And so it was really probably pretty well directly over Island Crossing which is about three miles away.

We have a high powered telescope and so I sided it in and as I was looking at it it was coming closer to me

and that's when I woke everybody up I was really excited.

And I got close enough to me where we could see the bottom of the ship turning.

You know you could see the reflection of the lights that were in the center of the sphere.

They were shining on the bottom of the ship and you could see it actually making a revolution.

First what it did is the lights, the assembly of lights first of all would turn a brilliant red.

Then they would go to a brilliant green and then they would go to a beautiful gold color and they would alternate like that.

And then after I saw that one there was a smaller one that was below it.

I can't give you a feed. It was quite a distance away you know but we could see it and it was doing the same thing.

It seemed to be, although they were about the same distance away, the first one that we saw was higher in the air, quite a bit higher than the other one.

Like they would play with one another would switch positions you know and they would make like 90 degree angles and dart across the sky at a super high rate of speed.

And then about after, I would say around two and a half hours the smaller ship left and it left pretty abruptly.

And then the larger ship, well the last sighting we saw but it was moving very very slow and it came down in elevation probably about 500 feet something like that.

And then it just sort of very very slowly just drifted off into the sense that it took about, oh I don't know, I would say probably two hours to disappear.

So we saw the bigger ship. We saw it for almost four hours.

Now the first one was the biggest one right?

Which direction was it approaching from?

It would be coming from the west to the east.

Now do you feel that it got quite close?

Um, I would say probably within less than a mile from our house.

Now the only thing that you could see on this was the lights.

The light assembly and then it got close enough with the telescope that we could see the reflection of the bottom of the ship making it through evolution.

Okay.

You feel that this reflection was coming from the lights on the ship?

40

Yeah.

So that's what it looked like to us.

Okay.

But could you see a definite outline to this object?

Yeah, you could.

It got close enough in the telescope, not with the naked eye but in the telescope that you could actually see that there was more like it.

46

It wasn't really, it was a very flat type thing really.

47

00:03:28,000 --> 00:03:32,000

But there was a definite dome on the top and on the bottom.

48

00:03:32,000 --> 00:03:34,000

I mean it wasn't just a flat line, you know.

49

00:03:34,000 --> 00:03:36,000

I mean there was a little bit of curvature.

50

00:03:36,000 --> 00:03:43,000

You could also tell too with the assembly that, the light assembly that went around the center of it, that it started to turn, you know.

51

I mean to look like that it was round.

52

00:03:46,000 --> 00:03:52,000

I mean I can't say for positive that it was round but it looked like to us that it was round and very, very flat.

53

Okay now would that, the thinnest part be shaped somewhat like a lens?

54

Well, let's see, how can I explain it?

55

It's like if you take two fosters, you know, a little cup of fosters and you tip them upside down to each other.

56

Rim to rim?

57

00:04:08,000 --> 00:04:09,000

Rim to rim.

58

00:04:09,000 --> 00:04:10,000

Okay.

59

00:04:10,000 --> 00:04:11,000

That's what it looked like.

60

And then the dome on top and the dome on the bottom.

61

And they were, like the top of the ship really didn't look to me like it was any, any higher than the bottom of the ship.

62

It just looked like it was just equal.

63

Okay.

Now I know this is a difficult question.

Or if you were holding a ruler up at arms length, could you determine its width?

It would probably have been at the closest point, maybe a quarter of an inch.

You know, as when, excuse me, that was the, of the biggest ship, the closest point.

And then the further it pointed, of course it was, you know, a minute amount of level or a measure.

It was just really tiny.

But of course in the telescope then it was, it was a lot larger, of course.

Now scoping in on these other two objects, did you get any good look at those or was it just the lighted?

No, well they, what, now the smaller, see there were only two of them.

Now there was the larger ship, the one that I first had seen.

Okay.

And then the smaller one.

The reason I say it smaller is because maybe it was further away in distance.

But it looked to me as though it were smaller because they seemed to be the same distance away.

But it could have been further, you know, further to the west.

86

And then I would have, you know, and also I didn't have my glasses on.

I wear glasses, my eyes aren't, you know, really all that bad.

But I didn't have my glasses on and looking at, with my naked eye, it looked to me as though they were the same distance away.

But this one seemed smaller and it had the same, they had the same lighting.

91

In other words, it would turn the red and then the green and then the gold that the assembly did.

It never got close enough to us to actually see the revolution turning.

93

Okay.

And you observed both of these objects on the move, moving across the sky doing these fairer, you know.

In their movements in the sky, was it, did these movements carry or cover quite a distance?

115

It's really hard to say, probably, yeah, they did.

116

Maybe a quarter of a mile, half a mile at, you know, when they would move they would dart like.

117

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:37,000

I see, okay.

118

00:07:37,000 --> 00:07:41,000

In other words, there was no question in your mind that they were moving around in the sky.

119

00:07:41,000 --> 00:07:42,000

No, absolutely not.

120

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:43,000

Okay.

121

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:50,000

In fact, I wanted to be sure of myself so, you know, I asked others and then they, you know, they, they thought too.

122

Okay.

123

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:55,000

Did they maintain about the same color patterns all through this site?

124

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:56,000

Yeah, yeah, they did.

125

00:07:56,000 --> 00:07:57,000

Okay.

126

00:07:59,000 --> 00:08:04,000

It kind of gave me the feeling, you know, with seeing them, you know, lit up like that.

127

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:12,000

It kind of gave me the feeling maybe they might, you know, be approaching one of land or something because it seemed like, you know, the way, when you, when you know, like at night,

128

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:18,000

when you see the airplanes coming in for landing and they have all these lights on them and, you know, they flash all this stuff.

129

00:08:18,000 --> 00:08:20,000

Well, this is what I kind of was thinking.

130

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:24,000

And I would, in fact, I was kind of hoping they would land, but they didn't.

131

00:08:24,000 --> 00:08:25,000

Okay.

132

00:08:25,000 --> 00:08:28,000

They never, never disappeared from the skyline.

133

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:37,000

And we live on a cliff and then there's really high trees that are below our cliff that come up, but it was, they were pretty high up in the air because otherwise I wouldn't have been able to see them.

134

Okay.

135

00:08:39,000 --> 00:08:45,000

We would have really wanted to take a picture of them, but we didn't have a camera that we felt, you know, that would be acceptable for a picture.

We just have, you know, inexpensive, insomniacs, that kind of thing.

Okay.

140

Oh, my sister gave it to me because she had been talking about your organization and so I thought, well, who should I call?
