want to build machines,

952

00:59:20,000 --> 00:59:22,000

and who might go flying in them.

953

00:59:22,000 --> 00:59:27,000

We cannot discredit the possibility that there could be, in other words, man,

954

00:59:27,000 --> 00:59:30,000

and I've used man in his quotes,

955

00:59:30,000 --> 00:59:34,000

man's UFOs, which are machines, structures,

956

00:59:34,000 --> 00:59:37,000

guided by the intelligence either writing in that machine

957

00:59:37,000 --> 00:59:40,000

or controlling it robotically from a distance from a mothership.

958

00:59:40,000 --> 00:59:43,000

There is no reason why that category could also not be included.

959
