And look when it got brighter, it looked like it got a lot bigger.

7

And it really hurt your eyes.

8

And I kept thinking, see maybe it's the transformer on top of a pole or something caught on fire.

9

But then it wasn't that because it just got real funny, you know?

10

And then it just, it moved up.

11

00:00:38,000 --> 00:00:42,000

And it looked to me at one time like it moved over.

12

And then it would get real tiny, real small.

13

00:00:45,000 --> 00:00:51,000

And then all of a sudden it would just turn this funny shade of red.

14

And stay that way for a few minutes and then just turn this real brilliant yellow-orange.

15

And then just get great big.

16

00:00:58,000 --> 00:01:01,000

And then it started moving in toward town.

17

00:01:01,000 --> 00:01:04,000

And it went up a little bit higher and a little bit higher.

18

Then it went almost out like a star and just sat there.

19

As it moved up higher, it sat there a little bit.

20

And then it just got like a star.

21

You'd think it was like a real brilliant evening star.

22

And then all of a sudden it moved up a little bit higher and just came this great big brilliant light again.

And then it started moving in toward town.

24

00:01:24,000 --> 00:01:27,000

And then it came right over the back and we were on our patio.

25

00:01:27,000 --> 00:01:31,000

And it just came right back over the top of the roof.

26

00:01:31,000 --> 00:01:33,000

You know, it was up in the sky.

27

00:01:33,000 --> 00:01:36,000

And it got so far and it stopped.

28

And then it waited a few minutes and it was still this great big brilliant color.

29

And then there was no noise.

30

35

We couldn't until it got over and going past us.

36

And then it was still this great big bright light.

37

And I kept looking for a shape, you know, of something.

38

00:02:12,000 --> 00:02:16,000

And you couldn't detect any body because it was dark.

39

00:02:16,000 --> 00:02:19,000

And you couldn't detect the body of it.

40

00:02:19,000 --> 00:02:23,000

But there were some other lights on it.

41

00:02:23,000 --> 00:02:25,000

Okay, what color were those?

42

00:02:25,000 --> 00:02:28,000

The other light was so brilliant.

43

00:02:28,000 --> 00:02:31,000

You couldn't make out, you know, like a red or green or a blue or anything.

44

00:02:31,000 --> 00:02:37,000

It looked to me like it was the same, about three other little lights on it, the same color.

45

00:02:37,000 --> 00:02:39,000

There was no red or green on it.

46

00:02:39,000 --> 00:02:40,000

Okay.

47

00:02:40,000 --> 00:02:47,000

But that light itself, in all the time that you were watching it, the light itself never took on any particular shape.

48

It just started off and on when it was over the tree.

49

00:02:51,000 --> 00:02:54,000

And as it moved up, it was funny.

50

00:02:54,000 --> 00:02:58,000

But it wasn't, you know, I couldn't tell whether it was because it was so bright.

51

You know how when you look at a light that's real bright at a distance, you can see, you know what I mean?

52

Right.

53

00:03:04,000 --> 00:03:07,000

It's a funny thing. You can't even explain it.

54

Okay.

55

00:03:08,000 --> 00:03:11,000

But it didn't take an oval shape, you know, or any different shape.

56

It was just a glowing.

57

00:03:13,000 --> 00:03:17,000

Was this object covering more or less at tree top level?

58

00:03:17,000 --> 00:03:20,000

It was at tree top level for me.

59

00:03:20,000 --> 00:03:22,000

You know, like we were looking at our backyard.

60

00:03:22,000 --> 00:03:23,000

Yes.

61

00:03:23,000 --> 00:03:29,000

And we're looking out sort of north, well not really northwest, it's west period, just west.

62

00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:37,000

And when you look out west, it was down low like tree top level because I was looking at it from a distance.

63

00:03:37,000 --> 00:03:38,000

Right.

64

00:03:38,000 --> 00:03:42,000

And then as it moved up, you know, then it got up away from the trees.

65

00:03:42,000 --> 00:03:43,000

Right.

66

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:45,000

And then it started moving into our town.

