My husband and two daughters saw the same thing I saw.

Okay, we'd like to hear about it.

7

We live south of Wenatchee near Malaga.

8

00:00:17,000 --> 00:00:18,000

Malaga.

9

00:00:18,000 --> 00:00:19,000

In the area.

10

00:00:19,000 --> 00:00:21,000

That's maybe you don't, but...

11

00:00:21,000 --> 00:00:24,000

And we saw something. We thought it was a star.

12

00:00:24,000 --> 00:00:28,000

We lived what they call a jump off where they have a big television antenna.

13

00:00:28,000 --> 00:00:31,000

You know, pull it in TV and reflect it.

14

00:00:31,000 --> 00:00:36,000

And we thought it moved just from behind a tree to behind another tree and all that.

15

00:00:36,000 --> 00:00:37,000

It just moved slow.

16

00:00:37,000 --> 00:00:39,000

And it looked just like a star.

17

00:00:39,000 --> 00:00:41,000

And I said, what star should move and funny, you know?

18

00:00:41,000 --> 00:00:46,000

And all at once it took off across the skylight above our house.

19

00:00:46,000 --> 00:00:50,000

And we heard no noise of airplane, you know, back noise.

20

00:00:50,000 --> 00:00:51,000

Yes.

21

00:00:51,000 --> 00:01:01,000

And it has been hovering every sense 20 minutes to 10 now over approximately the Rock Island Dam area.

22

00:01:01,000 --> 00:01:06,000

And all at once my husband was out there while I was calling the Sheriff's Department and the FAA,

23

00:01:06,000 --> 00:01:07,000

when we called over here.

24

00:01:07,000 --> 00:01:08,000

Yes.

25

00:01:08,000 --> 00:01:14,000

And they gave me your number, this...what?

26

00:01:14,000 --> 00:01:18,000

Center over here to call you and report to you.

27

00:01:18,000 --> 00:01:20,000

And I was calling them though.

28

00:01:20,000 --> 00:01:29,000

My husband saw another one that took south about from Pangborn area field, I mean Pangborn-Fathfield area.

29

00:01:29,000 --> 00:01:30,000

Yes.

30

00:01:30,000 --> 00:01:35,000

Took south directly south towards the mountains.

31

00:01:35,000 --> 00:01:36,000

Was this it?

32

00:01:36,000 --> 00:01:38,000

And they're both still hovering over here.

33

00:01:38,000 --> 00:01:42,000

I said, I feel dumb reporting anything like this, but it scared us.

34

00:01:42,000 --> 00:01:44,000

Which part of the sky is it hovering in now?

35

00:01:44,000 --> 00:01:48,000

Well, the one is hovering over the Rock Island Dam area.

36

00:01:48,000 --> 00:01:54,000

And the other one, of course, is probably real high, but the other one is hovering approximately over...

37

00:01:54,000 --> 00:01:56,000

We can just see it over the ridge of the mountain.

38

00:01:56,000 --> 00:01:59,000

And my husband and other daughters are standing out there now watching us.

39

00:01:59,000 --> 00:02:01,000

Are they watching this through binoculars by any chance?

40

00:02:01,000 --> 00:02:02,000

They had binoculars.

41

00:02:02,000 --> 00:02:06,000

And they could see red and green...they look like they're horrors.

42

00:02:06,000 --> 00:02:10,000

And they could see red and green lights going around and around, you know.

43

00:02:10,000 --> 00:02:14,000

But you saw both of these objects moving into that area?

44

00:02:14,000 --> 00:02:15,000

Yes.

45

00:02:15,000 --> 00:02:16,000

Okay.

46

00:02:16,000 --> 00:02:21,000

And my husband said he just...I don't think any jet planes could catch them as fast as they moved.

47

00:02:21,000 --> 00:02:26,000

Okay, are these similar objects in description?

48

00:02:26,000 --> 00:02:28,000

Yes, they just look like two stars.

49

00:02:28,000 --> 00:02:29,000

Two bright lights, no?

50

00:02:29,000 --> 00:02:30,000

Two bright stars.

51

00:02:30,000 --> 00:02:31,000

Okay.

52

00:02:31,000 --> 00:02:35,000

And with these red and green lights going around, and they look like they're horrors to the binoculars, you know.

53

00:02:35,000 --> 00:02:37,000

Of course, a binoculars aren't the night kind.

54

00:02:37,000 --> 00:02:38,000

Yes.

55

00:02:38,000 --> 00:02:39,000

And they can see them.

56

00:02:39,000 --> 00:02:41,000

They look like they're kind of horrors.

