Were the lights continuous? They were, weren't they?

Yeah, they were continuous.

Okay.

That's right. I mean, the only one that blink was the red one in the middle.

Okay.

And like I said, I mean, we thought it was an aircraft to begin with until the last minute.

because that's when I, you know, I would no longer fear the plane crashing or whatever it was.

You see, when I'm just, you have a picture in your mind of what I'm talking about.

Um, it wasn't very high at all, and it was traveling very slow, too slow for any normal aircraft,

except for, of course, a helicopter which can hover.

But a helicopter at that distance, you'd definitely hear and everything else.

75

Uh-huh.

And we would have seen the props.

77

You know, we were looking for anything on the thing, but it was just a solid mass.

And just the average fur tree in a forest and double it.

I see, okay.

85

Alright, double or triple it, somewhere right in there.

86

00:06:01,000 --> 00:06:02,000

That's still pretty low.

87

00:06:02,000 --> 00:06:03,000

Yeah, very low.

88

00:06:03,000 --> 00:06:05,000

Right.

89

00:06:05,000 --> 00:06:08,000

Okay, yeah, go ahead.

90

Uh, do you have any visual estimate regarding size?

91

Okay, size, Karen.

92

It was bigger than the one that they saw.

Yeah, they said the size of the Cadillac and ours was bigger than that.

The one that we saw was bigger than that.

It wasn't much bigger than that.

96

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:34,000

I'd say about two car lengths in length and maybe a car length and a half in width.

97

Okay.

98

00:06:36,000 --> 00:06:41,000

You're gonna have to translate those things in the feet, you know, just roughly.

99

Would there be any possibility of getting a drawing of this from you?

100

Yeah, in fact, we made one right after we saw it, if we still have it.

101

00:06:49,000 --> 00:06:50,000

How do you like that?

102

00:06:50,000 --> 00:06:52,000

That's great.

103

00:06:52,000 --> 00:06:57,000

Karen, do we still have that drawing that we made right after we saw it?

104

00:06:57,000 --> 00:07:01,000

Yeah, we made it up at Camino right after we saw it.

105

00:07:01,000 --> 00:07:03,000

You know, I'd have to go up there and check to make sure that we still have it.

106

00:07:03,000 --> 00:07:05,000

I see.

107

00:07:05,000 --> 00:07:09,000

Yeah, it was my mother cleaning, I don't know what she got.

108

00:07:09,000 --> 00:07:10,000

Yeah.

109

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:16,000

Okay, now have you determined exactly what part of the island you were on at the time?

110

Yeah, it's a sunrise boulevard.

111

Now, is that what side of the island is that on?

112

00:07:21,000 --> 00:07:26,000

Okay, that would be the inside of the island facing Warm Beach.

113

00:07:26,000 --> 00:07:29,000

You know where Warm Beach is on the mainland there?

114

00:07:29,000 --> 00:07:30,000

You have a map?

115

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:31,000

Warm Beach?

116

00:07:31,000 --> 00:07:33,000

Yeah, it's facing Warm Beach.

117

00:07:33,000 --> 00:07:34,000

Okay.

118

00:07:34,000 --> 00:07:35,000

Okay.

119

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:39,000

Do you have a map there?

120

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:45,000

Not right here, no, but I have checked it on a map and I couldn't find the name of that road on the map.

121

Yeah, that's because they just put it in this last year.

122

00:07:48,000 --> 00:07:49,000

I see, okay.

123

00:07:49,000 --> 00:07:56,000

Okay, so you won't find that road there except on an absolutely completely new map.

Okay.

Alright, so it's the inside of the island facing...

What direction would that be facing, Camino?

127

Facing east.

128

Are you going to go to your canyon?

129

00:08:06,000 --> 00:08:09,000

Well, the road that leads up will be south of UFO.

130

00:08:09,000 --> 00:08:13,000

Oh, it's really south of UFO.

131

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:15,000

Which way was the UFO coming?

132

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:25,000

UFO was going north, west, north, north, north, west.

133

00:08:25,000 --> 00:08:28,000

Yeah, the UFO was heading north to northwest.