67

00:03:45,000 --> 00:03:49,000

Okay. Do you have any estimate at how far away it was from you?

68

00:03:49,000 --> 00:03:53,000

Let's see.

69

00:03:53,000 --> 00:04:00,000

Like we live in Oakdale and I was estimating it would be clear, maybe clear over maybe 16 or 17.

70

00:04:00,000 --> 00:04:07,000

I don't know how to figure feet, you know, but like 16 or 17 miles is what it would seem like to me from where we were if that far.

71

00:04:07,000 --> 00:04:11,000

I don't, you know, it moved into town awful fast, but may not have been that far out.

72

00:04:11,000 --> 00:04:14,000

It might have only been maybe five or six miles from me.

73

00:04:14,000 --> 00:04:15,000

Right. Okay.

74

00:04:15,000 --> 00:04:22,000

But you know, but length of sky is funny, you know, like a jet can be a mid-est and we can see it in Oakdale.

75

00:04:22,000 --> 00:04:29,000

But so I can't, I don't really think it would be 16 or 17 miles because it moved in here awful fast.

76

00:04:29,000 --> 00:04:31,000

I mean, it was just right out of where the tree moved in.

77

00:04:31,000 --> 00:04:33,000

So maybe I am wrong there on that.

78

00:04:33,000 --> 00:04:36,000

I was being corrected by the other person that saw it with me.

79

00:04:36,000 --> 00:04:40,000

And she says it seemed to her like it was just doubted by the river, you know.

80

00:04:40,000 --> 00:04:42,000

Okay.

81

00:04:42,000 --> 00:04:46,000

And did you hear any sound at all during this whole?

82

00:04:46,000 --> 00:04:49,000

There was nothing. There was not even a sound.

83

00:04:49,000 --> 00:04:51,000

I thought, well, maybe it was an airplane.

84

00:04:51,000 --> 00:04:57,000

We were trying to think of all these things, you know, but there was nothing and there was no shape of an airplane.

85

00:04:57,000 --> 00:05:00,000

There was no body behind it like a tail.

86

00:05:00,000 --> 00:05:01,000

Yes.

87

00:05:01,000 --> 00:05:09,000

There was nothing. It looked to me like when it got over us, you know, it looked to me like it was,

88

00:05:09,000 --> 00:05:13,000

it would have to be round because there was nothing behind it.

89

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:16,000

Okay. Did it go directly over you?

90

00:05:16,000 --> 00:05:19,000

Not where I could look right up at the belly of it.

91

00:05:19,000 --> 00:05:28,000

Like when you just bring your arm up from your waist and bring it up almost at a 90 degree angle.

92

00:05:28,000 --> 00:05:30,000

And that's where it was over me.

93

00:05:30,000 --> 00:05:35,000

Okay. Did it, during that period, did it pause or slow down at all?

94

00:05:35,000 --> 00:05:36,000

It did.

95

00:05:36,000 --> 00:05:37,000

Uh-huh.

96

00:05:37,000 --> 00:05:38,000

Okay.

97

00:05:38,000 --> 00:05:42,000

And then, and that's what Beth and I said, oh, there's no way an airplane can do that.

98

00:05:42,000 --> 00:05:43,000

Uh-huh.

99

00:05:43,000 --> 00:05:45,000

You know, and you can hear an airplane.

100

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:46,000

Right.

101

00:05:46,000 --> 00:05:51,000

And you can hear a jet. You can hear a helicopter, anything like that. You can hear it.

102

00:05:51,000 --> 00:05:55,000

Did you notice any interference with lighting in the area at the time?

103

00:05:55,000 --> 00:05:56,000

No.

104

00:05:56,000 --> 00:05:57,000

Okay.

105

00:05:57,000 --> 00:06:00,000

Because we had our patio light on and everything, everything was fine.

106

00:06:00,000 --> 00:06:05,000

Okay. Was there any pets in the neighborhood making any out of the way noises?

107

00:06:05,000 --> 00:06:07,000

My dog was barking.

108

00:06:07,000 --> 00:06:08,000

Okay.

