And then almost a few seconds after that, my daughter, she's only 11,

But about a matter of three seconds, and his own mom said, I got an electrical shock.

29

And it was about 8 feet of the top of the size of our patio.

30

I don't think that's far up to about 8 feet.

So then he didn't see the standing lights, but she could see it.

48

She's like, just barely seen it.

49

And she disappeared so quickly.

Now when you say disappeared, did it move away?

51

Or did it just snap out?

52

No, it moved away.

She said it moved away because she said she could see a good twist to crack.
