This thing, it had all kinds of little blue lights all over it and it had like a circle

8

of red lights underneath with blue lights in the middle.

9

00:00:41,160 --> 00:00:45,600

And like I say, it was very, very strange looking and you know, we could see it turning

10

and every time it would turn, it would get very bright looking.

And we watched that thing for as far as we could watch it and all of a sudden it just

Okay, and it had like just, it just had like a small dome on the top of it was all.

Was that dome lighted?

20

Yes, it was.

What color?

22

It was blue.

Okay.

And the circular part was done in red and then just underneath it was, you know, more

little blue lights but not as many as there was all over the top.

Okay, now were these lights around the perimeter, were they flashing or pulsating at all?

27

Yes, they were.

Okay, did they seem to be moving?

29

00:01:46,520 --> 00:01:47,520

Um.

30

00:01:47,520 --> 00:01:50,520

As though the whole object or the A and the R?

31

Yeah, like the whole object was moving.

32

00:01:52,760 --> 00:01:54,760

You know, just like in a circle.

33

00:01:56,760 --> 00:01:58,760

Did that get very close to you?

34

00:01:58,760 --> 00:02:00,760

Yeah, it sure did.

35

00:02:00,760 --> 00:02:02,760

Have you heard no sound?

36

00:02:02,760 --> 00:02:07,760

Um, I don't know because I, you know, like I say, my windows, my windows were rolled

37

up and it almost, it nearly ran us off the road.

38

Already came that low?

39

00:02:14,760 --> 00:02:15,760

Oh yeah.

40

Okay, could you estimate the altitude?

41

Oh, I see about 300, 400 feet.

42

Well did this, uh, swoop down on you?

43

It just, alright, now see, there's an open field and it just came from the top of the

44

trees down to this open field and right across the road and back on up again.

45

Okay, now was this, when it did this, was this passing in front of you?

46

Yes it was.

Okay, which roadway were you traveling?

I was on, um, Highway 20.

49

I was coming back into Ocarver.

Okay, were you headed north or south?

51

Uh, wait a minute.

52

I kind of remember which way is north and which way is south.

53

Alright, if I'm going up towards Mount Vernon on 20, I'm going north.

54

Okay, I was heading north.

55

Okay, back into Ocarver.

Back into Ocarver.

It's bigger than my car.

67

Okay.

68

If that's any help.

69

You know, I didn't know whether to report this or not, you know, so we had gone to a meeting

70

tonight and I asked the com-master there, I said, what should I do?

71

That's the whole object you're talking about?

81

The whole object, you know, except for the red lights, you know, they would get more brilliant.

82

Would you say in your opinion that the object was surrounded by a corona of light?

83

Yes.

84

00:04:40,500 --> 00:04:42,500

Okay, and this was a bluish?

85

A bluish color, you know.

86

00:04:43,500 --> 00:04:45,500

And it fluctuated in intensity then?

87

Right.

88

Okay.

Which direction was it heading?

90

124

I had a little bit of static, but not much.

125

Is now, is even a little bit unusual over there?

126

Just a little, not a whole bunch.

127

00:06:30,500 --> 00:06:34,500

Usually I have a good clear, clear station, you know, I get several clear stations.

128

But the static you got, did it just shove the broadcasting reception off?

129

00:06:38,500 --> 00:06:39,500

Yes, it did.

130

00:06:39,500 --> 00:06:42,500

Okay, did you have any problem with your car engine or anything?

131

Uh...

132

00:06:43,500 --> 00:06:46,500

Car lights, ignition system?

133

No, the car, not really, because like I say, the thing, you know, I put my foot on the brake,

134

And we stopped and once the thing went back up over the top of the trees, I'd be lining

175

berserkies so she went outside and she said she smelled something real funny.

176

You know, and I said, you sure I said it wasn't your farm or something.

177

And her dog is usually the first one out the door but she had to keep calling her dog,

The same day.

197

Well, we went to play bingo.

198

And going down the hill right by the surface, fans, which is about two miles from my house,

199

208

And, uh, so anyway, went on down.

210

211

And I looked behind me going back.

215

I didn't see nothing.

216

So anyway, got down to, uh, the Fleet Reserve, some gals that you wouldn't get involved,

217

but got down to the Fleet Reserve that night and sit across the table from some woman.

218

And I said, it's weird to say it was on the live, you know, it's something that leaves

219

He's the one I saw sitting about nine months ago.

226

Well, anyway, I got home.

227

I have a 11 year old boy, the babysit, my little kids.

