I'll tell you what he told me.

5

Okay, this happened on the 18th of November, outside of White Mountain, outside of Cicampera, New Mexico.

6

00:00:28,000 --> 00:00:34,000

He was lost in deer hunting in that area, he got lost, he was several miles from camp,

7

00:00:34,000 --> 00:00:37,000

he got dark on his fourth year in Mexico.

8

00:00:37,000 --> 00:00:42,000

He saw him come here, there was eight of them on the ground.

9

00:00:42,000 --> 00:00:46,000

I'm sorry, my voice gets shaking, I get shaking every time I talk to them.

10

00:00:46,000 --> 00:00:47,000

It's okay.

11

00:00:47,000 --> 00:00:56,000

One guy, he said they were about two stories high, he said they were false or straight,

12

00:00:56,000 --> 00:01:05,000

they had a top and a bottom, a ridge slide, like he told me, like the edge of a paper slide, not ridge.

13

00:01:05,000 --> 00:01:06,000

Okay.

14

00:01:06,000 --> 00:01:11,000

He said they were on the top and on the bottom, in the middle there was a band of lights,

15

00:01:11,000 --> 00:01:19,000

there was white, but they had the red lights that were in the shape of ends, on the sides.

16

00:01:19,000 --> 00:01:27,000

Okay, they had a, and he had served these for seven to eight hours, and they had served him.

17

00:01:27,000 --> 00:01:31,000

They had an antenna that could be over here, one of them.

18

00:01:31,000 --> 00:01:38,000

That's, okay, he was 200 yards from the one ship that he could see.

19

00:01:38,000 --> 00:01:39,000

Yes.

20

00:01:39,000 --> 00:01:46,000

There, but there was one ship that was closer to him, he knew that they had, the ones that had the antenna were his head.

21

00:01:46,000 --> 00:01:57,000

Okay, they had a square light on the top ship, that produced kind of like a spotlight, but it was very bright and it was foggy looking.

22

00:01:57,000 --> 00:02:09,000

To a detail light, they had a revolving light that went 183, and it's black, red, green, and blue.

23

00:02:09,000 --> 00:02:10,000

Uh-huh.

24

00:02:10,000 --> 00:02:18,000

And the spotlight, as it went around, he would, my husband would, that time, he, uh, he was a lot, he didn't know what that thing was doing.

25

But he, at the time of the Passover, he would get down.

26

00:02:22,000 --> 00:02:33,000

And he said, as it passed, he said, as he hit the bush in the grass, he said, it sounded like wind blowing, but he said the grass did not lay down, like it was being blown.

27

He said, all it did was shimmer.

28

00:02:36,000 --> 00:02:47,000

And, and, uh, it had, okay, the space he said, landing lights on the bottom, he did not see any landing gear, so it came down, but he did not see any landing gear.

He says, there was eight of them on the ground, they were all about, I think he said, half a mile apart, I'm not sure of this, yes.

30

I forget, he can tell you exactly, he can subscribe real well.

31

Yes.

32

00:03:03,000 --> 00:03:04,000

Okay.

33

And we saw each one of them have a minimum of four antennas.

34

And he was watching these two scopes on his gun.

35

He said, when it first came in, he was just scared and scared.

36

You know, he was both frightened and didn't even want to do it.

37

He didn't have any ammunition in his gun because he had, uh, shot some wolves earlier that was tracking him.

38

And he also said there was coyotes in the area.

39

And finally, as he got over the initial shot, the thing, the thing to come in, he lit a fire.

He said, we're also not going to bother me after this time, you know.

41

Uh-huh.

42

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:46,000

He just went lit a fire, he said coyotes also.

43

And, uh, he said the antennas in this one ship, it's almost, oh, it had a fifty-facet,

44

00:03:53,000 --> 00:03:56,000

and he was watching for a while and then disappeared.

45

00:03:56,000 --> 00:03:58,000

Two minutes later, he's come back again.

46

00:03:58,000 --> 00:04:01,000

He figures in they weren't going to bother him.

47

00:04:01,000 --> 00:04:07,000

But, uh, he said the antennas were a rectangle.

48

00:04:07,000 --> 00:04:10,000

He said they did not have a boundary, though.

49

00:04:10,000 --> 00:04:14,000

He could see, and he didn't see anything attaching them to the ship.

50

00:04:14,000 --> 00:04:18,000

He said they looked like little, uh, twinkly lights.

51

00:04:18,000 --> 00:04:23,000

He said they were red and they looked like little, green.

52

00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:25,000

And he said all they did was flash a twinkly.

53

00:04:25,000 --> 00:04:28,000

He said it looked like a neon light, red to the round.

54

00:04:28,000 --> 00:04:29,000

Uh-huh.

55

00:04:29,000 --> 00:04:36,000

And he said, and he looked at these antennas, or whatever they were, two weeks ago.

56

00:04:36,000 --> 00:04:38,000

He said he didn't see the twinkly lights.

57

00:04:38,000 --> 00:04:45,000

He said he saw a thing that looked like a car flare in the shape of a beam on its side.

58

00:04:46,000 --> 00:04:51,000

And, uh, he said there was one in the sky.

59

00:04:51,000 --> 00:04:55,000

And he said they would flash a lightning up to the one in the sky,

60

00:04:55,000 --> 00:05:00,000

and then there was one in the sky, and that was one down to the one on the ground that he was watching.

61

00:05:00,000 --> 00:05:05,000

And he said also, when they came in, they did not make any noise.

62

00:05:05,000 --> 00:05:12,000

And he said they would, uh, he said he thought they were communicating from ship to ship,

63

00:05:12,000 --> 00:05:22,000

because they did make a noise from, there's a real sharp, high, flip noise back and forth to the other ship.

64

00:05:22,000 --> 00:05:23,000

A beeping sound?

65

00:05:23,000 --> 00:05:24,000

Yeah.

66

00:05:24,000 --> 00:05:25,000

Okay.

