Currently, he is a board member of the Ivan T. Sanderson Foundation.

bestseller as you know.

They have also published books by Major Donald Keyhub.

Dr. Keyhub's articles, which he has written in the last year or so on the subject of UFOs,

have appeared in True Magazine, in Saga Magazine and in the Flying Saucer Review in London,

which is one of the finest UFO magazines in the world, if not the finest.

It has also appeared in Saucer News and various other publications in the Flying Saucer field.

And it gives me, personally, a great deal of pride and satisfaction to bring him now to

Mr. John Keyhub.

Jim forgot one question earlier.

He should have asked how many of you are from the FBI, because I have had a full text of

This text, as you know, has been censored and butchered for many years.

It was believed that such organizations should be watched because of their potentially great

influence on mass thinking, if widespread sightings should occur.

The apparent irresponsibility and possible use of such groups for subversive purposes

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00:03:42,120 --> 00:03:44,560

should be kept in mind.

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00:03:44,560 --> 00:03:51,440

Now what this means when it comes from someone like the CIA and ends up in a report which

turns up on the desks of many high officials, it means that it really gives the FBI and

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00:03:57,520 --> 00:04:01,760

the CIA carte blanche to investigate these groups.

As many of you know, they've done this over the years.

They've harassed UFO investigators, amateur UFO investigators, civilians, they've harassed

people who have taken photographs of these things, and they've done it all because of

this couple of sentences.

A number of things in here which are rather appalling.

There was a member of this panel named Dewey Fornay, he's not named in here but this is

the man involved, who spent several months preparing an airtight case, he thought, prove

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00:04:34,520 --> 00:04:37,520

the flying saucers came from outer space.

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00:04:37,520 --> 00:04:43,840

He prepared an extensive document on this and he presented it before this panel.

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00:04:43,840 --> 00:04:48,160

Now I haven't seen the document but I know a great deal about it and I know that he did

it very thorough, Jeff.

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00:04:49,640 --> 00:04:54,400

Now here's what they say about Dewey Fornay's report.

One of the panel members in his presentation showed how he had eliminated each of the known

and probable causes of sightings, leaving him extraterrestrial as the only one remaining

in many cases.

His background as an aeronautical engineer and technical intelligence officer could not

be slighted.

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00:05:11,640 --> 00:05:17,320

However, the panel could not accept the cases cited by him because they were raw, un-evaluated

reports.

I don't know how you would define an evaluated report.

I suppose it's when they decided it's a weather balloon or swamp gas.

On the next page, on page six, we have the story of the famous Fremontan, Utah film.

They shot a movie film in back in the early 50s, 1600 frames of a formation of flying

In color yet, the intelligence command of the Air Force took this film and microscopically

analyzed it.

Here's what they say about it.

The panel received a briefing by representatives of the U.S. Navy Photo Interpretation Laboratory

on their analysis of the film.

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00:06:02,080 --> 00:06:08,360

This team had expended at Air Force Request approximately 1,000 hours of professional

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00:06:08,360 --> 00:06:13,640

and subprofessional time in the preparation of graph plots of the individual frames of

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00:06:13,640 --> 00:06:18,320

the film, showing apparent and relative motion of the objects and variation in their light

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00:06:18,320 --> 00:06:19,320

intensity.

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00:06:19,600 --> 00:06:25,040

It was the opinion of the PIL representatives that the objects cited were not birds, balloons

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00:06:25,040 --> 00:06:29,560

or aircraft, were not reflections because there was no blinking while passing through

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00:06:29,560 --> 00:06:33,680

60-degree of arc, and were therefore self-luminous.

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00:06:33,680 --> 00:06:38,360

Plots of motion and variation in light intensity of the objects were displayed.

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00:06:38,360 --> 00:06:44,080

While the panel members were impressed by the evident enthusiasm, industry, and the extent

of effort of the PIL team, they would not accept the conclusions reached.

