I'm going to leave our office number with you and if any of these other gentlemen would care to call us, we'd like to arrange something for a telephone interview.

And that's the UFO Reporting Center in Seattle, Washington.

Right.

I'm very surprised they didn't get in on that right away.

Well, the law covered it up. In fact, they run a guy away from it yesterday that was from Flagstaff.
