79

80

along the hillside, you know, it's made of skin now,

81

because you just ride along the hillside, ride about in the center of the hillside, so

82

you wouldn't really have to, and I just said it was, you know, because I don't know.

83

I really don't know, it was not.

84

But then, it didn't make any noise at all, so you're all down the windows, came off the light,

85

thin, but the object wasn't thinning around completely,

Yeah, it was just spotted, and it was much cleaner than it seemed, and it might be

106

a little bit better. Now, when it was hovering near your

107

truck, it just hovering directly over here, it was off, and I don't know if it was

108

00:07:54,000 --> 00:07:58,000

off on an angle, it wasn't in that state of the art,

109

00:07:58,000 --> 00:08:02,000

but it was on a line, and, and, and,

110

00:08:02,000 --> 00:08:06,000

okay, what's the direction for that, dude? Okay, it would, it would be

111

00:08:06,000 --> 00:08:10,000

okay, we were, it would be south of us,

112

00:08:10,000 --> 00:08:14,000

and it says we were, uh, heading, we were heading south,

113

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:18,000

down the road, and it just got, and south side of us,

114

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:22,000

it just came down, it cleared off more or less toward there,

115

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:26,000

uh, a left northern, uh, angle

116

00:08:26,000 --> 00:08:30,000

towards the little town. Okay, were you on the main roadway at the time?

117

Uh, that is, no, we were on a third roadway, and it was

118

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:38,000

about, oh, 15 miles down the third road, and,

and, and, we came back on the main road, which was the main road,

120

probably about three miles from the little town,

121

next to you, and we stopped at the main highway. Yeah, that's the main highway, that takes

122

to, uh, outskirts, if you remember the number of that highway,

123

uh, I can put the number here, I think, oh, that's the problem

124

with the, like, 189 or something like that. Okay, then,

125

uh, in relation to the highway, would be, uh, north or

126

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:10,000

south of the highway, which means, uh, highway, south, south of

127

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:14,000

the highway, okay, and it remains on the south side of the highway while

128

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:18,000

you went into town, yes, you did.

129

00:09:18,000 --> 00:09:22,000

Were you driving the first, no, I was

130

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:26,000

just not at the side of the, okay, and it stayed down the left side of the

131

00:09:26,000 --> 00:09:30,000

highway, and it had a, yeah, okay, and it didn't diverge from that

132

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:34,000

area at all, no, not at all, okay.

133

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:38,000

Now, when you got to this, uh, the rest of the, the other

134

people were watching at what angle would be on just the way to the

135

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:46,000

point, okay, that was, uh, the case, the rest of the, it was north,

136

00:09:46,000 --> 00:09:50,000

north, north, north, north side, and they were watching it, and it looked

137

00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:54,000

like it was quite the south, well, you know, yeah,

138

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:58,000

they didn't watch it, so we, uh,

139

00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:02,000

we were, uh, just, uh, we didn't know about it, uh, the people

140

00:10:02,000 --> 00:10:06,000

were, uh, part of the people even, the carers, so, you know,

141

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:10,000

we were so stupid, it was something we didn't want to, let

142

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:14,000

yourself lose, it was something that wasn't happening or anything, and then we

143

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:18,000

started, we started to get sat there and watch it, and we were like, wow, that's really amazing,

144

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:22,000

you know, it's just, you know, you don't have any type of clean lens, you can reach and other things,

145

but if they don't have any type of clean lens camera, I think you could have gotten good pictures

146

of it, uh huh, if you could have given us closer to the object, and

147

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:34,000

if you had some shot-off on it, you know, all the analysis you would have seen, and you could

148

00:10:34,000 --> 00:10:38,000

have done it, and it's all, what was the condition of the sky?

149

It was, it was pretty clear, okay, now when you're at the restaurant, if you have any idea

150

how many degrees above the horizon and object, like, I was curious

151

about it, I was curious,

152

00:10:50,000 --> 00:10:54,000

it was about a 35, maybe 30 to 40 degree

153

angle, and still maintained the same color, yes, okay,

154

and uh, when the day breaks, then

155

now you head to the restaurant, and the restaurant was about, it was just

156

about 5 30 days, I think it was about

157

5 40, 80, 5 50,

158

something like that, so it was just, it was just the 40s, or the

159

00:11:18,000 --> 00:11:20,000

objects move away before they, very, very, very high, and just, just, just

160

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:24,000

put them back, and that's, that's, that's, that's the case, a little

161

00:11:24,000 --> 00:11:28,000

after 5 60 days, okay, now when it moves away, it is, which is the

162

00:11:28,000 --> 00:11:32,000

rest of the space, though, it could seem like, it could be, that,

163

00:11:32,000 --> 00:11:36,000

oh, now, like, you, it could be, now, it's really, it's, it's, it's, it's, okay,

164

00:11:36,000 --> 00:11:40,000

did you have any problems with the pressure when I think it's following you now,

165

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:44,000

now, uh, it was, I, I can't, see, I can't

166

00:11:44,000 --> 00:11:48,000

see, uh, you see, now, but, you can hear the news, like, I mean, you know, because

167

00:11:48,000 --> 00:11:52,000

I talked to a lot of people, they said they can, uh,

168

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:56,000

uh, talk to people like that, you know, they can't, they can't

169

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:59,000

show up, they can't point at anything, they said that he could be in a cellar

170

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:03,000

race going down the dirt road, but I don't think he was going

171

00:12:03,000 --> 00:12:07,000

60 miles an hour, he could have just done it faster, but, uh,

172

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:10,000

the thing is that he felt so fast in a little

173

00:12:10,000 --> 00:12:14,000

and it got to, I think that's what they were over the years.

