And like, very few people even go to these woods at night, but we do. But anyways, it all stopped.

5

So we just bypassed it as maybe something that, you know, we're not sure what we saw.

6

It could have been a falling star. Well, last night, they were standing out in the yard, about 10.30.

7

They came across the sky and did a few zig-zags and went over and it landed again.

8

Well, when it landed, we watched and watched and watched for it to leave or whatever it was going to do, but it never did.

9

So by an hour and a half later, we heard this sound coming out of the woods.

10

Now I live up into the woods. We're in the best property.

11

And right across the fence line, you hear there's a sound coming. There was no animal.

12

Like I've ever heard in the woods. It sounded to me, my brother's in the computer,

13

and it sounded to me like some sophisticated piece of machinery.

14

And here last year, right across the street, on my neighbor's farm, one of his cows was immune-related.

15

His titties were cut off by a surgical knife. One of its ears, its tongue, its hands, what can I say, you know.

16

It was all surgically done. This was 30 years ago, and they got pictures of it over and over happening.

17

But this sound, it was up into the woods. The next thing, it was about two, three hundred feet from the house.

18

And we just sat there listening to it, and it was bouncing around, but it was like hollow, coming out of a cave.

19

Well, there's no caves without just one thing.

20

00:02:02,000 --> 00:02:06,000

And one minute, it'd be real close to it, just a few hundred feet away.

21

And the next minute, it would be kind of off into the woods.

22

And then what really bothered me, I wouldn't have thought too much about it.

I was pretty down about a little bit, and one time, it was back into the woods.

24

But that's wilderness. There's a hundred miles of wilderness area here.

25

And it's just, nobody goes in there at night because you've got to walk in. It's rattlesnake and

busted.

26

It's all big lava rocks. It's got some of the other flows and stuff.

27

And you just don't go in there at night. You're supposed to keep, you know, if you don't know what to do, and you don't know these woods.

28

Yes.

29

00:02:33,000 --> 00:02:35,000

And this scared the hell out of us.

30

00:02:35,000 --> 00:02:39,000

But when my partner probably took the light, and he got tired of it, and he shined the light up into the woods.

31

It stopped. It completely stopped.

32

My hips were just healed again later, about two, three hours later, once or twice.

33

But finally, we just went to bed. But it was a scary situation.

34

We got goats and animals and stuff down here. My goats were nuts. They were crazy.

35

They wanted out of their pens. And, you know, animals have instinct.

36

00:02:57,000 --> 00:03:03,000

And my animals, my goats, usually are calm at night. They never get up to sleep about nuts and nothing.

37

They're always sleeping bothers at night, and they rest easy.

38

Last night, they were just with nuts up all night, hitting the pens and trying to get out of the pens.

39

All my baby goats were bad, and crawling and crying and crying and crying for no real reason.

40

We thought there was no coyotes around, because my dogs hit them.

41

00:03:19,000 --> 00:03:23,000

You hear this, but that's how you right now. My dogs were kind of a traitor when not come out.

42

00:03:23,000 --> 00:03:29,000

But what I did, he would not come out. And he used to kind of dog, that he could get in the dog when the other one.

43

00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:32,000

And of course, given them the words, that's kind of dog you got to have.

44

00:03:32,000 --> 00:03:37,000

And it just, it's been here now. We saw it last night, the night before that we didn't see it,

45

00:03:37,000 --> 00:03:41,000

but the night before that we saw it. But the night before, we wasn't outside either.

46

00:03:41,000 --> 00:03:46,000

So it could have been here, or whatever. Now I haven't went up in the woods. I've checked around.

47

I haven't looked. I haven't done nothing to sleep about. I am not a brave person.

48

00:03:50,000 --> 00:03:54,000

And there's never am going to go up in here unless I know exactly what's going on.

49

00:03:54,000 --> 00:03:57,000

But we stood down here, and it got off of close to the trail there.

50

00:03:57,000 --> 00:04:01,000

The pain is bright enough that we got our weapons out, and he was the news.

51

00:04:01,000 --> 00:04:05,000

It was a chemistry yard, and I went and caught up with the door. I mean, I was feeling, I don't know what it was.

