100

And he just felt that I had a stroke, you know.

101

And he, I had, years ago, I had an experience up there that I told him about then.

102

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:14,000

And I said, I may not have come back again if I have to drive at night.

103

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:23,000

But anyway, this was night again because my car, my car that I was, I just retired from the after-line tonight.

104

And when I would get off work before I'd jump on the plane, go down, drive in the open on a car,

105

and then go over half of, you know, the real winding, steep road,

106

115

But this, I've lost two hours.

117

It's just worried the stuff out of me.

118

I don't know, I don't know where I was or what I was doing.

119

I mean, just, you know, just when I came to and I was driving.

120

And then got my bearings back and it was weird.

121

And I don't think my daughter believes that I'm coming from around,

122

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:28,000

but I don't think she believes me either.

123

But let's go back to when you first started on the road

124

and you were starting out in spite of the object and was that in an open field?

125

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:39,000

Yes, there was no house on the corner.

126

00:09:39,000 --> 00:09:41,000

It was not.

127

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:44,000

I remember seeing an open field funny.

128

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:53,000

I never, it was, I think it was at the end of the street.

129

00:09:53,000 --> 00:09:55,000

Now there's no house right on the corner to my heart.

130

00:09:55,000 --> 00:09:58,000

I don't know, or maybe I turned the corner and,

131

00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:00,000

but I don't remember turning the corner.

132

00:10:00,000 --> 00:10:06,000

All I remember was the road is not straight going up to my son's house or where he lived.

133

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:12,000

There was a bend in the road and it looked like on my right down the road I could see,

134

00:10:12,000 --> 00:10:16,000

I can picture it, but it's hard for me to tell, you know.

135

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:22,000

But it was, it wasn't anything that landed it, it had already landed, whatever it was.

136

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:24,000

It was already there.

137

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:25,000

Already on the ground.

138

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:27,000

It was already on the ground.

139

00:10:27,000 --> 00:10:33,000

And I, maybe I'm just thinking it was in the road because that is all I remembered.

140

00:10:33,000 --> 00:10:36,000

You know, that the road was down that way.

141

00:10:36,000 --> 00:10:42,000

But I don't know, I feel kind of foolish even telling anybody this much of it,

142

00:10:42,000 --> 00:10:47,000

but it just worried me because I don't know what my two hours were still.

143

00:10:47,000 --> 00:10:48,000

Okay.

144

00:10:48,000 --> 00:10:51,000

Can you estimate the size of the object?

145

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:52,000

Oh, God.

146

00:10:52,000 --> 00:10:57,000

You know, it wasn't real huge.

147

00:10:57,000 --> 00:11:04,000

I would say it was not really high either.

148

00:11:04,000 --> 00:11:09,000

Let me think for a minute.

149

00:11:09,000 --> 00:11:17,000

I would think it would be no more than 10 to 12, maybe 12 feet high.

150

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:21,000

And I would say that it was no more than if you would measure from one side to the other,

151

00:11:21,000 --> 00:11:26,000

maybe no more than 15 because it was kind of, in the middle it was kind of flatter, you know,

152

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:29,000

it was kind of 15 to 20.

153

00:11:29,000 --> 00:11:30,000

Okay.

154

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:31,000

Maybe 15.

155

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:33,000

And that was close to the roadway?

156

00:11:33,000 --> 00:11:35,000

Yes, it was.

157

00:11:35,000 --> 00:11:38,000

I don't have my phone back in the house, I just don't have it.

158

00:11:38,000 --> 00:11:45,000

But I want to call my son and see if he'll go down and see if there was, you know, anything down there.

159

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:48,000

I just, it just worries me.

160

00:11:48,000 --> 00:11:52,000

But it may not, it may not have been at the end of that road, I don't know.

161

00:11:52,000 --> 00:12:02,000

So where it was an open field, so to speak, where I thought it was in the corner of the road.

162

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:06,000

But that was, I'm not going down there again at night.

163

00:12:06,000 --> 00:12:11,000

I mean, I might be driving at night, that's for sure, that does it.

164

00:12:11,000 --> 00:12:14,000

Okay, are you living in Charlotte?

165

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:16,000

I live out by the airport.

166

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:19,000

I just retired working for the last airline.

167

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:22,000

I just supervised a reservation for it.

168

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:24,000

And I've been retired for about three months.

169

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:30,000

But I didn't have that kind of effect on me.

