The men in black really are not anything new.

6

00:00:32,000 --> 00:00:35,000

Can you hear me in the back? I may fade away here.

7

00:00:35,000 --> 00:00:41,000

There are many references in the Bible which could be interpreted as men in black type incidents

8

00:00:41,000 --> 00:00:49,000

because although they're called angels, they're usually in threes as our men in black are.

9

00:00:49,000 --> 00:00:54,000

They travel in threes and they got into all sorts of mischief.

10

00:00:54,000 --> 00:01:01,000

Remember the three men who went to Sodom and Gomorrah and warned the innocent people, the few innocent people there?

11

00:01:01,000 --> 00:01:06,000

Today that would be interpreted as a men in black incident because a men in black is a generic term.

12

00:01:06,000 --> 00:01:14,000

It doesn't perjust the men in black and black Cadillacs who arrive at the scene of UFO incidents.

13

00:01:14,000 --> 00:01:18,000

As I'll describe to you later, there are all kinds of men in black.

14

00:01:18,000 --> 00:01:23,000

They're mystery men and we don't know who they are, where they come from or who's supporting them.

15

00:01:23,000 --> 00:01:28,000

And some of these people apparently have a lot of logistical support and financial support.

16

00:01:28,000 --> 00:01:30,000

It's very mysterious.

17

00:01:30,000 --> 00:01:35,000

In the Orient for thousands of years, there's been a legend called...

18

Is this Mike that sensitive? Is this showing up on the tape?

19

00:01:40,000 --> 00:01:43,000

I need this to hold myself up.

20

00:01:43,000 --> 00:01:48,000

In the Orient for thousands of years, they've had a legend called the King of the World.

21

00:01:48,000 --> 00:01:51,000

And it's surprising how many people believe in this.

22

00:01:51,000 --> 00:02:02,000

And then the 20s and the 30s, various explorers who were traveling through the Himalayas and India and Mongolia,

23

00:02:02,000 --> 00:02:08,000

Outer Mongolia, they all had these legends and there were a lot of books in the 20s and 30s that mentioned the King of the World.

24

00:02:08,000 --> 00:02:15,000

He's right behind me now, rewinding.

25

00:02:15,000 --> 00:02:21,000

The King of the World supposedly lives in an underground city.

26

00:02:21,000 --> 00:02:23,000

And we've all heard about underground cities.

27

00:02:23,000 --> 00:02:31,000

Well, somewhere in the reaches of Outer Mongolia, there's supposed to be an underground city where the King of the World resides.

28

00:02:31,000 --> 00:02:38,000

And he sends out his agents to control the world, the Swiss world, and these agents are men in black.

29

00:02:38,000 --> 00:02:45,000

They're orientals. They look oriental. They're dressed in black garments and they supposedly travel all over the world.

30

00:02:45,000 --> 00:02:50,000

And these legends are very extensive and they've been going on for a long time.

31

00:02:50,000 --> 00:02:59,000

So half the world believes that the men in black are from the underground, from the Agasta.

32

00:02:59,000 --> 00:03:04,000

You've heard that name probably. There have been various books in it.

33

00:03:04,000 --> 00:03:15,000

And as I say in the 20s and 30s, a lot of books in the 1940s, a man named Richard Shaver sort of revived it and gave it an American twist with his shaver mystery,

34

Which was about again about underground cities populated by detrimental robots or duro's who controlled everything on the surface with their mysterious rays.

35

00:03:26,000 --> 00:03:39,000

And the shaver mystery today, it's almost forgotten, but it dominated the UFO field for the first five or six years from 1947 to 1955.

36

The shaver mystery was the number one explanation for everything that was going on.

37

00:03:44,000 --> 00:03:49,000

Ray Palmer published quite a few books supposedly written by Shaver.

38

00:03:49,000 --> 00:04:02,000

But as it turns out, they were really written by Ray Palmer promoting this idea and promoting the shaver notions of men in black because there were a lot of men in black stories in the shaver mystery.

39

00:04:02,000 --> 00:04:10,000

And until just recently, there was a magazine out west called the Shaver Tron, which was about the shaver mystery.

40

00:04:10,000 --> 00:04:19,000

Another magazine called the Hollow Hassel, which was about the Hollow Earth where all of these men in black were coming from supposedly.

41

00:04:19,000 --> 00:04:32,000

Then if you go to other religions, the Western religion, you find all kinds of men of black stories, especially in the Catholicism and in Protestant religions.