134

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Still good.

135

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:31,000

And we were looking at it.

136

00:08:31,000 --> 00:08:42,000

It seemed to come right over us and we were situated at that time right there on the west side of the island.

137

Okay, right as you come onto the island, right as you come onto the island, right?

Okay, and then there's another branch in the road and it was right at that branch where we finally stopped to make our decision of which way to go to get away from the crash, which we thought at that time was an airplane.

Okay.

147

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:31,000

And it was coming, like I said, it was coming right over us heading towards, kind of like it was heading towards Woodbury Island, right?

148

I see, okay.

149

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:34,000

But how long do you feel you observed that?

150

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:36,000

Okay, how long did we observe that?

151

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:40,000

Yeah, about three minutes, I think.

152

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:42,000

Three or four minutes.

153

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:49,000

But we didn't stay to watch it, remember, as soon as we saw that it was something unidentified, we didn't know what it was, we made it.

154

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:52,000

Do you notice any interference with the car?

155

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:54,000

Was the time a car radio?

156

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:55,000

No, no.

157

00:09:55,000 --> 00:10:03,000

Now this was another reason that we didn't want to stay because I've heard about things like this happening before and it was a dark road and a dark night.

158

00:10:03,000 --> 00:10:10,000

And we just weren't prepared for any kind of unusual happening and there wasn't anything that did happen.

159

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:18,000

There was another car that came down the other road and it seemed to be, you know, from what we could observe that it wasn't having any type of interference at all.

160

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:21,000

It was just, there was no contact made at all.

161

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:24,000

And did you report this to any agency other than the State Patrol?

162

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:25,000

No, I didn't.

163

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:26,000

Okay.

164

00:10:27,000 --> 00:10:29,000

Oh, you want me to?

165

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:30,000

No, no, that's fine.

166

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:32,000

I had to borrow money to phone an agency of State Patrol.

167

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:33,000

It was long distance.

168

00:10:33,000 --> 00:10:38,000

So believe me, I was pretty, I mean, we were pretty shook up.

169

00:10:38,000 --> 00:10:40,000

Well, I can understand that.

170

00:10:40,000 --> 00:10:42,000

It takes person by surprise, you know.

171

00:10:42,000 --> 00:10:43,000

Yeah.

172

00:10:43,000 --> 00:10:49,000

Well, you know, if it happened again, I'd definitely stay and observe the whole thing because I didn't want to see one all my life.

173

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:50,000

You know?

174

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:53,000

And then it comes into the final moment, what do I do?

175

00:10:53,000 --> 00:10:54,000

I check it out.

176

00:10:57,000 --> 00:10:58,000

So.

177

00:10:58,000 --> 00:11:01,000

Well, I've often wondered what it would happen if I saw one myself.

178

00:11:02,000 --> 00:11:06,000

Well, I'm going to be kicking myself in the rear end now for a long time.

179

00:11:07,000 --> 00:11:10,000

And I'm, you know, I don't, I write things off pretty easy.

180

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:15,000

I mean, I, if I didn't just grab an inquirer, I probably never would have called you guys about it back.

181

00:11:16,000 --> 00:11:18,000

But that just, I mean, they're a description.

182

00:11:18,000 --> 00:11:23,000

I mean, it's just, okay, it seemed to be triangular in V shape.

183

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:26,000

I can make out ready slights of one side of hair green on the other.

184

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:27,000

I didn't get you.

185

00:11:27,000 --> 00:11:28,000

Yes.

186

00:11:28,000 --> 00:11:30,000

There was no sound at all.

187

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:31,000

Same as mine.

188

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:33,000

Had one big spotlight.

189

00:11:33,000 --> 00:11:36,000

The first guy says, and the other one says, you know, two big spotlights.

190

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:42,000

V shapes with blue lights, a ball of red light in the center.

191

00:11:42,000 --> 00:11:44,000

There were two big beams, like searchlights.

192

00:11:44,000 --> 00:11:45,000

I'm reading from the inquirer.

193

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:46,000

Yes.

194

00:11:46,000 --> 00:11:47,000

Okay.

