It looked like it kind of disappeared, kind of exploded into a hill just behind the hardware

store, a big hill.

9

I mean, from vision, you know, how the vision things look, it looked like the size of a

10

fist, but of course it would have been a lot bigger, a big object.

11

I don't believe that you have phones, but I just called the sheriff's department and

12

they said that there was a lady on the phone right now that it seemed the exact same thing

13

that I'd seen.

14

00:00:58,960 --> 00:01:05,120

You know, you're not seeing meteors, they kind of light up the whole sky.

15

It just didn't, and I could tell it wasn't way out there in space.

16

It was right here in Penn Valley, you know, and it apparently landed in a hill behind

17

the hardware store.

18

Okay, what color was it?

19

What color?

20

00:01:20,200 --> 00:01:21,200

Right.

21

It looked so quick, you know, like I'm trying to just recap how it was, but the ball itself

22

looked to me to be kind of a goldish color and the tail appeared to be kind of a, maybe,

23

I know it had blue in it, you know, it was a long, a bright thing, you know, it looked

24

real pretty, you know.

25

00:01:40,080 --> 00:01:45,080

It's like my first impression, it looked like some kind of a fireworks, but when I saw it,

26

you know, I knew that that wasn't what it was and that it was as big as that and it

27

00:01:51,400 --> 00:01:57,600

wasn't real sparky, you know, it looked more just like a tail, you know.

28

Yes, what was the direction of flight?

29

00:02:00,040 --> 00:02:05,520

Well, I've only lived out here since March and 1st in Texas and I'm kind of still turned

30

around, but let me see if I can get my bearings straight.

Okay.

To me, it looked like it was going kind of, okay, now I live in Penn Valley, it looked

33

like it was going towards Grass Valley and Grass Valley is north of here, so I'd say

34

it was going kind of northwest.

35

Okay.

36

Now, was this coming in at an angle or was it coming straight down?

37

No, it was going, it wasn't going straight down to the ground, it was going, I'd say,

what do you say, vertical?

39

00:02:39,480 --> 00:02:45,760

I mean, it wasn't going straight up now, but you know, it was going at an angle.

40

Just angling in, you know, okay.

41

But it wasn't a sharp angle.

42

Right, okay.

43

You know, it was more, it was not horizontal but vertical.

44

Did you hear any sound associated with this?

45

We had the windows up in the car.

46

We were talking at the time and I didn't hear anything.

47

Okay.

Did you hear your radio on in the car?

49

No, we were just talking.

50

Okay.

And then we started it.

52

But what time did that happen?

53

Okay, right now it's 1131, I'd say it was about 01110, something like that.

And that was you and your wife were witness to that.

And then it exploded like a Roman candle and it then went vertical right down to the earth.

And then began to extinguish as it went down.

66

Okay, sir.

And then back on this we got three or four other lines going.

68

Okay, we'll get back to you in a few minutes.

69

Okay, thank you.

Thank you for holding, sir.

71

It looks like we're going to get a lot of reports from on that thing.

One person called, said, a woman here near Jackson, said she thought she seemed like a

flying object and then the flash.

Uh-huh.

I seen the flash and I, of course, I was kind of downtown and hell, our phone is just lightin'

Well, apparently it lit up an area of 60-hundred miles in diameter.

Where's Swamp with Calls?

119

You are too.

Do you have any idea what it is?

121

A tentative identification meteor fireball.

122

Fine, thank you very much.

123

You're welcome.

124

I don't know what I saw.

125

00:06:04,200 --> 00:06:07,200

UFO, I just saw something burning in the sky tonight.

126

Uh-huh.

127

00:06:08,200 --> 00:06:10,200

And did you get any other calls about it?

128

00:06:10,200 --> 00:06:11,200

Yes, sir.

129

00:06:11,200 --> 00:06:12,200

Where are you located?

130

00:06:12,200 --> 00:06:13,200

Uh, Pleasanton, California.