174

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:18,000

And they would say, I think it was the 72, okay,

175

00:12:18,000 --> 00:12:21,000

and in high office speed, I see the population

176

00:12:21,000 --> 00:12:24,000

that could stay in place and would pick up,

177

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

but there's the energy that's left there,

178

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:28,000

and just be able to talk about it.

179

And now, I think it's really exciting to say that to,

180

I don't know, I think it wasn't,

181

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:37,000

but again and again, I more or less think that

182

going down a big road just a mile from the Arby Street,

183

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:44,000

that's about as fast as you go down from that town.

184

So I don't think at any point in that,

185

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:49,000

any stroll over the rest of the road,

186

00:12:49,000 --> 00:12:51,000

or the vehicle you drive,

187

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:53,000

because I think when I sit out in the streets,

188

00:12:53,000 --> 00:12:56,000

because I'm in a big, I got to hold myself to know,

189

00:12:56,000 --> 00:12:59,000

and then I started thinking more like,

190

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:01,000

well, we've been in the back-up,

191

00:13:01,000 --> 00:13:06,000

but there's no point in doing that kind of stroll.

192

So it was interesting to see that I went,

193

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:12,000

and I looked at a lot of that,

194

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:14,000

a real close thing that went on,

195

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:16,000

that's when I was running,

196

00:13:16,000 --> 00:13:21,000

and that was, I think that was the start of November.

197

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:25,000

And that kind of reached me,

198

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:28,000

and it's been a good, it's been a good morning.

199

Early AM, yeah.

200

Okay, when you stop for a stop,

201

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:32,000

if you stop for a stop,

202

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:33,000

you look at it,

203

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:36,000

if you get out, you can see the approach to it anytime.

204

So it's good to stop to test that out,

205

00:13:39,000 --> 00:13:40,000

to look at it,

206

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:41,000

and it's still a little bit weird,

207

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:43,000

but it's still,

208

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:45,000

when you look at it in an object,

209

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:48,000

and you even start to get to looking at it,

210

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:52,000

and it never seemed like it was kind of close to us,

211

00:13:52,000 --> 00:13:54,000

maybe it was our imagination,

212

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:56,000

running away, or something,

213

00:13:56,000 --> 00:13:59,000

but no, I think it's,

214

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:01,000

because we run the truck, you know,

215

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:02,000

and I look back,

216

00:14:02,000 --> 00:14:03,000

it seemed like it's kind of

217

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:06,000

moving the handle towards the little town

218

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:09,000

called Westfield where we were heading.

219

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:11,000

It seemed like it was

220

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:12,000

just close to us,

221

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:15,000

it's like it's blowing into a lot of driving,

222

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:16,000

and you know,

223

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:17,000

as you're looking at it a couple of times,

224

00:14:17,000 --> 00:14:19,000

and on the way back in,

225

00:14:19,000 --> 00:14:22,000

but I don't think it's,

226

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:24,000

it didn't come exactly straight at us,

227

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:25,000

you know, our truck,

228

00:14:25,000 --> 00:14:26,000

and that's because,

229

00:14:26,000 --> 00:14:28,000

I'm sure we must have been,

230

00:14:28,000 --> 00:14:30,000

we really only like to look up there

231

00:14:30,000 --> 00:14:31,000

for 20 miles,

232

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:33,000

and that's the object that we've seen,

233

00:14:33,000 --> 00:14:34,000

and I must have seen it,

234

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:35,000

when I look over on the hill,

235

00:14:35,000 --> 00:14:36,000

by the way,

236

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:39,000

it had to be a traffic jam,

237

and then when we jumped it up again,

238

in front of it,

239

I thought, you know,

240

00:14:43,000 --> 00:14:44,000

a lot of our vehicles,

241

it didn't fit that side, you know,

242

00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:47,000

it's really,

243

00:14:47,000 --> 00:14:49,000

it's kind of moving somewhere,

244

00:14:49,000 --> 00:14:51,000

and it's really, you know,

245

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:52,000

it's a really, really, really,

246

00:14:52,000 --> 00:14:53,000

after you know.

247

00:14:53,000 --> 00:14:54,000

Well now that you're going to,

248

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:55,000

traveling on,

249

00:14:55,000 --> 00:14:56,000

was that traveling?

250

00:14:56,000 --> 00:14:58,000

Was that north or south, or in the in-highway?

251

00:14:58,000 --> 00:15:00,000

Were you traveling south?

252

00:15:00,000 --> 00:15:01,000

In other words,

253

when you were driving up that road

254

to the in-highway,

255

you were traveling north,

okay, then the object,

258

at that point,

with that connection,

maybe it was behind the,

261
