Got a whole bunch of these burgers. I've been watching them now for about two weeks.

Okay, what do they look like?

11

They look like a submarine with a tail on it, like an airplane,

12

or an airplane with no wings.

You know, they're looking at an airplane from the side.

14

Like an airplane, a few slush.

15

Right.

16

00:00:43,000 --> 00:00:44,000

Okay.

17

00:00:44,000 --> 00:00:49,000

It's got little green, red, yellow, and purple lights all the way around here.

18

This thing comes in from the east, these things do, from like Cody.

19

And they're real bright like a star, and when it gets closer to you, it gets dimmer.

20

Then when it lands, it goes into a big, big orange.

21

00:01:08,000 --> 00:01:11,000

Kind of like looking at the sun or something.

22

Uh-huh.

23

And then when the light goes out, it's like you turn down a kerosene lamp.

24

You ever heard of anything like that before?

25

Well, yeah.

Okay.

27

When do you actually see the fuselage type logic?

28

Is this after the light goes out or while it's on?

29

Well, it's looking at it with a naked eye.

30

00:01:38,000 --> 00:01:40,000

It's before it goes out.

31

Okay.

32

00:01:41,000 --> 00:01:45,000

Now we're looking at it with two binoculars, and then we can see the fuselage of it.

33

Other than that, just looking at it with a naked eye, you don't see nothing but a bright light.

34

Okay.

35

00:01:50,000 --> 00:01:55,000

And these objects are the operating close to you or distant?

36

Uh, well, both.

37

00:01:57,000 --> 00:01:58,000

Okay.

38

00:01:58,000 --> 00:02:03,000

I live right on the Big Horn River, and right across the river, up on Sheep Mountain, these things are landing up there.

39

Okay.

40

00:02:04,000 --> 00:02:11,000

Right on the opposite side of the Sheep Mountain, I work for Dresser Industries, MI Drilling Floods,

41

00:02:11,000 --> 00:02:15,000

and I go to work like at four in the morning, and I see them.

42

00:02:15,000 --> 00:02:23,000

Then they come off of Sheep Mountain and go over and land on Beaver Hill, which is another one of our pets.

43

And then I work out there till midnight on the other ship, two in the afternoon till midnight, and they're real active.

44

But these things, just right behind my house on the cliff over there is a big cave.

45

They're landing on top of that thing, and it's just right against me.

46

Okay.

47

And then the night, I would never tell anybody about this because everybody's, you know, I didn't want to be who rogged about it.

48

I understand.

49

So I got my brother out there, and I told him about it the night before last.

50

And we watched the ones come in on Sheep Mountain.

51

And he's called it everything in the book, the satellite, the Earth's moving and the stars are coming up, you know.

52

Then the following night, which was last night, the one came in from the east, and I said, okay, you're going to sit here and watch this.

So he sat there, him and my sister-in-law, and watched it come in and land.

And these lights, we've seen three of them come in there and sat down.

64

And after they sat down, they were putting off more light than what that midnight plant was putting

off.

Okay, now do you have any estimate of the size of these objects?

66

Oh, that'd be hard to say. Looking out into the binoculars.

67

You know, I'd say big as a car.

68

Okay.

Probably.

70

Here, would you pick up any sound from them?

71

No sound at all.

Now, when did this activity start?

73

Okay, it's been here, oh geez, six months.

74

Here in the last two weeks is when it's really gotten heavy, like more of them.

There's like a dozen up out there now.

77

Okay, now do you see just one at a time or are they coming groups?

78

They coming groups.

79

Okay.

80

00:04:47,000 --> 00:04:54,000

They look like just one bright star comes in, it looks like a whole bunch of them coming out of the bottom.

81

Okay.

82

00:04:55,000 --> 00:05:03,000

You know, the light that's coming out of the bottom of this bright star are like all kind of amber light, you know.

83

00:05:03,000 --> 00:05:06,000

They're not real bright.

84

00:05:06,000 --> 00:05:09,000

But do they come down to the ground like the others?

85

00:05:09,000 --> 00:05:10,000

Yes, sir.

86

00:05:10,000 --> 00:05:11,000

Okay.

