50

57

59

78

We're getting quite a bit of interference on our TV set

79

83

Okay, any of the other law enforcement agencies

85

get anything?

86

No, sir, just the police department.

87

That's it.

88

Now, the man that works down there,

89

you know, as I stated in my letter,

90

the man that works that shift,

91

he's not very indulgent about writing on the log,

92

93

94

It wasn't gone, but I mean, it was out of good,

127

00:03:54,000 --> 00:03:56,000

clear visual range.

128

Okay, anyway.

129

I'll tell you something.

130

I'm scared of it.

131

Has anyone tried any pictures?

132

No.

133

I've got a professional photographer,

134

but he was out of town that night that it was here.

135

And he's planning on trying to get some pictures of it

136

if it comes back.

137

00:04:10,000 --> 00:04:11,000

But we're stymied.

138

00:04:11,000 --> 00:04:12,000

My folks are scared.

139

00:04:12,000 --> 00:04:13,000

My dad has a heart problem.

140

00:04:13,000 --> 00:04:15,000

He's a little upset about it.

141

00:04:15,000 --> 00:04:17,000

And that way...

142

Well, he hasn't made any threatening moves.

143

00:04:19,000 --> 00:04:20,000

No, sir.

144

00:04:20,000 --> 00:04:21,000

No, sir.

145

00:04:21,000 --> 00:04:22,000

I think so.

146

00:04:22,000 --> 00:04:24,000

None of them usually do.

147

00:04:24,000 --> 00:04:25,000

I just wish it would...

148

00:04:25,000 --> 00:04:27,000

Whatever it is, I wish it had land and come up

149

00:04:27,000 --> 00:04:30,000

and have a cup of coffee with it.

150

00:04:30,000 --> 00:04:32,000

How far away is that power station?

151

00:04:32,000 --> 00:04:36,000

The power station is about eight miles away.

152

00:04:36,000 --> 00:04:38,000

Eight to ten miles away from here.

153

00:04:38,000 --> 00:04:39,000

Okay.

154

00:04:39,000 --> 00:04:42,000

It's a huge power station.

155

00:04:42,000 --> 00:04:46,000

In fact, it burns something like 40,000 tons of coal a day

156

00:04:46,000 --> 00:04:48,000

or something from them tomorrow.

157

00:04:48,000 --> 00:04:50,000

It serves as a whole area.

158

00:04:50,000 --> 00:04:53,000

Do you have any of the high transmission lines close by?

159

00:04:53,000 --> 00:04:55,000

I don't know if we have any transmission lines,

160

00:04:55,000 --> 00:04:57,000

high power transmission lines close by or not.

161

00:04:57,000 --> 00:04:58,000

I think there are.

162

00:04:58,000 --> 00:05:01,000

As a matter of fact, it usually comes from the direction

163

00:05:01,000 --> 00:05:05,000

of the radio station right over the top of the radio station.

164

00:05:05,000 --> 00:05:07,000

KMSD radio.

165

00:05:07,000 --> 00:05:08,000

Okay.

166

00:05:08,000 --> 00:05:09,000

Do they have any problems that you know of?

167

00:05:09,000 --> 00:05:10,000

No, sir.

168

00:05:10,000 --> 00:05:13,000

I haven't spoke to any of the engineers out there at all

169

00:05:13,000 --> 00:05:15,000

with reference to it.

170

00:05:15,000 --> 00:05:18,000

So I don't know if they're having any transmission problems

171

00:05:18,000 --> 00:05:19,000

or not.

172

00:05:19,000 --> 00:05:20,000

Okay.

173

00:05:20,000 --> 00:05:23,000

No doubt then the power station is the same as attracting this thing.

174

00:05:23,000 --> 00:05:24,000

Right.

175

00:05:24,000 --> 00:05:26,000

I think that's what it is.

176

00:05:26,000 --> 00:05:31,000

And I'm convinced that it's nothing from our global engineering,

177

00:05:31,000 --> 00:05:34,000

nothing that we've designed or anything.

178

00:05:34,000 --> 00:05:36,000

I'm just assuming a lot of things,

179

00:05:36,000 --> 00:05:38,000

but I've never seen anything like it before in my life.

180

And it keeps coming back to between our barn and our hog house.

181

182

Now how far is this away from the house?

184

185

That's pretty darn close.