170

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:33,000

Okay, we'd like to get back to you on this.

171

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:35,000

And...

172

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:39,000

I'm sure that was the craziest thing that ever happened in my life that happened to me.

173

00:12:39,000 --> 00:12:47,000

And I'm, you know, I'm an alert person, I'm not, I'm not some bingling.

174

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:50,000

You know, the dream was something like that.

175

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:55,000

It would be possible for somebody to photograph that spotting everybody.

176

00:12:55,000 --> 00:13:00,000

Sure, I don't, yeah.

177

00:13:00,000 --> 00:13:05,000

It's been really since, it's been Saturday.

178

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:10,000

If it all possible, we'd like to have somebody get some shots today.

179

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:12,000

If someone has a big camera.

180

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:15,000

Okay, you want me to find somebody to take a picture of it?

181

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:17,000

If someone in your family is possible.

182

00:13:17,000 --> 00:13:21,000

We'll see, I only have a daughter that lives here, and I don't even think she has a camera.

183

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:22,000

Oh, okay.

184

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:25,000

And I, both of my cameras are in Burbank.

185

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

That's the place where I go.

186

00:13:26,000 --> 00:13:28,000

Oh, okay.

187

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:33,000

It's, um, that one spot is about a little bit bigger than my phone,

188

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:36,000

and then it has a tiny or spot alongside of it.

189

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:37,000

Okay.

190

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:40,000

I'll see if we can get somebody in there.

191

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:43,000

We'll have them tell you about that after Thursday.

192

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:46,000

Okay, I, I, I assume there's still me there by that time,

193

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:50,000

but it, it really, when I saw it Saturday night after I took a shower,

194

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:55,000

it really looked like something had, you know, something had approached me there.

195

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:56,000

Okay.

196

00:13:56,000 --> 00:14:02,000

And if you, as you remember new things, it might be a good idea to write it down.

197

198

So, I don't forget.

199

I, I can, I can just see it, yeah.

200

I just thought it was, it was just a real puzzle for me.

201

So.

202

00:14:13,000 --> 00:14:15,000

I appreciate your thought on reporting that.

203

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:16,000

No, okay.

204

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:17,000

Is this a government office?

205

00:14:17,000 --> 00:14:18,000

I know they don't, I know.

206

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:21,000

No, it's, uh, private, private organizations.

207

00:14:21,000 --> 00:14:22,000

It's an act of reporting center.

208

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:26,000

Okay, because I, I didn't want to report to the government office

209

00:14:26,000 --> 00:14:29,000

because they usually, you know, there's nothing to it, anyway.

210

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:31,000

But I know what I know.

211

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:37,000

So, it's been reported around the world for many years now.

212

00:14:37,000 --> 00:14:40,000

Well, this is so weird because I mean, I was fully awake.

213

00:14:40,000 --> 00:14:41,000

I was dressed.

214

00:14:41,000 --> 00:14:43,000

I had my makeup on and everything.

215

Come back.

229

Do you have to report in center?

230

See, are you the person I just talked to?

231

00:15:25,000 --> 00:15:26,000

Yes, ma'am.

232

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:27,000

Oh, okay.

233

00:15:27,000 --> 00:15:28,000

I just remembered, this is the house on the phone.

234

00:15:28,000 --> 00:15:29,000

I remember something else.

235

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:30,000

Okay.

236

00:15:30,000 --> 00:15:37,000

When I came to, my right arm was throbbing so bad and there was nothing wrong with it

237

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:38,000

before I got in the car.

238

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:44,000

But it's just like my arm had been pulled out of the socket and twisted.

239

00:15:44,000 --> 00:15:45,000

And, um,

240

00:15:45,000 --> 00:15:47,000

That would be if this is too hard to me.

241

00:15:47,000 --> 00:15:49,000

Yeah, right in the car itself.

242

00:15:49,000 --> 00:15:50,000

Okay.

243

00:15:50,000 --> 00:15:54,000

And also the back of my neck, I had a dull throbbing.

244

00:15:54,000 --> 00:16:01,000

In fact, when I got back to my son's house, they called him on radio and he went to,

245

you know, I stopped at his house and on the way out.

246

253

254

You know, I started to, and I let out this yell.

255

And I started to reach up to see if my hair, you know, fixed my hair and so forth, see it.

256

And when I did that, I let out this yell and I, you know, and I just couldn't hardly do anything for,