57

00:02:41,000 --> 00:02:42,000

Okay, but what's up?

58

00:02:42,000 --> 00:02:43,000

We hear no sound.

59

00:02:43,000 --> 00:02:44,000

Okay.

60

00:02:44,000 --> 00:02:46,000

What time did you spot the first one?

61

00:02:46,000 --> 00:02:48,000

The first one we spotted at 10 after 9.

62

00:02:48,000 --> 00:02:49,000

Uh-huh.

63

00:02:49,000 --> 00:02:53,000

And we were sitting at the yard, you know, it was just dark.

64

00:02:53,000 --> 00:02:56,000

And it's dusky dark, you know, and we first spotted, and I said,

65

my daughter and I said,

66

00:02:57,000 --> 00:02:59,000

didn't that have pretty stars between those two trees?

67

00:02:59,000 --> 00:03:02,000

Of course, we could see the ridge of the mountain behind our house.

68

00:03:02,000 --> 00:03:03,000

Yes.

69

00:03:03,000 --> 00:03:06,000

And the darn thing moved just very slowly there.

70

00:03:06,000 --> 00:03:10,000

And moved over, moved over, kept moving over, and then until about 29th of September,

71

and I kept time, you know, clock, time on the clock,

72

00:03:13,000 --> 00:03:18,000

29th of September, it took off, and it took across the sky just to fly towards Rock Island.

73

00:03:18,000 --> 00:03:20,000

And then it came to a stop over that area.

74

00:03:20,000 --> 00:03:21,000

And it came to a stop over there.

75

00:03:21,000 --> 00:03:23,000

It's been hovering over there ever since.

76

00:03:23,000 --> 00:03:27,000

Do you have any estimation as to the altitude that that object is hovering over the dam?

77

00:03:27,000 --> 00:03:28,000

I know.

78

00:03:28,000 --> 00:03:29,000

Gosh, no.

79

00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:30,000

Okay.

80

00:03:30,000 --> 00:03:32,000

It's a lot higher than any airplane, I think we've ever seen.

81

00:03:32,000 --> 00:03:33,000

I'm sorry, I'm so nervous.

82

00:03:33,000 --> 00:03:35,000

I'm about ready to die.

83

00:03:35,000 --> 00:03:39,000

I just want to report anything like this, but the guy there, the other telephone up here,

84

00:03:39,000 --> 00:03:40,000

the, what, FFA?

85

00:03:40,000 --> 00:03:41,000

Is that him?

86

00:03:41,000 --> 00:03:42,000

FFA, yes.

87

00:03:42,000 --> 00:03:44,000

He told me, he said, I would advise you to report.

88

00:03:44,000 --> 00:03:46,000

And I said, well I don't want to be laughed at.

89

00:03:46,000 --> 00:03:48,000

He said, you won't be.

90

00:03:48,000 --> 00:03:50,000

That's right, we take a lot of calls here.

91

00:03:50,000 --> 00:03:54,000

But I, like I said, he said, he was there, still out there.

92

00:03:54,000 --> 00:03:56,000

My husband and daughter's still out there.

93

00:03:56,000 --> 00:03:59,000

I don't know if you're going to spend a whole night out there watching it or not.

94

00:03:59,000 --> 00:04:02,000

And there are two other witnesses, your husband and your daughter, right?

95

00:04:02,000 --> 00:04:03,000

Three.

96

00:04:03,000 --> 00:04:04,000

My two daughters.

97

00:04:04,000 --> 00:04:06,000

Two daughters, okay.

98

00:04:06,000 --> 00:04:12,000

Okay, and they haven't moved since they came to the stationary position?

99

00:04:12,000 --> 00:04:19,000

Not, not for, well, now the one, it was about ten o'clock, plus three minutes till ten, I guess,

100

00:04:19,000 --> 00:04:22,000

when the one took off and went towards the south mountain.

101

00:04:22,000 --> 00:04:23,000

Uh-huh.

102

00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:27,000

You know, he said he didn't know where he came from all at once, it was just there and moving fast.

103

00:04:27,000 --> 00:04:31,000

But the other one was still in the same place because they was watching it all the time.

104

00:04:31,000 --> 00:04:34,000

And he had this other one, you know, went across this path.

105

00:04:34,000 --> 00:04:35,000

Yes.

106

00:04:35,000 --> 00:04:37,000

But it looks like it's covered, kind of.

107

00:04:37,000 --> 00:04:40,000

Well, from where we're at, it looks like it's over Rock Island, Van.

108

It possibly could be farther away than that, I don't know.

109

00:04:43,000 --> 00:04:48,000

Can you compare the size of those objects with anything that you would know of?