67

00:05:25,000 --> 00:05:37,000

And, uh, okay, he said also occasionally during the night, they would flash an image in the sky.

68

00:05:37,000 --> 00:05:43,000

And he said the white lights, he said the image was like a triangle upside down,

69

00:05:43,000 --> 00:05:53,000

and he had two slants, like for an eye, eyes would be, and a long slant where a nose would be.

70

00:05:53,000 --> 00:05:59,000

And it's the only way I'd study, I don't know if it's a face or not, but that's just where the, you know, where the lights were.

71

00:05:59,000 --> 00:06:00,000

It is.

72

00:06:00,000 --> 00:06:04,000

And, and they would flash that in the sky every once in a while.

73

00:06:04,000 --> 00:06:11,000

And he said just before dawn, there's some thing that you can see is going out of the blink of an eye.

74

Or just before dawn, my husband was scared to death at it.

75

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:19,000

And then he screamed at him, told him to leave him alone, he was out of ammunition,

76

00:06:19,000 --> 00:06:23,000

and he couldn't work things up, as the frightened he was.

77

00:06:23,000 --> 00:06:32,000

And he said just before dawn, one of the ships flashed the screens to flash two of them up,

78

00:06:32,000 --> 00:06:39,000

and every one of them watched the player type thing in the middle of it.

79

00:06:39,000 --> 00:06:40,000

There it is.

80

00:06:40,000 --> 00:06:43,000

And they pointed at him to the direction to get off that.

81

Now, he, well, every didn't know what they were doing anyway, but you know, there was one going one way,

82

one going the other way, he said, what, they had come lost anyway.

83

to make them start fogging, and to just fog, to return the pale blue, and the pale green, and all of a sudden it was white.

And so it just looked like a fog.

91

And he said then they took off, and they were gone, and in just a few minutes it looked like a star in the sky.

And so he looked like a, uh, uh, falling star.

Okay, now, which day was it that they took off?

95

Okay, so he got lost, it was the 39th of the 18th, so that would make it Friday morning to 19th.

96

We went home, and we left, and as soon as he got back to the camp, he slept, and ate, and we came home.

97

And he's been afraid to talk about it, and he's afraid that, you know, people would think that we were off.

98

Yes.

99

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:22,000

And I thought, totally, I think they should be supported.

100

And I called the Air Force, and they didn't know what, you know, what they were interested in.

Did he see any openings in these objects?

102

Uh, not to my knowledge, he didn't see any people, he didn't see any people at all.

103

He didn't see any landing gear. He did see the landing lights on the bottom.

104

Okay.

105

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:56,000

They lost him for seven to eight hours, it was so scary, I can't believe how it spoke.

106

00:08:56,000 --> 00:09:03,000

And he said they were, oh, I guess, a couple hundred yards.

107

00:09:03,000 --> 00:09:09,000

Okay, now I want to get a confirmation on this date, he got lost on Thursday the 18th.

108

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:12,000

And he got out on Friday the 19th.

109

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:13,000

Right.

110

00:09:13,000 --> 00:09:14,000

Okay.

111

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:23,000

And he had, when it was getting dark and he knew he was lost, he heard a jeep going across the mesa in there.

112

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:30,000

And he saw the jeep coming, and he said they were going across that magmae so they could split.

113

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:35,000

So we fired three warning shots in the air, hoping they would stop pouring.

114

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:39,000

They turned the spotlight on him, most people wouldn't even stop for him.

115

00:09:39,000 --> 00:09:43,000

They just took off, so apparently they saw him too, coming in.

116

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:48,000

And he was at Tukum Carrier at the time?

117

00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:54,000

He was at Tukum Carrier, I think he said somewhere around the inside of White Mountain.

118

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:55,000

Okay.

119

00:09:55,000 --> 00:10:05,000

So he said work and we didn't know who to call, what to call, if we should call, you know, and he just asked me if I'd sign down about it today.

120

Okay, did he give any estimate of size on those objects?

121

He said they were about two still in time, but I don't know how long, I don't remember if he'd seen how long they were.

122

And has he told us to anyone else besides you?

124

00:10:20,000 --> 00:10:21,000

His friends.

125

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:26,000

His close friends, his people, but we wouldn't think they were crazy.

126

00:10:26,000 --> 00:10:29,000

He hasn't told that to any people.

127

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:34,000

Okay, now would he be willing to talk to someone if they came down there to see him?

128

00:10:34,000 --> 00:10:35,000

I sure he would.

129

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:36,000

Okay.

130

00:10:36,000 --> 00:10:48,000

He's gotten over the fright now and over the things that we have found out that people won't think we're crazy, other people have seen him and so forth.

131

00:10:48,000 --> 00:10:55,000

The first couple weeks he was home, he was right to tell any types of things that he was crazy or something.

132

00:10:55,000 --> 00:10:59,000

But my husband did not believe in UFOs for that time.

133

00:10:59,000 --> 00:11:00,000

Okay.

134

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:04,000

And I was skeptical, but I believe in him.

135

00:11:04,000 --> 00:11:13,000

Well, he's had a very rare experience and obviously he has knowledge of some very important scientific data.

136

00:11:13,000 --> 00:11:15,000

He was scared to death.

137

00:11:15,000 --> 00:11:17,000

He said, I was scared.

138

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:22,000

He said, at the beginning he was ice-creamed at him and all of that.

139

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:24,000

He shot a couple of wolves at least.

140

00:11:24,000 --> 00:11:25,000

He was the last of it.

141

00:11:25,000 --> 00:11:31,000

He had used stunts and they should try to get those other hunters to stop for him and they wouldn't stop.

142

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:36,000

And then he attacked.

143

00:11:36,000 --> 00:11:41,000

Did he give any estimates of how far away the objects were that were on the ground?

144

00:11:41,000 --> 00:11:47,000

The one he was watching, I think he said it was about 200 yards from here.

145

00:11:47,000 --> 00:11:58,000

He said he thought that there was one closer than that to him, but he didn't see it because he figured that the antennas or whatever it was, it was over his head.