195

00:11:47,000 --> 00:11:52,000

Well, like I said, we didn't see a take off, but we went about a mile and turned around.

196

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:57,000

It was gone, but it was flying so low that it could have just gone into a hill or a goalie or something like that.

197

00:11:57,000 --> 00:12:01,000

Now, did those beams from the object, did they appear to be directed to the ground?

198

00:12:01,000 --> 00:12:02,000

No.

199

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:03,000

That's what I said.

200

00:12:03,000 --> 00:12:04,000

That's why I knew it was not crashing.

201

00:12:04,000 --> 00:12:07,000

They were completely parallel with the tops of the trees.

202

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:12,000

When I first came out, I thought, you know, like I said, I thought the thing was crashing.

203

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:19,000

But until I, I still thought it was crashing until I focused my eyes on the beams.

204

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:26,000

I mean, that's the logical thing to do is look at the direction of the lights and then you can tell whether it's coming down or whether it's flying level or direction it's flying.

205

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:33,000

So until I focused my eyes on the two big beams that were coming out, I was still worried about the thing crashing.

206

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:37,000

In other words, it was giving that impression of coming down, but it wasn't.

207

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:38,000

It was flying parallel.

208

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:40,000

In other words, these beams are almost like headlights.

209

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:42,000

That's exactly what they were.

210

00:12:42,000 --> 00:12:47,000

Like big headlights or airplane landing lights.

211

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:48,000

Okay.

212

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:51,000

Do you think that we could get to copy that drawing?

213

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:52,000

Yeah.

214

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:55,000

And we would also like the map.

215

00:12:55,000 --> 00:13:01,000

It doesn't have to be too detailed showing your position in relation to the object in the object's movement.

216

00:13:01,000 --> 00:13:02,000

All right.

217

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:04,000

And you have our address?

218

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:07,000

Did you send it when you...

219

00:13:07,000 --> 00:13:09,000

Did they send the address on that?

220

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:10,000

Oh, I'm sure you did.

221

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:12,000

You have a return address on the envelope.

222

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:13,000

Yes.

223

00:13:13,000 --> 00:13:14,000

Oh, yes.

224

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:15,000

Okay.

225

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:18,000

And it might be about a week.

226

Oh, that's fine.

227

00:13:19,000 --> 00:13:21,000

Because I have to get back up there again.

228

I see.

229

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:24,000

Now, could we have the name of the lady that was with you?

230

00:13:24,000 --> 00:13:25,000

Yeah.

231

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

Why don't you just talk to her?

232

00:13:26,000 --> 00:13:27,000

Hold on.

233

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:28,000

Okay.

234

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:29,000

Hello.

235

00:13:29,000 --> 00:13:30,000

Hi there.

236

00:13:30,000 --> 00:13:31,000

You're a lucky one.

237

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:34,000

I wonder if we could get your name for additional... additional witness.

238

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:35,000

Okay.

239

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:37,000

It's Karen.

240

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:38,000

Okay, that's great.

241

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:39,000

Yeah, that was really strange.

242

00:13:39,000 --> 00:13:40,000

You know, I just...

243

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:44,000

I occasionally pick up the inquire just to send the answer to Reid.

244

00:13:44,000 --> 00:13:45,000

I was on the back page.

245

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:46,000

There's this week's issue.

246

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:47,000

And I took a...

247

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:49,000

Well, they have a drawing of it.

248

00:13:49,000 --> 00:13:50,000

I took one look at that.

249

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:51,000

I was like, God, you know?

250

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:53,000

And so I quick read the article and called up kids,

251

because you won't believe this.

252

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:56,000

So...

253

Yeah, I would be interested in that.

258

Sure.

259

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:08,000

Yeah, because I thought, well, you know, and then...

260

Well, I can't even quite remember the date we saw this.

261

It's state patrol.

262

I don't know if they keep...

Was that about the first part of June?

265

Was that it?

266

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:17,000

Do you have a record there?

267

I can't even quite remember the first part of June or July.

268

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:22,000

Tell them that card that they sent me.

269

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:23,000

No, I've got the...

270

00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:24,000

It's upstairs in the house.

271

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:27,000