131

00:06:13,200 --> 00:06:15,200

Did you get a lot of calls about it?

132

00:06:15,200 --> 00:06:17,200

Yes, with what it was called.

133

00:06:17,200 --> 00:06:19,200

And just the California area?

134

Right.

135

Okay, thank you very much.

136

You're welcome.

And what's your name?

139

And we thought we saw a plane crash.

146

Okay, could you hold for one moment, please?

147

Oh, they saw it too, huh?

149

00:06:43,200 --> 00:06:44,200

A lot of people.

150

Really?

151

Right.

152

It was always strange.

153

How big of an area was it seen?

154

It was over the Southwest.

155

Oh, you're kidding.

156

My goodness.

157

But it wasn't any Marsman or anything else?

158

We feel that the tentative identification would be a meteor fireball.

159

I see.

160

Okay.

161

00:07:05,200 --> 00:07:06,200

Okay, thank you.

162

00:07:06,200 --> 00:07:07,200

You're welcome.

163

Bye-bye.

164

This is Cuddling the Police Department in County.

165

00:07:09,200 --> 00:07:10,200

Yes, sir.

166

00:07:10,200 --> 00:07:16,200

Have you had any reports of anything strange, I guess, would be in the San Francisco area?

167

00:07:16,200 --> 00:07:20,200

Yes, we've had calls clear South to San Diego.

168

00:07:20,200 --> 00:07:23,200

And inland about 100 miles.

169

00:07:23,200 --> 00:07:24,200

Yeah.

170

00:07:24,200 --> 00:07:25,200

Well, I was outside.

171

00:07:25,200 --> 00:07:27,200

We've had several calls up here too.

172

00:07:27,200 --> 00:07:29,200

And I saw it out there.

173

00:07:29,200 --> 00:07:32,200

I've seen Cuddling Stars, but this was big.

174

00:07:32,200 --> 00:07:34,200

So I didn't know what it was.

175

00:07:34,200 --> 00:07:37,200

And I thought I might as well see if anybody else had called on it.

176

00:07:37,200 --> 00:07:39,200

Did you get any sound off of that explosion?

177

00:07:39,200 --> 00:07:41,200

I didn't even hear an explosion.

178

00:07:41,200 --> 00:07:45,200

We were about 35 miles north.

179

00:07:45,200 --> 00:07:48,200

We're about 50 miles north of San Francisco.

180

00:07:48,200 --> 00:07:49,200

Right.

181

00:07:49,200 --> 00:07:52,200

I was facing south when I saw it.

182

00:07:52,200 --> 00:07:53,200

And it was really fast.

183

00:07:53,200 --> 00:07:57,200

And like normal shooting stars, and I've seen her following stars, I'll be calling them.

184

00:07:57,200 --> 00:07:59,200

They kind of go for a while.

185

00:07:59,200 --> 00:08:02,200

This thing here was just for maybe a second.

186

00:08:02,200 --> 00:08:07,200

And it had a lot of real bright orange sparks behind it.

187

00:08:07,200 --> 00:08:12,200

And the more I was sitting in relationship, it was as big as the moon to me.

188

00:08:12,200 --> 00:08:20,200

And it was kind of a greenish white, I guess, with this orange tail.

189

00:08:20,200 --> 00:08:24,200

And then it went down behind where we could see.

190

00:08:24,200 --> 00:08:27,200

And then it led up the whole sky kind of whitish blue.

191

00:08:27,200 --> 00:08:34,200

In fact, when I saw it, I thought somebody had shot a fireworks or something just here in town.

192

00:08:34,200 --> 00:08:37,200

But then some other people said it was south of town.

193

00:08:37,200 --> 00:08:39,200

So I thought it would be cool anyway.

194

00:08:39,200 --> 00:08:41,200

I can think it was about 11, 25.

195

00:08:41,200 --> 00:08:42,200

Right.

196

00:08:42,200 --> 00:08:43,200

Okay.

197

00:08:43,200 --> 00:08:47,200

Our tentative identification on this is a meteor fireball of some kind, but that's not definite.