42

We have all the stories about the devil who very often is described as looking oriental, very sinister, oriental, dressed in black garments.

43

00:04:43,000 --> 00:04:53,000

So it's it has deep roots. This whole concept of the men in black in witchcraft, which is a booming religion right now, even though most of you aren't aware of it.

44

There are two stores in New York City that just sell the equipment for witchcraft.

45

00:04:58,000 --> 00:05:09,000

During the rituals of some witches indulge in they have one of the number dressed up in black and they act out the role of the man in black.

46

And this is a part of the witchcraft religion.

47

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:25,000

In the late 1940s, there was a famous World War two general named Carl Spock, who was the general in charge of the Air Force in Europe for part of the war.

48

00:05:25,000 --> 00:05:30,000

And he made a very strange statement around 1948, 49.

49

00:05:30,000 --> 00:05:33,000

He said there was absolutely this was a president.

50

00:05:33,000 --> 00:05:40,000

But he said there was absolutely no evidence that flying saucers were piloted by Spaniards.

51

00:05:40,000 --> 00:05:43,000

And this was really from left field.

52

00:05:43,000 --> 00:05:50,000

Apparently people have been informing the Air Force that they'd seen a flying saucer and a spanish got out of it.

53

00:05:51,000 --> 00:06:00,000

Meaning that he was an olive skinned person with who looked like a Spaniard.

54

00:06:00,000 --> 00:06:07,000

We never got the Air Force material that spots baked based that comment.

55

00:06:07,000 --> 00:06:13,000

But it was a very peculiar statement when I was traveling extensively around the country.

56

00:06:13,000 --> 00:06:27,000

I used to carry a lot of photographs with me in my briefcase photographs of different kinds of objects and also photographs of different ethnic groups because I was running into men and black witnesses all over the country.

57

And I would go through these photographs with them to ask them if they saw anyone that resembled the man in black that they had seen.

58

There were photographs of Indians.

59

00:06:36,000 --> 00:06:40,000

There were photographs of the various Negroi races from Africa.

60

00:06:41,000 --> 00:06:43,000

There were photographs of Eskimos.

61

There was a little mix of all kinds of ethnic groups.

62

00:06:47,000 --> 00:06:50,000

And there was one photograph that everybody jumped on.

63

00:06:50,000 --> 00:06:55,000

They stopped and say that is looks just like the guy that I saw.

64

00:06:55,000 --> 00:07:02,000

And believe it or not it was a photograph of a lap lander from Northern Sweden.

65

00:07:02,000 --> 00:07:05,000

Now they have a kind of oriental look to them.

66

00:07:05,000 --> 00:07:07,000

They're small and stature.

67

00:07:07,000 --> 00:07:11,000

And they they have a distinctive look.

68

00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:18,000

And so I'm not I'm not saying that men and black are all lap landers.

69

00:07:18,000 --> 00:07:24,000

But they they certainly look like them and seem to be related to them.

70

00:07:24,000 --> 00:07:29,000

Now we have the legends that everyone will see a man in black sooner or later.

71

00:07:29,000 --> 00:07:35,000

And the legend which is an old legend says you will see them the man in black three times.

72

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:38,000

And the third time you see him it means you're going to die.

73

00:07:38,000 --> 00:07:45,000

And if you go through the history books you'll find that a lot of people have reported this including Maria and for net.

74

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:53,000

And people that you wouldn't you wouldn't expect to have this kind of involvement.

75

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:55,000

Napoleon.

76

00:07:55,000 --> 00:08:02,000

So that that legend is a continuing legend and a strong one.

77

The other kind of man in black that we have and that I've seen myself we for the one of a name we call them the cadavers.

78

00:08:11,000 --> 00:08:18,000

Now these are people who look like they've been dead a long time and their clothes their clothes hang on them.

79

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:27,000

Their flesh is pasty white and they they look like maybe somebody had dug them up from a cemetery last week and they're walking around.

80

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:35,000

And this this cadavers type has turned up in strange places in England Sweden.

81

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:38,000

Brad Stegger saw one.

82

00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:45,000

As I say I saw one in the early 60s and we have no idea what these fellows are about.

83

00:08:45,000 --> 00:08:50,000

They're very illusive when you approach them they sort of hurry away.

84

00:08:50,000 --> 00:08:54,000

But I've never heard of them saying anything to anybody.

85

00:08:54,000 --> 00:09:02,000

But they do have a habit of turning up in UFO areas and following UFO investigators around.