52

I got my wife and two babies and one on the way, and I don't know what the heck it is.

53

00:04:09,000 --> 00:04:15,000

It's not human. It's not, it's like no one has found another seed. It doesn't hold.

54

It's like nothing I've never seen. It's like a big ball of fire coming out across the sky.

55

And it just, it just dropped, it just sat right down the ground. It didn't flop.

56

It just came down gentle and sat, and it was like deep, deep, thick, always green in color,

57

and a big, big, white ball from the dome on top of it.

58

And this is a night time what we saw on this.

59

Okay Bob, did that have a definite shape?

60

Well, the shape looked circular. I would say the estimation of the size to a top of the

position by the size of my tail up to 150 to cross.

62

It appeared to have a dome on top.

63

It appeared to have a bright, light dome on top of it.

64

00:04:55,000 --> 00:04:59,000

It glowed like a brilliant, brilliant light.

65

00:04:59,000 --> 00:05:01,000

That's what I was saying honestly about it.

66

First of all, we thought, well, it's a long star, because we have no love around here.

67

But there's no 12 behind it.

68

00:05:07,000 --> 00:05:13,000

And you know, it don't just kind of come in several, probably several, or a big dot in a few seconds.

69

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:17,000

And only at first I thought, I was a little pale at the start too,

70

00:05:17,000 --> 00:05:20,000

and I wasn't too sure, but when everybody saw it again last night,

71

00:05:20,000 --> 00:05:23,000

and we heard those noises coming out of the rope.

72

00:05:23,000 --> 00:05:28,000

It just, something like a big ball, it just, a roll.

73

00:05:28,000 --> 00:05:32,000

How far, do you have any estimate on how far it was when it landed?

74

00:05:32,000 --> 00:05:35,000

About a quarter of a mile.

75

00:05:35,000 --> 00:05:36,000

Pardon? About a quarter of a mile.

76

00:05:36,000 --> 00:05:38,000

Did you pick up any sound at all as it was coming in?

77

00:05:38,000 --> 00:05:40,000

No, no sound.

78

00:05:40,000 --> 00:05:42,000

Just go straight and we cut our eyes.

79

00:05:42,000 --> 00:05:45,000

Did this thing come straight down or did it glide in?

80

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:48,000

It came straight down from the sky.

81

00:05:48,000 --> 00:05:53,000

It stopped, made a, I guess it would be a very good left hand, complete left hand turn.

82

00:05:53,000 --> 00:05:56,000

Went out across the sky and it set down.

83

00:05:56,000 --> 00:05:57,000

Okay.

84

00:05:57,000 --> 00:05:59,000

So, I'm sure it's got a fun start.

85

00:05:59,000 --> 00:06:02,000

Did it use that same pattern when it came down the second time?

86

00:06:02,000 --> 00:06:06,000

No, it came in roughly the same way, but not the same pattern.

87

00:06:06,000 --> 00:06:12,000

The first time I saw it, it came in kind of at an angle, and then it leveled off and set down.

88

00:06:12,000 --> 00:06:16,000

Okay, now, while all this was going on, were your animals acting up at the time?

89

00:06:16,000 --> 00:06:22,000

My animals didn't really act up until last night until the sound got right down to my fence line.

90

00:06:22,000 --> 00:06:27,000

Fence line was built in about a hundred feet from our top of the line.

91

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:30,000

And they couldn't, I know what they might have been able to see it.

92

00:06:30,000 --> 00:06:36,000

We couldn't see anything, but we could hear it and like, it's hard to explain the sound.

93

00:06:37,000 --> 00:06:43,000

It was like a bong, bong, and then it would just, like an echo.

94

00:06:43,000 --> 00:06:48,000

But there's nothing here to create an echo like that, and not make it jump all over the woods.

95

00:06:48,000 --> 00:06:54,000

And this is what I do. One minute we would hear it right on the fence line, and right up behind, we

got big ponderosa trees.

