He gave us a direction from where he saw, which is pretty close to where we're at right now.

So we looked out through our back door window, which is just about due west.

It's bright light.

It looks like, you know, it would be one of the bright stars like the North Star, except

that it's in the wrong area.

Okay.

So we told him we saw it too.

84

I called the Nevada Police Department here and informed that, informed my mobile unit

He told me he had a person with him at that time who had seen it move from Oakland up to

Okay, but what time did you spot that?

It was reported to us, oh, I'd say about 10 minutes to 7 hour time.

It's a brilliant white light and it got brighter a couple of times, you know, like it was coming

103

And then it started fading back out.

Okay, how's the sky conditions there tonight?

The sky conditions seem to be fairly clear.

108

I saw one airplane tonight that is falling between me and the subject.

I saw the same airplane flying, I know, as I would be looking towards this object to the left

110

and below it.

And I was just down my front yard where I could get a better view of it, trying to get a picture

And one of my friends called my attention to another object that was in the sky, which

I heard no noise from it, but I saw an equilation of lights and everything on that.