86

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:08,000

So if you ever see a cadavers looking man out there following you you'll know who he is.

87

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:12,000

He's one of them.

88

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:23,000

Now we have a lot of mystery men in this country that we've never been able to explain mystery men who turn up at UFO sightings

89

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:27,000

and spread all kinds of false material around.

90

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:34,000

There was a well one that comes to immediately to mind happened in Texas a few years ago.

91

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:41,000

There was a big movement to dig up a grave in Texas where a little man was supposedly buried.

92

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:51,000

And one a very well dressed businessman type came to the cemetery and he handed out his business card and he spent hours there

93

00:09:51,000 --> 00:09:59,000

and got everybody all stirred up and he left and it turned out that his business card was a fraud

in the name that he gave everybody was a fraud.

94

00:09:59,000 --> 00:10:06,000

And we don't know where he came from or where he went or why he bothered to go to the cemetery.

95

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:15,000

The story was that in 1896 a UFO had crashed in this little town in Texas and there had been a little man aboard

96

00:10:15,000 --> 00:10:18,000

and the people had buried him in the local cemetery.

97

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:23,000

Now this story turns out was a newspaper hoax because there are a lot of stories from 1896 work.

98

00:10:23,000 --> 00:10:32,000

But somebody dug up this clipping in the 1970s and there was a stampede to go to Texas to this little town and dig up the cemetery.

99

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:39,000

Of course the local people didn't like that very much and it was all a big sensational brew.

100

00:10:39,000 --> 00:10:45,000

Nobody ever found anything in the cemetery but it was great fun for a while.

101

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:54,000

And we have we have a lot of that type of incident where somebody deliberately stirs up a UFO bus and then they vanish.

102

00:10:54,000 --> 00:11:00,000

And the UFO bus remains stirred up sometimes for months or many months afterwards.

103

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:10,000

And very often the stories of these strange bogus people circulate get into the UFO literature and become part of the UFO literature.

104

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:20,000

During the Vietnamese war in those days and I'm talking about the 60s I had a network of informants all over the country who were sending me

105

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:23,000

newspaper clippings for a newsletter that I was publishing.

106

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:33,000

And I started getting these little clippings from random places of far flung places Minnesota and New Mexico and Oregon.

107

00:11:33,000 --> 00:11:40,000

And it was the damndest thing somebody was visiting the families of men who were in Vietnam.

108

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:51,000

And this somebody was dressed in a military uniform and they would drive up to the house of the family and they would follow military procedures exactly.

109

00:11:51,000 --> 00:11:59,000

They would inform the mother or the wife or the father or the brother or whoever that their relative had been killed in Vietnam.

110

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:05,000

And this this was a very sinister thing because it would turn out to be untrue.

111

00:12:05,000 --> 00:12:11,000

But you can imagine what it would do to the family for a few days until they found out that it was not true.

112

00:12:11,000 --> 00:12:17,000

And these these fellows whoever they were they were dressed in the proper military uniform.

113

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:19,000

I'm men in black by the way when they're in military uniform.

114

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:28,000

There's always something wrong with it. There's something askew that these men were dressed in proper military uniforms and they were driving proper vehicles.

115

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:34,000

Anyone who's been in the Army knows that military officers don't write around a black Cadillac.

116

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:39,000

They write around in Sudan. Chevy's and Ford's and things that are painted usually painted brown.

117

00:12:39,000 --> 00:12:48,000

And that's the way these men what they would be driving would be a simple car sedan that's been painted brown.

118

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:57,000

And I as I kept getting these clippings because if we got a few clippings about this it probably was happening in a lot more places.

119

00:12:57,000 --> 00:13:04,000

I assumed that sooner or later the FBI or some police department would do something and we'd have a big story out of it.

120

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:09,000

But it never happened. These stories trickle in for maybe two or three years.

121

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:16,000

And whoever these crazy people were they were doing a lot of damage to these families.

122

00:13:16,000 --> 00:13:22,000

You also have to realize that they had to know about the boy in Vietnam.

123

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:27,000

What unity was stationed with and everything. And they also had to know where his family was located.

124

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:32,000

Some of these families were located on isolated farms. It would be pretty hard to find.

125

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:41,000

And yet these guys would drive up to the farm and talk to the mother or the relative and say tell them that the boy had been killed.

126

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:50,000

So they had to have some kind of elaborate support connection with the military in order to do that kind of thing.

127

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:54,560

And it didn't seem there was a lot of anti war sympathy of course at that time.

