And if I'm correct, I think that the beginning of the famous Darrow story or the Shaver mystery

13

is actually this was started by Ray Palmer, isn't that true?

Yes, it was started while Ray Palmer was the editor of Amazing Stories.

15

Ray Palmer was the editor of Amazing Stories for 12 years and during this time Palmer did

16

run the series which were written by Richard S. Shavill, which Palmer admitted he painted

17

00:01:51,160 --> 00:01:56,560

in order to make it more interesting for the readers of Amazing Stories.

18

Now that original story which really created the whole Shaver mystery, so to speak, was

19

00:02:05,080 --> 00:02:11,800

a story called I Remember Lemuria, which was written in 1945.

20

00:02:11,800 --> 00:02:18,840

And right after that story hit the stands and people began to read the magazine, it began

21

00:02:18,840 --> 00:02:28,120

to get circulated around and the next month 50,000 letters were received by W.B. Ziff,

22

00:02:28,120 --> 00:02:30,400

who was the publisher at the time.

23

00:02:30,400 --> 00:02:33,560

And that was after the first printing of the story, John.

24

Now actually Shaver wrote these thought records as he called them later on and I'll explain

just how that came about.

Well I'm trying to figure out how can you write a thought record?

Well Shaver claimed that he was receiving messages.

No actually-

So I thought when you said a record I was thinking in terms of a disc on a turntable.

Yes, well it may be something like that John.

Actually we don't know just what these mechanisms in the caverns look like.

Shaver claimed that actually the history of these race of beings who resided on the earth

20,000 years ago was on a thought record and being transmitted there by a mechanism in

And when I say that I have to go into detail there-

Well was Shaver in the cavern?

Is this where he saw this equipment?

A little later on he claims to have had some type of-

outer source so to speak because from what I can gather from Ray himself Ray Palmer is

62

that Palmer claims that Shaver used to send these manuscripts into him and he would have

63

to edit them and these manuscripts were written on the backs of envelopes scrap paper.

64

In other words they weren't they weren't in proper form for submission to any publication.

65

What was their reason for this was Mr. Shaver a poor man and couldn't afford to have a.

I don't think so John I think that he was just a little odd we may say in his way of writing

67

he probably wrote what he received these so-called messages he would find an envelope in his

68

pocket and more or less the way it appeared anyway.

I'd anything let's put it this way that's the way Shaver made it appear anyway and I

70

don't know whether he did it because he didn't have paper he couldn't afford it but that

71

is the way Palmer claims he used to receive these manuscripts.

72

Now Shaver sent these manuscripts in a condensed form and he sent them into amazing stories

73

as true.

Now amazing story I mean the refer from did amazing stories up to that time ever print

75

a nonfiction story.

No well strangely enough John before I remember when you were here was published in Amazing

77

Stories Shaver I believe did submit a small sort of a two page deal which dealt with an

78

alphabet which he claimed to have received or had possession of Shaver Shaver received

79

00:06:55,920 --> 00:07:01,360

this alphabet and that was printed in 1943 from what I can get which was before the story

80

00:07:01,360 --> 00:07:08,720

I remember the mural and according to Palmer after this story I remember the mural was

81

00:07:08,720 --> 00:07:11,200

published these fifty thousand letters.

82

Well I mean it's very difficult to believe of course but Palmer claims that almost all

83

00:07:17,040 --> 00:07:20,720

these fifty thousand letters were more or less what we make term positive letters.

84

Let me ask you this Domini I understand that the circulation for that particular month

85

was only fifty thousand is that true or was it an additional fifty thousand.

Well I know the circulation went up to one hundred and eighty five thousand copies per month

87

and it needed the publication about half a million dollars.

So well I mean that's that's neither here nor there about the amount of money I was

89

interested in the circulation you say that the circulation was about a hundred and eighty

Well then there is a possibility that they could receive fifty thousand letters let's

92

just say that the circulation was actually a hundred and fifty thousand for round figures

and that would be a third of the readers that sent in a letter of course that would be a

94

00:08:17,760 --> 00:08:25,440

tremendous amount. I mean that's very unusual but let's face it if we're going to accept that

95

circulation figure and I have no reason to doubt the word of just Davis as a publishing

96

outfit and if they had that amount of circulation well they could have received well I find

97

I want to take your statement John it wasn't that Davis that made this claim it was Palmer himself

98

that made this claim. Well now let me let me ask you this Domini are you familiar with ABC

99

audit Bureau of Circulation that's an unbiased organization that determines the circulation

100

of any publication that is a member of their organization. Now you can't pay them off in

101

other words no money would ever in other words you couldn't even offer them enough money at any time

102

that maybe they would try to give you a break and add a little additional circulation to their report.