198

00:08:47,200 --> 00:08:48,200

Yeah.

199

00:08:48,200 --> 00:08:49,200

Okay.

200

00:08:49,200 --> 00:08:50,200

Well, I appreciate your information anyway.

201

00:08:50,200 --> 00:08:51,200

Okay.

202

00:08:51,200 --> 00:08:52,200

Thank you.

203

00:08:52,200 --> 00:08:53,200

Bye-bye.

204

00:08:53,200 --> 00:08:54,200

You're aboard boarding, sir.

205

00:08:54,200 --> 00:08:55,200

Is this the right course?

206

00:08:55,200 --> 00:08:57,200

Are you prior flight service stations?

207

00:08:57,200 --> 00:08:58,200

Yes.

208

00:08:58,200 --> 00:08:59,200

Hello?

209

Yes.

210

Are you familiar with where we are here?

211

Yes, sir.

212

Okay.

We're getting lots of UFO-type reports.

214

00:09:05,200 --> 00:09:09,200

Actually, they don't say that, but they say balls with green light.

215

00:09:09,200 --> 00:09:14,200

And one fellow was looking right up to the west of Ukiah here.

216

00:09:14,200 --> 00:09:20,200

He saw a red and green and white flashing object in the sky, not moving it up, up, and down.

217

00:09:20,200 --> 00:09:21,200

Uh-huh.

218

00:09:21,200 --> 00:09:25,200

We saw a great big flash of light was reported by several different people, including the

219

00:09:25,200 --> 00:09:30,200

police and ILA patrol, just to the east of Ukiah here.

220

00:09:30,200 --> 00:09:37,200

And I called the Sheriff's Department and they said they'd been having reports all over California.

221

00:09:37,200 --> 00:09:39,200

And I got another call just after that.

222

00:09:39,200 --> 00:09:42,200

It was the first period I spent a row in there.

223

00:09:42,200 --> 00:09:47,200

They said that there was a fellow called and reported three such objects out around

224

00:09:47,200 --> 00:09:51,200

Mount Santa Monica in the area, just to the northeast of them.

225

00:09:51,200 --> 00:09:52,200

Uh-huh.

226

00:09:52,200 --> 00:09:57,200

Okay, we're getting calls from as far south as San Diego and probably 75 to 100 miles

227

00:09:57,200 --> 00:09:58,200

inland.

228

00:09:58,200 --> 00:10:02,200

I don't know of any special military operations or anything going on, or something like that.

229

00:10:02,200 --> 00:10:05,200

Is there any U-shells expected in the area?

230

00:10:05,200 --> 00:10:11,200

No, not really, but from the descriptions we have a tentative of a navigation of a meteor

231

00:10:11,200 --> 00:10:15,200

fireball, although on the explosion there was no sound, which is very unusual.

232

00:10:15,200 --> 00:10:21,200

Well, there's nothing more than one, because these things are coming in at different times

233

00:10:21,200 --> 00:10:22,200

at a different place.

234

00:10:22,200 --> 00:10:23,200

Right.

235

00:10:23,200 --> 00:10:28,200

And I'm really interested in the one that the guy was looking at and watching that was

236

00:10:28,200 --> 00:10:29,200

doing anything.

237

00:10:29,200 --> 00:10:30,200

Uh-huh.

238

00:10:30,200 --> 00:10:35,200

So, he saw something just coming in to relieve me, so he saw what looked like a fake fireball

239

00:10:35,200 --> 00:10:38,200

that went down, but he didn't see anything.

240

00:10:38,200 --> 00:10:39,200

Uh-huh.

241

00:10:39,200 --> 00:10:42,200

So, anyway, I'm glad I had my two discs worth there.

242

00:10:42,200 --> 00:10:43,200

Thanks very much.

243

00:10:43,200 --> 00:10:44,200

Okay.

244

00:10:44,200 --> 00:10:45,200

Right.