Now here are these people who had worked a thousand hours, it says here, preparing all

kinds of graphs and charts and everything to prove their case, and the panel just threw

it out.

They do this page after page.

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00:07:01,240 --> 00:07:07,320

I get so mad when I read this that I'm just appalled that any government official reading

this kind of report could accept it.

It seems to me that any responsible general or politician on reading something like this

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00:07:17,480 --> 00:07:19,240

would demand further explanation.

And then there are all kinds of nonsense thrown in.

They happen to mention in here thousands of reports received through channels each year

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00:07:27,960 --> 00:07:31,960

and then it says in parentheses, 1900 and 1952.

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00:07:31,960 --> 00:07:35,840

Well in all of the Air Force data sheets that they put out every year, they say there were

1500, but here it says 1900, so they don't even get their statistics right.

I could talk all night about that.

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00:07:44,880 --> 00:07:50,640

As I mentioned last night on Long John Show, I've been going over with a fine tooth comb,

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00:07:50,640 --> 00:07:56,080

I've been going over all the reports of 1966, and I've been dealing primarily with what

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00:07:56,080 --> 00:07:58,080

we call the Type 1 reports.

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00:07:58,080 --> 00:08:01,160

Of course there are all kinds of reports.

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00:08:01,200 --> 00:08:07,200

The Type 1 report is either a landing or a very low level sighting in which the witness

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00:08:07,200 --> 00:08:13,360

is considered to be a very good witness, a police officer or a person of responsibility

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00:08:13,360 --> 00:08:18,360

in his community, and it's not a drunk or a hoaxer.

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00:08:18,360 --> 00:08:25,360

And I selected 730 of these Type 1 reports and ran an analysis on them.

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00:08:26,360 --> 00:08:32,080

And as I told Long John last night, we broke some of it down statistically, we're still

113

doing it.

00:08:33,080 --> 00:08:37,400

We found that 20% of all the sightings occurred on a Wednesday.

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00:08:37,400 --> 00:08:40,920

We had the most sightings on a Wednesday, and if you want to really see a flying saucer,

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00:08:40,920 --> 00:08:45,160

your best chance to see one is at 10 o'clock on Wednesday night.

Now I don't know why that is.

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00:08:49,600 --> 00:08:53,560

It seems to me that if we were dealing with a psychological phenomenon, this would be

spread out evenly across the week.

It seems that there would be more people out on a Saturday night, and therefore your chances

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00:09:00,000 --> 00:09:02,000

of seeing these things would be much greater.

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00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:04,040

That is, we'd get more reports on a Saturday night.

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00:09:04,040 --> 00:09:05,540

But that isn't true.

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00:09:05,540 --> 00:09:08,840

Wednesday night, when everyone should be home watching television, they're out seeing

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00:09:08,840 --> 00:09:09,840

flying saucers.

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00:09:09,840 --> 00:09:16,040

Now here's a, I'll give you an example of what we call flaps.

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00:09:16,040 --> 00:09:21,120

Now these things are sighted all across the country on these flap dates.

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00:09:21,120 --> 00:09:25,840

You go for two or three days with no sightings at all, or just one or two random sightings.

Now, for example, on Wednesday, March 30th and 31st, there were 160 sightings in every

state in the country.

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00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:39,560

There was a very near landing out on Long Island that night.

Before I forget it, there was a landing last week in Long Island out near East Hampton.

It hasn't been reported to the press.

I got a call tonight.

The police out there, instead of calling the Air Force now, they call me.

Because I go out there, and I've been cooperating with them, and I've set this up around the

country.

And I get calls from all over the country now, from people who are caught up for the Air

Force, and they don't know who to turn to, so they turn to that nut with a beard that

passed through last month.

And I get some very weird stories from mayors and police officers.

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00:10:15,840 --> 00:10:19,440

And that's why I'm going back to West Virginia, because the Civil Defense Director down there

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00:10:19,440 --> 00:10:22,520

has been very upset about some things that have been happening.