146

00:11:58,000 --> 00:12:01,000

That's why he's calling because he don't know what else to call.

147

00:12:01,000 --> 00:12:02,000

Yes.

148

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:05,000

He said there's about 50 feet over his head.

149

00:12:05,000 --> 00:12:10,000

He thought that they were coming from a ship that was closer than that to him.

150

00:12:10,000 --> 00:12:16,000

He said, I think he said there were half miles, three quarters of a mile apart, each one of these that were on the ground.

151

00:12:16,000 --> 00:12:21,000

And he didn't know how high one in the sky was, but he counted eight.

152

00:12:21,000 --> 00:12:22,000

Okay.

153

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:24,000

And then one in the sky.

154

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

He didn't see any occupants at all?

155

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:28,000

He didn't see any occupants at all.

156

00:12:28,000 --> 00:12:31,000

He said, I didn't even see any landing gear.

157

00:12:31,000 --> 00:12:35,000

He said, I saw the landing lights.

158

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:47,000

And he described that far right and described this other little light on the tail that he only went ahead and it was green.

159

00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:51,000

He said it was black, blue, green, and red.

160

00:12:51,000 --> 00:12:53,000

Okay, what time does your husband get home from work?

161

00:12:53,000 --> 00:13:02,000

Well, he's in business for himself and right now he's working a lot, so I don't know exactly when he's going to be in and out during the time.

162

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:04,000

He's self-employed and in and out during the daytime.

163

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:05,000

Uh-huh.

164

00:13:07,000 --> 00:13:13,000

That's why he asked me to call so he figured he would get him to last a dark and take all anybody

in to dark.

165

Right, okay.

166

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:20,000

Well, we sure appreciate this report and we'll see if we can't get somebody down there to talk to him.

167

The State Police.

Bye-bye.

This is the U.F.O. Reporting Center in Seattle, Washington.

182

Yes.

183

And your wife was telling us this morning that you had quite an experience.

184

Yes.

185

00:13:52,000 --> 00:13:59,000

I wonder if we could get your rundown on it right from the beginning.

186

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:03,000

Well, 100 long in New Mexico was not supposed to do.

187

00:14:03,000 --> 00:14:04,000

Uh-huh.

188

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:08,000

And went down into the canyon.

189

00:14:08,000 --> 00:14:12,000

And I stayed too long in the canyon.

190

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:14,000

It was the first step to New Mexico.

191

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:15,000

I see.

192

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:20,000

And when I came out of the canyon, I did go far enough.

193

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:30,000

And I started as it got so quickly, more or less, got turned around and went out in the direction.

194

00:14:30,000 --> 00:14:32,000

And I kept walking, kept walking.

195

00:14:32,000 --> 00:14:36,000

I stayed across a fence line or a road.

196

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:40,000

And, uh, well, I did.

197

00:14:40,000 --> 00:14:42,000

And I kept finding warning shots.

198

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:44,000

I don't think that's a fire.

199

00:14:44,000 --> 00:14:45,000

Very.

200

00:14:45,000 --> 00:14:50,000

Somebody either going to hear you, and fire one shot to the home here.

201

00:14:50,000 --> 00:14:54,000

Well, I've seen some flies.

202

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:55,000

It flies.

203

00:14:55,000 --> 00:15:02,000

It flashed about, oh, 15, 20 seconds apart.

204

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:13,000

And I figured, well, it was bright enough to be a beacon for air force.

205

00:15:13,000 --> 00:15:14,000

Yes.

206

00:15:14,000 --> 00:15:15,000

Okay.

207

00:15:15,000 --> 00:15:20,000

But I was a heck of a long way from it.

208

00:15:20,000 --> 00:15:22,000

But I started going to it.

209

00:15:22,000 --> 00:15:26,000

Man, I was lost in my little gears and pale.

210

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:31,000

And I kept going and kept going and kept going.

211

00:15:31,000 --> 00:15:38,000

And that was the light, you know, kept coming up on the light.

212

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:48,000

And when I got up there, uh, little way, oh, before I got to the fire, finally stopped there.

213

00:15:48,000 --> 00:15:52,000

I kept thinking about my name, or being an air force.

214

00:15:52,000 --> 00:15:55,000

Not where I'm at.

215

00:15:55,000 --> 00:15:57,000

But maybe it's raining anyway.

216

00:15:57,000 --> 00:15:58,000

Our game was.

217

00:15:58,000 --> 00:15:59,000

Yes.

218

00:15:59,000 --> 00:16:00,000

Hurt me.

219

00:16:00,000 --> 00:16:05,000

So I went on, and I got this little mold.

220

00:16:05,000 --> 00:16:10,000

And this big light was, looked like a beacon.

221

00:16:10,000 --> 00:16:12,000

It was coming across.

222

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:17,000

And it was several other lights in the area.

223

00:16:17,000 --> 00:16:21,000

And I heard this jeep coming.

224

00:16:21,000 --> 00:16:28,000

And the jeep was running full speed across this mace.

225

00:16:28,000 --> 00:16:31,000

This mace is about three miles in diameter.

226

00:16:31,000 --> 00:16:35,000

Well, I fired my gun.

227

00:16:35,000 --> 00:16:41,000

And they'd shine the spotlight on me.

228

00:16:41,000 --> 00:16:45,000

And they would flash in the spotlight all over the area.

229

00:16:45,000 --> 00:16:47,000

But they wouldn't stop.

230

00:16:47,000 --> 00:16:49,000

And I kept shooting and screaming at them.

231

00:16:49,000 --> 00:16:51,000

They wouldn't stop.

232

00:16:51,000 --> 00:16:53,000

But the jeep evidently did see them.

233

00:16:53,000 --> 00:16:55,000

And they were just getting out of there.

234

00:16:55,000 --> 00:16:56,000

Well, anyway.

235

00:16:56,000 --> 00:16:58,000

What time was this? Do you recall?

236

00:16:58,000 --> 00:17:00,000

Oh, this was about 11.

