Could you estimate that size by comparing it with something?

They just had a big flare in the sky, about four or five of them.

And I think it's a meteor shower. It's just outside and it looks.

But we're getting calls on them and everything.

Which city was this?

65

Mount Tomine Hill.

66

It's a big one. It lit up the sky.

68

It might have been an old satellite or something, you know, re-entry,

69

but it had long streaming and everything on it. People are calling.

70

Okay, we'll get back to you soon as we give an ID on it if we do.

When we first came in, we thought they were falling stars or meteors.

I've seen one.

139

I thought it was a meteor, but there were three of them coming through and three right behind us.

Okay.

Which direction were you looking at the time?

142

We were looking north-east, kind of north-east when we first came in.

143

We watched them and they went across beyond the valley going north to south.

145

We watched them go across and we could just see the tail of them because they went through the cloud cover and then down to the south.

I could see the tail of one of them just went out of sight through the cloud.

147

They told Hill Air Force Base and they fell out there so that they had some other calls in there.

148

He said to call the Ogden Police Department.

149

I called there because they were supposed to have a line.

I guess it was you or something.

151

I called there and they said they hadn't had anybody else report it.

I don't know if it's fancated with anybody else or not.

We're getting calls from our east, Missola, Montana, South Lake City, Utah.

Possibly, yes.

Northwest to southeast is general.

180

It's people down in Utah are reporting multiple objects up to 40, so I don't know what we've got going.

We are traveling in a northwestern way to southeastern way.

to the south, a little to our east, and they were really high and going just really fast.

213

Did I tell you anything?

There's about 15 guys just getting off work, and they show up to this.

268

Okay.

Which direction is that going?

270

Well, it was heading almost due south from us.

271

It was headed to south and to the east.

272

It was almost as if it looked like it was going to go right over Moscow from here.

273

And what kind of Idaho was that?

274

It's kind of...

Well, we're just in the high where the Panhandle Starks North.

Uh, we were driving over, um, a place called Tharding Canyon on the way up here,

that was tracked in by radar,

648

and scheduled to come in at that time.

649

Uh-huh.

650

00:28:10,300 --> 00:28:16,300

And we had calls from, uh, all Idaho, Montana, Utah, Washington.

651

So a lot of people saw it.

652

I had asked definitely where it was.

653

Okay, so there were re-entry of the Soviet rocket body.

654

Uh-huh.

Okay.

Thanks very much for the call anyway.

So, uh, I was on the plane tonight about 1110.

661

And about 1110, I went up to get in my car,

668

and I turned towards the east.

669

Here in Ogden, and, um, okay, there was kind of cloudy here in patches,

Clear and cloudy.

673

674

North is just a little, you know, there's towns,

675

but it's just a little bit north.

I could see some lights coming through the clouds, you know.

677

And when it comes to a clear patch, you know,

678

the mountains behind, it was like, um, I don't know how to explain,

like, um, okay, like when the fourth of July,

and they shoot off the firecrackers,

682

and they explode, and then some just go out like with tails.

Okay, I saw about 10 of them, though.

685

And they were bright, and they had long tails on them,

687

they were just going like parallel.

688

You know what I mean?

689

Right.

Okay, and when the clouds were clear,

691

I could see the horizon of the mountain behind them,

692

00:29:44,300 --> 00:29:47,300

and they were going right parallel with the mountains,

693

00:29:47,300 --> 00:29:48,300

just even.

694

00:29:48,300 --> 00:29:50,300

They weren't dropping or raising or anything,

695

00:29:50,300 --> 00:29:53,300

and I saw them all maybe for about three minutes,

696

00:29:53,300 --> 00:29:56,300

and then I lost them over Weber Canyon,

697

00:29:56,300 --> 00:29:59,300

I think it's not more cloudy, you know,

698

00:29:59,300 --> 00:30:02,300

and I couldn't see any more, but there were about 10 of them,

699

00:30:02,300 --> 00:30:05,300

and they were like, um, I don't know, like a flying,

700

00:30:05,300 --> 00:30:08,300

I mean, like a falling star, you know,

701

00:30:08,300 --> 00:30:10,300

but they weren't falling towards the ground,

702

00:30:10,300 --> 00:30:12,300

they were just going, just even level.