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00:10:22,520 --> 00:10:26,320

I'm going back down and play hero and sell the whole thing.

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00:10:26,320 --> 00:10:29,920

Probably I'll be taking a board of lines saucer and flown to Venus.

And when I get back, nobody will believe me, and that'll be the end of my career.

I mentioned that on August 16th, we had a flap on a Tuesday, which was the only real

The rest of the year, Tuesday, gave us only 7% of our sightings.

But on August 16th, there was a flap in five states, including New Jersey.

We had sightings in New Jersey that night, people seeing these things coming down over

power lines.

Out in Michigan and in Minnesota, there were sightings from one end of the state to the

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00:11:06,720 --> 00:11:07,720

other.

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00:11:07,720 --> 00:11:11,920

There was a landing at the Flying Cloud Airport outside of Minneapolis.

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00:11:11,960 --> 00:11:16,880

And pilots and police officers at the airport saw this thing come down on the runway, and

157

00:11:16,880 --> 00:11:21,120

they all started pouring on foot, and the thing took off again.

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00:11:21,120 --> 00:11:27,240

In Arkansas, the flap was so great over the major cities in Arkansas that the local news

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00:11:27,240 --> 00:11:31,880

commentators took their microphones out into the street and did a live broadcast.

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00:11:31,880 --> 00:11:32,880

But that's nothing.

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00:11:32,880 --> 00:11:37,840

In 65, during a flap in Mexico, they flew television cameras out into the street in

Mexico City and did a live broadcast.

Here in New York City, we don't really hear much about flying saucers or see much of them.

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00:11:47,040 --> 00:11:50,560

You find that throughout the country, people believe in them because they see them all

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00:11:50,560 --> 00:11:51,560

the time.

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00:11:51,560 --> 00:11:57,840

There are some areas where now they're so commonplace, people don't report them anymore.

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00:11:57,840 --> 00:12:00,640

That area in West Virginia, for example.

On Wednesday, November 2nd, a man named Woodrow Durmberg, who claimed that he came upon a flying

saucer on a highway and that a plane got out and spoke to him.

And you may have seen it was in the Look Magazine issue on flying saucers.

And I'm going to be spending some time with Mr. Garrenberger, I think, when I go down

there.

Four days later, in about 30 miles away, an elderly man, a 70-year-old man in a very

small town called Fullers Falls, was out taking a walk.

And he saw a large object on a tripod arrangement and it scared the living daylights out of

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00:12:39,800 --> 00:12:40,800

him.

And he turned around and started to leave the scene.

And he claims that he heard a voice saying, don't run, don't run.

He said he didn't run, but he walked pretty fast.

We have now, we have several thousand cases of people seeing the creatures that get out

181

of these things or seeing people around these things.

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00:13:04,560 --> 00:13:09,040

A lot of people think in terms of contactees, people who talk to the flying saucer beings

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00:13:09,040 --> 00:13:11,840

and get a message for the good of mankind.

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00:13:11,840 --> 00:13:16,600

But we have many people who just simply report that they've seen the creatures, that the

creatures jumped into the craft and flew off and that's all.

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00:13:20,240 --> 00:13:22,840

And we call them contactors.

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00:13:22,840 --> 00:13:24,040

And they're all over the country.

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00:13:24,040 --> 00:13:26,080

Everywhere I go, people tell me these stories.

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00:13:26,080 --> 00:13:30,840

When I was traveling through Virginia and West Virginia and Ohio, I would be sitting

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00:13:30,840 --> 00:13:32,320

in a restaurant having coffee.

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00:13:32,320 --> 00:13:37,720

And I'm rather conspicuous and in a small town, everyone knows a stranger anyway.

192

00:13:37,720 --> 00:13:40,480

And farmers and people would come up to me very shyly.

193

00:13:40,480 --> 00:13:45,400

And they would ask me if I was the color, I was searching for flying saucers.

194

00:13:45,400 --> 00:13:49,560

And then they sit down and they say, something happened to me last week or last month.