186

Yeah.

187

00:05:52,000 --> 00:05:53,000

Okay.

188

00:05:53,000 --> 00:05:57,000

At that distance, what distance do you give in size?

189

I would say last night it was for the light,

190

00:06:00,000 --> 00:06:03,000

the night I sat, which was the night before last.

191

00:06:03,000 --> 00:06:07,000

The light itself was 40 feet across, about 40 feet across.

192

00:06:07,000 --> 00:06:09,000

I still can't see any vehicle with any kind.

193

00:06:09,000 --> 00:06:12,000

Well, the only time we've seen, last night,

194

00:06:12,000 --> 00:06:14,000

or the night before last again when I sighted it,

195

00:06:14,000 --> 00:06:16,000

I didn't stand around.

196

00:06:16,000 --> 00:06:19,000

I saw, I was not shalally walking out to my car.

197

00:06:19,000 --> 00:06:21,000

I spotted it and immediately came back in the house.

198

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:24,000

So I didn't really look for any structure outside of the structure

199

00:06:24,000 --> 00:06:27,000

that my father and I viewed in the diagram that I sent.

200

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:29,000

Any mining in that area?

201

00:06:29,000 --> 00:06:31,000

No mining whatsoever.

202

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:32,000

No.

203

00:06:32,000 --> 00:06:34,000

No wells, oil wells?

204

00:06:34,000 --> 00:06:40,000

No, no wells or any energy sources that would be around in this area at all.

205

00:06:40,000 --> 00:06:42,000

How far is the closest neighbor?

206

00:06:42,000 --> 00:06:47,000

The closest neighbor, I would say, is one mile directly north,

207

00:06:47,000 --> 00:06:49,000

or a mile and a half north,

208

00:06:49,000 --> 00:06:52,000

and then we have another neighbor in that general direction,

209

00:06:52,000 --> 00:06:54,000

about two miles away.

210

00:06:54,000 --> 00:06:56,000

Have you ever seen anything in their area?

211

00:06:56,000 --> 00:06:57,000

No, sir.

212

00:06:57,000 --> 00:06:59,000

No, sir. I haven't even visited with them,

213

00:06:59,000 --> 00:07:01,000

but I know that there's another farmer who's right.

214

00:07:01,000 --> 00:07:04,000

He's seen it himself, but he's seen it from some distance.

215

00:07:04,000 --> 00:07:06,000

And I was curious to know what it is.

216

00:07:06,000 --> 00:07:08,000

Another man, he has a police scanner,

217

00:07:08,000 --> 00:07:10,000

and of course he always comes out whenever he hears a police call

218

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:12,000

and he tries to see what's going on,

219

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:14,000

and he came out, he saw it himself.

220

00:07:14,000 --> 00:07:17,000

So all in all, there's probably 12 or 14 people that have viewed this,

221

00:07:17,000 --> 00:07:20,000

and several of them are pretty knowledgeable about, you know, aircraft.

222

00:07:20,000 --> 00:07:23,000

Two or three of them are pilots, as a matter of fact.

223

00:07:23,000 --> 00:07:26,000

Okay, then the only close approach is would be around your place.

224

00:07:26,000 --> 00:07:28,000

Yes, sir.

225

00:07:28,000 --> 00:07:30,000

Okay.

226

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:32,000

I'm sorry, this is costing you a pretty penny.

227

00:07:32,000 --> 00:07:34,000

If you're going to fly to Korea and war dead, your phone's going to...

228

00:07:34,000 --> 00:07:36,000

Important information.

229

00:07:38,000 --> 00:07:43,000

How about physical or mental experiences and sensations

230

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:45,000

when these things are in the area?

231

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:46,000

Anyone get anything?

232

00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:49,000

When it's in the area, I wouldn't say that anybody has any physical

233

00:07:49,000 --> 00:07:53,000

or mental experiences, although that I know since it started coming,

234

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:55,000

I have a heart problem.

235

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:59,000

And I don't know if it's because of what's going on

236

00:07:59,000 --> 00:08:02,000

or what it is, but I know both my father and I have really been feeling bad.

237

00:08:02,000 --> 00:08:05,000

As a matter of fact, our dog had a heart attack and a stroke

238

00:08:05,000 --> 00:08:07,000

just the other night, and we had to put it to sleep.