237

00:17:00,000 --> 00:17:01,000

Okay.

238

00:17:01,000 --> 00:17:03,000

10.30.11.

239

00:17:03,000 --> 00:17:09,000

Well, yeah, I think it was about 10.30.11.

240

00:17:09,000 --> 00:17:11,000

It could have been around nine.

241

00:17:11,000 --> 00:17:16,000

Well, anyway, I tried to see where the jeep went.

242

00:17:16,000 --> 00:17:18,000

I thought maybe he went to a road.

243

00:17:18,000 --> 00:17:20,000

I just followed the road back.

244

00:17:20,000 --> 00:17:24,000

And I went back the way the jeep went.

245

00:17:24,000 --> 00:17:25,000

He patted behind me.

246

00:17:25,000 --> 00:17:29,000

And I went back the other way where the jeep was going.

247

00:17:29,000 --> 00:17:31,000

And I stopped.

248

00:17:31,000 --> 00:17:34,000

Because he was just definitely gone.

249

00:17:34,000 --> 00:17:36,000

He wouldn't stop nobody.

250

00:17:36,000 --> 00:17:40,000

And then one of the lights come on.

251

00:17:40,000 --> 00:17:42,000

I guess it was him.

252

00:17:42,000 --> 00:17:46,000

He must have been a lot less than half a mile from me.

253

00:17:46,000 --> 00:17:50,000

And I didn't even know he was there.

254

00:17:50,000 --> 00:17:53,000

And he turned this light on.

255

00:17:53,000 --> 00:17:58,000

And so I didn't know what it was,

256

00:17:58,000 --> 00:18:04,000

but I knew it wouldn't be anything that I've ever seen before.

257

00:18:04,000 --> 00:18:08,000

Because the light was a big rectangular light.

258

00:18:08,000 --> 00:18:11,000

I did not look directly in the light.

259

00:18:11,000 --> 00:18:16,000

And it put out a glow like a fog.

260

00:18:16,000 --> 00:18:19,000

It wasn't a sharp light like a headlight.

261

Was it quite great?

Yeah, but it was a soft light.

263

00:18:24,000 --> 00:18:29,000

But it looked like a big fog.

264

00:18:29,000 --> 00:18:33,000

It chopped off a big rectangular stretch of fog.

265

00:18:33,000 --> 00:18:35,000

That's the way it looked.

266

00:18:35,000 --> 00:18:37,000

He was shining the light through it.

267

00:18:37,000 --> 00:18:38,000

Yes.

268

00:18:38,000 --> 00:18:39,000

Okay.

269

00:18:39,000 --> 00:18:49,000

So I started looking at the other objects that was around.

270

00:18:49,000 --> 00:18:55,000

I counted eight on the ground, the first one I counted.

271

00:18:55,000 --> 00:19:00,000

And the light would pass.

272

00:19:00,000 --> 00:19:06,000

And it sounded like when it would hit the bushes, it sounded like wind.

273

00:19:06,000 --> 00:19:08,000

When this light would hit the brush.

274

00:19:08,000 --> 00:19:09,000

Yes.

275

00:19:09,000 --> 00:19:17,000

But it didn't affect the brush like wind did affect it.

276

00:19:17,000 --> 00:19:20,000

Well now, could I stop for a minute?

277

00:19:20,000 --> 00:19:21,000

Yes.

278

00:19:21,000 --> 00:19:23,000

You say that when the light was going around,

279

00:19:23,000 --> 00:19:27,000

was there some kind of a shaft of light being shined around?

280

00:19:27,000 --> 00:19:30,000

Yes, this was something like a search light.

281

00:19:30,000 --> 00:19:34,000

You know, you've seen search lights are used for advertising.

282

00:19:34,000 --> 00:19:35,000

Right.

283

00:19:35,000 --> 00:19:38,000

Yes, well that was a type of light, but it was a rectangular light.

284

00:19:38,000 --> 00:19:41,000

I see.

285

00:19:41,000 --> 00:19:50,000

And I just guesstimated that the far away it could have been on 4x8.

286

00:19:50,000 --> 00:19:52,000

It could stop being.

287

00:19:52,000 --> 00:19:53,000

Uh huh.

288

00:19:53,000 --> 00:19:58,000

Well, when the light come around the first time I got down,

289

00:19:58,000 --> 00:20:01,000

I don't know why I got down, but I got down.

290

00:20:01,000 --> 00:20:07,000

And I still had my rifle with me, but I used the rifle.

291

00:20:07,000 --> 00:20:08,000

That's pretty well.

292

00:20:08,000 --> 00:20:10,000

I don't see you on the move this light around.

293

00:20:10,000 --> 00:20:12,000

I'm not even spotting a deer out there.

294

00:20:12,000 --> 00:20:19,000

And that's when I seen the bushes shake.

295

00:20:19,000 --> 00:20:21,000

It's when the light was on.

296

00:20:21,000 --> 00:20:23,000

I did not look directly in the light.

297

00:20:23,000 --> 00:20:24,000

Yes.

298

00:20:24,000 --> 00:20:27,000

And I looked through the scope.

299

00:20:27,000 --> 00:20:31,000

Now, it would take this brush and it would just shake it.

300

00:20:31,000 --> 00:20:35,000

And when the light would pass by, the bush would stop.

301

00:20:35,000 --> 00:20:38,000

And it would do the grass the same way.

302

00:20:38,000 --> 00:20:41,000

It would just take it and just shake it.

303

00:20:41,000 --> 00:20:43,000

Not blow it down like a wind does.

304

00:20:43,000 --> 00:20:50,000

It would just shake the grass and shake the bush.

305

00:20:50,000 --> 00:20:56,000

And while I was watching them, I watched the other one.

306

00:20:56,000 --> 00:20:58,000

I called the mason.

307

00:20:58,000 --> 00:21:05,000

It was one that had a revolving light right on the port.

308

00:21:05,000 --> 00:21:11,000

And I looked at it and the light was rolling in a counter-clockwise direction.