195

00:13:49,560 --> 00:13:52,040

I'm afraid to tell anybody about it.

196

00:13:52,040 --> 00:13:55,200

But maybe you know something about this and you can help us.

197

00:13:55,200 --> 00:13:59,320

And then they tell me the wildest damn stories, wilder than anything in the literature.

198

00:13:59,320 --> 00:14:01,200

For example, cattle stealing.

199

00:14:01,200 --> 00:14:05,600

I've heard these stories in every state that the farmers see these things come down in

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00:14:05,600 --> 00:14:08,120

their fields and take away a color to.

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00:14:08,120 --> 00:14:14,980

And you're all familiar probably with the classic story of 1896 where a farmer named

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00:14:14,980 --> 00:14:19,520

Alexander Hamilton signed an affidavit that this happened to him.

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00:14:19,520 --> 00:14:23,760

Since then we've had such cases in France and in California.

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00:14:23,760 --> 00:14:26,440

And now we're having it apparently an epidemic of it.

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00:14:26,440 --> 00:14:30,320

But most of these people are not not coming forward with these stories because they don't

know who to tell.

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00:14:31,320 --> 00:14:35,880

And when I'm in the area, they usually tell me or some of them do anyway.

208

00:14:35,880 --> 00:14:40,280

But this is part of a real part of the problem is that the American public isn't telling

209

the Air Force the truth about flying saucers.

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00:14:43,800 --> 00:14:48,040

And this is something that I've been I've been feeding the Air Force some of the information

211

00:14:48,040 --> 00:14:53,320

I collect so that later when they can't say we didn't know about that because then I can

212

00:14:53,360 --> 00:14:57,480

whip out my file and say well I sent it to you on such and such a date.

213

00:14:57,480 --> 00:15:01,600

I've been in communities where the people were afraid to go out at night because so

214

00:15:01,600 --> 00:15:03,920

many strange things were happening.

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00:15:03,920 --> 00:15:09,000

I've met and talked with many people who are now afraid to drive alone at night.

216

00:15:09,000 --> 00:15:14,920

Men and women both because of the strange things that have been happening.

217

00:15:14,920 --> 00:15:19,080

There are quite a few alleged kidnapping attempts which I'm still investigating and building

218

00:15:19,160 --> 00:15:24,200

quite a fire line and have upset whole communities.

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00:15:24,200 --> 00:15:27,480

And the Air Force claims they don't know anything about these.

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00:15:27,480 --> 00:15:31,760

And as near as I can determine, there have been no government investigators in these

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00:15:31,760 --> 00:15:32,600

areas.

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00:15:32,600 --> 00:15:36,680

It's all happening very quietly, almost underground.

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00:15:36,680 --> 00:15:42,040

And the local police generally are rather, you know, they don't like anything to upset

224

00:15:42,040 --> 00:15:46,400

the routine and they don't take these things seriously until the roof falls on them.

225

00:15:46,520 --> 00:15:49,320

And in a few communities it has.

226

00:15:49,320 --> 00:15:58,200

Now going back to the business of the contactors, on December 3, 1966, a California highway

227

patrol officer named Byrne Morris with his wife and a few other people saw what they

228

00:16:04,400 --> 00:16:07,360

described as a flying water heater.

229

00:16:07,360 --> 00:16:12,120

It was a cylinder and it was hovering just above the ground and there was a man in it.

230

00:16:12,160 --> 00:16:18,960

Now he said that they could see the man's head and that he was wearing a silver crash helmet.

231

00:16:18,960 --> 00:16:23,720

And they watched this object for several minutes as it maneuvered over a field and then shot away.

232

00:16:23,720 --> 00:16:24,920

It was a glowing object.

233

00:16:24,920 --> 00:16:27,640

It was surrounded by the usual luminous glow.

234

00:16:27,640 --> 00:16:31,520

Now Byrne Morris has gone on record and these are some of the newspaper clippings.