87

00:05:11,000 --> 00:05:15,000

And they scan the ground, they can back and forth across the ground flying.

88

00:05:15,000 --> 00:05:17,000

Okay.

89

00:05:17,000 --> 00:05:25,000

Do they ever use or employ beams of light when they get down close to the ground?

90

00:05:25,000 --> 00:05:26,000

Yes, sir.

91

00:05:26,000 --> 00:05:27,000

Sure do.

92

00:05:27,000 --> 00:05:33,000

Okay, now is that like a shaft of light or a cone of light?

93

00:05:33,000 --> 00:05:37,000

More like a cone, like the northern lights.

94

00:05:37,000 --> 00:05:38,000

Okay.

95

00:05:38,000 --> 00:05:43,000

And what color?

96

00:05:43,000 --> 00:05:44,000

White.

97

00:05:44,000 --> 00:05:45,000

Okay.

98

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:51,000

Do those cones of light always extend down to the ground?

99

00:05:51,000 --> 00:05:54,000

No, sir, they're in the air after they land.

100

00:05:54,000 --> 00:05:55,000

Okay.

101

00:05:56,000 --> 00:06:02,000

Now when was the last, or the most frequent time that you spotted them?

102

Okay, at eight o'clock last night is when the first one started coming in.

103

They came in and it looked like the first star of the evening in the east.

104

00:06:10,000 --> 00:06:11,000

Okay.

105

00:06:11,000 --> 00:06:16,000

And do you watch these take off also after they land?

106

Yes, sir.

107

00:06:17,000 --> 00:06:22,000

This morning I got up at four o'clock this morning to go to work and I'd say about five o'clock

108

before daylight this thing came up orange up into the air and just disappeared.

109

00:06:30,000 --> 00:06:35,000

Okay, have you ever spotted any of those up on the mountain during the daytime?

110

00:06:35,000 --> 00:06:36,000

Daylight hours?

111

00:06:36,000 --> 00:06:37,000

No, sir.

112

00:06:37,000 --> 00:06:40,000

Okay, do they appear just to come in at night and then leave early in the morning?

113

00:06:40,000 --> 00:06:41,000

Yes, sir.

114

00:06:41,000 --> 00:06:42,000

Okay.

115

00:06:42,000 --> 00:06:48,000

Have you ever noticed any aircraft activity around there when they're around?

116

00:06:48,000 --> 00:06:49,000

No, sir.

117

00:06:49,000 --> 00:06:50,000

Okay.

118

00:06:51,000 --> 00:06:54,000

But you know, you can see a jet.

119

00:06:54,000 --> 00:06:56,000

Now, I take that back.

120

00:06:56,000 --> 00:06:59,000

You can see the lights of jets way up there.

121

00:06:59,000 --> 00:07:01,000

These things are close to the ground.

122

00:07:01,000 --> 00:07:03,000

Yes, okay.

123

00:07:03,000 --> 00:07:08,000

But the one special item up on that mountain you say is a large cave?

124

00:07:08,000 --> 00:07:09,000

Yes, sir.

125

00:07:09,000 --> 00:07:10,000

Okay.

126

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:12,000

Have you ever been up to that cave?

127

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:13,000

Yes, sir.

128

00:07:13,000 --> 00:07:15,000

Anything special about it?

129

00:07:15,000 --> 00:07:19,000

No, it goes in about 300 yards and dead end.

130

00:07:19,000 --> 00:07:21,000

That's just kind of a natural form of cave?

131

00:07:21,000 --> 00:07:22,000

Yes, sir.

132

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:23,000

Okay.

133

00:07:23,000 --> 00:07:27,000

But there is a cave on up from it about a quarter mile.

134

00:07:27,000 --> 00:07:29,000

It is a big cavern.

135

00:07:29,000 --> 00:07:30,000

Okay.

136

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:35,000

But they're all over the sheet mountain, not only in this one special place, and there'll

137

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:39,000

be like three or four of them land up there, you know, at a time.

138

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:40,000

Okay.

139

00:07:40,000 --> 00:07:44,000

Now, have you heard of any other talk among your acquaintances about anyone else seeing

140

these things?

141

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:46,000

Yes, sir.