110

00:04:48,000 --> 00:04:50,000

Just the star.

111

00:04:50,000 --> 00:04:52,000

Just about the size of an ordinary star.

112

00:04:52,000 --> 00:04:56,000

Well, like, like you would look at Mars or something, you know, bigger stars.

113

00:04:56,000 --> 00:04:57,000

Uh-huh.

114

00:04:57,000 --> 00:04:58,000

Yeah.

115

00:04:58,000 --> 00:05:00,000

Are they pulsating by any chance?

116

00:05:00,000 --> 00:05:02,000

What do you mean, putting out light?

117

00:05:02,000 --> 00:05:06,000

I mean, just pulsating, the brightness pulsating or is it just changing color?

118

00:05:06,000 --> 00:05:08,000

No, they're pulsating and changing colors at the same time.

119

00:05:08,000 --> 00:05:10,000

Okay, what are the colors?

120

00:05:10,000 --> 00:05:11,000

Do you remember?

121

00:05:11,000 --> 00:05:12,000

Red and green.

122

00:05:12,000 --> 00:05:13,000

Red and green.

123

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:18,000

Red and green and then the pulsating color, you know, like, like, the white, like a star blink, you know.

124

00:05:18,000 --> 00:05:19,000

Yes.

125

00:05:19,000 --> 00:05:20,000

Or kind of twinkles.

126

00:05:20,000 --> 00:05:21,000

Yes.

127

00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:26,000

Okay, well, we'll see, we'll get on this and see if we can't come up with some kind of identification.

128

00:05:26,000 --> 00:05:29,000

And if we do, I will get back to you and let you know.

129

00:05:29,000 --> 00:05:34,000

And if we need additional information on this, could we feel free to call you back?

130

00:05:34,000 --> 00:05:38,000

My daughter says, when you look through the peduncers, it looks like it's spinning.

131

00:05:38,000 --> 00:05:40,000

Spinning, rotating, okay.

132

00:05:40,000 --> 00:05:41,000

I didn't understand what you were.

133

00:05:41,000 --> 00:05:45,000

I said she was talking to me here, she's, we're all upset.

134

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:46,000

Well, I can understand.

135

00:05:46,000 --> 00:05:48,000

Everybody else in that area seen it.

136

00:05:48,000 --> 00:05:54,000

Well, we sure appreciate this and if we do get anything on it, we'll get back to you and let you know.

137

00:05:54,000 --> 00:05:55,000

Okay, thank you.

138

00:05:55,000 --> 00:05:57,000

Thank you for calling for the UFO Reporting Center.

139

00:05:57,000 --> 00:05:58,000

Yes.

140

00:05:58,000 --> 00:06:02,000

And we're curious to know what happened to the two objects you were observing last night.

141

00:06:02,000 --> 00:06:08,000

Well, we watched them till, the one, until 1130.

142

00:06:08,000 --> 00:06:09,000

Uh-huh.

143

00:06:09,000 --> 00:06:15,000

And we decided, well, you know, he just kept moving, uh, easterly, in an eastern direction, you know.

144

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:16,000

Yes.

145

00:06:16,000 --> 00:06:21,000

And he just kept it smaller and smaller until when we finally quit watching 1130, it was just a pinpoint.

146

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:25,000

But about 11, 10, 10 is after 11.

147

00:06:25,000 --> 00:06:31,000

We kind of ran, of course, we have a large bear area.

148

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:39,000

And we saw another one going right, like from Pangborn Field again, in that direction, towards the

south, towards the mountains.

149

00:06:39,000 --> 00:06:42,000

Now the other one was still hanging and was still over there in the one area.

150

00:06:42,000 --> 00:06:43,000

Yes.

151

00:06:43,000 --> 00:06:47,000

So we went out around a bunch of trees we had there because it went behind our trees.

152

00:06:47,000 --> 00:06:51,000

We went around them and watched it, we didn't see it come back out.

153

00:06:51,000 --> 00:06:54,000

Now whether it took off somewhere else or whether it's still up there, of course we know.

154

00:06:54,000 --> 00:06:55,000

Uh-huh.

155

00:06:55,000 --> 00:07:00,000

But then at 20 minutes, if we sit and watch them about 10 minutes, watch for it, you know, kept looking.

156

00:07:00,000 --> 00:07:13,000

At 20 minutes after 11, again from the jump off ridge, that way, if you know, if you know the area, going north, in the north-easterly,

157

00:07:13,000 --> 00:07:18,000

direction, was another one and it was really moving and it was really high.