235

00:16:31,520 --> 00:16:34,120

Here's his picture, drawings of the object.

236

00:16:34,120 --> 00:16:38,560

He's taken a big chance with his reputation to go on record for this story.

237

00:16:38,600 --> 00:16:43,080

And he's only one of the hundreds that are coming forward with these stories.

238

00:16:43,080 --> 00:16:48,640

Strange story. What kind of what could this thing be with a man in it, a hot water heater with a man in it?

239

00:16:48,640 --> 00:16:53,640

Yet it must have happened or this man wouldn't have gone out on the wind that he did.

240

00:16:53,640 --> 00:16:59,760

Now, last night we started off the Long John show with my discussion of the Mock man,

241

00:16:59,760 --> 00:17:02,640

which probably many of you had never heard of this case.

242

00:17:02,640 --> 00:17:08,320

Although this case was carried on the wire services, it was widely published in every state in the

243

00:17:08,320 --> 00:17:14,200

country. The New York newspapers never mentioned it to my knowledge, but it was published in newspapers

244

00:17:14,200 --> 00:17:15,960

everywhere else.

245

00:17:15,960 --> 00:17:20,720

And there have been constant sightings of this creature down there.

246

00:17:20,720 --> 00:17:26,120

And I want to point out something that I never did get a chance to say in the Long John show.

247

00:17:26,120 --> 00:17:31,920

The area where this creature is being seen is a World War Two ammunition dump,

248

00:17:31,920 --> 00:17:36,680

which is still filled with high explosives, 2,500 acres of it.

249

00:17:36,680 --> 00:17:43,160

These high explosives are kept in concrete igloos, which are camouflage so they can't be seen from the air.

250

00:17:43,160 --> 00:17:47,040

I'm going to show you a short strip of film that I took down there.

251

00:17:47,040 --> 00:17:53,280

Again, it's a very dull film because it's just the area where these sightings have taken place.

252

00:17:53,280 --> 00:17:59,680

In this film, you will see the power plant, the abandoned power plant, which was used.

253

00:17:59,680 --> 00:18:02,760

There was an arsenal there during the Second World War.

254

00:18:02,760 --> 00:18:06,600

And this power plant was used for that arsenal.

255

00:18:06,600 --> 00:18:09,920

And the first sighting of the creature took place around that power plant.

And there are another sightings since around that power plant.

257

I had some very strange experiences there on December 11th, 1966.

258

Mr. Chester Laporte and Steve Pearson, Jr. saw the Mothman in this area over one of these concrete igloos and watched fly away.

259

00:18:30,120 --> 00:18:35,280

And at that very moment, I was about half a mile away in another section looking for the damn thing.

260

00:18:35,280 --> 00:18:41,040

So that was my luck. I never saw the Mothman, but other people did while I was there.

261

00:18:41,040 --> 00:18:50,600

The Mothman has pursued automobiles on a number of occasions and has reached speeds up to 100 miles an hour, scaring the daylights out of the drivers.

262

00:18:50,600 --> 00:18:54,160

There is only one bird that can go anywhere near that fast.

263

00:18:54,200 --> 00:19:00,000

It's a certain eagle and it can reach 70 or 80 miles in a steep dive straight down.

264

00:19:00,000 --> 00:19:03,360

It's diving at some prey on the ground.

265

00:19:03,360 --> 00:19:05,720

We don't know of any bird that could do this.

266

00:19:05,720 --> 00:19:11,200

And if this thing is a bird, it's the weirdest bird we've pushed out.

267

00:19:11,200 --> 00:19:20,920

When Mothman first appeared, a number of distinguished scientists hundreds of miles away decided that it was the Sandhill Crane.

268

00:19:20,960 --> 00:19:24,160

So I got some pictures of a Sandhill Crane, which is a large bird.

269

00:19:24,160 --> 00:19:26,840

It stands about this high, has very long neck.