309

00:21:11,000 --> 00:21:15,000

I'd actually make out that.

310

00:21:15,000 --> 00:21:17,000

And I've got a good scope on my gun.

311

00:21:17,000 --> 00:21:19,000

I've got a leaf of it.

312

00:21:19,000 --> 00:21:22,000

And I could see any decals at all on that light.

313

00:21:22,000 --> 00:21:28,000

And it would flash blue, red, and green.

314

00:21:28,000 --> 00:21:35,000

And the light all you could see on it was a 180-degree slaughter.

315

00:21:35,000 --> 00:21:40,000

You couldn't see the full 360-degree like you'd look at a regular light bulb.

316

00:21:40,000 --> 00:21:44,000

And it would roll in that counter-clockwise direction.

317

00:21:44,000 --> 00:21:46,000

And that was on the ground also?

318

00:21:46,000 --> 00:21:48,000

It was on the ground also.

319

00:21:48,000 --> 00:21:50,000

Okay.

320

00:21:50,000 --> 00:21:54,000

So I was, man, I was confused.

321

00:21:54,000 --> 00:21:58,000

I was a bamboo game.

322

00:21:58,000 --> 00:22:04,000

And in the meantime, this other light kept moving back and forth.

323

00:22:04,000 --> 00:22:09,000

And I noticed he was only moving 180 degrees.

324

00:22:09,000 --> 00:22:12,000

And I didn't know which way to run.

325

00:22:12,000 --> 00:22:16,000

And I built me a fire right there.

326

00:22:16,000 --> 00:22:21,000

And when I built the fire, I looked up.

327

00:22:21,000 --> 00:22:34,000

And in the sky, they could make like a little antenna that would tear in mid-space.

328

00:22:34,000 --> 00:22:38,000

I'd say it's a rectangular antenna.

329

00:22:38,000 --> 00:22:40,000

Now there's no wires attached.

330

00:22:40,000 --> 00:22:43,000

It's just projected in mid-space.

331

00:22:43,000 --> 00:22:48,000

It had blue, green, and a little red light.

332

00:22:48,000 --> 00:22:51,000

It looked like a bridge.

333

00:22:51,000 --> 00:22:54,000

And it was just like there, just twinkling.

334

00:22:54,000 --> 00:22:57,000

I never seen that like this for my whole life.

335

00:22:57,000 --> 00:23:01,000

It was just an ascended and mid-air method.

336

00:23:01,000 --> 00:23:04,000

It just appeared.

337

00:23:04,000 --> 00:23:07,000

Do you have any estimate of altitude on that?

338

00:23:07,000 --> 00:23:10,000

Oh, that's saying I think it wouldn't over 30 feet for me.

339

00:23:10,000 --> 00:23:11,000

Okay.

340

00:23:11,000 --> 00:23:15,000

And oh, it's probably 25, 40 feet in air.

341

00:23:15,000 --> 00:23:22,000

And this thing was just right over the top of it.

342

00:23:22,000 --> 00:23:27,000

If you had a rectangular board and you could take the board

343

00:23:27,000 --> 00:23:30,000

and you could just turn it any position you want to.

344

00:23:30,000 --> 00:23:32,000

That's the way they did it.

345

00:23:32,000 --> 00:23:38,000

And the one that drove me was just like a straight man in the flag.

346

00:23:38,000 --> 00:23:40,000

And I didn't know what the hell it was.

347

00:23:40,000 --> 00:23:41,000

I was talking.

348

00:23:41,000 --> 00:23:44,000

I was, I mean, I was so scared I was talking at that.

349

00:23:44,000 --> 00:23:45,000

I told him leave me alone.

350

00:23:45,000 --> 00:23:48,000

I wouldn't want to do no harm.

351

00:23:48,000 --> 00:23:55,000

And I just thought I'd look at it with scope on my rifle.

352

00:23:55,000 --> 00:24:04,000

And I looked at this thing and you couldn't see these little flickering lights.

353

00:24:04,000 --> 00:24:10,000

Blue, red and green little lights in it.

354

00:24:10,000 --> 00:24:14,000

When you put the scope on it, you could look right through it.

355

00:24:14,000 --> 00:24:18,000

And what I've seen is maize to hell out of maize.

356

00:24:18,000 --> 00:24:23,000

It looks like a rose flare.

357

00:24:23,000 --> 00:24:26,000

A rose flare, burn.

358

00:24:26,000 --> 00:24:28,000

With two wings on it.

359

00:24:28,000 --> 00:24:29,000

It's just that there.

360

00:24:29,000 --> 00:24:34,000

And you take the scope away and a little grid and say right there.

361

00:24:34,000 --> 00:24:39,000

You put the scope on, you come up with a rose flare.

362

00:24:39,000 --> 00:24:42,000

Real weird.

363

00:24:42,000 --> 00:24:47,000

But it was just, you couldn't see the rose flare if you neck it out.

364

00:24:47,000 --> 00:24:53,000

But the scope would look right through it and in the center of that thing it looked like a rose flare.

365

00:24:53,000 --> 00:25:01,000

And it would disappear and then it would reappear at a different location.

366

00:25:01,000 --> 00:25:05,000

And at times it'd have two, three.

367

00:25:05,000 --> 00:25:07,000

At different places.

368

00:25:07,000 --> 00:25:13,000

Because if it was one thing I could figure out, it might have been a closed circuit, TV.

369

00:25:13,000 --> 00:25:15,000

And maybe sound transmission.

370

00:25:15,000 --> 00:25:17,000

I don't know what it was.

371

00:25:17,000 --> 00:25:20,000

But I figured it was in that town.

372

00:25:20,000 --> 00:25:28,000

And I was burning a fire at this time.

373

00:25:28,000 --> 00:25:34,000

And I watched these things all night long.

374

00:25:34,000 --> 00:25:42,000

But one time the night, a red flash of pictures like a face in the back.

375

00:25:42,000 --> 00:25:45,000

And I could draw that face.