109

00:06:08,000 --> 00:06:11,000

It didn't start barking until it got over our yard.

110

00:06:11,000 --> 00:06:14,000

Oh, not right over a yard, but you know, over us.

111

00:06:14,000 --> 00:06:15,000

Yes.

112

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:20,000

And then, um, my dog started barking and he ran out of the house.

113

00:06:20,000 --> 00:06:27,000

Okay. Did you and the other party experience any out of the ordinary physical sensations at the time?

114

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:28,000

No.

115

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:29,000

Okay.

116

00:06:29,000 --> 00:06:30,000

It's just excitement.

117

00:06:30,000 --> 00:06:31,000

Right.

118

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:35,000

But nothing, nothing at all other than that.

119

00:06:35,000 --> 00:06:37,000

Okay.

120

00:06:37,000 --> 00:06:40,000

And there were two witnesses, just you and another party?

121

00:06:40,000 --> 00:06:41,000

Me and my mother, yeah.

122

00:06:41,000 --> 00:06:42,000

Okay.

123

00:06:42,000 --> 00:06:46,000

I kind of wish my husband had been home, but he isn't home from work yet.

124

00:06:46,000 --> 00:06:48,000

And no one took any pictures?

125

00:06:48,000 --> 00:06:49,000

No.

126

00:06:49,000 --> 00:06:50,000

Okay.

127

00:06:50,000 --> 00:06:53,000

About what time did you first spot that?

128

00:06:53,000 --> 00:06:58,000

At 1230, must have been around 1230 because I watched it and I can see, do you look at that?

129

00:06:58,000 --> 00:07:02,000

Funny light, isn't that weird? You know, I just watched that for a few minutes.

130

00:07:02,000 --> 00:07:07,000

And you know what's funny is I've seen a light, something like that before in that same area,

131

00:07:07,000 --> 00:07:11,000

but nothing, and I've watched it out my bedroom window, maybe for about 20 minutes,

132

00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:14,000

and it changed all these different shapes, but never move in.

133

00:07:14,000 --> 00:07:15,000

It would go out.

134

00:07:15,000 --> 00:07:18,000

I mean, go out, completely out.

135

00:07:18,000 --> 00:07:22,000

Is there anything over, any special surface feature in that area?

136

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:29,000

Any, uh, man-made, any dams or electric power stations?

137

00:07:29,000 --> 00:07:31,000

Not, there is.

138

00:07:31,000 --> 00:07:36,000

There's an electric power station on River Road, and that would be following it right down the river.

139

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:37,000

Uh-huh.

140

00:07:37,000 --> 00:07:44,000

And it, now let's see, I have to stop and think, it would be a sort of in that same area, really,

141

00:07:44,000 --> 00:07:49,000

because it's clear out, it's on River Road, and you go clear out, and like I'm two blocks,

142

00:07:49,000 --> 00:07:51,000

maybe four blocks in from the river.

143

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:52,000

Yes.

144

00:07:52,000 --> 00:07:56,000

And it is down the river, Pichini's sub-station.

145

00:07:56,000 --> 00:07:57,000

Okay.

146

00:07:57,000 --> 00:08:00,000

And it's a Malonea sub-station.

147

00:08:00,000 --> 00:08:04,000

I think it's called, but we have a Malonea's dam being built clear up in the, you know, clear on up.

148

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:05,000

Yes.

149

00:08:05,000 --> 00:08:06,000

But that, it wasn't up over there.

150

00:08:06,000 --> 00:08:07,000

Okay.

151

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:09,000

It was down the mouth of the river, clear down.

152

00:08:09,000 --> 00:08:12,000

And, um, there is a sub-station in there.

153

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:13,000

Okay.

154

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:18,000

Now, you know, that's a funny thing, because I was trying to locate it along River Road,

155

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:22,000

because along the river, you know, whenever I was telling you where it was at,

156

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:28,000

I have no sense of miles, I mean, you know, or anything like that, as far as feet goes,

157

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:29,000

or yards or anything.

158

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:31,000

I just, I have no sense whatsoever.