703

00:30:12,300 --> 00:30:16,300

They weren't, you know, they weren't dropping or raising or anything.

704

Right, but they would just fade out.

705

00:30:18,300 --> 00:30:22,300

No, oh no, they were going just beautiful, just bright,

706

00:30:22,300 --> 00:30:24,300

and then when they would come into a clearing,

707

they would just light up everything, you know,

708

00:30:27,300 --> 00:30:30,300

and I was just wondering if they were the ones that farm

709

00:30:30,300 --> 00:30:32,300

or if they were recorded or not.

710

Well, we had reports from Utah,

711

00:30:36,300 --> 00:30:39,300

North to Northern Idaho, and Washington, Montana,

712

00:30:39,300 --> 00:30:43,300

of something very big and spectacular coming into the atmosphere,

713

00:30:43,300 --> 00:30:47,300

and the only thing that we've been able to get on it

714

00:30:47,300 --> 00:30:49,300

was from the North American Air Defense Command,

715

00:30:49,300 --> 00:30:53,300

they said it was a re-entry of a Russian rocket casing.

716

00:30:54,300 --> 00:30:56,300

The North?

717

00:30:56,300 --> 00:30:58,300

Why?

718

00:30:58,300 --> 00:31:01,300

And apparently down in the Utah areas where the things started

719

00:31:01,300 --> 00:31:04,300

to break up because it was intact in the other states,

720

00:31:04,300 --> 00:31:08,300

but in, uh, the most far south, this Salt Lake City,

721

00:31:08,300 --> 00:31:11,300

we had reports of multiple objects.

722

00:31:11,300 --> 00:31:14,300

Yeah, this was about three to fifteen of them, just, uh, like,

723

00:31:14,300 --> 00:31:18,300

you know, like when you shoot off, uh, you know,

724

00:31:18,300 --> 00:31:21,300

and they were just, oh, they were really going fast.

725

00:31:21,300 --> 00:31:23,300

Right. Right.

726

00:31:23,300 --> 00:31:26,300

Right, well, this, uh, the parallel flight

727

00:31:26,300 --> 00:31:28,300

had been reported by other people too,

728

00:31:28,300 --> 00:31:31,300

and it's a little bit mysterious, though, as to how this could be,

729

00:31:31,300 --> 00:31:36,300

but, uh, uh, like I said, the only thing we have

730

00:31:36,300 --> 00:31:40,300

is from NORAD in relation to that rocket body.

731

00:31:40,300 --> 00:31:42,300

Uh-huh.

732

00:31:42,300 --> 00:31:45,300

Well, wouldn't it have dropped big down,

733

00:31:45,300 --> 00:31:47,300

or it wouldn't have gone parallel, would it?

734

00:31:47,300 --> 00:31:49,300

No, that's the big mystery.

735

00:31:49,300 --> 00:31:51,300

How that thing could do parallel.

736

00:31:51,300 --> 00:31:53,300

Uh-huh.

737

00:31:53,300 --> 00:31:55,300

It should come in at an angle,

738

00:31:55,300 --> 00:31:57,300

or at a fairly short angle, it would be set.

739

00:31:57,300 --> 00:31:59,300

Yeah, it would drop right there, like, like a city star.

740

00:31:59,300 --> 00:32:01,300

Right.

741

00:32:01,300 --> 00:32:03,300

Oh, no, these were not parallel.

742

00:32:03,300 --> 00:32:06,300

I mean, you know, I thought, well, God, they were, you know,

743

00:32:06,300 --> 00:32:08,300

sleepy or something, you know, or something,

744

00:32:08,300 --> 00:32:11,300

but they were going parallel, and they were going fast, boy.

745

And, uh, when they'd go through the clouds,

746

there was a bright, like, the head of it was bright,

747

00:32:16,300 --> 00:32:18,300

and they'd have a long tail,

748

and there was just, like, one or two or three right under each other.

749

They're not right exactly under each other,

750

00:32:25,300 --> 00:32:27,300

like, one ahead of each other, you know what I'm saying?

751

Right.

752

And they would just go along, just look at the whistle, boy,

753

00:32:31,300 --> 00:32:33,300

and they would move.