270

00:19:26,840 --> 00:19:31,160

I took this picture around to all the witnesses of Mothman and showed it to them.

271

00:19:31,160 --> 00:19:35,160

And they said it wasn't a bird. It wasn't the Sandhill Crane.

272

00:19:35,160 --> 00:19:39,280

And then in January, somebody shot a large owl down there.

273

00:19:39,280 --> 00:19:42,960

And so they decided we've solved the mystery. We believe it's an owl.

274

00:19:42,960 --> 00:19:46,640

And the owl, of course, stood about this high. It was a pretty big owl.

275

00:19:46,680 --> 00:19:53,240

But again, the witnesses went around and looked at the owl and said, no, that's not the Mothman.

276

00:19:53,240 --> 00:19:56,760

The Mothman is from six to seven feet tall.

277

00:19:56,760 --> 00:20:00,680

He has two large red eyes, two inches in diameter.

278

00:20:00,680 --> 00:20:03,680

And all of the witnesses say the same thing.

279

00:20:03,680 --> 00:20:05,840

He has a wingsprout of 10 feet.

280

00:20:05,840 --> 00:20:08,920

And here's another little irony.

281

00:20:08,920 --> 00:20:13,560

An object this size needs very large wings to support it.

282

00:20:13,560 --> 00:20:22,120

A human being, you or I, if we were going to make a glider that we could strap on ourselves and fly with,

283

00:20:22,120 --> 00:20:25,520

that we would need a wingspan of about 35 feet.

284

00:20:25,520 --> 00:20:28,200

Now Mothman is bigger than we are.

285

00:20:28,200 --> 00:20:32,880

And he's got a 10-foot wingspan and he flies anyway, like the bumblebee.

286

00:20:32,880 --> 00:20:41,280

Some of the witnesses down there now say that they have heard the sound of some kind of motor humming sound as the object passes over their head.

287

00:20:41,320 --> 00:20:43,920

So possibly this thing is propelled by something.

288

00:20:43,920 --> 00:20:46,680

The wings do not move when it's in flight.

289

00:20:46,680 --> 00:20:51,240

When this creature is standing on the ground, his wings are folded back.

290

00:20:51,240 --> 00:20:54,440

And then when he takes off, the wings spread.

291

00:20:54,440 --> 00:20:57,360

As I said last night, no one has seen any arms on this thing.

292

00:20:57,360 --> 00:21:00,160

The wings spread. The thing takes off straight up.

293

00:21:00,160 --> 00:21:03,440

Now most large birds need a running start.

294

00:21:03,440 --> 00:21:09,640

If you've ever watched any kind of large bird, whether it's a seagull or even very often pigeons,

295

00:21:09,640 --> 00:21:11,960

they take a few steps before they take off.

296

00:21:11,960 --> 00:21:15,640

They have to sort of build up speed, ground speed.

297

00:21:15,640 --> 00:21:16,760

And this thing doesn't do that.

298

00:21:16,760 --> 00:21:23,440

It just goes straight up in the air and then goes straight across and pursues whatever it's pursuing.

299

00:21:23,440 --> 00:21:30,200

People or automobile are flying to its flying saucer to go away.

300

00:21:30,200 --> 00:21:31,040

What?

301

00:21:31,040 --> 00:21:32,320

I'm glad you're here today.

302

00:21:32,320 --> 00:21:33,000

Yes?

303

00:21:33,000 --> 00:21:35,480

Daddy, today you go from an island.

304

00:21:35,480 --> 00:21:37,200

Well, uh...

305

00:21:37,200 --> 00:21:45,680

I don't know if an angel...

306

00:21:45,680 --> 00:21:47,600

I don't know if an angel would be that ugly.

307

00:21:47,600 --> 00:21:53,480

Well, we've got a pretty ugly angel down there.

308

00:21:53,480 --> 00:21:58,800

Well, mothman is a term that the newspapers have tagged down to this thing.

309

00:21:58,800 --> 00:22:02,320

This is a newspaper term.