228

And we have a great big picture window that overlooks the whole Fandifuka area.

229

00:11:46,500 --> 00:11:48,500

You know this at all out here.

230

00:11:48,500 --> 00:11:49,500

Do you know this area at all?

231

00:11:49,500 --> 00:11:50,500

No, ma'am.

232

00:11:50,500 --> 00:11:51,500

All right.

233

00:11:51,500 --> 00:11:54,500

Well, anyway, we kind of sit up on the hill and it overlooks the whole bay.

234

00:11:54,500 --> 00:11:56,500

Is that looking west?

235

00:11:56,500 --> 00:11:57,500

Yes.

236

00:11:57,500 --> 00:11:58,500

Okay.

237

00:11:58,500 --> 00:12:03,500

And the thing was I got home that night and he was, my oldest kind of a little bit shook.

238

00:12:03,500 --> 00:12:05,500

I said, what's the matter with you?

239

00:12:05,500 --> 00:12:09,500

He turned around and he says, I saw the funniest thing tonight.

240

00:12:09,500 --> 00:12:11,500

And I had not mentioned this at all to him.

241

Like I just walked into the door and I said, what was it?

242

00:12:14,500 --> 00:12:17,500

He said, well, I looked out the window and he said, I saw this thing.

243

He said, it was real bright.

244

00:12:18,500 --> 00:12:20,500

I said, can you describe it to me?

245

00:12:20,500 --> 00:12:24,500

He said, well, it was kind of, he gave the same description as all that I had given.

246

Uh huh.

247

00:12:25,500 --> 00:12:26,500

And I said, where was it?

248

00:12:26,500 --> 00:12:32,500

He said, well, just over, well, we have 11 acres out here and not six of our acres goes

249

00:12:32,500 --> 00:12:33,500

down the hill.

250

00:12:33,500 --> 00:12:34,500

This is towards the bay.

251

00:12:34,500 --> 00:12:35,500

Yes.

252

00:12:35,500 --> 00:12:38,500

And he said, well, it's just right out here in the middle of the field.

253

00:12:38,500 --> 00:12:41,500

I said, was it high or was it low?

254

00:12:41,500 --> 00:12:43,500

And he said, well, it's just, even with my window.

255

00:12:43,500 --> 00:12:47,500

You know, he said, you didn't really have to look up too high for it.

256

00:12:47,500 --> 00:12:54,500

Well, anyway, I turned around and I was kind of nervous at this time anyway a little bit.

257

00:12:54,500 --> 00:13:02,500

And so anyway, I turned around and about 10.30 quarter to 11, I have geese, I have about

258

200 animals out here, geese ducks, you know.

259

Right.

260

And the thing is that about 10.30 quarter to 11, my geese out here, I'd like to go and

261

kill some.

262

They just started raising holy med.

263

00:13:13,500 --> 00:13:15,500

My TV went fuzzy.

264

00:13:15,500 --> 00:13:17,500

And I looked out the back window.

265

00:13:17,500 --> 00:13:19,500

Well, these geese had their necks test out.

266

00:13:19,500 --> 00:13:21,500

My cows are kind of mowing.

267

00:13:21,500 --> 00:13:23,500

My chickens are raising med.

268

00:13:23,500 --> 00:13:29,500

And I looked out there and these geese, so I have about 75 feet from my house, a garage.

269

And these geese had their necks test out towards that garage.

270

It's like a dog had come at them or something and they were giving.

271

But there was nothing there.

273

281

And it kind of looks like an Australian teat dog, but it's nothing more than a Heinz type dog.

290

292

You go through back, just a little bit of closed back porch and down the steps.

293

The other side's open.

So anyway, I turned around and I told Panda,

295

Up in the sky, towards Oak Harbor area, was the same object.

This is about the way this was doing.

349

352

353

376

And there was no reason to have a dead rabbit.

408

There was no physical marks on it, no nothing. The thing was just dead in the pen.

And you say you had similar loss, one of the geese?

410

Uh, one of the geese, it's real strange to that. I don't know exactly.

411

416

418

I mean, we ate the thing last night, but I mean, it was just the basic fact it had this rupture.

419

420

And, uh, it was really strange because there's nothing, I mean, it didn't look like one of our cows

421

It had no physical marks, no broken bones, no nothing.

423

Am I just imagining things or what is going on?

424

Am I crazy?

425

00:21:44,500 --> 00:21:46,500

Oh, I don't think you're imagining things.

426

No, the things which you described fit right into what we've been picking up for years.

427

What does that mean?

428