239

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:09,000

I don't know if that means anything or not,

240

00:08:09,000 --> 00:08:11,000

but that did happen just the other night,

241

00:08:11,000 --> 00:08:13,000

and the dog was only seven years old.

242

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:16,000

Was that... was the object in the area that night?

243

00:08:16,000 --> 00:08:17,000

I believe so, yes.

244

00:08:17,000 --> 00:08:18,000

What night was it?

245

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:21,000

That was last Friday night.

246

00:08:21,000 --> 00:08:23,000

That's very... okay, that'd be the...

247

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:25,000

No, a week ago tonight, I'm sorry.

248

00:08:25,000 --> 00:08:26,000

That'd be the 13th.

249

00:08:26,000 --> 00:08:27,000

Yes.

250

00:08:27,000 --> 00:08:28,000

Okay.

251

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:32,000

We had to put the dog to sleep in the vet's city,

252

00:08:32,000 --> 00:08:35,000

and, you know, really see anything like that before.

253

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:39,000

His dad apparently had a heart attack and a stroke, both.

254

00:08:39,000 --> 00:08:41,000

Well, had that dog shown any particular disturbance

255

00:08:41,000 --> 00:08:43,000

when the objects were in the area?

256

00:08:43,000 --> 00:08:45,000

And all his veins were collapsed.

257

00:08:45,000 --> 00:08:47,000

Oh, no, none that I noticed.

258

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:49,000

I don't know if the dog was upset or anything.

259

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:52,000

At that time, we were concentrating so on what was going on

260

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:54,000

that we really didn't pay any attention to him, Mr. Gribble.

261

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:56,000

Okay.

262

00:08:57,000 --> 00:08:59,000

And I know that, like I say, both my father and myself

263

have been feeling rather bored.

264

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:04,000

And again, it might be stress or nerves

265

00:09:04,000 --> 00:09:06,000

or wondering what the devil it is, you know?

266

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:08,000

Any dreams, any kind?

267

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:09,000

Yes, sir.

268

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:12,000

I'm telling you, I've had some dreams that have knocked you out.

269

Since that thing has come, it's put a lot of...

270

00:09:15,000 --> 00:09:17,000

And I have a creepy feeling.

271

00:09:17,000 --> 00:09:19,000

I can't understand it, but I have a feeling like...

272

If I can explain it to you, and you won't think I'm insane...

273

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:23,000

Go ahead.

274

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:26,000

I have a feeling like it's coming back for somebody.

275

00:09:26,000 --> 00:09:28,000

That's just the feeling I have and the dream that...

276

00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:30,000

And I told my folks that one night, I said,

277

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:32,000

I know it's coming back and it did come back.

278

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:35,000

And it's just that I have dreams a lot.

279

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:37,000

Have you had any dreams, Mom?

280

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:40,000

I had dreams about UFOs and things.

281

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:42,000

It might just be because it's a shock of the whole thing,

282

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:44,000

but I have had about three or four, in fact,

283

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:46,000

waking up in the night sweating from

284

00:09:46,000 --> 00:09:49,000

because they're so frightening and so very real and vivid.

285

Okay.

286

00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:52,000

Do you get the feeling that somebody's trying to communicate with you?

287

Yes, sir, I do.

288

00:09:53,000 --> 00:09:54,000

Mentally?

289

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:57,000

I don't know if it's...

290

00:09:57,000 --> 00:09:58,000

I don't know.

291

00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:00,000

It's an experience like I've never had before

292

00:10:00,000 --> 00:10:05,000

and I try to decipher the real feelings from the superficial things.

293

They plan and come in and have a cup of coffee with it.

294

00:10:08,000 --> 00:10:12,000

Well, there's a few technical problems involved there.

295

Yeah, I'm sure.

296

I can assure you there's no hostility.

297

I doubt very much if there's any hostility intended.

298

It's observation.

299

In the past, we have seen a very marked pattern from all over the world

300

where they picked certain individuals or certain families or certain groups

301

where they make close approaches and appear to be

302

either studying the individual or presenting themselves

303

so that they can...

304

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:55,000

what they're doing is acting as a conditioning program

305

00:10:55,000 --> 00:10:58,000

to condition the individual or groups that,

306

00:10:58,000 --> 00:11:05,000

here I am, I want you to believe that we exist.

307