Now as if Davis I'm very sure I don't know about that in those days but if Davis I'm very sure

104

is a member of the audit Bureau of Circulation so any circulation figure that would be given out by

the Ziff Davis publishers or any member of audit Bureau of Circulation would be an accurate

circulation figure. Now if this figure was given out that figure of a hundred and eighty five

107

thousand by the Ziff Davis publishers then you and I can bet our bottom dollar that that was

the legitimate paid circulation there is no exaggeration there's no cream that's been put on

top or anything to puff it up. That's a fantastic circulation for a magazine of that type at the

time. I wouldn't be in a position to judge. I don't know what would be considered good circulation

for a science fiction publication. I might just say this to you that I understand that life

112

has a circulation of I think something like six or seven million. I know that fake magazine has a

circulation of sixty five thousand and certainly that's that's a magazine that well it's directed to

114

a very very limited group of readers so it's quite possible that they had that. I mean I think we should

115

at least be fair to Palmer and to Ziff Davis and to Mr. Shaver and say that this is quite

116

possible and if they if they had a hundred and eighty five thousand readers that month

117

or if they had a hundred eighty five thousand paid circulation then there is a possibility as

118

remote as it may seem that they could receive fifty thousand letters. Yeah well from what I

119

hear Geron is that there was a paper shortage at the time and as the circulation began to increase

120

and began to get at these large figures they began taking paper from their other magazines

121

in order to keep up the quantity of amazing stories. In other words they had I think a detective

122

publication at the time and they would borrow paper so they would publish less of one publication
and

123

put out more copies of amazing stories. Yeah that's what I heard Geron. I can believe it.

124

Did you hear this from Palmer or is this known in the trade. This is sort of known in the trade. I

125

mean it's sort of a trade rumor so to speak and I myself know that at the time I was very

126

interested extremely interested in Shaver and in Palmer of course because I did like amazing

127

00:12:16,720 --> 00:12:22,560

stories. I like to read them as science fiction and I found that they became extremely fascinating

128

as as propounding the Shaver mystery and sort of putting it over as truth and by myself used to

129

00:12:30,960 --> 00:12:38,240

have trouble sometimes finding a newsstand which had the magazine about four or five days after it

130

hit. It seemed like it was doing the water during the time when the Shaver mystery was

131

running more or less every month. But was that during the war. Yes that was during the war.

132

It was just near the end of the water and actually it really started 1945 when he hit with that one

133

terrific story that I remember in the area and that seemed to have keyed everybody off. But

134

people began writing in and saying it's true. This thing happened to me and this happened to my

135

neighbor and Shaver is telling the truth and they began backing him up one right up to the

136

hill one hundred percent. Well an interesting thought at least I think it's rather interesting to

137

think about for a moment. I was always under the impression that the majority of people who

138

purchased or did purchase at that time amazing stories that these were science fiction fans.

139

Now do you think that science fiction fans would be the type who would write in letters and say I

140

believe this. This happened to me and all because they're so accustomed to these wild fantastic

tales that they've been reading the magazine for any length of time. Well John I don't really know

142

because I noticed that the epithet story come out whether we've got around or whether it was the

143

cover or whether whatever it was. But I noticed many of my friends who weren't interested in

144

science fiction began buying amazing stories and in all probability some of the science fiction

145

fans and I can't say percentage wise up to what degree but I'd say some of the science fiction

146

fans did buy the Shaver story besides buying amazing stories. Wasn't it also true down that they

147

there were Shaver clubs at that time and many people would tell others. There were Shaver mystery

148

clubs started and they were more or less we could liken them to the saucer clubs of today.

149

And the strangest thing is actually is that Shaver in his original stories explained what people

150

called the saucer mystery today. Actually Shaver had it long before the so-called saucer mystery

151

ever came into the headlines. Well he was the one that puts in pretty good saucer stories out.

152

Who shaved. Shave it. Well they weren't exactly saucer story. He didn't call him saucer so

153

no he had a different name for them and he was using a lot of if you put notice in his writings

154

but I don't know whether it was Shaver's touch or whether it was promise touch which gave it that

155

sort of ancient Hindu mythological angle sort of and they were terrific stories they were

156

or I wouldn't say they were the best in science fiction by no means but it was the

157

the footnotes to the stories which made them interesting in other words Palmer would that

158

probably expand one paragraph of Shavers into two pages of script in the magazine

159

and then below this he would more or less try and reclaim what was the supposed

160

truths hidden in Palmer's rendition of Shaver's so-called thought record receptions.