376

00:25:45,000 --> 00:25:54,000

And it would tear and it would put white colored lights.

377

00:25:54,000 --> 00:25:57,000

And then they would flash another one.

378

00:25:57,000 --> 00:26:01,000

Now what I mean by flash, it would just appear in the sky.

379

00:26:01,000 --> 00:26:04,000

Just as always being protected right into the atmosphere.

380

00:26:04,000 --> 00:26:05,000

Right.

381

00:26:05,000 --> 00:26:07,000

And it looked like neat.

382

00:26:07,000 --> 00:26:14,000

Like these little lights where it took several in a motel.

383

00:26:14,000 --> 00:26:15,000

Lights.

384

00:26:15,000 --> 00:26:17,000

That's what it looked like.

385

00:26:17,000 --> 00:26:19,000

It looked like a burnout neon.

386

00:26:19,000 --> 00:26:21,000

That's what it looked like.

387

00:26:21,000 --> 00:26:23,000

And it just projected like that.

388

00:26:23,000 --> 00:26:26,000

And it had a face though.

389

00:26:26,000 --> 00:26:29,000

And then it would disappear.

390

00:26:29,000 --> 00:26:34,000

And then another one would come up and it would step you.

391

00:26:34,000 --> 00:26:41,000

But it had a border around it plus some other market cities.

392

00:26:41,000 --> 00:26:46,000

And they appeared at several different times.

393

00:26:46,000 --> 00:26:51,000

Twice, I don't know if I can remember real clearly.

394

00:26:51,000 --> 00:27:02,000

And then, only time I've seen actual landing lights on the craft.

395

00:27:02,000 --> 00:27:09,000

It's when one was coming in and it was on the fixed loop on the bottom.

396

00:27:09,000 --> 00:27:11,000

They were lights on the bottom.

397

00:27:11,000 --> 00:27:15,000

But after you touch down, they would turn them off.

398

00:27:15,000 --> 00:27:22,000

That's the one time they were saying that, like, that's the old landing gear or nothing.

399

00:27:22,000 --> 00:27:30,000

Also, from the, just one big crash.

400

00:27:30,000 --> 00:27:33,000

You could see colors on it.

401

00:27:33,000 --> 00:27:34,000

Okay.

402

00:27:34,000 --> 00:27:41,000

It looks basically like a band going around the middle of it.

403

00:27:41,000 --> 00:27:50,000

And this band must have been at least as far away as I was, at least for a while.

404

00:27:50,000 --> 00:27:55,000

And the band had something like a picket fence going through it.

405

00:27:55,000 --> 00:27:58,000

And these, not like a picket fence.

406

00:27:58,000 --> 00:28:03,000

I've seen a diagonal type fence like a Z bar type.

407

00:28:03,000 --> 00:28:11,000

And these panels were red with a white background.

408

00:28:11,000 --> 00:28:16,000

And these Z bars all the way around this place.

409

00:28:16,000 --> 00:28:18,000

Now this was moving around on the horizontal.

410

00:28:18,000 --> 00:28:21,000

No, this was stationary. This was stopped.

411

00:28:21,000 --> 00:28:23,000

Uh-huh.

412

00:28:23,000 --> 00:28:27,000

What I mean is the band was around on the horizontal, not on the vertical.

413

00:28:27,000 --> 00:28:28,000

Right.

414

00:28:28,000 --> 00:28:29,000

Okay.

415

00:28:29,000 --> 00:28:30,000

Right.

416

00:28:30,000 --> 00:28:32,000

Okay.

417

00:28:32,000 --> 00:28:41,000

Now, I never thought I'd ever believe, but when these things took off, I watched these

418

00:28:41,000 --> 00:28:46,000

things all night till sunrise.

419

00:28:46,000 --> 00:28:49,000

They would lay on the edge.

420

00:28:49,000 --> 00:28:52,000

And they'd go about 300 feet.

421

00:28:52,000 --> 00:28:57,000

And then they'd lay, uh, horizontal with the ground.

422

00:28:57,000 --> 00:28:58,000

Right.

423

00:28:58,000 --> 00:29:02,000

Then it started to panel up.

424

00:29:02,000 --> 00:29:05,000

The panel would turn white first.

425

00:29:05,000 --> 00:29:11,000

Then it would go to a pastel blue to a pastel green.

426

00:29:11,000 --> 00:29:18,000

And then as long as they stayed there, it started to come to a pastel white, but a bald white.

427

00:29:18,000 --> 00:29:28,000

And as long as he stayed there and learned that sound, it would just fight with the bulk

428

00:29:28,000 --> 00:29:29,000

of the grass.

429

00:29:29,000 --> 00:29:33,000

You could just watch it spread from bottom to bottom.

430

00:29:33,000 --> 00:29:35,000

And then he'd just move off.

431

00:29:35,000 --> 00:29:41,000

And he didn't make a bit of sound or anything on leaving or anything like that.

432

00:29:41,000 --> 00:29:51,000

They'd run one sound pattern while I was there, two sound patterns.

433

00:29:51,000 --> 00:29:54,000

And one was a great big boofy.

434

00:29:54,000 --> 00:30:02,000

And the other was just a plain sound, straight pattern.

435

00:30:02,000 --> 00:30:04,000

And he was running to another shift over there.

436

00:30:04,000 --> 00:30:07,000

He was running a back and forth, different sound patterns.

437

00:30:07,000 --> 00:30:14,000

But that's the only noise they ever made that I've seen.

438

00:30:14,000 --> 00:30:23,000

Uh, let's see, what is it?

439

00:30:23,000 --> 00:30:31,000

Well, each one of these plants took off on their edge one at a time.

440

00:30:31,000 --> 00:30:34,000

Wow, this was daylight when they started doing this.

441

00:30:34,000 --> 00:30:35,000

No.

442

00:30:35,000 --> 00:30:36,000

No.

443

00:30:36,000 --> 00:30:42,000

They started probably pulling out around 3.30, 3 to 3.30.

