We had a power failure here at the apartment complex.

And my wife, I wasn't in bed yet.

00:00:23,000 --> 00:00:28,000

My wife called me out the window and toward the north of my apartment window,

8

00:00:28,000 --> 00:00:32,000

we saw it appear to be a flaming object in the sky.

9

00:00:32,000 --> 00:00:37,000

And it proceeded up from the horizon up overhead.

10

And the real slow, it took probably about 15 minutes.

11

And it looked just like a flaming round object, maybe, quite a bit of a look.

And it proceeded over the top of our apartment house,

and it stayed over the top of our apartment house for a good five minutes,

working over the other side.

And I got the field glasses out and looked at it,

and it looked the same size in the field glasses as it did with an ankle eye.

Our window is apartment house, parallel to the SeaTac runway.

And I don't remember the runway, which runways are which,

but we're looking towards the north.

Okay.

37

00:02:06,000 --> 00:02:07,000

Probably northwest.

38

00:02:07,000 --> 00:02:12,000

And then it disappeared to the southeast or south,

39

but generally in a northerly, southerly direction,

40

maybe northwest to southeast.

Uh-huh.

And it was straight up in the sky above our apartment,

43

but it looked like it was going over a little bit.

As you look at it to the north, my wife said she thought it went over to the left more,

And then it started kind of changing course and came up over here.

And how long did that stay overhead?

Well, it was out of our sight over our roof.

You know, we looked out both sides of the house,

51

and it must have been up there about this five minutes.

Uh-huh.

It could have been moving across, but it was moving off the stove

54

by the time it got up overhead.

It seemed like it was moving slower when it was overhead,

but we couldn't see it,

and it was coming up on the right.

Now, my wife said the slower it moved, the smaller it got.

Okay, and this seemed to give off particles in the distance at one time.

Yes.

00:03:20,000 --> 00:03:23,000

All the time during we went across the sky, we didn't see it losing any particles.

Yes.

00:03:24,000 --> 00:03:27,000

But it was just as it went down in the south,

65

00:03:27,000 --> 00:03:29,000

when it started getting a little bit smaller,

I had the grass on all the time then,

67

and it looked just like something shot out from it real fast two or three times,

68

and they were little round fiery objects, like the color of it was.

Were they shooting out in the same direction or different directions?

In the same general direction that it was going.

I see.