128

00:13:54,560 --> 00:14:01,520

But it didn't seem to be an action of one of those anti war groups.

129

00:14:01,520 --> 00:14:08,080

So for a lot of a better name we would call these people men in black and they may still be out there.

130

00:14:08,080 --> 00:14:15,800

Who knows what they're doing now. When I first got into the UFO thing in 1960s in a big way.

131

00:14:15,800 --> 00:14:21,120

It was a popular belief that men in Air Force uniforms were silencing witnesses.

132

00:14:21,120 --> 00:14:32,960

And this belief was spread by Afro and I kept because they would keep getting reports that a man in an Air Force uniform would arrive at the home of the witness and tell him to shut up and keep quiet.

133

00:14:32,960 --> 00:14:42,000

Appeal to their patriotism. Well we had a rash of these things on Long Island and I had strong connections in the Pentagon at that time.

134

00:14:42,200 --> 00:14:47,440

An old army buddy of mine was an assistant to the secretary of the Air Force.

135

00:14:47,440 --> 00:14:51,320

And these Air Force officers would give a name.

136

00:14:51,320 --> 00:15:02,120

Sometimes they'd show credentials. They would always be in a black Cadillac, which as I say is not standard procedure for military officer.

137

00:15:02,120 --> 00:15:08,760

Usually somebody else would be driving the Cadillac and these men would be in military uniform.

138

00:15:08,760 --> 00:15:23,000

But there would be something just a little bit wrong. The insignia would be in the wrong place on the jacket or they would be wearing the wrong type of shoes to see a military officer dressed in a dress uniform and wearing sneakers.

139

00:15:23,000 --> 00:15:27,560

Kind of strange. And there was always something that the witness would remember.

140

00:15:27,560 --> 00:15:38,720

He said hey, that was funny. Well, one woman in Wisconsin told me that she invited the officer in and offered him some jello and he tried to drink the jello.

141

00:15:39,160 --> 00:15:51,520

And so it didn't take me long to figure out that maybe these guys really weren't Air Force officers and my contacts in the Pentagon could not locate these people, the names that they were being given.

142

00:15:51,520 --> 00:15:56,880

A few cases we had the license numbers of the cars. We would check those out, which is very easy to do.

143

00:15:56,880 --> 00:16:07,600

And we find out the license had never been issued to anybody. So now how in the world, if you were going to make up a phony license plate, what kind of luck would it take for you to come up with a number that nobody else had?

144

00:16:09,080 --> 00:16:15,160

So I started antagonizing the UFO bus by saying these guys are not from the Air Force.

145

00:16:15,160 --> 00:16:24,200

And he said, I feel is obviously working for the CIA. But as soon as I got wise to them, they started using other techniques.

146

00:16:24,200 --> 00:16:37,480

They always stayed one step ahead of me. We had a variety of strange incidents that happened over and over again and never made any sense at all.

147

00:16:37,960 --> 00:16:51,760

One of my favorites is the Phantom meter reader. This is where a man would knock at a door of a house in suburbs and say he'd come to read the meter, the electric meter, the gas meter.

148

00:16:51,760 --> 00:16:56,680

And he would be dressed in the proper coveralls and all and they would let him in.

149

00:16:56,680 --> 00:17:05,600

They'd go down into the basement and he wouldn't come out. And these people after about an hour, they said, what the hell is he doing down at my basement?

150

00:17:05,640 --> 00:17:11,520

And they would look and sometimes the man would be gone altogether, never to be seen again.

151

00:17:11,520 --> 00:17:22,280

And even though there was no way out of his faith at that basement and other times they were the man would be just starting up the stairs as they opened the cellar door to find out where he was.

152

00:17:22,280 --> 00:17:29,840

So the phantom meter readers was one type of M.I.B. that we we've had.

153

00:17:29,840 --> 00:17:35,720

Then we had the phantom photographers and these were humdingers because these fellows turned up everywhere.

154

00:17:35,720 --> 00:17:41,880

They often traveled in pairs. One would be a woman and the other would be a man.

155

00:17:41,880 --> 00:17:50,360

And they were usually quite well dressed and they usually would arrive in a black Cadillac and still I started doing articles about the black Cadillacs.

156

00:17:50,360 --> 00:17:57,560

And then they switched to Volkswagen's and they were driving around West Virginia in their Volkswagen's.

157

00:17:57,600 --> 00:18:06,280

And they they they would drive up to the house of a witness, a UFO witness, who had just had a baby and they would say that they were photographers,

158

00:18:06,280 --> 00:18:09,560

professional photographers and they wanted to photograph the baby.

