I've talked to the sheriff about it.

I was scared out of my wits.

It was after Shashone, it was between the ice cave, well, on this side of the ice cave,

about a mile-walker between, I think it's about nine, eight or nine, six.

8

But it was after the ice cave, and it was right after the last railroad track that he crawls before he came into Bellevue.

9

And there was a dense fog, real dense, and I was going about 45 miles an hour.

10

And after I hit the last railroad track, I felt this pain.

You know, like, I thought it was my tire hitting, you know, some ice on the road.

Yes.

13

00:01:17,000 --> 00:01:26,000

And all of a sudden, I heard this kind of a whirling noise over my car, and I saw these red lights,

I mean, red lights, like, all around, like on the hood, you know, like a reflection.

15

Yes.

00:01:33,000 --> 00:01:41,000

And also on the ground, as I was moving, and the inside of my car felt like it was 100 degrees.

And this happened on three different occasions.

And you didn't see anything other than that?

19

00:01:47,000 --> 00:01:48,000

That's all.

20

But it secured the shit out of me.

Okay, about what time did the first incident happen?

22

00:01:55,000 --> 00:02:01,000

It started, the first one I noticed was about ten minutes or two.

And I have a CB radio in my car, and right after that happened, it stunned me for a minute.

24

00:02:08,000 --> 00:02:13,000

And then the second one happened, and then the third one happened.

25

00:02:13,000 --> 00:02:21,000

And then I got on my CB and started calling the sheriff in Bellevue, and I started giving the mile markers out.

I think about 100, and they could hear me at 104.

27

Okay.

00:02:32,000 --> 00:02:36,000

Did you have any problems with the car every time this happened?

29

00:02:36,000 --> 00:02:37,000

What do you mean?

30

00:02:37,000 --> 00:02:40,000

Any engine problems or any electrical problems?

31

No, not that I know of.

32

00:02:42,000 --> 00:02:48,000

It was too dark, I was going to check the top of the car to see if it was burnt.

33

Anyway.

Okay.

00:02:52,000 --> 00:02:55,000

How about physical?

36

It secured the hell out of me.

Did you feel any tingling or anything?

Yeah, I felt tingling, my hair stood on edge.

I mean, I had my hat off, and my hair just stood straight up.

I have short hair, or relatively short.

41

I stood straight up, and my dog, I have a German Shepherd, and my dog was asleep at the time prior to the happening, and she started whimpering.

Okay.

00:03:26,000 --> 00:03:29,000

Did you have any problems with that CB radio?

44

00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:36,000

Well, they couldn't understand me until mile marker 104.

45

Okay.

46

00:03:38,000 --> 00:03:40,000

Did you have your car radio playing?

47

00:03:40,000 --> 00:03:41,000

No.

48

00:03:41,000 --> 00:03:43,000

Okay.

49

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:47,000

Was this light strong enough to illuminate the ground around you?

50

00:03:47,000 --> 00:03:48,000

Yes.

51

00:03:48,000 --> 00:03:50,000

How about the inside of the car?

52

00:03:50,000 --> 00:03:52,000

Yeah, the whole car just lit up.

53

00:03:52,000 --> 00:03:53,000

Okay.

54

00:03:53,000 --> 00:04:03,000

I mean, it felt like, I mean, my heater in my car doesn't work very well, and I was like, you know, kind of chilly.

55

00:04:03,000 --> 00:04:10,000

Yeah, because I was driving late at night, and it usually keeps you awake.

56

00:04:10,000 --> 00:04:19,000

And it just felt like, I mean, I started sweating, I started perspiring. It was so hot.

57

00:04:19,000 --> 00:04:23,000

Okay, and did all of this go back to normal as soon as these events quit?

58

00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:24,000

Right.

59

00:04:24,000 --> 00:04:27,000

Okay.

60

00:04:27,000 --> 00:04:42,000

And I talked to the sheriff of Bellevue, he met me at the entrance of Bellevue, plus a state trooper, plus, you know, some other policemen.

Yes.

00:04:43,000 --> 00:04:51,000

And they said, you know, they said they had other reporting such as this and told me to call this number.

I've lived here for three years.

69

And I've heard, you know, people out in like Trump reporting, you know, sightings or, you know, and people were there where I used to work.

Yes.

71

00:05:27,000 --> 00:05:31,000

There was a girl that, you know, was going down like towards Gannett.

72

It's awful Bellevue, the side road.

73

And, you know, she said she saw this thing in the middle of the road.

And so, I mean, she had to go to the doctor, you know, like Burke.

75

Uh-huh.

You know, this is in the paper here.

77

But I've lived here for three years.

78

And, you know, I didn't believe anything like this, but it happened to me.

Now you're a believer.

80

Yeah.

Now, I was, I mean, I was frightened to death.

82

I had a shotgun in my car, but I didn't have any shells.

83

And I was like, if I had some shells, I would have stopped.