245

00:10:45,200 --> 00:10:46,200

Thank you.

246

00:10:46,200 --> 00:10:55,200

I just observed a big flash outside of my house, and let's see, three minutes after I

247

00:10:55,200 --> 00:10:59,200

observed the flash, I walked back inside with some other friends of mine.

248

00:10:59,200 --> 00:11:00,200

Uh-huh.

249

00:11:00,200 --> 00:11:05,200

And observed a big bone, like my whole house.

250

00:11:05,200 --> 00:11:09,200

It was like a sonic bone, where the house starts shaking.

251

00:11:09,200 --> 00:11:10,200

Where are you living?

252

00:11:10,200 --> 00:11:11,200

Chiropractor.

253

00:11:11,200 --> 00:11:12,200

Chiropractor, okay.

254

00:11:12,200 --> 00:11:15,200

It was like a breathing flash.

255

00:11:15,200 --> 00:11:19,200

It lasted at least two to three seconds.

256

00:11:19,200 --> 00:11:24,200

Long enough for me to look at the guy that was looking at it out of the window and then

257

00:11:24,200 --> 00:11:26,200

look at the flash myself out of the window.

258

00:11:26,200 --> 00:11:29,200

Did you see the object that's south-corn across the sky?

259

00:11:29,200 --> 00:11:30,200

No.

260

00:11:30,200 --> 00:11:34,200

It wasn't like a streak, but it was a spark or something.

261

00:11:34,200 --> 00:11:35,200

Okay.

262

00:11:35,200 --> 00:11:43,200

The streak, how in the sky, what was it in relation to directly overhead to you?

263

00:11:43,200 --> 00:11:49,200

It wasn't even, well, how far up do you think it was?

264

00:11:49,200 --> 00:11:52,200

We can't look to.

265

00:11:52,200 --> 00:11:55,200

Is this right or not?

266

00:11:55,200 --> 00:11:58,200

Like a four, five-story building.

267

00:11:58,200 --> 00:12:00,200

Okay, what I mean is, was this overhead?

268

00:12:00,200 --> 00:12:01,200

Did it pass overhead?

269

00:12:01,200 --> 00:12:02,200

No.

270

00:12:02,200 --> 00:12:07,200

Okay, looking out of my window, I would say it was like someone would throw something

271

00:12:07,200 --> 00:12:10,200

out of a four or five-story building.

272

00:12:10,200 --> 00:12:11,200

I see, okay.

273

00:12:11,200 --> 00:12:14,200

No clouds in the sky.

274

00:12:14,200 --> 00:12:15,200

Okay.

275

00:12:15,200 --> 00:12:17,200

You know, I call it week's apartment until the morning.

276

00:12:17,200 --> 00:12:19,200

Well, maybe it's raining.

277

00:12:19,200 --> 00:12:20,200

Okay.

278

00:12:20,200 --> 00:12:21,200

There are no clouds in the sky.

279

00:12:21,200 --> 00:12:23,200

He said he saw it also.

280

00:12:23,200 --> 00:12:24,200

Right.

281

00:12:24,200 --> 00:12:29,200

We're getting calls from Northern California to San Diego and about 100 miles inland.

282

00:12:29,200 --> 00:12:33,200

And the tentative identification on this so far is a meteor fireball.

283

00:12:33,200 --> 00:12:34,200

A meteor fireball?

284

00:12:34,200 --> 00:12:37,200

Which exploded upon entering the atmosphere.

285

00:12:37,200 --> 00:12:40,200

That's just tentative, not definite.

286

00:12:40,200 --> 00:12:41,200

Oh, it's tentative.

287

00:12:41,200 --> 00:12:42,200

Right.

288

00:12:42,200 --> 00:12:44,200

A meteor fireball that fired off where?

289

00:12:44,200 --> 00:12:47,200

To explode it after it entered the atmosphere.

290

00:12:47,200 --> 00:12:49,200

Oh, it exploded after it entered the atmosphere.

291

00:12:49,200 --> 00:12:50,200

Right.