96

00:06:54,000 --> 00:06:58,000

And right behind the trees, the next minute, just a few seconds later, we'd do it again,

97

00:06:58,000 --> 00:07:04,000

it would be another, oh, maybe 7,800 feet, 8,000 feet up on the hill, then it would be back down the hill.

98

00:07:04,000 --> 00:07:10,000

Then you would hear it kind of coming down to the woods, and it would just stop being there quite a while, and I never heard anything like that.

99

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:12,000

Do they sound like a mechanical sound?

100

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:16,000

Yes, a sound. That's what bothers us. They sound mechanical.

101

00:07:16,000 --> 00:07:22,000

And that's the reason, if we're going to have war for our coyote, or maybe we don't even have bears

around here, though,

102

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:27,000

I thought to myself a bear, you know, because a bear can have strange bark.

103

00:07:27,000 --> 00:07:30,000

But it don't have that mechanical sound.

104

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:34,000

You can hear it. I mean, it's a definite mechanical sound.

105

00:07:34,000 --> 00:07:39,000

Okay, you're outdoors while all this is going on. Did you pick up any foul odor of any kind?

106

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:47,000

No. He picked up an odor. He picked up an unusual smell. No odor is out.

107

00:07:47,000 --> 00:07:51,000

Okay, was there any special change in the atmosphere, temperature, or anything?

108

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:52,000

No.

109

00:07:52,000 --> 00:07:53,000

Any mysterious winds?

110

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:55,000

No, it's the hot and dry out there.

111

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:58,000

But nothing out of the ordinary.

112

00:07:58,000 --> 00:08:00,000

Nothing in the real deep dark.

113

00:08:00,000 --> 00:08:01,000

Okay.

114

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:04,000

I know we just had the U.L. pier, but it's nothing really unusual.

115

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:08,000

Just the sound, though, is the most unusual thing.

116

00:08:08,000 --> 00:08:12,000

I can't relate to anything because I've never heard nothing like it.

117

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:13,000

Right.

118

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:14,000

It's hard to explain.

119

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:15,000

Well, does this sound moved around?

120

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:20,000

Would it appear to you, in your opinion, that it was being directed more than anything?

121

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:23,000

Indeed. It was. Indeed it was.

122

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Well, you know how you get various feelings about things, and that was something else.

123

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:33,000

It was just a kind of various feeling when something was wrong.

124

00:08:33,000 --> 00:08:36,000

Did you have the feeling you were being watched?

125

00:08:36,000 --> 00:08:39,000

We did. My heart stopped not telling. We just knew we were being watched.

126

00:08:39,000 --> 00:08:40,000

Okay.

127

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:46,000

That's right. In fact, it was kind of off in the distance, I would say, in a couple of

128

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:49,000

minutes in the yard, until we walked outside.

129

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:51,000

What we did, we had some signs we had to go take down.

130

00:08:51,000 --> 00:08:54,000

For the last time, we just went to check them down, and we lived along the roadway.

131

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:59,000

But anyway, as we walked back up, we heard it, and we had been talking to each other,

132

00:08:59,000 --> 00:09:01,000

and we had heard it three or four times.

133

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:03,000

We thought, well, it might be the dog, but the dog was up there.

134

00:09:03,000 --> 00:09:06,000

Besides, it came right down onto the fence line.

135

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:08,000

Never crossed the fence.

136

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:10,000

Never really came in across the fence.

137

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:14,000

But you knew it's spot behind the trees, and you can see it behind the trees,

138

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:17,000

especially it's one big tree out here.

139

00:09:17,000 --> 00:09:19,000

Did you sign no movement at all out there?

140

00:09:19,000 --> 00:09:23,000

No movement, but I did hear the brush break a couple of three times.

141

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:24,000

Uh-huh.

142

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:25,000

So that was nothing.

143

00:09:25,000 --> 00:09:27,000

But also, we had cows over there, too, see.

144

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:30,000

But normally, a cow don't move at night.

145

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:32,000

It's characteristic for a cow.

146

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:35,000

A cow also doesn't come to think of it.

147

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:40,000

The first night that we saw it, a mama cow was baiting, she was calling her baby in,

148

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:42,000

and cried, and cried, and cried.