159

00:18:09,560 --> 00:18:13,240

And of course, new parents would be delighted to have that done.

160

00:18:13,240 --> 00:18:23,120

So they they would set up their equipment, they take pictures of the baby and they give the people a card with a neighboring town listed on the card as an acne photographer.

161

00:18:23,160 --> 00:18:28,240

And they would drive away. And it would turn out that there was no such thing as acne photographers.

162

00:18:28,240 --> 00:18:34,600

And they would never come back. And if they were professional photographers, they'd never try to sell the photographs to these families.

163

00:18:34,600 --> 00:18:37,800

So that that was another mystery.

164

00:18:37,800 --> 00:18:43,720

And then we had the phantom photographers who after somebody say you'd never seen a UFO before in your life.

165

00:18:43,720 --> 00:18:52,360

And then one night you're you're out driving home way and you see a UFO close up and you live in the suburbs the next day.

166

00:18:52,480 --> 00:19:01,480

You're getting up and there's a Cadillac park in front of your house and some men get out and they take out a big tripod and a big heavy camera.

167

00:19:01,480 --> 00:19:05,520

And they set it on the tripod and they take a picture of your house.

168

00:19:05,520 --> 00:19:07,920

And then they put it all back in the car and they drive away.

169

00:19:07,920 --> 00:19:13,000

You figure they're going to come up to the door and offer to sell you a picture of your beautiful house.

170

00:19:13,000 --> 00:19:16,280

But they don't do that. They just get in the car and drive off.

171

00:19:16,280 --> 00:19:24,440

And I in the course of my investigations, I learned to ask people about not just about what they had seen,

172

00:19:24,440 --> 00:19:31,480

but about any strange thing that had happened to them around the time of their sighting that week or even that month.

173

00:19:31,480 --> 00:19:36,600

And a lot of people would come up with some very strange things, very strange visitors.

174

00:19:36,600 --> 00:19:44,200

And we still get reports of these strange visitors about 10 years ago in New York City.

175

00:19:44,200 --> 00:19:52,120

There was a lady in black that used to hang around the the pickup bars around Second Avenue.

176

00:19:52,120 --> 00:19:55,120

And this this woman became a legend in New York. I don't know.

177

00:19:55,120 --> 00:20:06,000

Some of you may have heard of her. She she was approached men and in the bar and get them all

excited.

178

00:20:06,000 --> 00:20:14,040

And then she would excuse herself and go into the ladies room and never come out again.

179

00:20:14,880 --> 00:20:18,680

There must have been a hundred of these stories during that period.

180

00:20:18,680 --> 00:20:25,640

We had supposedly a very good looking lady who dressed in a very slinky black dress.

181

00:20:25,640 --> 00:20:30,680

And God knows what game that was or what the purpose of all that was for.

182

00:20:30,680 --> 00:20:37,760

That is, I said, we've had an opportunity witnesses, a lot of witnesses have either offered them food or seen these people in restaurants.

183

00:20:37,760 --> 00:20:43,680

And we've had an opportunity to see the reading habits, which are disgusting.

184

00:20:43,720 --> 00:20:46,880

These people do not know how to eat. They don't.

185

00:20:46,880 --> 00:20:50,720

They said one of them tried to drink yellow.

186

00:20:50,720 --> 00:20:55,560

They don't know how to handle a knife and fork.

187

00:20:55,560 --> 00:21:01,840

In one incident, the waitress had to come over and show her show the man how to cut a steak.

188

00:21:01,840 --> 00:21:06,760

And then they didn't shoot their food. They just sort of swallow it, go put down.

189

00:21:06,760 --> 00:21:12,120

And they they figured they're getting away with it. But everybody in the place is watching them do it.

190

00:21:12,560 --> 00:21:18,480

Again, they always look like orientals who are not quite oriental.

191

00:21:18,480 --> 00:21:28,480

Again, the lap-lander kind of look and they're always dressed in black clothes, which most often is out of style.

192

00:21:28,480 --> 00:21:35,200

They're wearing something that would have been in style in 1946 instead of 1986.

193

00:21:35,200 --> 00:21:39,360

And so there's always some little thing that's that's out of quack for these people.

194

00:21:39,400 --> 00:21:43,640

Just as an military officer, we're sneakers, as I said.

195

00:21:43,640 --> 00:21:49,040

We have a lot of things lumped into the same category.