292

00:12:50,200 --> 00:12:52,200

But that was pretty heavy, man.

293

00:12:52,200 --> 00:12:53,200

Yes.

294

00:12:53,200 --> 00:12:58,200

Well, a lot of spectacular sightings are being described to us tonight.

295

FAAF tool said they thought it might be a reentry vehicle from the tons of space hardware

369

that floats around the air.

Perhaps the best explanations came from the veteran airline pilot Hugh Williams who spotted

371

00:16:41,200 --> 00:16:46,200

the object as he was parking his car near the intersection of Boken and the Sonic streets

372

00:16:46,200 --> 00:16:47,200

here in the city.

373

00:16:47,200 --> 00:16:54,200

Williams, 46, and a pilot for the last 25 years, said, quote, it came in from the southwest

374

00:16:54,200 --> 00:17:01,200

at about 2,000 feet altitude, going between 6,000 and 8,000 miles an hour at an angle

375

00:17:01,200 --> 00:17:02,200

of about 60 degrees.

376

00:17:02,200 --> 00:17:08,200

The mass of the object was huge, Williams said, estimating that it could have been as much

377

00:17:08,200 --> 00:17:12,200

as 500 feet long, about the size of a dirigible or a blimp.

378

00:17:12,200 --> 00:17:15,200

Williams said the object was sheathed in white flame.

379

00:17:15,200 --> 00:17:20,200

When it came over him, he said it burst into an explosion of red flashing and then turned

380

00:17:20,200 --> 00:17:25,200

into a greenish copper flame and finally into a green blaze.

381

Williams said it was the biggest meteor I've seen in my professional career and I guarantee

382

00:17:30,200 --> 00:17:34,200

you that had hit the ground a lot of people would have known about it.

383

00:17:34,200 --> 00:17:39,200

An air controller at San Francisco International Airport said it was by far the biggest thing

384

00:17:39,200 --> 00:17:41,200

I've seen coming in like that.

385

00:17:41,200 --> 00:17:46,200

The object was spotted by Steve Rector, an 18-year-old college of Marin student.

386

00:17:46,200 --> 00:17:50,200

He spotted it from a park near his home in San Rafael.

387

00:17:50,200 --> 00:17:52,200

I saw a big flash of lightning.

388

00:17:52,200 --> 00:17:56,200

Rector said it was just like flashed cord, like lightning in the sky.

389

00:17:56,200 --> 00:18:01,200

The coast guard said they had not yet dispatched vessels to see if they could find the object.

390

00:18:01,200 --> 00:18:07,200

But now they had telephone calls reporting the sky striker from the Vede Gabbay to Monterey.

391

Okay, beautiful.

392

Okay, you want me to add anything to that?

393

00:18:12,200 --> 00:18:13,200

If you'd like.

394

395

And the only party that we've talked to so far to report any sound was in Turlock, which

396

You said sound.

398

They heard noise in Turlock.

399

Yes, a tremendous explosion which he said shook his house.

400

Wow.

401

And now that's the only report we've got so far of an explosion which would indicate something

402

had disintegrated within the atmosphere.

403

Did anybody actually see this thing hit the bay?

404

No, that's really not clear on where it's gone.

That came from Penn Valley.

435

and disintegration east of this year in Nevada.

436

00:20:22,200 --> 00:20:25,200

So it all depends on where the individual was at.

437

He's going to be looking at it from a different angle and they're going to give different descriptions.

438

Do you think it might have been disintegration instead of hitting the water?

439

00:20:33,200 --> 00:20:36,200

That's the thing that hit the San Francisco Bay.

440

00:20:36,200 --> 00:20:39,200

Everybody in the Bay Area would have known about it.

441

00:20:39,200 --> 00:20:42,200

Can you talk to a reporter on this for a second?

442

Sure.

443

Yeah, here.

Which entered the atmosphere, apparently over the San Francisco Bay Area and exploded.