149

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:44,000

I don't know if it's me, it was talking about it.

150

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:48,000

But at night time, your cows just fell right down your chute, or whatever they are,

151

00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:50,000

fell right down the tip mama, this is close to midnight.

152

00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:53,000

They're just baiting, and baiting, and calling for her baby.

153

00:09:53,000 --> 00:09:55,000

She bait, bait, bait for several hours.

154

00:09:55,000 --> 00:10:01,000

Of course, we don't go out and check them, but this guy has passed you next to her.

155

00:10:01,000 --> 00:10:05,000

She has a bunch of mama cows and baby cows in there, and there's like 10000 acres roughly.

156

00:10:05,000 --> 00:10:08,000

So, to give you an idea of how big the place is.

157

00:10:08,000 --> 00:10:09,000

Yes.

158

00:10:09,000 --> 00:10:14,000

Now, of course, ours is only a few acres, but we're out over here, but we live out of it.

159

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:18,000

It runs several hundred miles around us, it's just open wilderness land,

160

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:22,000

national pores, and one thing or another.

161

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:30,000

You know, I've seen undefined flying things in the sky before, but never enough to make that.

162

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:35,000

Okay, now, you have, there have been any reports of hairy creatures up around your area lately?

163

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:36,000

No, well, yes.

164

00:10:36,000 --> 00:10:37,000

When I picked the things.

165

00:10:37,000 --> 00:10:38,000

Yes.

166

00:10:38,000 --> 00:10:42,000

And of course, we get them up here, but it wasn't a big, but we've heard bigfoot calls before,

167

00:10:42,000 --> 00:10:44,000

and there's not a big, big, big fox in there.

168

00:10:44,000 --> 00:10:47,000

No, there are big folks, got our high species, in fact, we almost take one right now.

169

00:10:47,000 --> 00:10:50,000

You can hear them back off in the wilderness now, again.

170

00:10:50,000 --> 00:10:54,000

And they do come through this time of year, but they'll make up.

171

00:10:54,000 --> 00:10:56,000

You might understand, if any of them says you make a clear out,

172

00:10:56,000 --> 00:10:59,000

but I've heard the high-pitched species, you've found that they'll put off the mating,

173

00:10:59,000 --> 00:11:00,000

what they call the mating call.

174

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:01,000

Right, that is, right.

175

00:11:01,000 --> 00:11:07,000

And it's a high-pitched, like something you've never heard before, but it's always been deep in the woods.

176

00:11:07,000 --> 00:11:11,000

And they never, ever come down close to the house, ever.

177

00:11:11,000 --> 00:11:15,000

And like, now here, three weeks, or a month ago, there was a lady,

178

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:19,000

suppose we got kidnapped 250 miles from here by one, but that was a big publicity stunt.

179

00:11:19,000 --> 00:11:20,000

Right.

180

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:26,000

But, uh, supposedly, they don't come around this January or too much.

181

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:30,000

Okay, now, getting back to that first incident, was that on the Friday night, the night?

182

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:32,000

That was Thursday night, wasn't it?

183

00:11:32,000 --> 00:11:34,000

Was it Thursday night?

184

00:11:34,000 --> 00:11:36,000

Yes, it was Thursday night.

185

00:11:36,000 --> 00:11:39,000

Thursday night, about 11 o'clock, I would say.

186

00:11:39,000 --> 00:11:42,000

And, uh, nothing on Friday night?

187

00:11:42,000 --> 00:11:47,000

Well, we went out, we got piloters coming down, and we were about in the start.

188

00:11:47,000 --> 00:11:49,000

So we got to know what a barnacona is?

189

00:11:49,000 --> 00:11:50,000

No.

190

00:11:50,000 --> 00:11:53,000

Well, a barnacona is, it's what makes it, like a rabbit in distress.

191

00:11:53,000 --> 00:11:54,000

Oh.

192

00:11:54,000 --> 00:11:58,000

And so you just walk out into the woods, away, get you a nice rock and open spot,

193

00:11:58,000 --> 00:12:02,000

start blowing that rabbit collar, and those piloters come right into you, but there's a few feet.

