Right, and I called our neighbors last night, and they saw it too, and it looked just like a bright start

at then, but they watched, and I'd say a half an hour, so it just stays behind the ridge of the mountain.

Okay, now about what time does this happen?

About 15 to 7, and I've noticed that all three gave me, and the day now, I saw in the daylight

It slowly moves, there's a clump of trees there, and of course it's a lot higher than them,

but I identify by that, and it slowly moves sort of west, northwest,

and then all of a sudden it just goes behind the ridge of the mountains.

And then it doesn't come up?

No, I never see it again.

Okay, does this light have any defined shape of any kind?

No, it doesn't, except that it, as I say, looks identical to a star, only it's so much brighter.

No, I can't, obviously would not be a star of any kind, no way.

Uh-huh, and have you ever had any reports on anything similar?

Well, yes, not in this area, but I mean this is nothing new, having glowing objects hovering and then dropping down behind the hill, I would say.

It was three nights, and not only I had seen it, but my kids and like today now,