534

Well, we're not too sure of the altitude, but we're getting kind of a scramble of reports

535

right now.

536

We haven't been able to get the puzzle put together.

537

Well, we were sure it's a meteor fireball or something.

538

That's what I thought it was, but there's no place I could call.

719

739

Yeah.

741

Okay, and my uncle's records are that good.

742

So, when I was looking out, the Webster Street side of the Blue Cross building,

743

whichever way Webster Street runs, is roughly the same way that the UFO thing was going.

And it looked like, have you ever been in an open?

755

and you know, it could have crossed my vision,

and it looked like it disappeared behind those hills.

761

That's where, there was a light plane crossing beyond, you know, I can catch a valley.

762

00:34:51,200 --> 00:34:52,200

Right.

763

00:34:52,200 --> 00:34:55,200

That's what it looked like to me, but then my next to a neighbor in Mantica said,

764

00:34:55,200 --> 00:35:01,200

he saw something that looked like a lightning, you know, about the same time,

765

00:35:01,200 --> 00:35:04,200

and that's 70 miles away from where I work.

766

00:35:04,200 --> 00:35:08,200

Right, we had quite a few reports of a brilliant flash in this guy.

767

00:35:08,200 --> 00:35:09,200

This was a flash.

768

00:35:09,200 --> 00:35:14,200

This is Google yellowish orange plane, and it looked like,

769

00:35:14,200 --> 00:35:17,200

as large as the private plane, three or four yards away,

770

00:35:17,200 --> 00:35:20,200

but it looked like a cigar cut off at one end,

771

00:35:20,200 --> 00:35:23,200

and then it had just dug on a stripe at about a 45 degree angle,

772

00:35:23,200 --> 00:35:29,200

going, you know, going back,

773

00:35:29,200 --> 00:35:34,200

that way from top to bottom, it was slanted from the top to the bottom.

774

00:35:34,200 --> 00:35:36,200

I'm not being clear, am I?

775

00:35:36,200 --> 00:35:41,200

Anyway, it was a flash, you know,

776

00:35:41,200 --> 00:35:49,200

like if you took a rectangle and drew a line from the top side to the bottom side,

777

00:35:49,200 --> 00:35:58,200

then as you face that rectangle, the angle to your left would be the obtuse angle,

778

00:35:58,200 --> 00:36:01,200

and the angle to your right on the top would be the acute angle,

779

00:36:01,200 --> 00:36:02,200

the smaller the angle is,

780

00:36:02,200 --> 00:36:05,200

and on the bottom would be just the opposite,

781

00:36:05,200 --> 00:36:07,200

the angle on your left would be less than 90,

782

00:36:07,200 --> 00:36:09,200

and the angle on your right would be more than 90,

783

00:36:09,200 --> 00:36:12,200

and the obtuse angle would be the big one.

784

00:36:12,200 --> 00:36:17,200

We had one pilot describe that thing as being almost 500 feet long,

785

00:36:17,200 --> 00:36:19,200

what would be your opinion?

786

00:36:19,200 --> 00:36:21,200

I wouldn't know where, like I say,

787

00:36:21,200 --> 00:36:25,200

I'm standing left to the street, and it looked like to me like it was about four or five hundred yards away,

788

00:36:25,200 --> 00:36:27,200

and it looked like it was bigger than a private plane.

789

00:36:27,200 --> 00:36:29,200

Now, where it was at in relation to that,

790

00:36:29,200 --> 00:36:35,200

I had no way of knowing it, it looked to me like a private plane about three or four hundred yards away,

791

00:36:35,200 --> 00:36:38,200

so I would say, you know, like this, that big,

792

00:36:38,200 --> 00:36:41,200

but I am not very clear on the distance.

793

00:36:41,200 --> 00:36:44,200

Well, if we get any definite answers on this,

794

00:36:44,200 --> 00:36:46,200

why we'll get back to you and let you know.

795

00:36:46,200 --> 00:36:50,200

Okay, because no way was in the media, like the paper says, no way, no way.

796