194

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:04,000

And we was calling them.

195

00:12:04,000 --> 00:12:07,000

And we could hear them, they were baying, they were calling them, what they were doing,

196

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:09,000

they were calling the pack together to come in on it.

197

00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:12,000

And we could hear them calling, and then we were sitting there waiting for them,

198

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:16,000

and they were howling, they were going, maybe, they'd get blocked away.

199

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:17,000

And they were coming in.

200

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:22,000

Then we seen this light, and the coyotes stopped making noise, and they'd make another sound.

201

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:27,000

And just, just with dead, not a sound, we said, about two and a half to three hours.

202

00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:30,000

And not one came in, like one came out there right now.

203

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:34,000

Or I don't know about now, but usually I'd blow my rabbit, rabbit thing.

204

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:37,000

It's a close-by, what come I didn't do it to get that rabbit to eat.

205

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:41,000

Okay, now when that object came down, and you saw a settle down there,

206

00:12:41,000 --> 00:12:44,000

it's a settle down on top of a hill.

207

00:12:44,000 --> 00:12:48,000

Well, I live kind of on a hill, I live on the side of a hill.

208

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:52,000

And it looked like it sat down in the valley, it was a big reservoir over there.

209

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:54,000

It looked like it sat down by the reservoir.

210

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:58,000

Okay, now did it maintain its glowing condition while it was there, at all times?

211

00:12:58,000 --> 00:13:02,000

When it sat down on the ground, it went down below the tree line and went out.

212

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:04,000

And I didn't see it no more.

213

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:05,000

And you didn't see it take off?

214

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:06,000

No, I didn't.

215

00:13:06,000 --> 00:13:08,000

No, we took it for hours and watched it, and it never did take off.

216

00:13:08,000 --> 00:13:11,000

No, and then the second incident was last night?

217

00:13:11,000 --> 00:13:14,000

Oh, so the kid that was with me that night, before he saw something,

218

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:18,000

so he was putting it down, so we just kind of shined it out.

219

00:13:18,000 --> 00:13:20,000

But it could have been possible.

220

00:13:20,000 --> 00:13:23,000

Now we were about the world, before he saw something standing there by tree watching us.

221

00:13:23,000 --> 00:13:25,000

Kind of a white thing.

222

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:30,000

We bright passed it because we didn't, you know, he was pretty young, about 12 years old.

223

00:13:30,000 --> 00:13:31,000

Yes.

224

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:34,000

So we didn't pay much attention to it, now I don't know.

225

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:36,000

Now the second incident then occurred last night?

226

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:37,000

Yes, sir.

227

00:13:37,000 --> 00:13:38,000

Okay.

228

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:43,000

And you didn't see that object take off either?

229

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:44,000

No, sir.

230

00:13:44,000 --> 00:13:45,000

It came down in about the same area?

231

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:46,000

Yes, sir.

232

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:47,000

Okay.

233

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:48,000

Roughly in this engineering area.

234

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:49,000

Different pattern now.

235

00:13:49,000 --> 00:13:54,000

Okay, is there anything on the way of a big power plant, up your way?

236

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:57,000

Generating stations, hydroelectric dams?

237

00:13:57,000 --> 00:14:01,000

No, no hydroelectric dams, no big power stations.

238

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:04,000

There's one out there that's 50 miles from here.

239

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:05,000

Any military bases?

240

00:14:05,000 --> 00:14:08,000

Also, my neighbor across the street seen this thing last night too.

241

00:14:08,000 --> 00:14:10,000

But I called him and he said, you know, I saw that.

242

00:14:10,000 --> 00:14:12,000

I saw that come across the sky.

243

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:15,000

So I asked somebody else he saw it too.

244

00:14:17,000 --> 00:14:21,000

Because I called him because it looked like he was a man over by his nose.

245

00:14:21,000 --> 00:14:25,000

And he said, no, they saw it and went right on down to the sky.

246

00:14:28,000 --> 00:14:31,000

Because he was a big valley drop-off over here, the trees were big.

247

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:35,000
