It's too high to be a bluer ship.

I called the Coast Guard the first evening.

The Coast Guard sent a lifeboat out to see what it might be to have no explanation for it.

They unofficially felt that it might be a UFO also.

That would be the Grace Harbor Coast Guard.

Yes.

It appears very, very brilliant in red, prior red like a signal type red, red light.

I guess you're like a quarter of a star red light.

And it also has white flashing lights on it.

Long enough that the Coast Guard sent their motor life boat out to see if maybe somebody was in trouble.

Well, they quit, they just don't understand what the hell it is.

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00:04:06,000 --> 00:04:08,000

They said, man, we don't know.

We don't have no explanation for it.

Okay, how long was it visible?

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00:04:13,000 --> 00:04:14,000

Huh?

How long was it visible tonight?

Well, when we first saw it this evening, oh, I'd say 15 minutes.