158

00:07:18,000 --> 00:07:21,000

And it disappeared, it just plain disappeared.

159

00:07:21,000 --> 00:07:29,000

I mean, just from where we live, it just completely disappeared in the northeast direction.

160

00:07:29,000 --> 00:07:30,000

I see.

161

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:36,000

So actually, I mean, we don't know whether we saw three or four.

162

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:37,000

You know what I mean?

163

00:07:37,000 --> 00:07:38,000

Yes.

164

00:07:38,000 --> 00:07:45,000

So whether they were this one that we saw take off and go in that northeast direction, the last one at 11-10, 11-20,

165

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:48,000

was the one that we saw at 11-20 or not.

166

00:07:48,000 --> 00:07:53,000

Whether it took off and went down around in a circle and made a circle or not.

167

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:54,000

It still bothers us.

168

00:07:54,000 --> 00:07:59,000

We feel kind of silly about saying anything about it, but we wonder if anyone else saw it.

169

00:07:59,000 --> 00:08:03,000

Well, we haven't had any additional calls, of course that doesn't mean other people didn't watch it either.

170

00:08:03,000 --> 00:08:04,000

Yeah.

171

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:08,000

Well, that's the way I called the Sheriff's office this morning and they said one of the sheriffs had went down

172

00:08:08,000 --> 00:08:14,000

and in the mallic area they said and looked for it, but he didn't spot anything.

173

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:22,000

We stood there last night now from what I called you till 11-30, we stood in our backyard,

174

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:28,000

whichever you want to call it, and watched that because we were kind of up towards the mountain by ourselves.

175

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Yes.

176

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:30,000

And we stood there and we watched it.

177

00:08:30,000 --> 00:08:33,000

My husband took a scope on his rifle and watched it.

178

00:08:33,000 --> 00:08:40,000

He said it was, you could see that red light, you know, blinking on it.

179

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:41,000

Yes.

180

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:46,000

He said it went through the scope on the rifle, it looked like it was whirling, you know,

181

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:53,000

and every once in a while you'd see it take a spur of and go off in kind of an angle away from its original path.

182

00:08:53,000 --> 00:08:54,000

It's scary.

183

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:56,000

Don't kid yourself.

184

00:08:56,000 --> 00:09:01,000

I mean, well, I mean, it's not really scary, but it's sound stupid, don't it?

185

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:03,000

I mean, we're something like that and wonder what in the world it was.

186

00:09:03,000 --> 00:09:05,000

We know it wasn't airplane because we heard no noise at all.

187

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:09,000

And generally we get this back, what do we call it, the noise after the jets have went over.

188

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:10,000

Right.

189

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:13,000

I mean, they can still be over our house, but we still get it.

190

00:09:13,000 --> 00:09:20,000

We don't, we have no traffic problems where we can, you know, that we interfere with the hearing of it,

191

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:21,000

if you know what I mean.

192

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:22,000

Yes.

193

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:27,000

Because we live back far enough away from the mallic and Alcoa Highway that we hear the traffic,

194

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:29,000

but we don't, we aren't really...

195

00:09:29,000 --> 00:09:36,000

So the one was hovering over the dam for about a half an hour and was that other one, that second one, still in the area at the time?

196

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:38,000

We don't, well, yeah.

197

00:09:38,000 --> 00:09:47,000

When it was still hovering over the dam during that half hour, the one that my husband and my daughter, oldest daughter saw came from, like I said, the Pangborn Field area.

198

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:48,000

Yes.

199

00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:50,000

Right straight over and went to the south.

200

00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:55,000

And it hung over the mountain south of the, south of it here.

201

00:09:55,000 --> 00:10:01,000

If you were here and I could show you, I mean, it would be better explained because if you don't know the area, I mean, if you don't know where I'm at,

202

00:10:01,000 --> 00:10:02,000

right.

203

00:10:02,000 --> 00:10:03,000

It's hard to explain.

204

00:10:03,000 --> 00:10:11,000

But it hung down on kind of on the, where we could see it, which would be, to us, would be just right on the horizon of the mountain, you know.

205

00:10:11,000 --> 00:10:12,000

Right.

206

00:10:12,000 --> 00:10:18,000

Or, I mean, from where we could see it, it looked like it was about six or eight foot above the mountain, but still, it was probably farther away than that, you know what I mean.

207

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:19,000

Okay.

208

00:10:19,000 --> 00:10:22,000

Now, we have nine tens at the time of the first sighting.

209

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:25,000

What time did that second object come in?

210

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:28,000

That probably was about nine twenty.

211

00:10:28,000 --> 00:10:29,000

Okay.