Just whimpering.

85

00:06:06,000 --> 00:06:07,000

Right.

86

00:06:07,000 --> 00:06:08,000

I mean, it wasn't having a nightmare.

87

I think he was fully awake.

88

00:06:10,000 --> 00:06:13,000

I mean, like she was sitting up in the seat whimpering.

89

00:06:13,000 --> 00:06:14,000

Okay.

90

00:06:14,000 --> 00:06:19,000

Does this, does the dog usually, when it's alert to something, do any barking or aggressive?

91

Yeah.

92

00:06:20,000 --> 00:06:21,000

Yeah.

93

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:22,000

She's very aggressive.

94

00:06:22,000 --> 00:06:23,000

Okay.

95

Did it appear to be just opposite of being aggressive this time?

96

00:06:25,000 --> 00:06:27,000

Well, she, yeah, it was like she was scared.

97

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:28,000

Scared, right.

98

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:29,000

Okay.

99

00:06:29,000 --> 00:06:34,000

And you didn't see anything strange along the roadway as all this was?

100

Well, you know, I mean, it was like a dense, it was, I mean, it was a real bad fog.

And it was, you know, kind of misty, you know, the wind was blowing, you know, the snow was

blowing off, you know, it was kind of, you know, dripping like, and, you know, I was

just, I was looking, you know, off to the sides.

Now how approximately, how long did each event occur?

108

What was the duration of each event?

Probably 15 seconds.

Okay.

And what about, what time gap was there between that?

Oh, I'd say three minutes.

113

Okay.

Three or four minutes.

115

00:07:20,000 --> 00:07:24,000

And was it the light intensity and everything almost identical each time?

116

Right.

117

00:07:25,000 --> 00:07:26,000

Okay.

118

00:07:26,000 --> 00:07:31,000

Well, it got, it got, the first one was much brighter than the second one.

119

And the second one was much brighter than the third one.

120

00:07:34,000 --> 00:07:36,000

Oh, okay.

121

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:39,000

And did you hear the sound each time?

122

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:40,000

Yes.

123

00:07:40,000 --> 00:07:42,000

I mean, that's what scared me.

124

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:46,000

I mean, I was just, you know, petrified.

125

00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:48,000

And did you say this was kind of a humming sound?

126

00:07:48,000 --> 00:07:55,000

Well, it was like a, it was like a whirling sound.

127

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:56,000

Okay.

128

00:07:56,000 --> 00:08:01,000

But, you know, I'm trying to think of, you know, something that would sound like, you

129

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:10,000

know, when my, you know, my motor humming, you know, it sounded like something, something

130

00:08:10,000 --> 00:08:12,000

was directly above me.

131

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:13,000

Okay.

132

00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:20,000

And did this, was this a steady sound or was it up and down frequency or was it?

133

00:08:20,000 --> 00:08:22,000

No, it was a steady.

134

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:23,000

Continuous.

135

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:24,000

Continuous.

136

00:08:24,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Okay.

137

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:34,000

And after each event, you said your hair stood on end and you could feel this tingling after

138

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:35,000

each event.

139

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:38,000

Did this discontinue until the next time?

140

00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:40,000

Well, it continued.

141

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:46,000

And the first time, when it first happened, I was, you know, and then, I mean, I didn't

142

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:51,000

get over the first happening until the second one appeared.

143

00:08:51,000 --> 00:09:00,000

And, you know, that just created more tingling or it just made me much more scared.

144

00:09:00,000 --> 00:09:01,000

Yes.

145

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:05,000

And then, you know, and I didn't, I didn't get over until I got home.

146

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:06,000

Okay.

147

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:12,000

I mean, I looked, I looked, I looked myself in the mirror when I got home and I was white

148

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:14,000

as a sheep.

149

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:15,000

Okay.

150

00:09:15,000 --> 00:09:22,000

I'm still pretty, you know, shaky about it right now.

151

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:27,000

Do you have a tape deck or anything in the car?

152

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:28,000

No.

153

00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:29,000

Okay.

154

00:09:29,000 --> 00:09:31,000

Could we have your age, Mr.

155

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:32,000

29.

156

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:34,000

All right, sir.

157

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:37,000

Well, we sure appreciate this report and we'll get on this right away.

158

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:41,000

And if we come up with any additional information, why we'll get back to you and let you know

159

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:42,000

about it.

160

00:09:42,000 --> 00:09:43,000

I mean, I appreciate it.

161

00:09:43,000 --> 00:09:48,000

I just, you know, they just came in this phone number and told me, you know, to call it.

162

00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:49,000

Right.

163

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:52,000

Well, we sure appreciate it because this is the type of information we'd like to get.

164

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:56,000

Well, I just, you know, I have it never happens to me again.

165

You know, I mean, I was, I mean, I spent, you know, I was in Vietnam.

166

And but I was scared this time.

168

They really scared me.