196

00:21:49,040 --> 00:21:51,440

There are various incidents that I was involved in over the years.

197

00:21:51,440 --> 00:21:58,880

We had a UFO investigator in Maine who was people and some of you probably know all about this.

198

00:21:58,880 --> 00:22:04,200

Get very obsessed with UFOs. It dominates their whole life.

199

00:22:05,160 --> 00:22:11,760

Especially if they become UFO investigators in a small town, it likes takes over their life.

200

00:22:11,760 --> 00:22:20,040

And then they they become very credulous and all sorts of strange things can seem to happen to them.

201

00:22:20,040 --> 00:22:28,160

We had a UFO investigator in Maine who was driving around an area where UFOs had been seen and saw a black Cadillac.

202

00:22:28,160 --> 00:22:33,680

And he had a gun with him and he got out of the car and started shooting at the black Cadillac.

203

00:22:34,560 --> 00:22:40,080

Really upset the guy who was driving the black Cadillac because it wasn't a black Cadillac at all.

204

00:22:40,080 --> 00:22:42,840

This UFO investigator was hallucinating.

205

00:22:42,840 --> 00:22:49,600

He thought he was seeing a black Cadillac and it was an ordinary car and this and being driven by an ordinary person.

He would get into his car and look in the back seat and there's an alligator in the back seat.

So he was he was hallucinating about alligators.

I he was writing me these long letters telling me about all the alligators he was saying.

He was he was afraid that Dr. Schwartz was a man in black.

Dr. Schwartz is a famous psychiatrist. But we do have a lot of I can't really call him screwballs because there's something more involved here.

It's it's where they their minds just get carried away with the whole UFO thing.

The term that I used to use was a distortion of reality.

222

So that very often the people that you're seeing may not be men in black at all.

Maybe just an ordinary guy in an ordinary suit and your mind is making him a man in black.

224

But he held a buddy in Barney Hill.

I don't know if you're up enough with the literature, but that he and Barney Hill had quite a few men in black episodes, which may have been just hallucinatory.

They would go into a restaurant and they would be followed by this man in a black suit with a mustache and he would sit down at the table next to them.

227

And while they're reading this man in black is eating soup and his mustache falls in a soup.

And it was obvious that these people were just following Betty and Barney Hill around.

The CIA has confessed to the fact that they were involved in UFO investigation between 48 and 52.

And after that, the CIA was supposedly out of it.

when we leave Lee Harvey Oswald was arrested, a large group of men in black suits went to the base in Japan,

where he had been stationed at one point and they searched the whole place.

239

This is with all the military officers standing by. And this is in the books about Lee Harvey Oswald.

240

So we do. We do have agents who are so smart that they wear black suits all the time and wrap around sunglasses.

241

And do really stupid things so that they'll stand out.

242

It would seem to me that if they wanted to be really smart, they would dress in dungarees and have long hair and carry a guitar.

243

But no, they have to dress in their uniform just as the FBI agents are always in uniform.

They all they look like clones. They're all they all have the same haircut.

245

But J Edgar Hoover was very strict. They had to they had to look like FBI agents.

Now, I had a friend in England. His name was Ted Holiday.

248

He wrote a number of very good books. He may have remembered Ted Holiday.

249

He saw a man in black, it's Loch Ness.

Now, he had been spending every summer at Loch Ness looking for the famous C-serf in there.

he realized that it was the exact spot where he had seen this man in black a year earlier.

Colin Wilson, the very famous British author, had a few comments to make on it.

Finally, the sheer weight of the evidence convinces them that something odd is going on.

And they tried to create what all this Huxley called a minimum working hypothesis,

an explanation that covers the basic facts.

267

This may be, for example, telepathy of a famous writer named Lethbridge,

268

00:28:42,840 --> 00:28:49,840

saw a ghost, a man dressed in a writing clothing in the rooms of a university friend.

269

00:28:49,840 --> 00:29:00,680

And he theorized that someone else may have been thinking about this man and that his own mind somehow picked up the image like a television picture without the sound.

270

00:29:00,680 --> 00:29:05,960

But he was forced to drop this explanation as he encountered other examples of the paranormal.

271

00:29:05,960 --> 00:29:10,000

And this tends to be the experience of the most serious investigators.

272

00:29:10,000 --> 00:29:18,400

Whenever they have formulated a watertight general theory, they stumble upon some new fact that simply refuses to fit in.

273

And then they have to extend the theory.