212

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:32,000

But see the first one, we watched over the jump off.

213

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:36,000

I told you, it took off and started hovering at the dam at nine tenths.

214

00:10:36,000 --> 00:10:40,000

But we watched it from ten minutes to nine up on the jump off area.

215

00:10:40,000 --> 00:10:41,000

Okay.

216

00:10:41,000 --> 00:10:43,000

We watched the dead moving around.

217

00:10:43,000 --> 00:10:46,000

It kind of moved in a, well, we saw it between trees.

218

00:10:46,000 --> 00:10:50,000

When my daughter came up, we'd taken my phone to show last night, but we had company nights.

219

00:10:50,000 --> 00:10:51,000

It's not an alarm.

220

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:53,000

I might have to sign on the news, girlfriend was out.

221

00:10:53,000 --> 00:10:58,000

And we were just sitting out in the backyard and she had wanted to go show her to come out and she said, mama, are we going to get to go?

222

00:10:58,000 --> 00:11:00,000

And I said, I don't think so.

223

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:02,000

And because it's too late, I said, what time is it?

224

00:11:02,000 --> 00:11:04,000

She says, it's about 10 to nine now.

225

00:11:04,000 --> 00:11:06,000

And I said, looking here, right, what I've been watching.

226

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:08,000

I said, isn't that a pretty star up there?

227

00:11:08,000 --> 00:11:09,000

You know, I said, look how it's blinking.

228

00:11:09,000 --> 00:11:12,000

Between these two trees, these two big pine trees up on the hill.

229

00:11:12,000 --> 00:11:15,000

And she watched it and she said, where to go to?

230

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:16,000

I said, I don't know.

231

00:11:16,000 --> 00:11:20,000

And I kept watching and then here it was, it came again between two more trees.

232

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:21,000

And I said, my guys, look at that.

233

00:11:21,000 --> 00:11:23,000

That star moved over.

234

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:25,000

And then we all got to watch it.

235

00:11:25,000 --> 00:11:26,000

You sat there and watched it.

236

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:27,000

You know, thought that's odd.

237

00:11:27,000 --> 00:11:28,000

No star moves like that.

238

00:11:28,000 --> 00:11:30,000

And then it moved between two more trees.

239

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:31,000

You know what I mean?

240

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:37,000

You could see it moving on a, well, away from its original position.

241

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:39,000

Now that was about 10 minutes till night.

242

00:11:39,000 --> 00:11:42,000

So my son and his girlfriend got ready and they left.

243

00:11:42,000 --> 00:11:44,000

And that's about nine.

244

00:11:44,000 --> 00:11:46,000

And he says, after what time?

245

00:11:46,000 --> 00:11:47,000

She's about nine o'clock.

246

00:11:47,000 --> 00:11:48,000

He said, we better be going.

247

00:11:48,000 --> 00:11:49,000

So they got up and they left.

248

00:11:49,000 --> 00:11:53,000

And then we sat there and just, you know, that's odd thing because it kept moving.

249

00:11:53,000 --> 00:11:56,000

And then, but then we were fascinated by it.

250

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:59,000

And about 10 minutes after nine, why?

251

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:02,000

It flipped right over our house.

252

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:05,000

Over our, you know, where we could really see it real plane.

253

00:12:05,000 --> 00:12:09,000

And then I told, I said, I'm going to go call somebody.

254

00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:12,000

Because I saw one years, years, years ago and everybody in the country laughed at me.

255

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:16,000

I thought I saw one and three or four people here when I saw it too, evidently.

256

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:19,000

And of course, like I said, one guy, he was quite a drinker.

257

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:20,000

And they said, oh, he was seeing it.

258

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:22,000

And you know, he was kind of seeing things.

259

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:24,000

And I thought, why should I not tell anyone that I saw it either?

260

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

Because they'd rather tell me a drink or two.

261

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:28,000

But I don't get it by everything.

262

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:30,000

I'm going to report it.

263

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:32,000

So last night I came in and I reported.

264

00:12:32,000 --> 00:12:34,000

I had a heck of a hard time finding anyone to listen to me.

265

00:12:34,000 --> 00:12:36,000

Did you originally call the Sheriff's Department?

266

00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:38,000

I called the Sheriff's Department.

267

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:41,000

And I called the airport over here, Panggwork few, but I couldn't get them.

268

00:12:41,000 --> 00:12:47,000

So I called this FSAA number.

269

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:50,000

And he gave me your number to call.

270

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:51,000

The Sheriff's Department.

271

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:52,000

What in the world is it?

272

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:53,000

Uh-huh.

273