444

00:30:42,000 --> 00:30:47,000

And the last one, most likely, oh, I guess it must have been a 4 to 5.

445

00:30:47,000 --> 00:30:53,000

But he pulled out and he sat up there, oh, I guess he was about a half mile or a mile

446

00:30:53,000 --> 00:31:01,000

up, and he sat there with the dawn coming in.

447

00:31:01,000 --> 00:31:04,000

And he just sat there and sat there.

448

00:31:04,000 --> 00:31:08,000

And I just watched the heck out of him.

449

00:31:08,000 --> 00:31:12,000

Could you see a solid surface on this?

450

00:31:12,000 --> 00:31:15,000

Could you see a solid surface on the last one?

451

00:31:15,000 --> 00:31:17,000

Oh, yeah, right.

452

00:31:17,000 --> 00:31:21,000

He was just sitting there, like suspended in space.

453

00:31:21,000 --> 00:31:25,000

There was no cloud or nothing around him.

454

00:31:25,000 --> 00:31:32,000

He was just there, just stopped, wouldn't make it a bit of noise.

455

00:31:32,000 --> 00:31:35,000

Okay, he was the last one to leave.

456

00:31:35,000 --> 00:31:42,000

Before he left, he must have been in the control ship over there, or something, because there

457

00:31:42,000 --> 00:31:47,000

was one in the sky and he looked like a bright star.

458

00:31:47,000 --> 00:31:52,000

But there was only one thing that was different.

459

00:31:52,000 --> 00:31:57,000

There was a light beam going up and a light beam coming down.

460

00:31:57,000 --> 00:32:01,000

It was just more or less like you could see two light beams.

461

00:32:01,000 --> 00:32:05,000

And it was going right to the star.

462

00:32:05,000 --> 00:32:08,000

It wasn't going past the star.

463

00:32:08,000 --> 00:32:16,000

And it was coming right down to this ship, the last one to leave.

464

00:32:16,000 --> 00:32:18,000

How was that?

465

00:32:18,000 --> 00:32:23,000

The star in the sky, the star lighting in the sky, was that quite large?

466

00:32:23,000 --> 00:32:29,000

Well, it was bright.

467

00:32:29,000 --> 00:32:33,000

I couldn't tell how big it was.

468

00:32:33,000 --> 00:32:41,000

But there was a light beam coming down, a tune, and one going up, because there were two light beams.

469

00:32:41,000 --> 00:32:48,000

And they looked like a beam that you would take one of these advertising times, and the

470

00:32:48,000 --> 00:32:51,000

lights shine one up and shine one down.

471

00:32:51,000 --> 00:32:54,000

And that's how bright they were.

472

00:32:54,000 --> 00:33:01,000

They appeared at about halfway through this maze, I'd say probably around one upon.

473

00:33:01,000 --> 00:33:07,000

And then maybe it's gone. The beams are gone.

474

00:33:07,000 --> 00:33:12,000

Okay, were those beams through this whole thing only directed onto the one craft?

475

00:33:12,000 --> 00:33:14,000

Only on that one craft.

476

00:33:14,000 --> 00:33:23,000

I can see it's directed on any other craft.

477

00:33:23,000 --> 00:33:26,000

And if I told you how it got out there, you wouldn't believe me.

478

00:33:26,000 --> 00:33:28,000

I'd like to hear about it anyway.

479

00:33:28,000 --> 00:33:38,000

These little, I'll be part of that.

480

00:33:38,000 --> 00:33:43,000

These little, I call them antennas.

481

00:33:43,000 --> 00:33:56,000

At dawn, when this ship picked up and moved up into the dock, there was another antenna appeared,

482

00:33:56,000 --> 00:34:02,000

approximately 60 feet from me.

483

00:34:02,000 --> 00:34:05,000

And I still looked at it from my scope.

484

00:34:05,000 --> 00:34:11,000

And the flare, remember, stepped two wings on the flare.

485

00:34:11,000 --> 00:34:20,000

It's not like wings with a bird, just like a regular road flare that you light up.

486

00:34:20,000 --> 00:34:24,000

And they can move these in any direction.

487

00:34:24,000 --> 00:34:28,000

These are low wings.

488

00:34:28,000 --> 00:34:31,000

They can be point and say, no.

489

00:34:31,000 --> 00:34:35,000

And what I'm talking about, the point is the base of the flare.

490

00:34:35,000 --> 00:34:37,000

You know what I mean?

491

00:34:37,000 --> 00:34:39,000

The burning section.

492

00:34:40,000 --> 00:34:50,000

It was important to about Southwest, I'd say Southwest.

493

00:34:50,000 --> 00:34:53,000

And another one was behind.

494

00:34:53,000 --> 00:34:59,000

It was one South West.

495

00:34:59,000 --> 00:35:08,000

And being lost, I said to hell with it, and I went the way the things pointed.

496

00:35:08,000 --> 00:35:14,000

And I come in with 50 yards of my truck.

497

00:35:14,000 --> 00:35:18,000

And I didn't get back to the truck until 1030 to 1100.

498

00:35:18,000 --> 00:35:24,000

And I'm in very good physical condition.

499

00:35:24,000 --> 00:35:32,000

I was going down through the canyon, the salt mountain, and that's not hunting, that's moving out.

500

00:35:32,000 --> 00:35:35,000

And I was totally exhausted when I got to that truck.

501

00:35:35,000 --> 00:35:38,000

And I couldn't have went another two miles without that.

502

00:35:38,000 --> 00:35:41,000

Okay, now was that 11 o'clock AM or PM?

503

00:35:41,000 --> 00:35:42,000

AM.

504

00:35:42,000 --> 00:35:43,000

Okay.

505

00:35:43,000 --> 00:35:53,000

And now I don't know how far away I was, but I figured I was going at least three miles in the mountain.

506

00:35:53,000 --> 00:35:56,000

I guess maybe less than 10 to 12 miles.

507

00:35:56,000 --> 00:36:01,000

I was a 10 to my truck.