159

00:08:31,000 --> 00:08:34,000

I could tell where it is, and he moved it off a fast, so he couldn't have been out.

160

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:37,000

As far as I said at first, there's just no way he could have been out that far.

161

00:08:37,000 --> 00:08:40,000

Well, visual estimates are very difficult.

162

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:41,000

Yeah.

163

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:42,000

Right.

164

00:08:42,000 --> 00:08:46,000

Well, would you consider filling in one of our questionnaires of a synod to him?

165

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:47,000

Oh, yeah.

166

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:48,000

Oh, yeah.

167

00:08:48,000 --> 00:08:52,000

I'm one of those that just can't believe this.

168

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:54,000

I mean, I believe in him.

169

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:59,000

I'm one, I'm about the only one in my area here that does, and when I called in, I told

170

00:08:59,000 --> 00:09:02,000

the girl, I said, you're just not going to believe this.

171

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:05,000

I said, I can't even tell you what it is.

172

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:09,000

And she didn't even know how to, I called the police department, and I know her,

173

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:11,000

because I work in the justice court.

174

00:09:11,000 --> 00:09:14,000

And I said, you're just not going to believe this, Pam.

175

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:16,000

And she says, well, tell me, tell me, and then they ran out.

176

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:20,000

Well, then the officer on duty, he says, oh, well, tell her it's just an airplane.

177

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:24,000

We saw it move out over town because I told them it was coming into our town.

178

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:28,000

It was on the outskirts of town, like they would have to look south to see it.

179

00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:29,000

Right.

180

00:09:29,000 --> 00:09:31,000

And but it was no airplane.

181

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:35,000

I know because there was no noise in our backyard except for my dog.

182

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:38,000

And they don't, they have a, well, they don't have that brilliant light.

183

00:09:38,000 --> 00:09:41,000

Even their headlight is white.

184

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:44,000

On an airplane, their headlight is white.

185

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:45,000

Right.

186

00:09:45,000 --> 00:09:47,000

And there'd be no reason why he'd have to hover.

187

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:52,000

And there'd be no way he could hover in an airplane except a helicopter and a helicopter,

188

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:56,000

a helicopter, a helicopter has a sound.

189

00:09:56,000 --> 00:09:57,000

You're going to hear it.

190

00:09:57,000 --> 00:09:58,000

Right.

191

00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:00,000

I don't care how high you hear a purr.

192

00:10:00,000 --> 00:10:02,000

And there was none.

193

00:10:02,000 --> 00:10:05,000

We listened, we thought it all out completely.

194

00:10:05,000 --> 00:10:08,000

We really did because I'm one of those.

195

00:10:08,000 --> 00:10:16,000

I mean, I went out one night and sat at the cemetery, believe it or not, for two and a half hours

196

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:19,000

because they had sightings in the area.

197

00:10:19,000 --> 00:10:21,000

And this was last year.

198

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:24,000

And I says, I'm going to see one of them to help me God.

199

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:27,000

That's when they had the sightings in Sonora, Twain Heart.

200

00:10:27,000 --> 00:10:28,000

Right.

201

00:10:28,000 --> 00:10:30,000

And I says, I know.

202

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:32,000

I'm going to go watch.

203

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:37,000

And I sat out and watched and watched because I believe in them and nobody else, they think I'm crazy.

204

00:10:37,000 --> 00:10:38,000

No way.

205

00:10:38,000 --> 00:10:45,000

And I says, I haven't seen one of them and damn it, I'm going to see one of them if I have to travel the Santa Cruz.

206

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:48,000

I'm going to see one of them in the next report.

207

00:10:48,000 --> 00:10:55,000

My dad used to see him every once in a while when he worked at Chachi Wireline.

208

00:10:55,000 --> 00:11:00,000

And he spends a mind on a ranch out in the out of Knightsbury and he's seen him before too.

209

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:05,000

And he says, he's even just giving up even saying anything to people about it because he says, they think you're crazy.

210

00:11:05,000 --> 00:11:06,000

They don't believe you.