142

00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:51,000

The guy at work at about, we just went out for the first load at four o'clock in the

143

morning, and he's seen this thing and he come running to my truck scared to death.

144

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:58,000

And we have a preacher that works with us.

145

00:07:58,000 --> 00:08:04,000

And this morning, you know, I had done some talk to a couple of the guys, you know, about

146

if they've seen any lights out or anything.

147

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:09,000

Well, the preacher's truck was broke down.

148

00:08:09,000 --> 00:08:10,000

He said, well, it's just as well.

149

He says, I don't want to have to go after him to see all the weird things I've been seeing

150

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:14,000

anyway.

151

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:17,000

And I looked at him and I said, have you been seeing things out there?

152

00:08:17,000 --> 00:08:20,000

I said, like lights flying around and such.

153

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:23,000

And he looked around there, wouldn't nobody be him and I there?

154

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:24,000

And he says, yep.

155

00:08:24,000 --> 00:08:25,000

He says, I certainly have.

156

00:08:25,000 --> 00:08:28,000

And he's a preacher, so I know he's not going to lie about it.

157

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Okay.

158

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:32,000

At first, when I was seeing these things, I figured I'd need to go get myself committed.

159

Okay.

160

00:08:33,000 --> 00:08:41,000

And I've called the Air Force and everybody else, you know, asking if they're doing testing

161

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:42,000

around this area or whatever.

162

00:08:42,000 --> 00:08:46,000

And of course, I don't figure they'll tell me if they were, but I don't think the U.S.

163

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:48,000

has got anything like these things are.

164

00:08:48,000 --> 00:08:49,000

They move too fast.

165

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:55,000

Well, they wouldn't likely test a secret weapon of any kind off of a military base anyway.

166

00:08:55,000 --> 00:08:56,000

Oh, no.

167

00:08:56,000 --> 00:09:01,000

Do you see that minister quite often?

168

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:02,000

Every day.

169

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:05,000

Would you ask him to call us?

170

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:07,000

Well, I don't know that he will or not.

171

00:09:07,000 --> 00:09:08,000

Well, yeah.

172

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:09,000

He's a minister.

173

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:10,000

Yeah.

174

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:11,000

Okay.

175

00:09:11,000 --> 00:09:14,000

Have you tried taking any pictures?

176

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:15,000

No.

177

00:09:15,000 --> 00:09:16,000

Sure have.

178

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:21,000

Does anyone have a camera with a lens on it or a telescopic lens?

179

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:22,000

I don't know.

180

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:23,000

I can check around.

181

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:27,000

I said, if I can find one, you almost need a night lens for that.

182

Well, if these things give off enough light, if they use sensitivity film, it should pick

183

it up.

184

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:33,000

Okay.

185

All right.

186

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:35,000

Yeah.

187

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:43,000

Have you had any sightings in this area before?

188

00:09:43,000 --> 00:09:46,000

Many years ago, there was a major UFO incident.

189

00:09:46,000 --> 00:09:51,000

In fact, I can take up two major UFO incidents in your area.

190

00:09:51,000 --> 00:10:01,000

One involved a police officer and another involved, I think it was a heavy truck driver.

191

00:10:01,000 --> 00:10:07,000

And in both cases, they saw objects come down and land or practically land come to a near-landing

192

00:10:07,000 --> 00:10:10,000

position, very large circular object.

193

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:11,000

Yeah.

194

00:10:11,000 --> 00:10:14,000

Well, I can't tell if these things are circular or not.

195

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:16,000

They look kind of like the submarine.

196

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:17,000

Yes.

197

00:10:17,000 --> 00:10:20,000

You know, fuselage thing with kind of a tail on it.

198

00:10:20,000 --> 00:10:21,000

Now, let me tell you this.

199

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:27,000

Now, there's something I've seen several years ago that makes me believe in UFOs.

200

I've seen this thing that looked like two rubber rafts, one on top of the other.

201

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:33,000

Yes.

202

00:10:33,000 --> 00:10:35,000

Landed in a church parking lot.

203

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:37,000

And it was mist and rain.

204

00:10:37,000 --> 00:10:41,000

And as I turned the corner, this was early morning hours, I was coming home and working.