I've been listening but I may have missed the point. Did you bring out that I hear this someplace

mention anything about Atlantis. Well he claimed that the continent of Atlantis and Lemuria or

Moon was it was known as did exist and was part of the ancient inhabited colonies of these Titans.

174

But one thing Shaver did say and that was that Atlantis did not necessarily sink. In other

175

words it did not go beneath the sea as we have come to more or less suppose but actually the

176

sinking was a misinterpretation what happened to it then according to Shaver. Well Shaver

177

claimed that the Atlantis or I can't recall exactly which one now was a long time ago that I read this

178

particular. I thought you were going to claim that you were there at the time. Well I don't know.

179

I might be a reincarnated Deere or Tiro. Is it Deerell or Gattle. Well I don't know. I guess you could

use sort of a freehand style on it. Well who was determined that they said. Well actually

man-tongued alphabet. De according to what man-tongued the alphabet. Oh sure. Supposedly

that alphabet as D. So in row. Row R. D. Row. D. Row. R stood for in the alphabet with a phonetic

alphabet and as Shaver claimed this alphabet each letter in the alphabet was descriptive of a

particular mental concept or sequence of mental concepts. It was sort of a basic source alphabet

186

for the human language. So what would D be. D would be disintegrate energy and it would be pronounced

D. E. And what would R all be. R would be horror and O stood for orifice or source. So D. Row would

stand for detrimental horror source and in other words detrimental row or detrimental row but

if we converted into modern English. Shaver claims that this alphabet works out in most languages

190

in. He wants to just divorce himself from all past associations. He doesn't pack a bag, he doesn't

take a toothbrush or razor blade, he doesn't even go to the bank and take all the money out. He's

got \$19.84 in his pocket, and he leaves. Sure, it's a tragic thing. It's a tragic situation for

his family. But why wouldn't it be possible to do this? And let me ask you another question. Is it

illegal to leave? Oh, I mean, providing that you don't take the car that you own notes on or

working to stop or alleviate the condition of people just disappearing. In India, you have

321

00:34:02,480 --> 00:34:06,000

people who are actually dying of starvation while they're walking while they're on their feet,

322

00:34:06,000 --> 00:34:12,800

practically. And actually, I doubt if statistics are kept to any great accuracy in India.

323

So we'll take just India alone, a country like India. Why go to India all of a sudden?

324

00:34:18,240 --> 00:34:23,840

Well, if this happens all over the country, there are 20,000 people down the link. I don't know why

325

00:34:23,840 --> 00:34:29,280

we should pick on India. We've got 120,000 people that are missing and you have implied

326

00:34:29,840 --> 00:34:36,480

that there's a possibility that maybe there's a percentage, maybe only 10 people out of 120,000

327

00:34:36,480 --> 00:34:44,000

people that are kidnapped by the D-roads. Well, first we'd have to sort of break it down into

328

00:34:44,000 --> 00:34:49,760

categories and then we have to figure from the viewpoint of percentage. How can you break anything

329

00:34:49,840 --> 00:34:53,600

down into categories when you know nothing about it? And I don't mean to be unconscientious.

330

I think that by going to a missing person's bureau or speaking to a missing person's expert,

331

we can get a statistical average of why people disappear. And by breaking down the known average,

by any normal explanation. Damnedu, most people disappear in remote areas of the United States.

334

Well, I would put it this way, I don't know. I don't know. Where to or disappear from? Do you

335

mean disappear from, say, a special area? Those small communities or people walking in the country

336

somewhere alone? I would say that a person living in a small community, if he disappears, it would

an apposition, mechanisms which can, by scientific knowledge or means by utilizing certain ways,

344

00:36:26,240 --> 00:36:31,840

create, or we may term, a state of teleport in the human body. In other words, people could

345

00:36:31,840 --> 00:36:36,640

disappear from a closed and locked room. Are you familiar with the story, I'm sure you are,

346

00:36:36,640 --> 00:36:41,280

down with the tape I have of this fellow who sent it to us, and he made the claim that while he was

347

00:36:41,280 --> 00:36:47,120

laying in bed one night, he remembered the story we told or was told a number of months ago with

348

Harlan Oason, that he was to make a large noise and start yelling, I want to see a Daro that the

349

Daros would come to him. This point I want to bring out is... Well, more than strangely enough,

beginning of a source of groups and they silenced the top group at that time. And as... Well, why

but don't state this particular fact. And then you, as my co-worker in attempting to arrive at

a solution to this problem, you would not say to me, well, Dom, you're wasting your time. You