211

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:07,000

I don't care.

212

00:11:07,000 --> 00:11:09,000

They think I'm crazy or not.

213

00:11:09,000 --> 00:11:11,000

Well, we get lots of calls.

214

00:11:11,000 --> 00:11:13,000

So they're being seen all over.

215

00:11:13,000 --> 00:11:15,000

Have you had any more in this area?

216

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:17,000

Not this evening, no.

217

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:21,000

Well, I wonder because you should be Sheriff's Office gets calls after calls after calls.

218

00:11:21,000 --> 00:11:25,000

One night I went all the way on Milne's Road about this time one night I was listening to my police radio.

219

00:11:25,000 --> 00:11:35,000

And they got a reciting on Milne's Road, which is between Turlock and here in Turlock, California, and I went out there and the Sheriff's car was out there.

220

00:11:35,000 --> 00:11:37,000

The Sheriff's car did see something.

221

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:39,000

They had gone by the time I got there.

222

00:11:39,000 --> 00:11:44,000

So, you know, I think that there is definitely something.

223

Well, we've come to the conclusion that we're dealing with vehicles not manufactured on this planet.

224

225

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:54,000

226

228

229

230

00:12:00,000 --> 00:12:06,000

231

232

233

Right.

234

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:20,000

And I said, but this definitely is when it moved out over us, you know, it was an airplane.

235

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:30,000

We need to get the after sound as it passed after it passed or something because we're right in the jet stream because the Castle Air Force Base is just 45 miles from here.

236

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:31,000

Right.

237

00:12:31,000 --> 00:12:33,000

And it headed out that way.

238

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:40,000

Now, whether Castle will turn it or not, I thought a couple of times calling Castle to see if they had reported anything.

239

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:46,000

Well, you'd be surprised how many hundreds of people will see something and not say anything.

240

00:12:46,000 --> 00:12:47,000

And not say anything.

241

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:48,000

Right.

242

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:49,000

Isn't that unreal?

243

00:12:49,000 --> 00:12:52,000

Well, we had one, this has been years and years and years ago.

244

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:54,000

I was a child, a real young girl at the time.

245

00:12:54,000 --> 00:13:02,000

And we had this friend that was hitchhiking from Modesto over here in the country and he swears up and down that one of them swooped down at him.

246

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:04,000

Oh, this happens all the time.

247

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:07,000

And, and, you know, followed him and scared him, scared him to death.

248

00:13:07,000 --> 00:13:09,000

I think he probably ran to Oakdale.

249

00:13:09,000 --> 00:13:10,000

Uh-huh.

250

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:12,000

And that 16 miles.

251

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:14,000

I mean, he was petrified.

252

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:15,000

He was a nervous wreck for days.

253

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:17,000

Now you don't just get that way over nothing.

254

00:13:17,000 --> 00:13:19,000

That's right.

255

00:13:19,000 --> 00:13:21,000

Well, we sure appreciate you calling.

256

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:25,000

And if we get any additional information on this, we'll get back to you and let you know.

257

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

Oh, I would.

258

00:13:26,000 --> 00:13:27,000

I'd really appreciate it.

259

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:29,000

I really would, even if you called.

260

00:13:29,000 --> 00:13:30,000

No, I would.

261

00:13:30,000 --> 00:13:33,000

I mean, I have, I mean, I just, I'll never go to bed all night.

262

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:35,000

I think I'm going without the country.

263

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:36,000

Uh-huh.

264

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:37,000

I mean, I want to see one of them.

265

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:38,000

I want to see one.

266

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:39,000

You know what I mean?

267

00:13:39,000 --> 00:13:41,000

I don't want to see it going over.

268

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:43,000

I'd like to see it come back by.

269

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:45,000

You know what I mean?

270

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:47,000

Sort of settle down.

271

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:49,000

Yeah, I'd kind of like to just see.

272

00:13:49,000 --> 00:13:53,000

I'd like people to know that this is, you know, not a thing that I have in my imagination.

273

00:13:53,000 --> 00:13:55,000

So there's just no way it is.

274