274

00:29:21,520 --> 00:29:26,080

Then they find still more awkward facts and they have to extend it still further.

275

00:29:26,080 --> 00:29:35,600

And at no time at all, their original, symmetrical theory looks like an old sock stuffed with rubbish.

276

00:29:35,600 --> 00:29:41,920

Years ago, when we had a lot of magazines that we don't have anymore,

277

00:29:41,920 --> 00:29:49,200

general magazines that carried a lot of articles, not only about UFOs, but about everything that was going on now.

278

00:29:49,440 --> 00:29:57,520

It's very rare that we get any real in depth investigative reporting anywhere.

279

00:29:57,520 --> 00:30:01,920

There was a magazine called Saga. They used to do a lot of this and I used to write for them.

280

00:30:01,920 --> 00:30:07,000

A lot of people wrote for them. A lot of the UFO writers wrote for Saga.

281

00:30:07,000 --> 00:30:14,280

And they once they started carrying UFO articles, they started getting all kinds of hoax letters.

282

00:30:14,280 --> 00:30:20,680

And we knew they were hoaxes because they were perfectly tight with no misspelling.

283

00:30:20,680 --> 00:30:28,400

And this was rare. You get an average letter from an average person and there's always, you know, sloppy.

284

00:30:28,400 --> 00:30:31,680

But these things were perfectly done and beautifully typed.

285

00:30:31,680 --> 00:30:36,360

Obviously, somebody had the best of IBM typewriters at that time.

286

00:30:36,360 --> 00:30:39,600

And they were these things were well thought out and carefully done.

287

00:30:39,640 --> 00:30:46,960

That's how we would know they were hoaxes. If we got a letter written in pencil and making all kinds of weird,

288

00:30:46,960 --> 00:30:50,320

exaggerated claims, we know that that maybe was authentic.

289

00:30:50,320 --> 00:30:54,440

But these hoax letters were something else.

290

00:30:54,440 --> 00:30:58,680

We got one M.I.B. account that the editor was quite excited about.

291

00:30:58,680 --> 00:31:04,160

And it was so well well written that I pointed out it had to have been written by a professional writer.

292

00:31:04,160 --> 00:31:06,960

There's no way that the average witness could have written this.

293

00:31:06,960 --> 00:31:14,080

It was beautifully done. And he followed all of the rules of writing, which most people don't even know where exists.

294

00:31:14,080 --> 00:31:30,200

And then he went into detail about this elaborate M.I.B. experience and then he followed it up with a postcard saying that he was leaving by a bus for an unknown destination so that we could never follow through and find out who he was.

295

00:31:30,200 --> 00:31:34,160

We've had around the world we've had what they call the Umo letters.

296

00:31:34,160 --> 00:31:38,960

How many of you have heard of Umo? There have been books about it.

297

00:31:38,960 --> 00:31:43,640

This has been going on for over 20 years, about 25 years now.

298

00:31:43,640 --> 00:31:50,600

These are very elaborate letters written in all languages and sent to leading researchers around the world.

299

00:31:50,600 --> 00:31:55,440

And these letters are filled with interesting philosophies.

300

00:31:55,440 --> 00:32:01,680

Whoever writes this, these things has a good knowledge of the science and philosophy.

301

00:32:01,680 --> 00:32:05,840

Some of the letters are quite impressive because they're just too many.

302

00:32:05,840 --> 00:32:12,320

And everyone has a different postmark. One man in Spain may get a letter postmarked in New Zealand.

303

00:32:12,320 --> 00:32:18,680

And the next Umo letter may turn up in Germany written in German and postmarked Canada.

304

00:32:18,680 --> 00:32:24,360

So whoever's mailing these things and mailing them from all over the world and they're writing them.

305

And that's who's ever doing it is doing it full time, which is a puzzle.

306

And as I say, there are now a couple of books.

307

I don't know if any of them have been translated into English, but books of these letters have been published in Europe.

308

And at one point the French government got involved in this and the French government became

convinced that they were in touch with another planet.

309

And I'm talking about high up in the French government, the minister of France, the leading scientists in France were all

310

involved and then it turned into a great embarrassment because then hoaxes were pulled on them.

311

And it was one of the sensational things of the 1970s.

312

The result was that the French government gave up on new phones and they decided instead to fund the private investigators,

313

the civilian investigators, and they gave them enough money to go out and investigate things, which is remarkable in any country.

And these French investigators all became anti UFO.

315

Now that they had the funding and they were able to travel around, they reopened old cases like the famous.