310

00:22:02,320 --> 00:22:10,560

Anyway, I want to show you this this movie of the the arsenal area and the power plant.

311

00:22:10,560 --> 00:22:16,720

You'll also see two of the young men who have seen this creature and they just sort of point out where they saw.

312

00:22:16,720 --> 00:22:19,000

But otherwise it's not a very dramatic film.

313

00:22:19,000 --> 00:22:26,440

And at the very end of the film, you'll see one of these concrete igloos, which has grass growing over it and it's rather camouflaged.

314

00:22:26,440 --> 00:22:33,400

This is the one particular igloo that Mr. Laporte and Pearson saw the creature flying over.

315

00:22:33,400 --> 00:22:39,520

Now we have over a hundred reports of mothman and more coming in every week.

316

00:22:39,520 --> 00:22:43,000

So there's not really much reason to doubt that he exists.

317

00:22:43,000 --> 00:22:46,360

He sounds unlikely, but there is something like this down there.

318

00:22:46,360 --> 00:22:50,200

And I'm sure anxious to find out what it is.

319

00:22:50,200 --> 00:22:52,760

It's Point Pleasant, West Virginia.

320

00:22:52,760 --> 00:22:59,040

It's about 50 miles from where Woodrow Dernberger had his contact.

321

00:22:59,040 --> 00:23:00,760

I said it's 2,500 acres.

322

00:23:00,760 --> 00:23:03,840

There are hundreds of these igloos there.

323

00:23:03,840 --> 00:23:07,440

There are four families living within this area.

324

00:23:07,440 --> 00:23:09,720

So it's very thinly populated.

325

00:23:09,720 --> 00:23:14,600

If mothman wanted to live there, not very many people would bother him.

326

00:23:14,600 --> 00:23:20,240

I also discovered that during the Second World War, when they were building this ammunition dump,

327

00:23:20,240 --> 00:23:29,240

they built a whole network of tunnels in which to transport the high explosives from the arsenal to the various igloos.

328

00:23:29,240 --> 00:23:34,240

No one in the whole region knew the location of these tunnels.

329

00:23:34,240 --> 00:23:36,560

There were no maps available.

330

00:23:36,560 --> 00:23:42,560

There were some entrances to some of these tunnels, but when I went into them, I found them full of water.

331

00:23:42,560 --> 00:23:47,200

But it's very possible that there is a network of tunnels down there that was not full of water.

332

00:23:47,200 --> 00:23:50,720

And I wanted to explore them more fully.

333

00:23:50,720 --> 00:24:02,160

But the few openings that I found I couldn't get anywhere, perhaps just as well as I couldn't because I hate to be crawling through a tunnel and meet something seven feet tall.

334

00:24:02,160 --> 00:24:07,680

I'm going back down there, as I said, and look around some more.

335

00:24:07,680 --> 00:24:09,720

And I had some more leads now.

336

00:24:09,720 --> 00:24:14,480

The as I thought of a pattern is building up now.

337

00:24:14,480 --> 00:24:25,600

And we may be able to get to the bottom of this one particular case and find out whether what Mottman is mechanical or an angel or what he is.

338

00:24:25,600 --> 00:24:30,880

Here's a fan letter that I got from France, Nice France.

339

00:24:30,880 --> 00:24:37,640

It says, Dear sir, I say the UFO knots are ignorant, silly and have no brains, plain fools.

340

00:24:37,640 --> 00:24:46,000

They have worked a long time probably to put together a machine that brings them from outer space or inner space in search of new worlds with life on them.

341

00:24:46,000 --> 00:24:50,680

And when they find one hours, they won't stick around to see the life on it.

342

00:24:50,680 --> 00:24:58,920

Talk with its people, examine our machines, vegetation, or try to find out whether we reproduce bisexual integration or binary fission.

343

00:24:59,760 --> 00:25:05,160

Doesn't sound like much fun.