205

00:10:41,000 --> 00:10:45,000

And as I turned the corner, I've seen this thing running down the sidewalk that looked

206

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:46,000

like Mr. Peanut.

207

00:10:46,000 --> 00:10:49,000

And I thought I was crazy.

208

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:53,000

Have you ever had anybody tell you that before?

209

00:10:53,000 --> 00:10:54,000

Mr. Peanut.

210

00:10:54,000 --> 00:10:57,000

Well, a short type person.

211

00:10:57,000 --> 00:10:58,000

Yeah.

212

00:10:58,000 --> 00:11:05,000

All over the years there have been many, many eyewitness accounts of short occupants being

213

seen near these craft that have landed.

214

00:11:08,000 --> 00:11:09,000

Yeah.

215

00:11:09,000 --> 00:11:14,000

I don't know about the Mr. Peanut type description, but very short people, three and a half or

216

00:11:14,000 --> 00:11:15,000

four feet tall.

217

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:17,000

Yeah, this would be about four foot tall.

218

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:18,000

Yeah.

219

00:11:18,000 --> 00:11:20,000

It would be shaped just like Mr. Peanut.

220

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:22,000

It used to be on the old peanut jars.

221

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:26,000

Did you see that individual going into the object?

222

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:27,000

No, sir.

223

00:11:27,000 --> 00:11:30,000

I seen him running down the sidewalk and nibbling on the hedge.

224

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:31,000

Okay.

225

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:34,000

But this object, it was mist and rain.

226

00:11:34,000 --> 00:11:38,000

And there's two neighbor ladies there that's seen this and one of them called my mother.

227

00:11:38,000 --> 00:11:40,000

The next day, I was telling her about it.

228

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:44,000

And I came in and got the tail end of my mom's conversation.

229

00:11:44,000 --> 00:11:46,000

And I asked her about it.

230

00:11:46,000 --> 00:11:51,000

And she told me that Mary and Athena UFO, you know, and her and her neighbor walked down

231

00:11:51,000 --> 00:11:54,000

the street and where this thing was sitting.

232

00:11:54,000 --> 00:11:59,000

Yeah, the streets and everything was wet and this one circle was dry.

233

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:06,000

So, and my brother says up on Sheet Mountain with his binoculars, he can see burn marks.

234

00:12:06,000 --> 00:12:07,000

Okay.

235

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:08,000

So.

236

00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:10,000

Is that quite a hike going up there?

237

00:12:10,000 --> 00:12:12,000

Oh, yes, sir.

238

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:14,000

Nobody walks up there.

239

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:15,000

Okay.

240

00:12:15,000 --> 00:12:16,000

Long ways up there.

241

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:19,000

Yeah, a trip for a helicopter then, I suppose.

242

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:20,000

Yes, sir.

243

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:22,000

Where did you get that number?

244

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:28,000

I got it from the Wayne Division of Warren Air Force Base.

245

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:29,000

Okay.

246

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:35,000

And I've been debating on whether to call you guys for a long time, you know, to call

247

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:36,000

somebody and tell them it was there.

248

00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:41,000

And then my brother actually seen it last night, him and his wife.

249

00:12:41,000 --> 00:12:45,000

He decided maybe we should all to tell somebody.

250

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:48,000

They were pretty convinced, were they?

251

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:49,000

Yeah, they were definitely.

252

Okay.

253

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:54,000

Yeah, everybody that's seen it is pretty welcome to ask.

254

Okay.

255

But it's more than one of them.

256

There's like a dozen of them.

257

All right, we sure appreciate you reporting this.

258

259

and you don't see this thing sitting over there across the river from you.

263

Yes.

Yes.

265

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:25,000

Does your dog usually act up when these things are around?

266

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

Yes, sir.

267

00:13:26,000 --> 00:13:29,000

Well, that's a very common phenomenon.

268

00:13:29,000 --> 00:13:32,000

Dogs and cats and farm animals.

269

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:33,000

You know, they go in the river.

270

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:36,000

I mean, this morning that one would be going whoop, whoop, whoop, whoop, you know, he's

271

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:37,000

really raising the hell.

272

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:38,000

I'll be there.

273

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:39,000

All right, sir.

274

Thank you again.

275