508

00:36:01,000 --> 00:36:07,000

And do you feel yourself that they were actually directing you in which direction to go?

509

00:36:07,000 --> 00:36:10,000

Yeah, I did.

510

00:36:10,000 --> 00:36:20,000

Because at one time, when I started to see them pictures on the sky, one of these antennas was there.

511

00:36:20,000 --> 00:36:25,000

And I explained to them, I said, I don't know who in the hell you are, but you sure got your shit together.

512

00:36:25,000 --> 00:36:27,000

You know what the hell you doing?

513

00:36:27,000 --> 00:36:30,000

That's what I told them.

514

00:36:30,000 --> 00:36:34,000

And I don't know if they could hear me or not.

515

00:36:34,000 --> 00:36:37,000

I told them I was lost and leaving me the hell alone.

516

00:36:37,000 --> 00:36:39,000

You can feel your thing.

517

00:36:39,000 --> 00:36:41,000

But I don't know what I can do with you.

518

00:36:41,000 --> 00:36:46,000

And that night I burnt two logs.

519

00:36:46,000 --> 00:36:53,000

Oh, I'd pray about 15 foot long, 20 foot long, all night long.

520

00:36:53,000 --> 00:36:57,000

I was afraid to go to sleep, lay at the cow, to get me up there.

521

00:36:57,000 --> 00:37:04,000

And I heard them holler, yelling, you go to sleep up there, and that makes them say, well, I get you.

522

00:37:04,000 --> 00:37:09,000

Okay, and you are sure that you did not sleep or lose any time at all?

523

00:37:09,000 --> 00:37:10,000

I'm sure that.

524

00:37:10,000 --> 00:37:11,000

Okay.

525

00:37:11,000 --> 00:37:13,000

I had to stay awake all night.

526

00:37:13,000 --> 00:37:20,000

Now, there's a couple times that I almost fell at fire.

527

00:37:20,000 --> 00:37:26,000

Now, I fell at no, you know, I stepped into the fire a couple times,

528

00:37:26,000 --> 00:37:36,000

and I'm not crazy enough that I wouldn't aware.

529

00:37:36,000 --> 00:37:41,000

But I'll tell you, I could close my eyes or look in a different direction

530

00:37:41,000 --> 00:37:44,000

or forget about them and turn around and they'll still be there.

531

00:37:44,000 --> 00:37:45,000

Okay.

532

00:37:45,000 --> 00:37:49,000

You know, I thought maybe you're seeing things.

533

00:37:49,000 --> 00:37:53,000

So, you know, the best way to do it is you think you're seeing things.

534

00:37:53,000 --> 00:37:55,000

Just don't look at it anymore.

535

00:37:55,000 --> 00:37:56,000

Right.

536

00:37:56,000 --> 00:37:57,000

Think about something else.

537

00:37:57,000 --> 00:37:58,000

Right.

538

00:37:58,000 --> 00:38:07,000

And so, I looked at it, went back there and started screaming and whistling and yelling

539

00:38:07,000 --> 00:38:11,000

and screaming, hollering and hailing and everything else.

540

00:38:11,000 --> 00:38:16,000

And turn around, they're still there.

541

00:38:16,000 --> 00:38:17,000

Okay.

542

00:38:17,000 --> 00:38:20,000

Now, the last object to leave, you've got a good look at that.

543

00:38:20,000 --> 00:38:22,000

Was it partial daylight then?

544

00:38:22,000 --> 00:38:23,000

Yeah.

545

00:38:23,000 --> 00:38:24,000

Okay.

546

00:38:24,000 --> 00:38:29,000

Now, in your opinion, would that object be metallic?

547

00:38:29,000 --> 00:38:34,000

With the scope, okay.

Okay.

If you looked at it in, your eye started spot.

712

Okay.

Now, did wild labor all on the ground during the night?

722

00:48:47,000 --> 00:48:53,000

Were they all maintaining about the same color and same intensity of light at all times?

723

No.

724

00:48:54,000 --> 00:48:55,000

No.

725

00:48:55,000 --> 00:48:56,000

No.

726

00:48:56,000 --> 00:49:01,000

Now, they'd run this big scan and light.

727

00:49:01,000 --> 00:49:04,000

Each one would run that scan and light.

728

00:49:04,000 --> 00:49:09,000

But they'd only run that scan and light for about two, three hours.

729

00:49:09,000 --> 00:49:16,000

And then they would turn that thing off, and sometimes you wouldn't even see the other

730

00:49:16,000 --> 00:49:20,000

shift, or maybe just one little light on the shift.

731

00:49:20,000 --> 00:49:21,000

Yes.

732

And the light was on the outside.

733

I could not see it.

734

I wouldn't even see the landing light unless that man turned them on, or whoever he was.

735

Yes.

But the best one I got to look at was the one that shot the beam from the top in the sky,

737

evidently, where the beam come down.

Now, that's the best one I got to look at, because he was directly in front of me.

Now, that beam that came down from that light, what is that one that came right to the ground?

No.

It went in, it stopped on top of the shift.

743

That's the object, okay.

744

00:50:04,000 --> 00:50:09,000

In other words, there was two running from that vehicle up to the one in the sky.

745

Yeah.

746

Okay.

747

Now, all of these objects that were sitting on the ground, were they all sitting up on

748

there, or standing, or parked, or whatever, on their side?

749

No.

750

00:50:18,000 --> 00:50:20,000

They were laying on their belly.

751

Flat, yeah.

Okay.

754

I could not see no landing gear on the ground.

755

Now, when they took off, did they rise off of the ground a little bit before they turned

756

up on edge?

757

Yeah.

758

Okay.

759

00:50:33,000 --> 00:50:38,000

They were totally suspended in there when he was on his side.

760

And the edge almost went on the ground.

761

He laid right on his edge, and then he just moved up.

762

Okay.

I have an empty gun, and I don't think the loaded gun is anything good.

828

If they got that kind of engine, I'm sure they'll know a lot about it.

Yes, I guess they do.