344

00:25:05,160 --> 00:25:12,400

That letter didn't come from the most literate thought in the world, but there's a bit of truth in what he says.

345

00:25:12,400 --> 00:25:18,200

Now we've had a chance to analyze over two thousand of these creatures sightings.

346

00:25:18,200 --> 00:25:27,360

And we find that the majority of the creatures sighted around grounded UFOs have behaved in a stupid and animal like manner.

347

00:25:27,360 --> 00:25:36,400

They have sometimes shown hostility and attacked human beings viciously and crudely in an animal like manner, flying and things like that.

348

00:25:36,400 --> 00:25:52,880

Now out of two thousand contactee and contactor cases, only about 100 of the alleged witnesses or five percent of the total have claimed that the beings that they encountered displayed superior or even normal intelligence.

349

00:25:52,880 --> 00:26:00,760

In the other 1900 cases, the witnesses claimed that the creatures behaved in a clumsy, stupid manner, had glassy eyes.

350

00:26:00,760 --> 00:26:06,200

And if they spoke, they had faltering and rambling and confused speech.

351

00:26:06,200 --> 00:26:09,640

In short, they're pretty stupid.

352

00:26:09,640 --> 00:26:21,480

Now, a very famous researcher named Amy Michelle, a French ufologist, recently wrote an article about the problem of contact.

353

00:26:21,480 --> 00:26:32,720

And he said this, quote, perhaps the beings who are really responsible for the UFO phenomenon are never there and nobody has seen them ever.

354

00:26:32,720 --> 00:26:34,840

All that we see are robots.

355

00:26:34,840 --> 00:26:42,080

These robots are made for a certain task just as we have produced milk cows, watch dogs, race horses and so on.

356

00:26:42,080 --> 00:26:47,000

The task for which they are destined would not comprise contact with us.

357

00:26:47,000 --> 00:26:54,040

As you know, in the majority of cases, the witnesses stumble on the creatures accidentally and the creatures quickly flee.

358

00:26:54,040 --> 00:26:57,280

They jump into their machines and take off.

359

00:26:57,280 --> 00:27:00,920

There seems to be a great deal of validity for this segment.

360

00:27:00,920 --> 00:27:07,600

We all like to believe that there's a superior intelligence behind these things, but so far they haven't shown much intelligence at all.

361

00:27:07,600 --> 00:27:12,880

Certainly in their pursuit of automobiles, that's remarkably stupid and goes on all the time.

362

00:27:12,920 --> 00:27:23,120

A few weeks ago, we had two women out in Long Island were scared to death when a flying saucer came in from the Atlantic and chased their automobile for about 10 miles.

363

00:27:23,120 --> 00:27:27,000

These automobile chases go on all the time.

364

00:27:27,000 --> 00:27:36,280

We haven't yet reached the point of my statistical survey where I've been able to sum up how many of them there were in 1966, but there were a lot of them.

365

00:27:36,320 --> 00:27:48,840

And usually when they chase an automobile, when the automobile reaches an area where there are bright lights, brightly lighted street or street signs or what have you, the object will then leave.

366

00:27:48,840 --> 00:27:51,640

It won't continue to follow them into a lighted area.

367

00:27:51,640 --> 00:27:58,920

Or if the thing has been chasing them along lonely roads, as soon as the traffic picks up, the actual leave them along.

368

00:27:58,920 --> 00:28:10,320

We could speculate that perhaps the objects were trying actually to catch these automobiles and to catch the people in them because we now have quite a few cases where this is apparently happened.

369

00:28:10,320 --> 00:28:13,720

You're all familiar with the Barney Hill case, Barney and Betty Hill.

370

00:28:13,720 --> 00:28:17,600

You're probably not aware that there are several other cases identical to it.

371

00:28:17,600 --> 00:28:21,360

I think I discussed them very briefly in Long Island last night.

372

00:28:21,360 --> 00:28:27,480

It's very late and I only had a chance to cover about 10 percent of what I was going to discuss tonight.