316

You may know that in 1952 there were a lot of UFO landings in France all over France.

317

They reopened a lot of these cases and they decided that they were all hoaxes.

318

And it was a very strange turnabout and it all started with the Umo letters to the top officials of France.

Now it is quite possible.

It's even probable that people high up in the American government have also been sucked into these

kinds of games and given up at some point.

Ten more minutes. Maybe I should take some questions.

I chased them. I missed them by ten minutes.

I was when I was in West Virginia and Ohio, people would call me up in my hotel and they say, Hey, these guys are here and come and come and get them.

326

And so I raced there and they they'd be gone by ten minutes.

327

And we had the local police in a lot of towns looking for them.

328

We had a one time I had hopes that we would catch one of these cars and solve a part of that mystery.

329

Somebody asked me about morey Island. That was considered the first men in black case.

330

And it turned out that's a very involved thing because I spent a lot of time on that morey Island case.

This is where a group of men were on a boat and to coma harbor and they saw a couple of objects fly over the boat.

This is in nineteen forty seven and early the next morning a black car pulled up in front of the home of one of the witnesses and a man got out and invited the witness to the breakfast.

This was before he told anybody. So this became one of our first men in black cases.

The Hanford works is very close to that where we make an bomb.

And the the original story where these these objects were flying over to coma harbor.

This story has a certain flaws to it. That namely that the one of the men who made the most noise about it proved to be a tremendous liar.

343

It's a very involved and complex case. I have enough material to do a book on it and nobody wanted to do the book.

It's not as 1947. Forget about it. Yeah.

345

But it was not one of our true men in black.

346

00:36:41,760 --> 00:36:50,360

Well, now the only the only photograph is Tim Beckley and his friends took a photograph some years ago in New Jersey.

347

00:36:50,360 --> 00:36:55,960

There was a black cat like a parked across from the home of a UFO investigator.

348

00:36:55,960 --> 00:37:00,480

And this man would get out of the black cat. I can stand around and look at the house.

349

00:37:00,480 --> 00:37:05,760

And so Jim Mosley and Tim Beckley and some others maybe they'll tell you about it later.

350

00:37:05,760 --> 00:37:09,840

They went out there with cameras and they went chasing after this cat.

351

00:37:09,840 --> 00:37:16,760

I might be as it was somebody chauffeur. Well, there are there are a couple of cases where they seem to be machine like.

352

00:37:16,800 --> 00:37:20,400

Like they run down like a clock.

353

00:37:20,400 --> 00:37:32,560

They'll talk for a witness for half an hour and they just run down and then they'll then they'll leave the house and say the witness lives way out in the country somewhere.

354

And they leave the house and they disappear and the witness looks out the window and there's no car out there.

355

00:37:37,200 --> 00:37:39,720

Nothing for them. No transportation for them.

356

00:37:39,720 --> 00:37:46,720

Another thing that happens in more than one case is it can be raining and miserable and these people will arrive at the

357

00:37:46,720 --> 00:37:51,560

door and they're dry and their feet aren't muddy or anything.

358

00:37:51,560 --> 00:37:55,120

Not we've had a lot of cases where they threaten people.

359

00:37:55,120 --> 00:37:59,280

But there are cases where they have bragged about killing people.

360

00:37:59,280 --> 00:38:04,400

There was a famous case where they bragged about killing a Barney Hill.

361

00:38:04,400 --> 00:38:09,800

Right to a doctor about that. But we don't have any direct evidence that that's happened.

362

00:38:09,800 --> 00:38:12,800

But there have been a lot of mysterious deaths in the UFO field.

363

00:38:12,840 --> 00:38:19,880

And from now on you can watch for this. A lot of the leading UFO investigators have died on June 24.

364

00:38:19,880 --> 00:38:22,720

In fact, even Jackie Gleason was a big UFO.

365

00:38:22,720 --> 00:38:26,200

He built a house up and get the Catskills that look like a UFO.

366

00:38:26,200 --> 00:38:30,840

When you drove by it, you swear a UFO and landed it with Jackie Gleason's home.

367

00:38:30,840 --> 00:38:34,120

But he died on June 24 two years ago.

368

00:38:34,120 --> 00:38:41,520

But there are many others who died. Frank Edwards, who's you all read his books probably Frank Edwards died on June 23.

369

00:38:41,560 --> 00:38:49,600

Of course, June 24 is the date that Kenneth Arnold saw the sight of the sightings in 1947.

370