754

00:32:33,300 --> 00:32:35,300

Did they actually pass through the cloud layer?

755

00:32:35,300 --> 00:32:37,300

Yes, yeah.

756

00:32:37,300 --> 00:32:39,300

See, they would, like, it was clouds up and down,

757

00:32:39,300 --> 00:32:41,300

and you know what I mean?

758

00:32:41,300 --> 00:32:43,300

Right.

759

00:32:43,300 --> 00:32:45,300

And they would go through, like, when you see an airplane go through,

760

00:32:45,300 --> 00:32:47,300

and then it comes up the other side.

761

00:32:47,300 --> 00:32:49,300

Right.

762

00:32:49,300 --> 00:32:51,300

Okay, they were doing just that.

763

00:32:51,300 --> 00:32:53,300

Oh, I see.

764

Did they seem to light up the clouds as they went through?

765

00:32:55,300 --> 00:32:57,300

You're not kidding, maybe.

766

00:32:57,300 --> 00:32:59,300

They lit up the whole cloud there, you know.

767

00:32:59,300 --> 00:33:01,300

And then when they would go through, I guess,

768

00:33:01,300 --> 00:33:03,300

a deeper, darker cloud, it would be dimmer,

769

00:33:03,300 --> 00:33:05,300

and then when they come through the, the clearing,

770

00:33:05,300 --> 00:33:08,300

or the cloud broke up, they would just light up.

771

00:33:08,300 --> 00:33:10,300

How long do you feel that you watch these?

772

00:33:10,300 --> 00:33:14,300

Okay, when I went outside, it was about 11.10,

773

00:33:14,300 --> 00:33:16,300

and I stood there for a minute,

774

00:33:16,300 --> 00:33:19,300

and I went to the car, and I turned around and I saw them,

775

00:33:19,300 --> 00:33:21,300

and then I had to run to the front of the house,

776

00:33:21,300 --> 00:33:24,300

because there was a great big tree, there was a block,

777

00:33:24,300 --> 00:33:27,300

and I watched them until I just couldn't see them anymore,

778

00:33:27,300 --> 00:33:29,300

and it was about 11.13,

779

00:33:29,300 --> 00:33:32,300

because I got a digit to watch, you know,

780

00:33:32,300 --> 00:33:35,300

and it shows, you know, the tan, length, 30.

781

00:33:35,300 --> 00:33:37,300

Right.

782

00:33:37,300 --> 00:33:39,300

And I had to look down and see what's ahead,

783

00:33:39,300 --> 00:33:42,300

and I had to look, and I even put my watch up

784

00:33:42,300 --> 00:33:45,300

to see what time it was, and I could see it.

785

00:33:45,300 --> 00:33:47,300

That's how bright it was.

786

00:33:47,300 --> 00:33:50,300

You know, my digital clock, I mean, the watch is dark,

787

00:33:50,300 --> 00:33:53,300

it's got dark letters, and I put my arm up towards

788

00:33:53,300 --> 00:33:56,300

where the light was, and I could see my,

789

00:33:56,300 --> 00:33:58,300

the numbers in it, so it was 11.13.

790

00:33:58,300 --> 00:34:00,300

And these were to the east of you, right?

791

00:34:00,300 --> 00:34:02,300

Yeah, they were to the east of Ogden.

792

00:34:02,300 --> 00:34:03,300

Okay.

793

00:34:03,300 --> 00:34:05,300

And I called the Air Force Base, and they said that they,

794

all of a sudden, they're boarding it up,

795

00:34:07,300 --> 00:34:09,300

and there was people calling them,

796

and they said that they were seeing all these

797

orchids close to the sky there.

798

Yeah.

799

And I thought maybe I was the only one, you know?

800

And he also said that they saw a lot of them,

801

00:34:19,300 --> 00:34:20,300

the tower there.

802

00:34:20,300 --> 00:34:21,300

Right.

803

00:34:21,300 --> 00:34:23,300

And a lot of people called them,

804

00:34:23,300 --> 00:34:25,300

and also Ogden Police Department,

805

00:34:25,300 --> 00:34:27,300

so they had a lot of calls.

806

807

808
