189

Okay.

Now, how long did this whole thing last, any idea?

191

Um, probably about, let me see, maybe, uh, almost a minute.

192

One minute, okay.

193

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:07,000

Yeah.

194

I'd say that's a pretty good guess.

195

Any definite shape to this thing?

196

No, I couldn't see anything, just the light.

197

199

200
